(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a buggy board for a stroller as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left-side, and top perspective view of a buggy board for a stroller showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof. The dashed broken lines depict portions of the buggy board for a stroller that form no part of the claimed design. The dot-dash broken lines are for defining the bounds of the claimed design only and form no part of the claimed design.

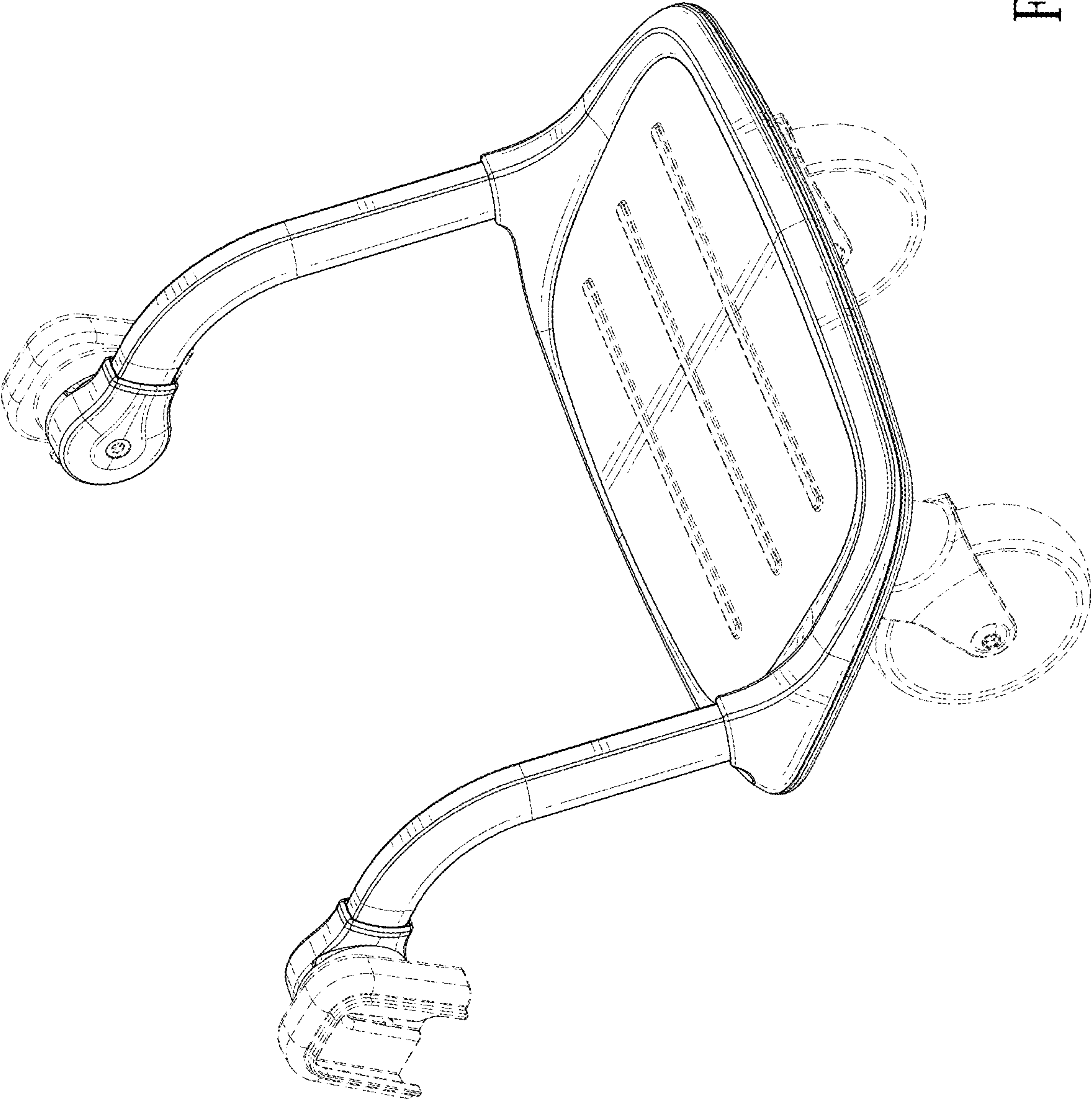

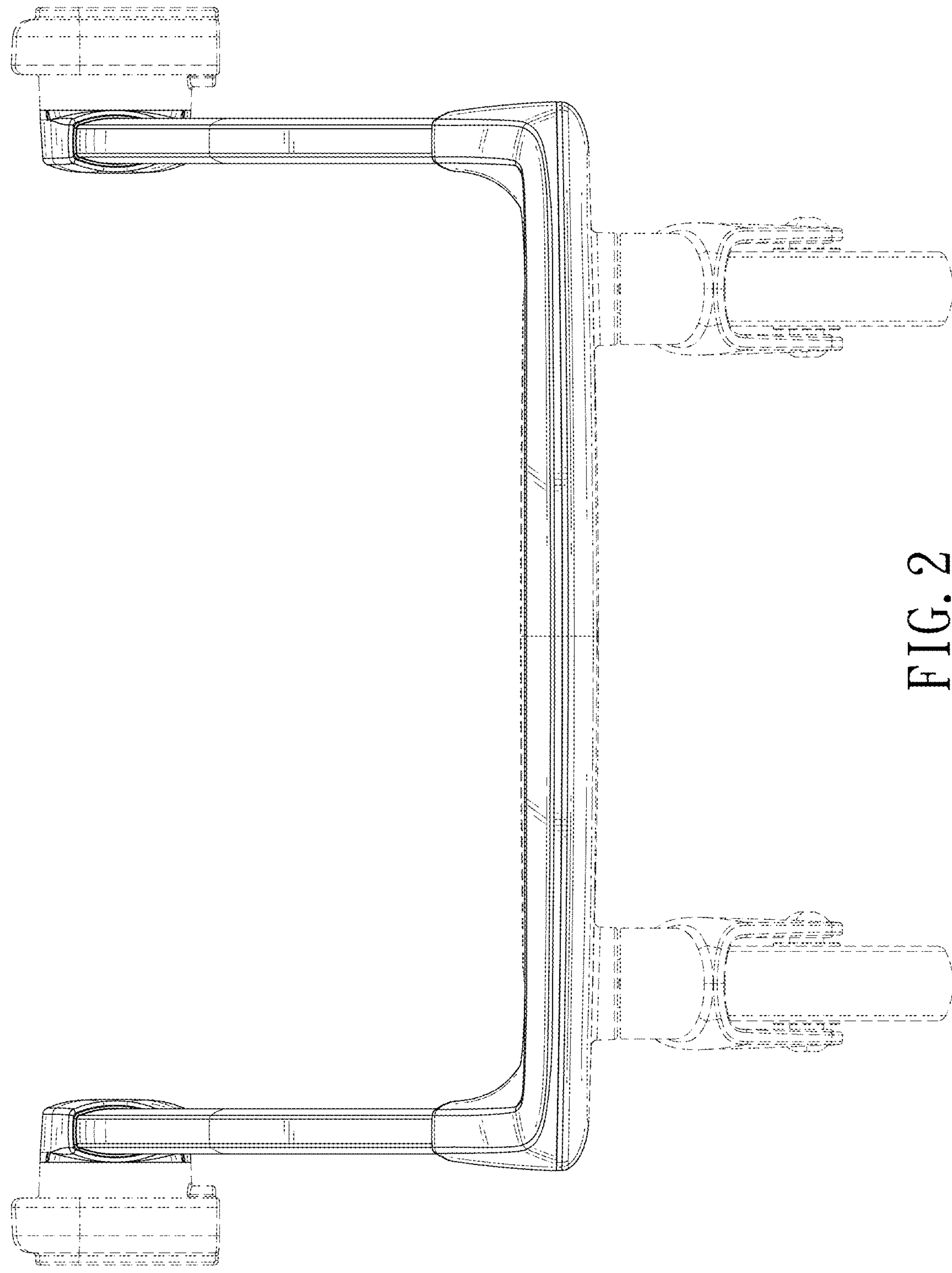

