DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a zipper detent showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view thereof, taken along the line 5-5 of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof;

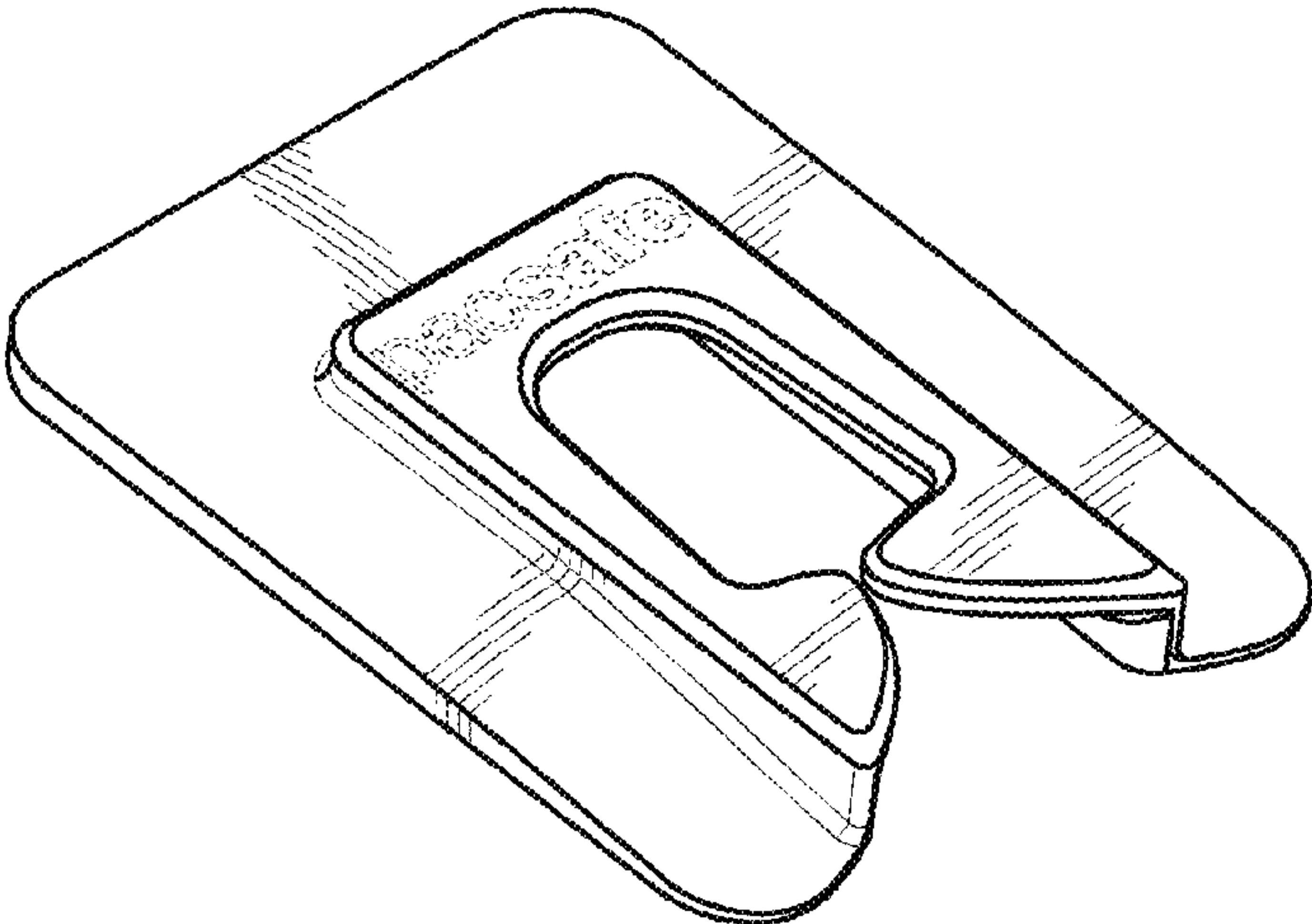
