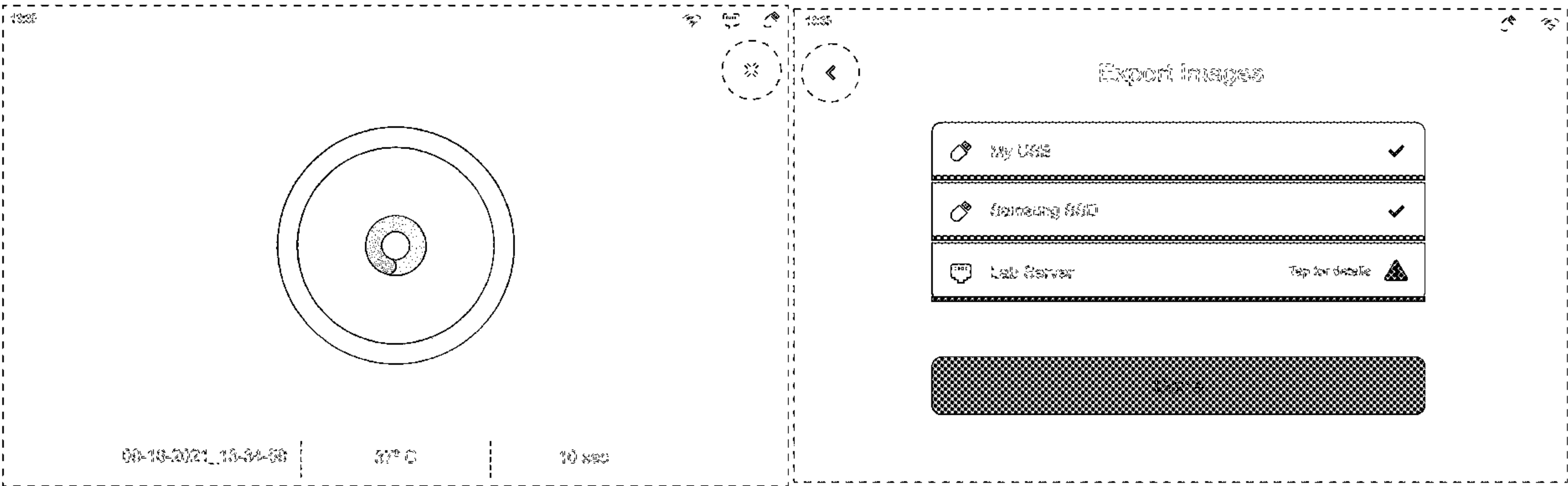

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 10 is a front view of a tenth image in the sequence according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a front view of an eleventh image in the sequence according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 12 is a front view of a twelfth image in the sequence according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 13 is a front view of a thirteenth image in the sequence according to the first embodiment;

FIG. 14 is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof with transitional graphical user interface showing a first image in a sequence according to a second embodiment of the claimed design, wherein the portions of the transitional graphical user interface that contrast with the display screen or portion thereof are indicated using a slanted line hatching pattern;

FIG. 15 is a front view of a second image in the sequence according to the second embodiment;

FIG. 16 is a front view of a third image in the sequence according to the second embodiment;

FIG. 25 is a front view of a twelfth image in the sequence according to the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 26 is a front view of a thirteenth image in the sequence according to the second embodiment.

FIG. 14 to FIG. 26 are lined for color.

The outermost broken lines showing the display screen or portion thereof forms no part of the claimed design. The remaining broken lines showing the graphical user interface form no part of the claimed design.

The appearance of the transitional image sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIG. 1 to FIG. 13 in the first embodiment and from FIG. 14 to FIG. 26 in the second embodiment. The process or period in which an image transitions to another image forms no part of the claimed design.

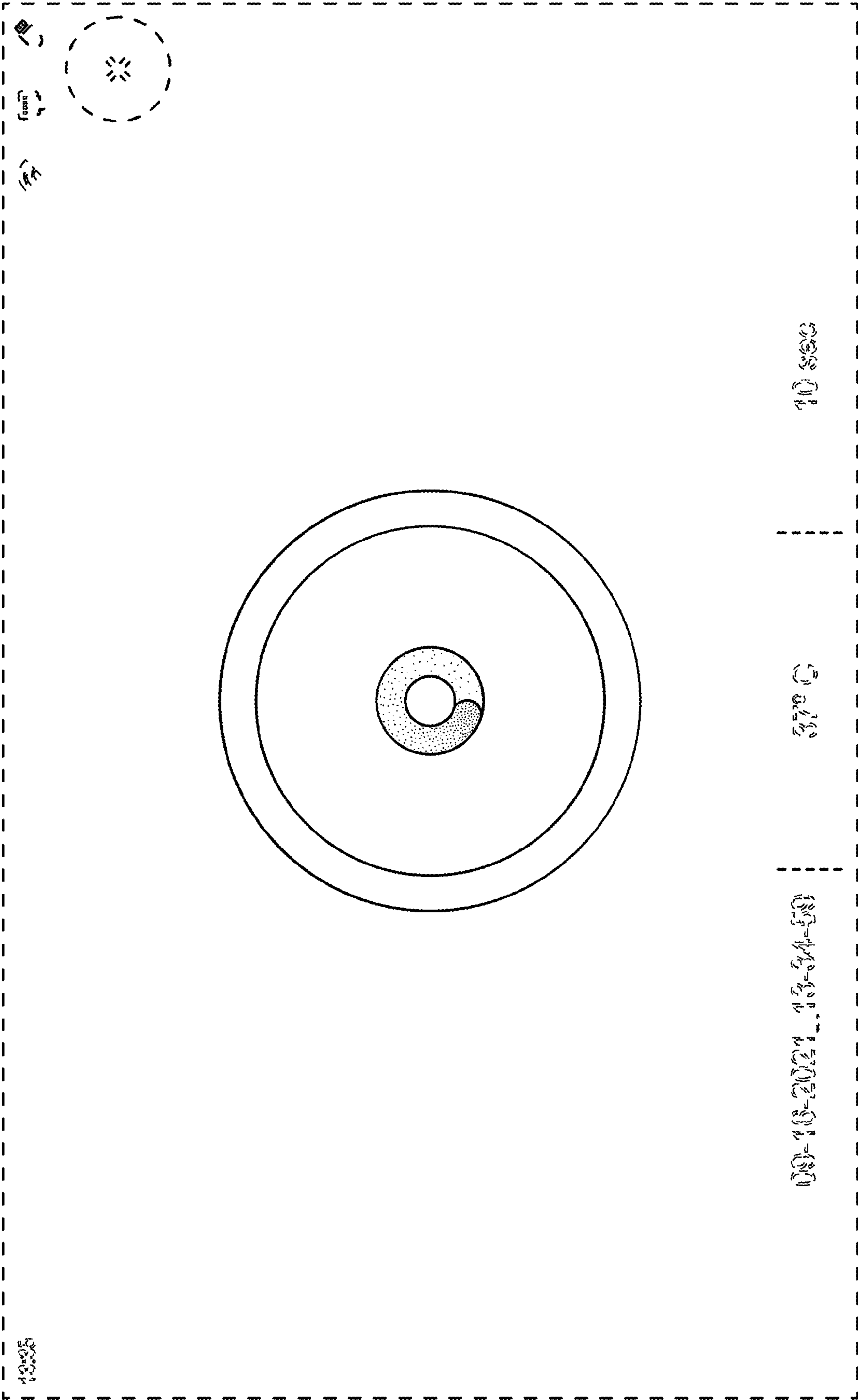


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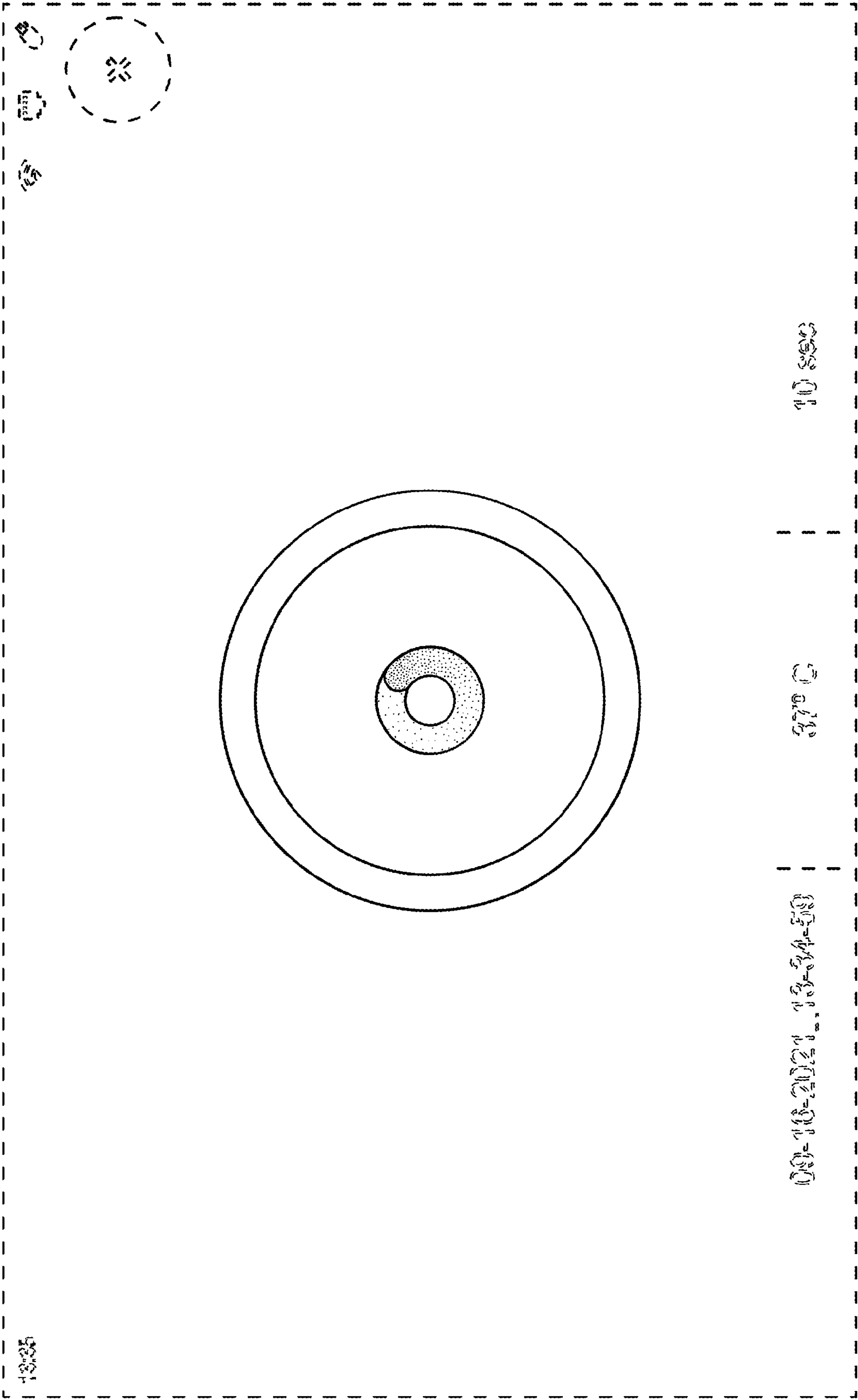


