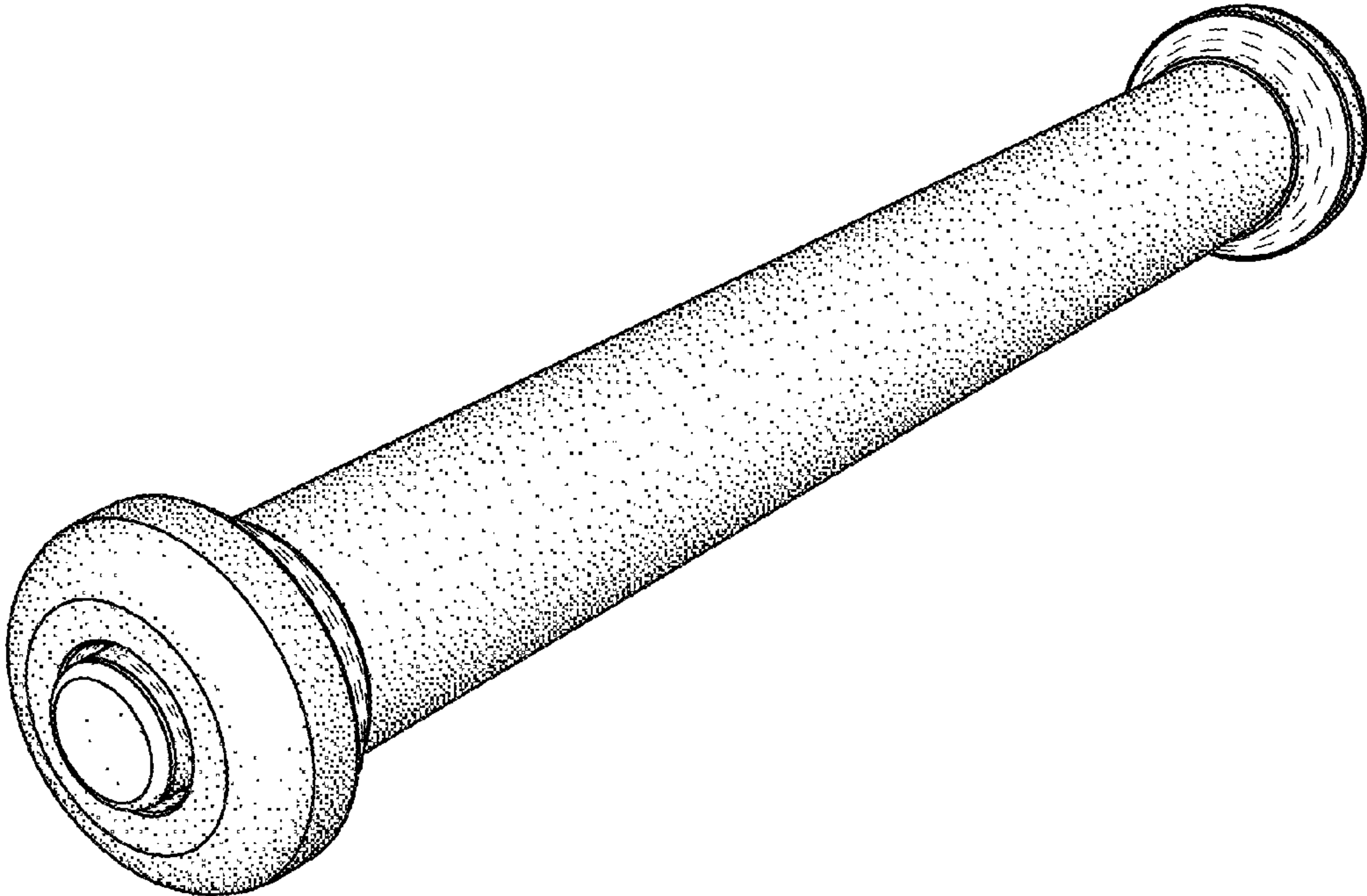
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rolling pin, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the rolling pin showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; the rear elevation is a mirror image of the front side.
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; the bottom plan view is a mirror image of the top side; the right side elevational view is a mirror image of the top side; the left side elevation view is a mirror image of the top side; and,
FIG. 4 is an exploded axon view thereof.
The broken lines in the drawings illustrate portions of the rolling pin which form no part of the claimed design.