FIG. 8 is a bottom side view thereof;

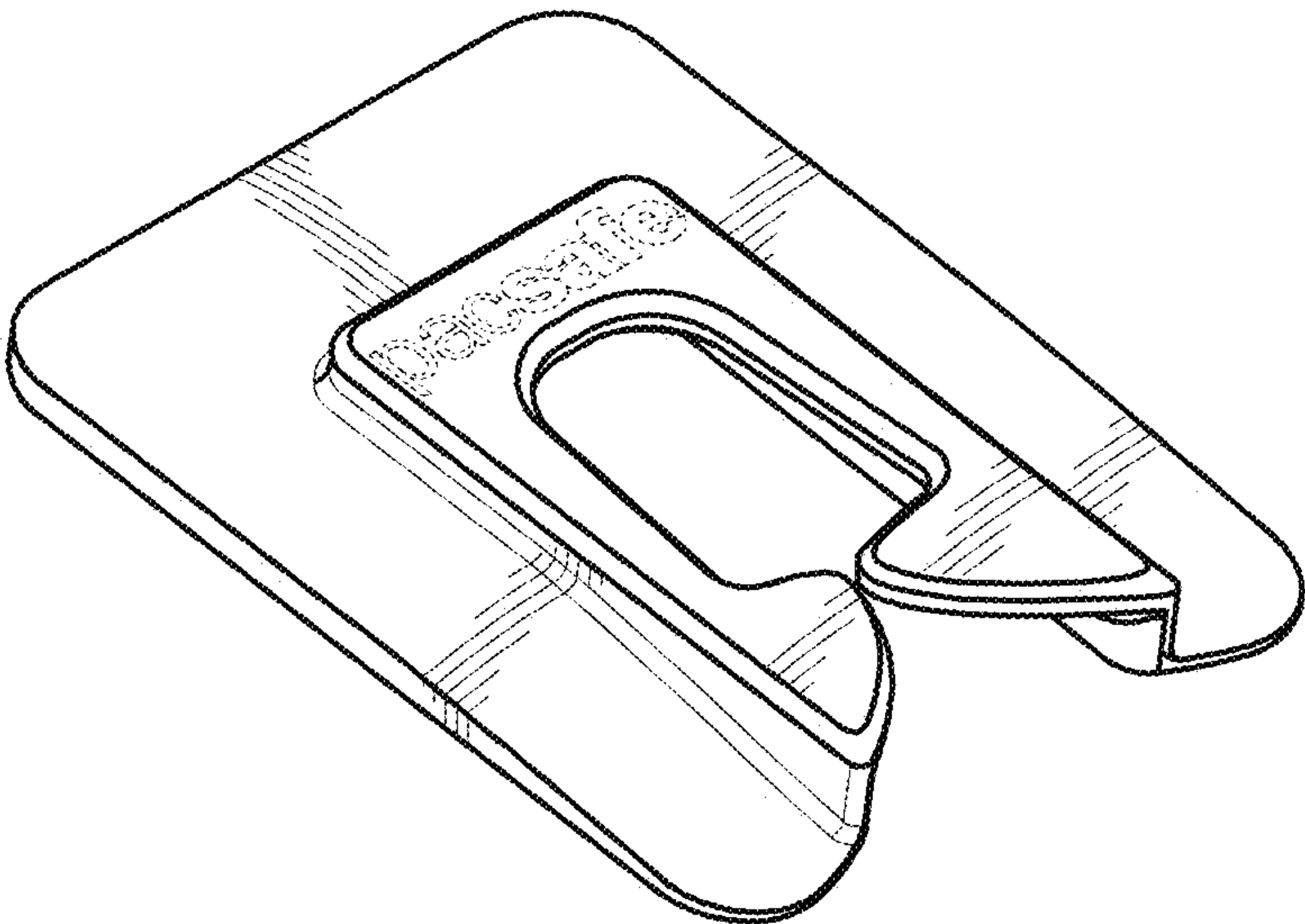

