FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the dispenser cartridge assembly showing the new design.

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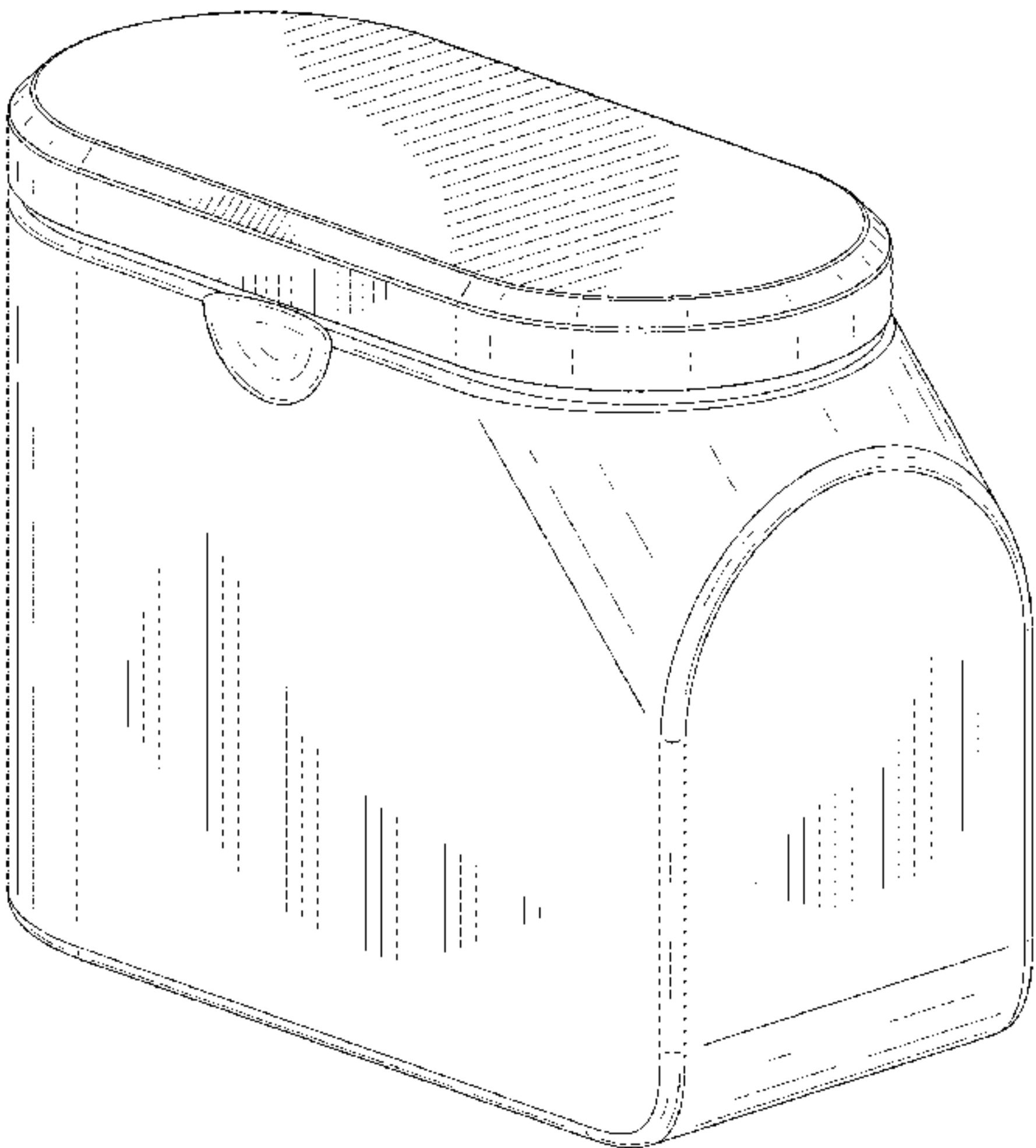


FIG. 4 is a left view of the dispenser cartridge assembly showing the new design.

