DESCRIPTION

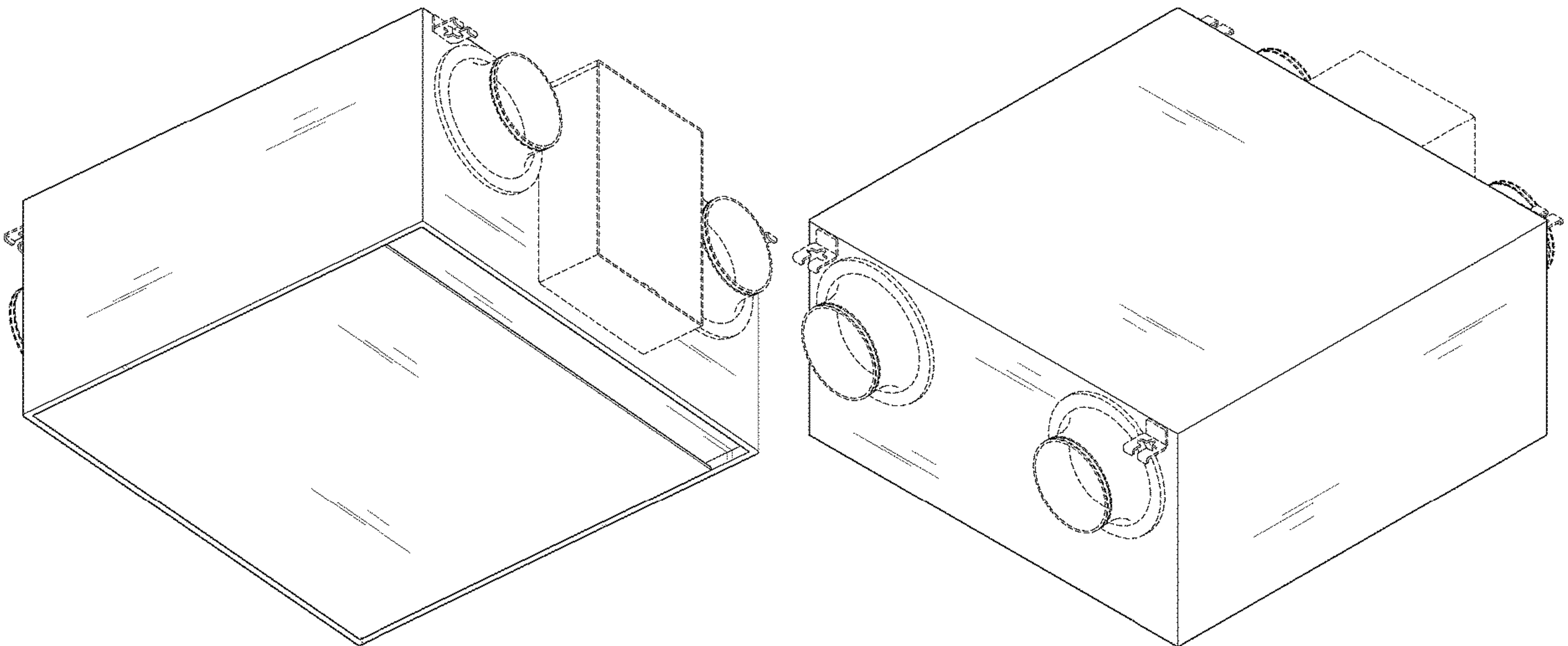

