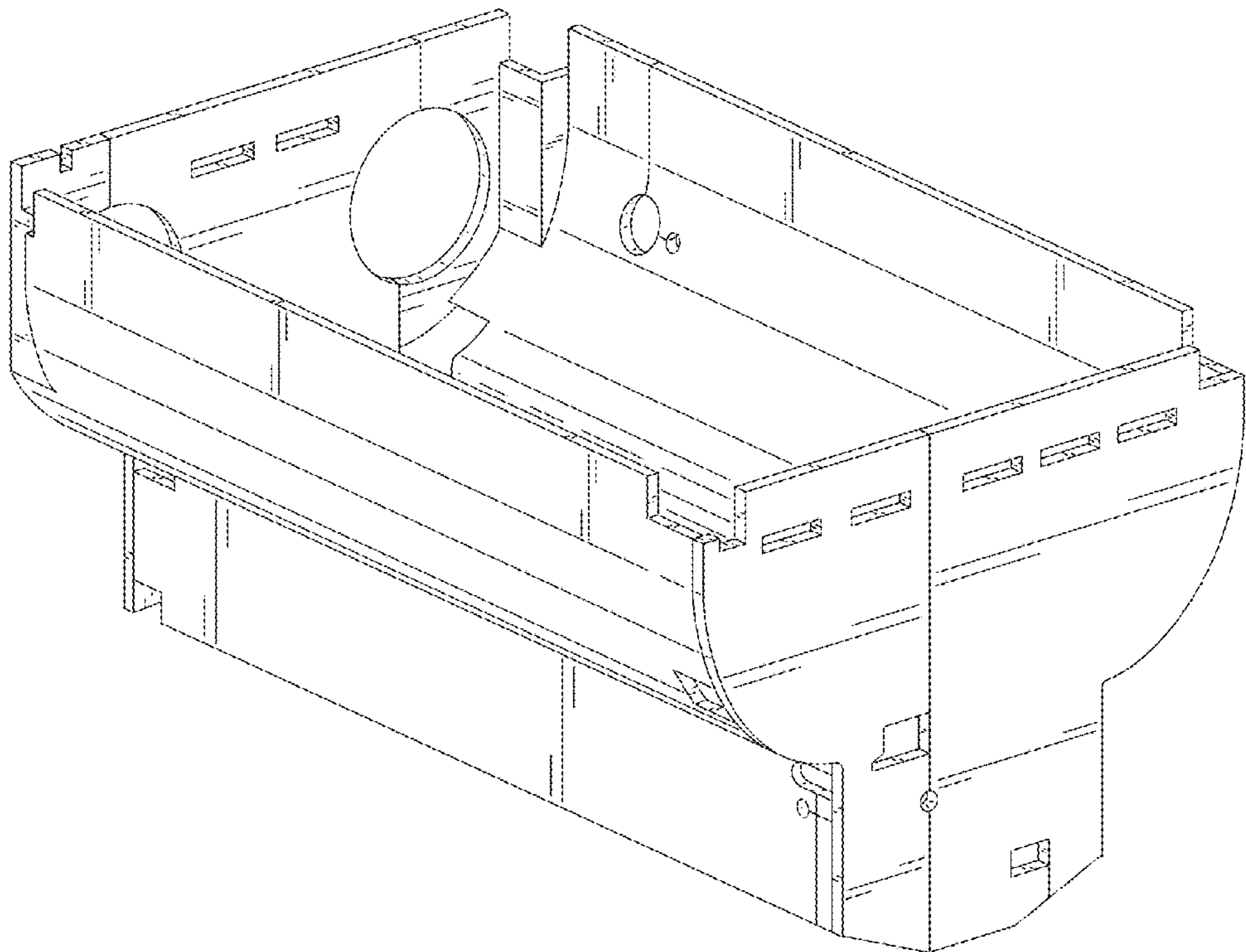

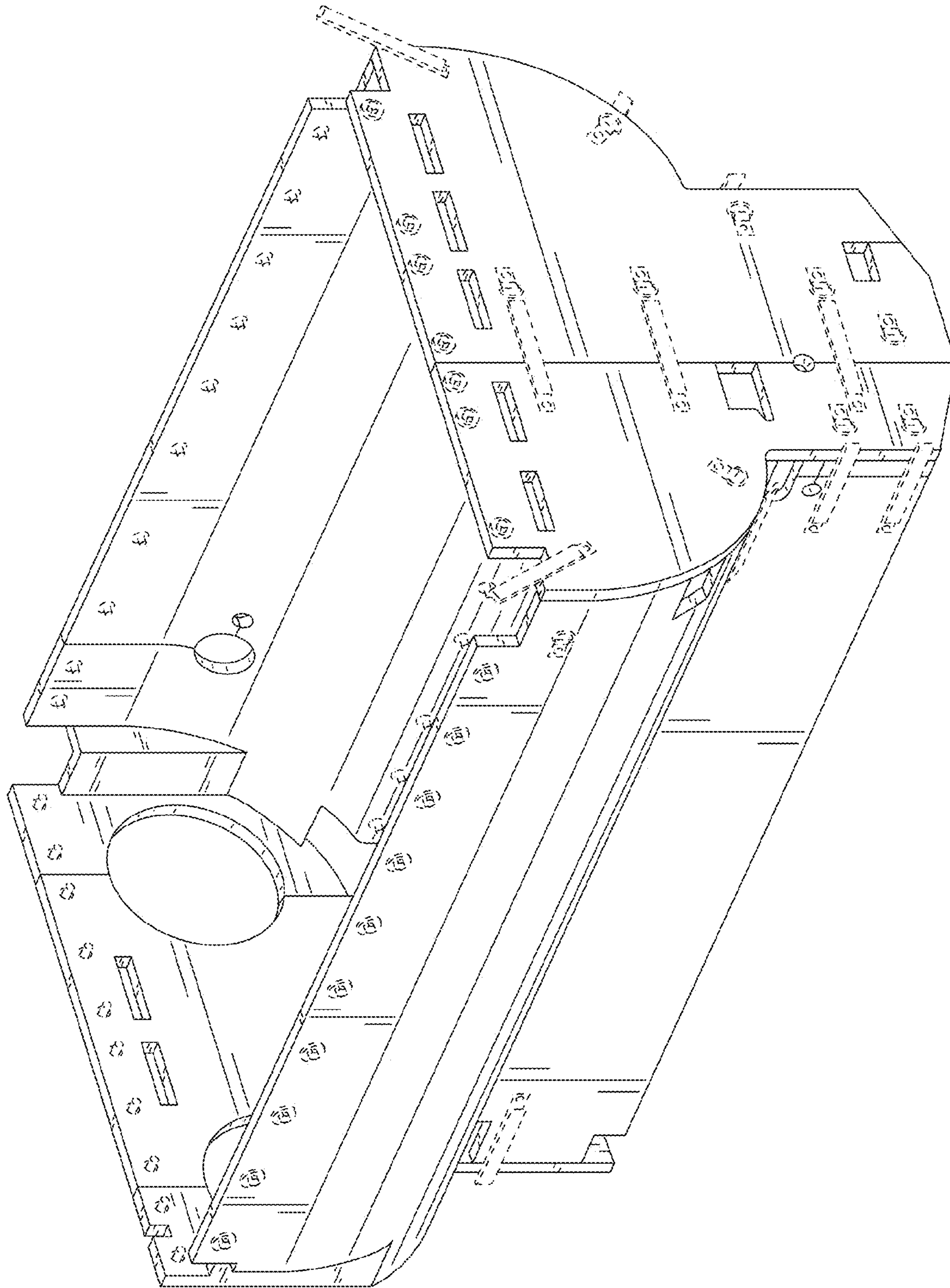
The ornamental design for a heat shield as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-top-left perspective