The broken lines in the drawings depict portions of the dispenser cartridge assembly that form no part of the claimed design.

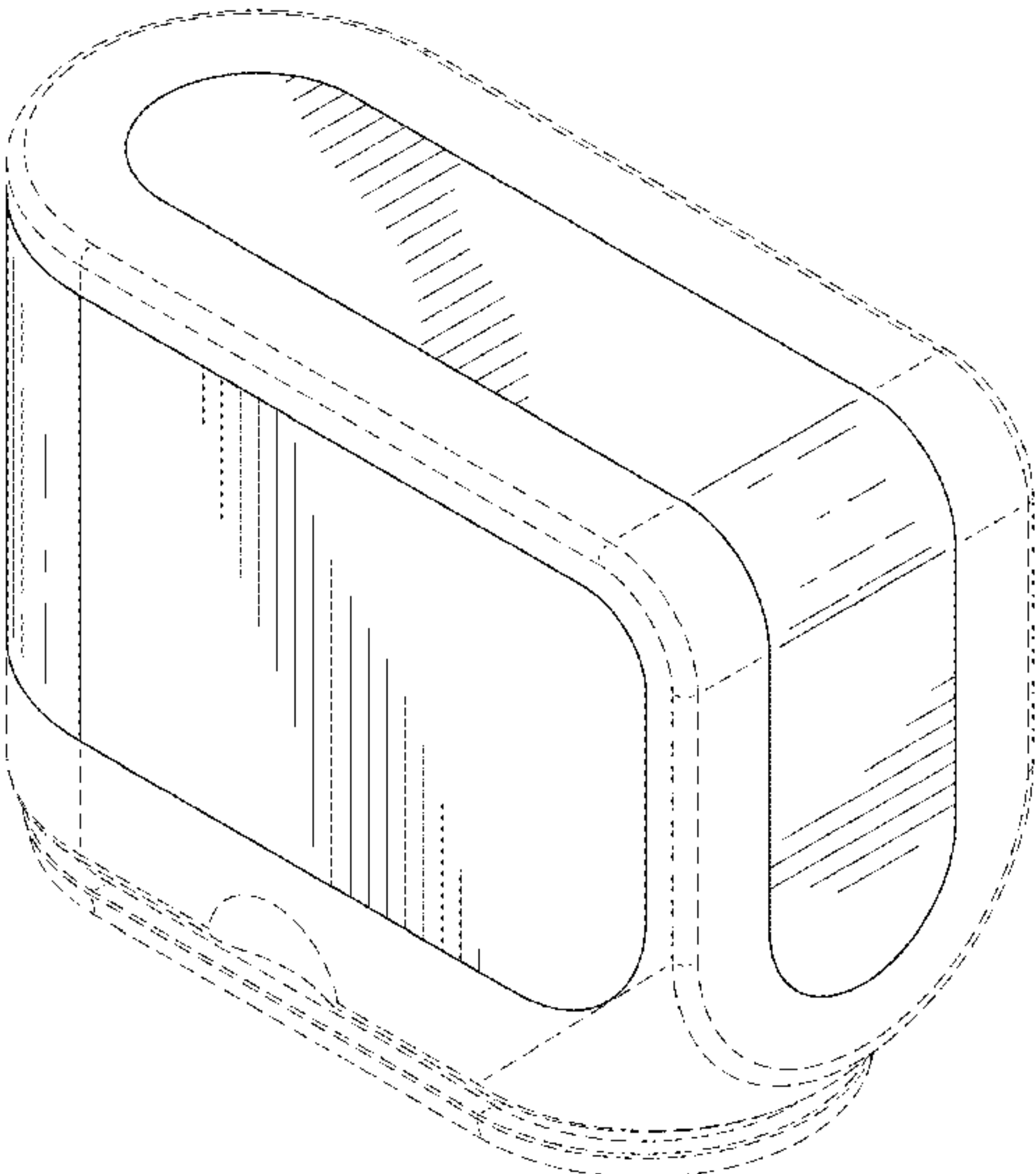