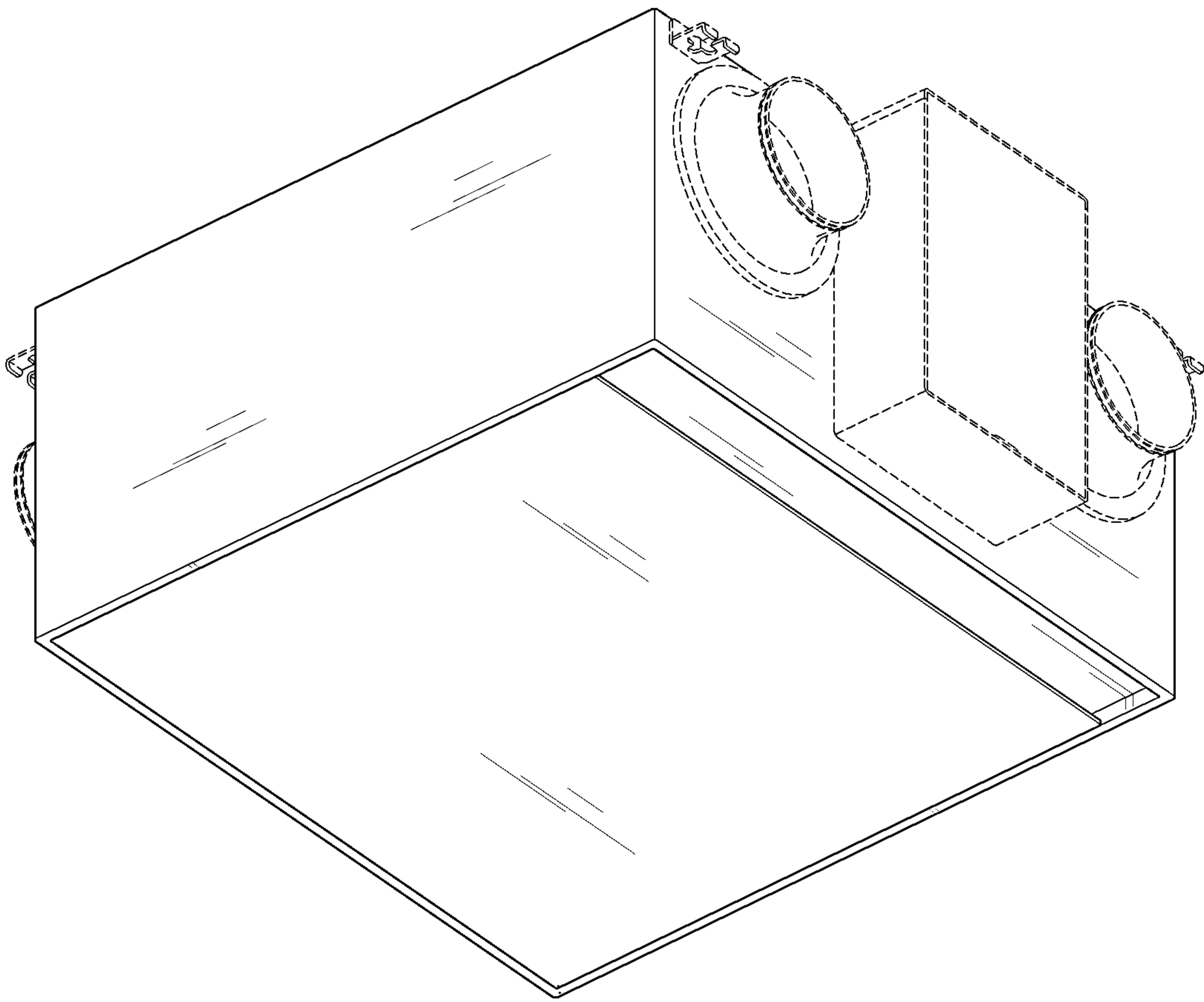

