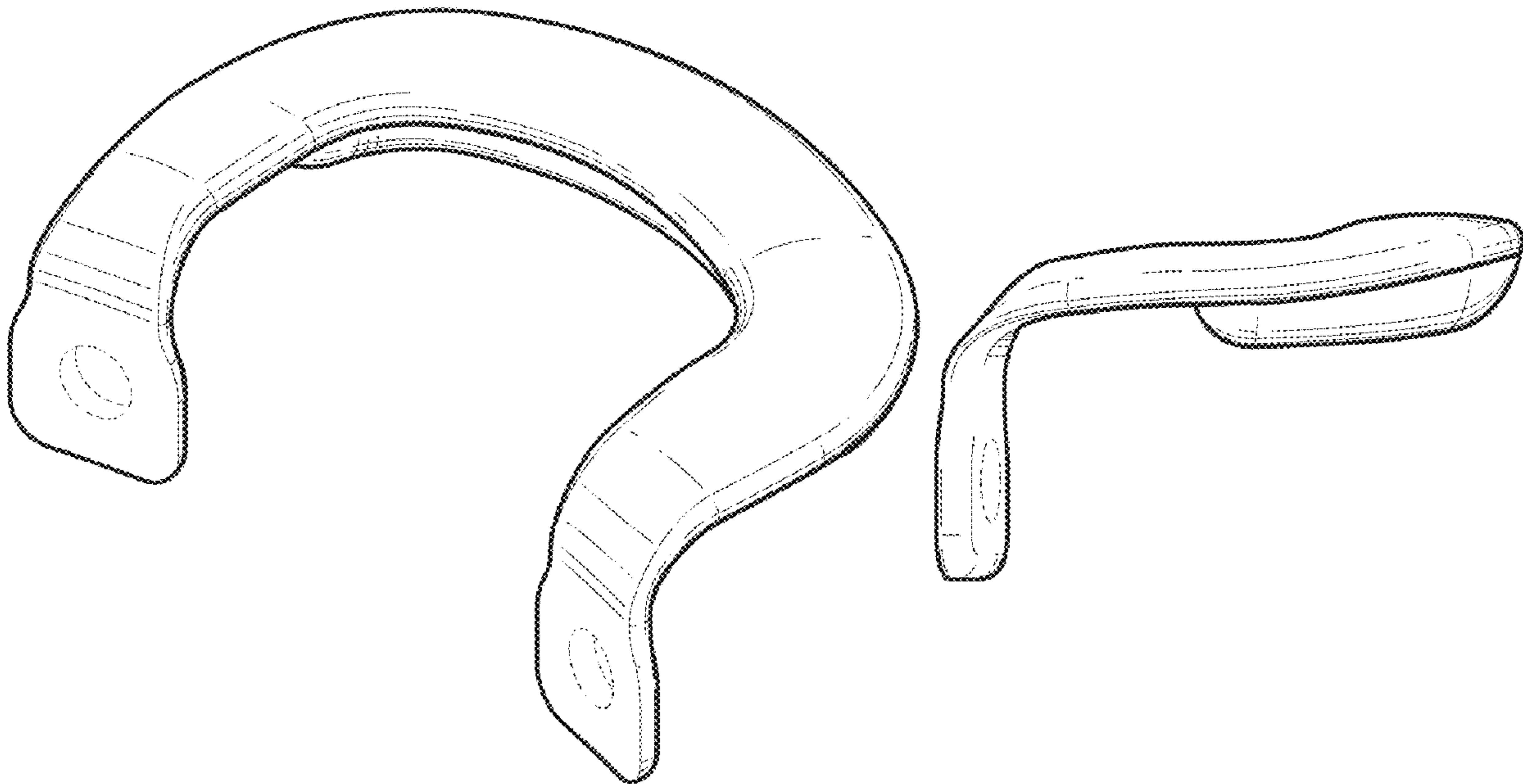
(57) CLAIM