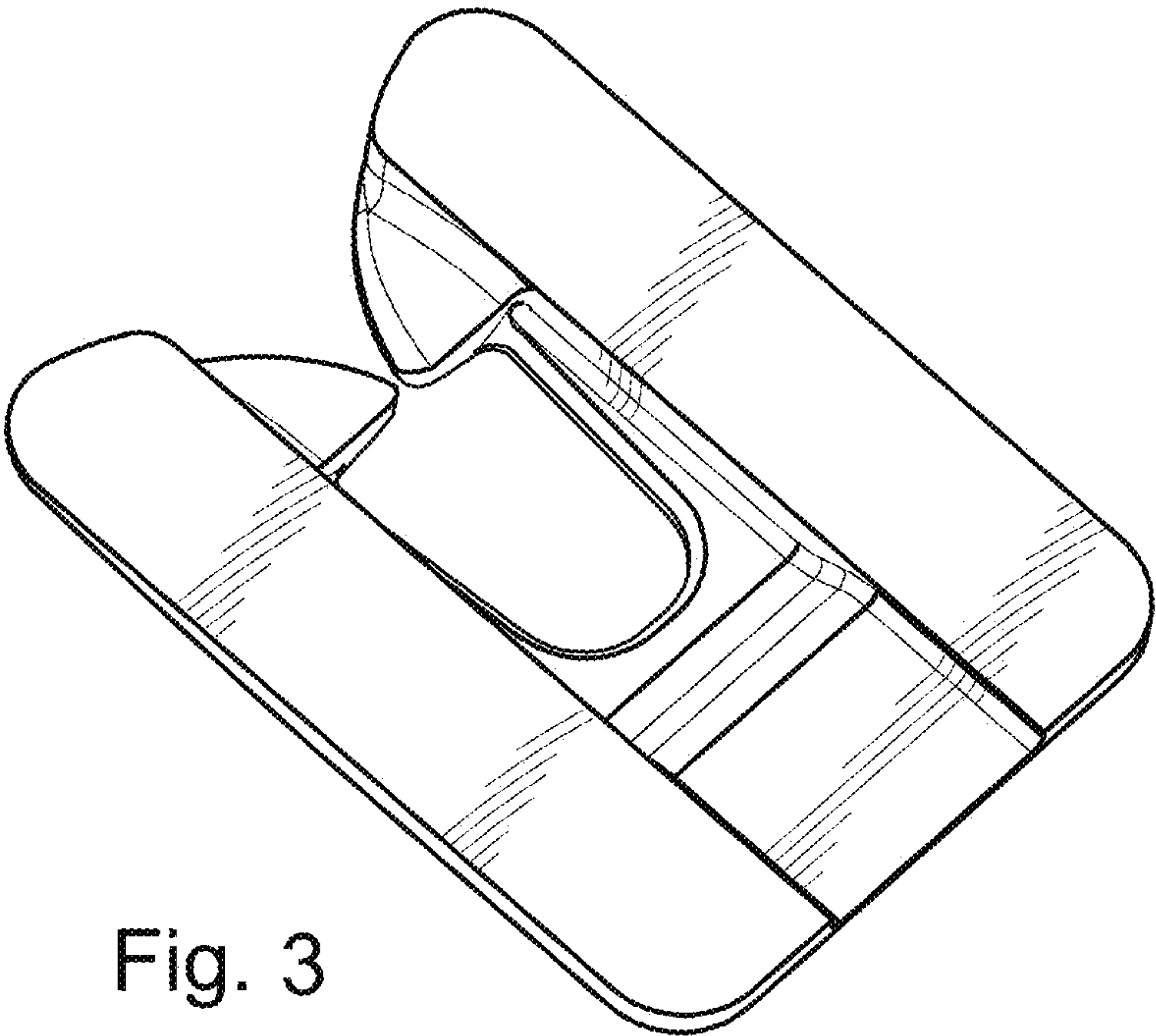

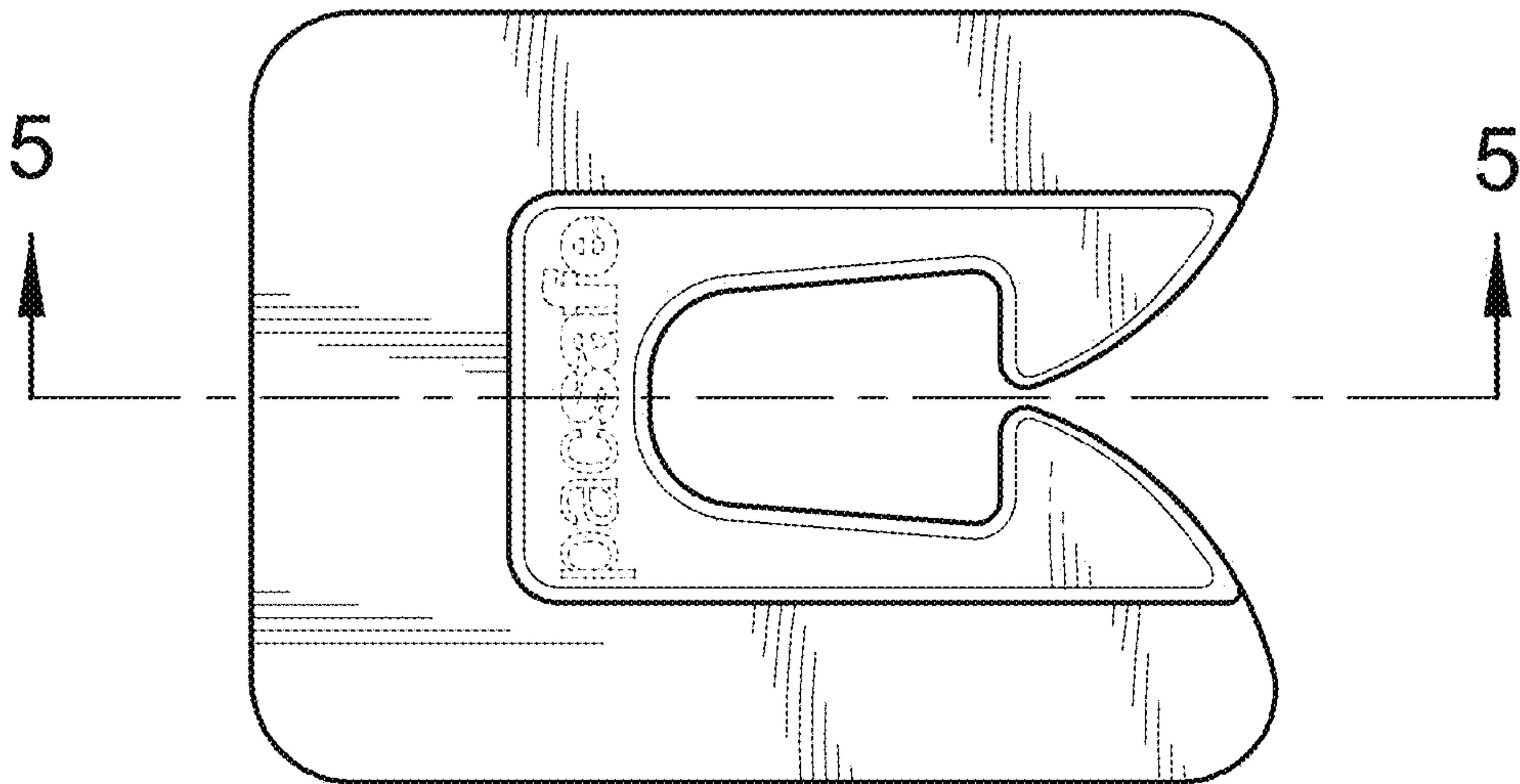

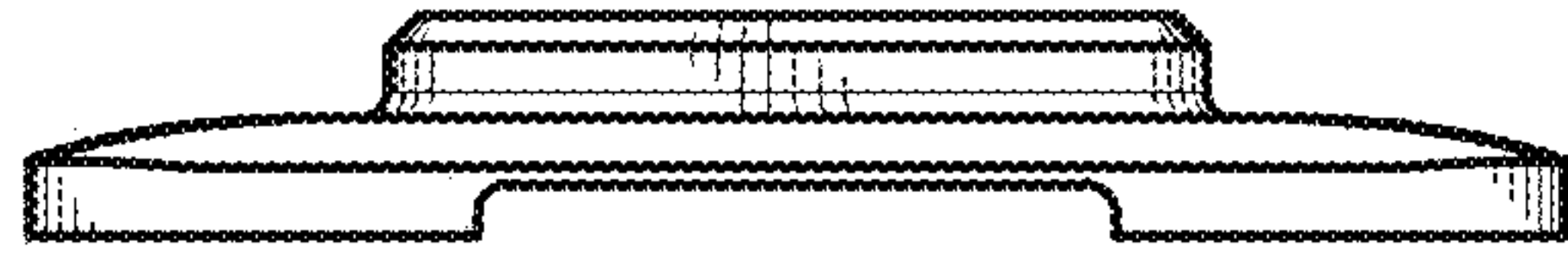

