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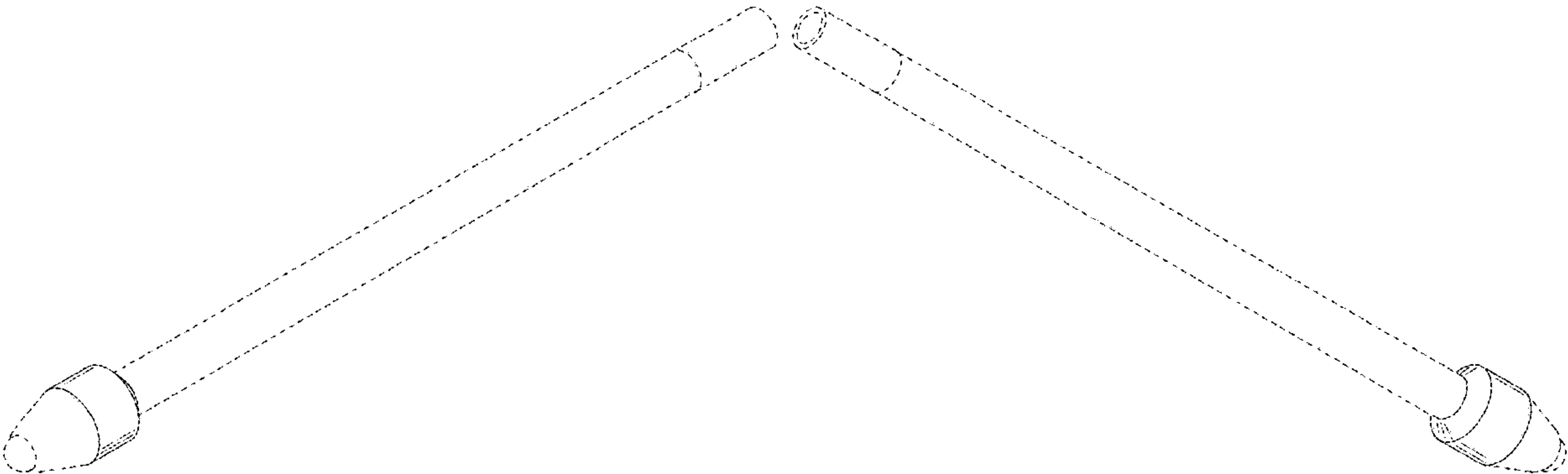
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top-front-left perspective view of a nib for a digital stylus according to an embodiment of our new design;
FIG. 2 is bottom-rear-right perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, wherein the rear elevational view is a mirror image the front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, wherein the bottom plan view is a mirror image of the top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The broken lines in the figures depict portions of the nib for a digital stylus that form no part of the claimed design.

