FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a face plate embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right-side view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left-side view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the face plate shown in FIG. 1 positioned on a dispenser.
The broken lines in the drawings show unclaimed subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design. In FIGS. 3-7, the broken lines show the rear surface of the face plate and connection tabs, which may face a dispenser and are not typically visible, and form no part of the claimed design. In FIG. 8, the broken lines show a dispenser as an environment for the face plate and form no part of the claimed design.

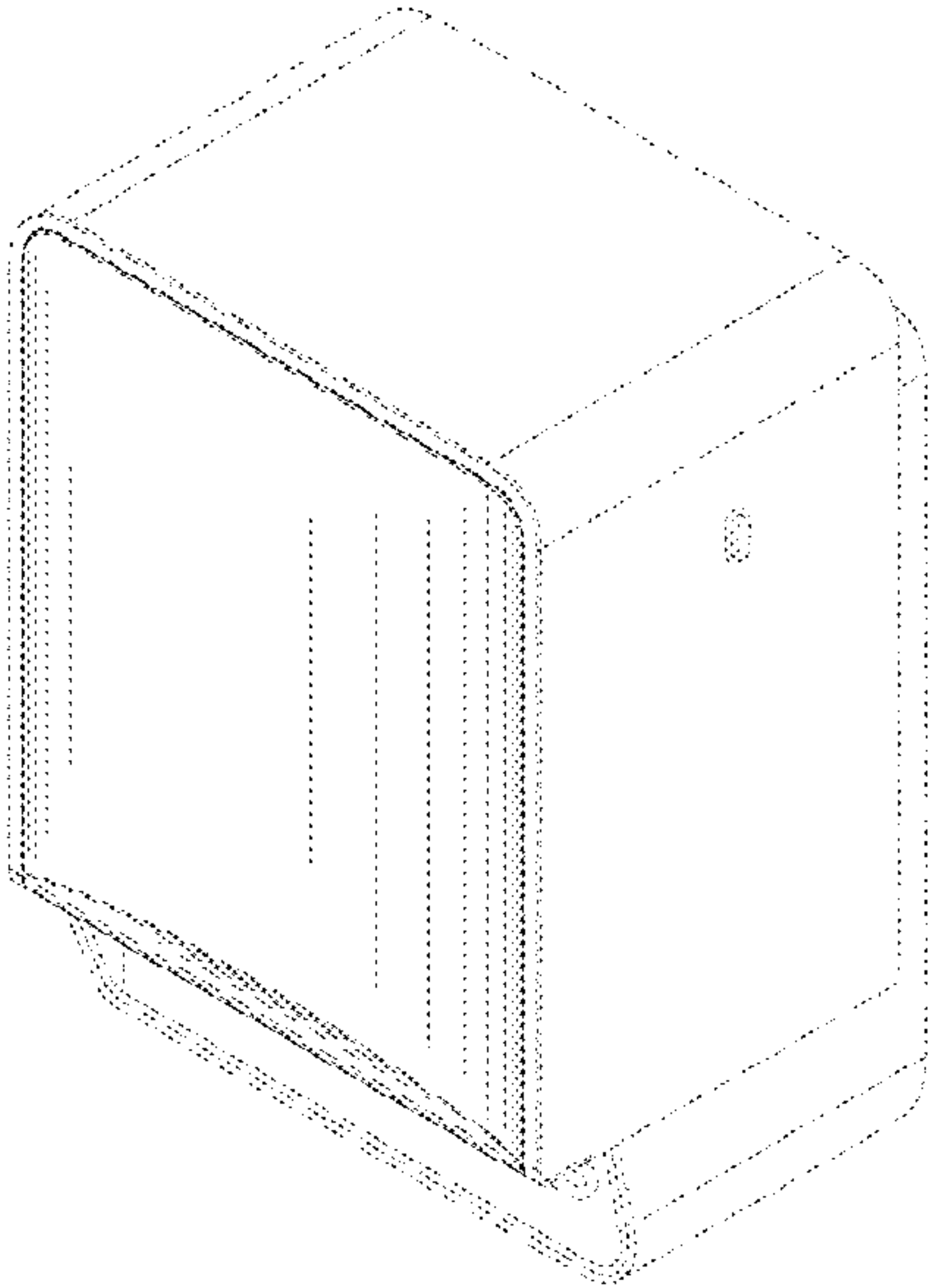

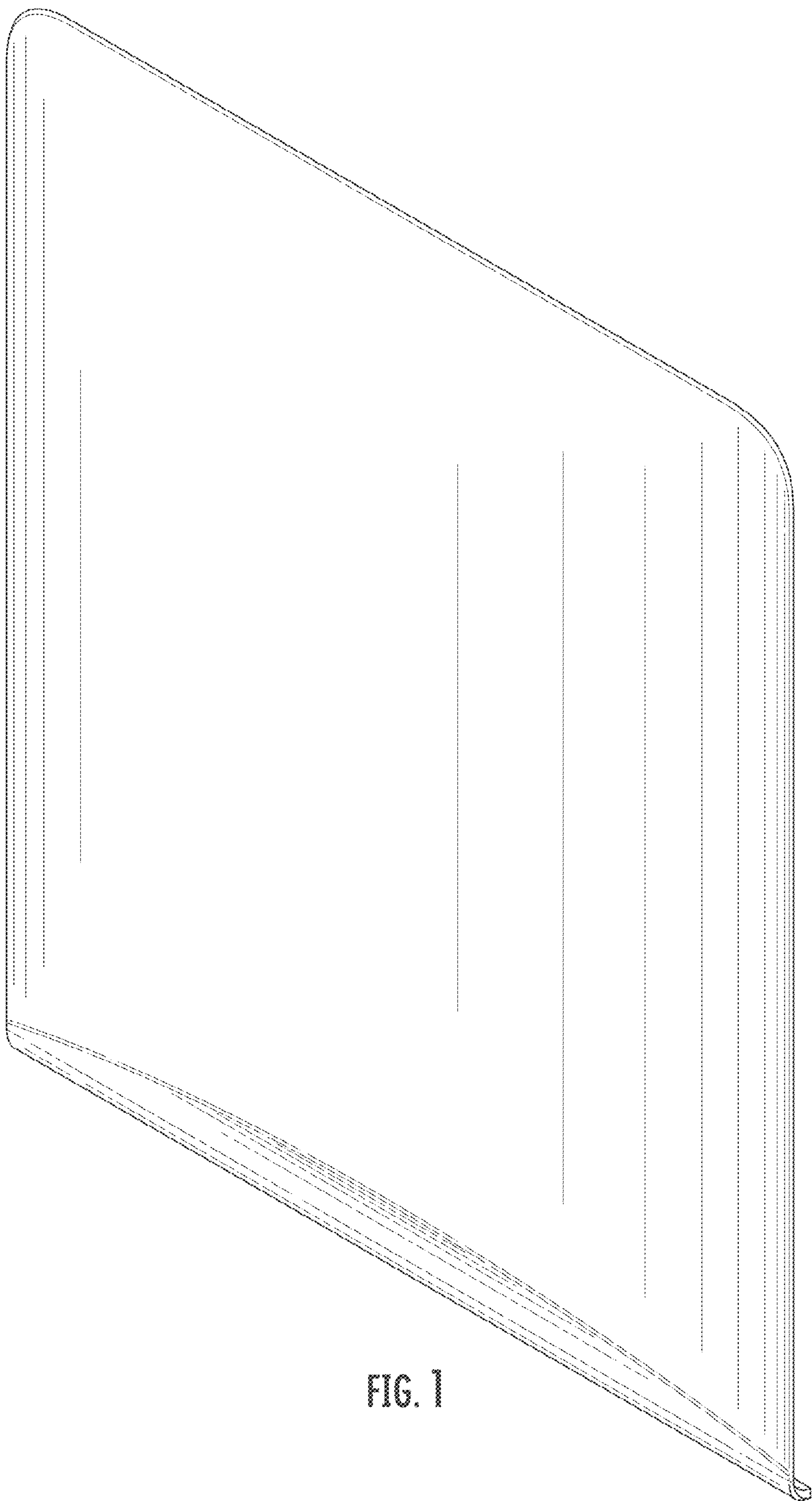

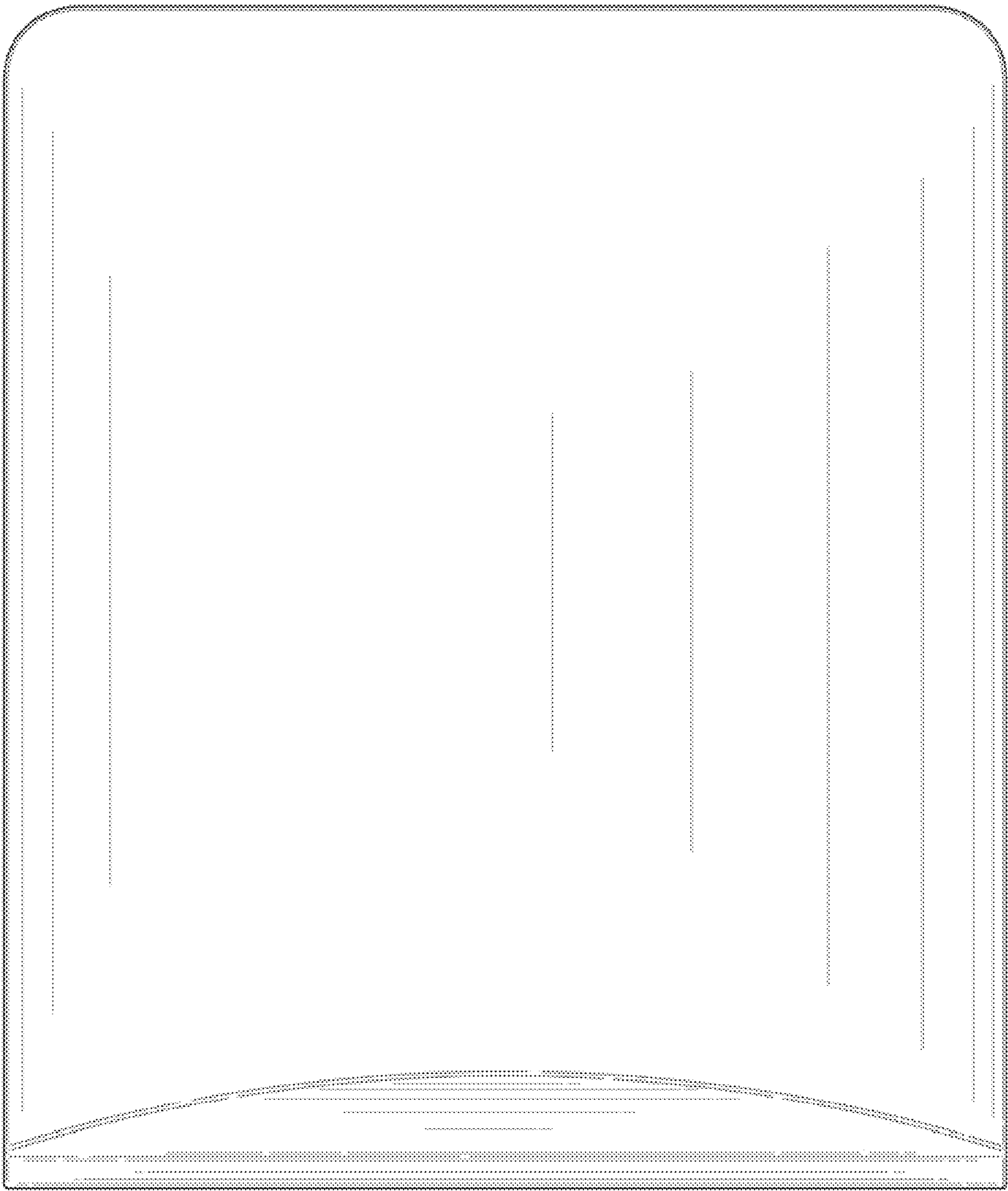