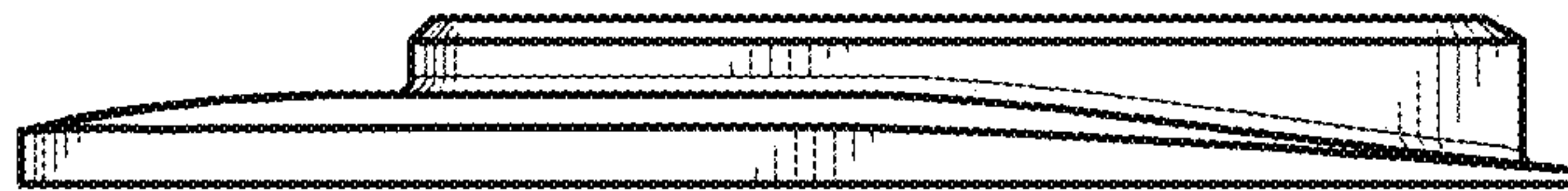

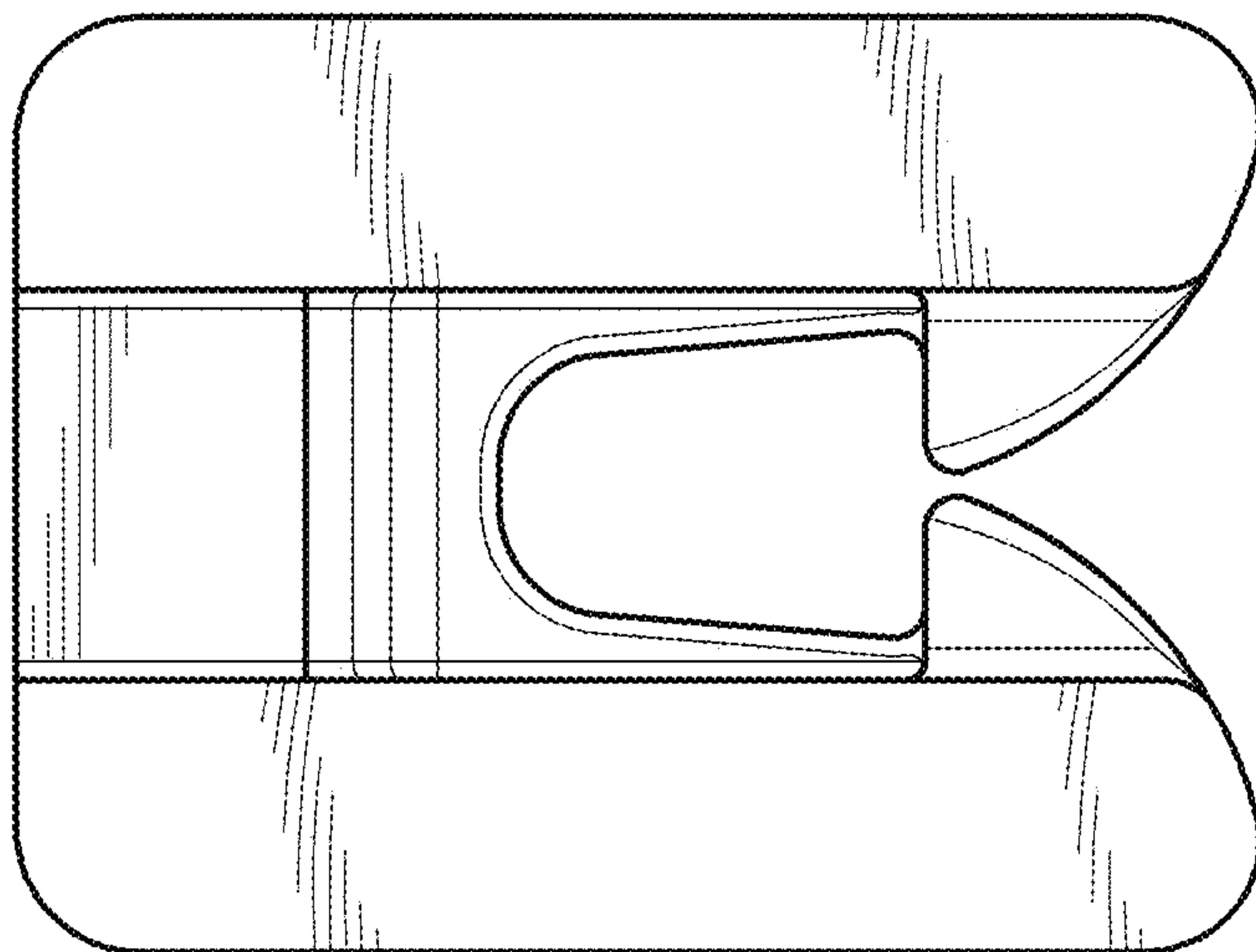

