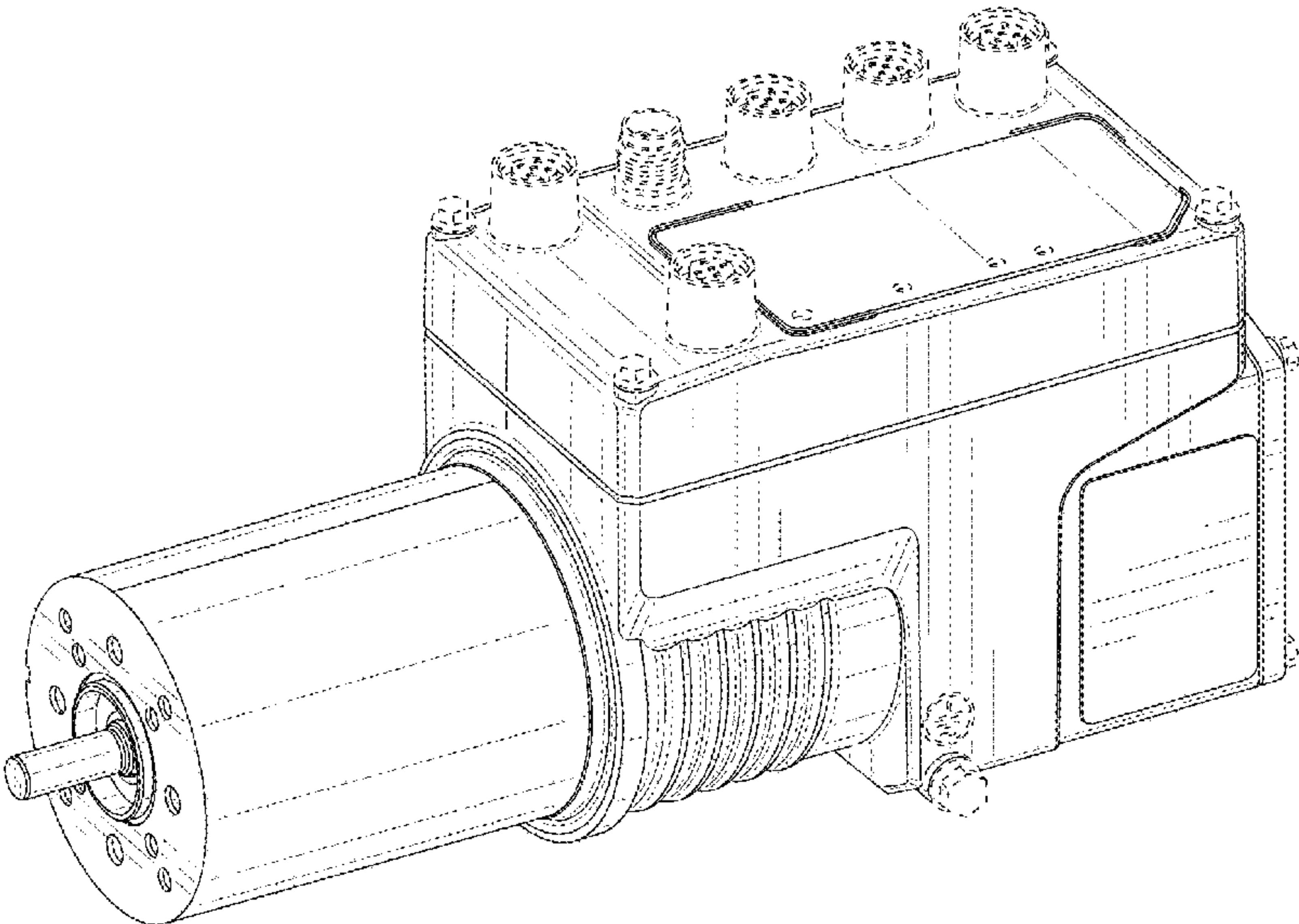

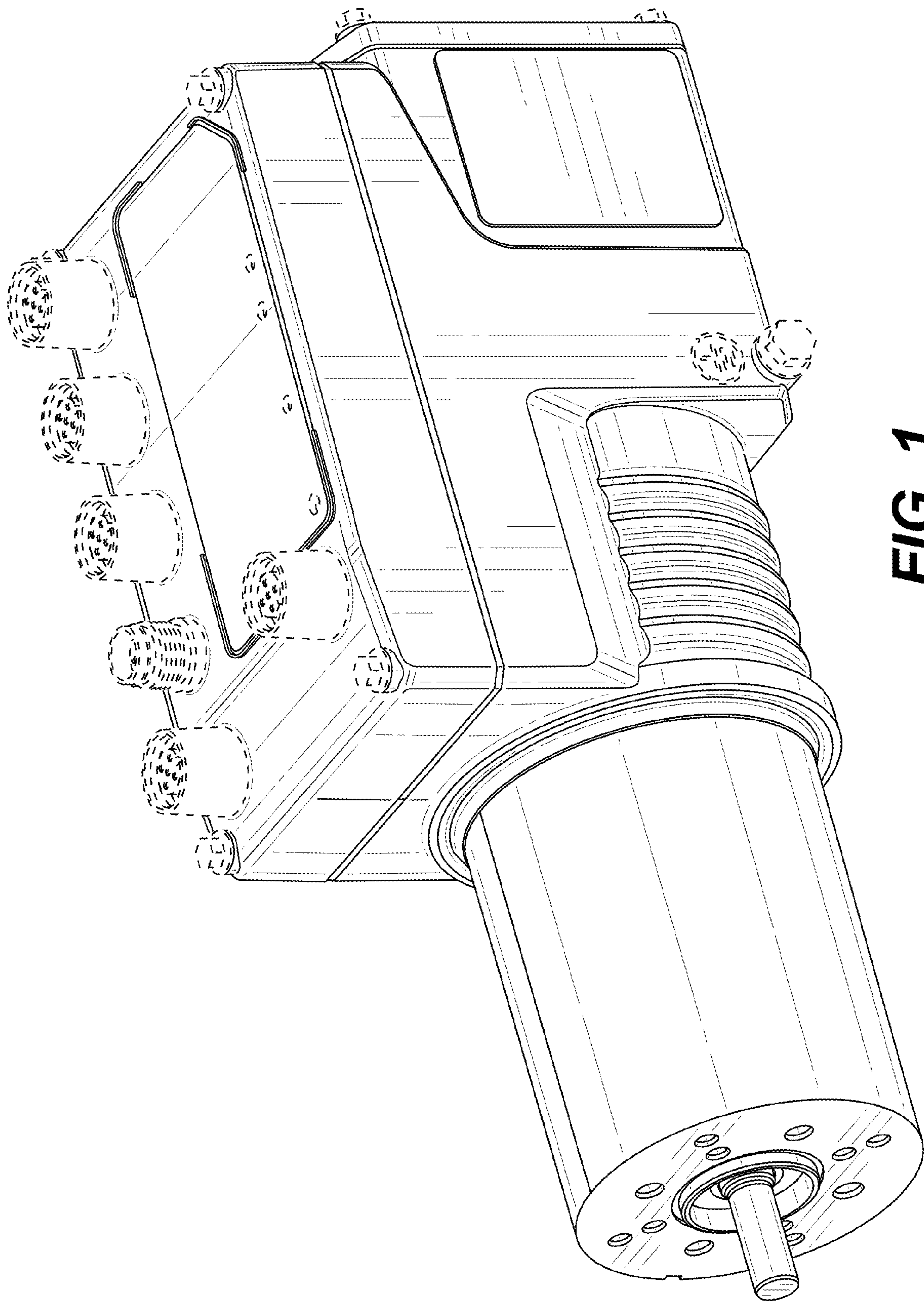
