FIG. 3 is a right side view of the claimed design.

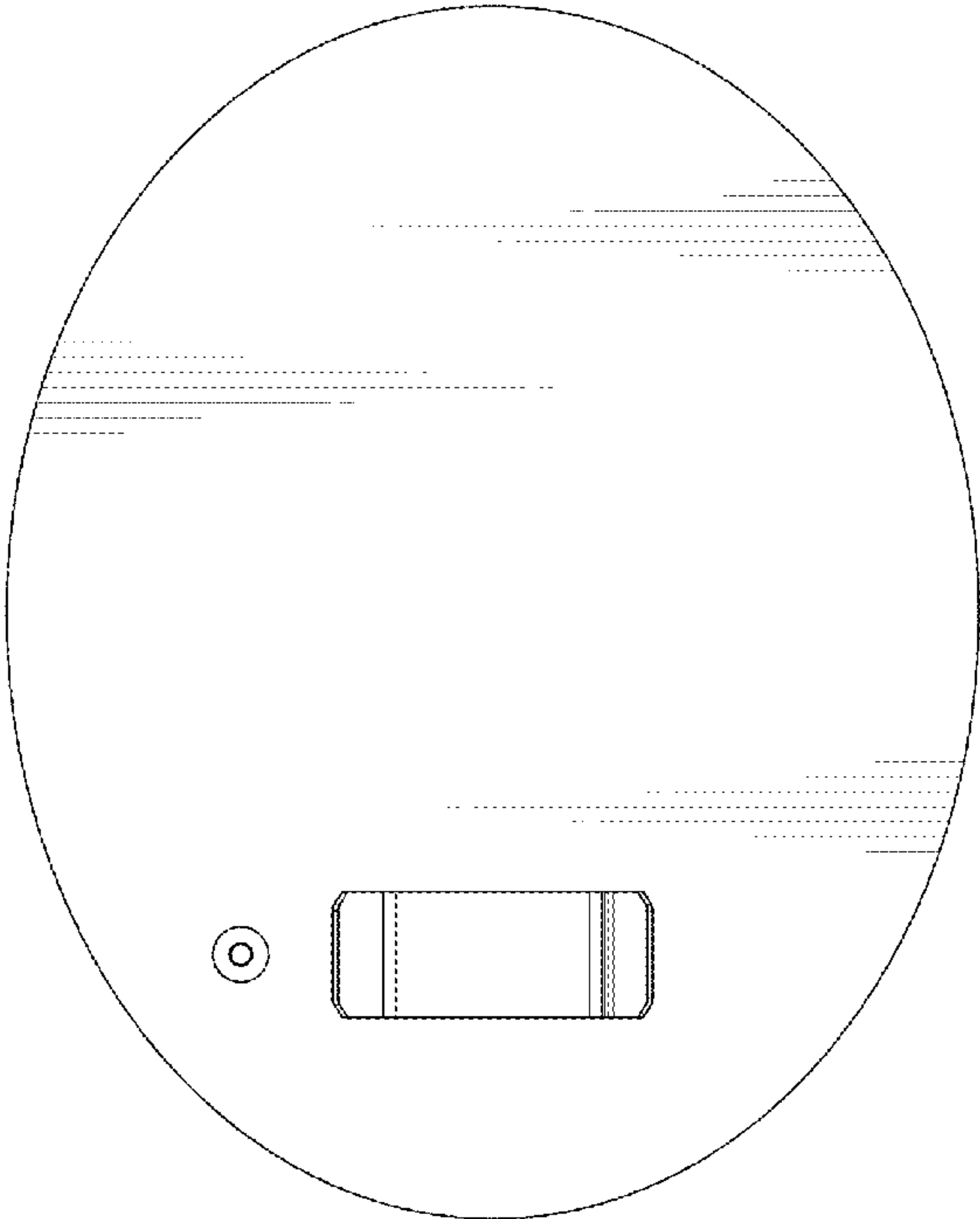
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the claimed design.