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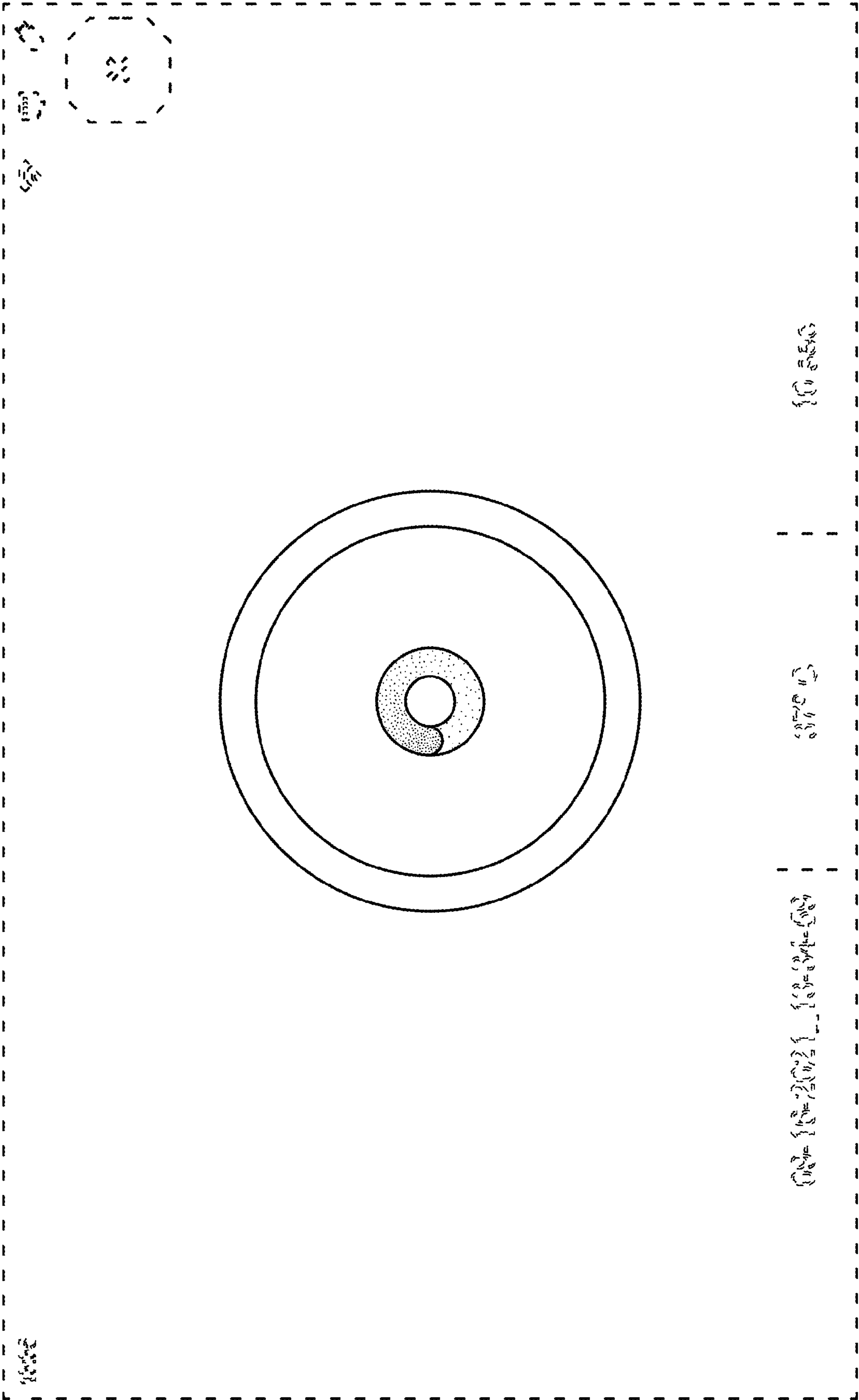


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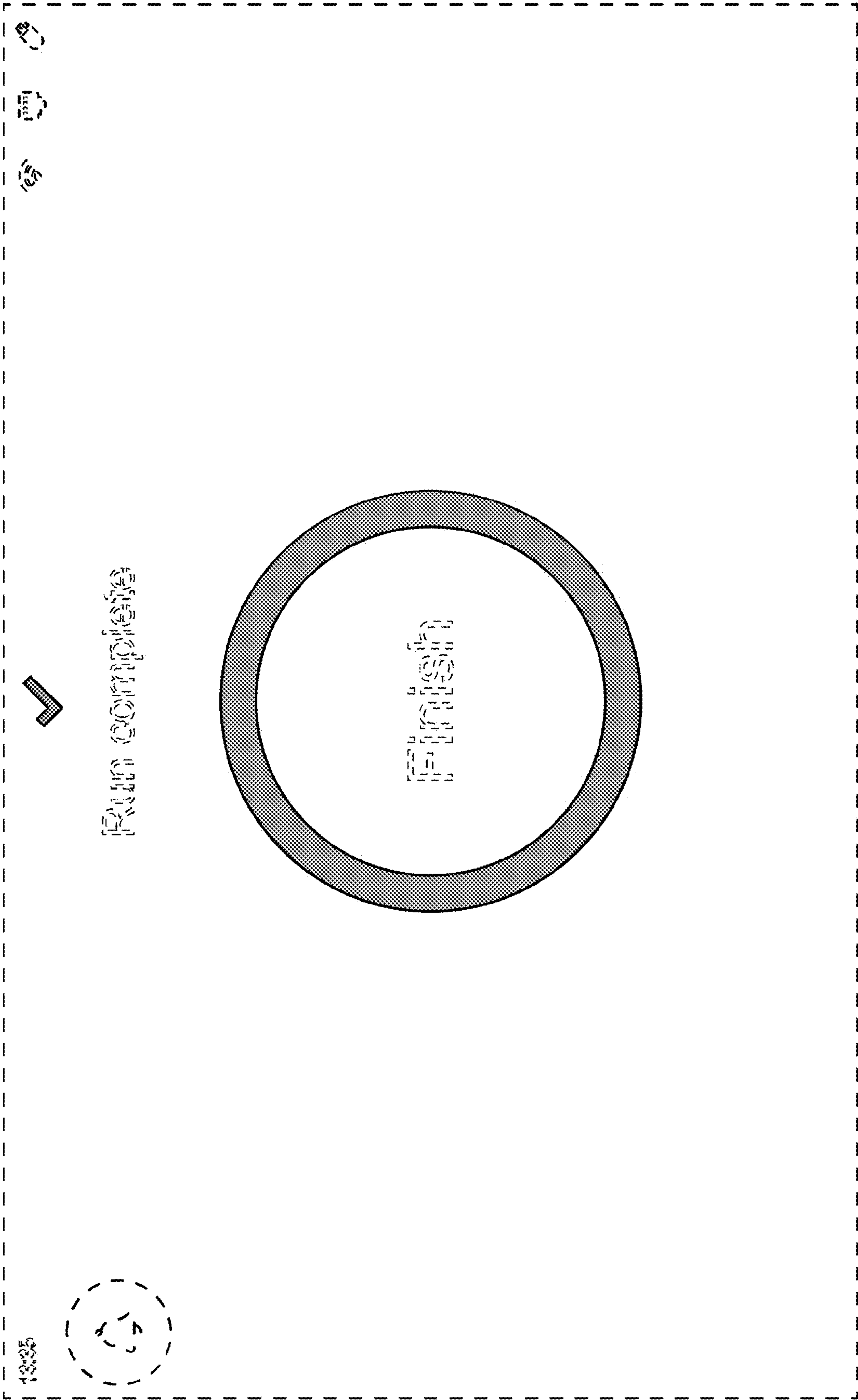


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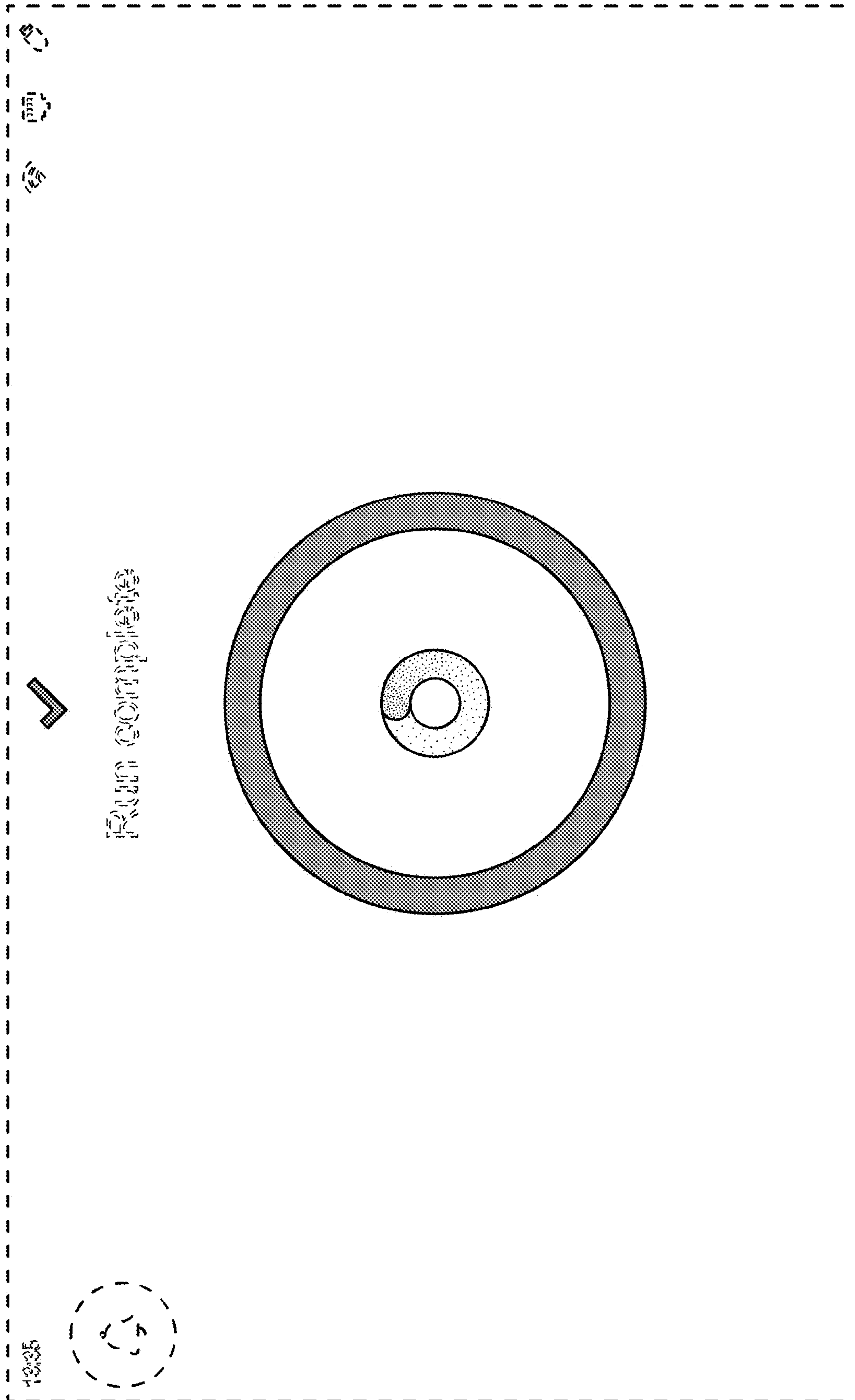

