The ornamental design for a floor mat as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a floor mat showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a detail view of the area labeled 2 in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front right top isometric detail view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation detail view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation detail view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevation detail view thereof; FIG. 7 is a left-side elevation detail view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 8-8 of FIG. 2.

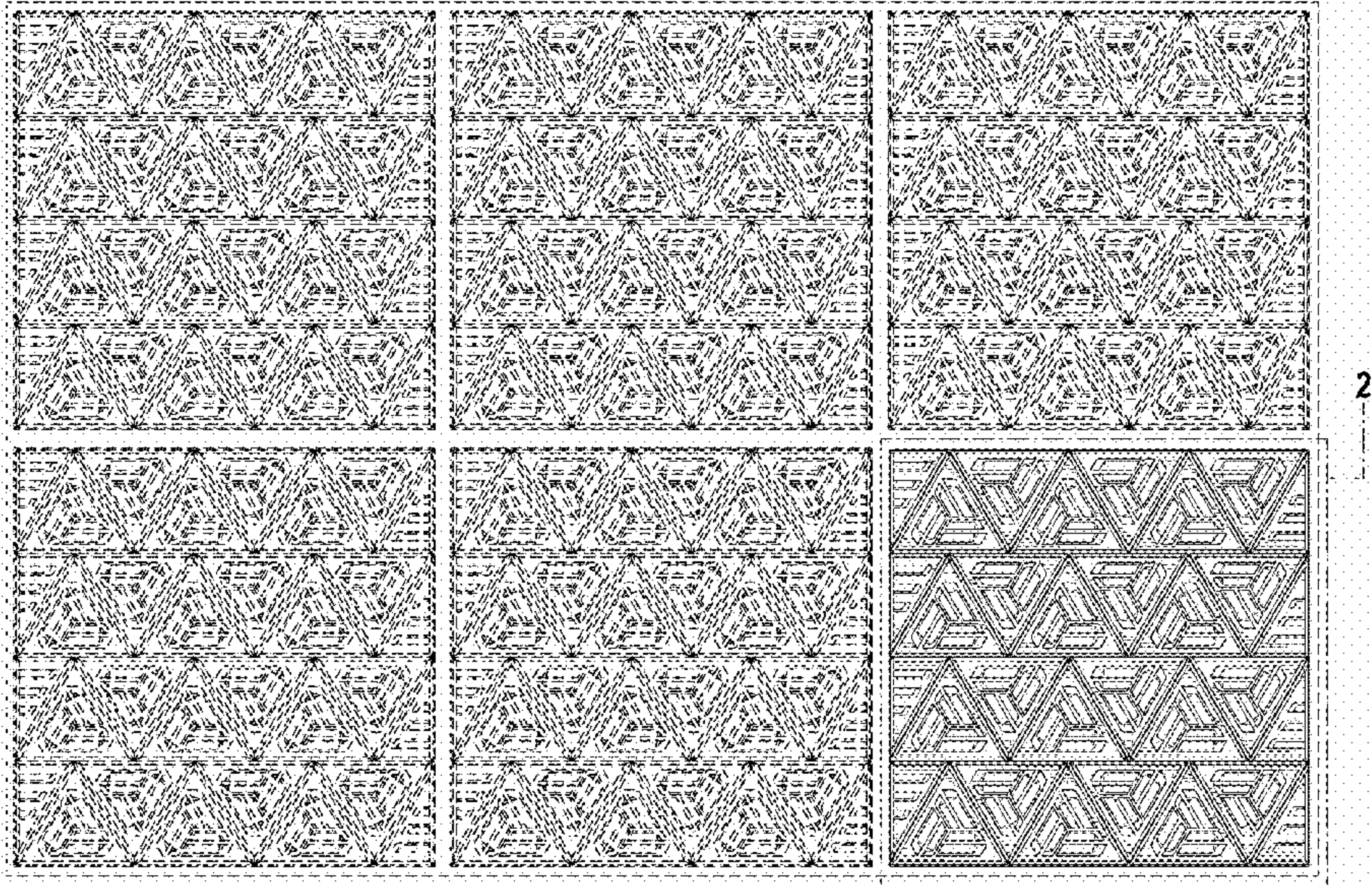

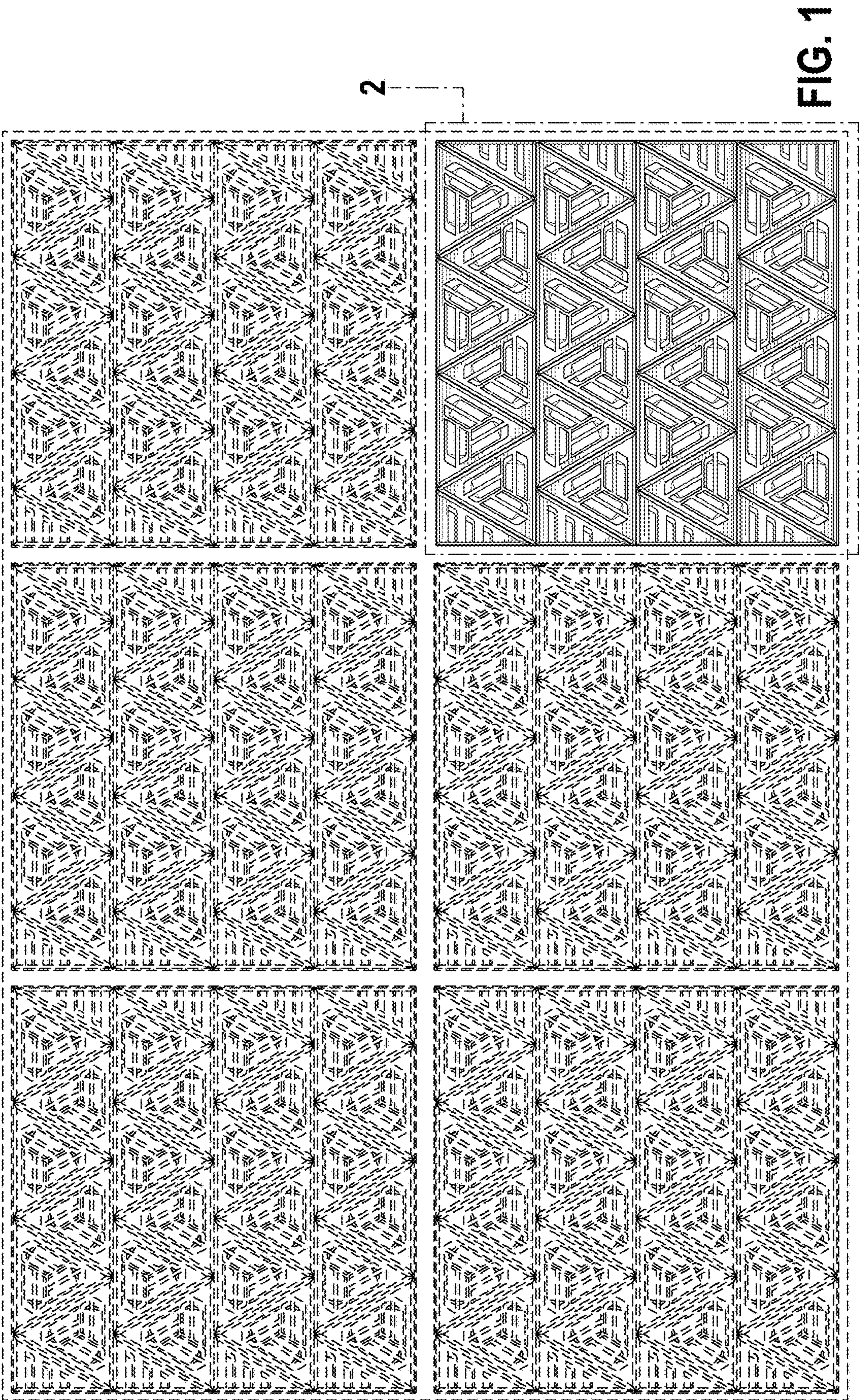