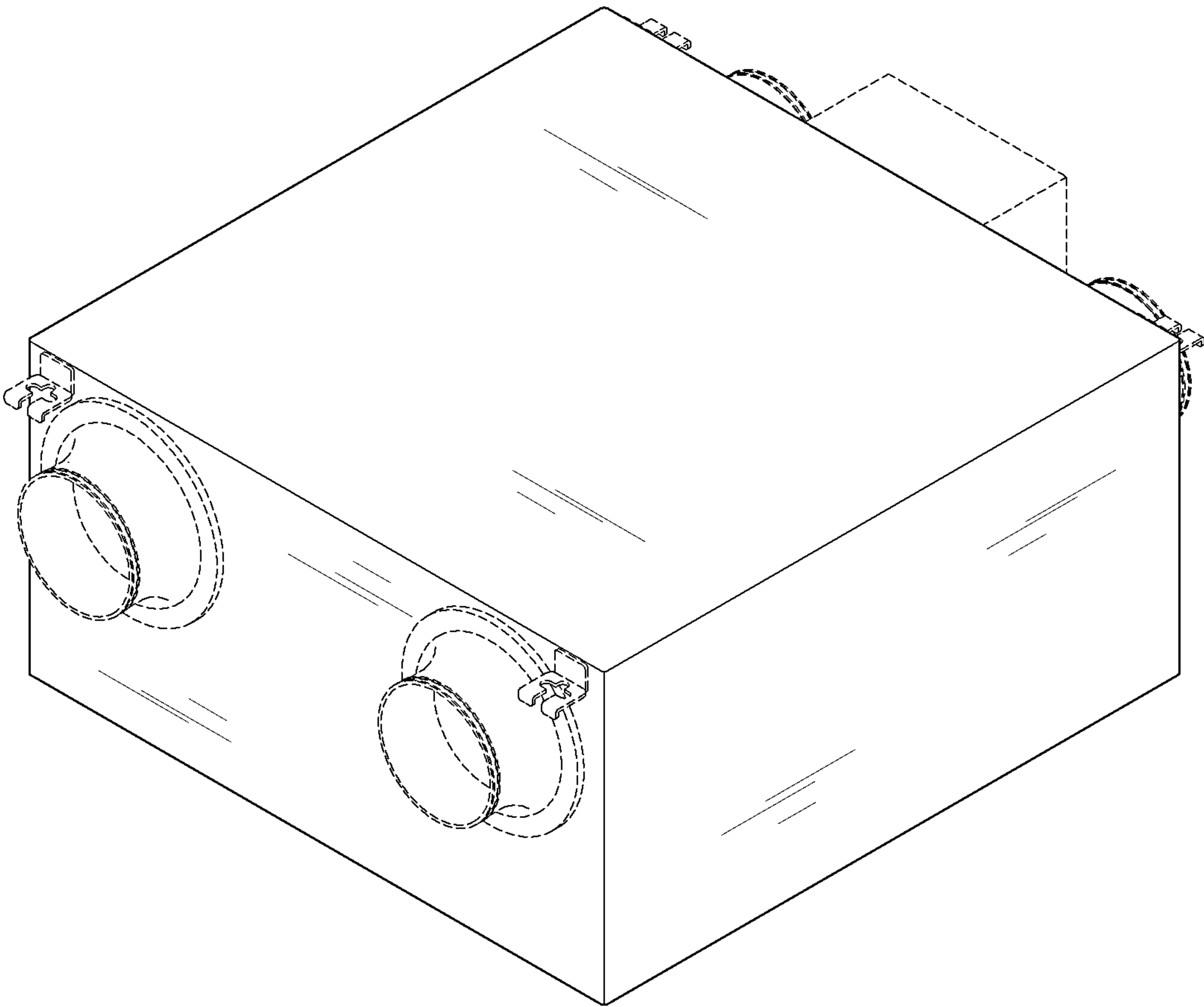