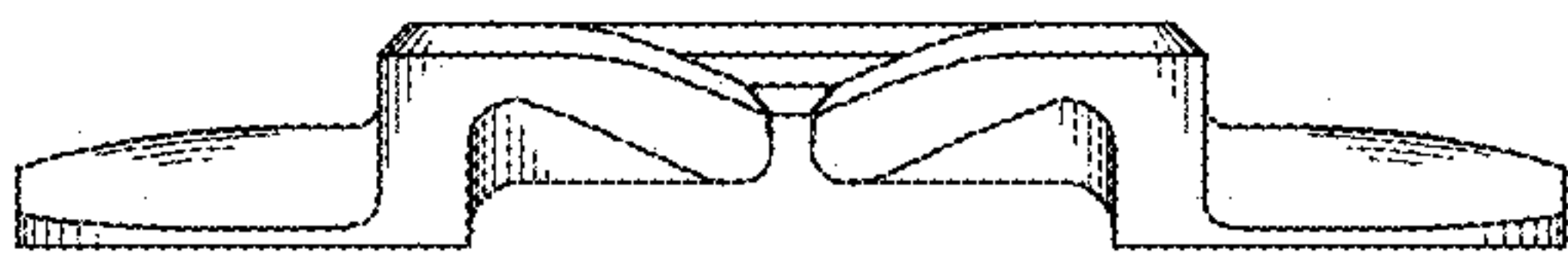

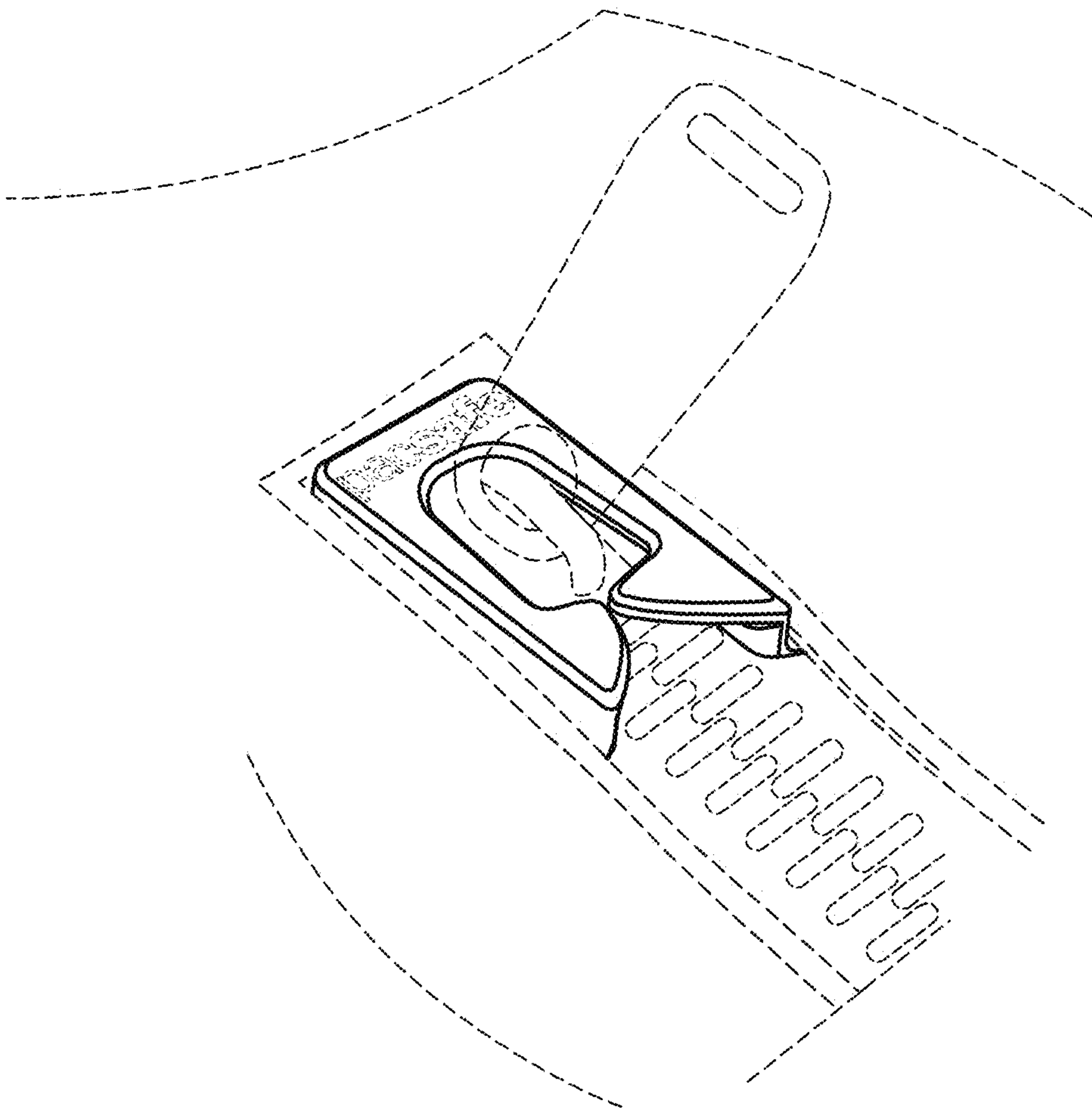