The ornamental design for an electric motor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, left perspective view of an electric motor, showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

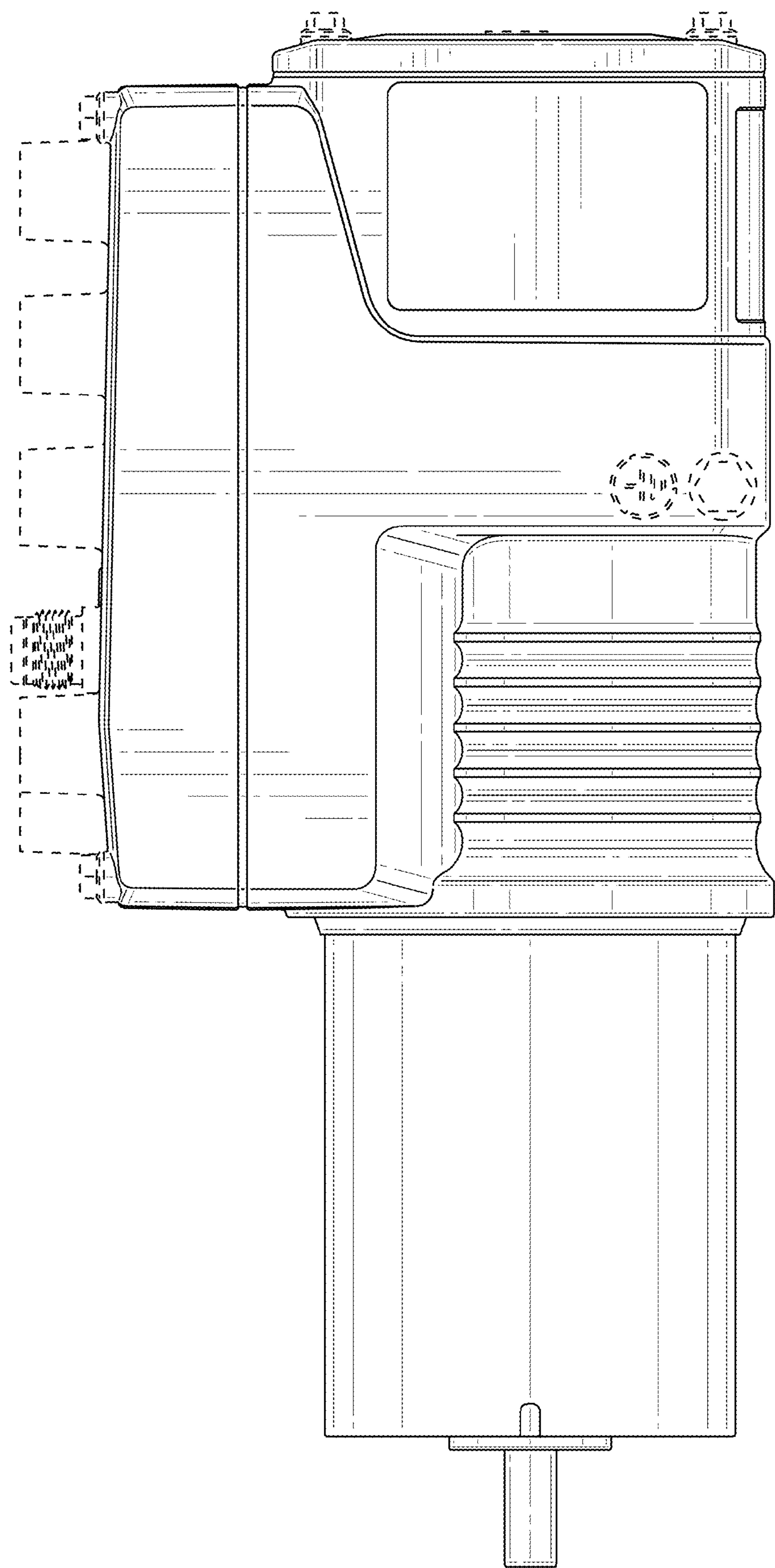