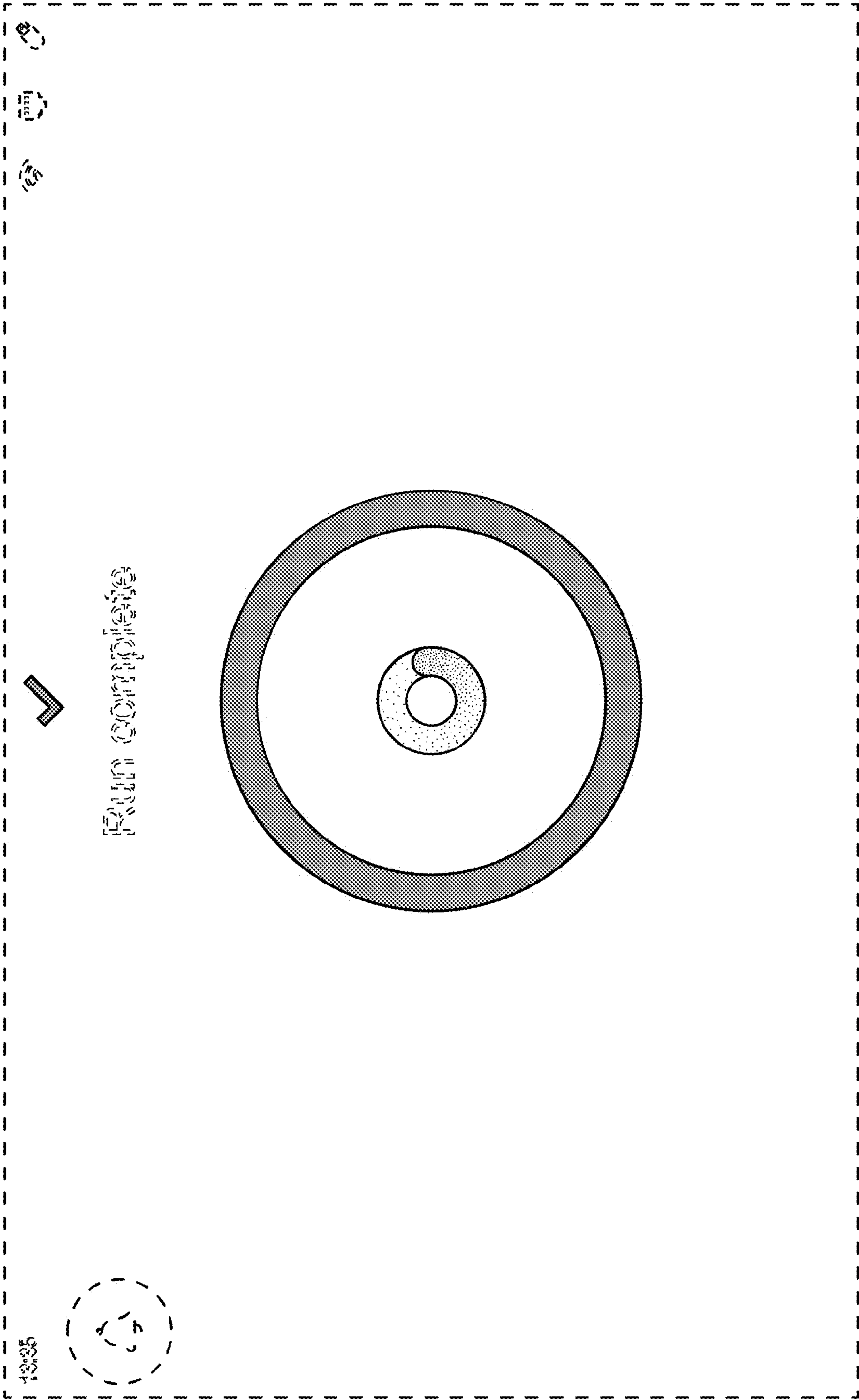


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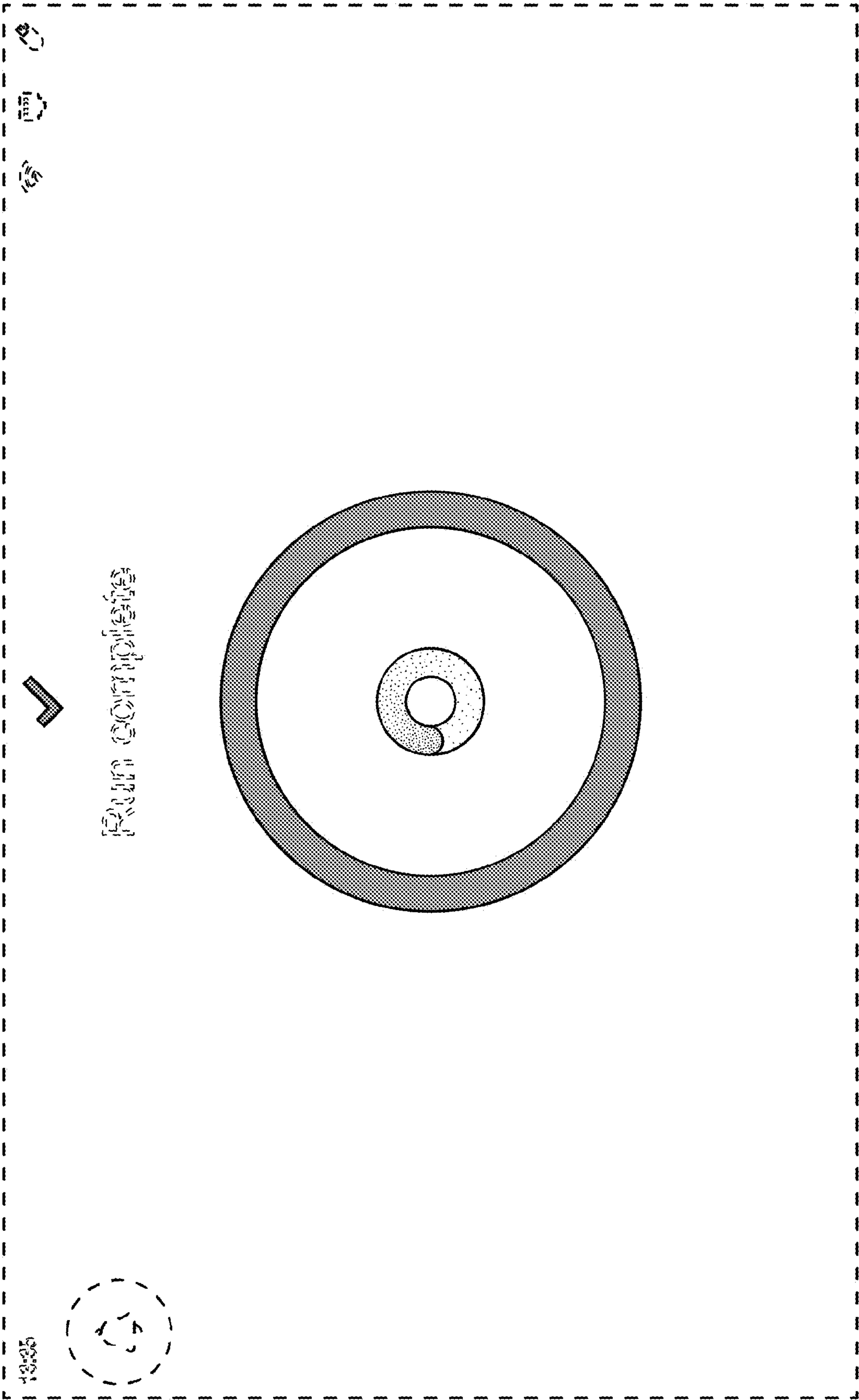


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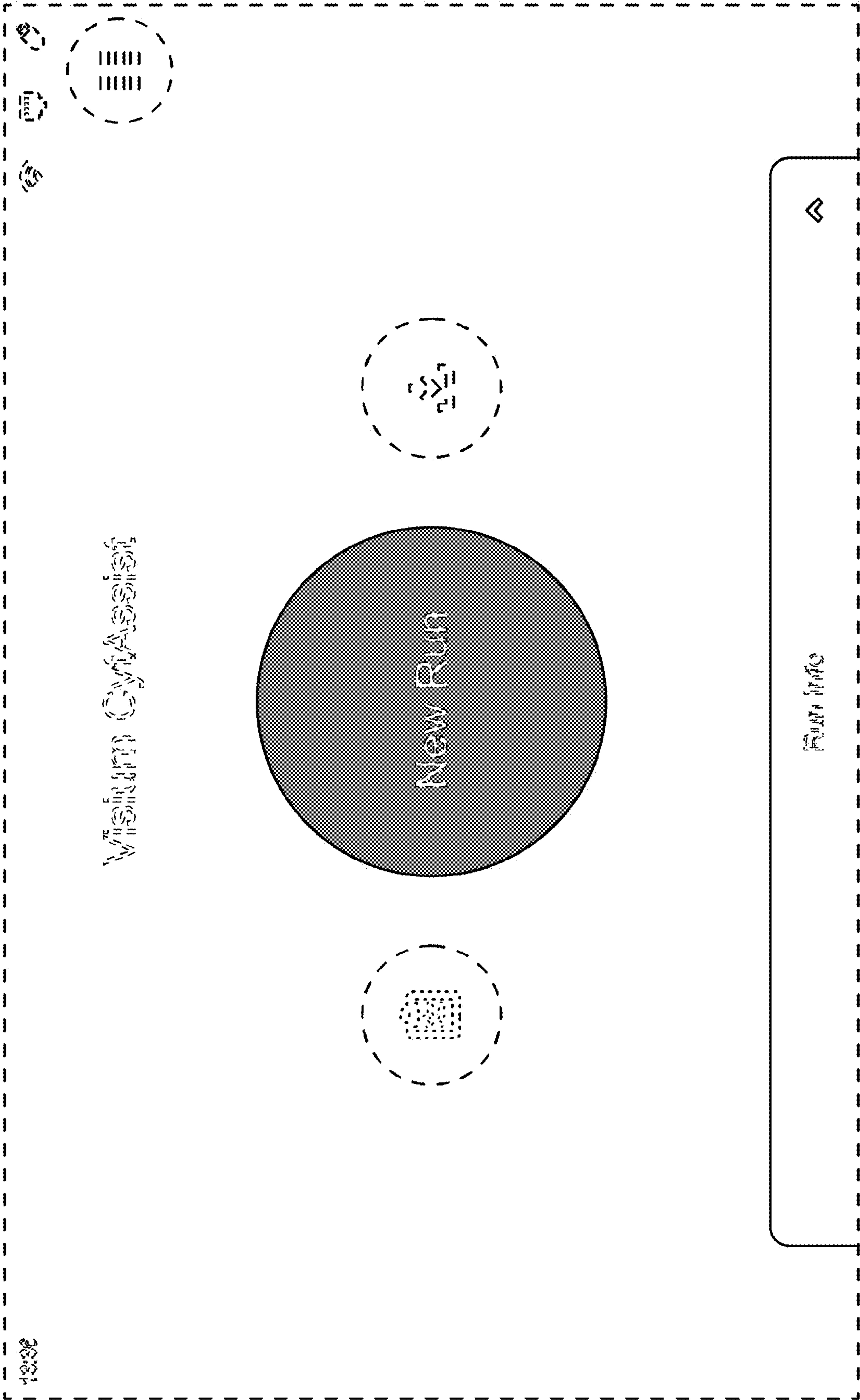
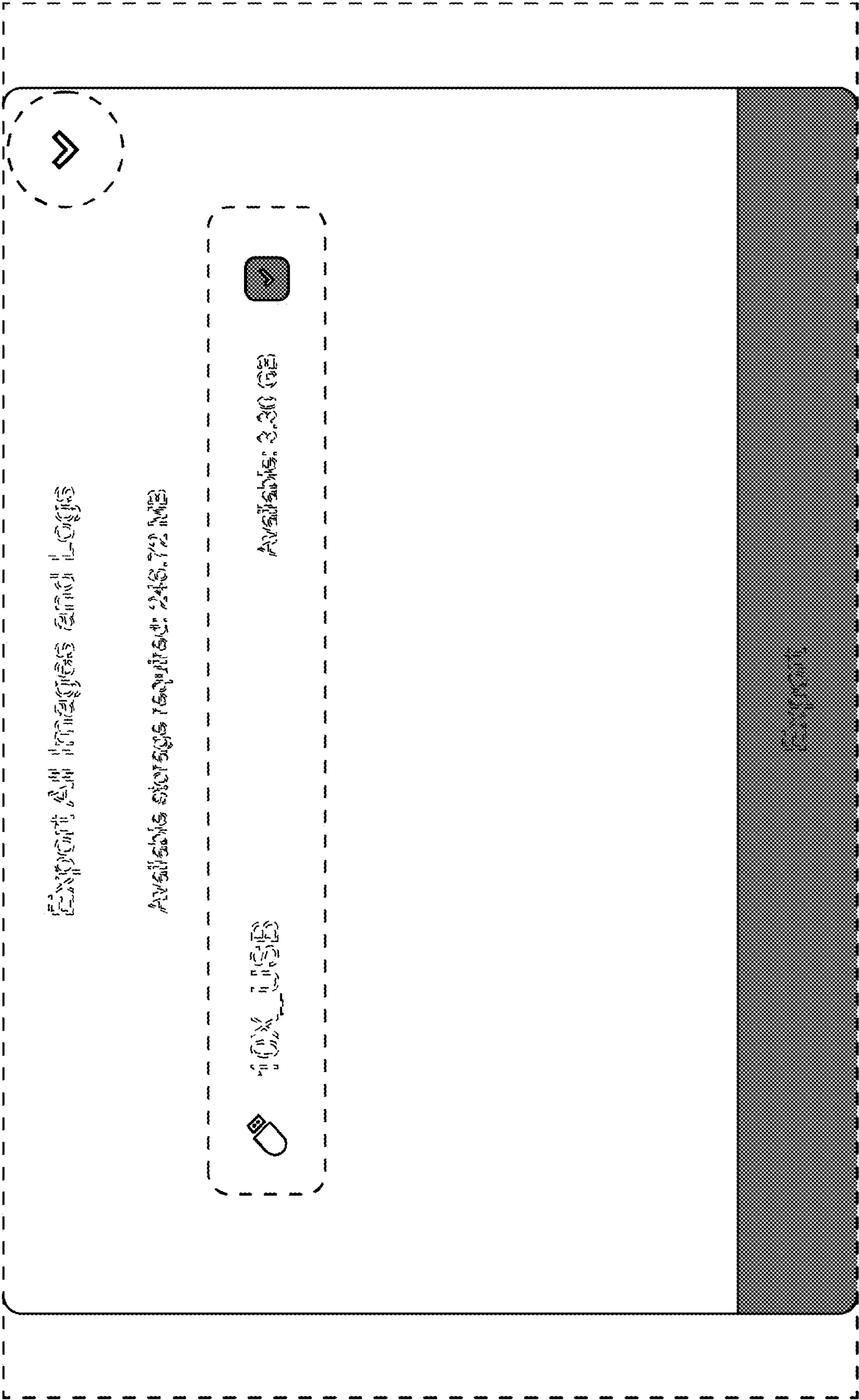