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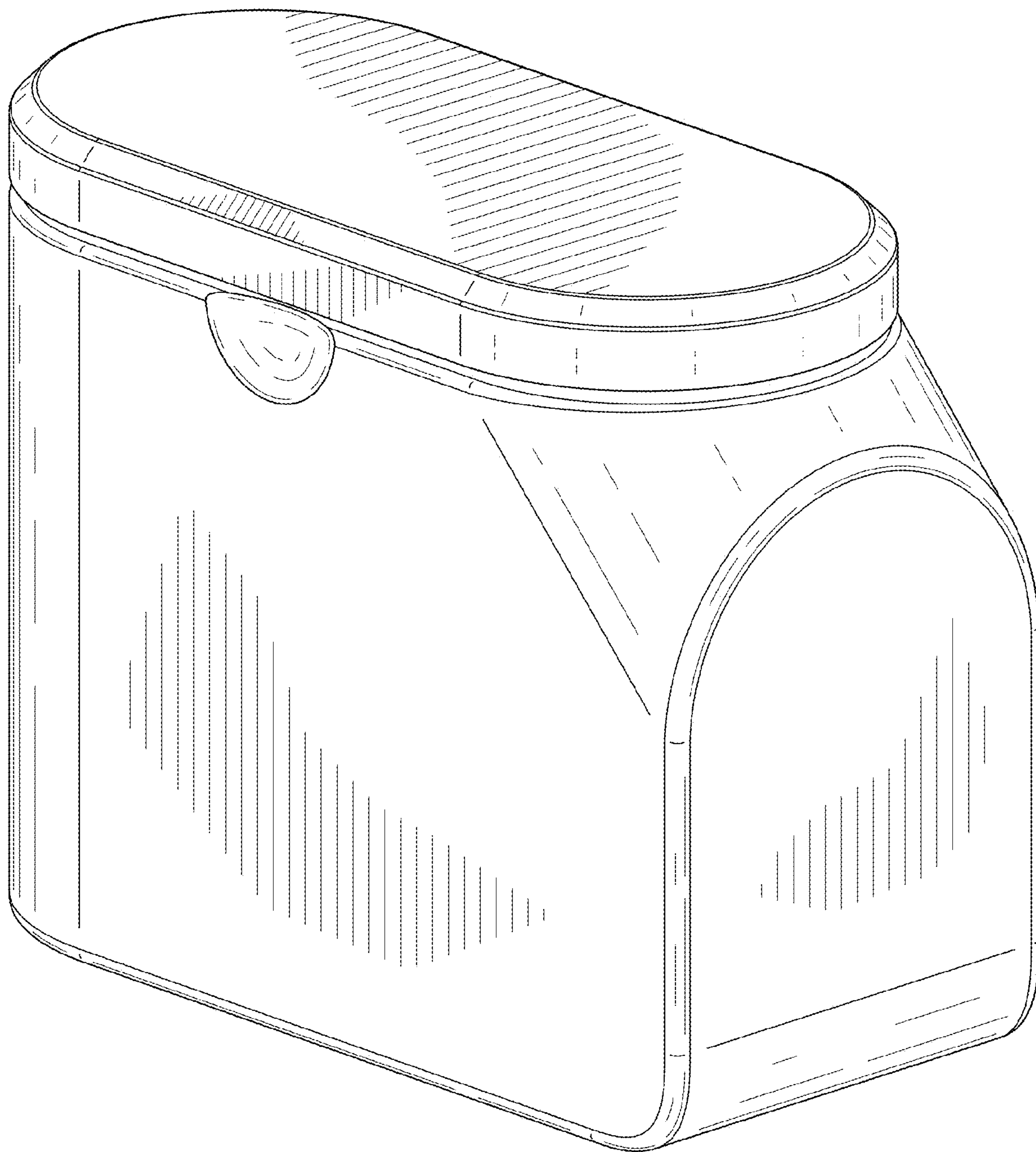