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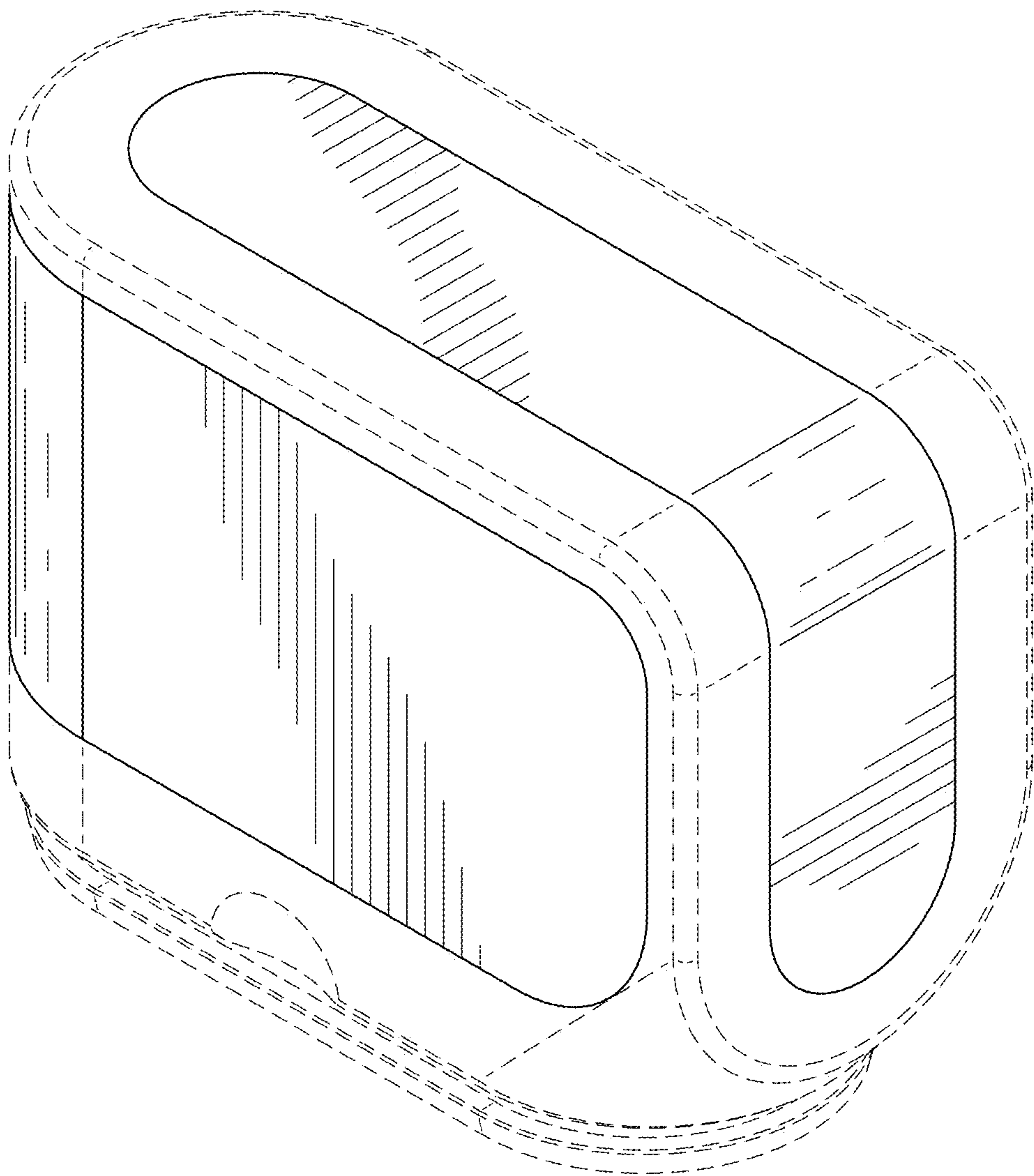

