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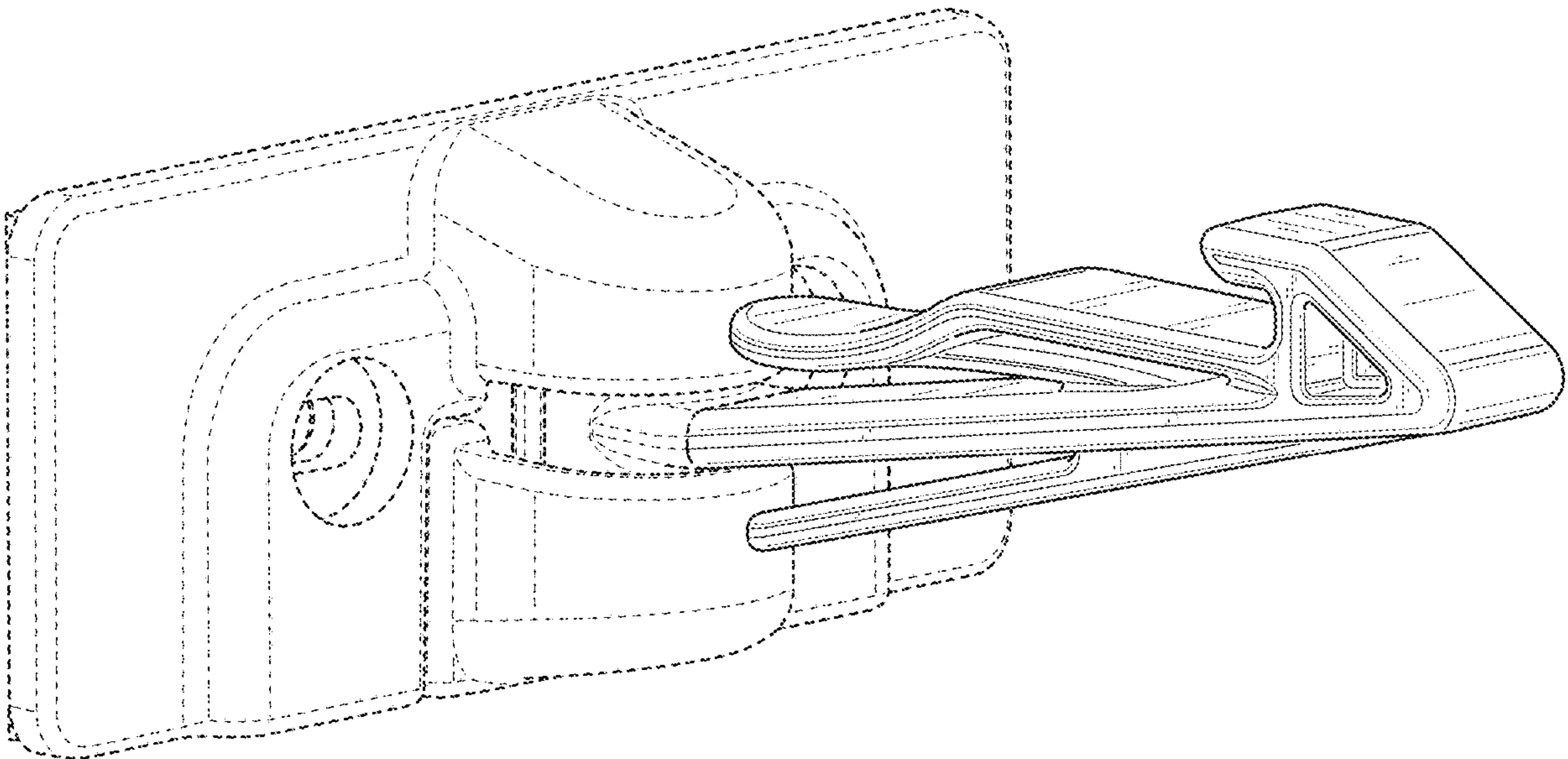