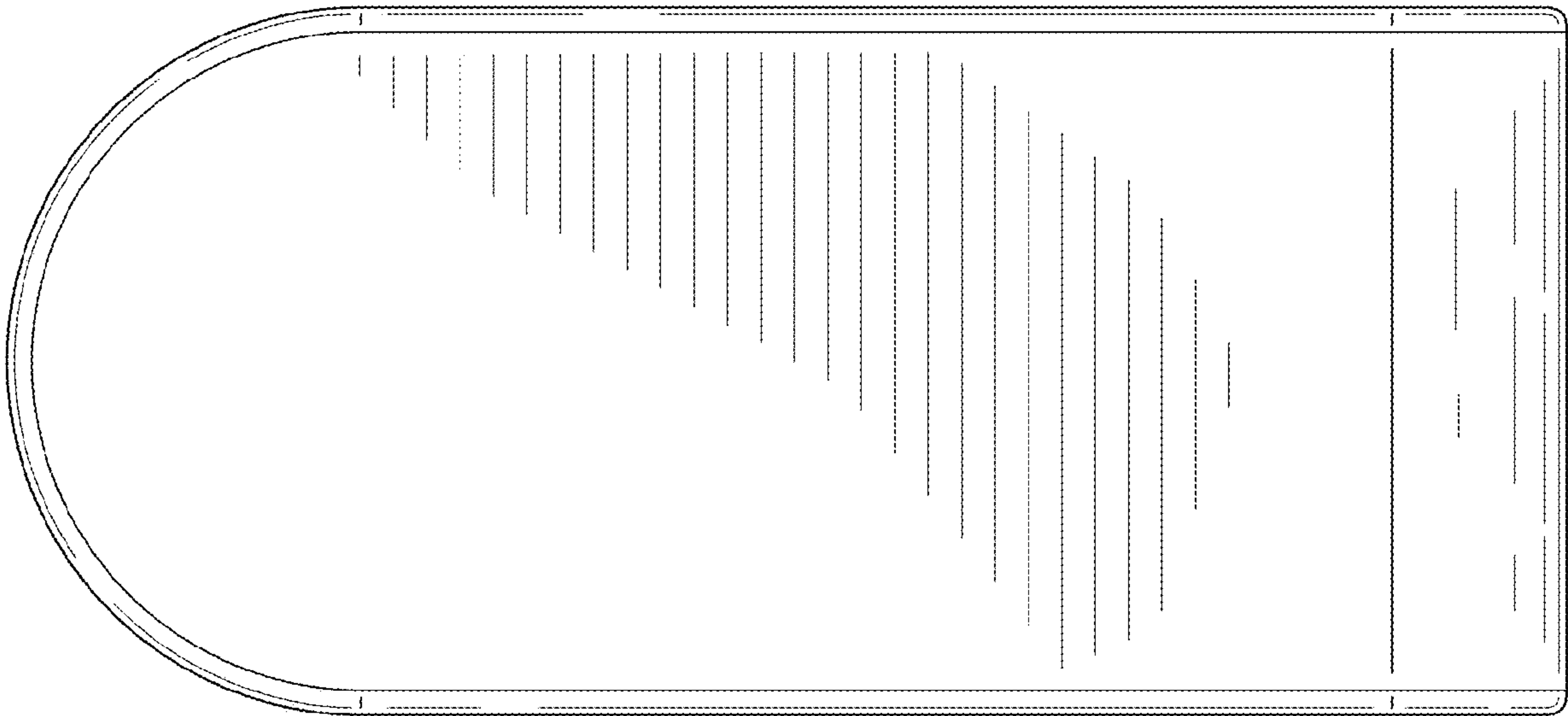

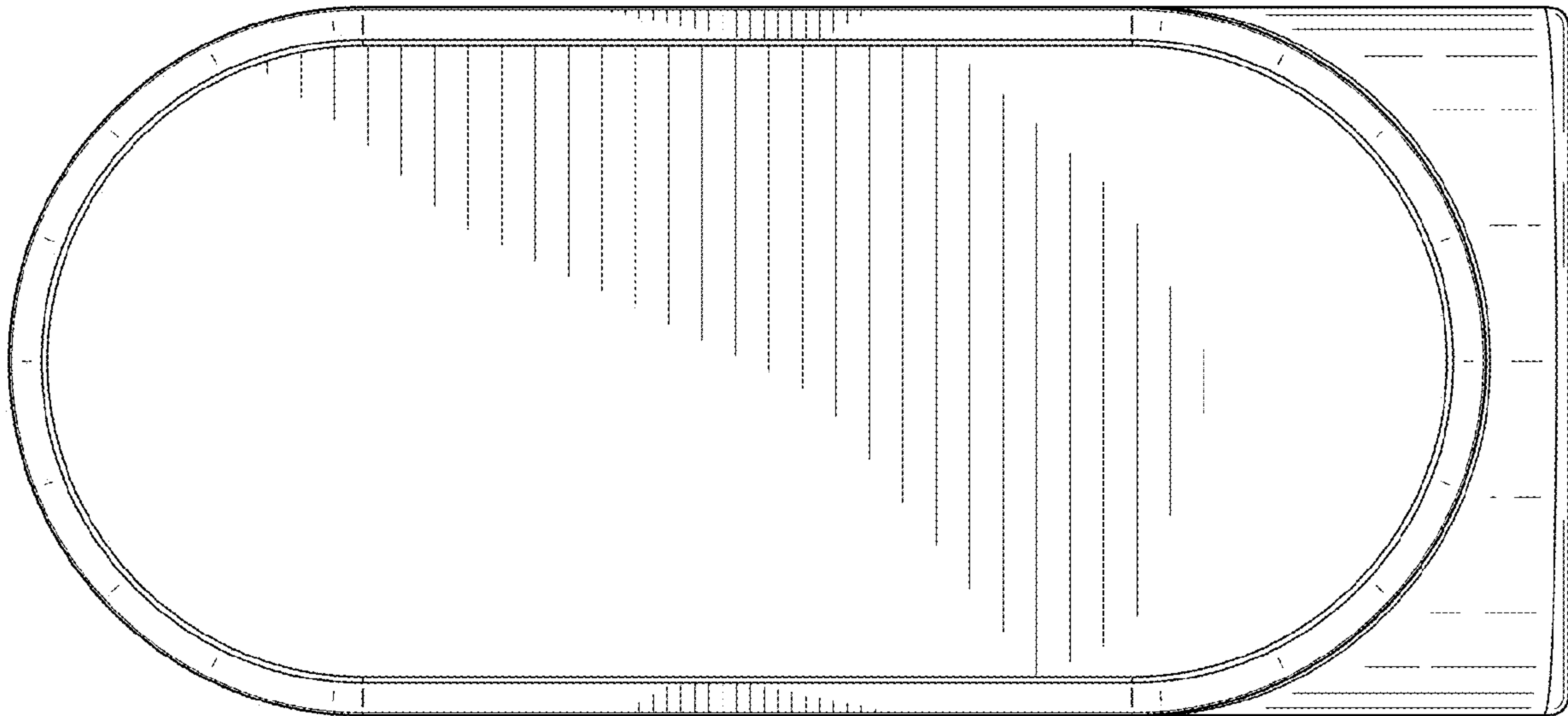

