FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the portable power tool body in accordance with our new design;

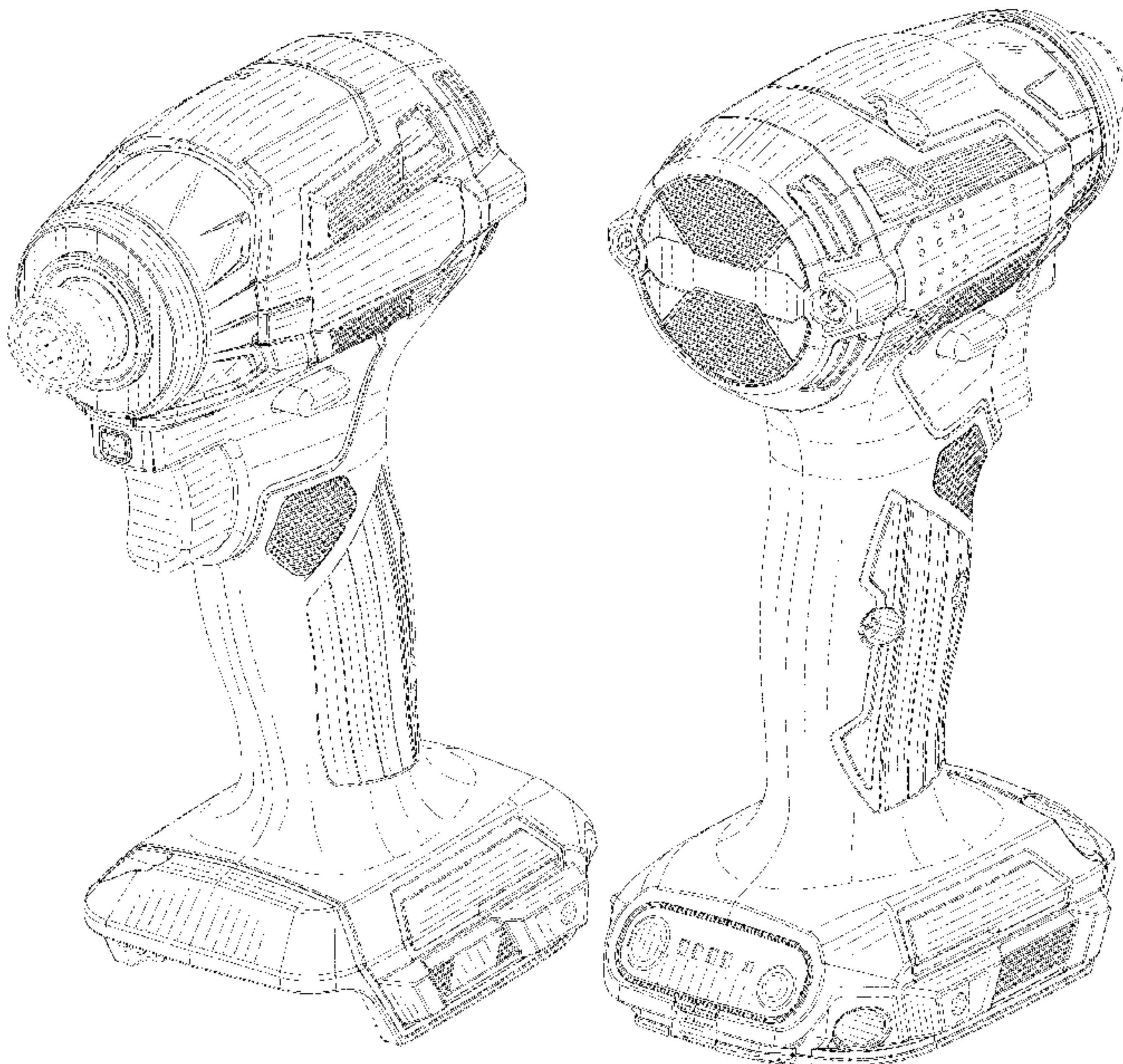
FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the portable power tool body in accordance with our new design; and,

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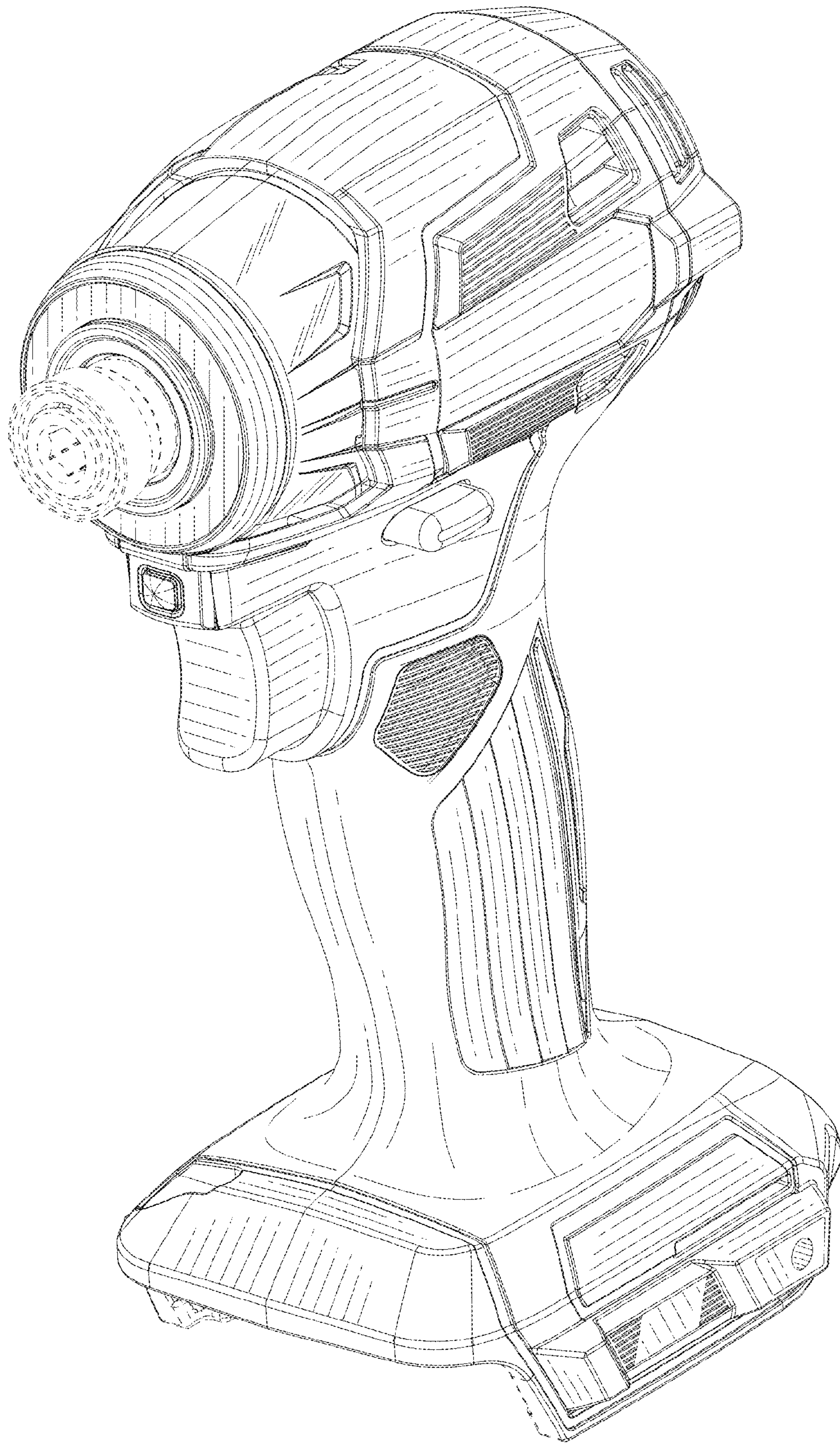

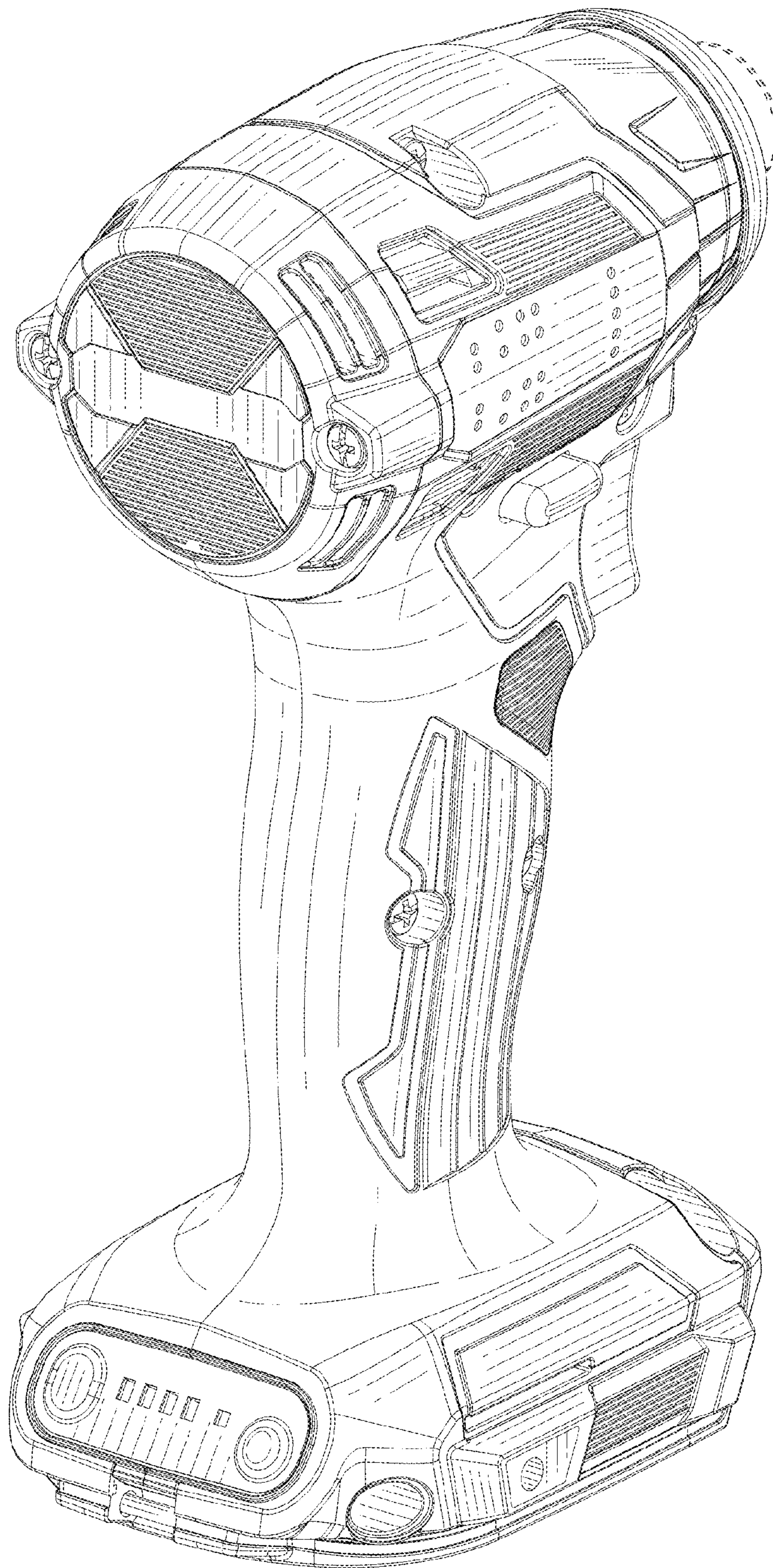

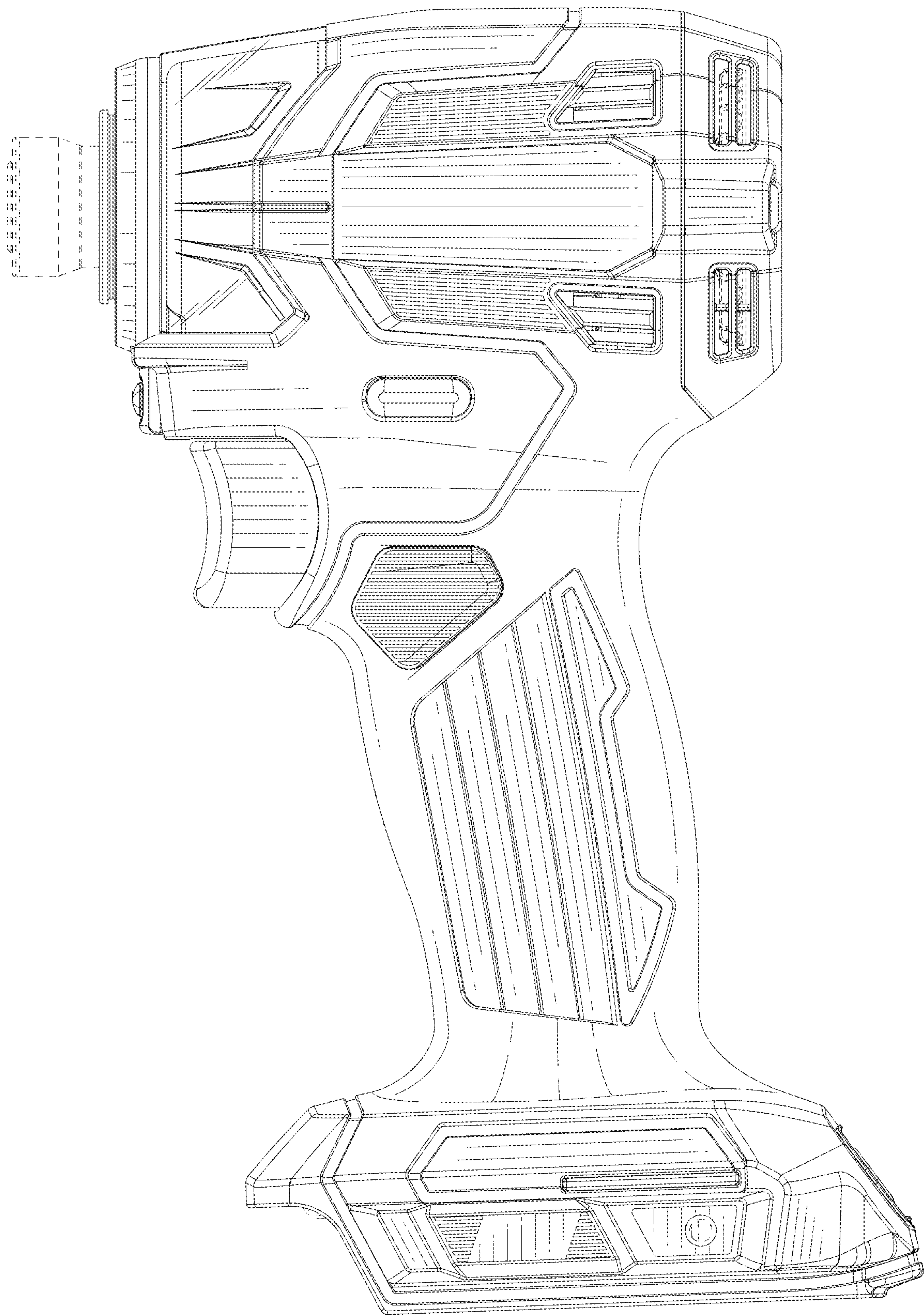

