DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the first image in the sequence for our new display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface design;

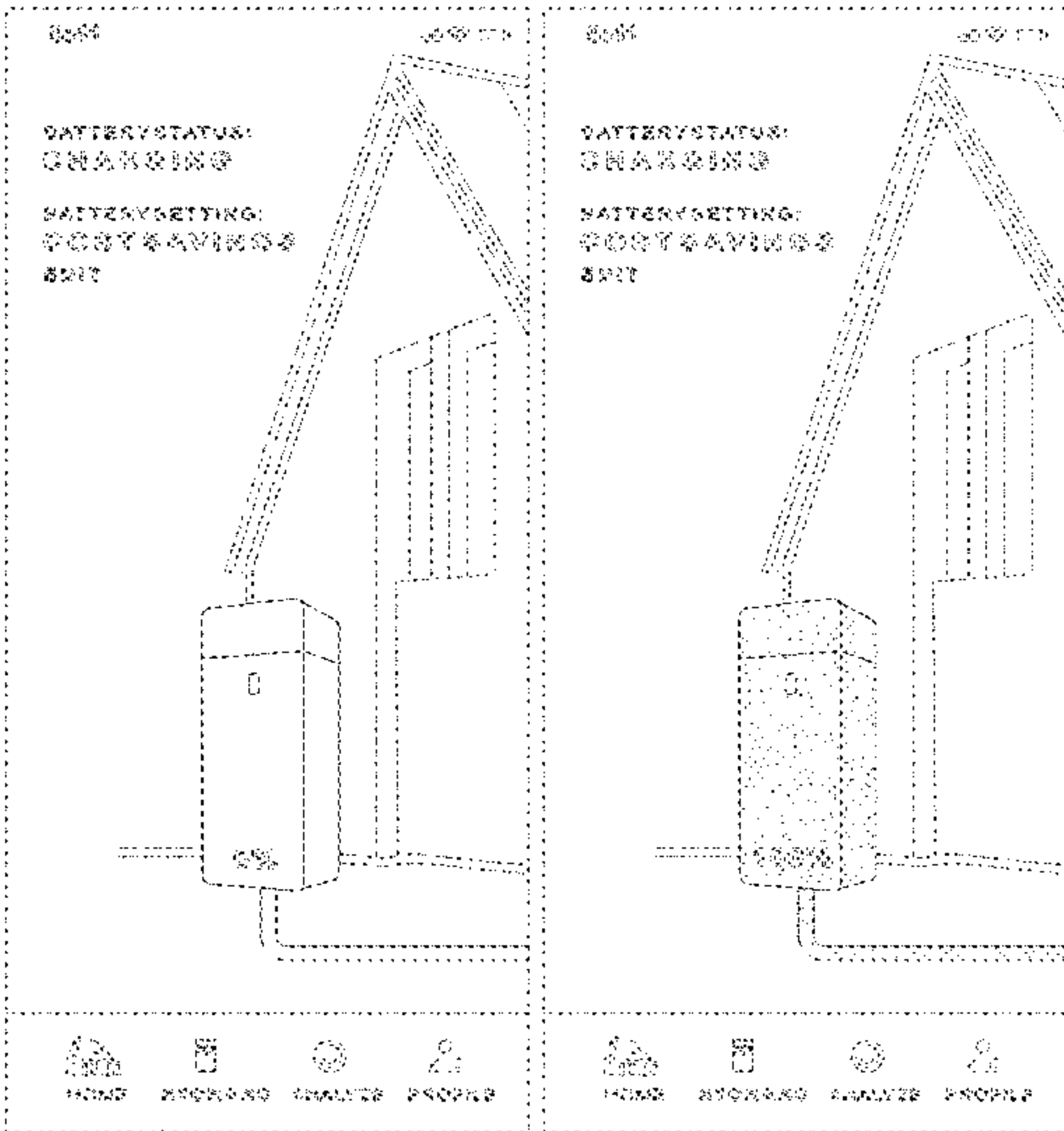
FIG. 2 is a front view of the second image in the sequence