view of a heat shield, according to a first embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a front view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a rear view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 4 is a left side view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a right side view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 6 is a top view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the heat shield of FIG. 1. FIG. 8 is a front-top-left perspective view of a heat shield, according to a second embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 9 is a front view of the heat shield of FIG. 8. FIG. 10 is a rear view of the heat shield of FIG. 8. FIG. 11 is a left side view of the heat shield of FIG. 8. FIG. 12 is a right side view of the heat shield of FIG. 8. 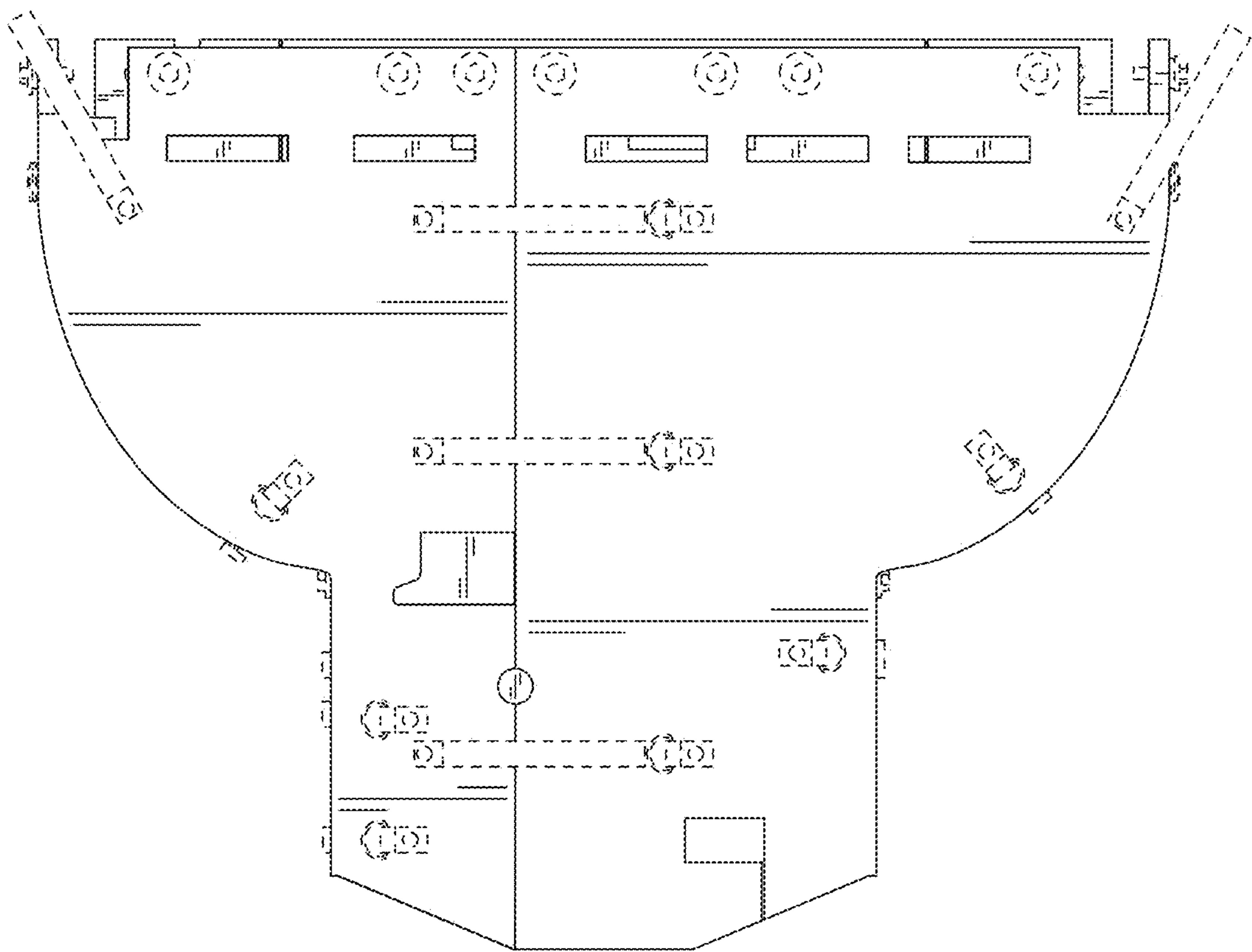

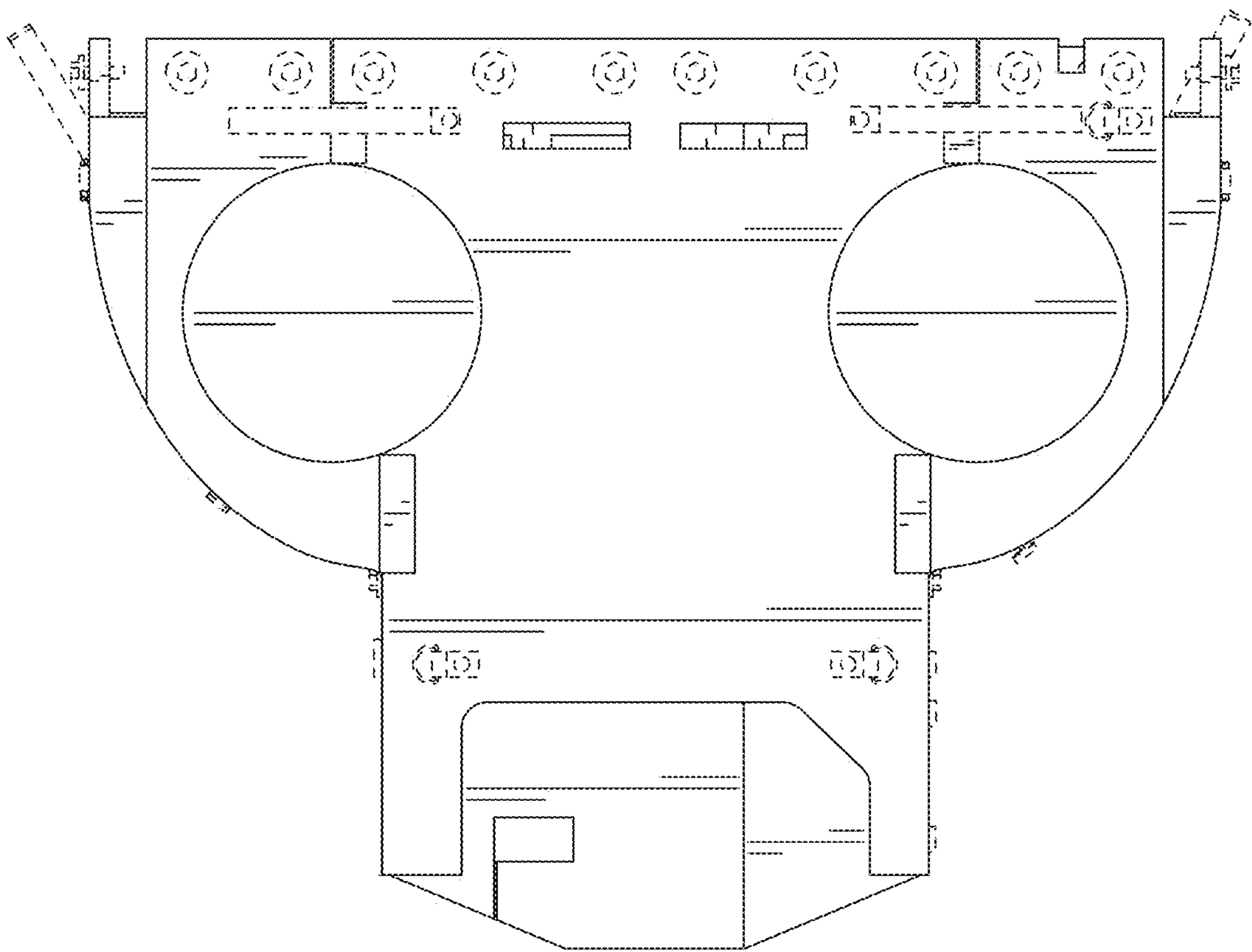

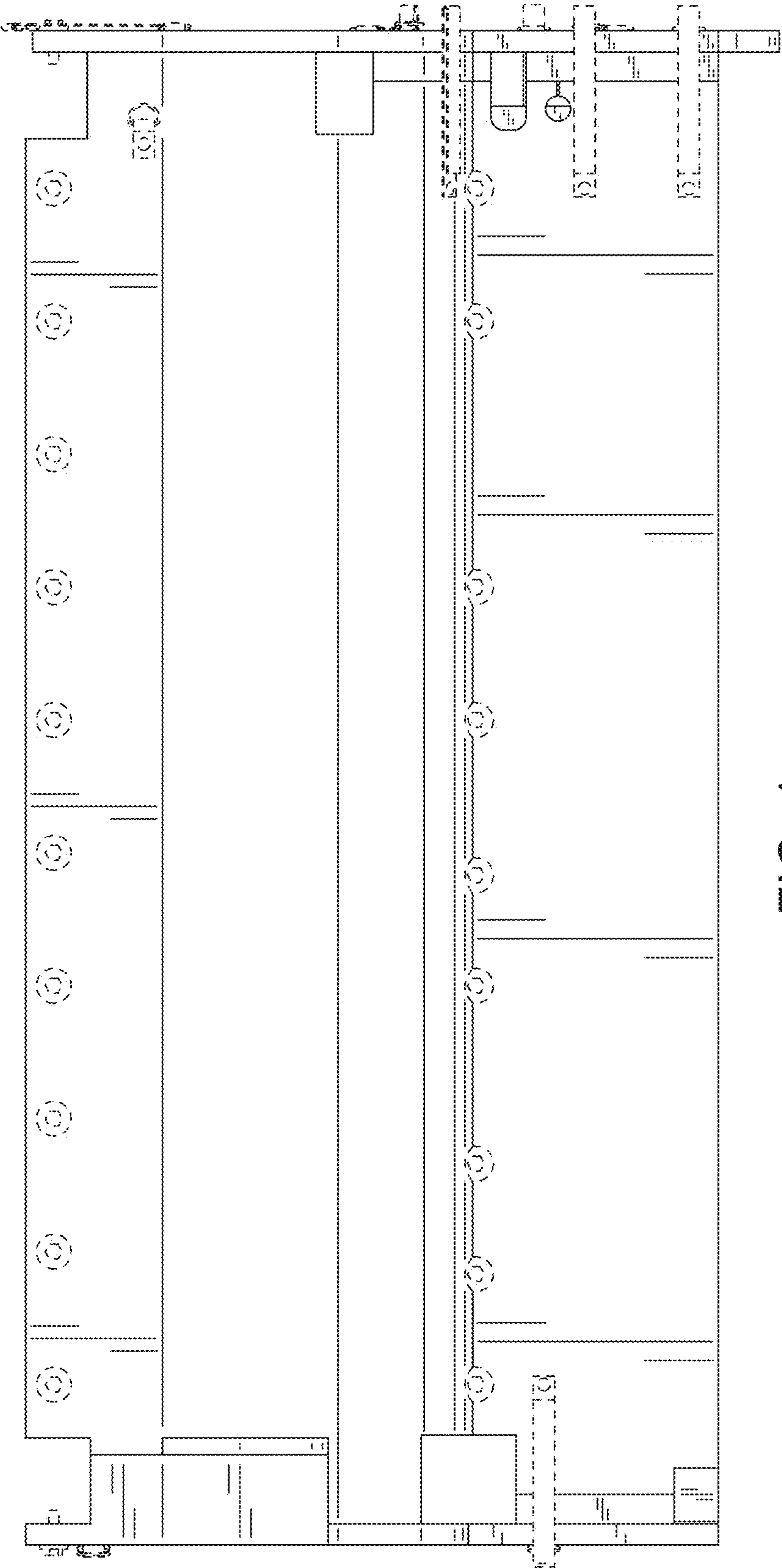
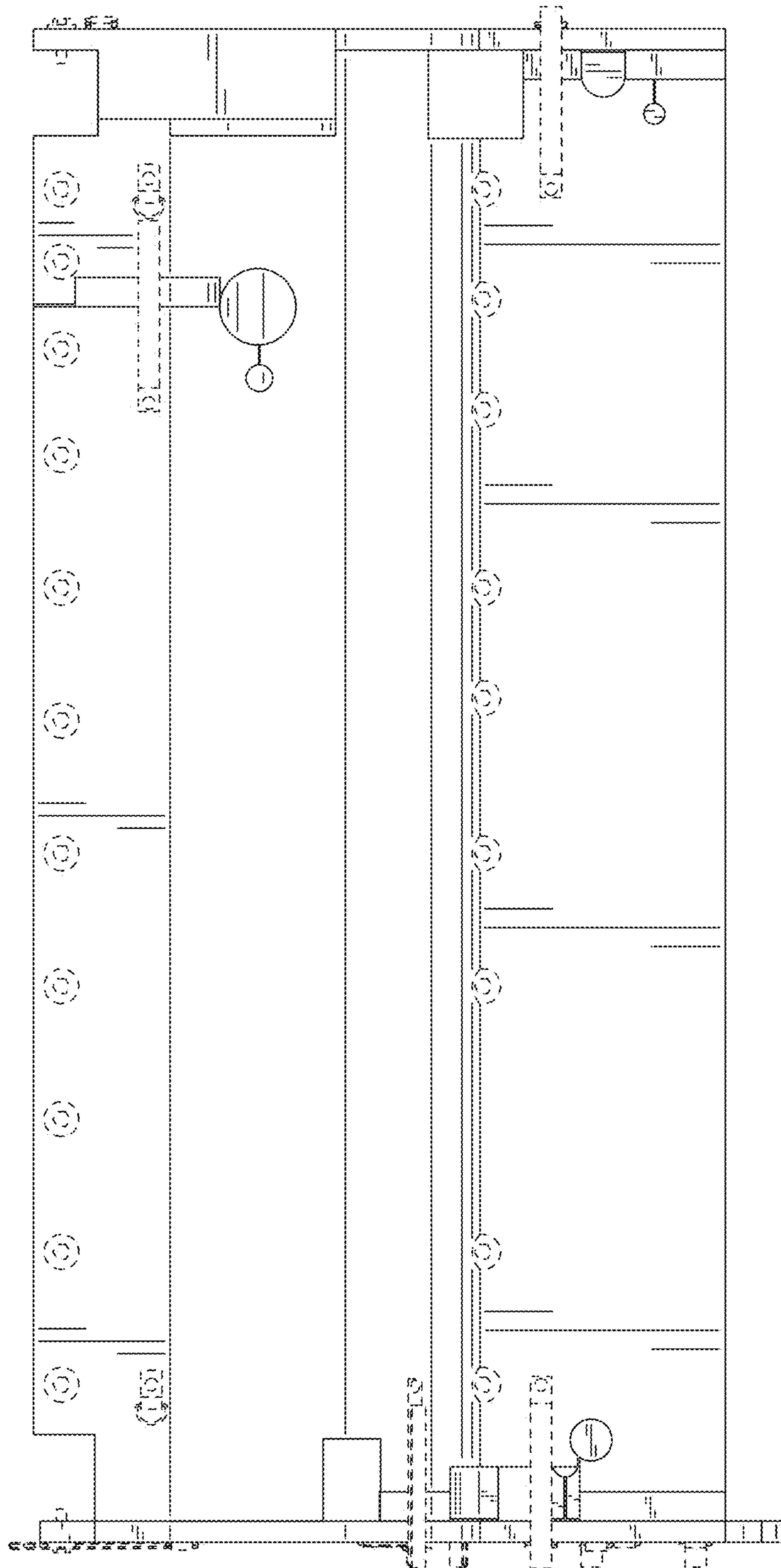