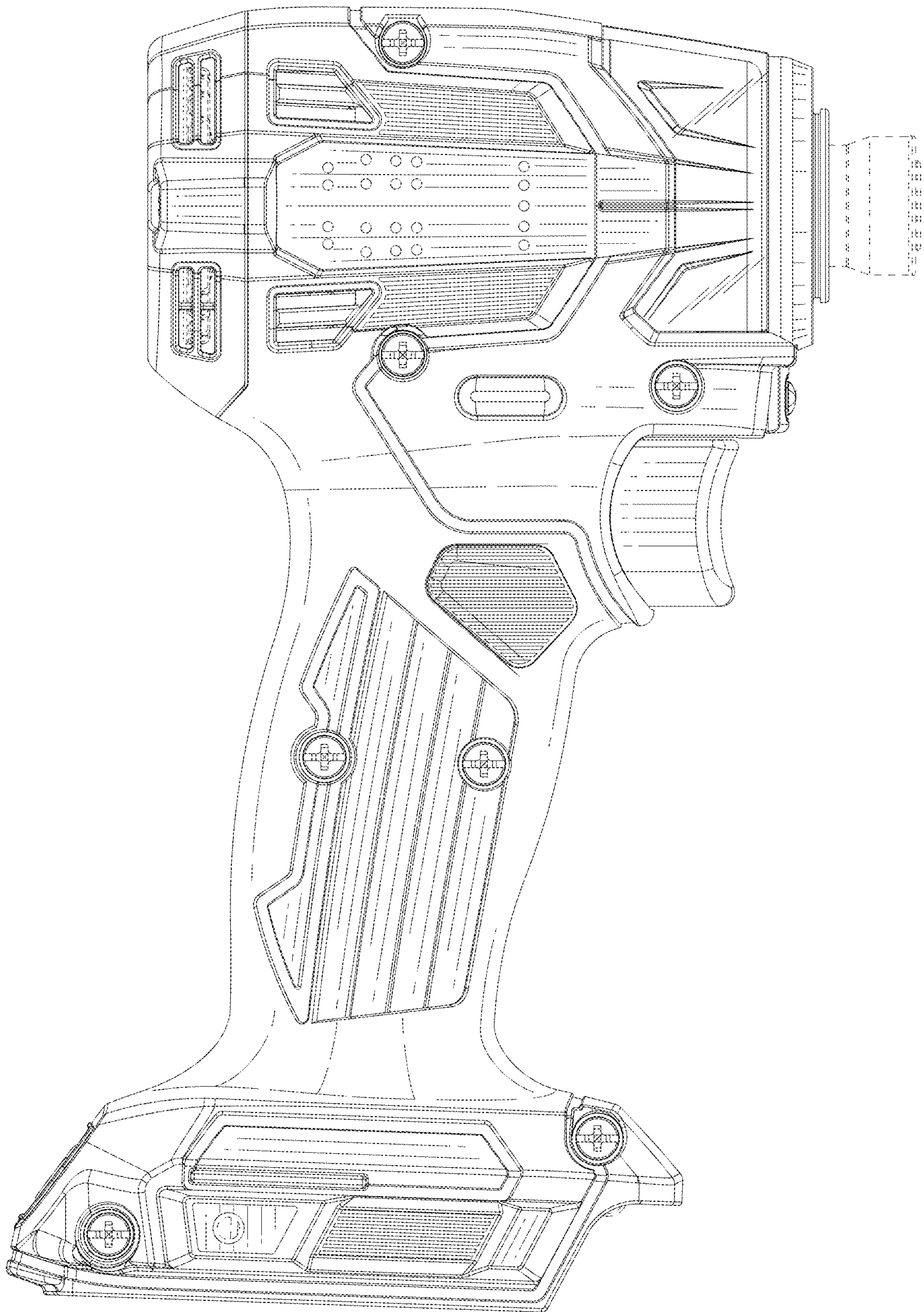

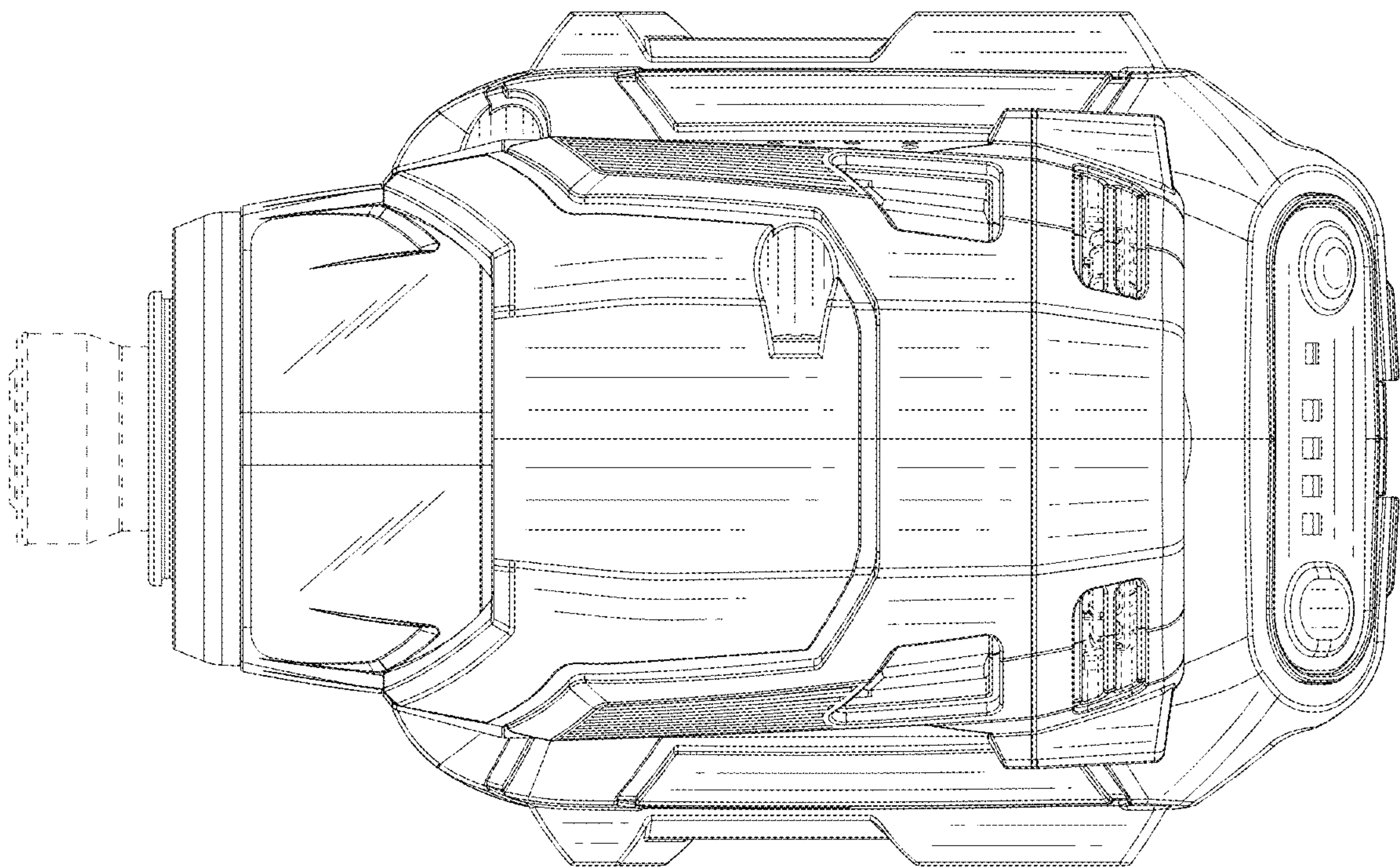