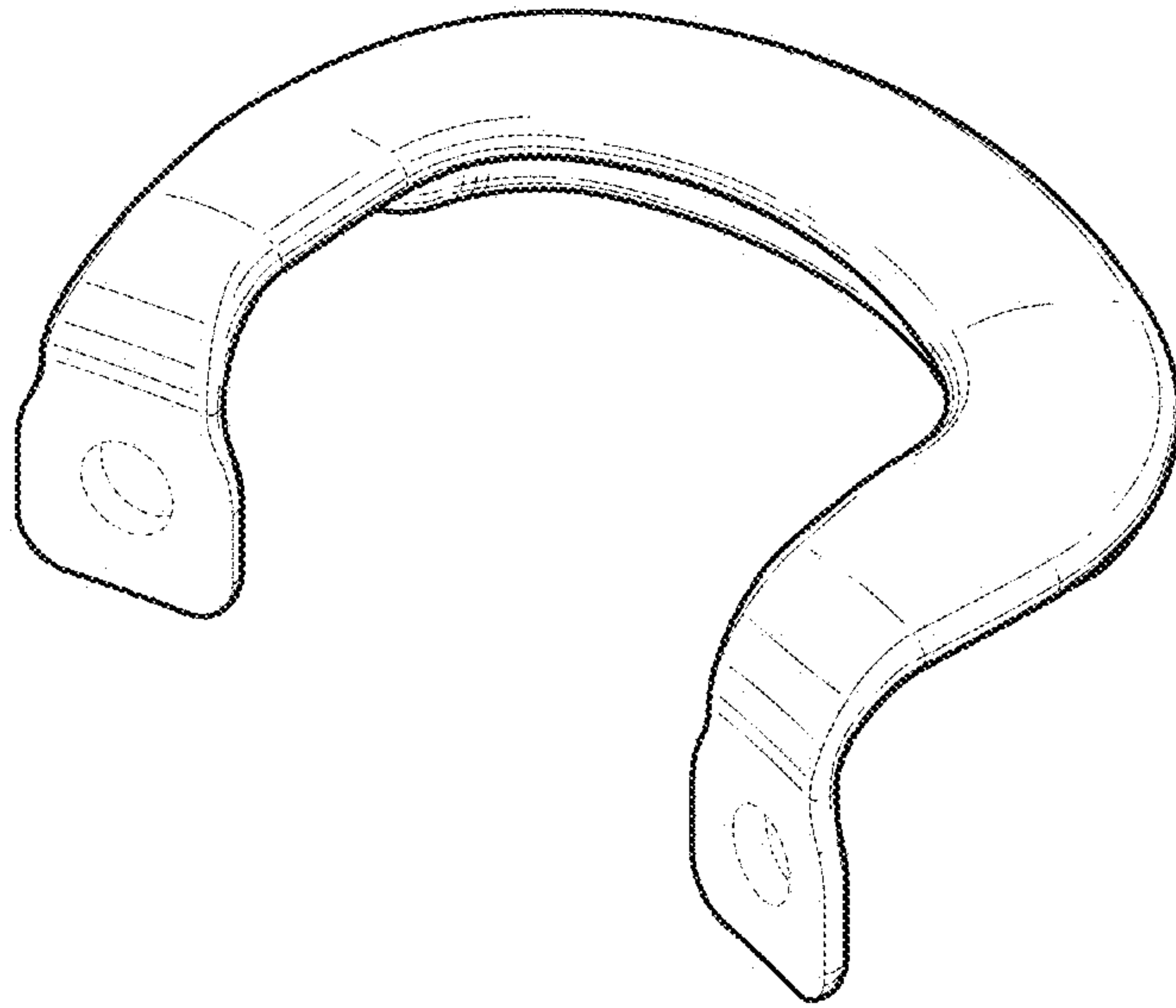

