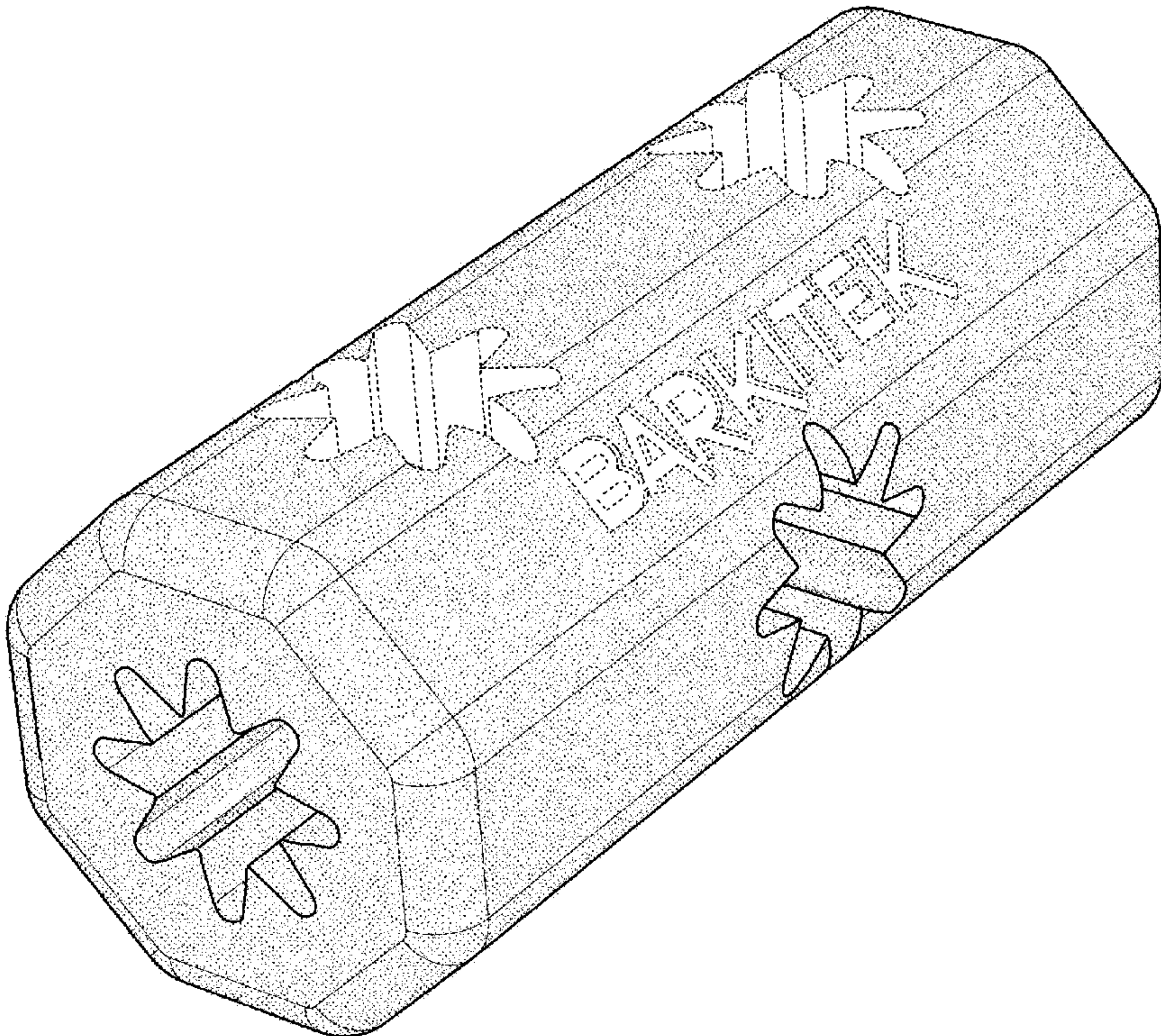
(57) CLAIM