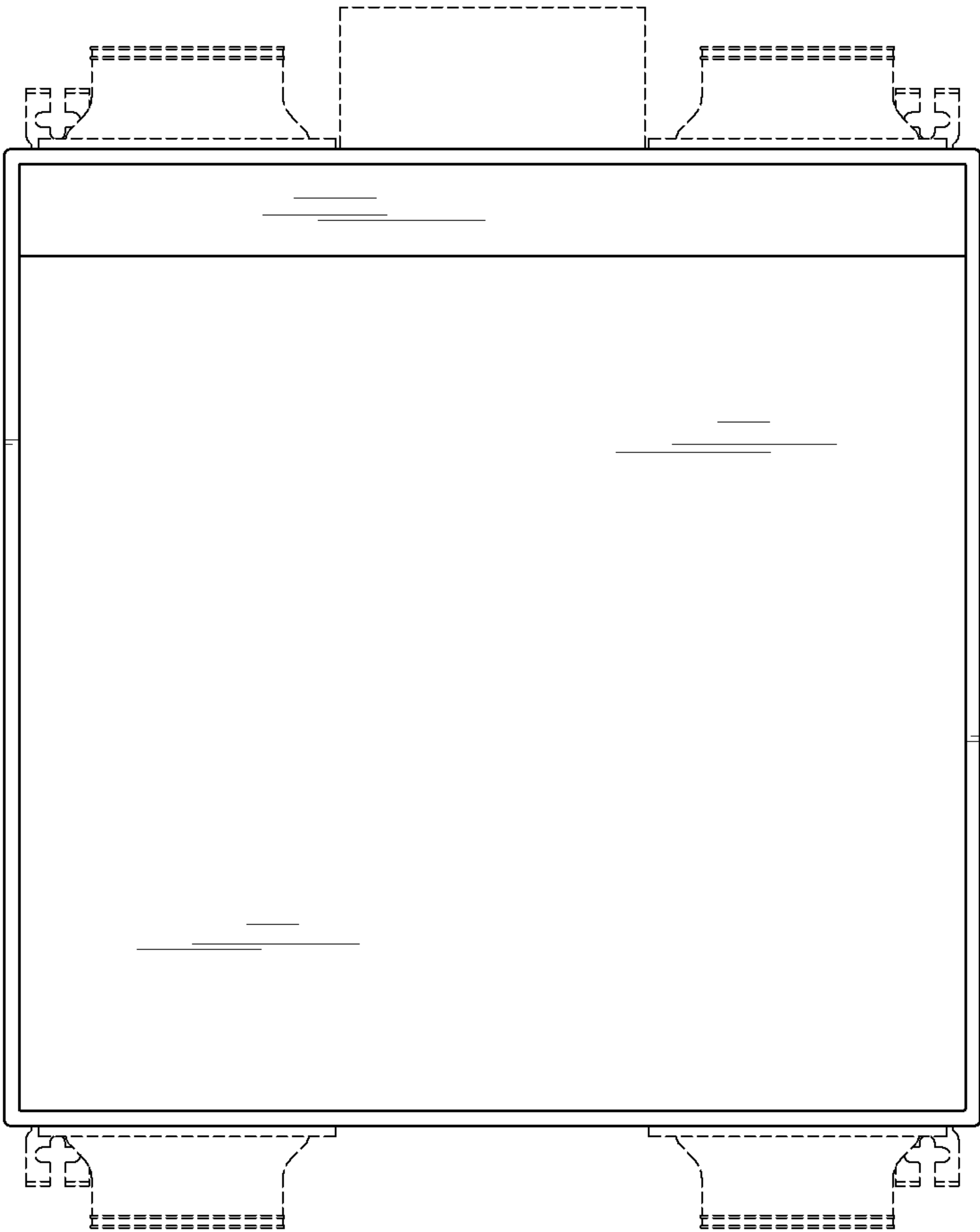