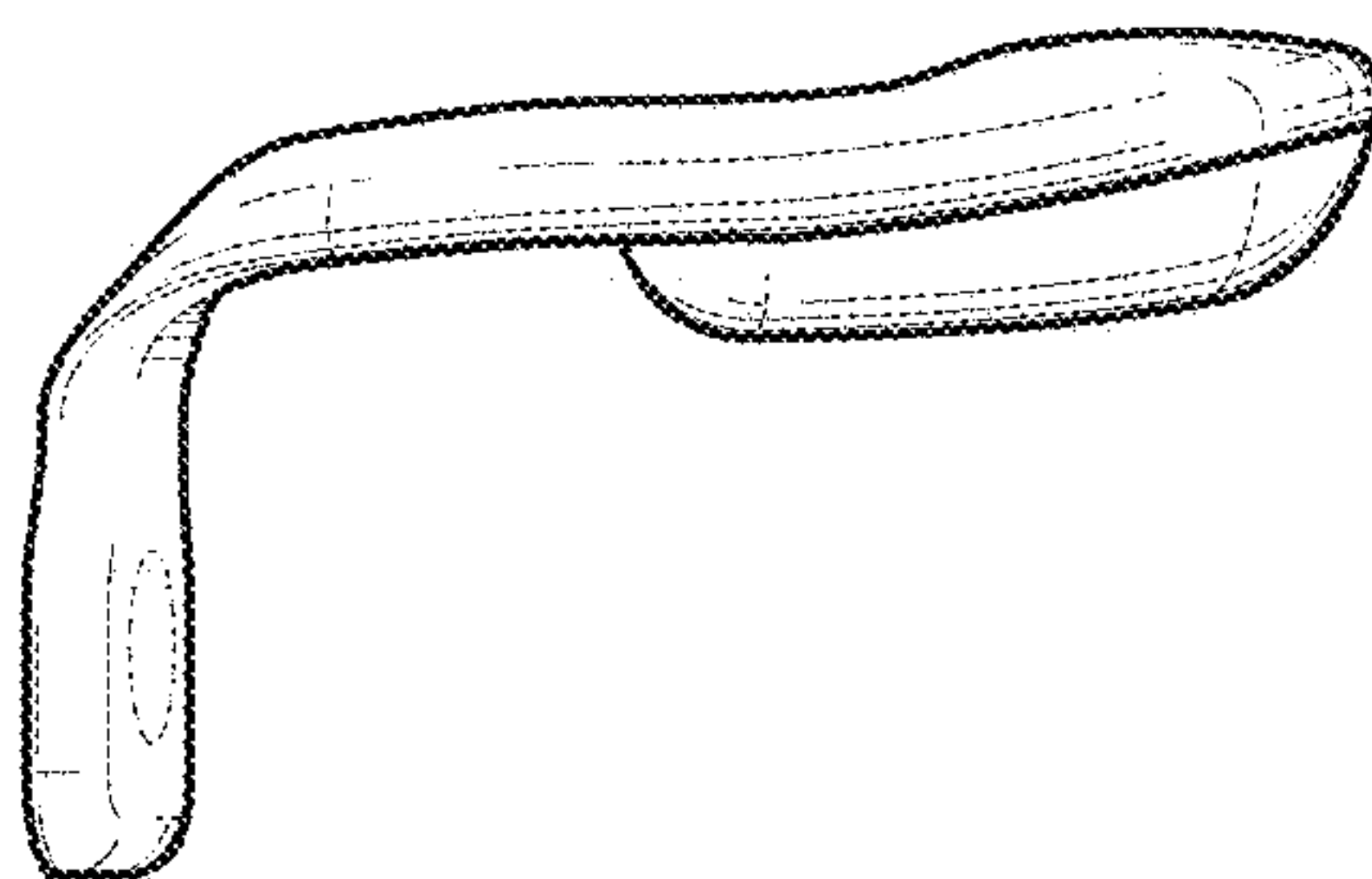