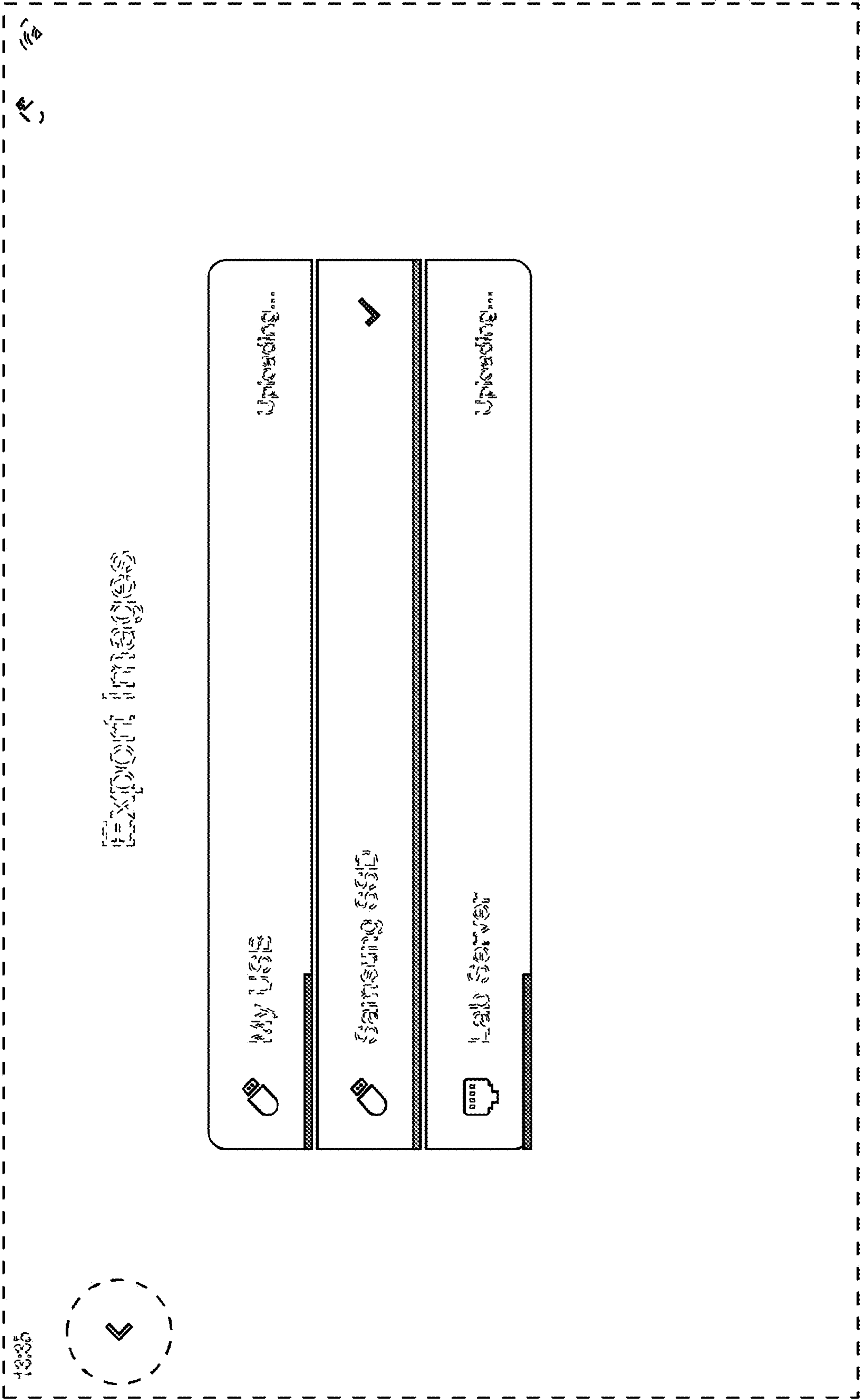


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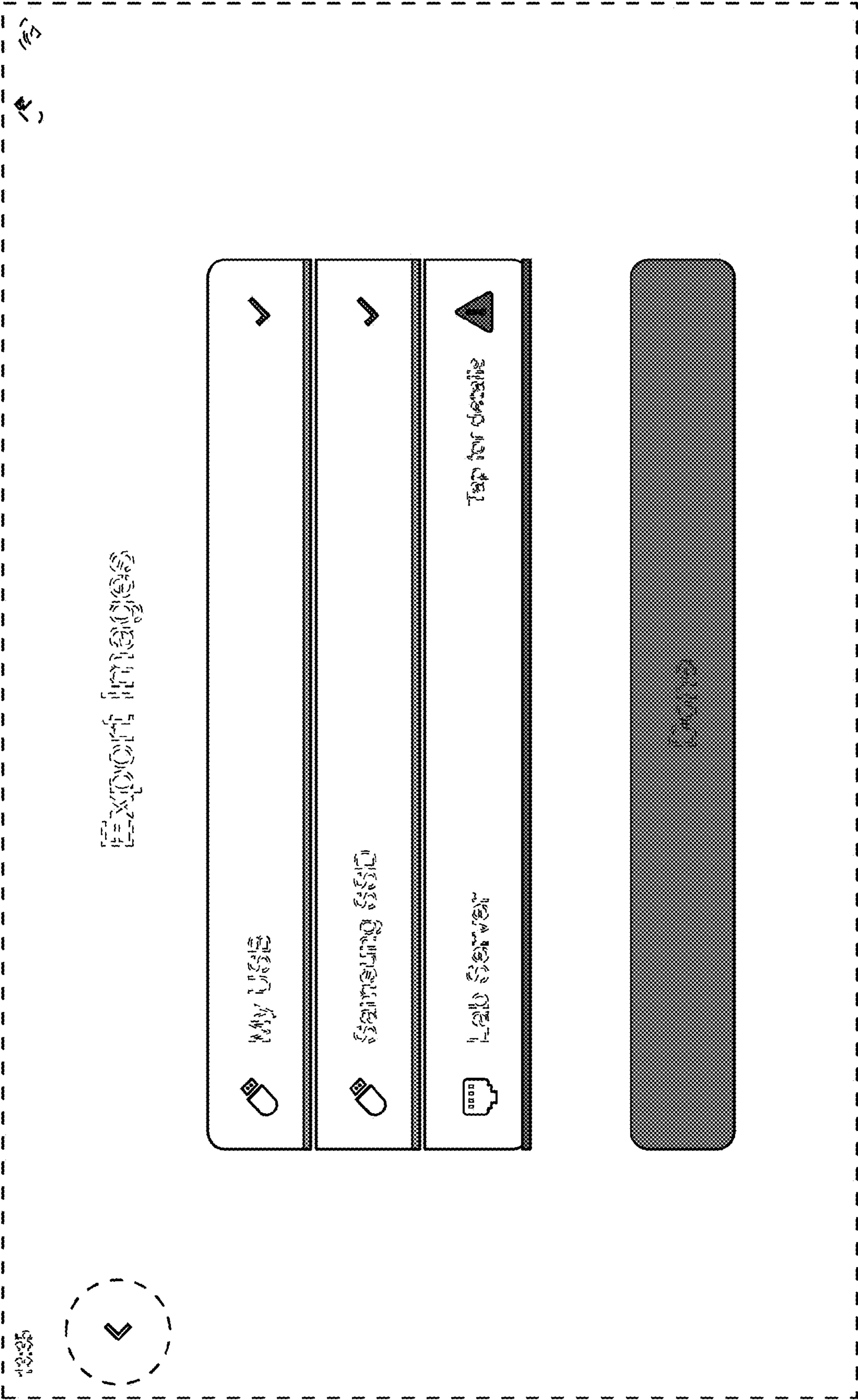