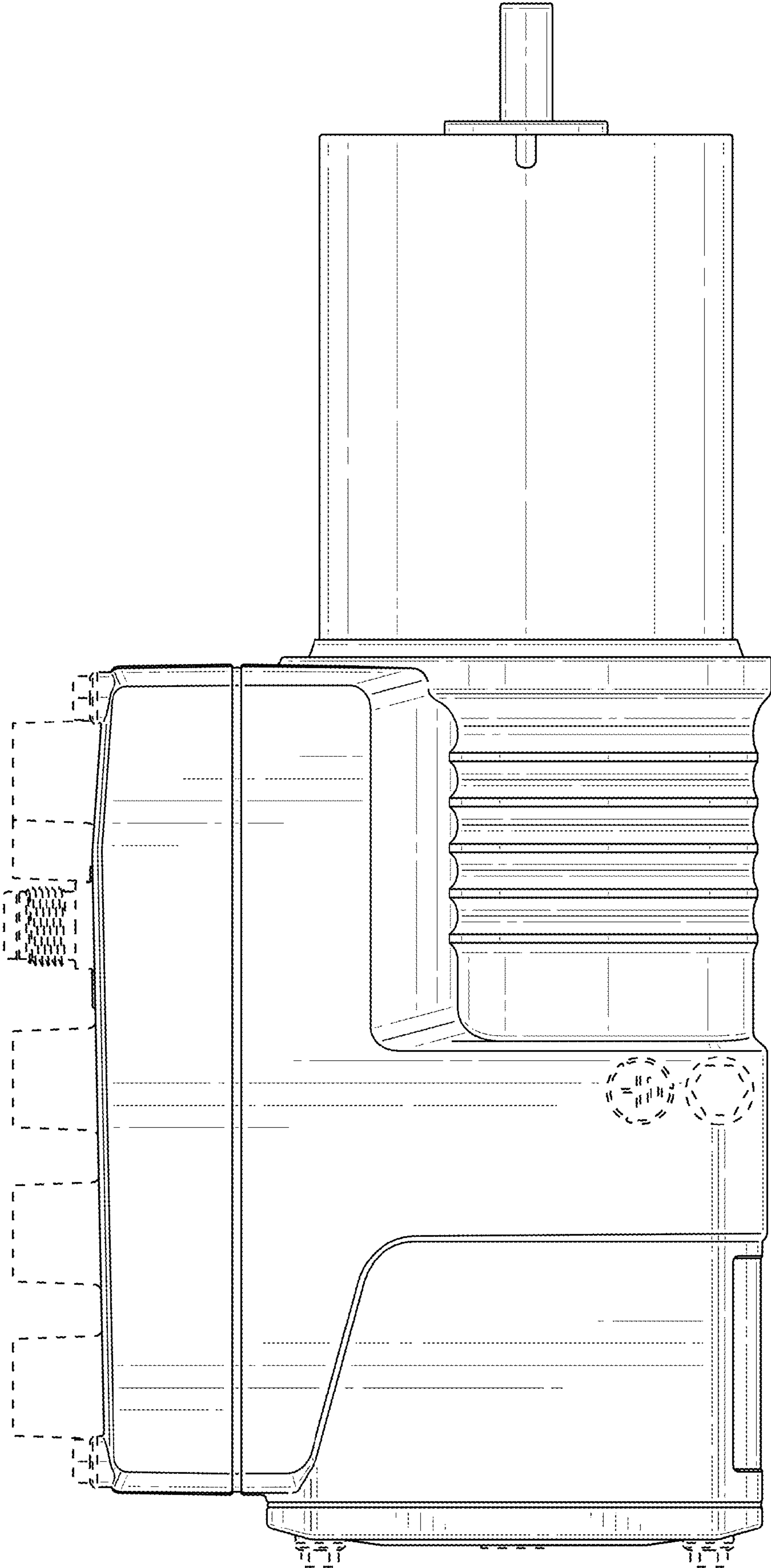