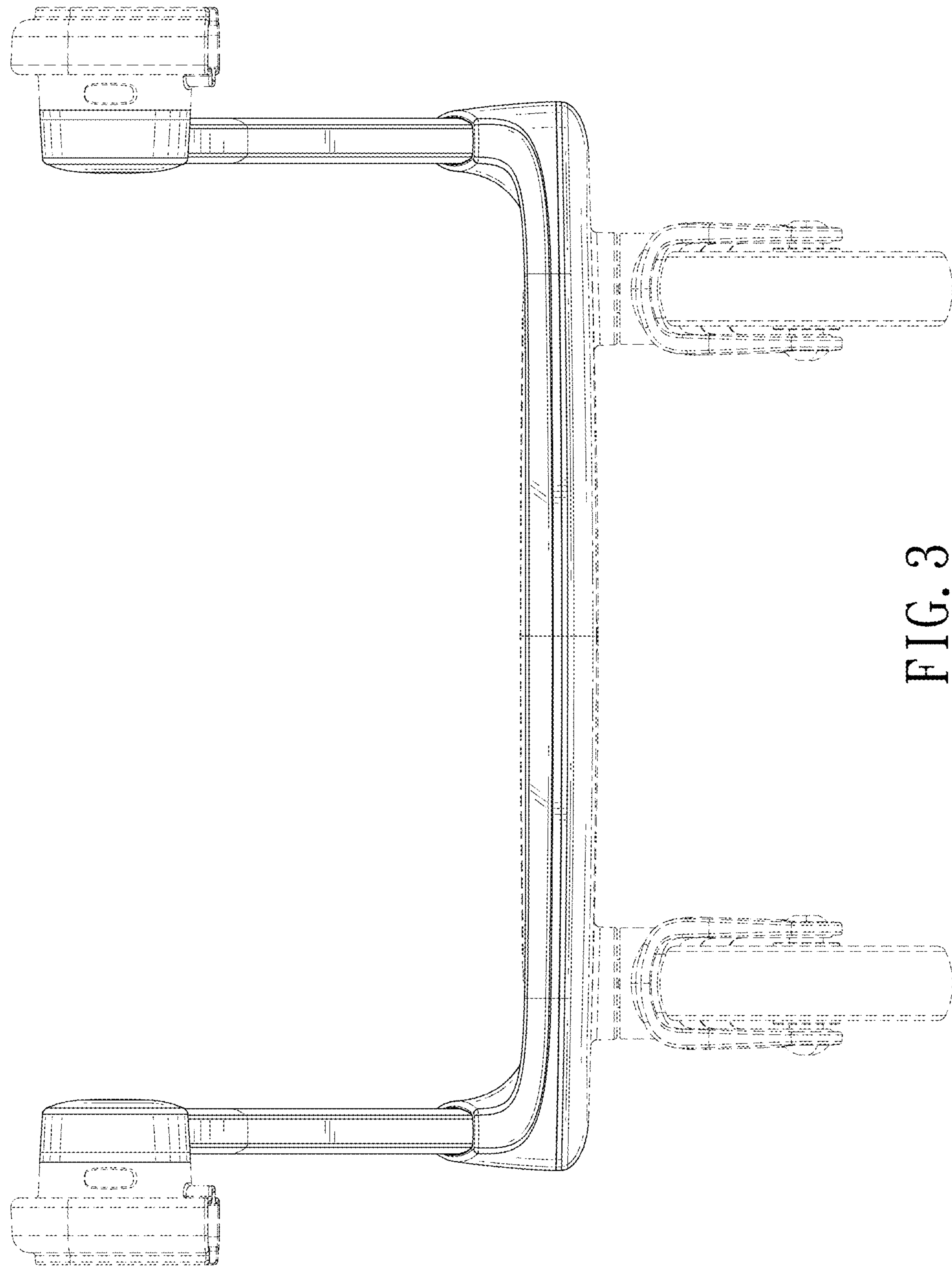

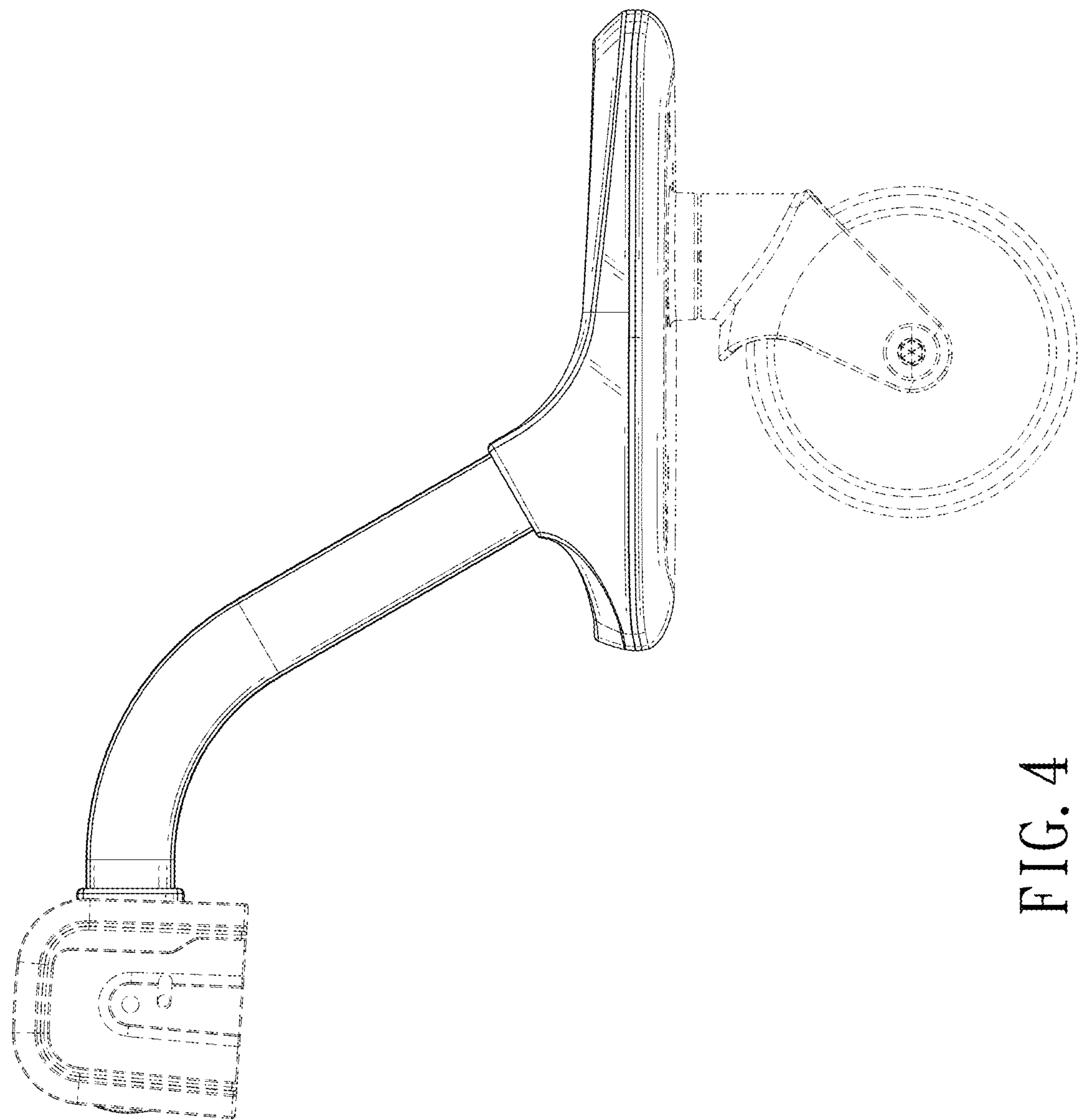