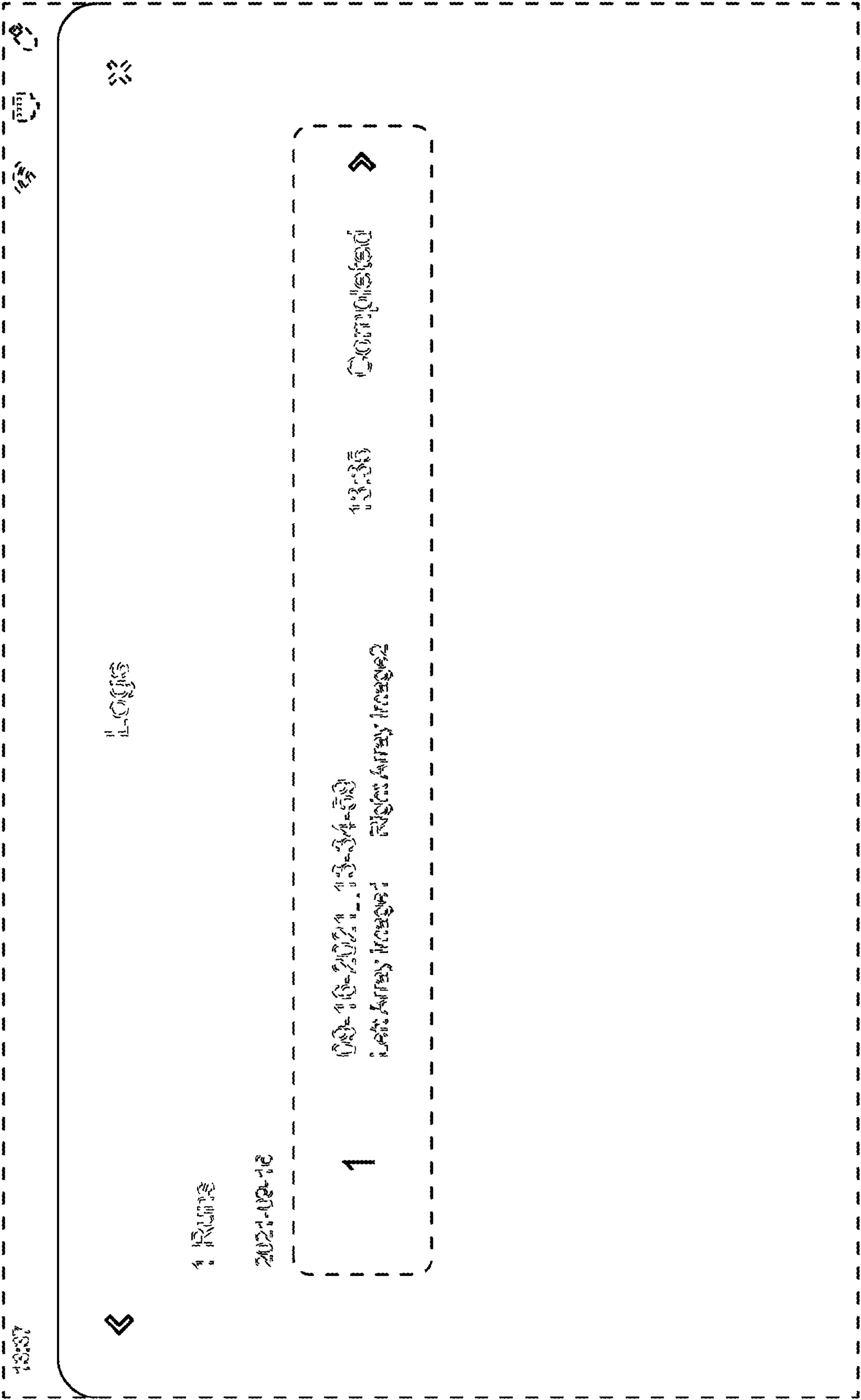

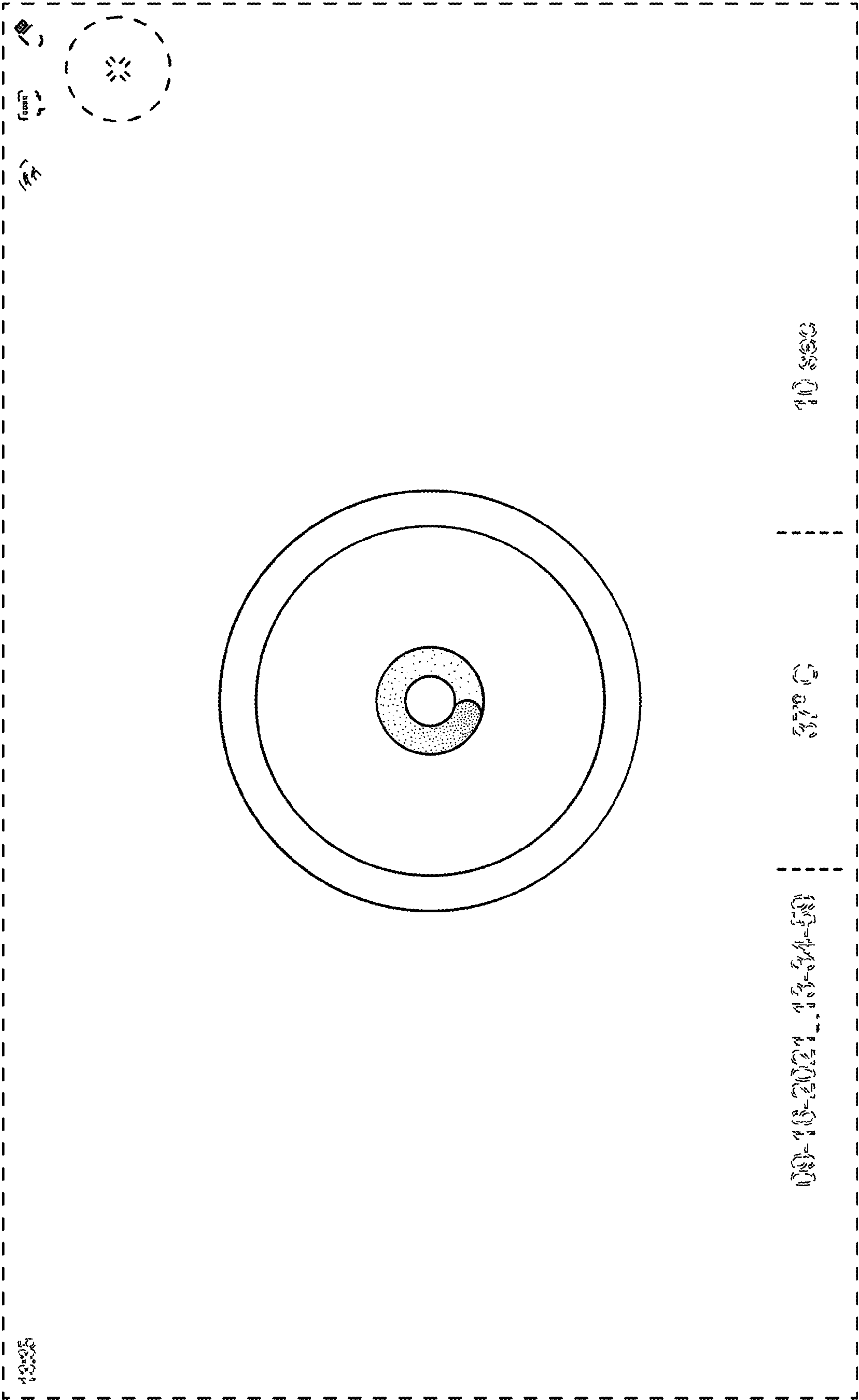


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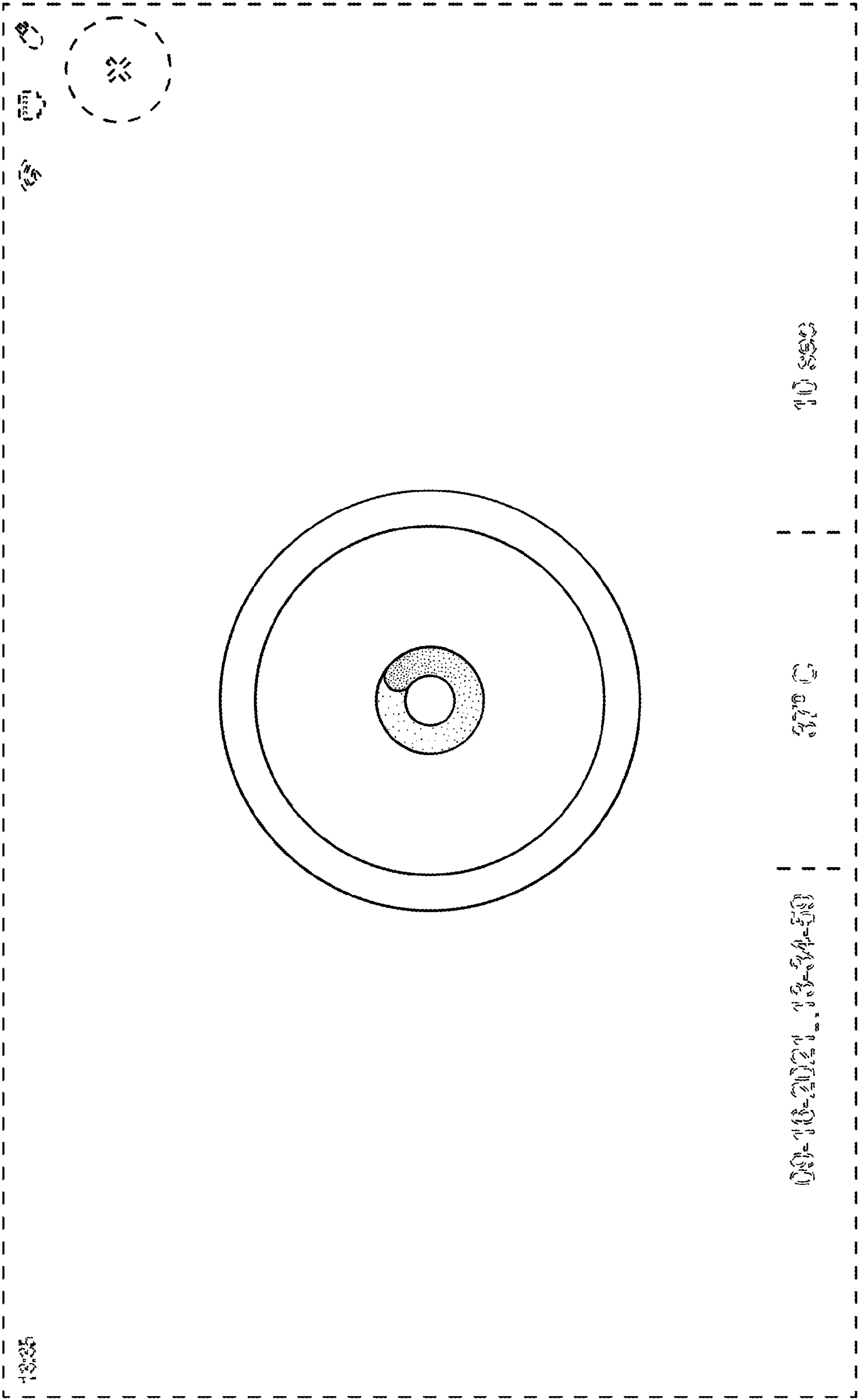


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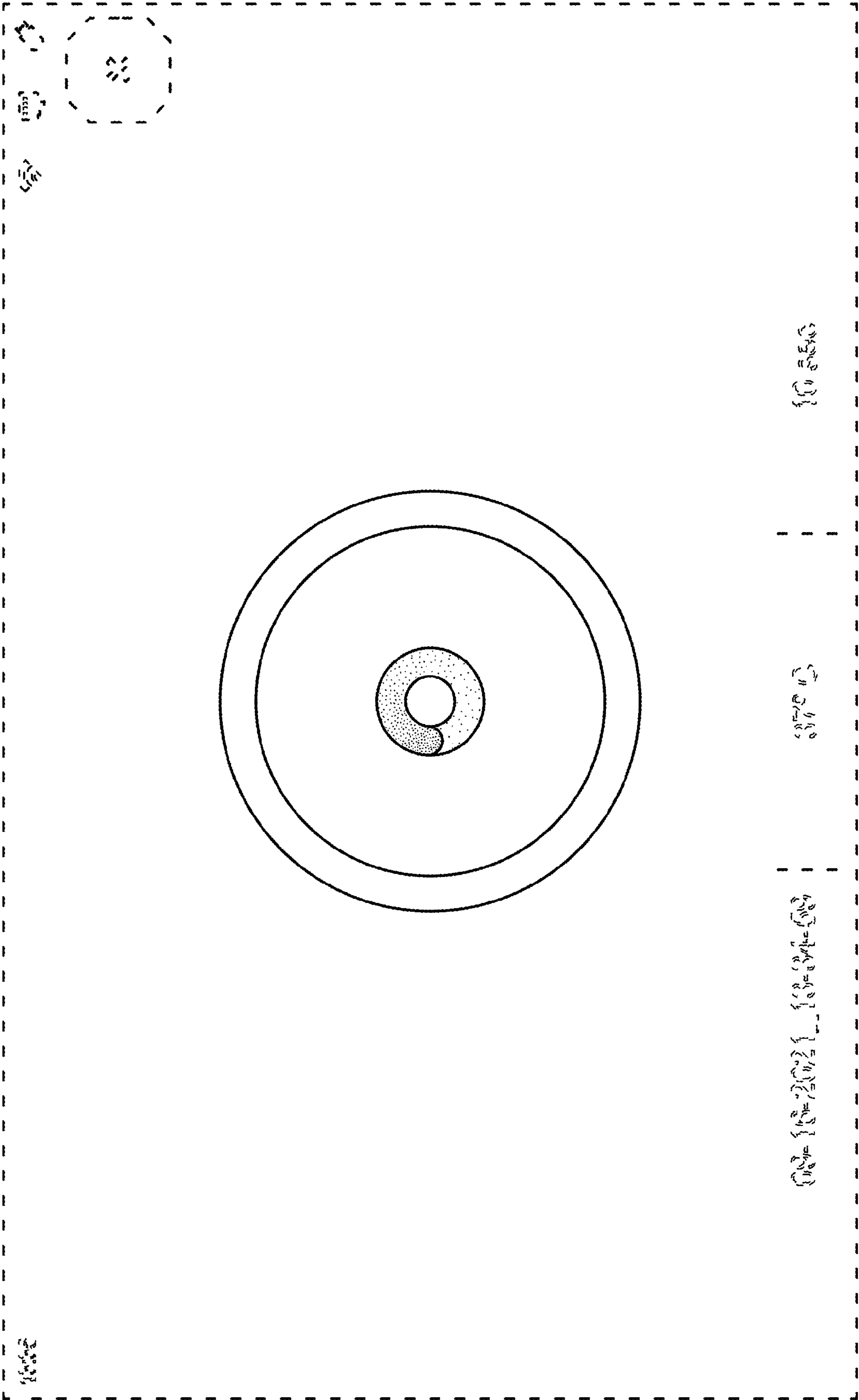