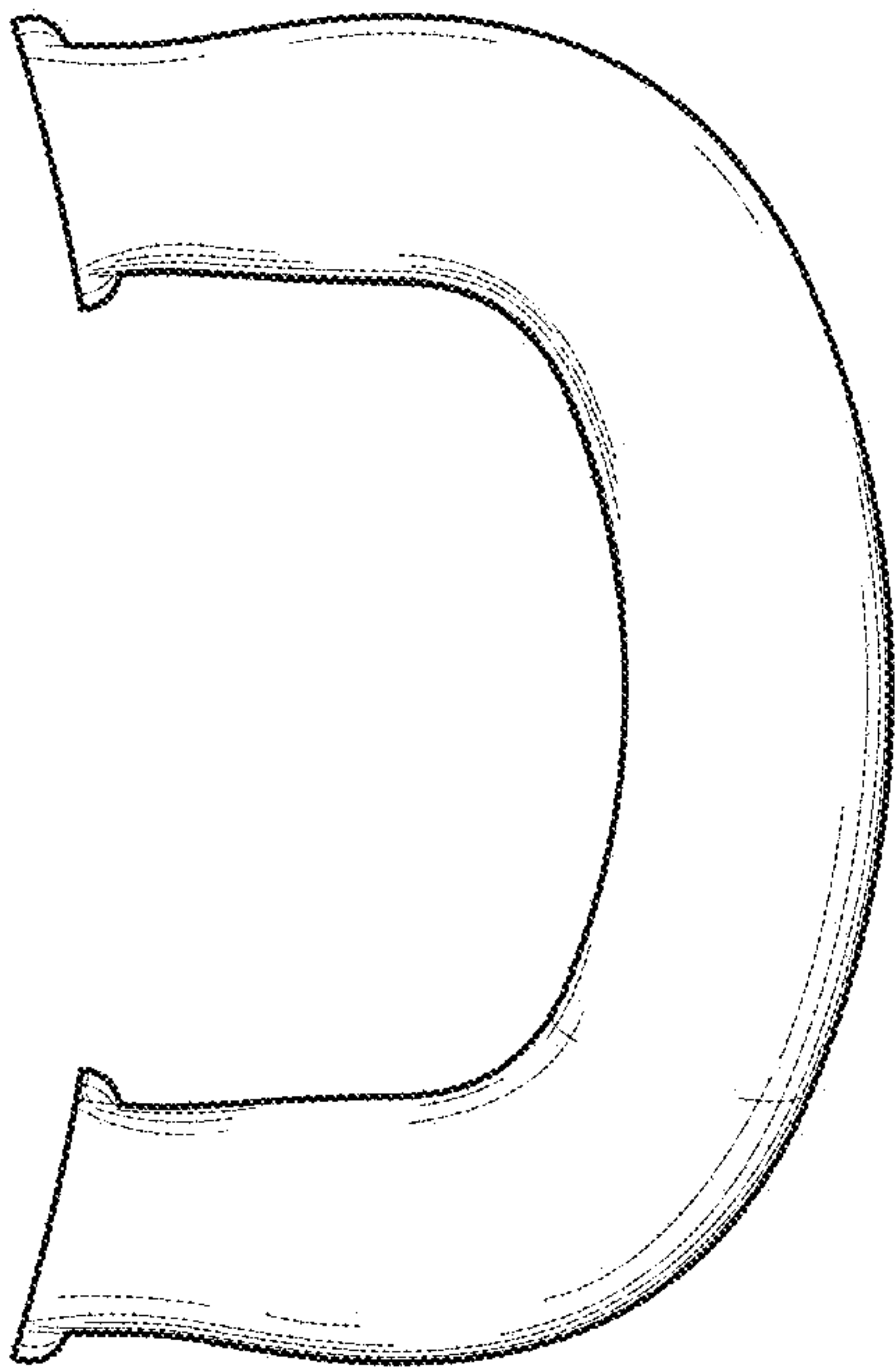

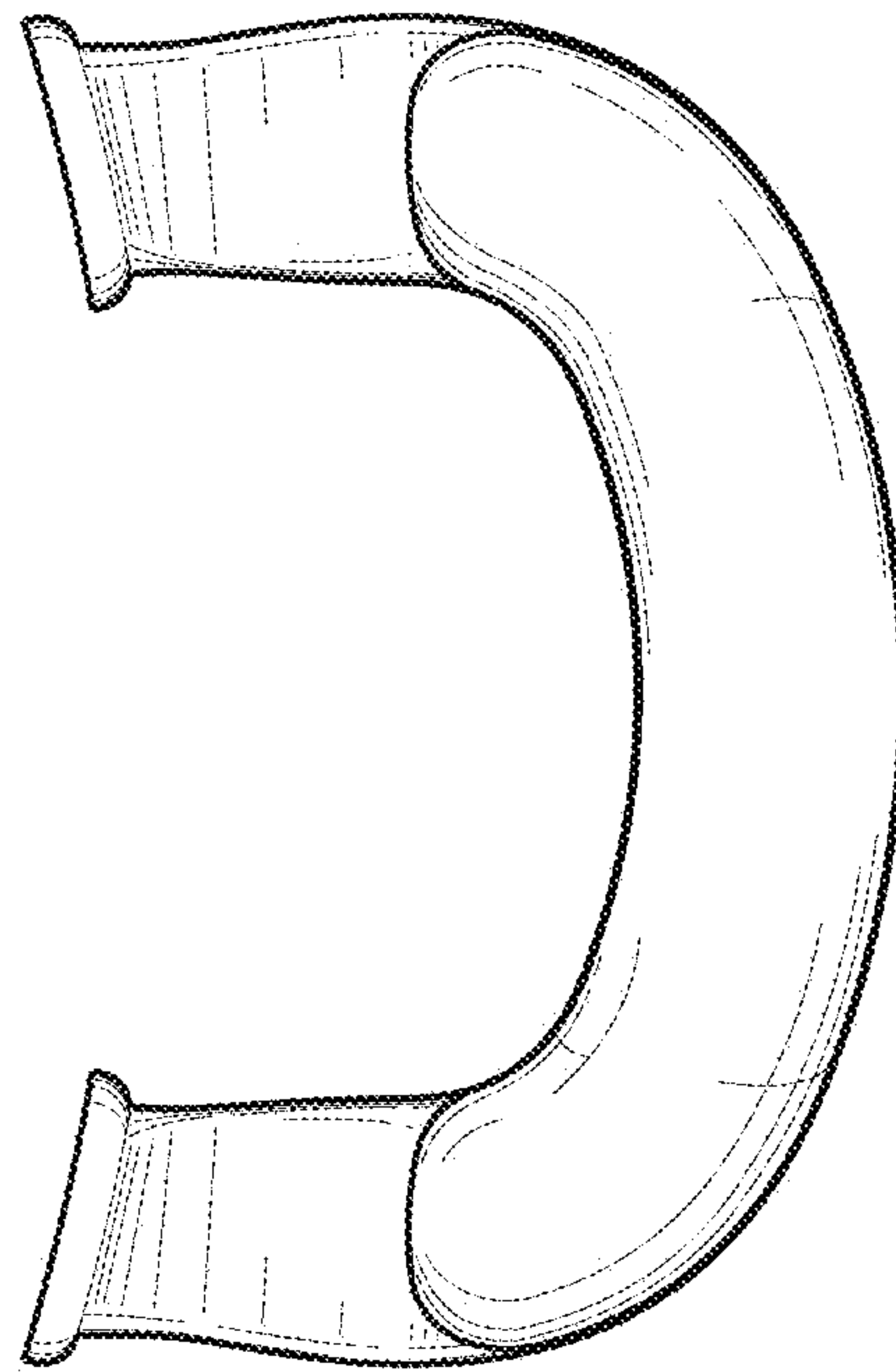