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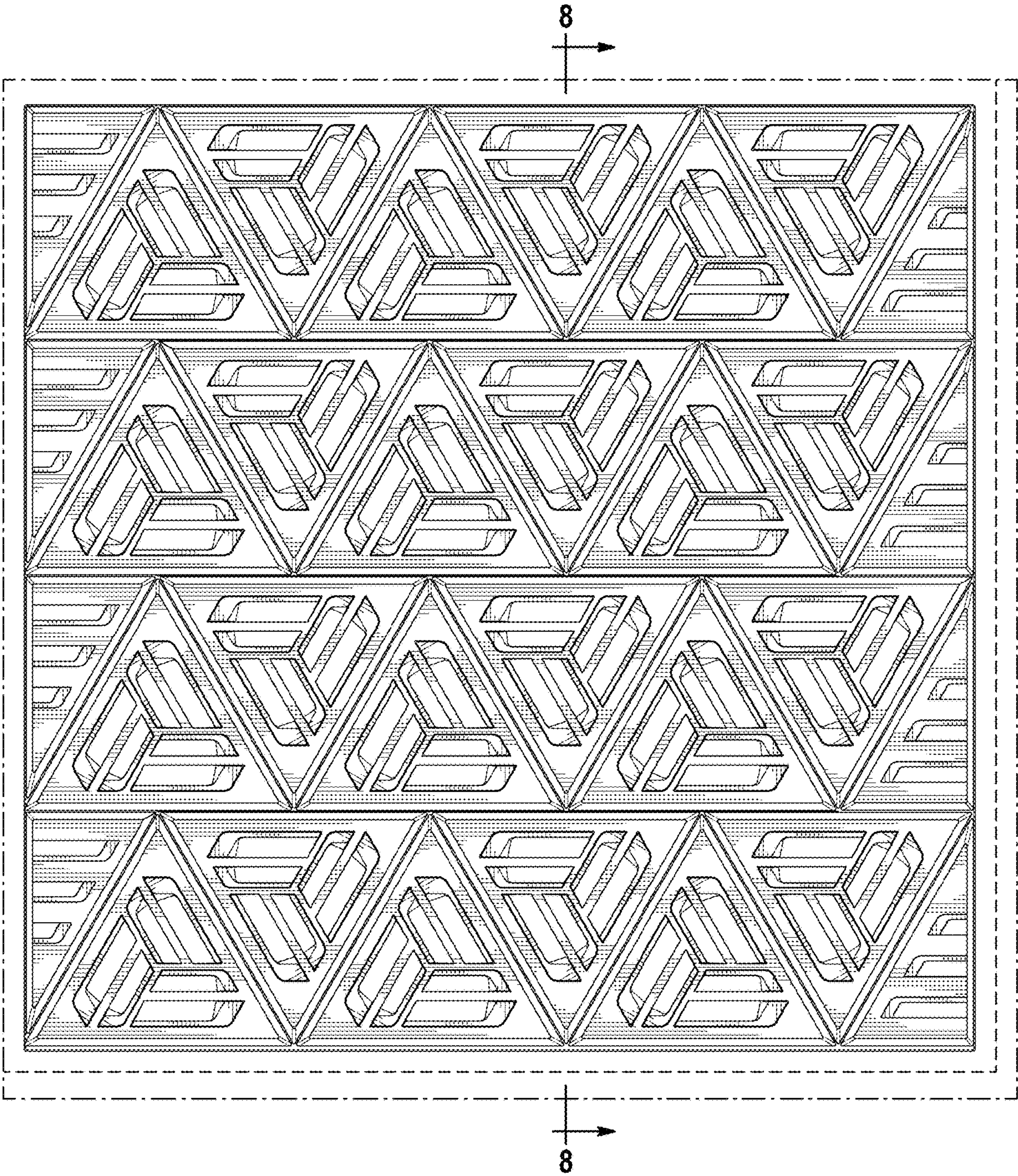

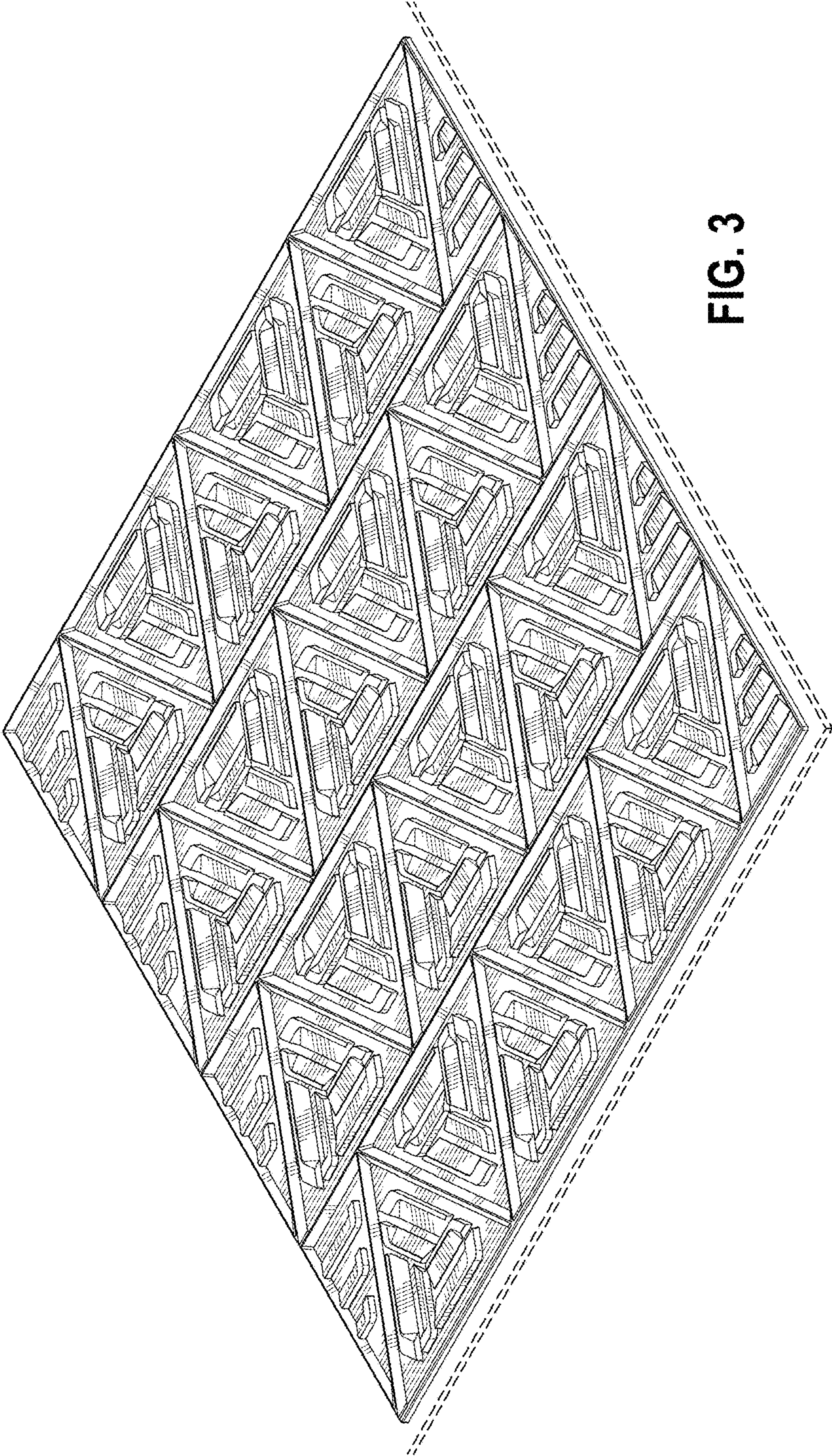

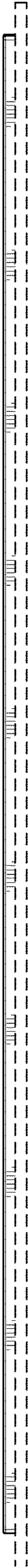

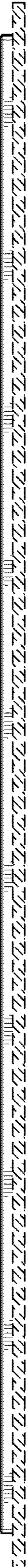