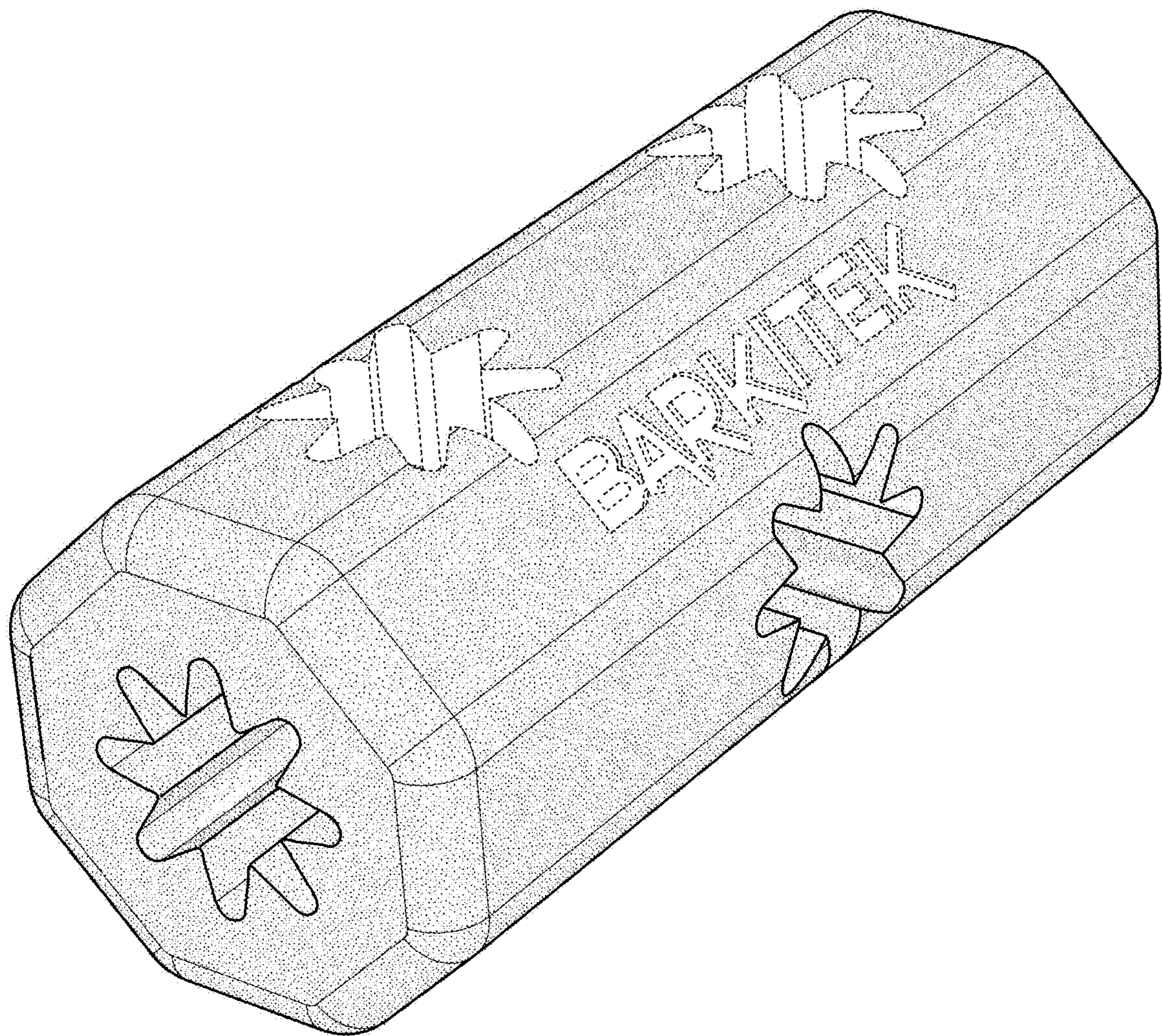