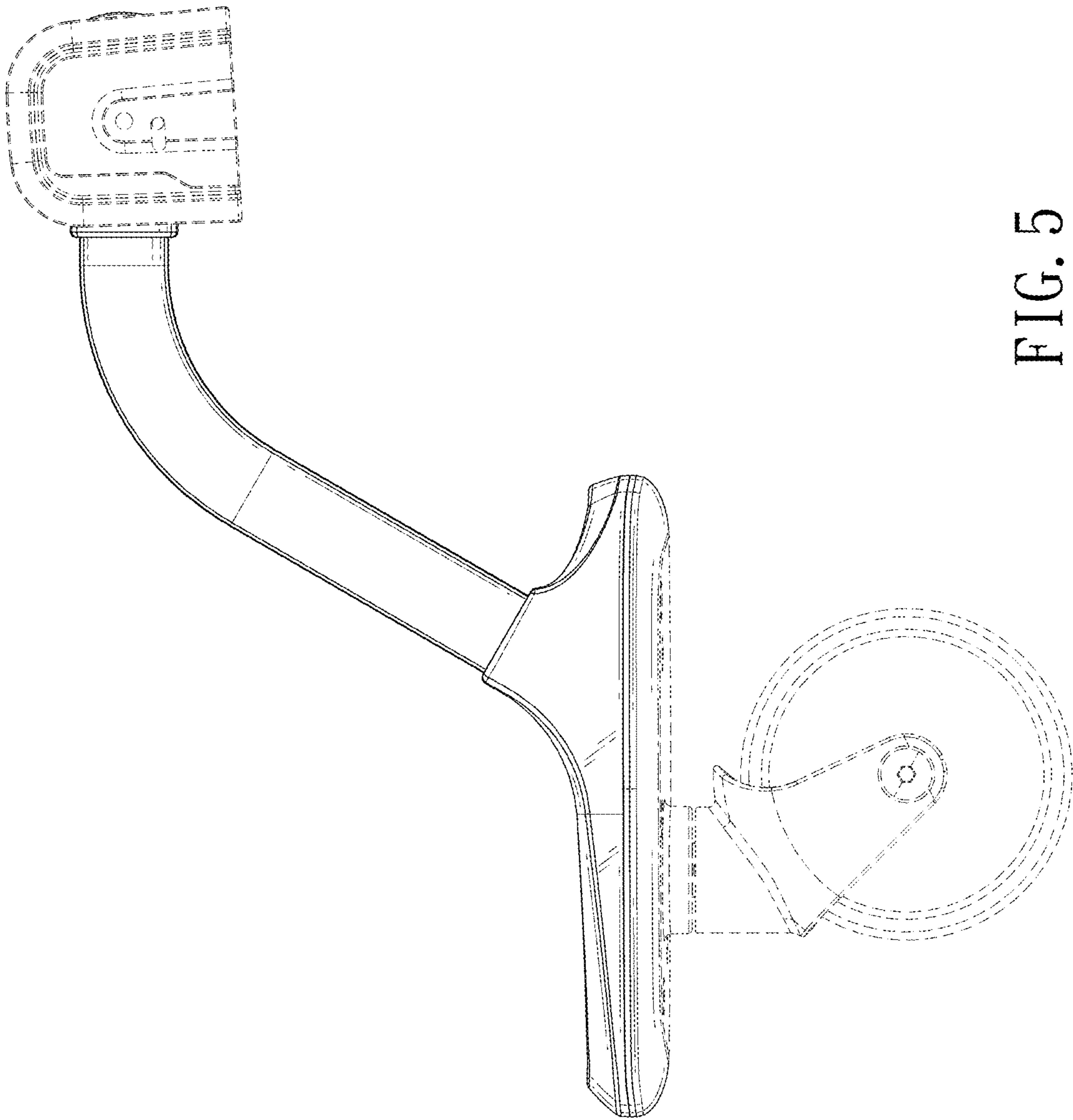

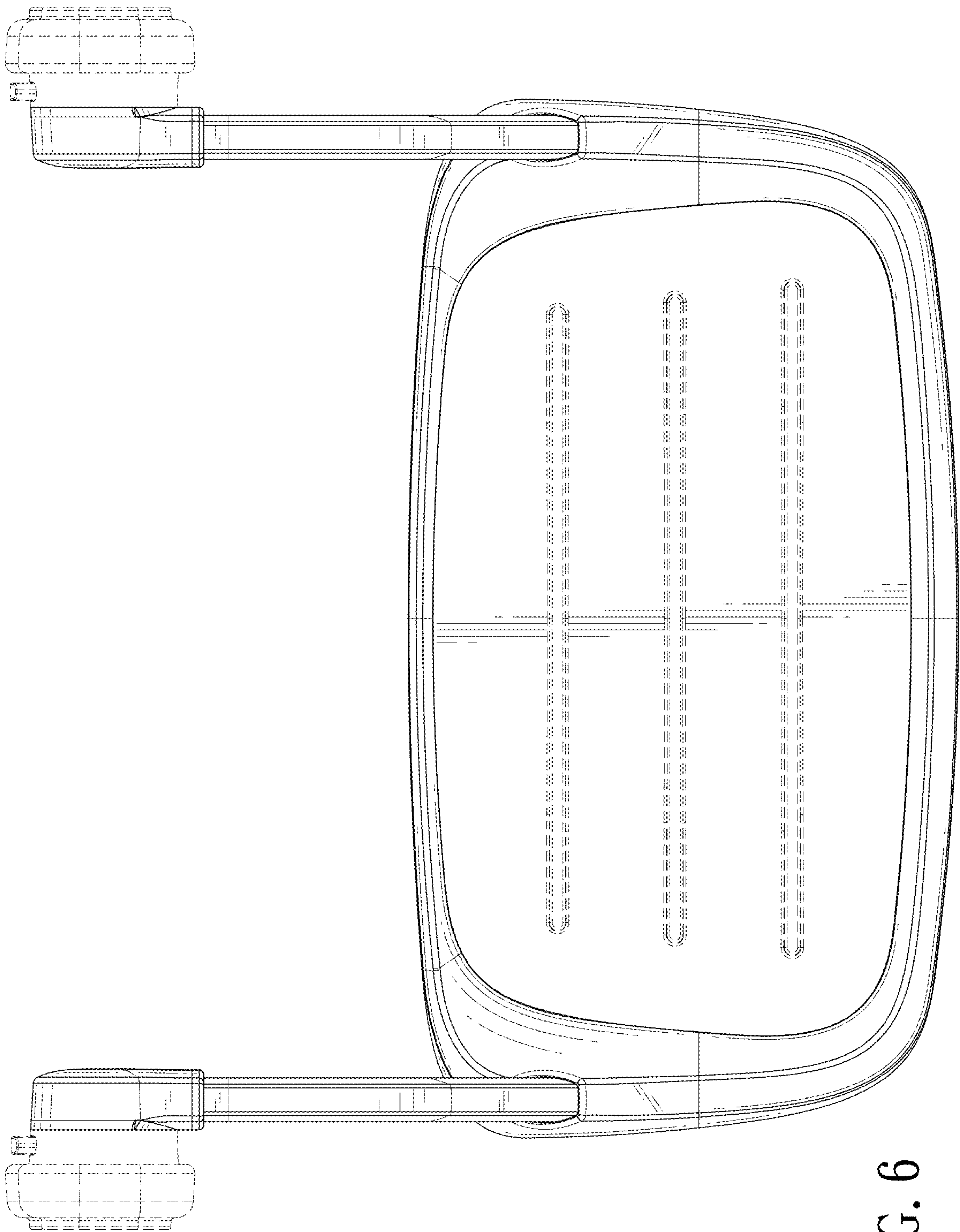

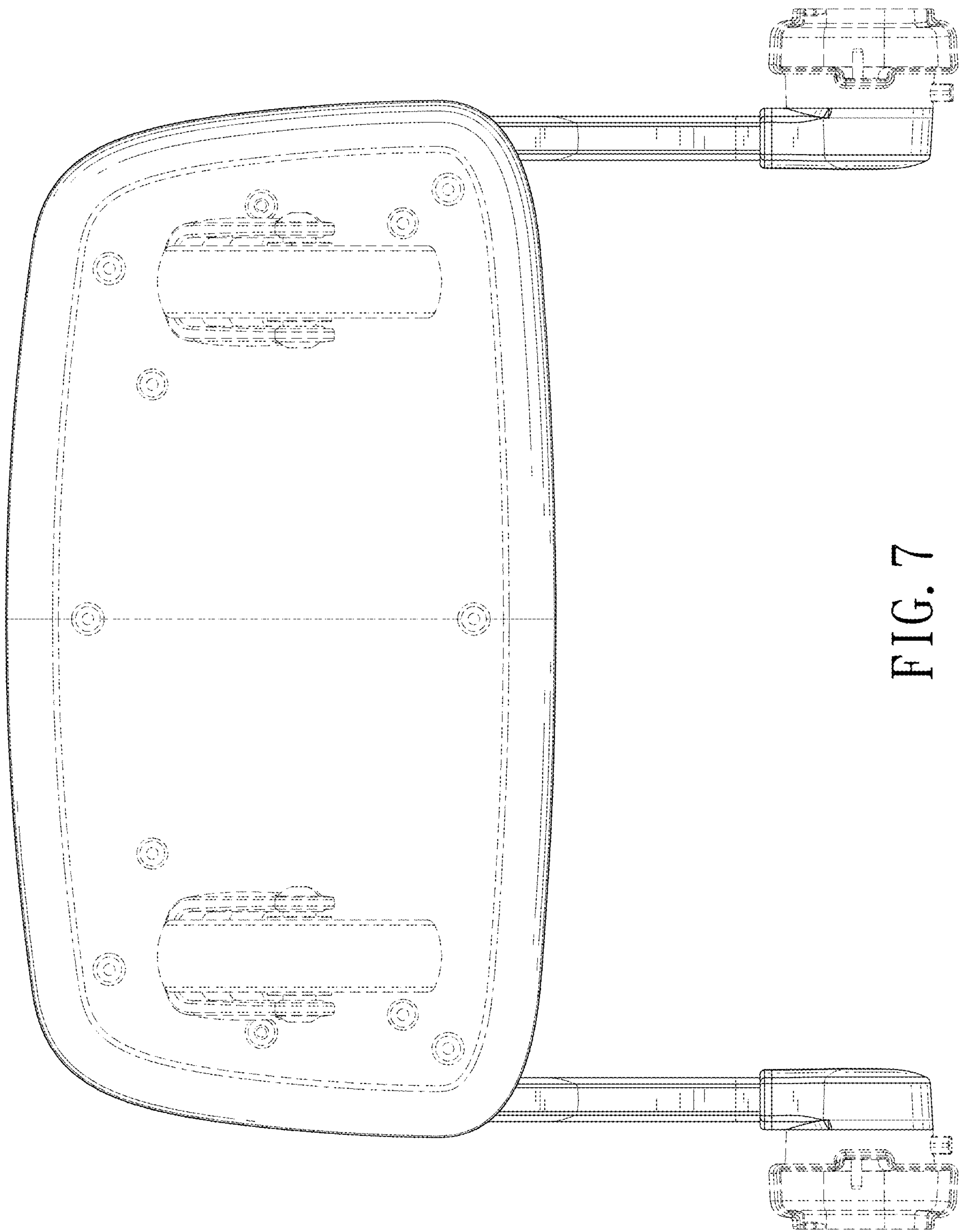