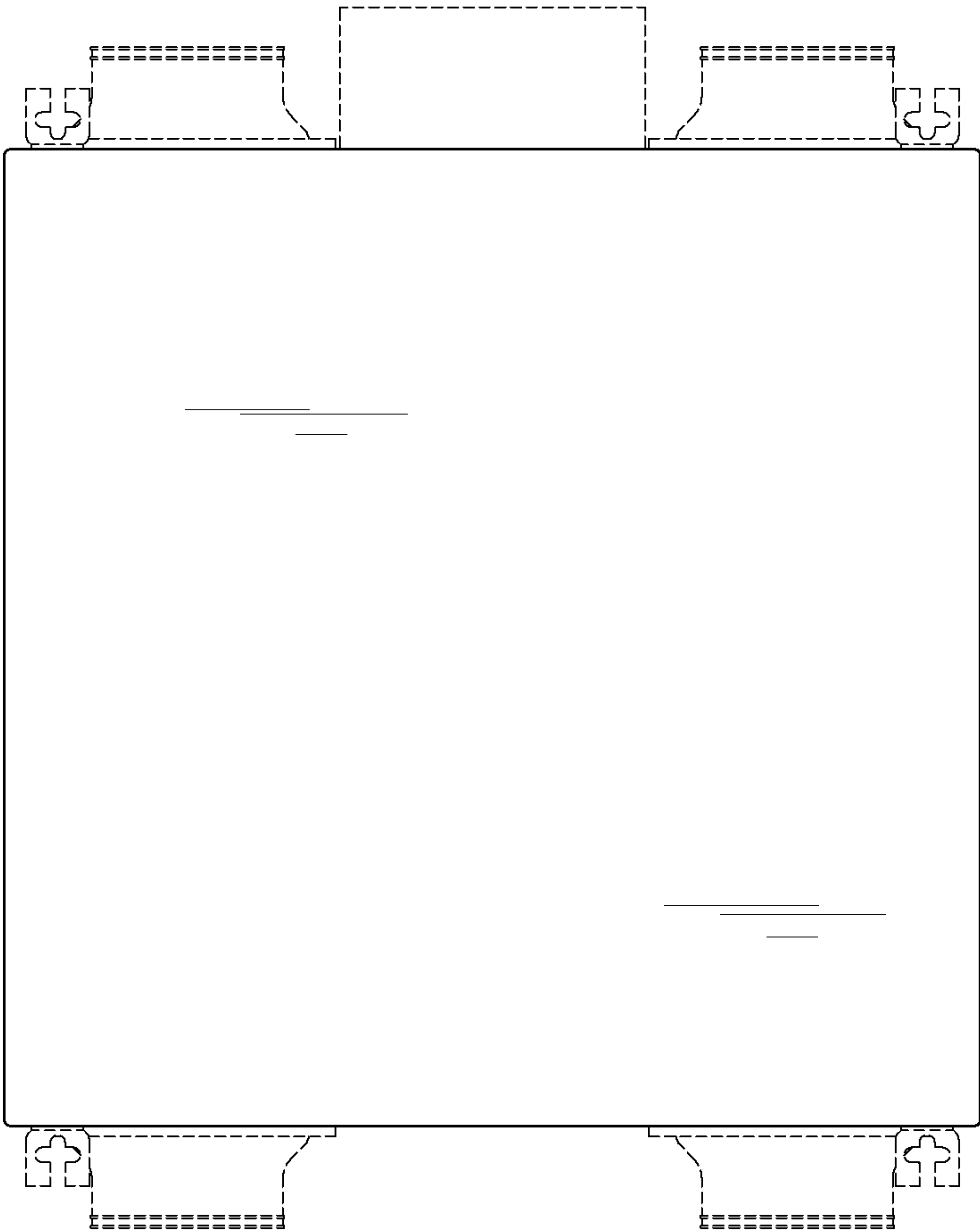

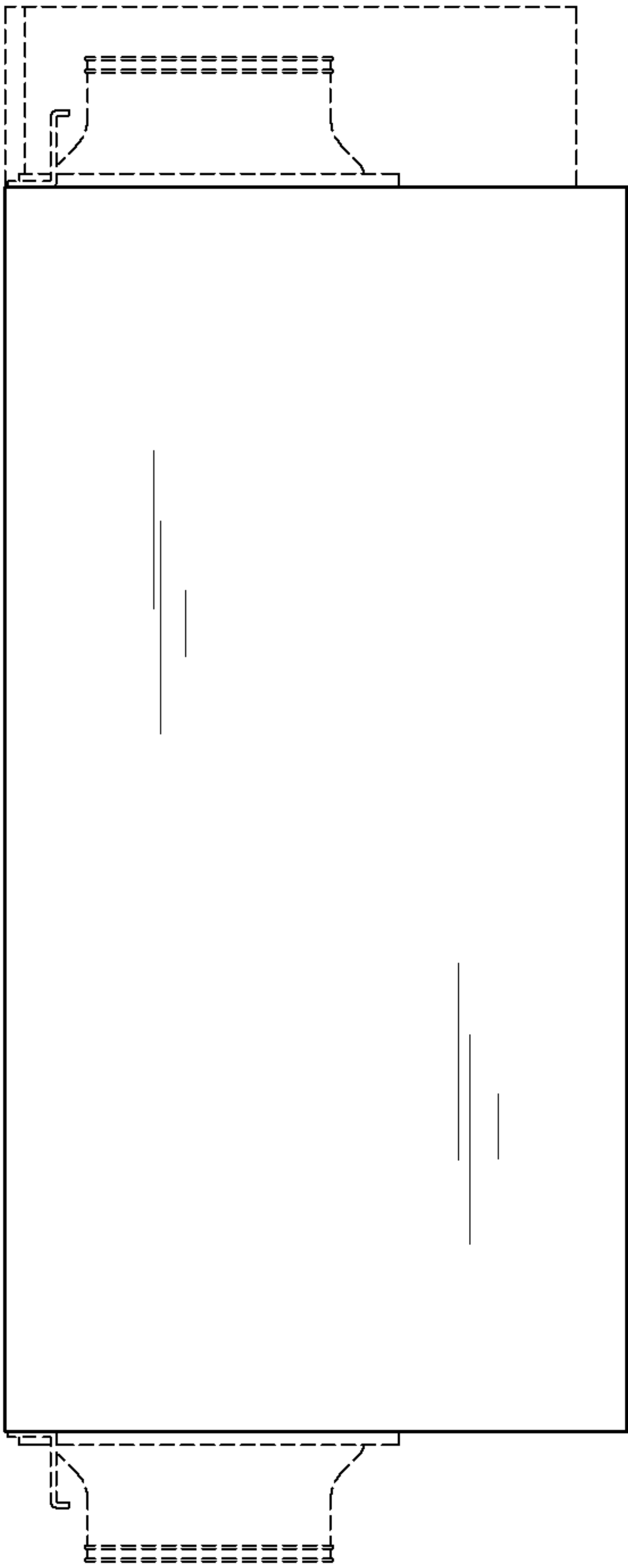