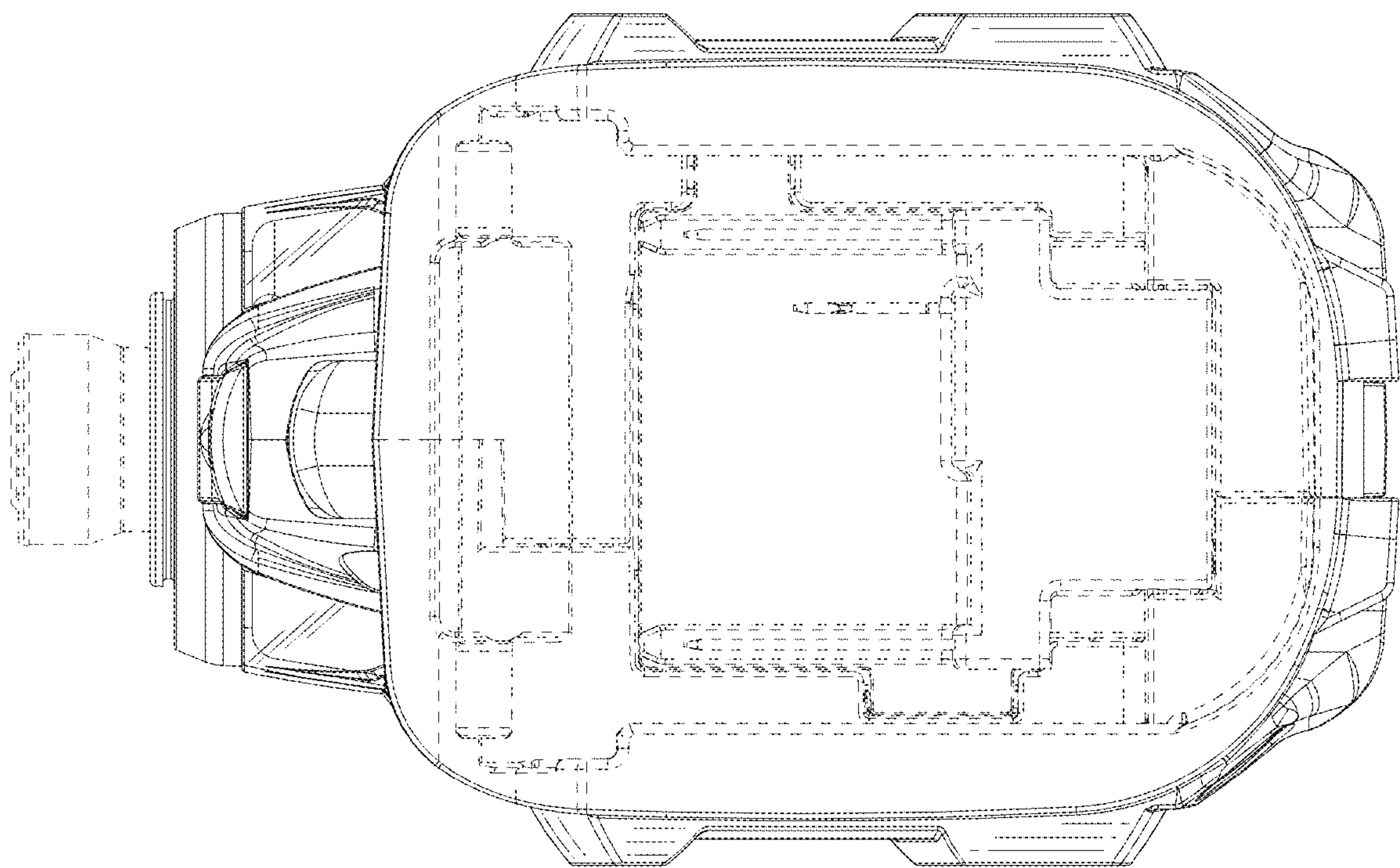

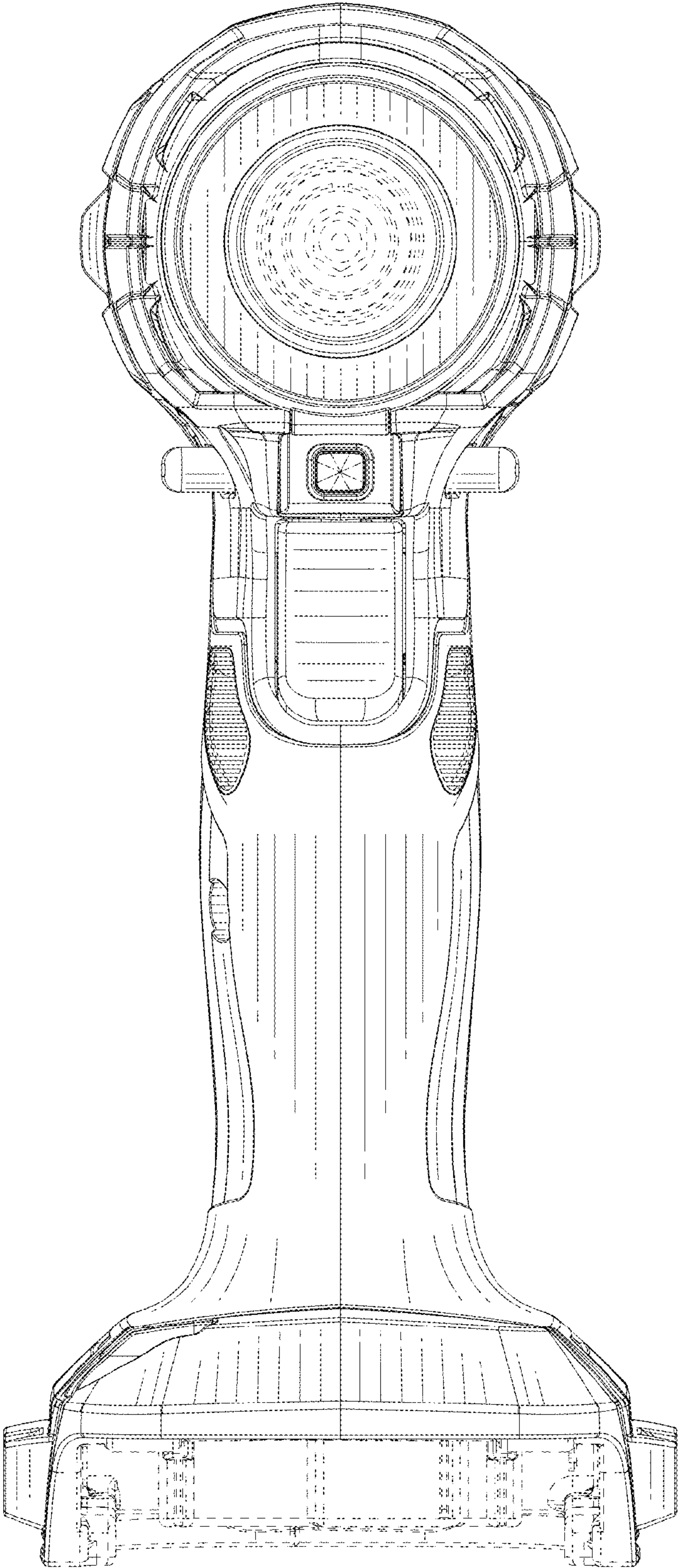