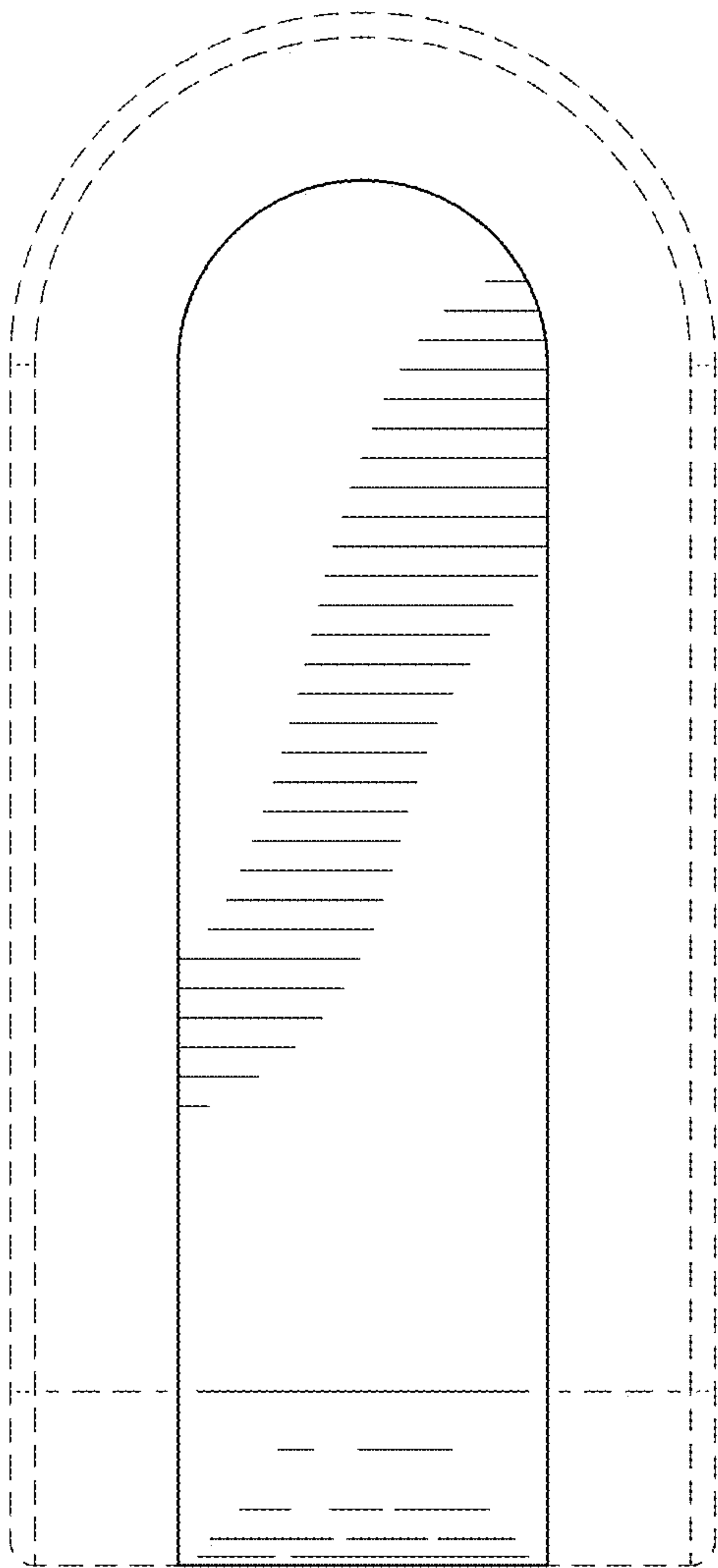