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a latch showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front, right side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof;

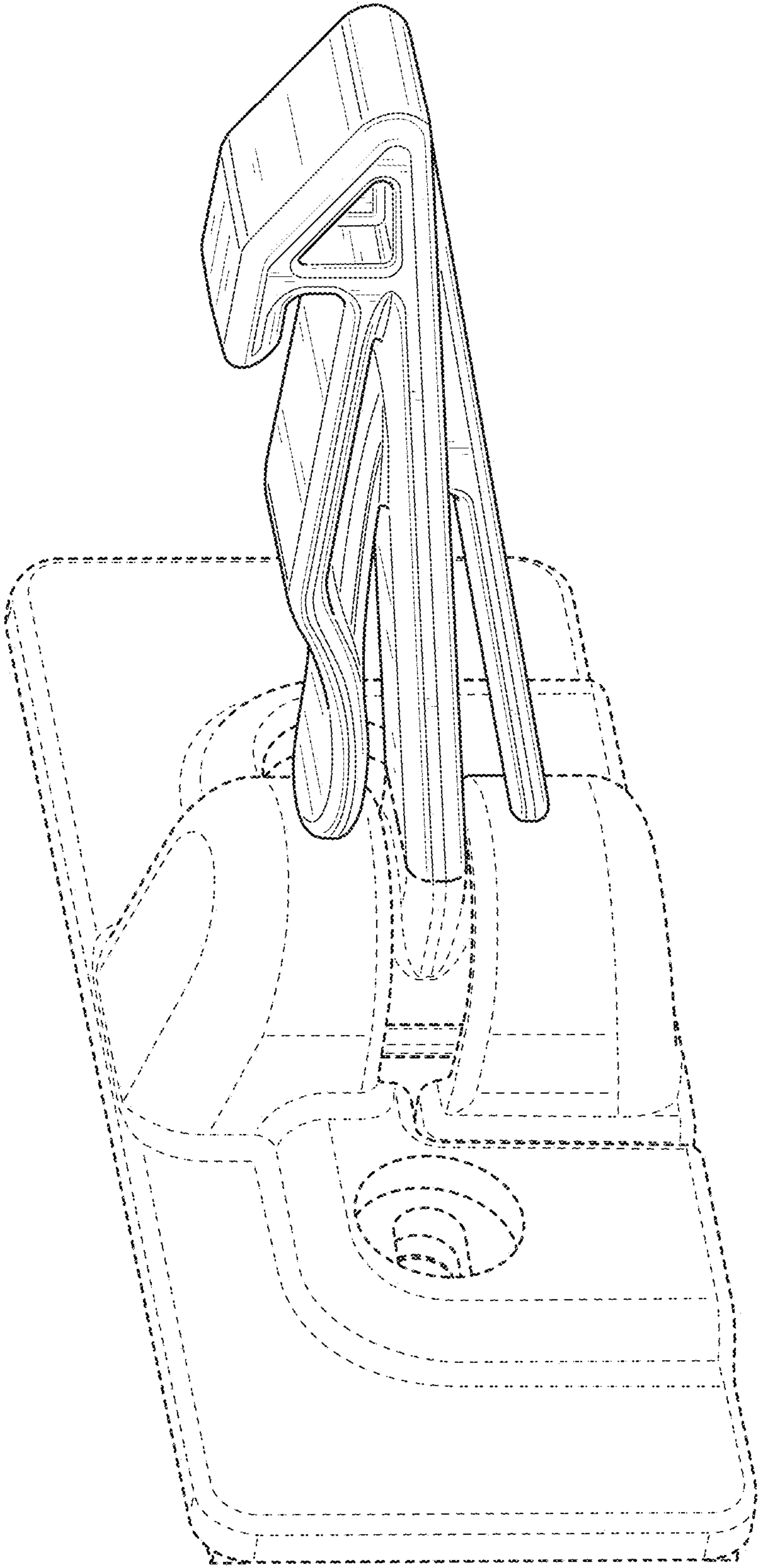