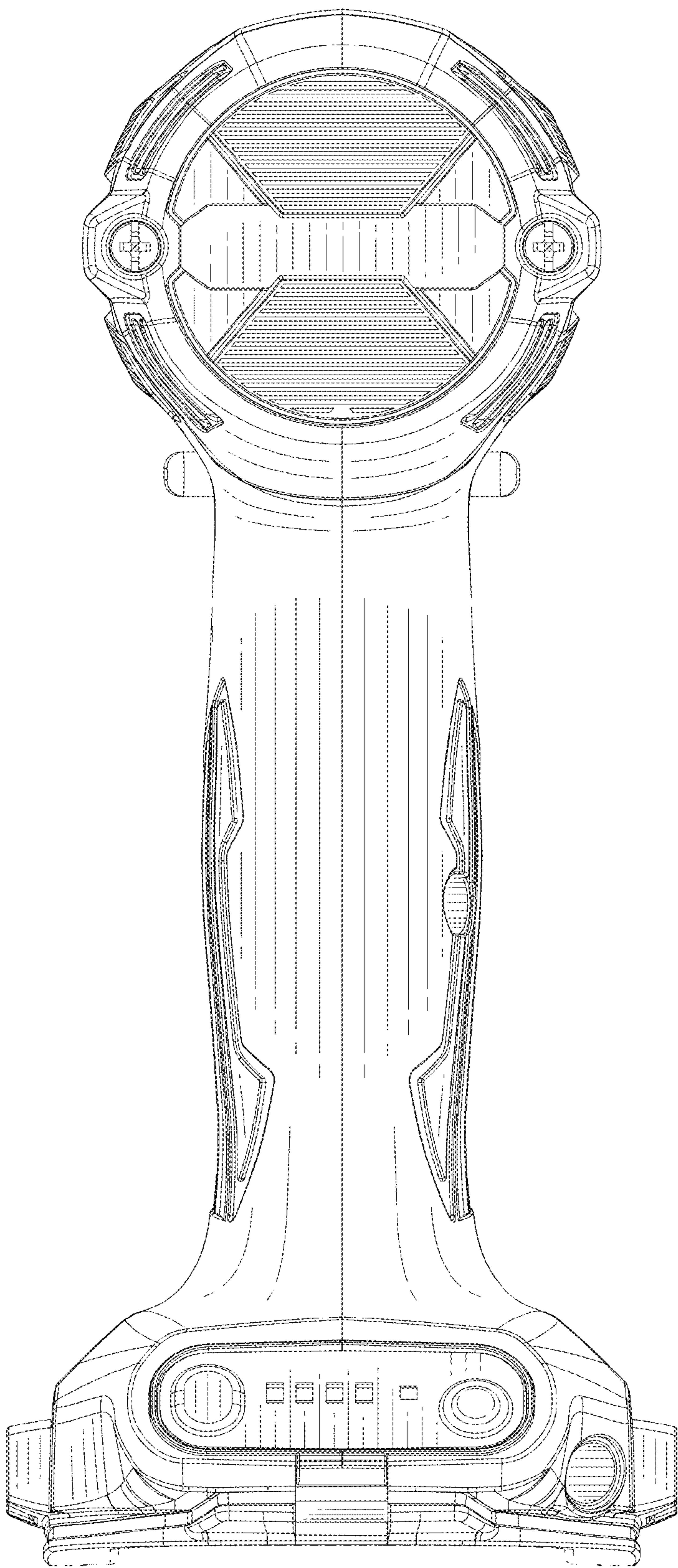

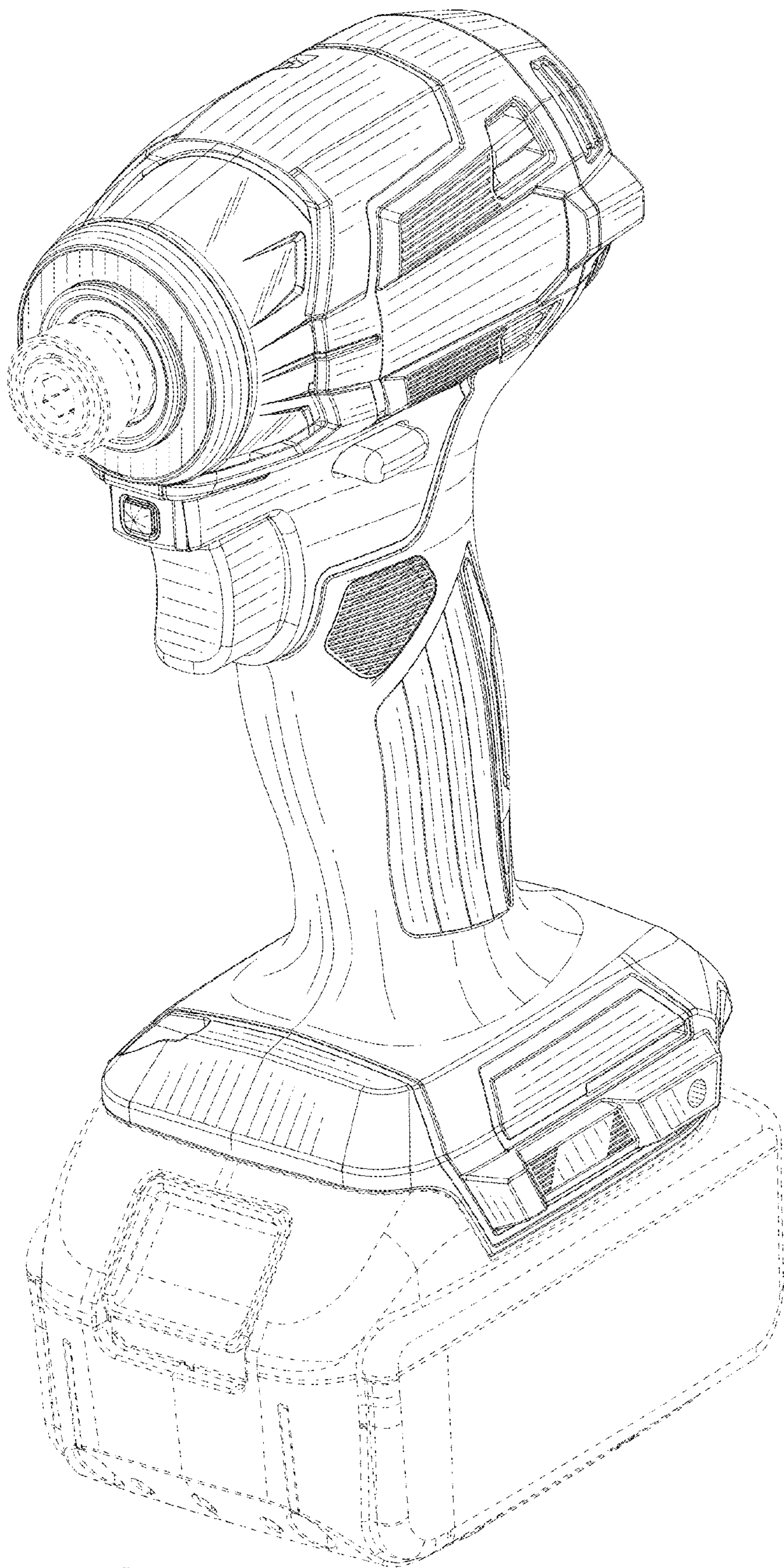