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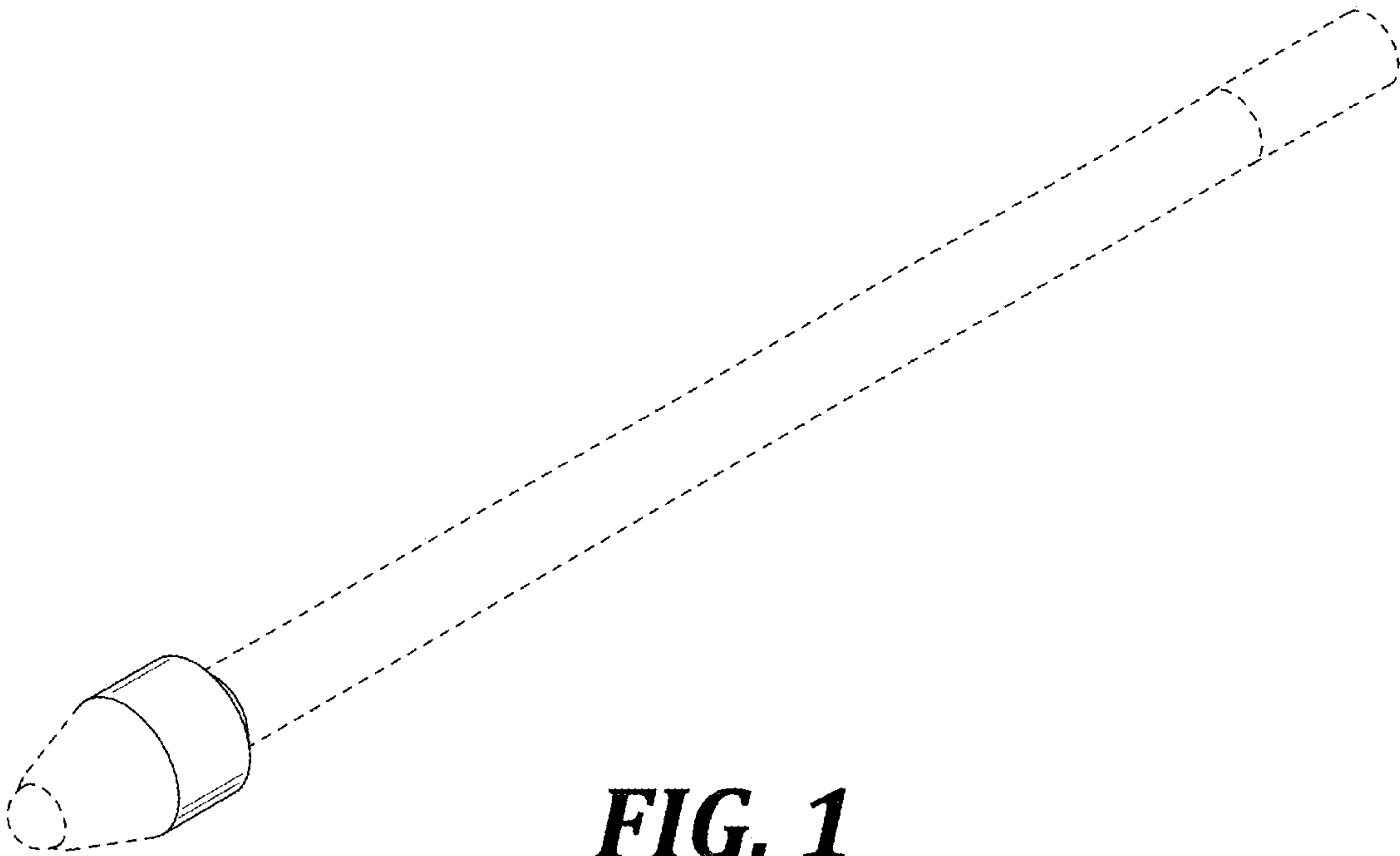