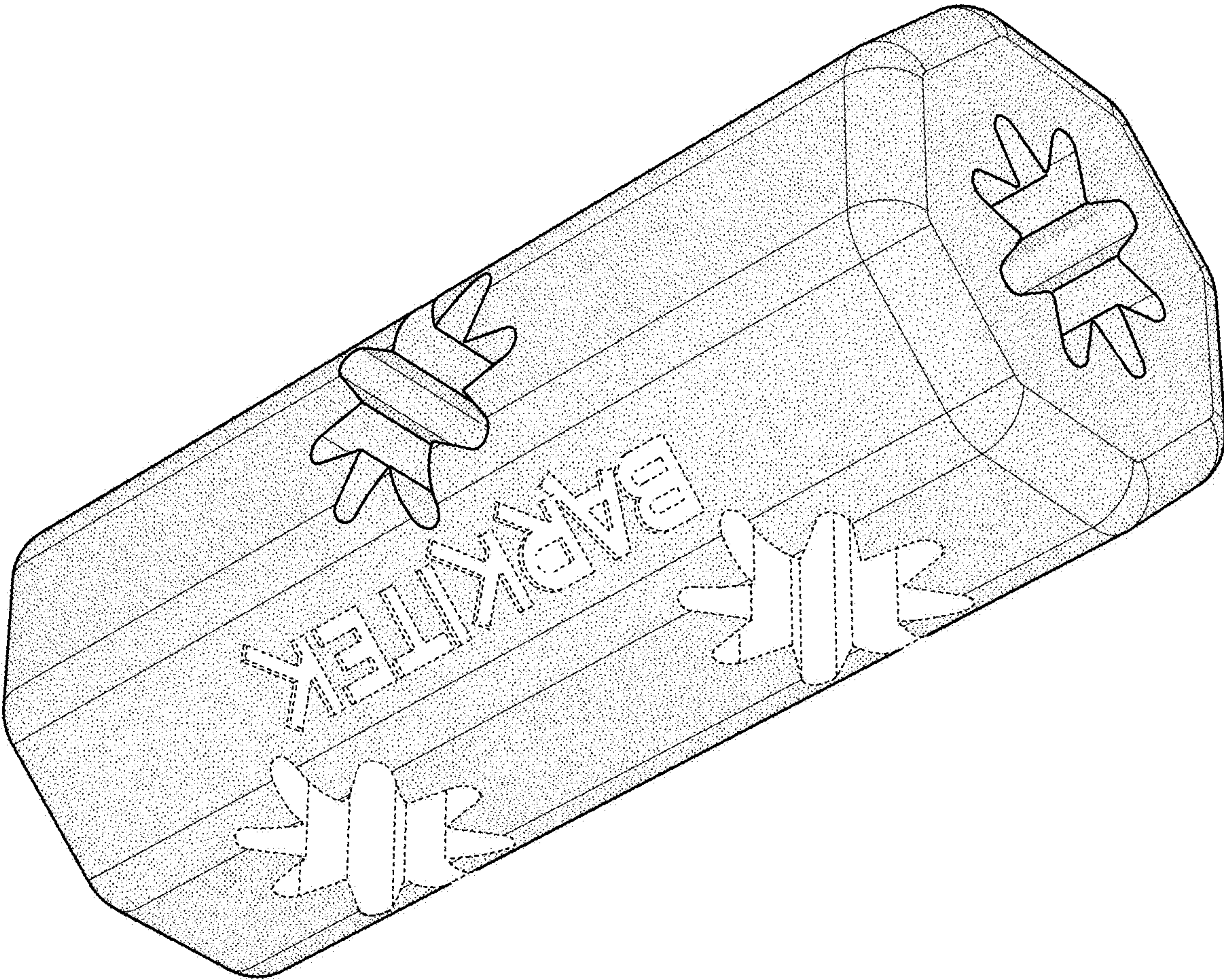