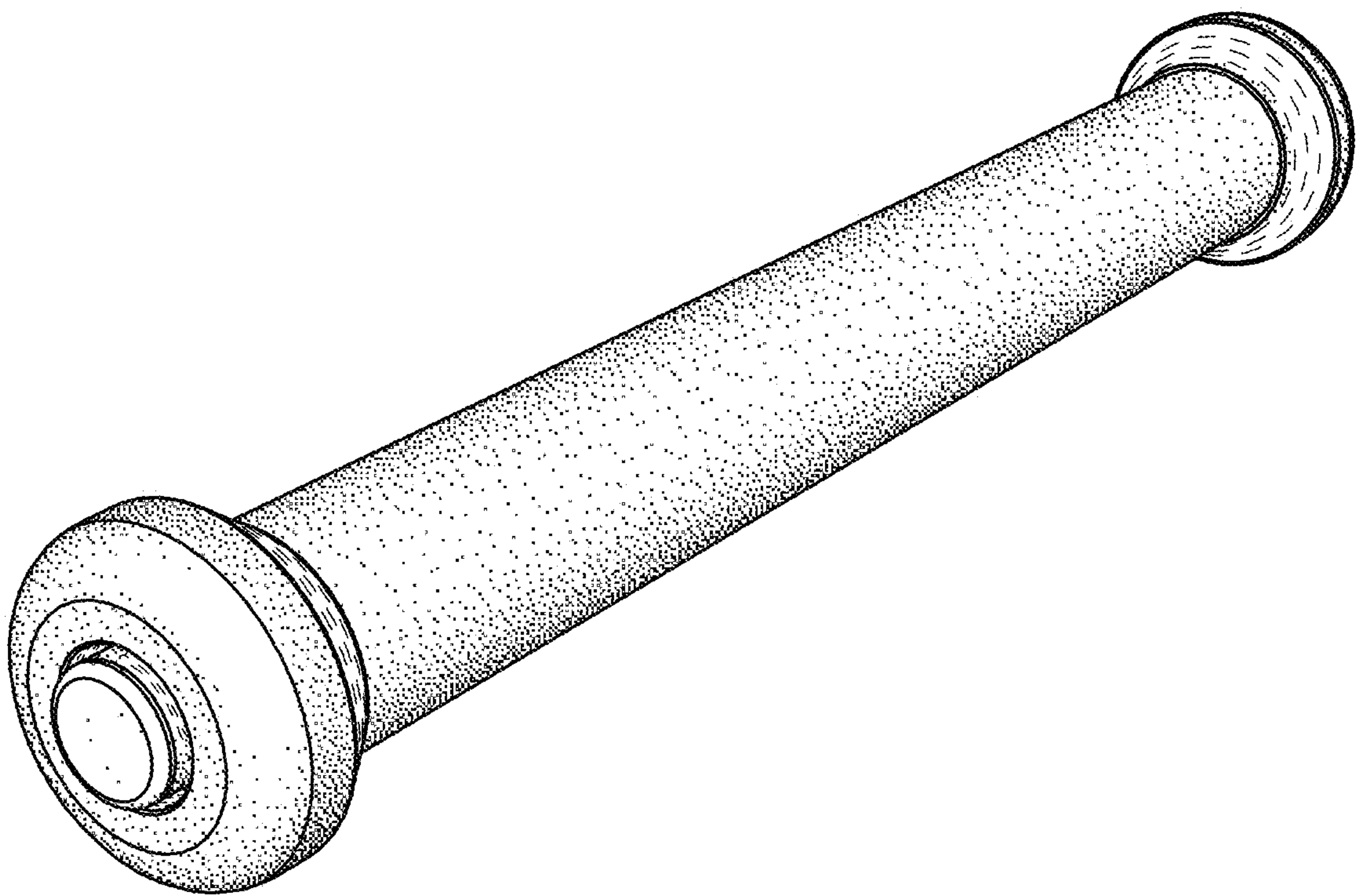