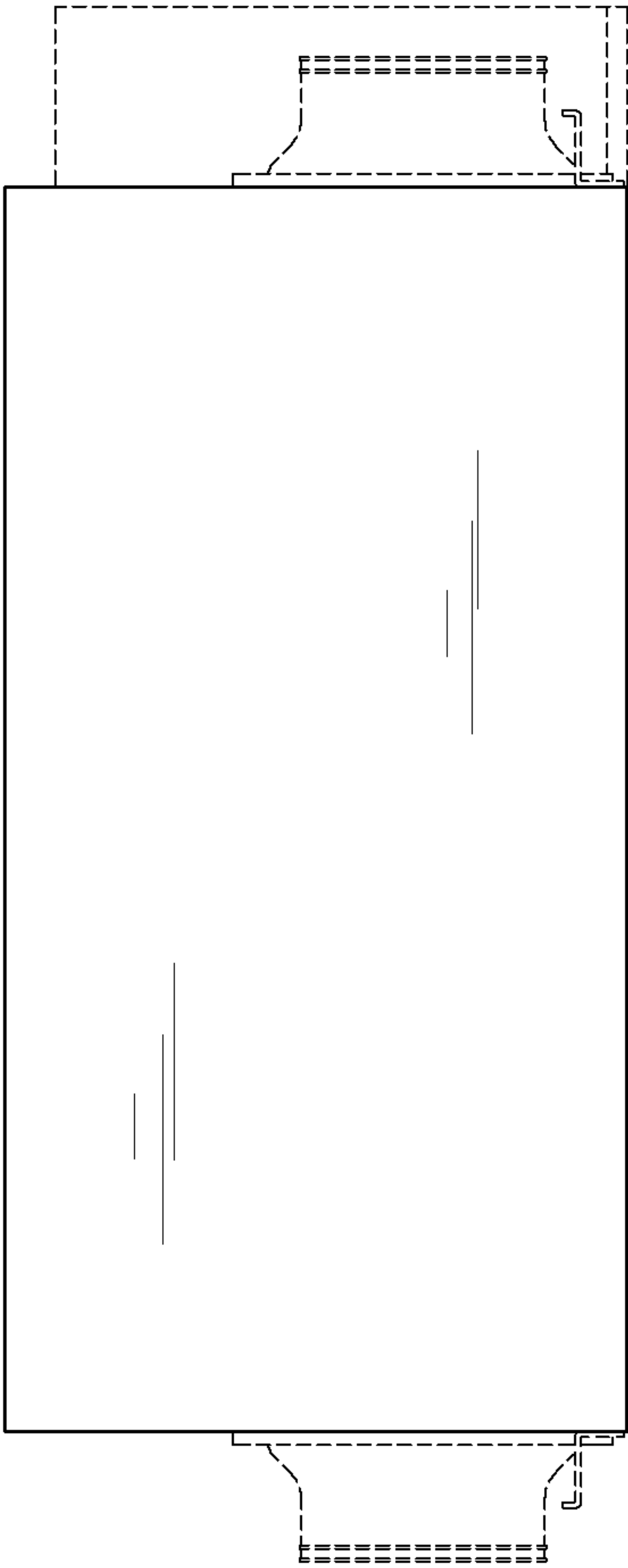