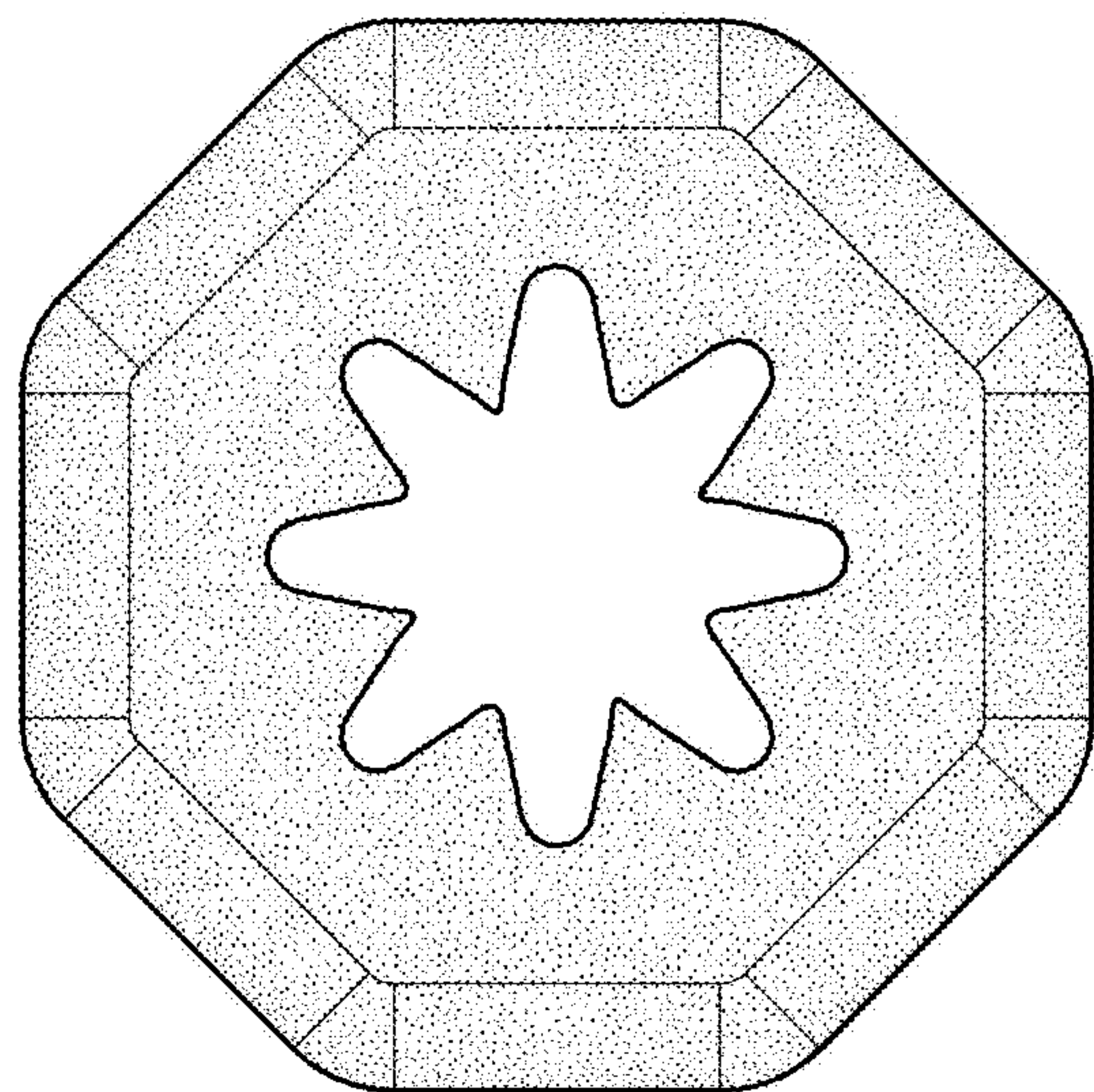