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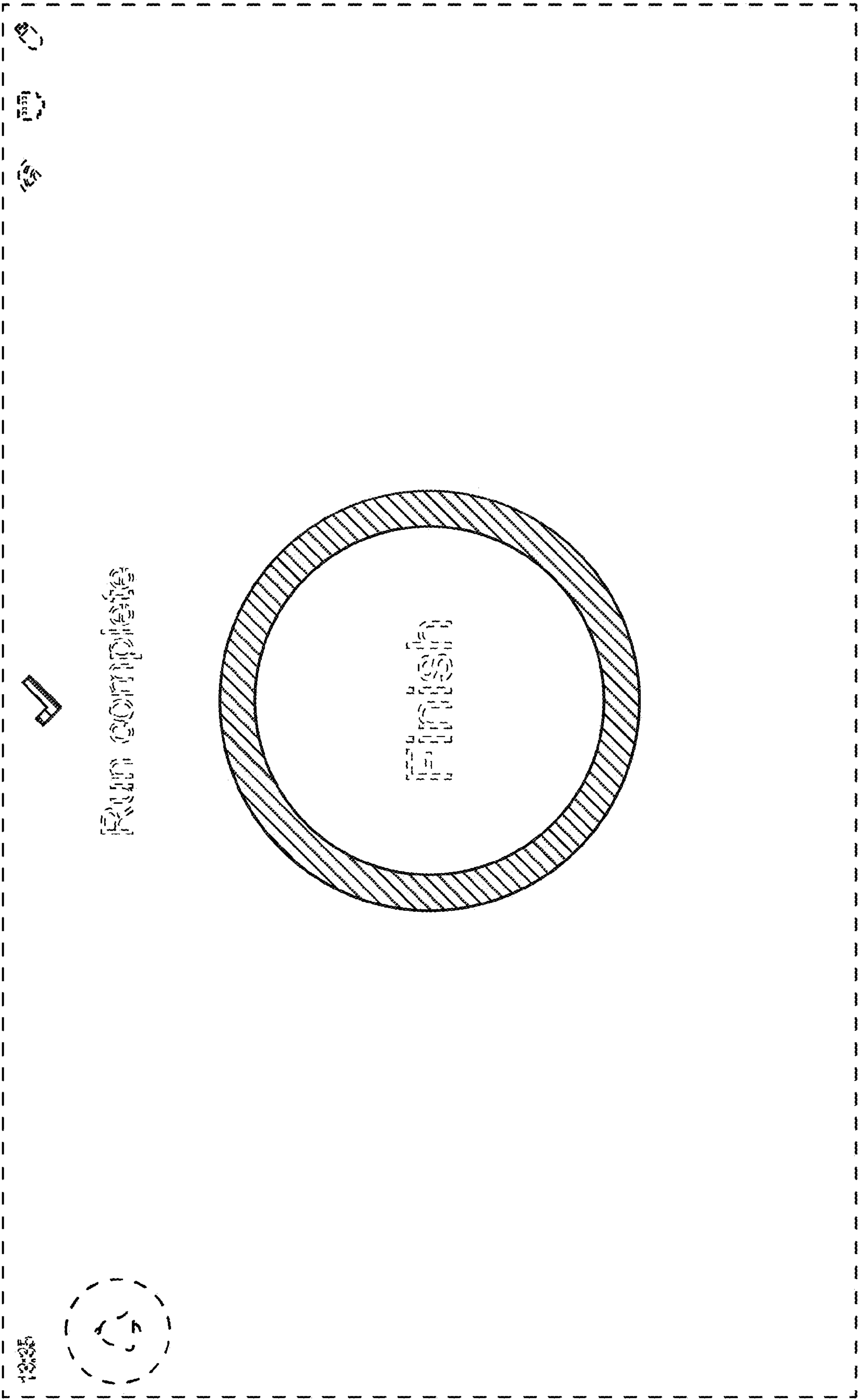


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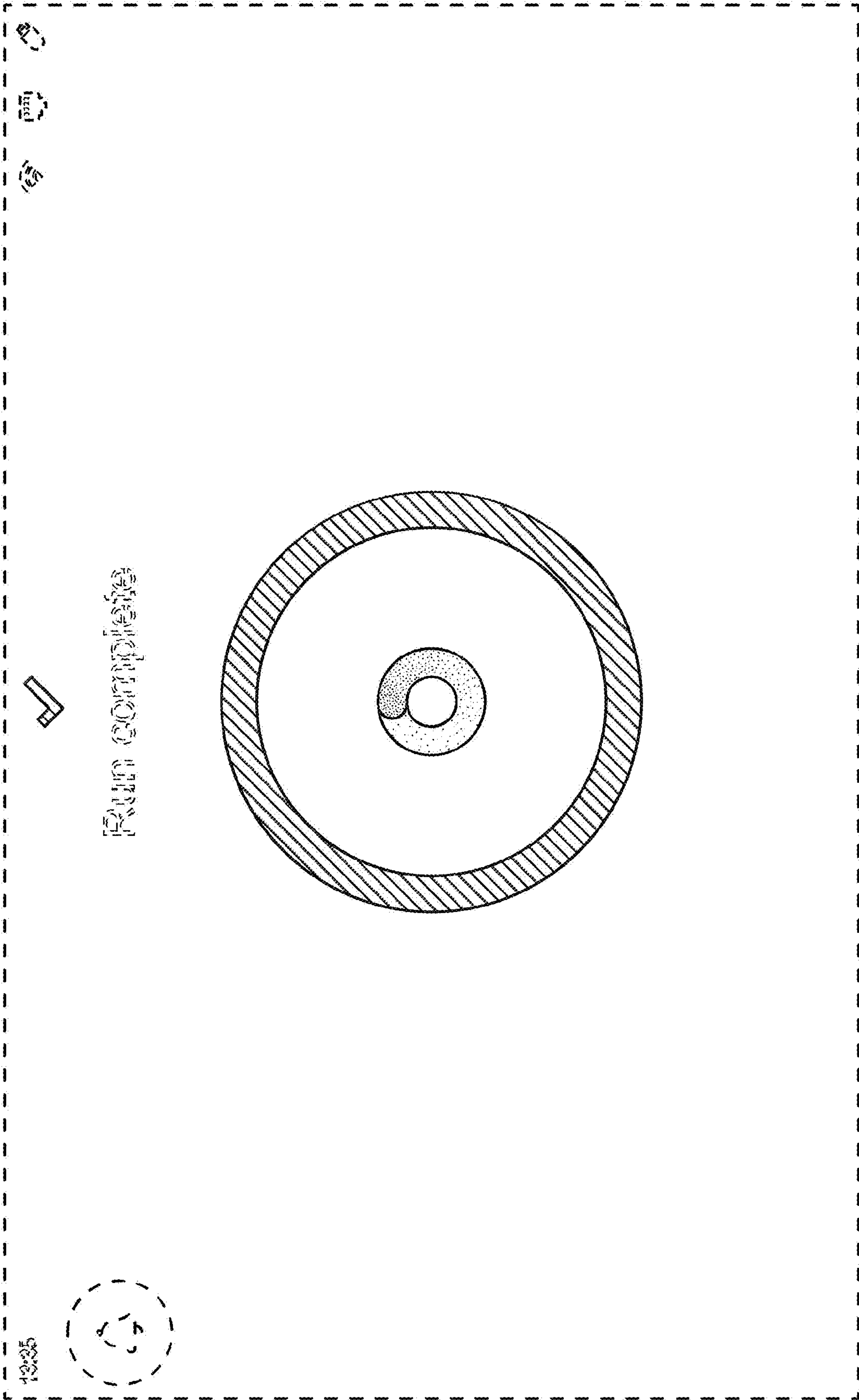


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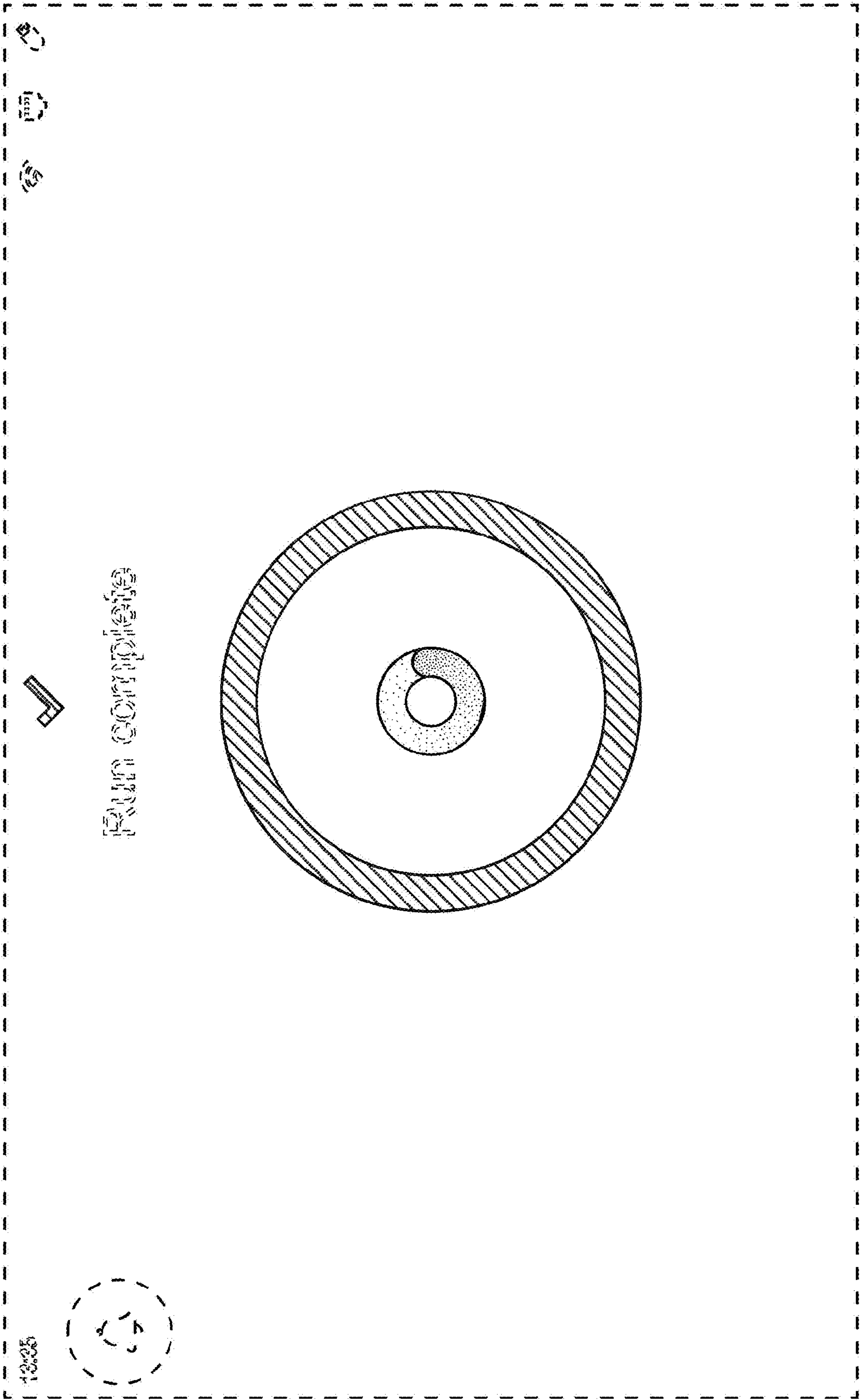