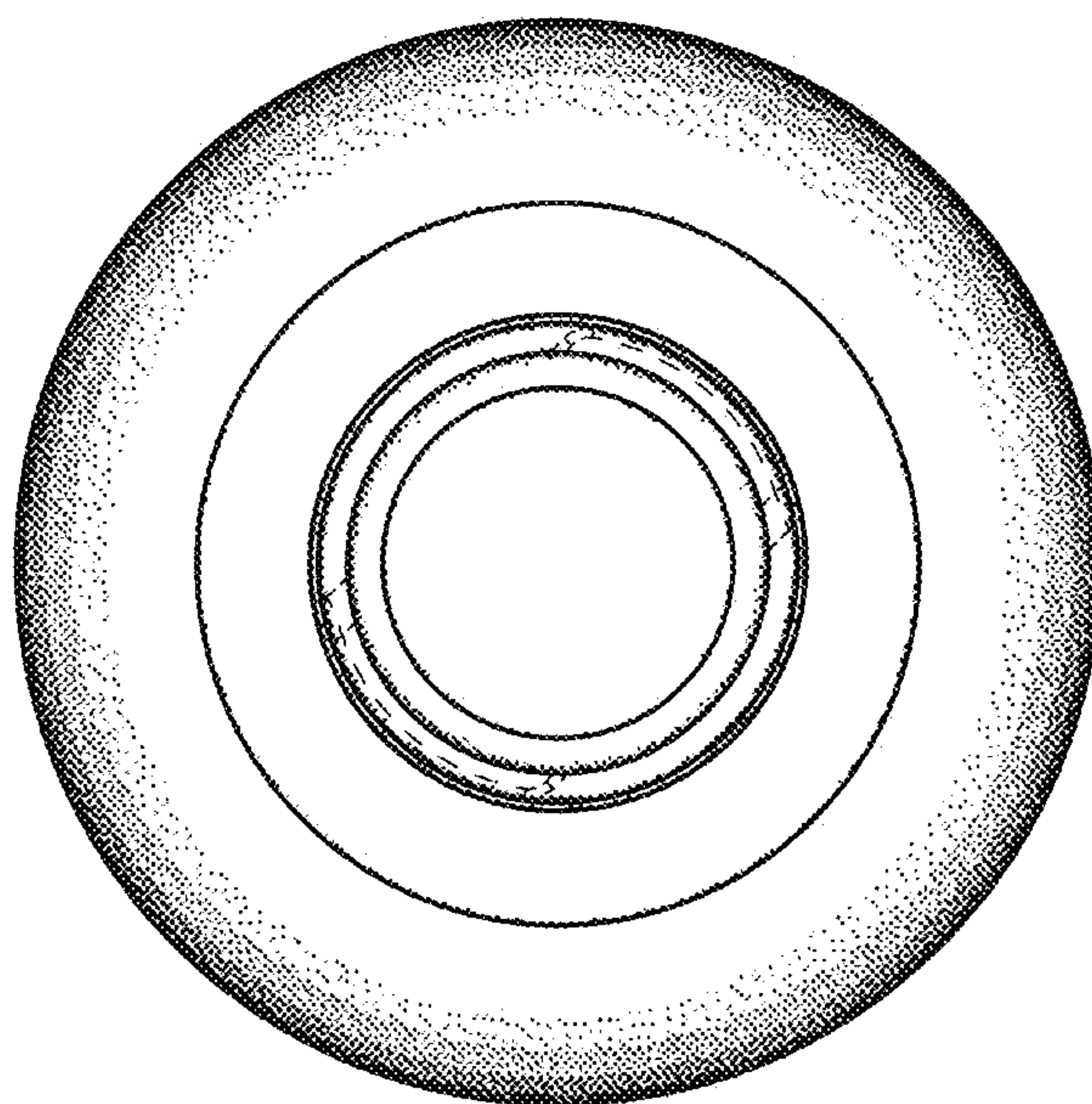

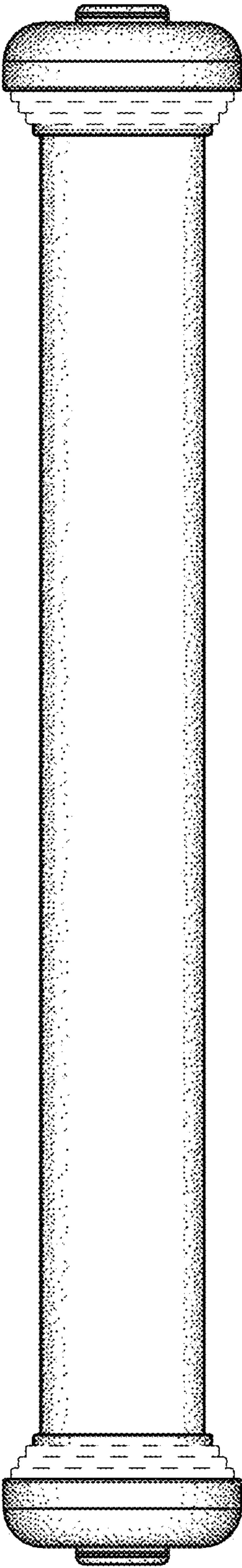