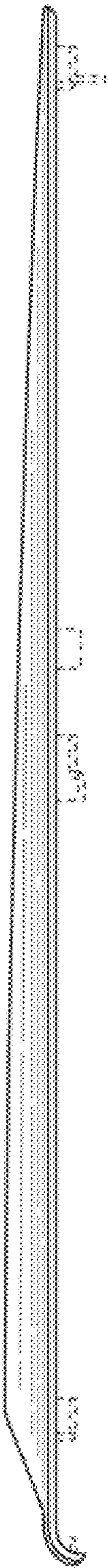

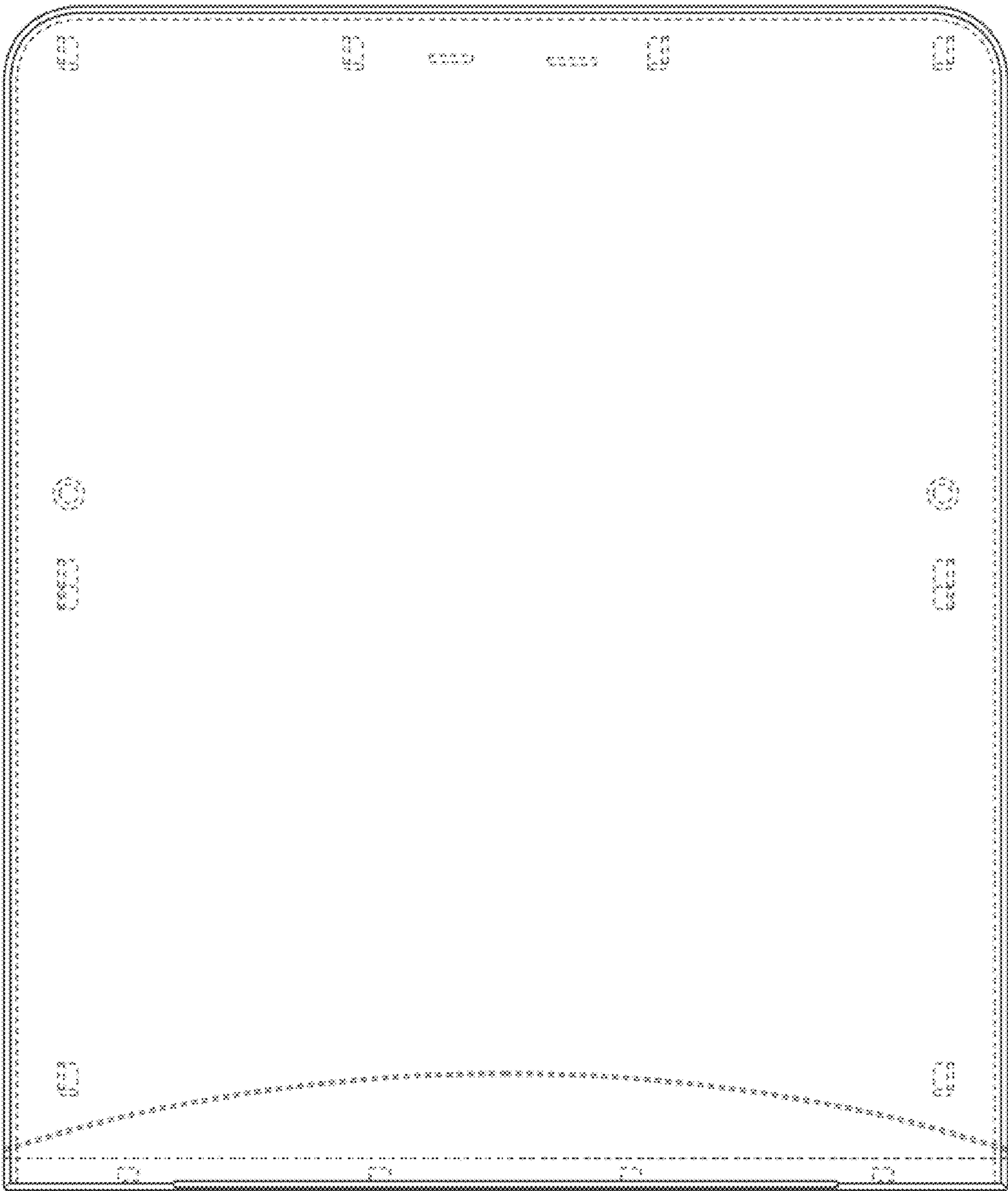

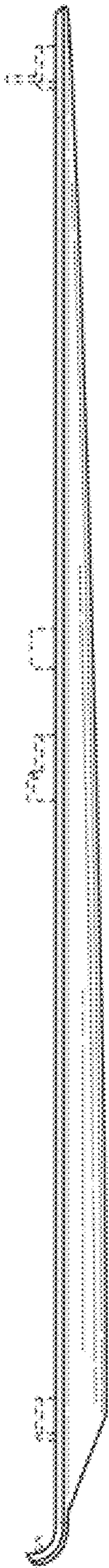

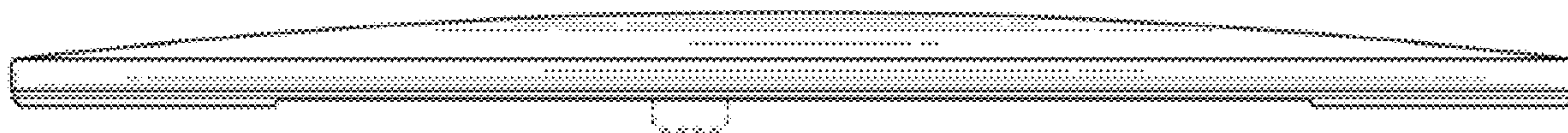

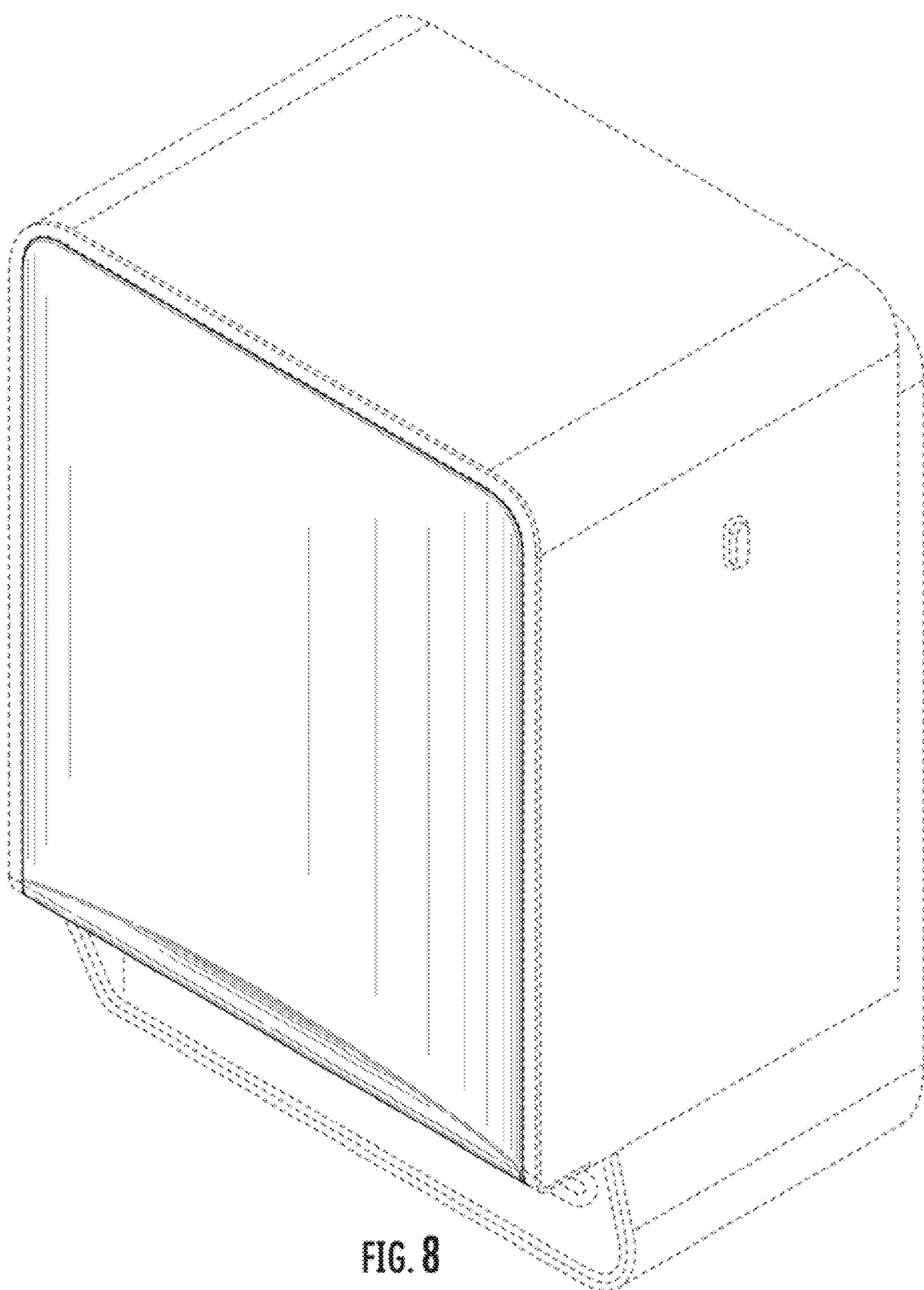