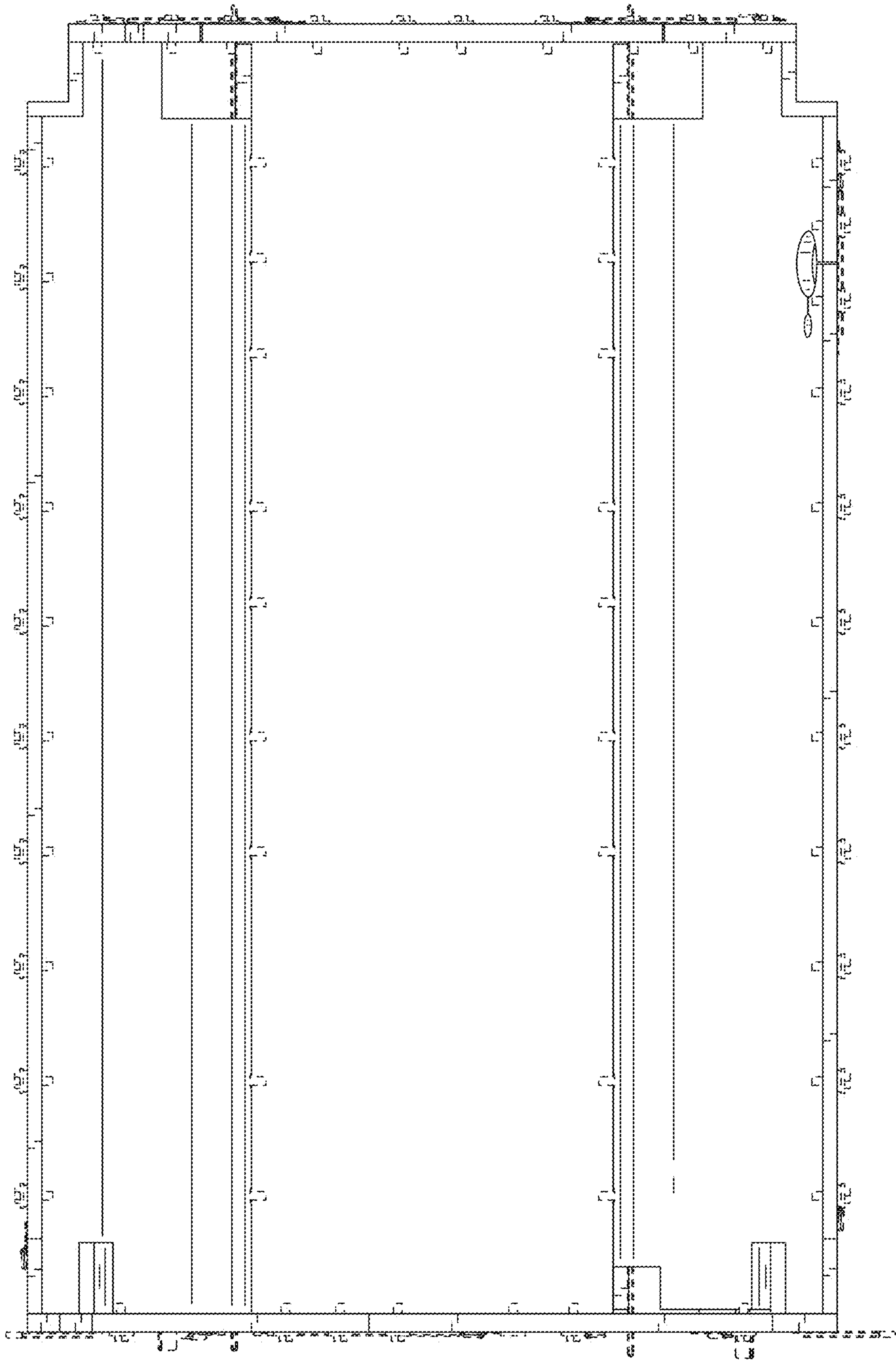

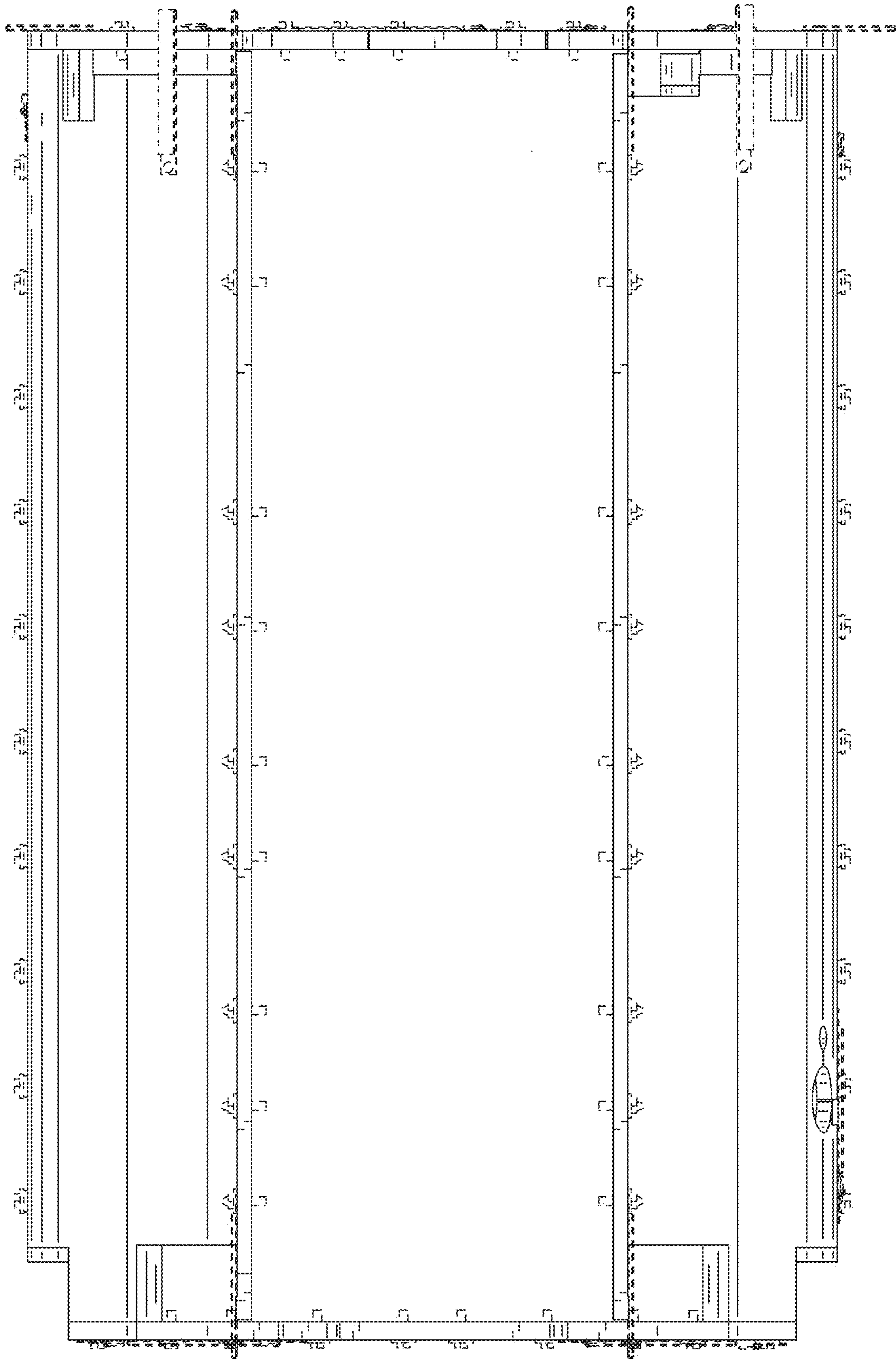

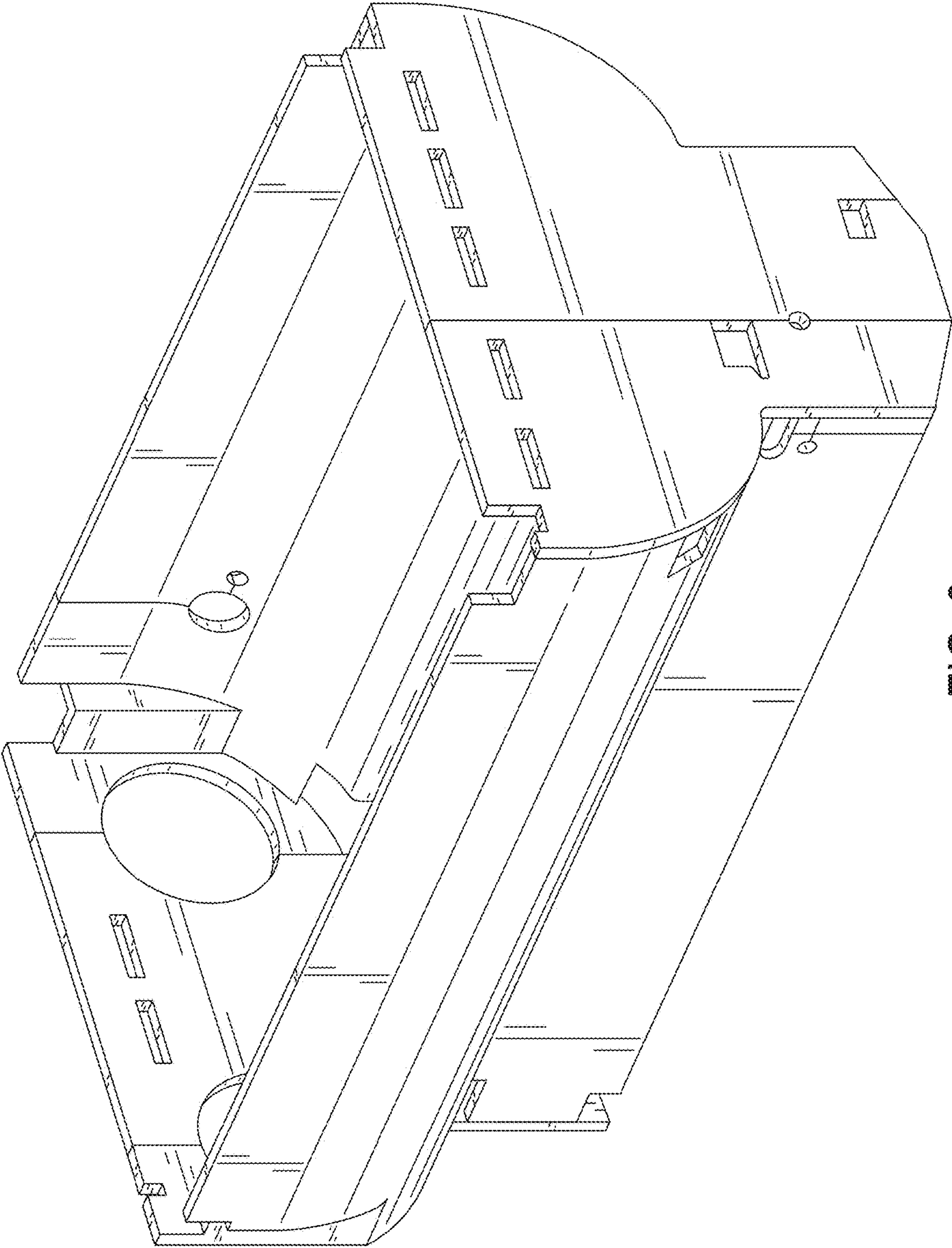

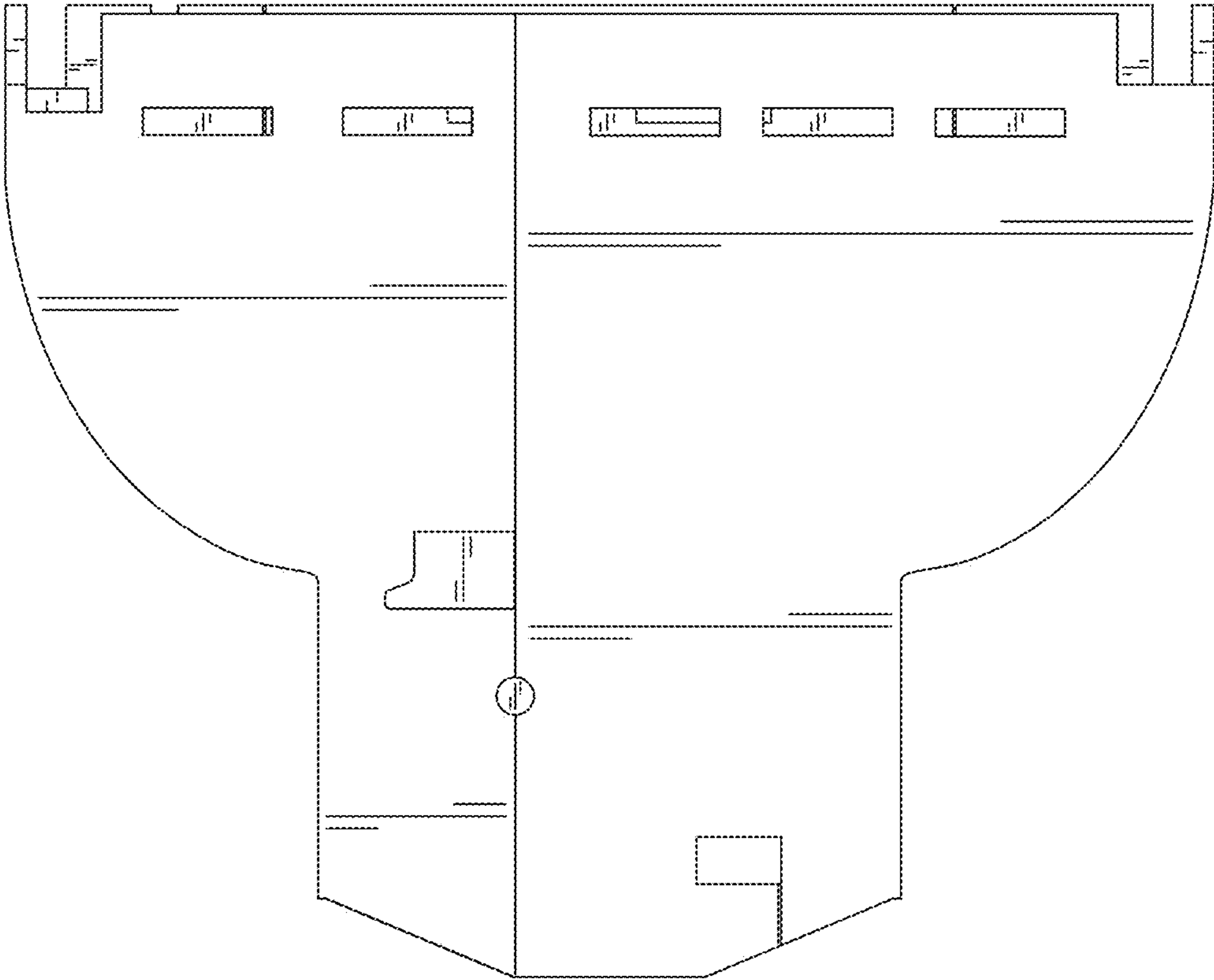