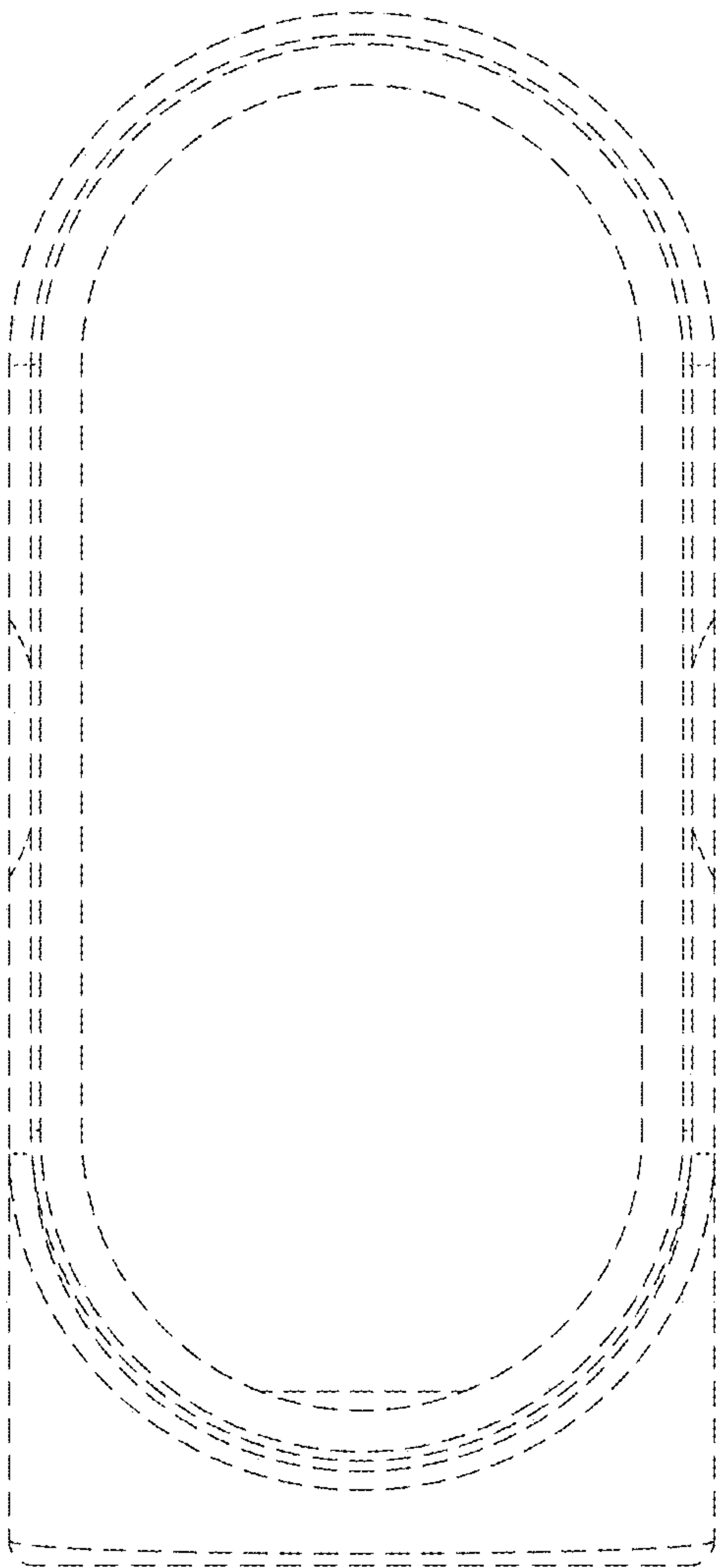

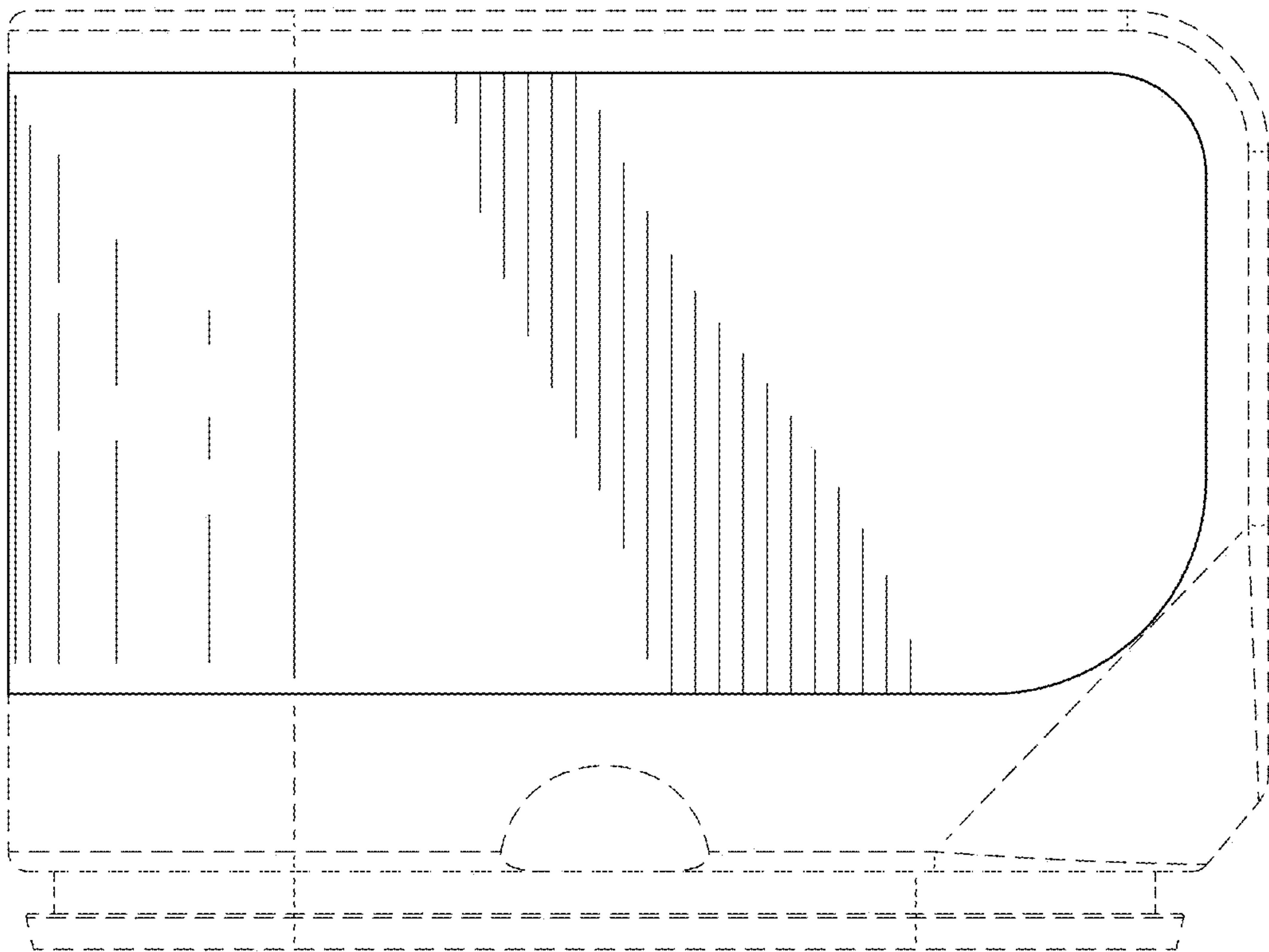