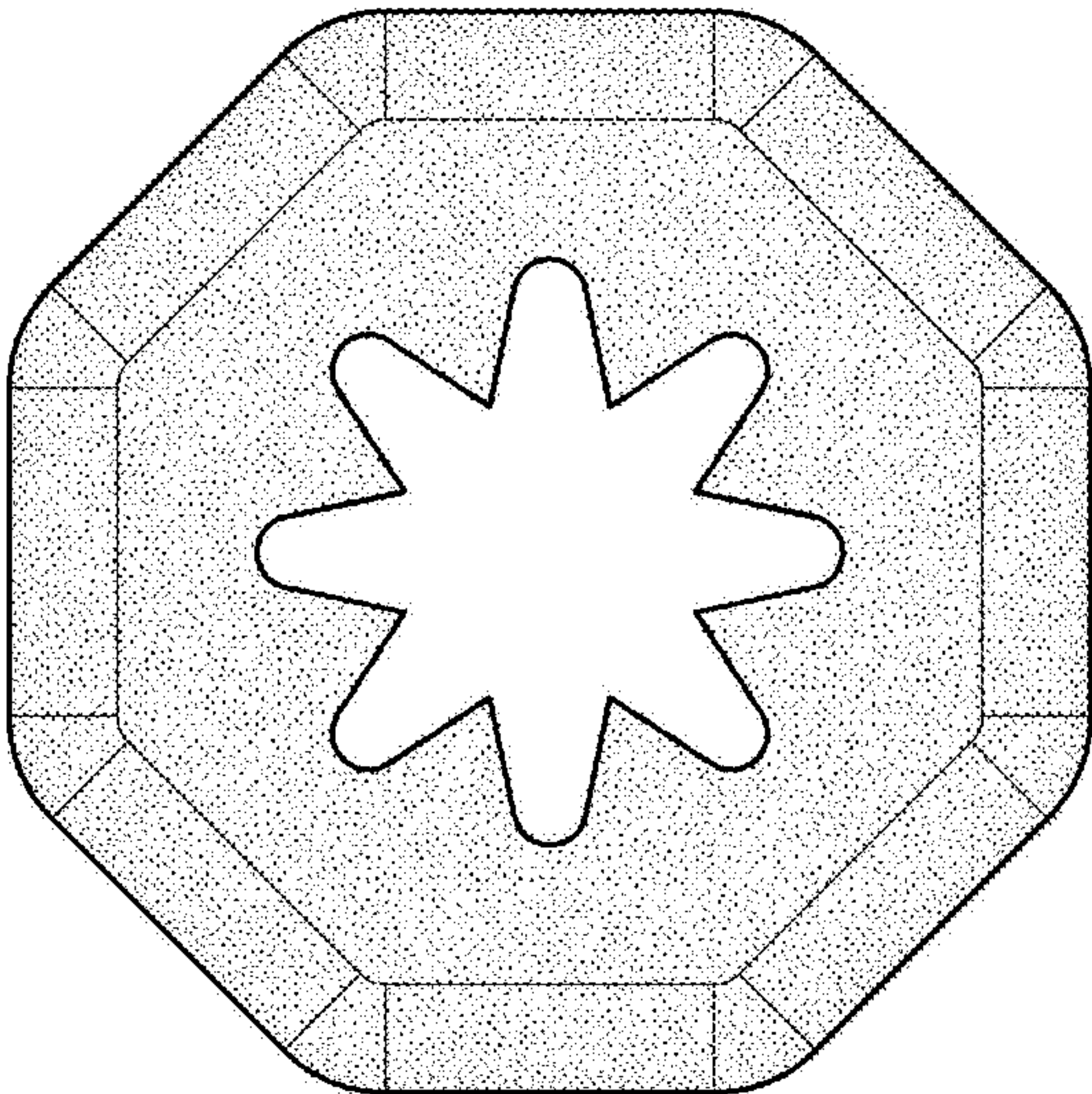

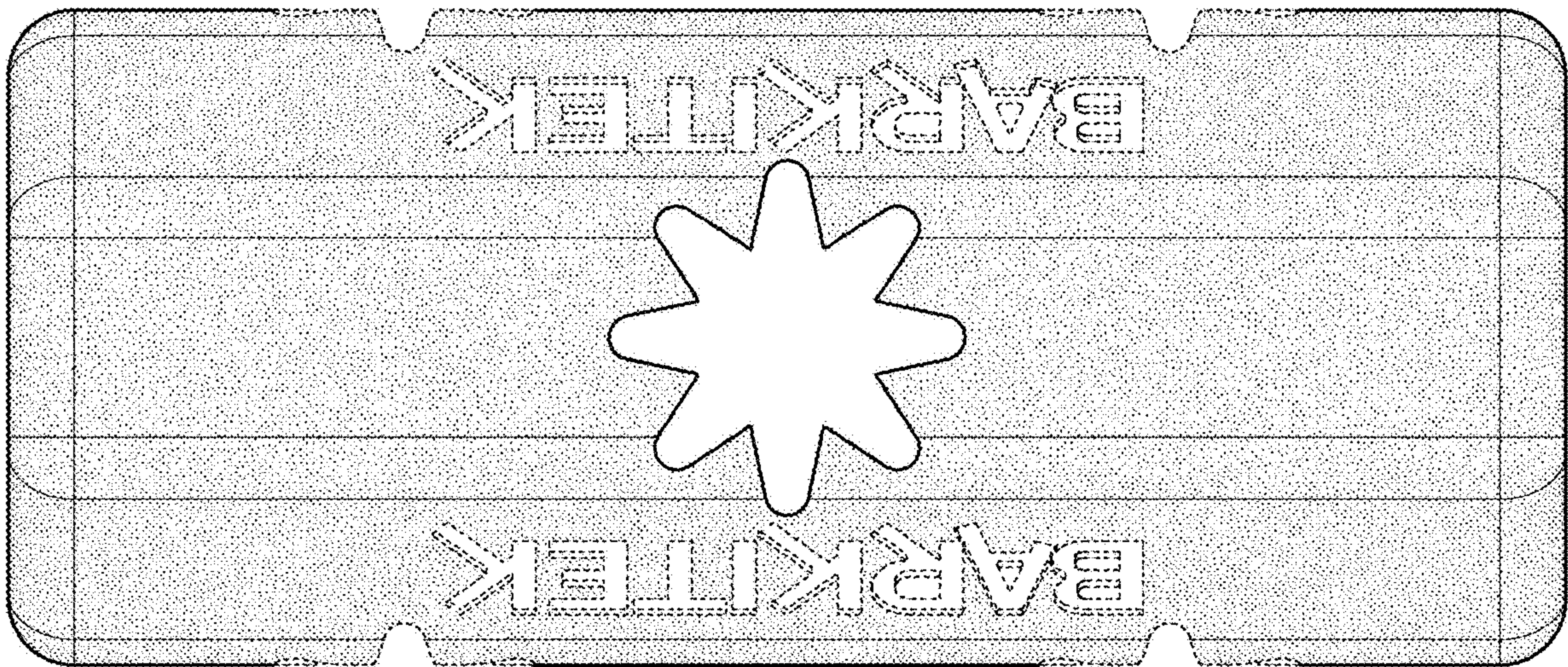