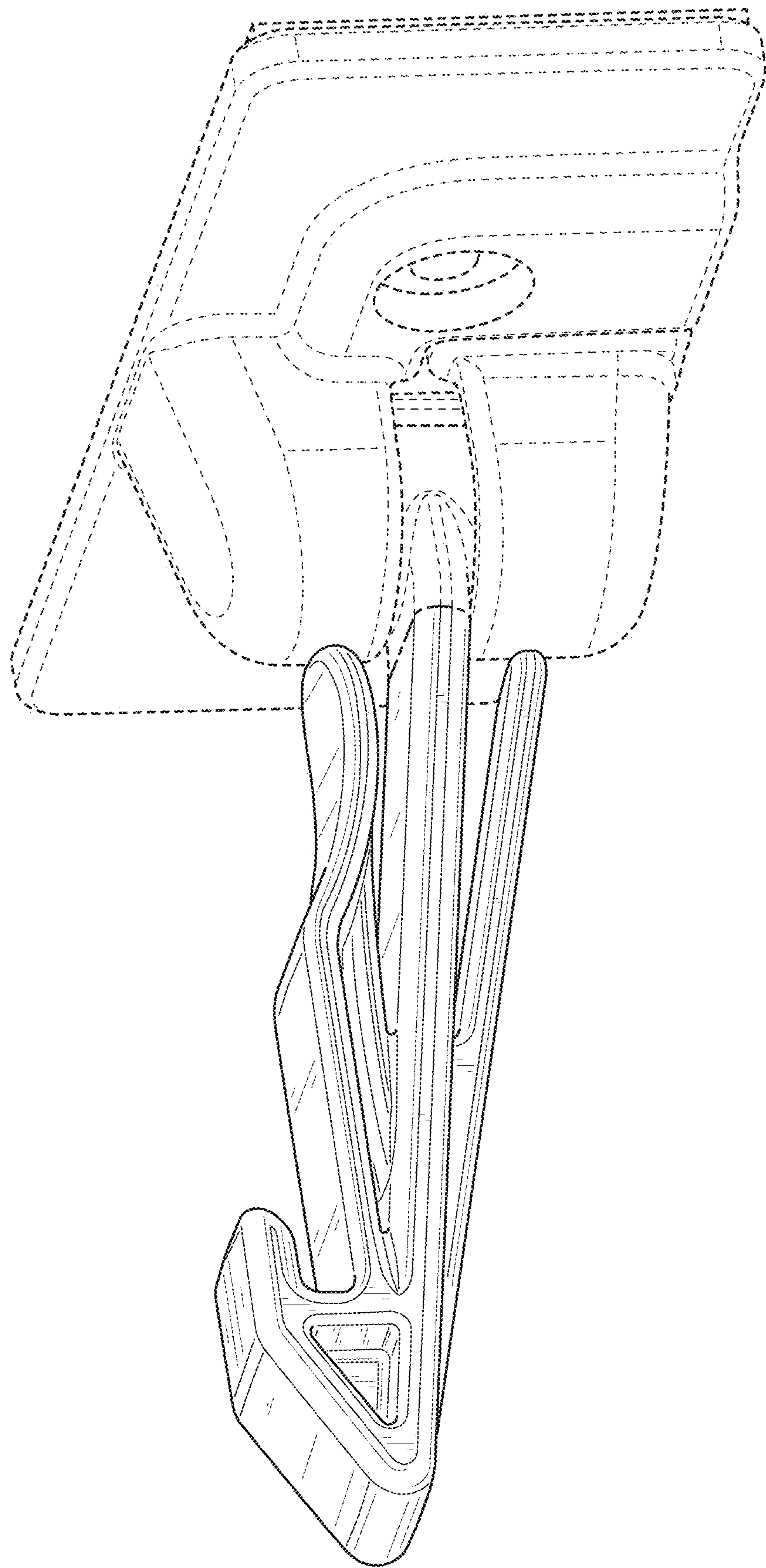