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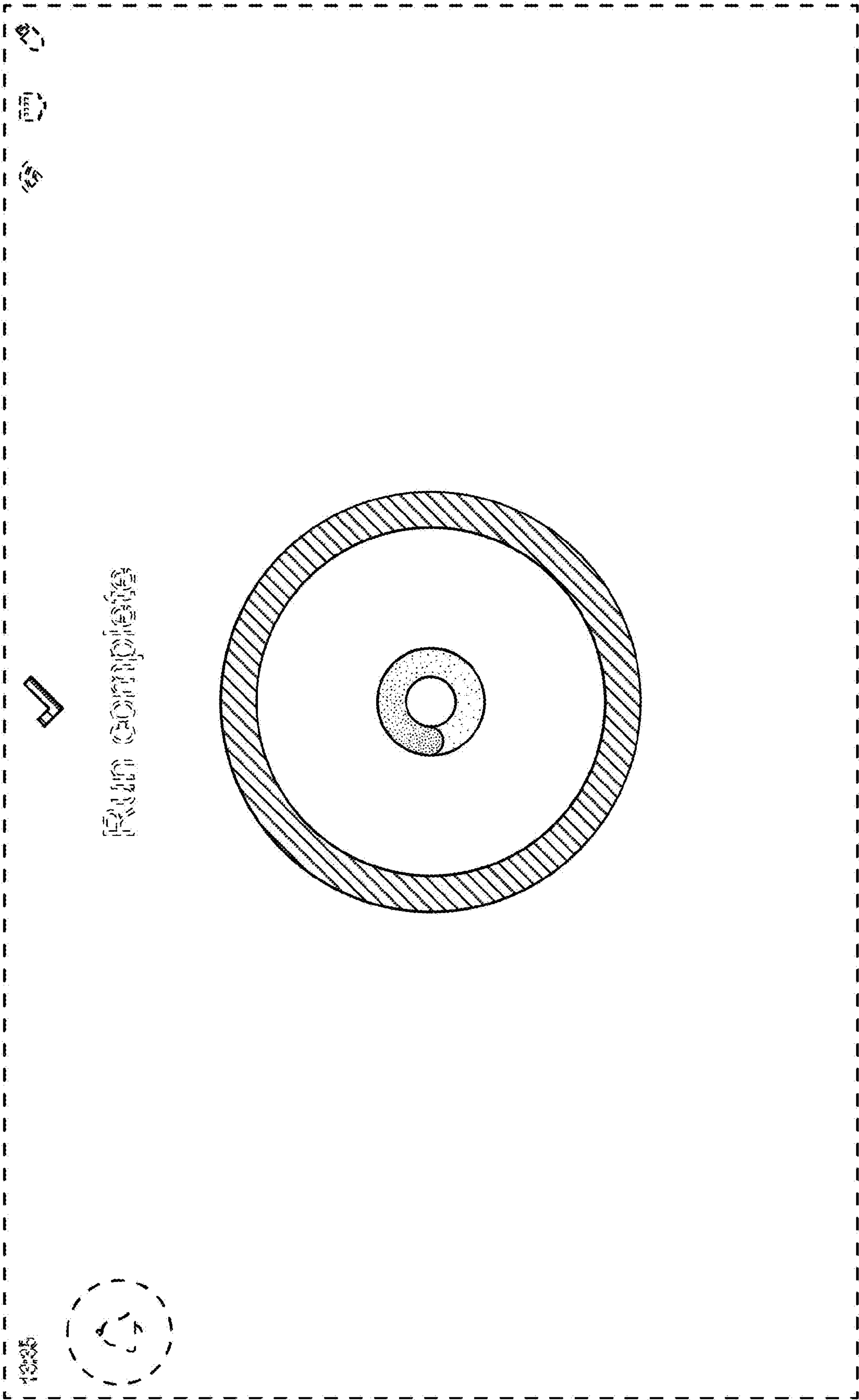


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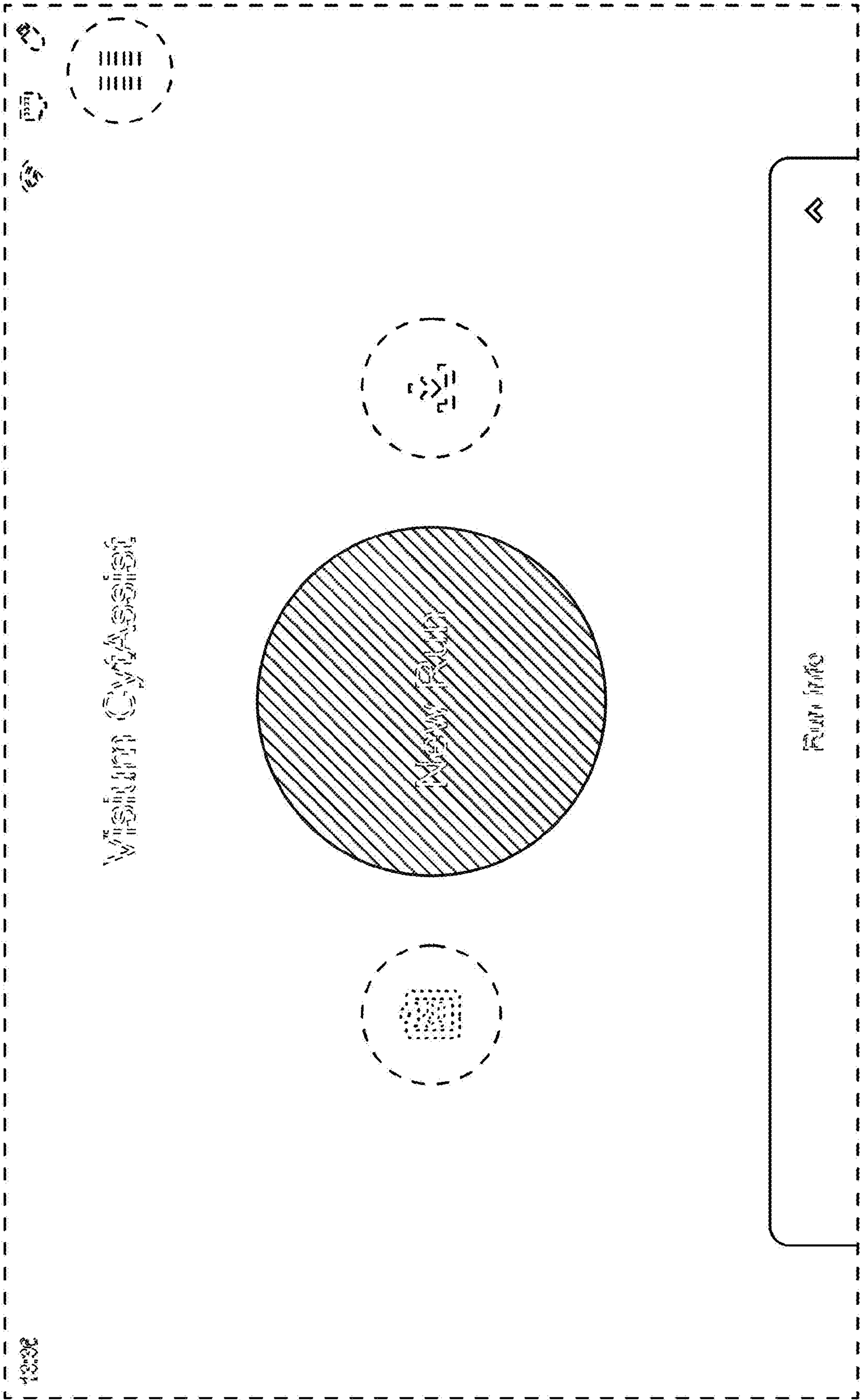