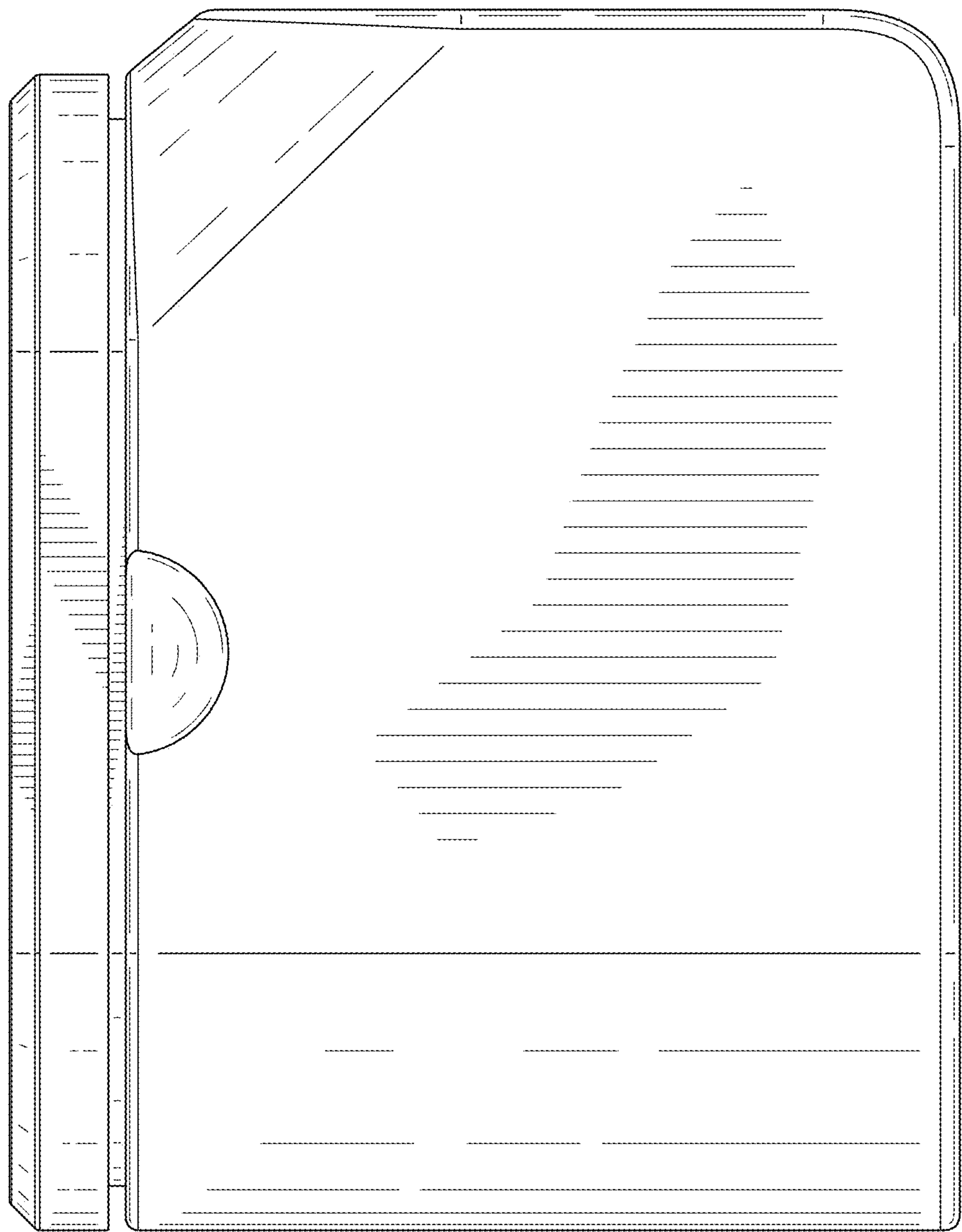