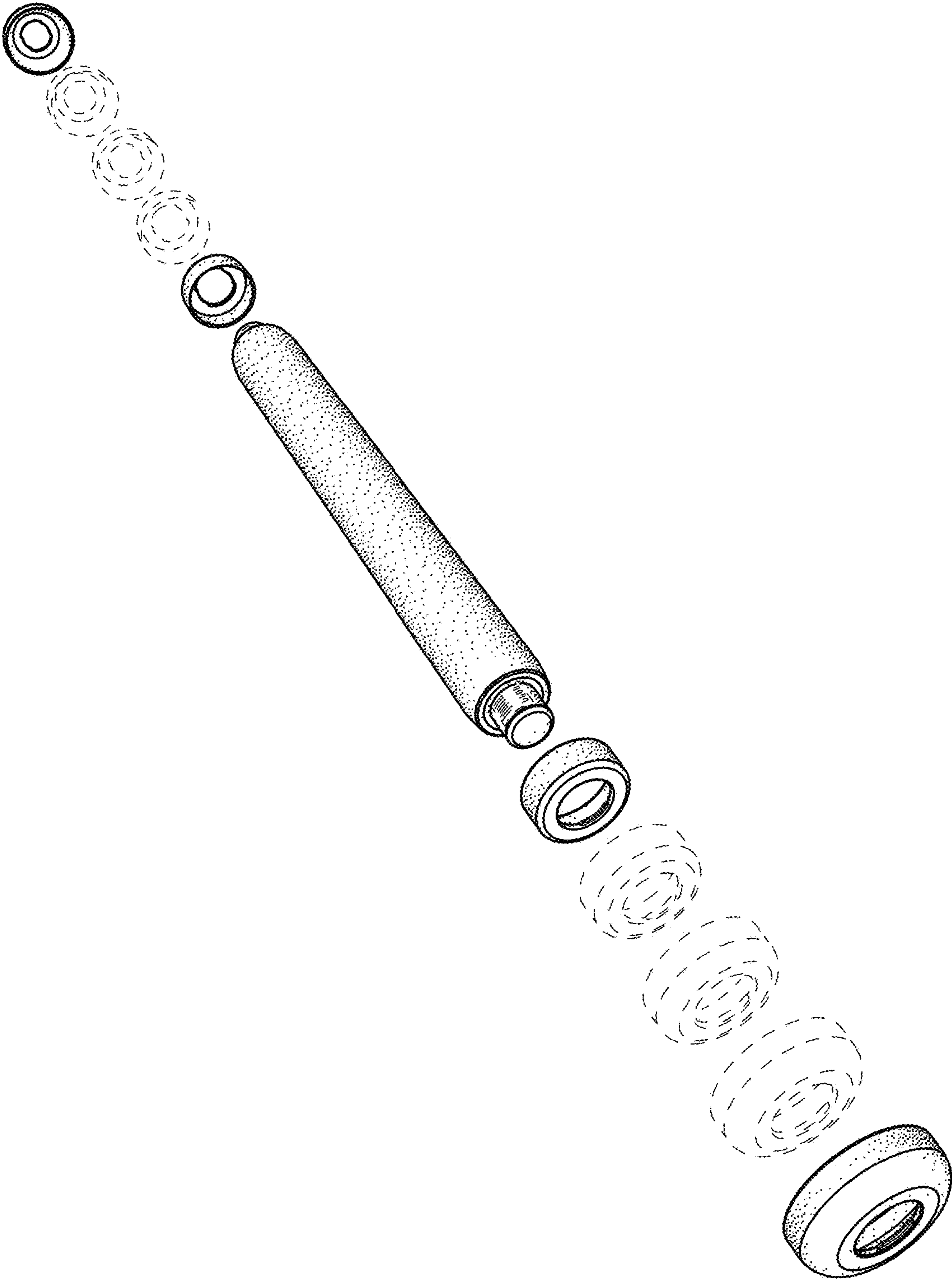