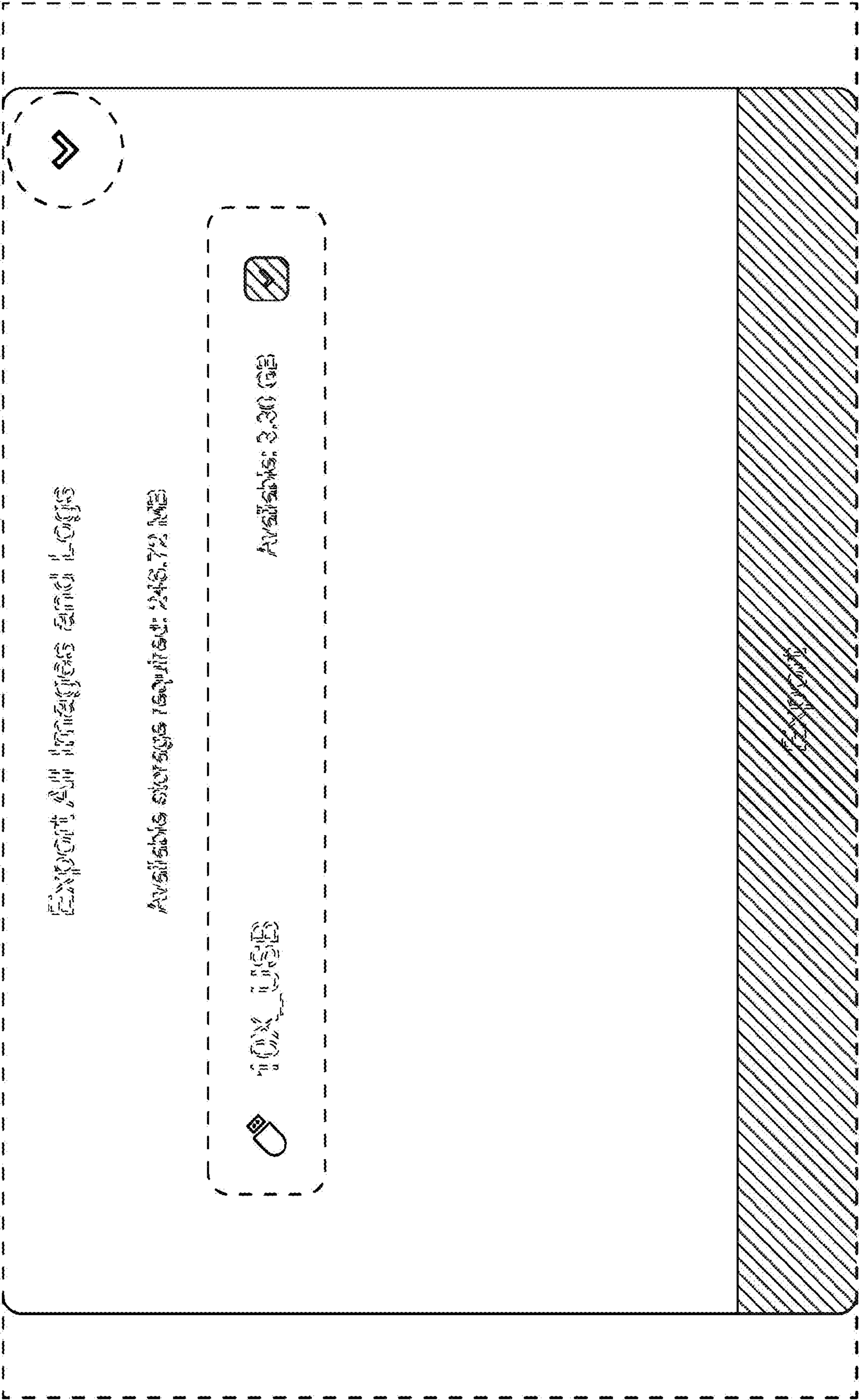

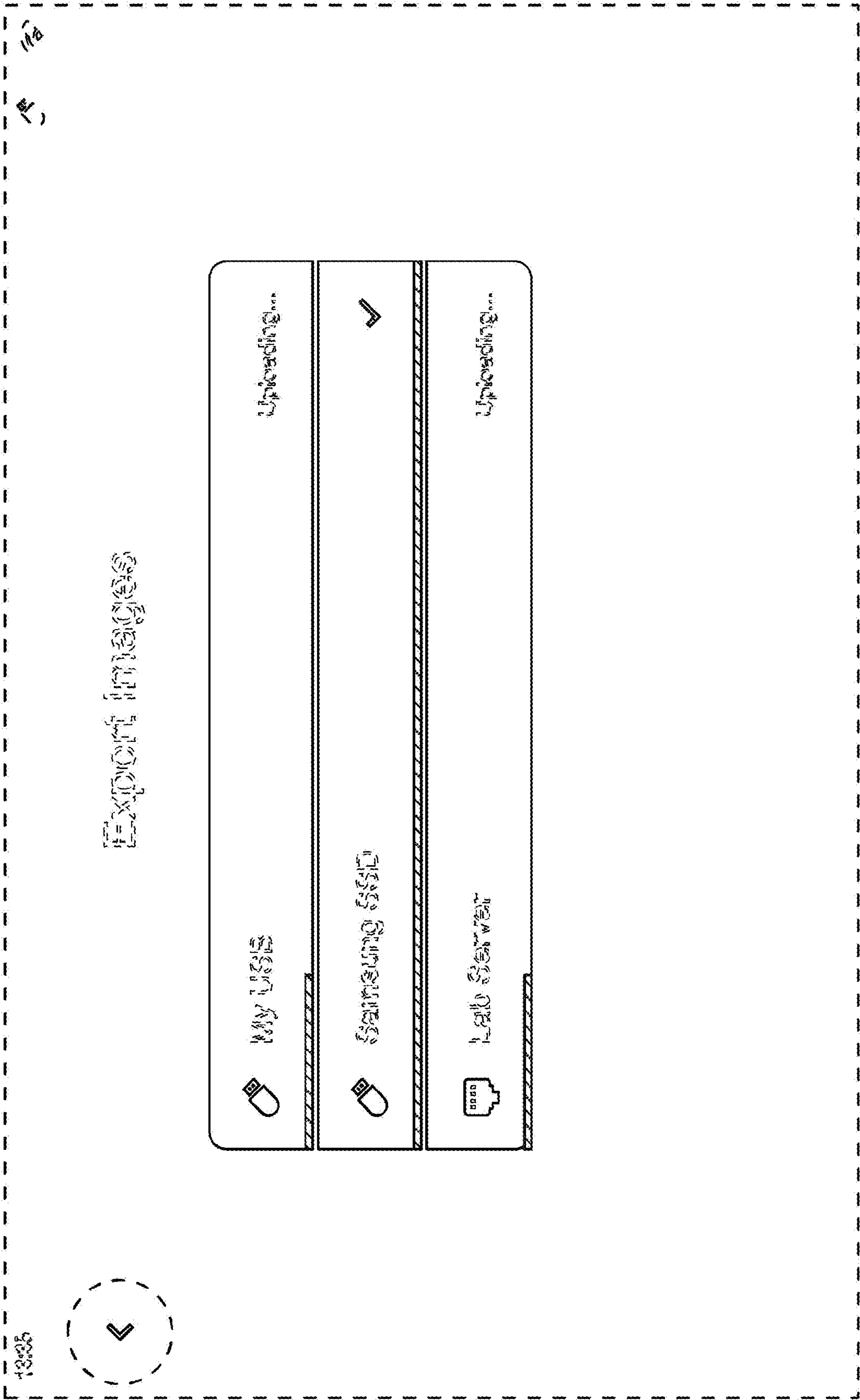

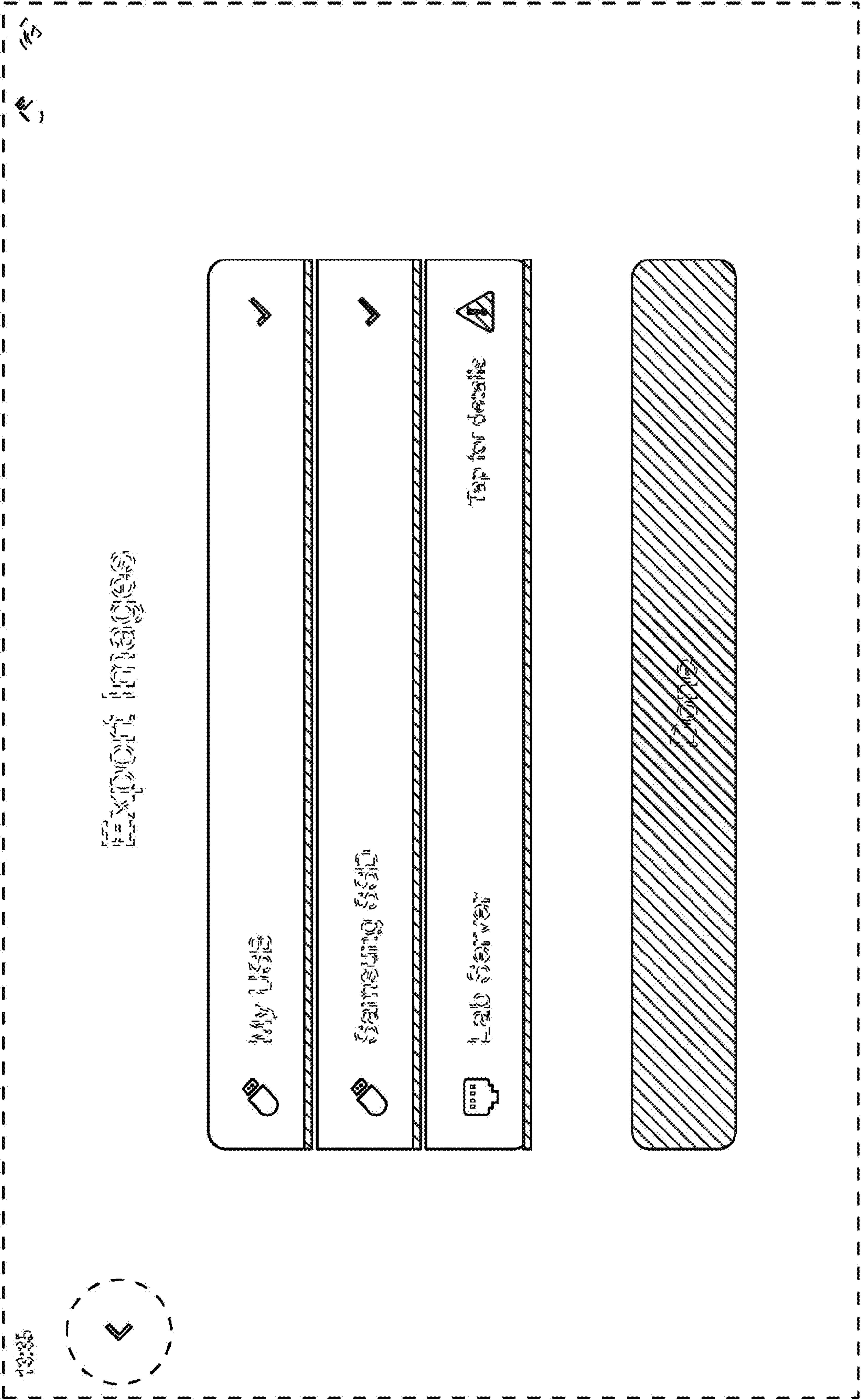

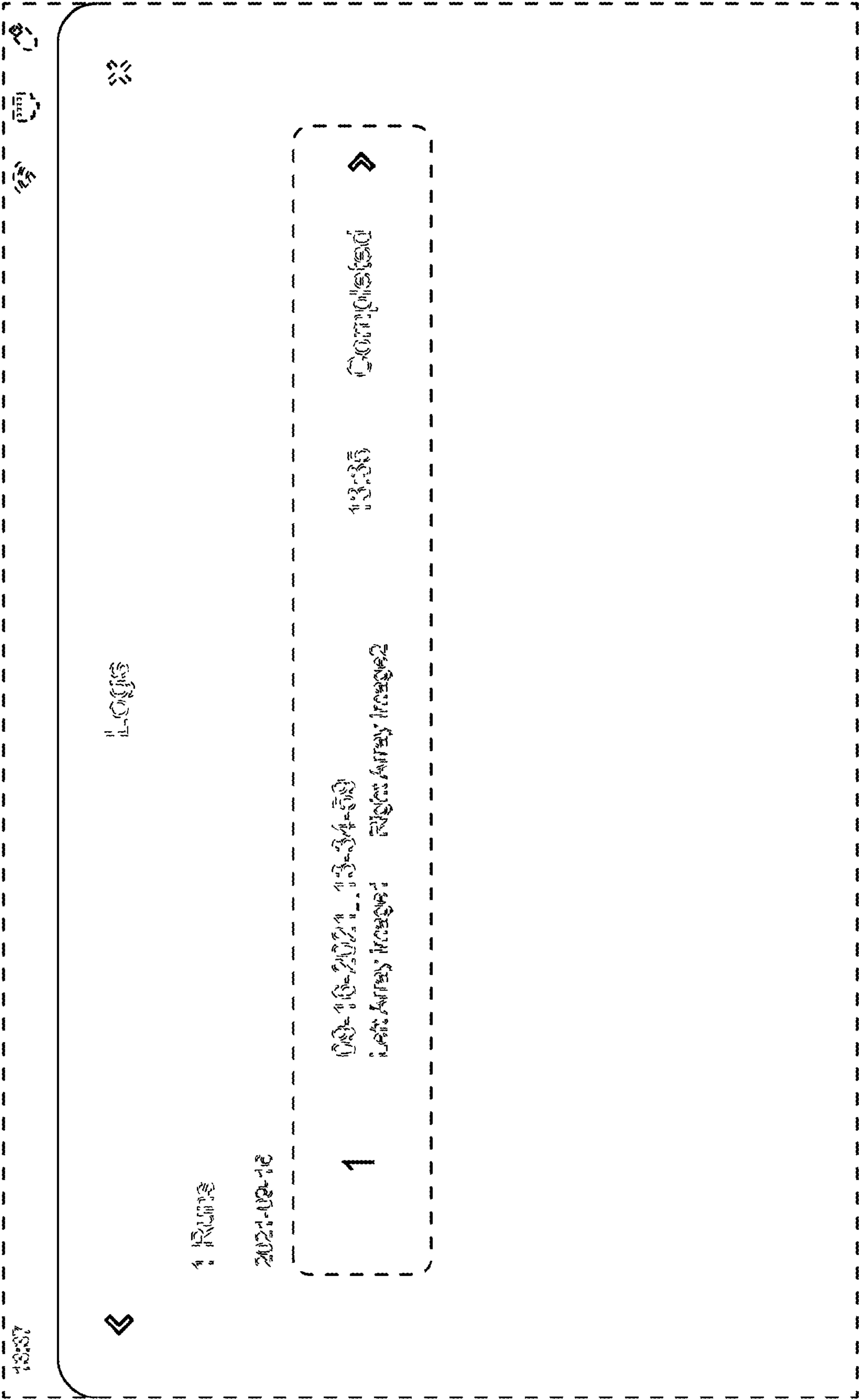