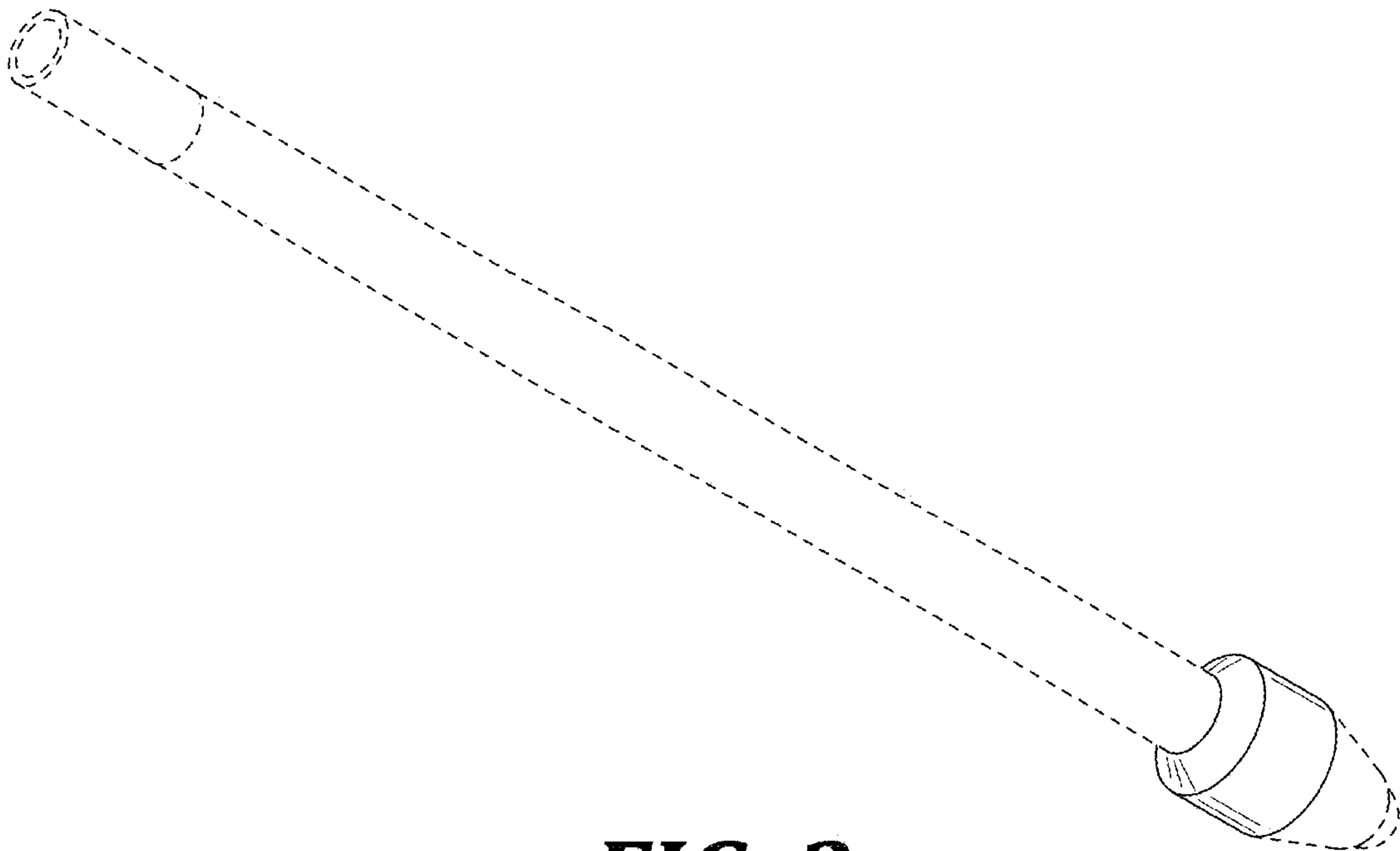

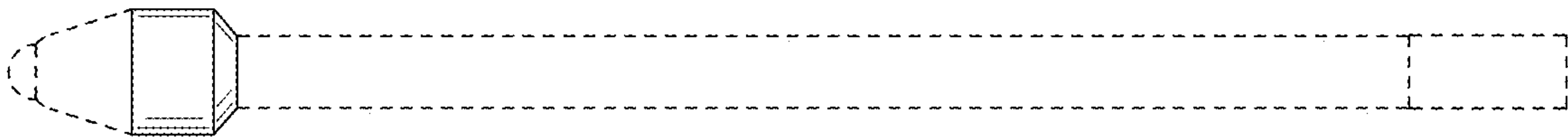

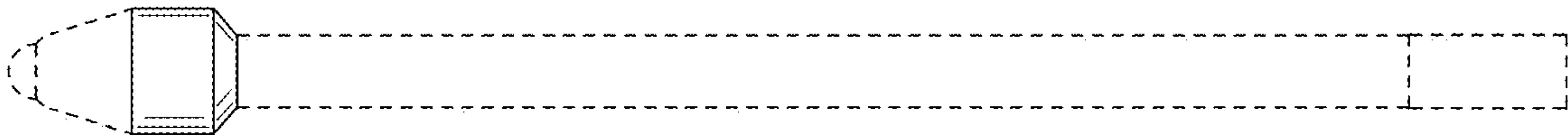

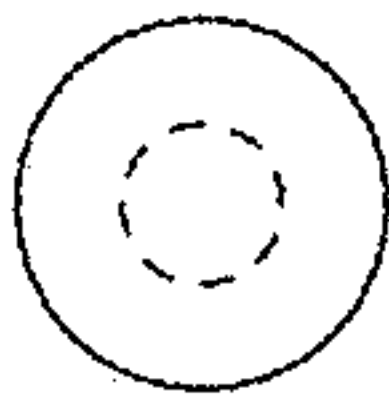

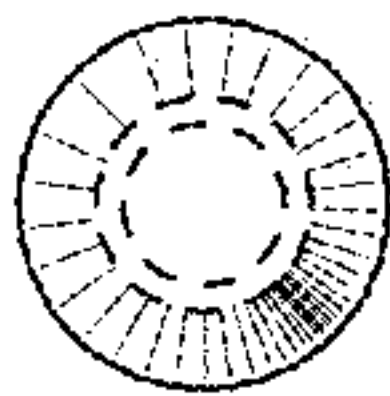