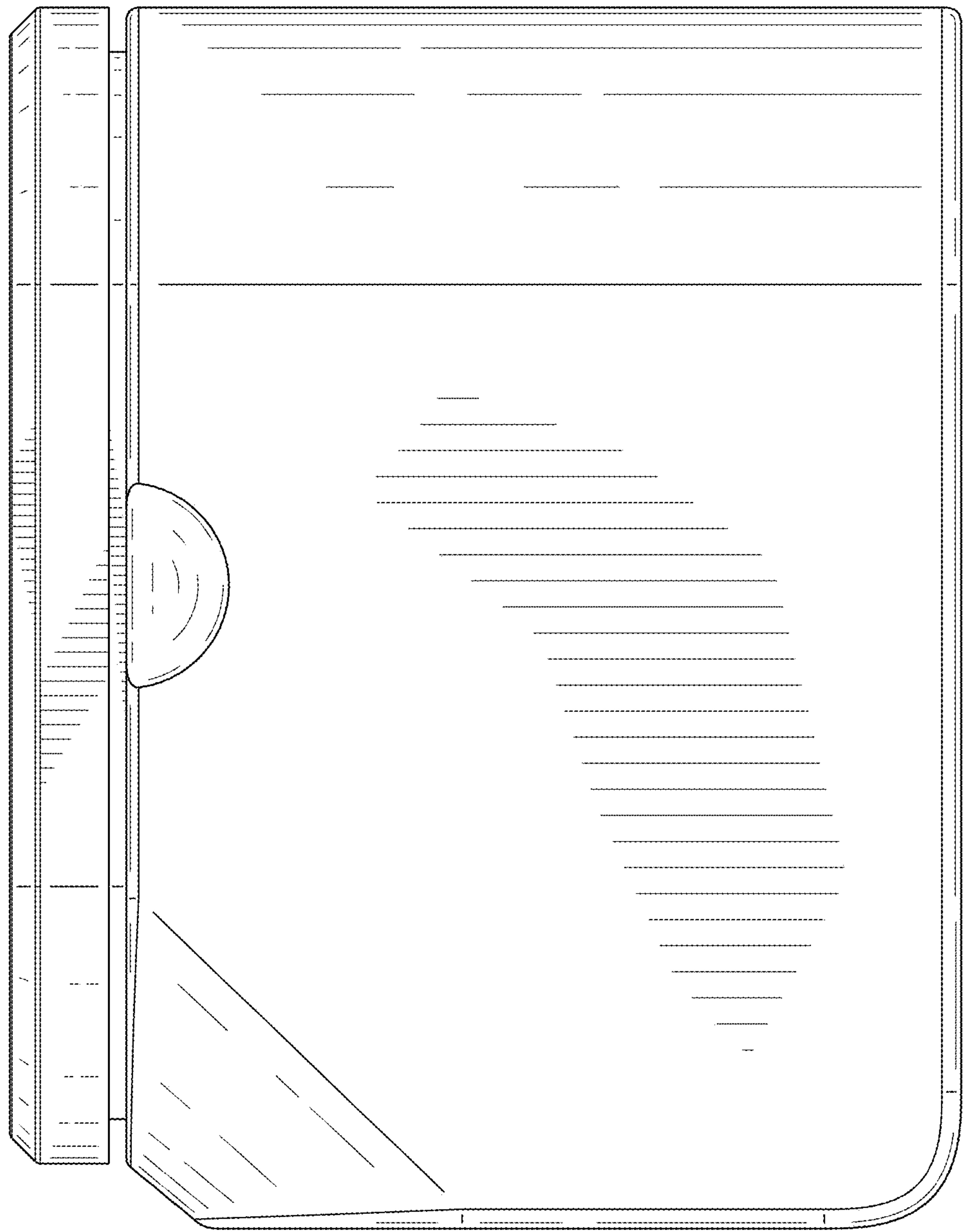

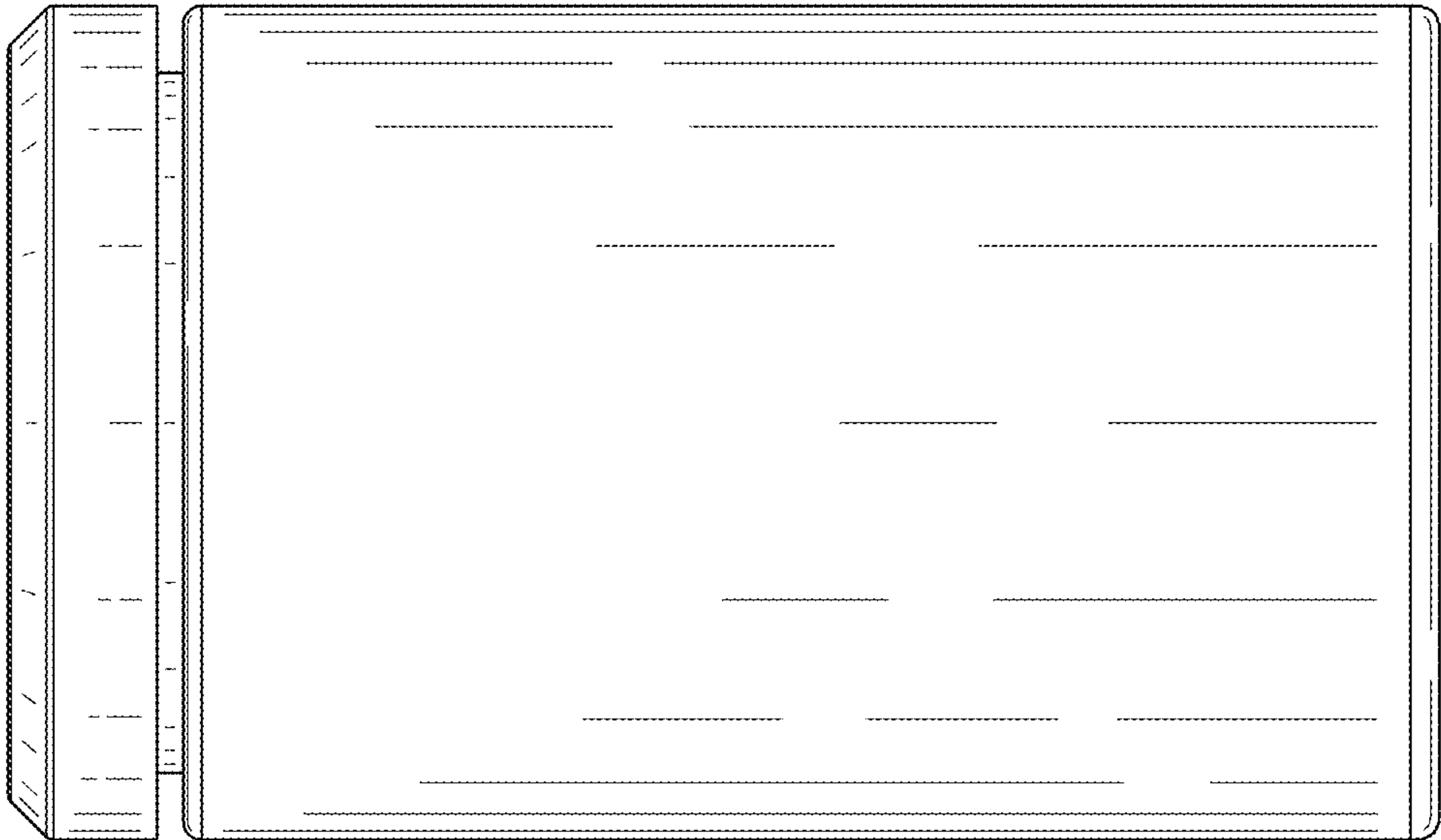