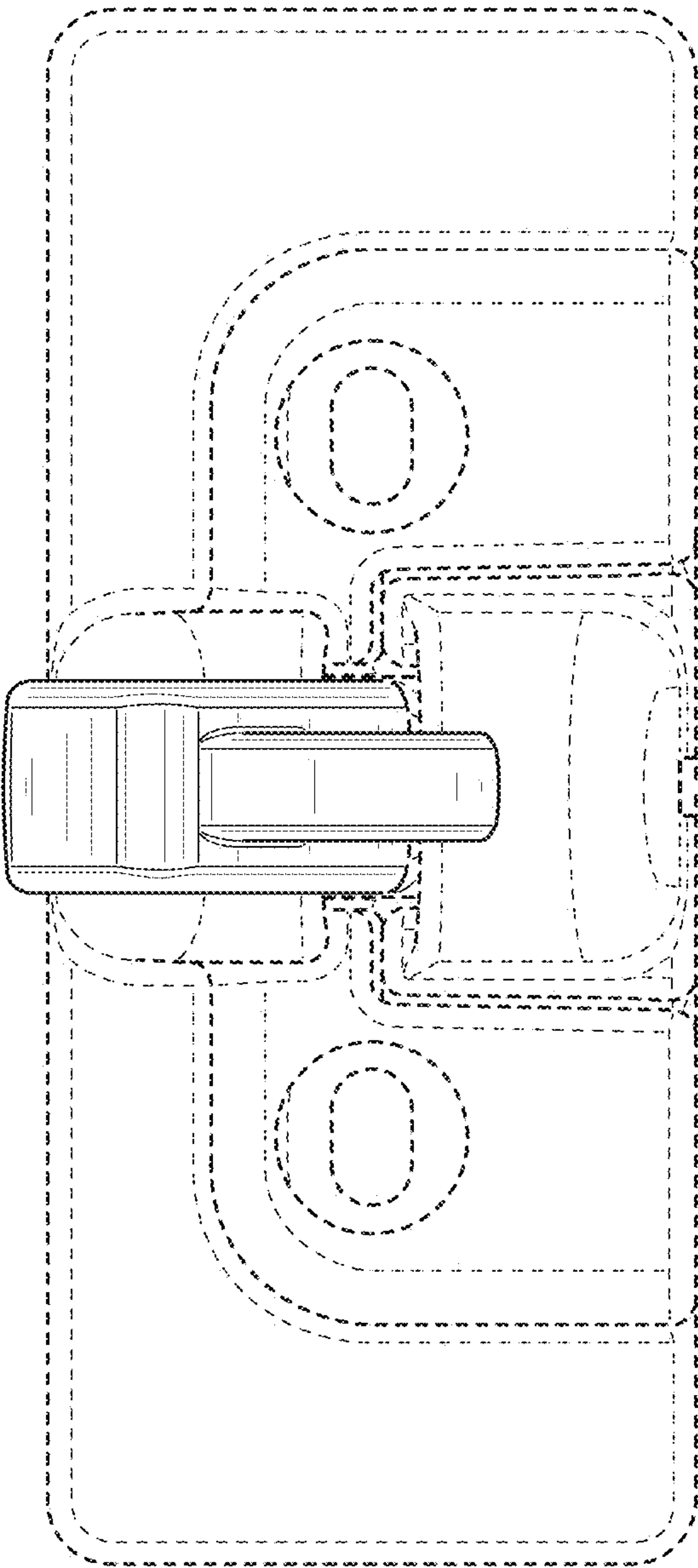

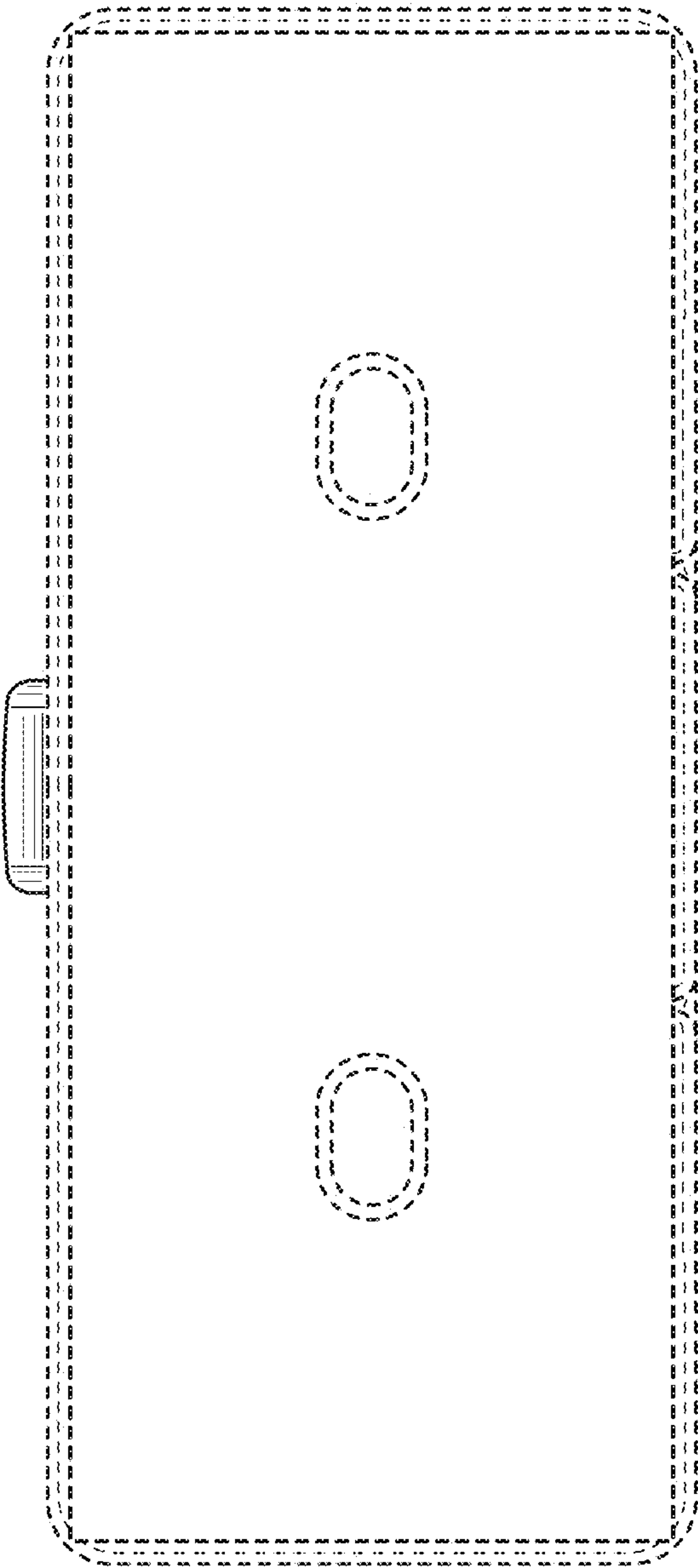