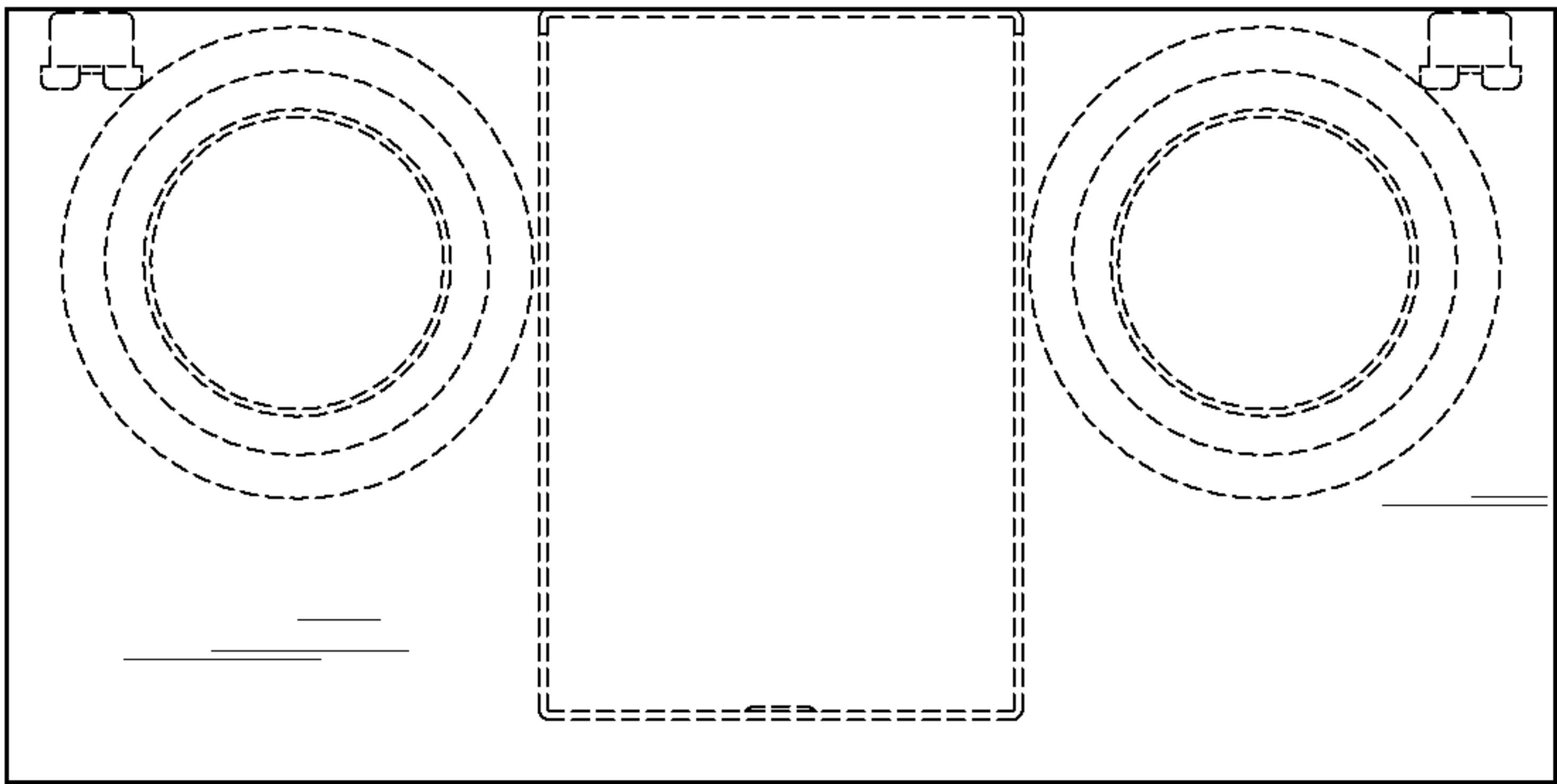