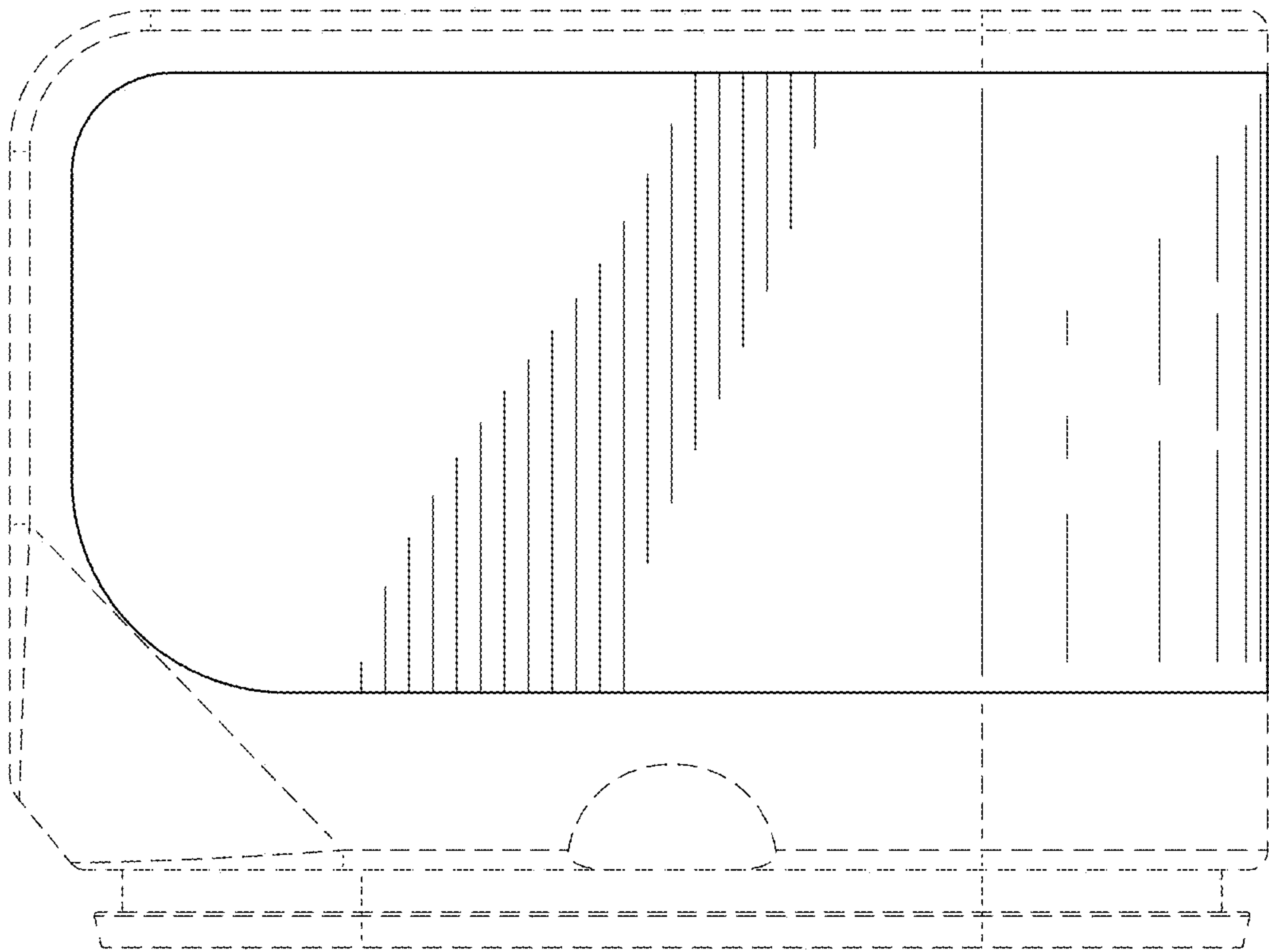