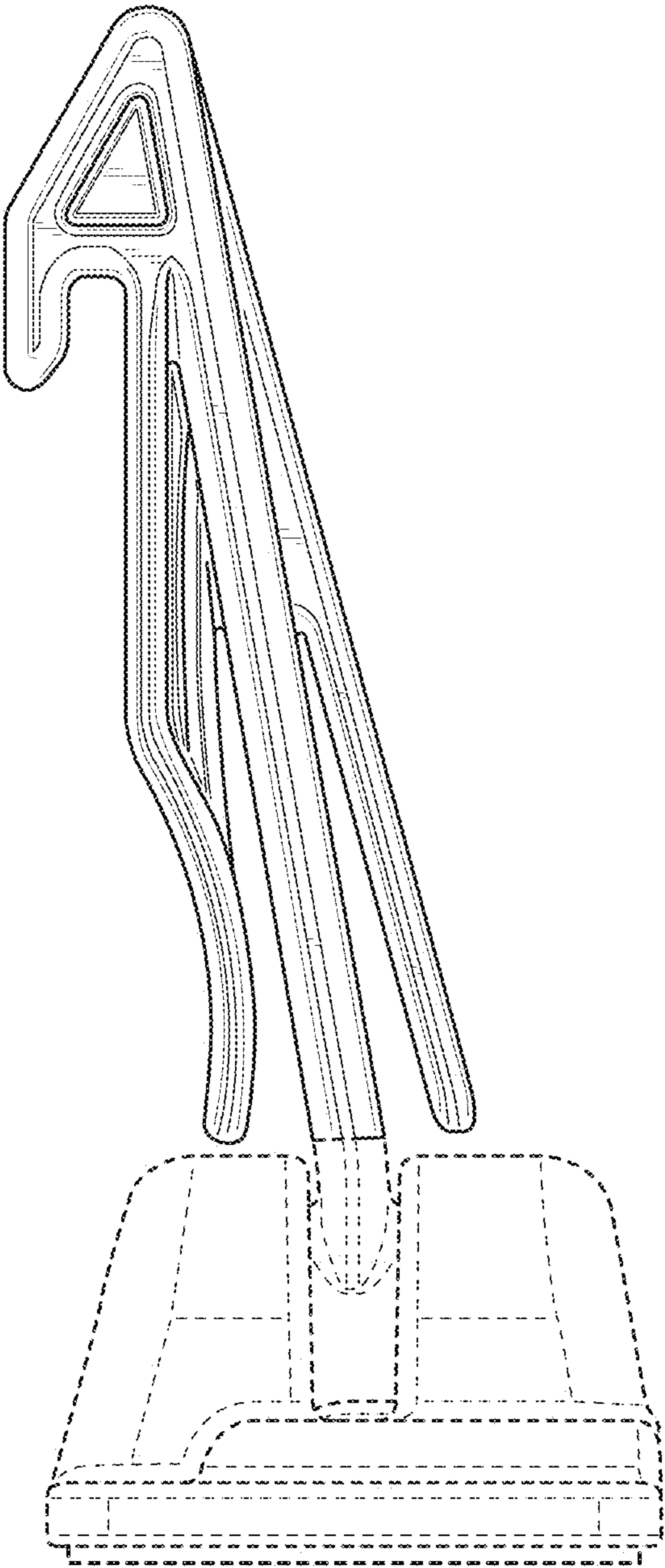

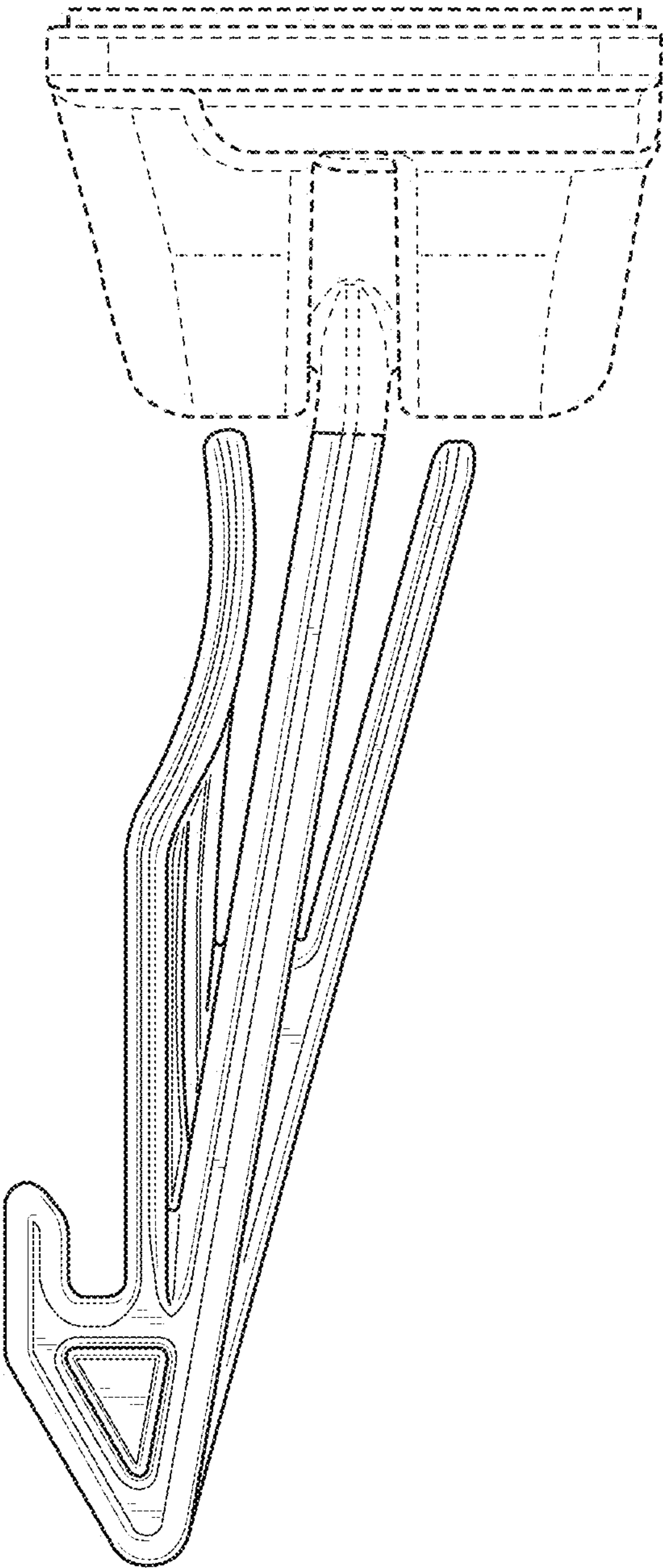