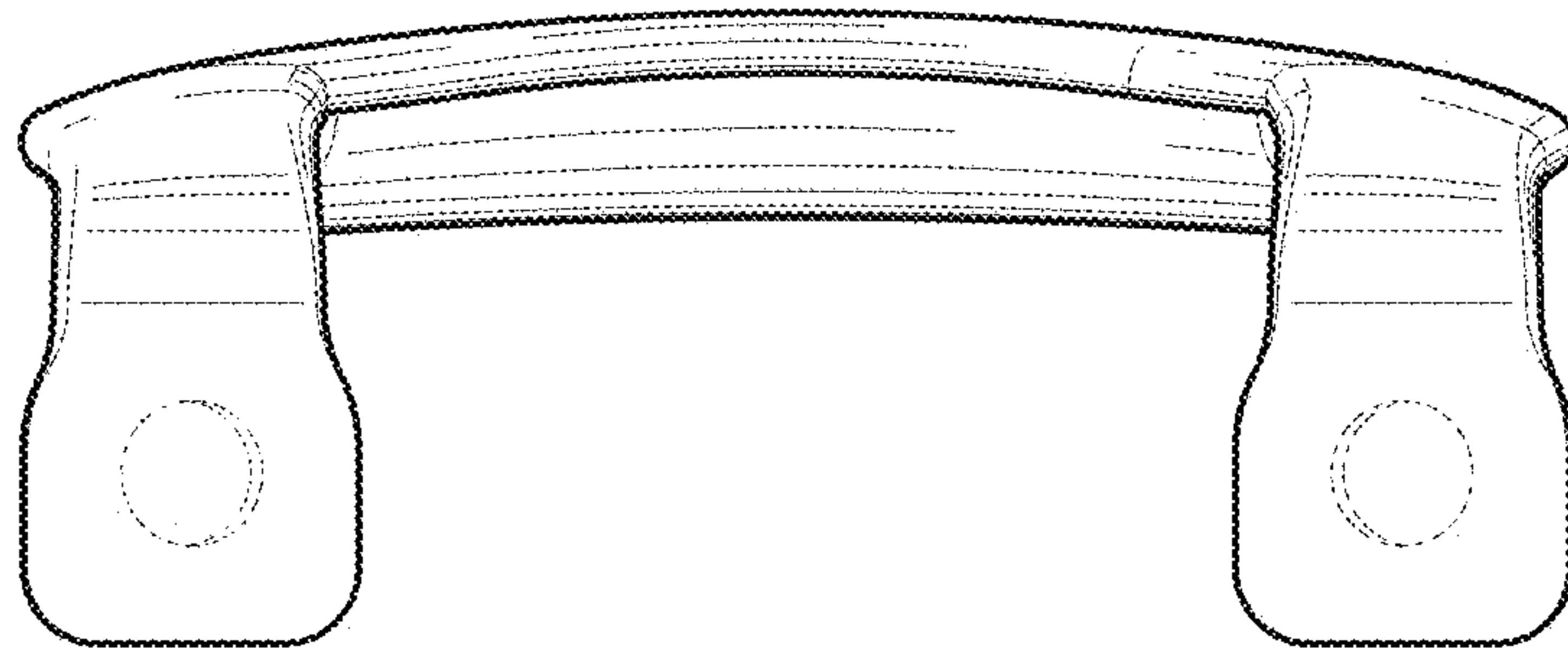