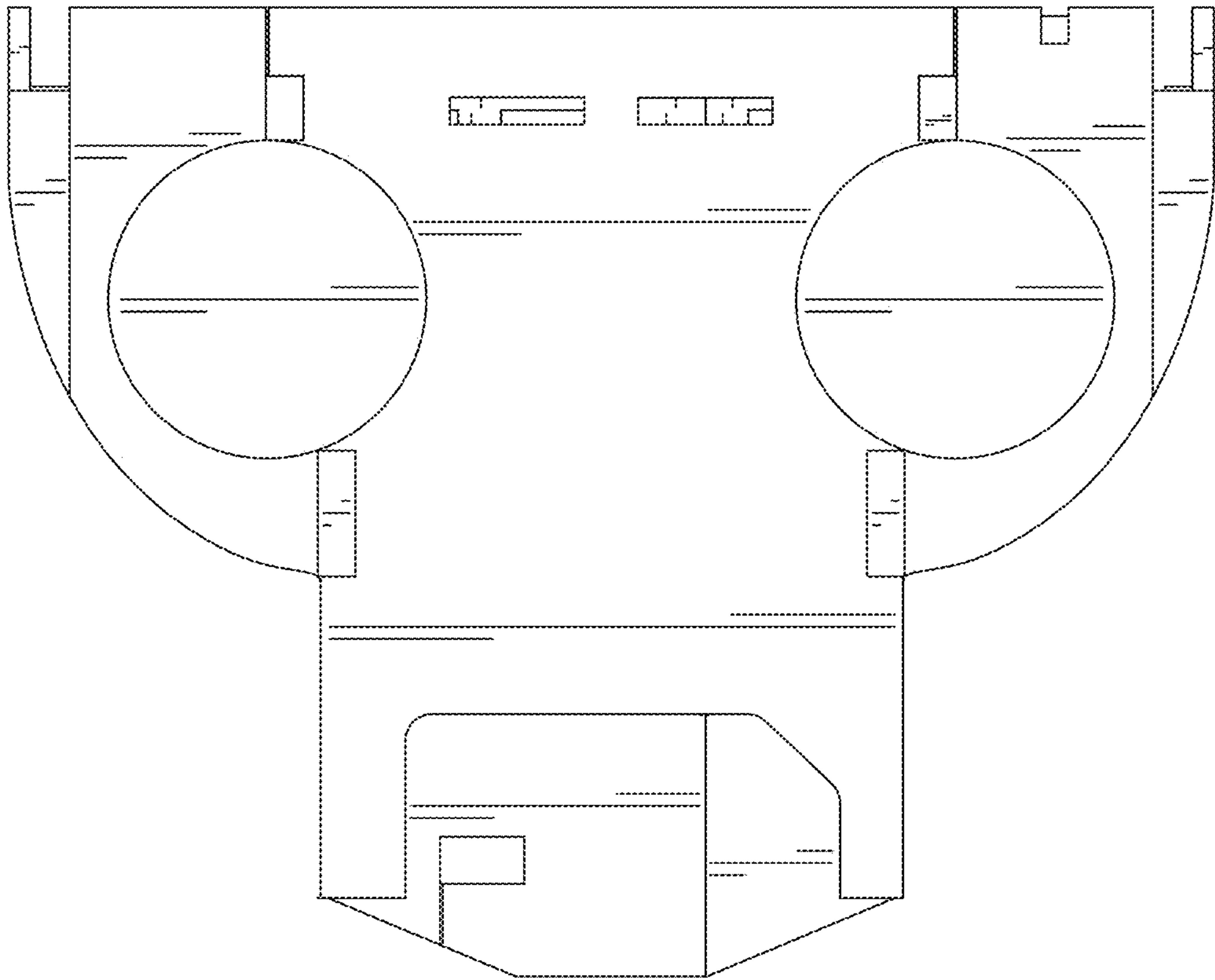

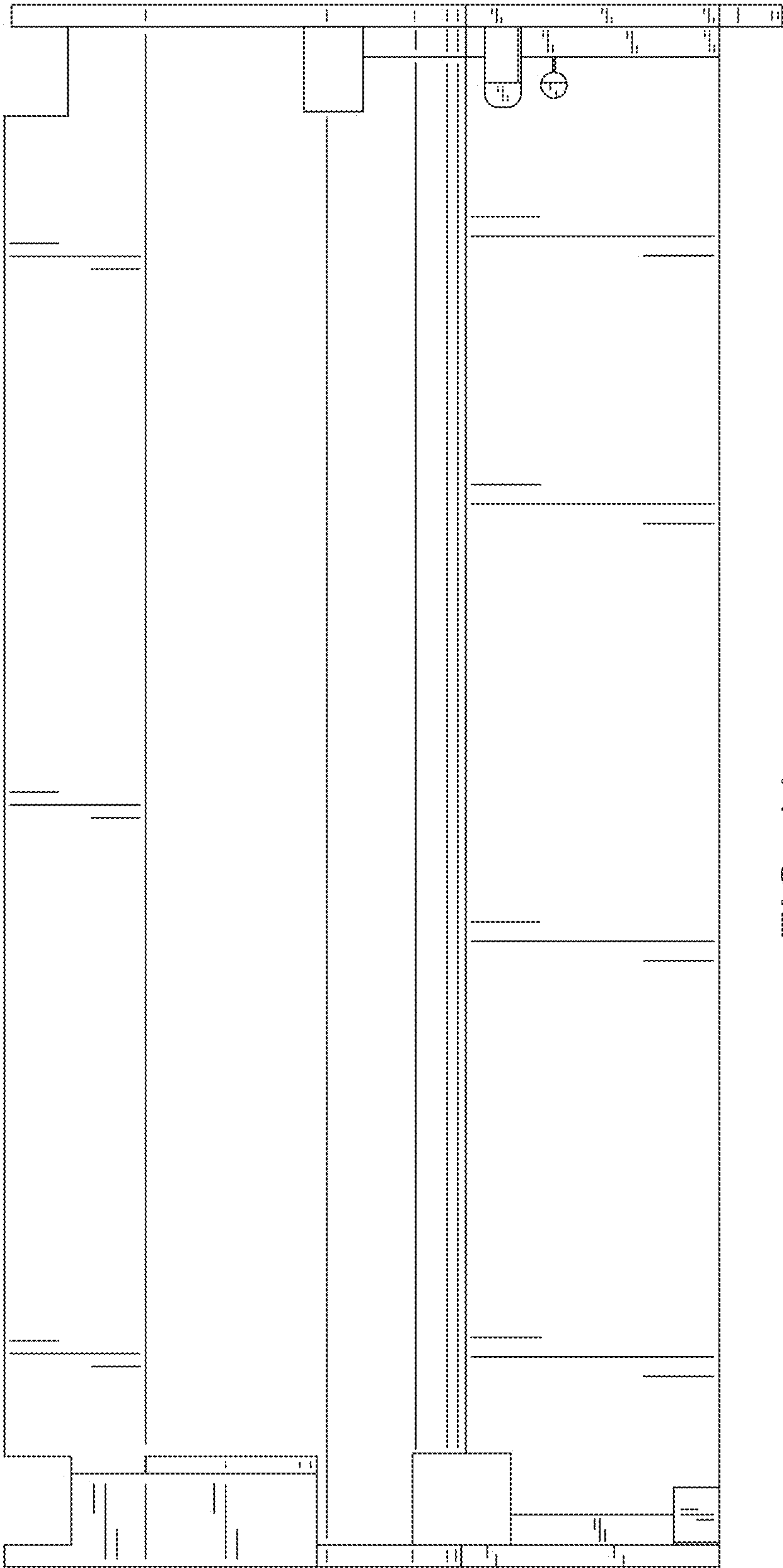

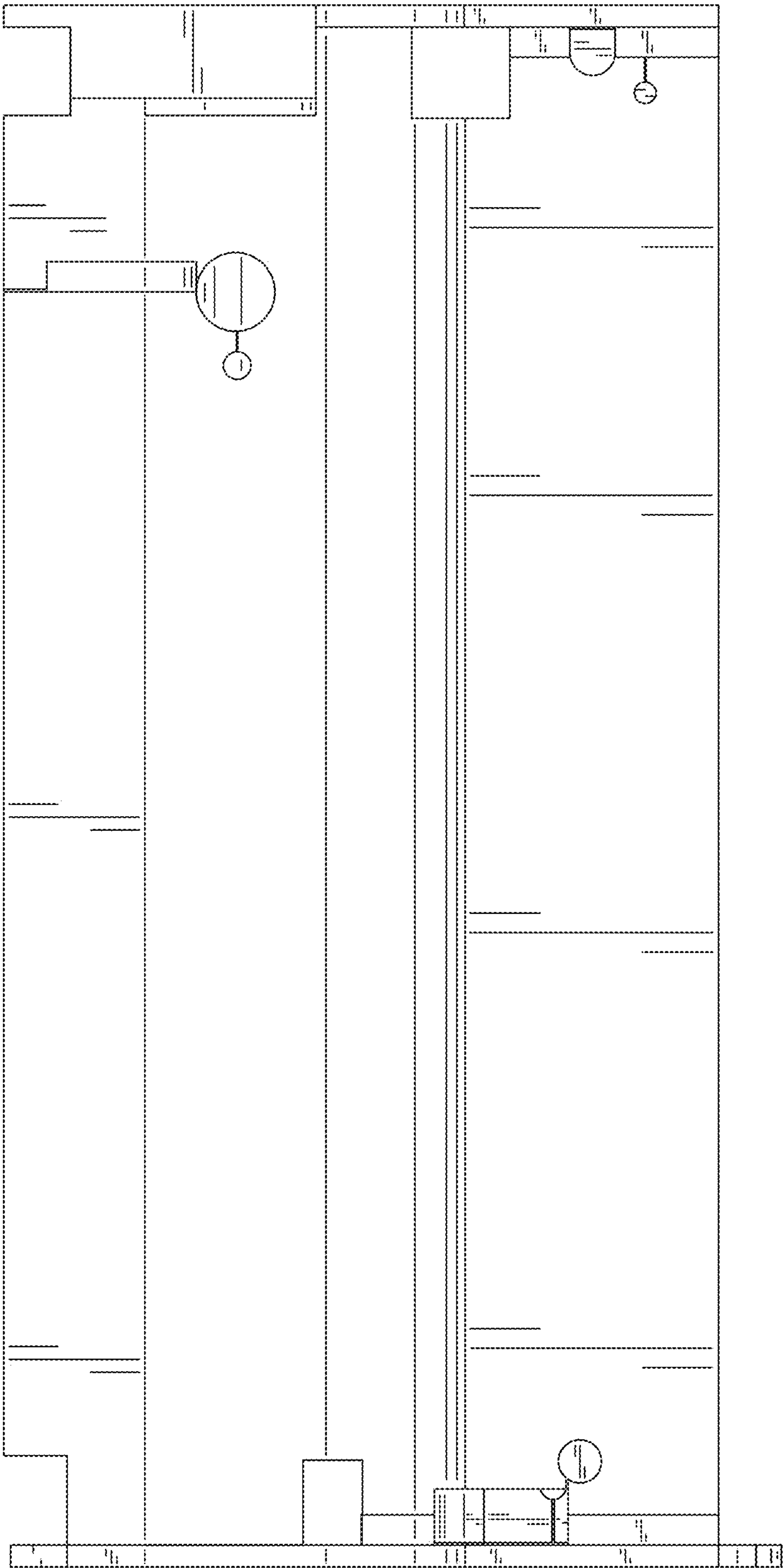

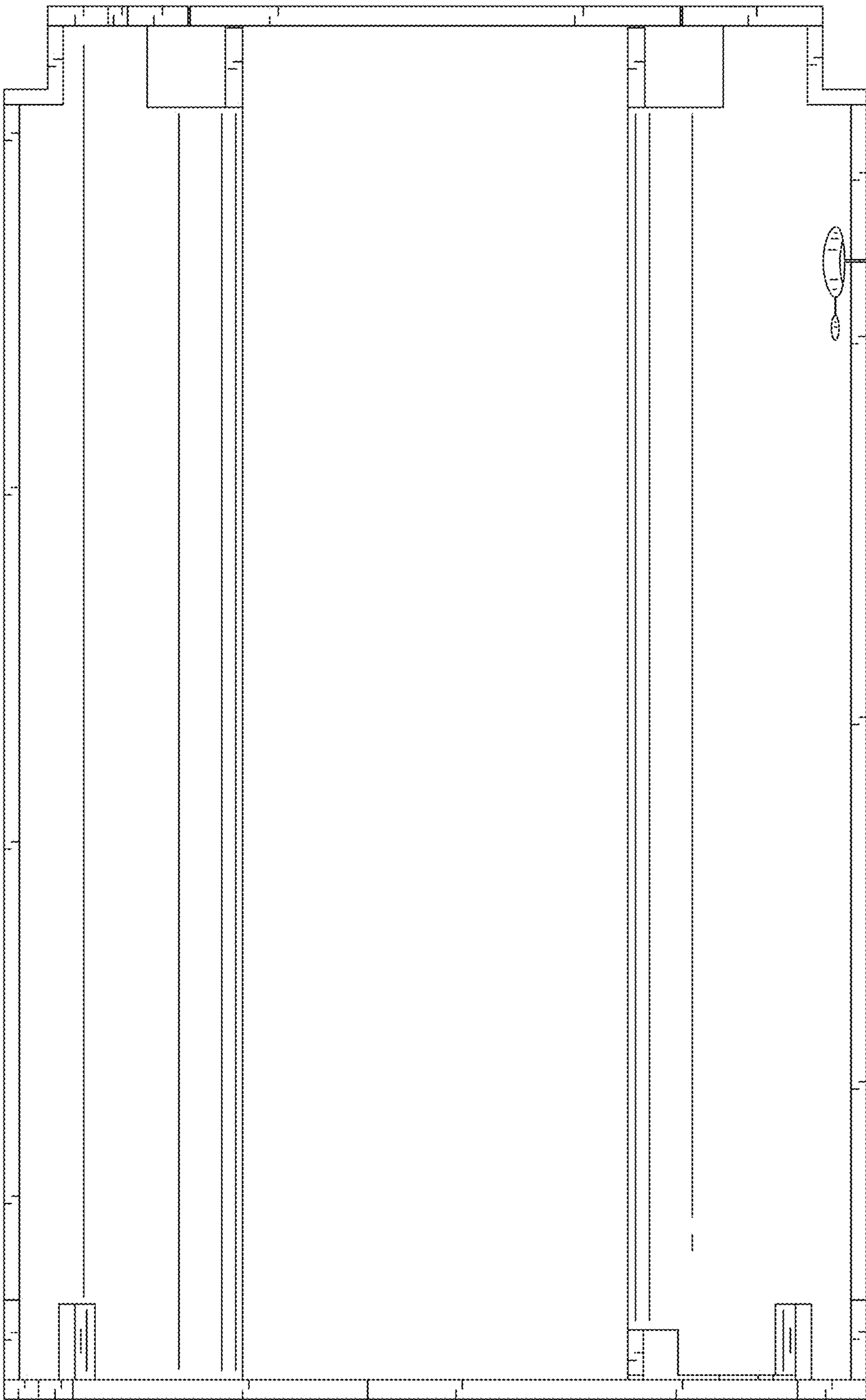

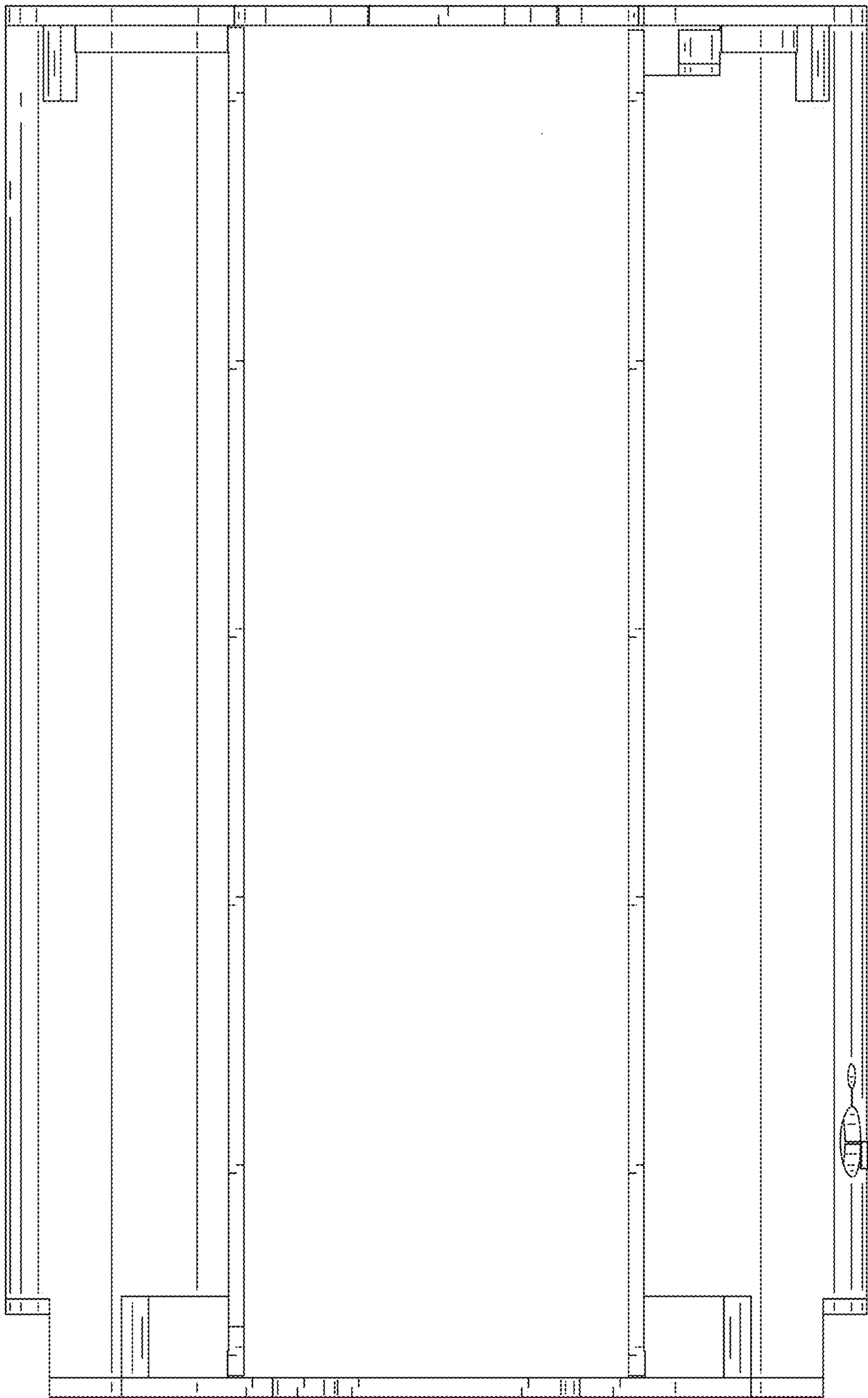