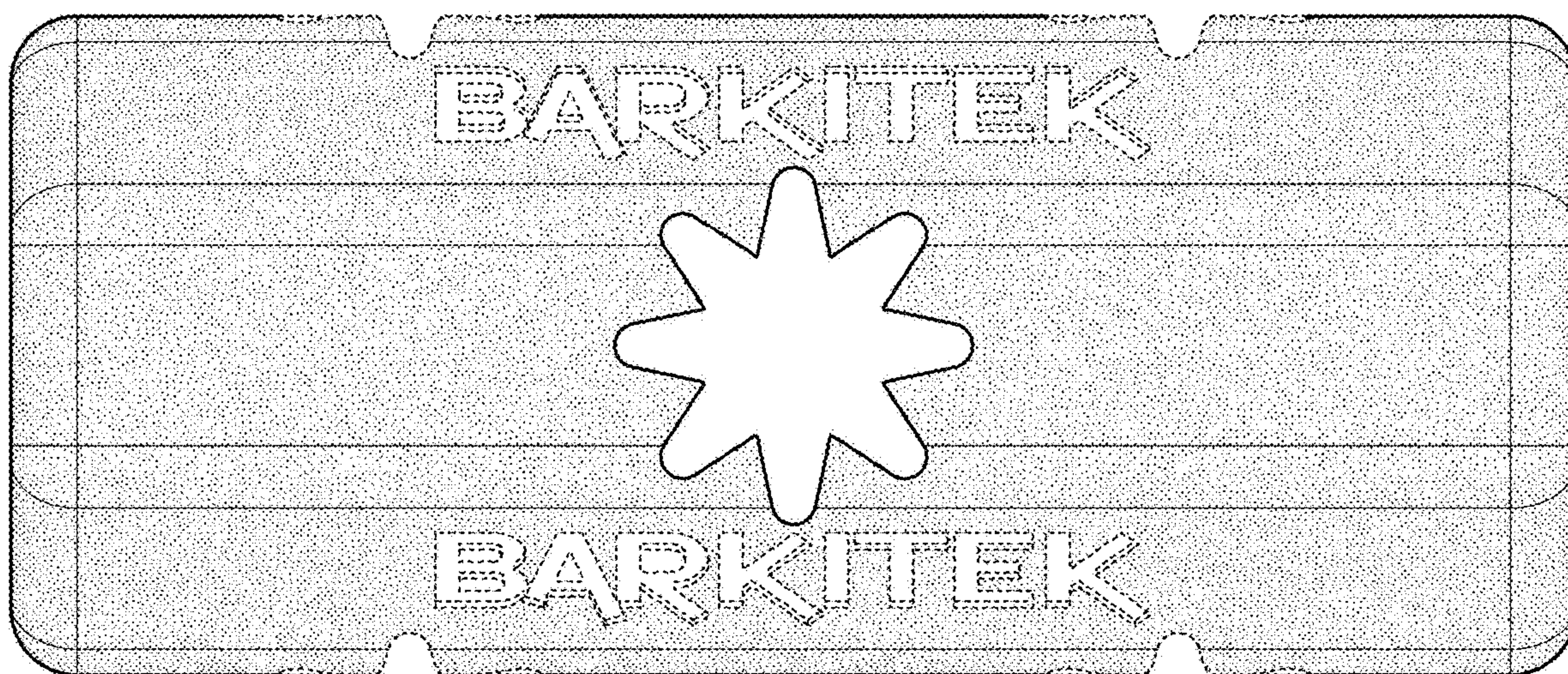