for our new display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface design; and,

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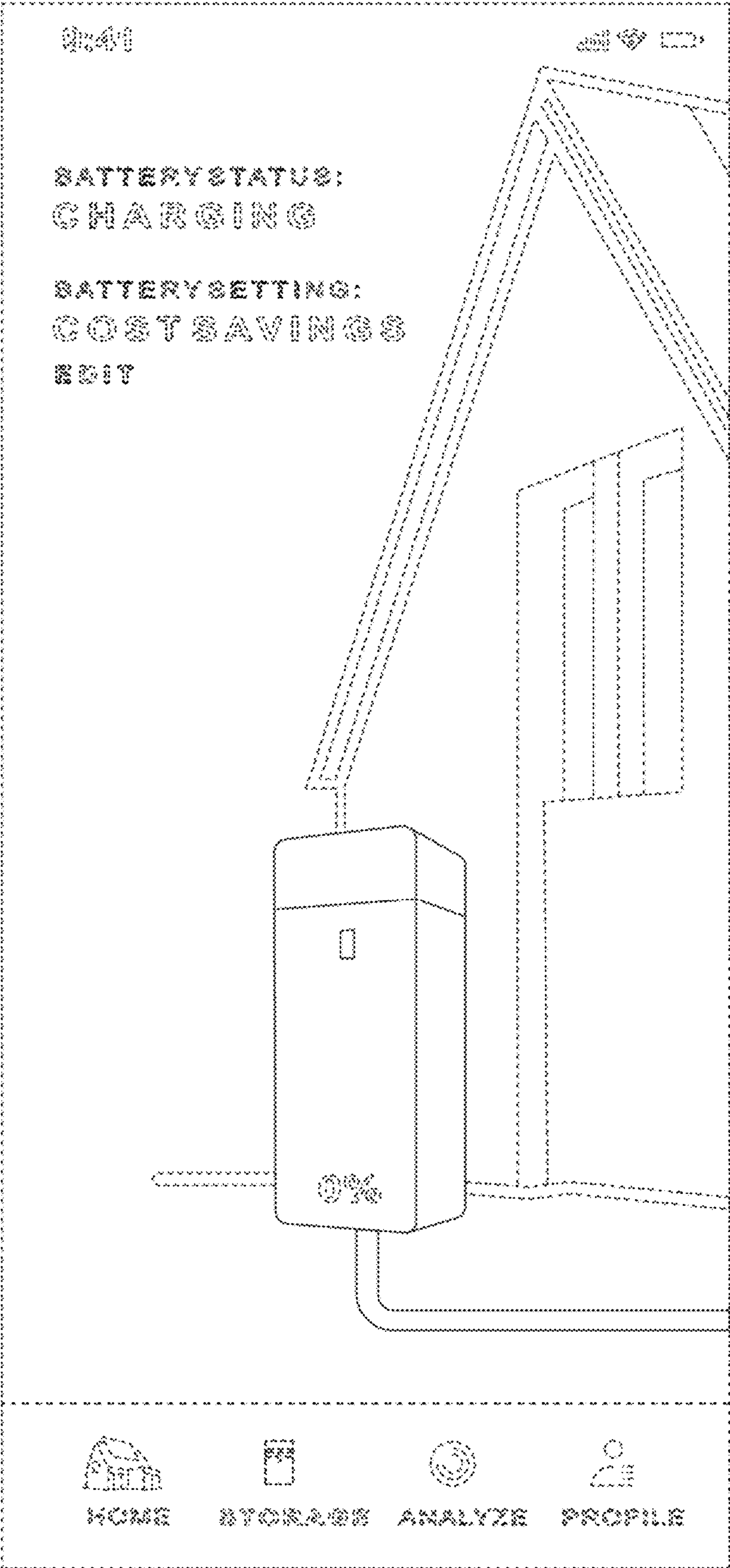

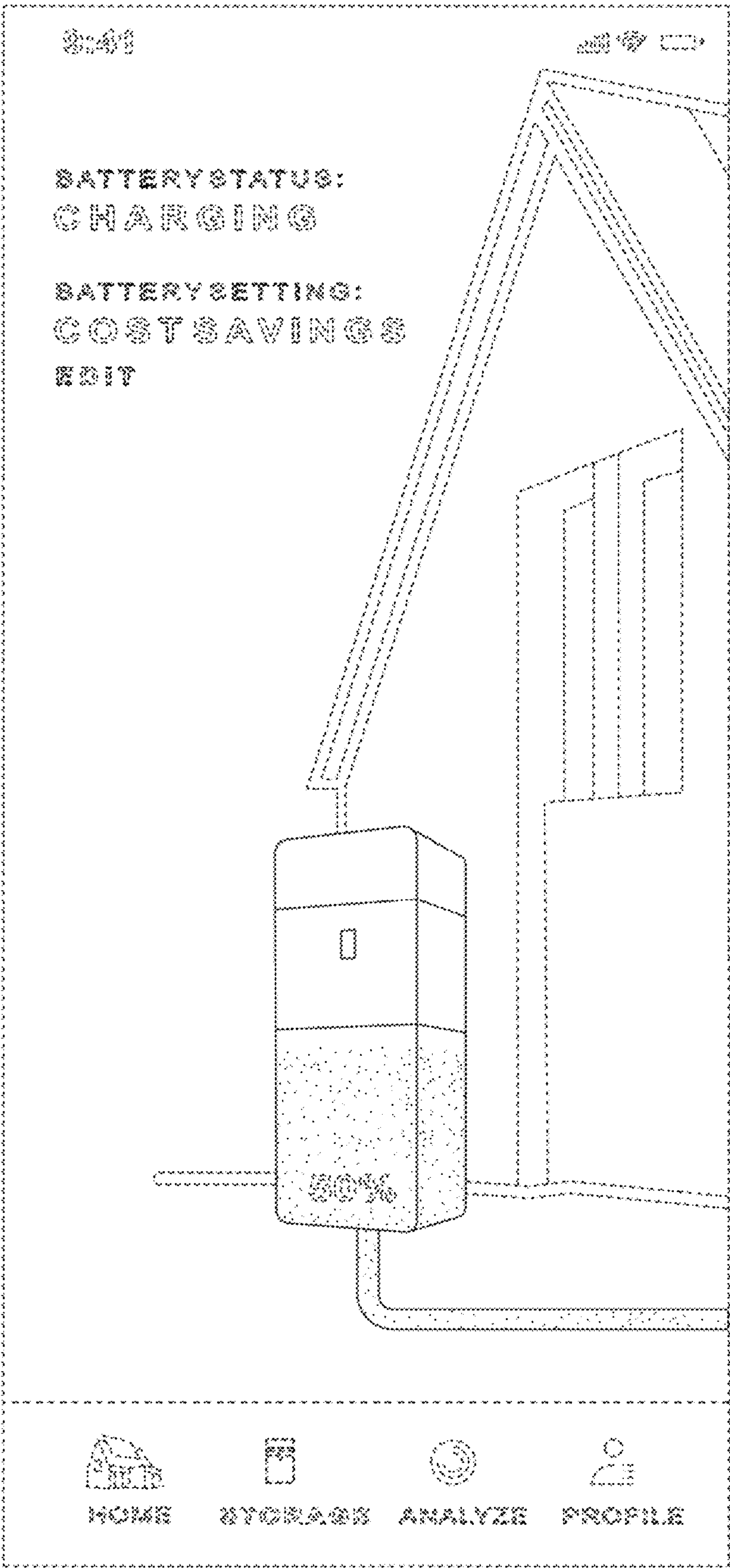

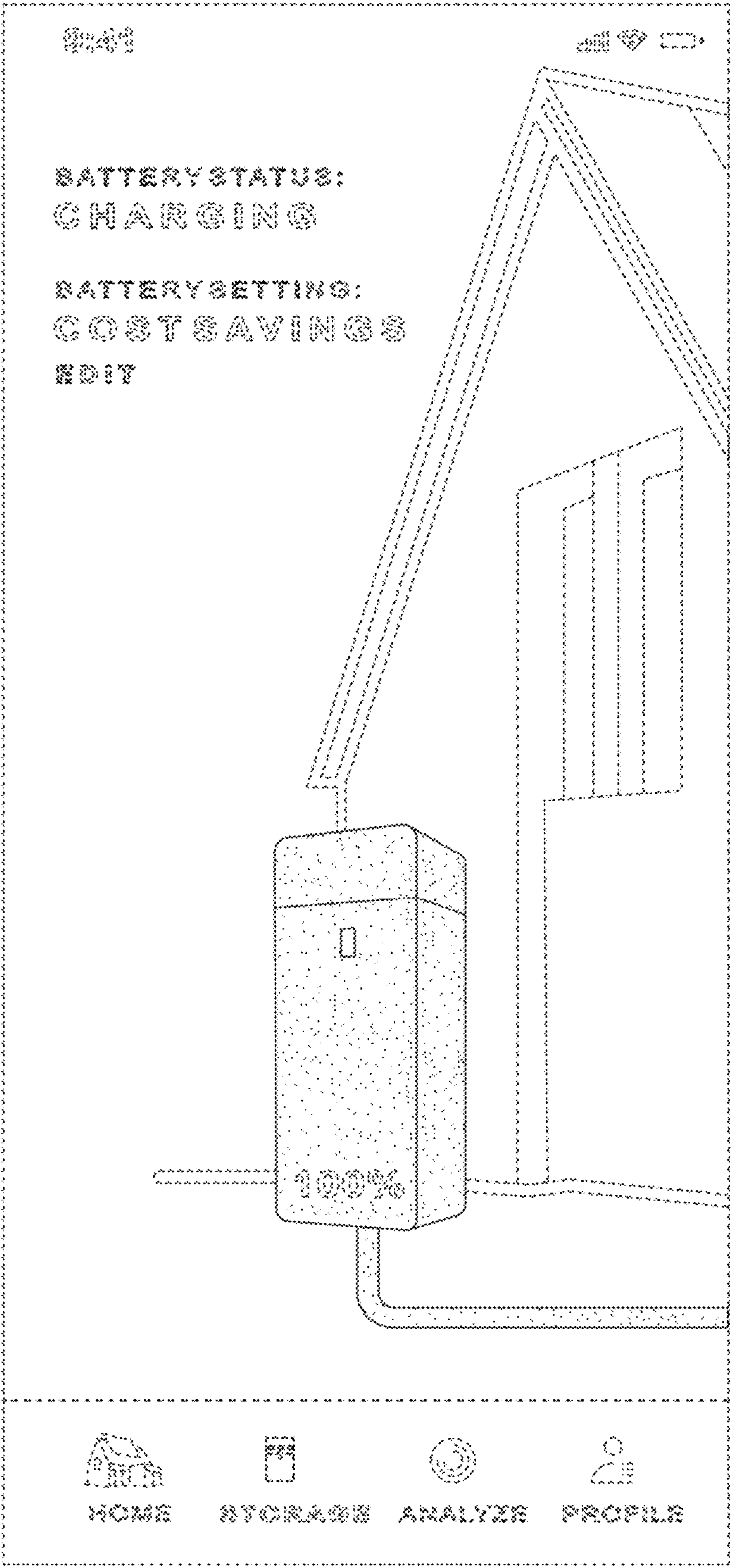