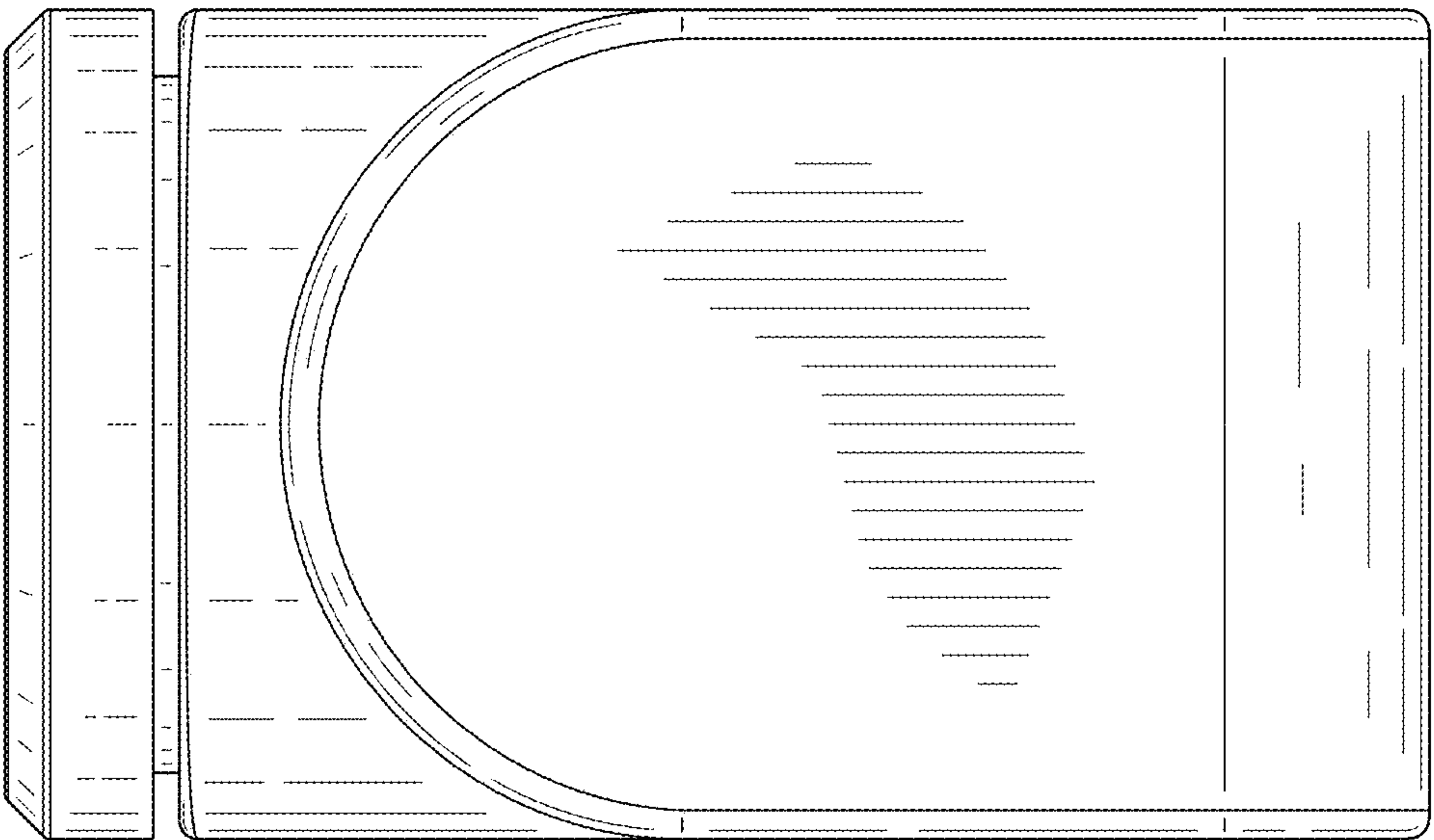