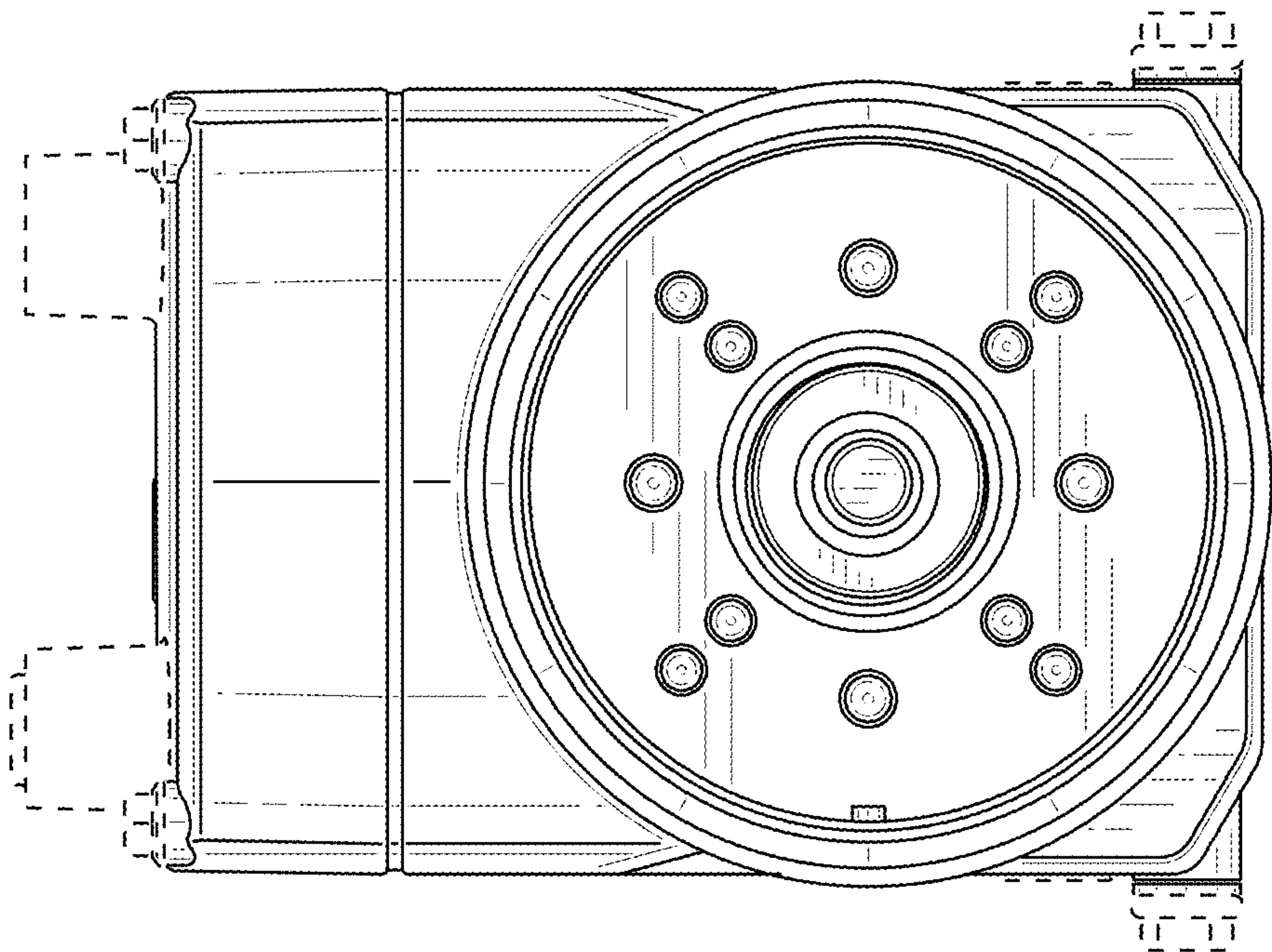

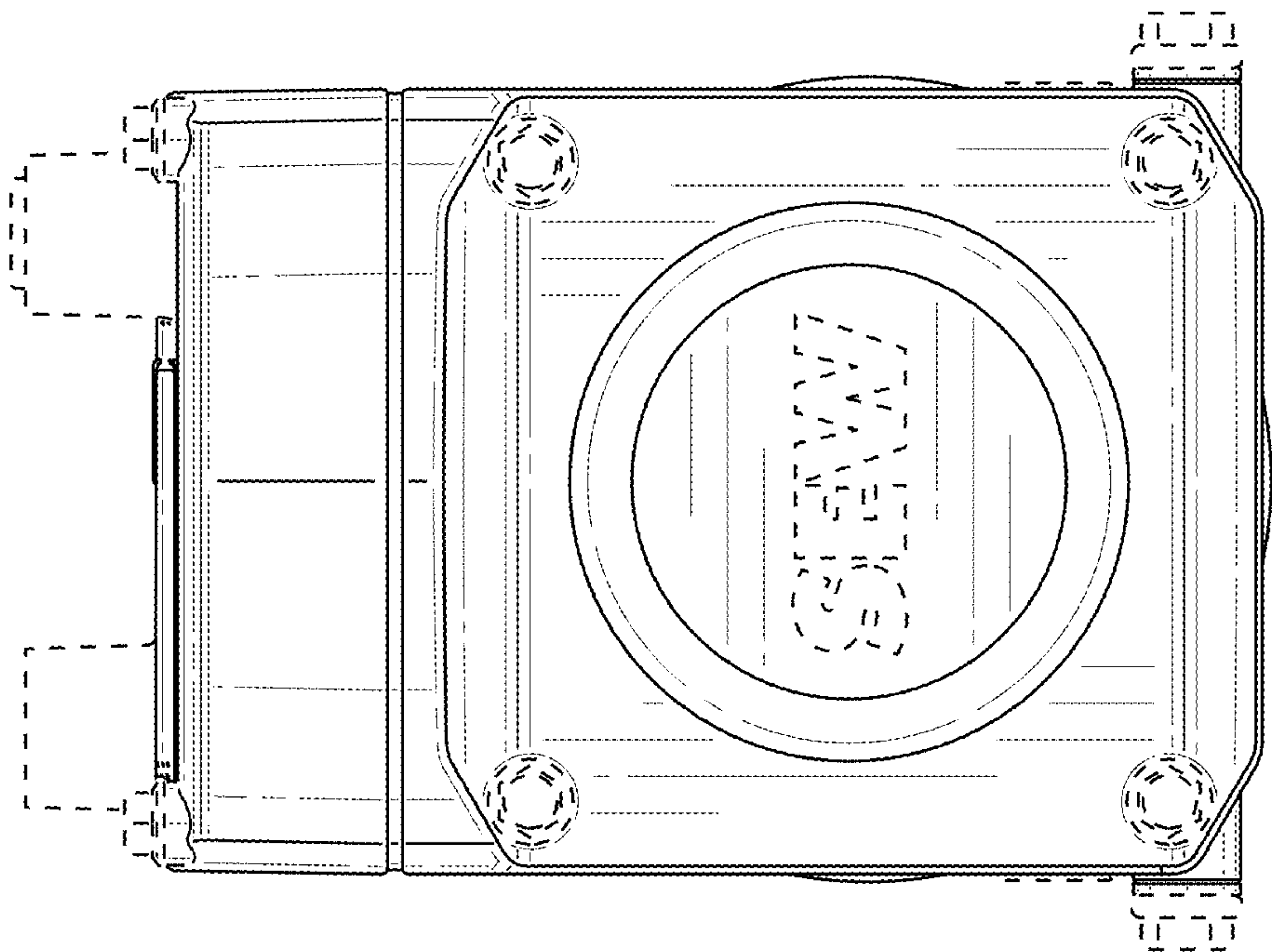