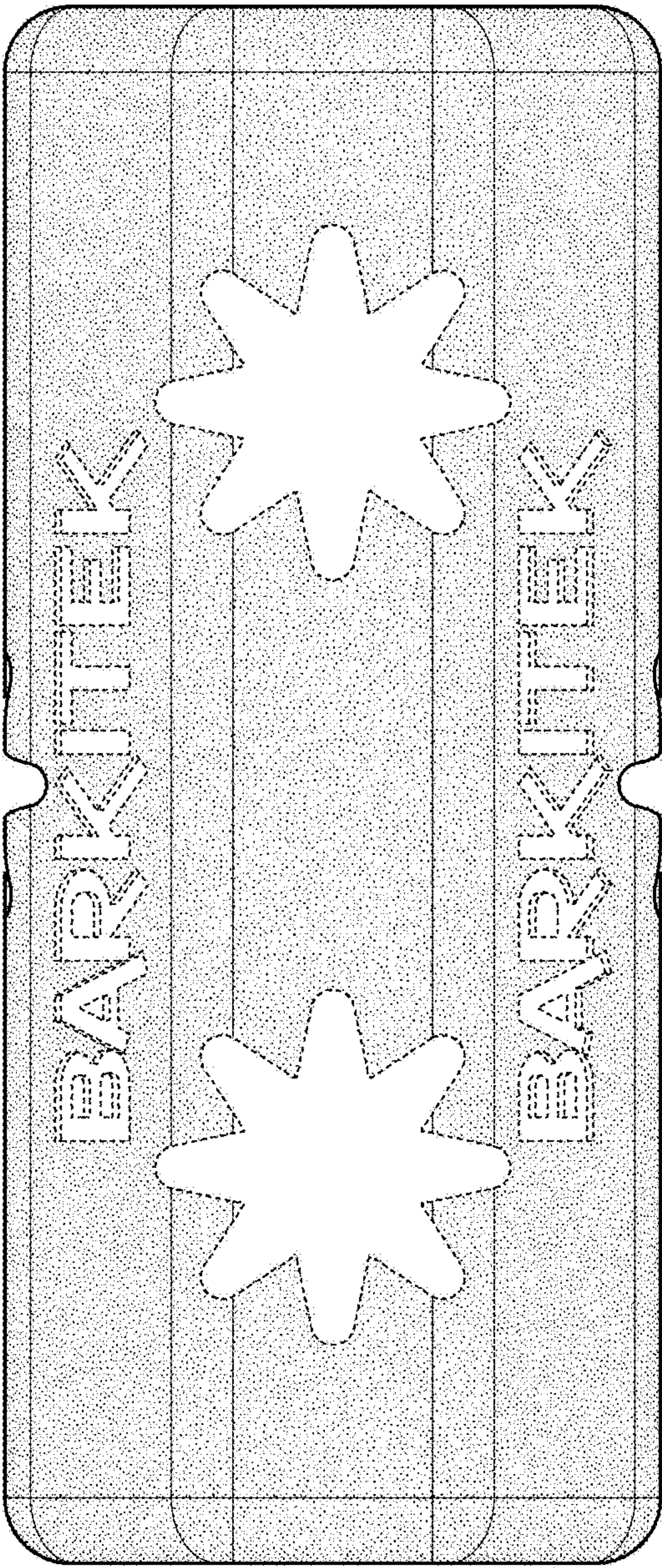