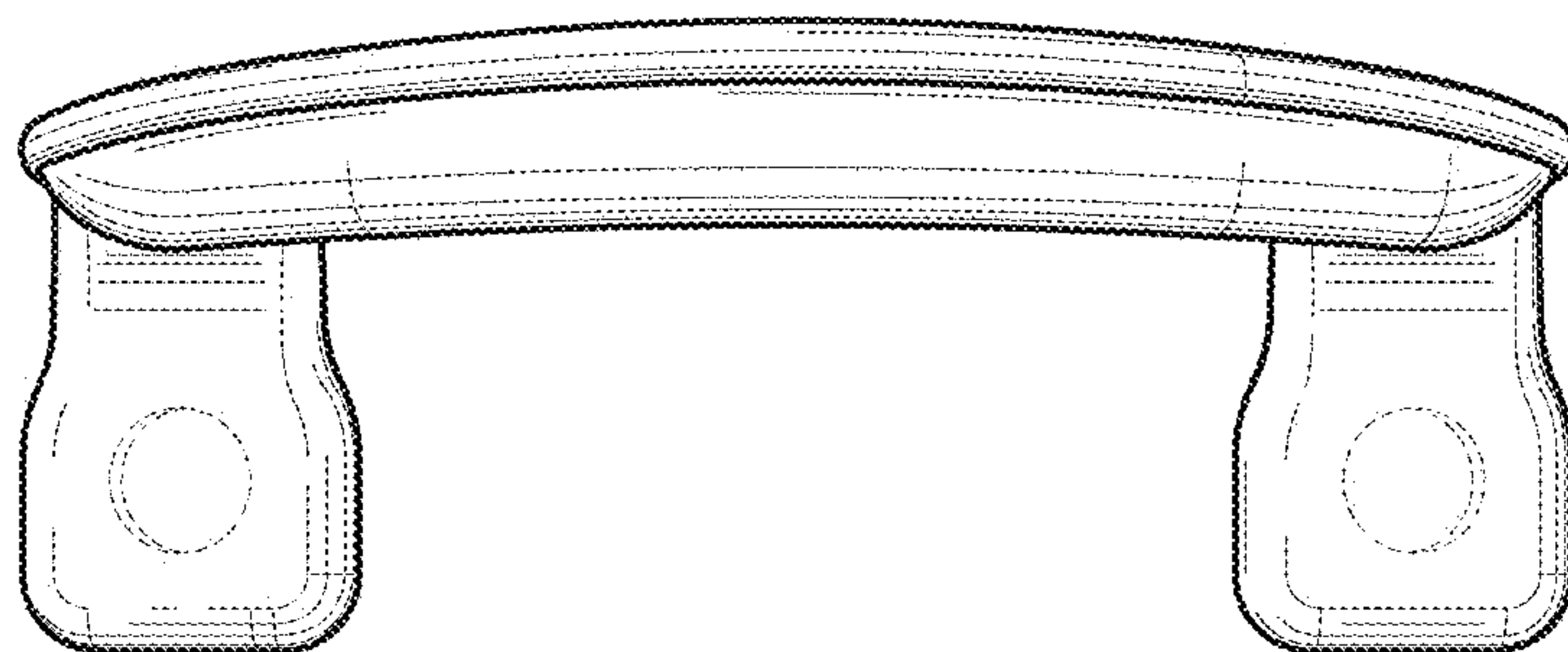