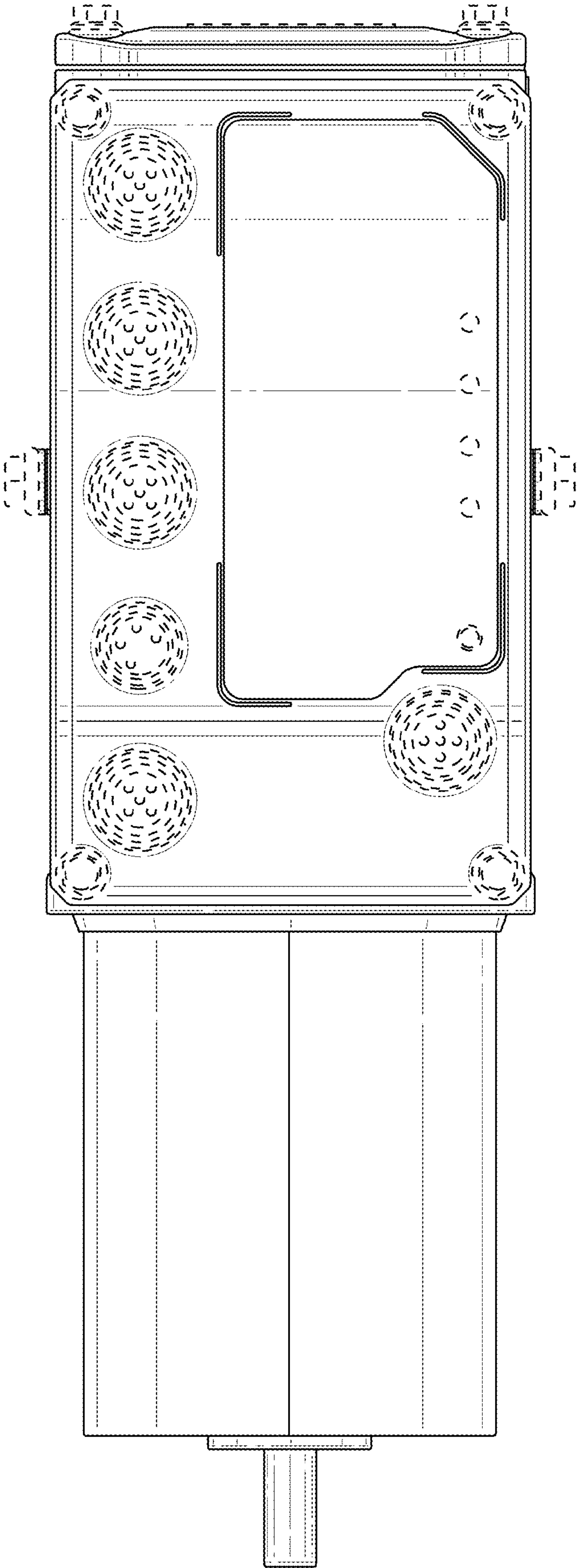

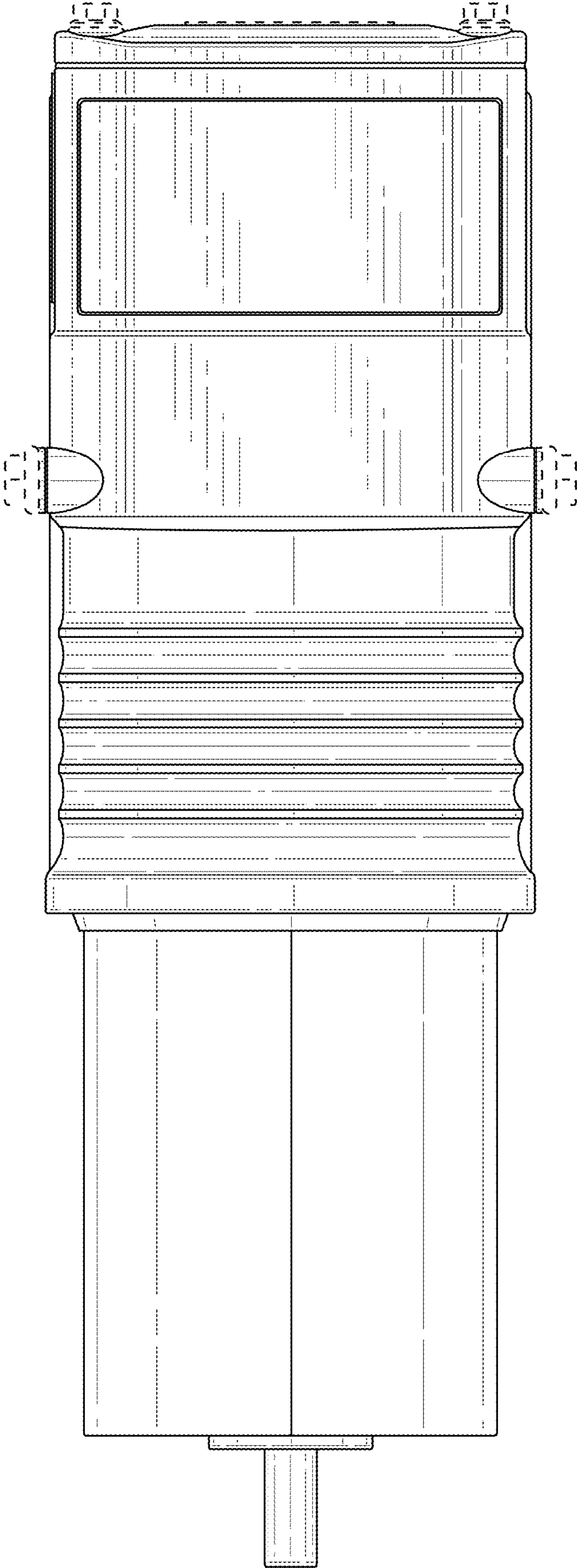