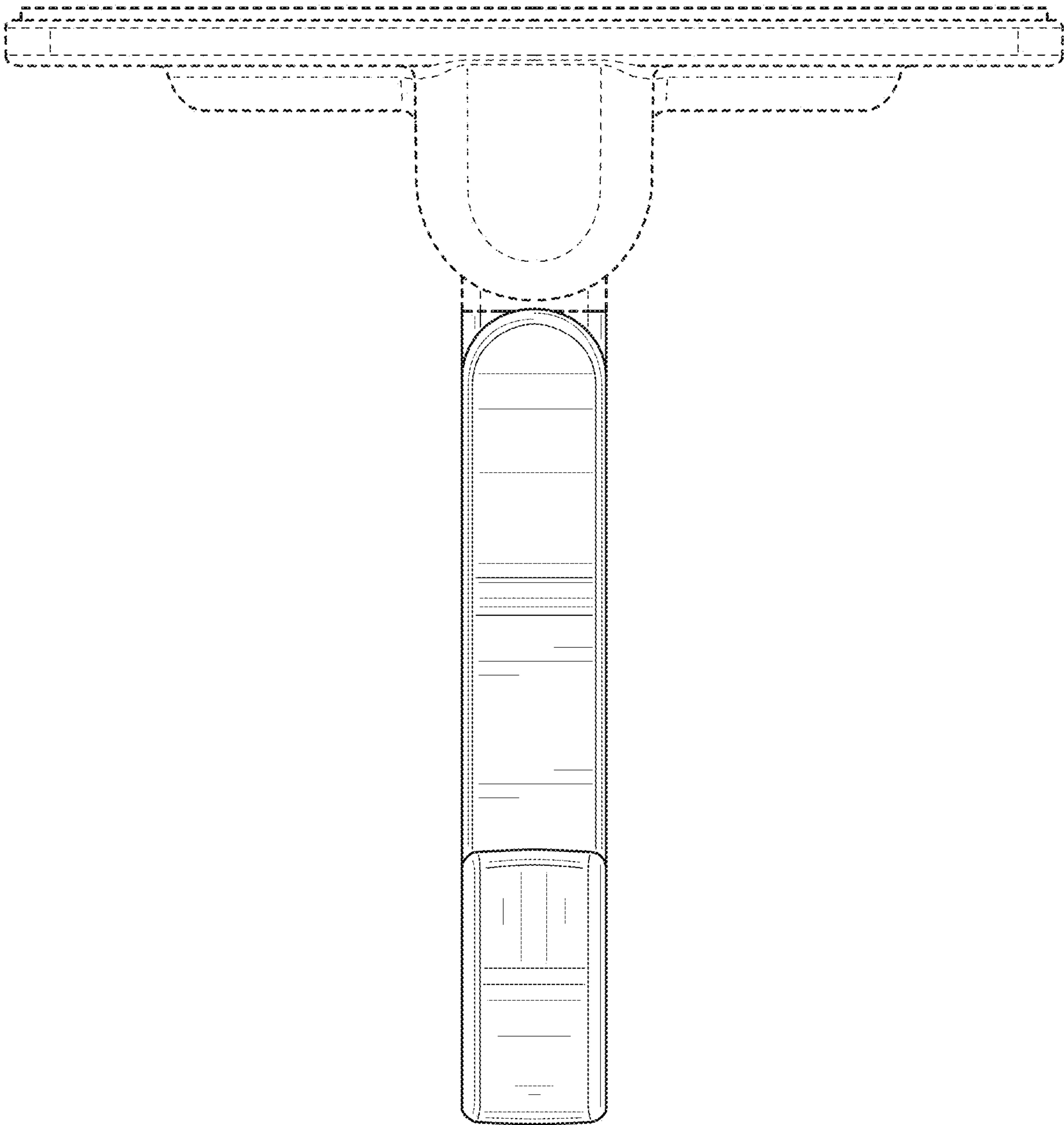

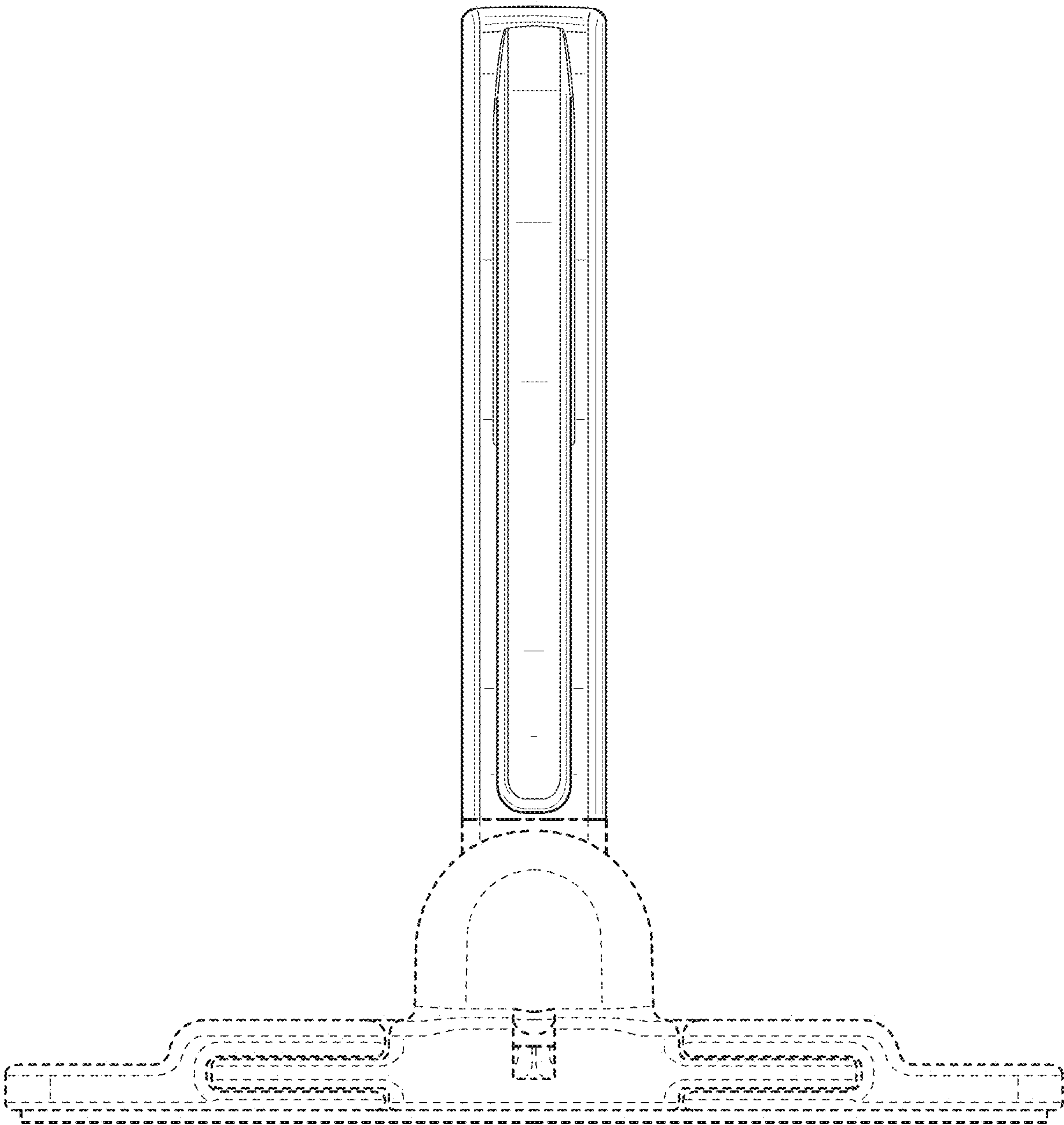