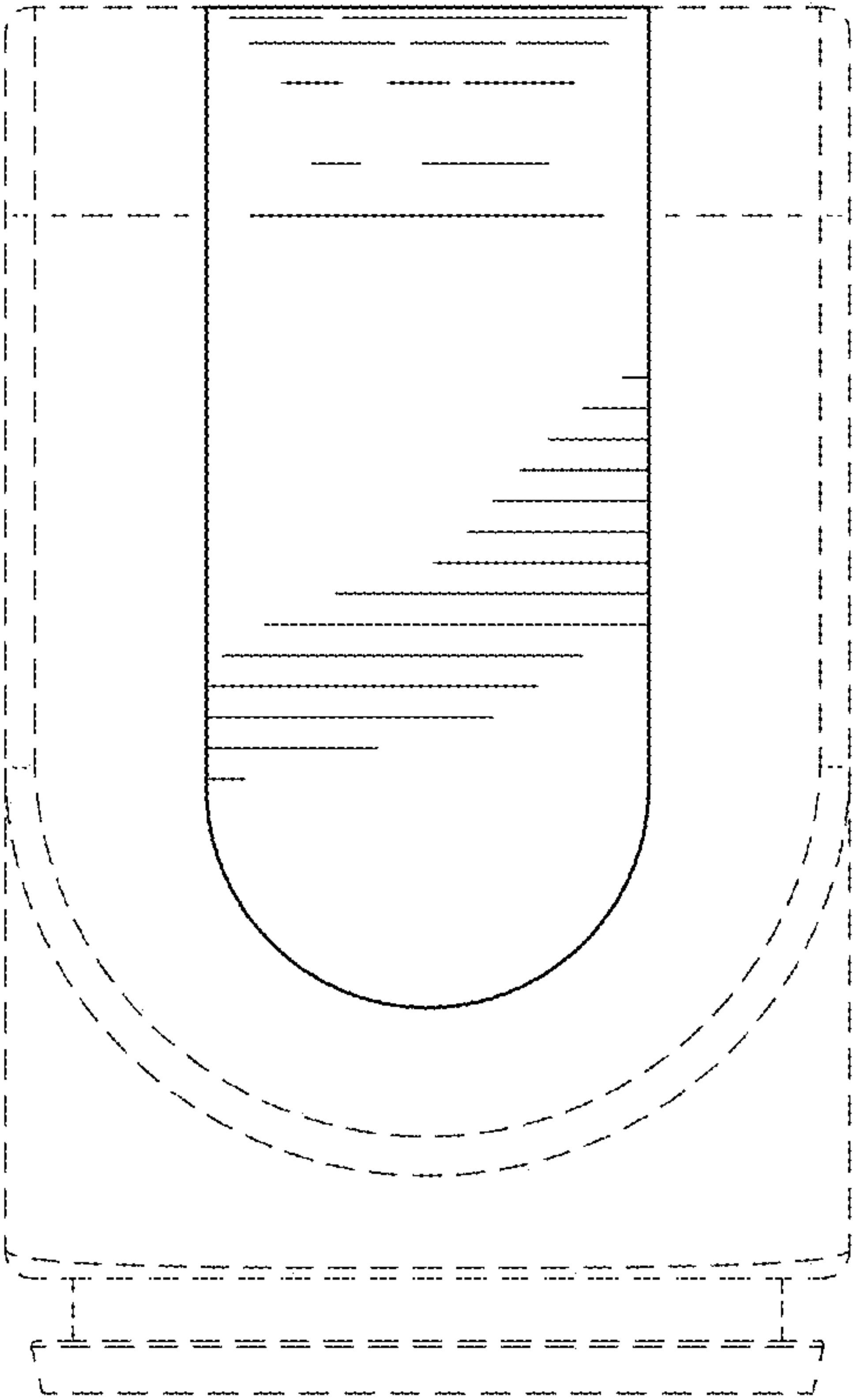

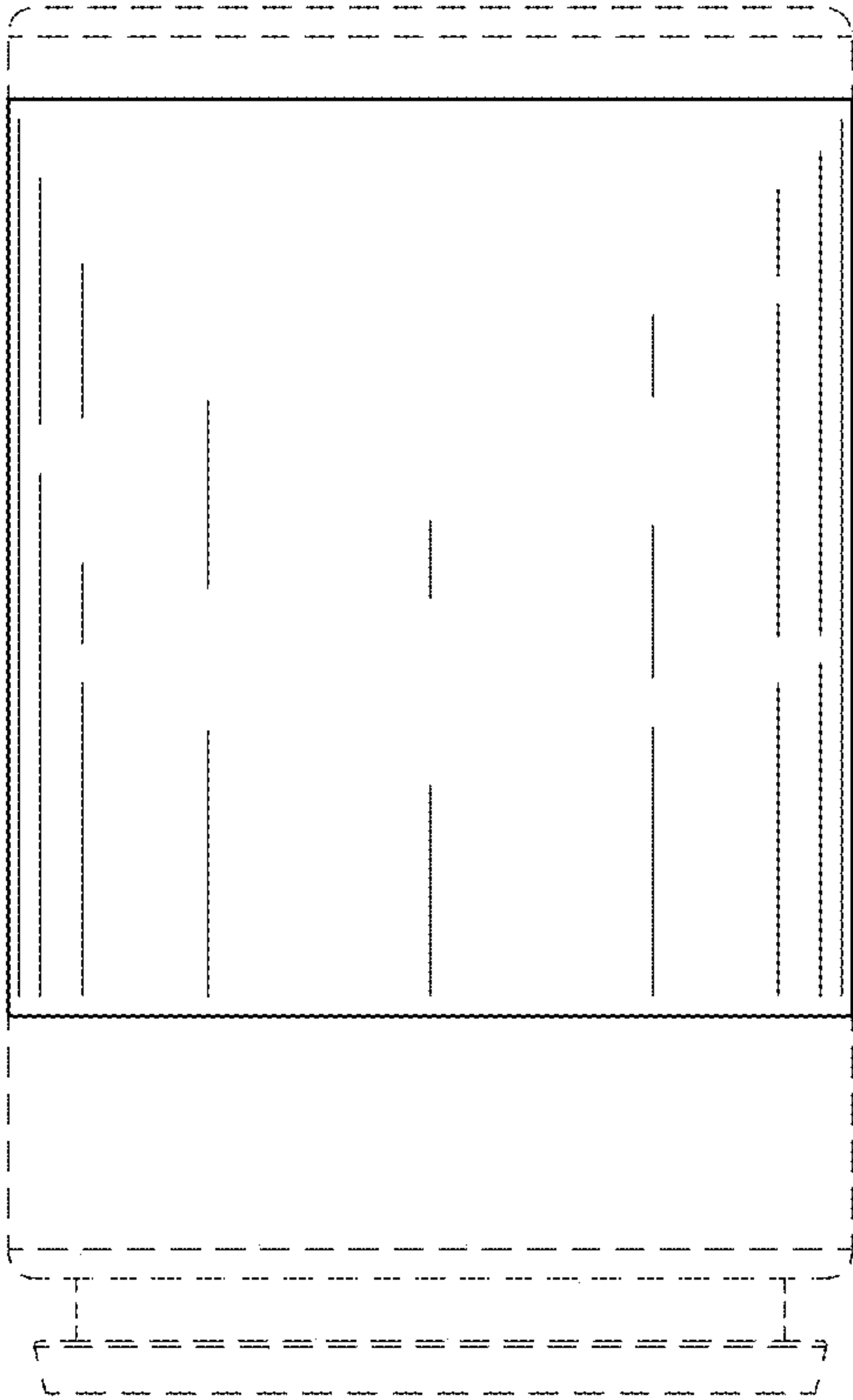