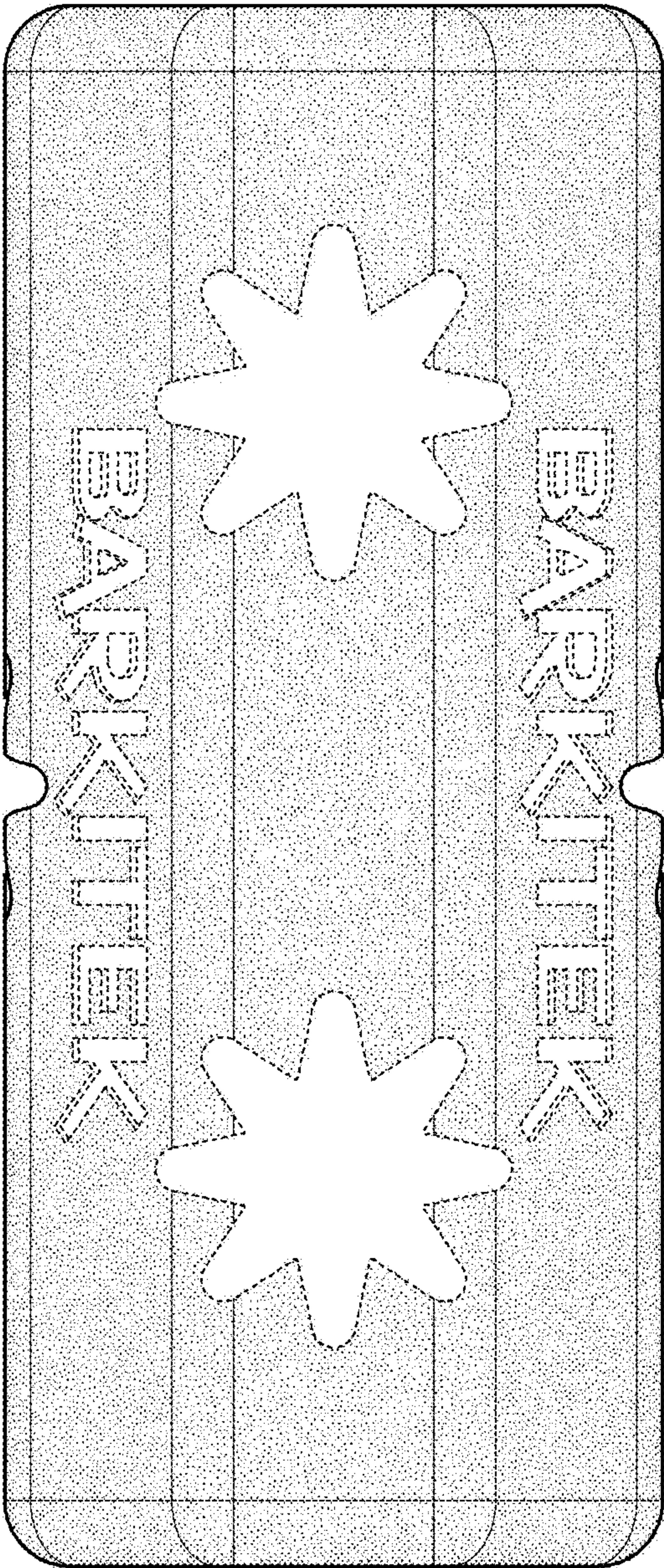