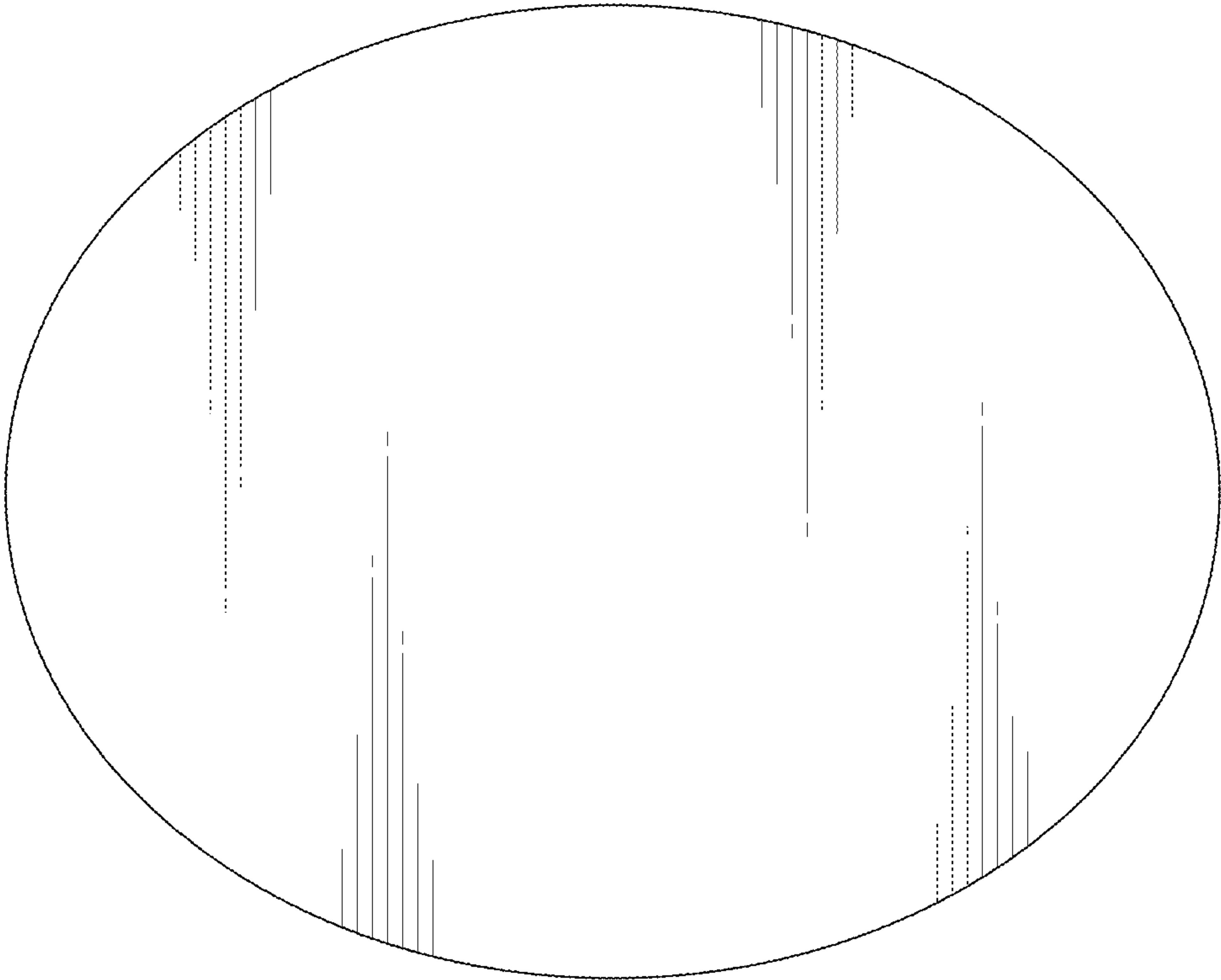

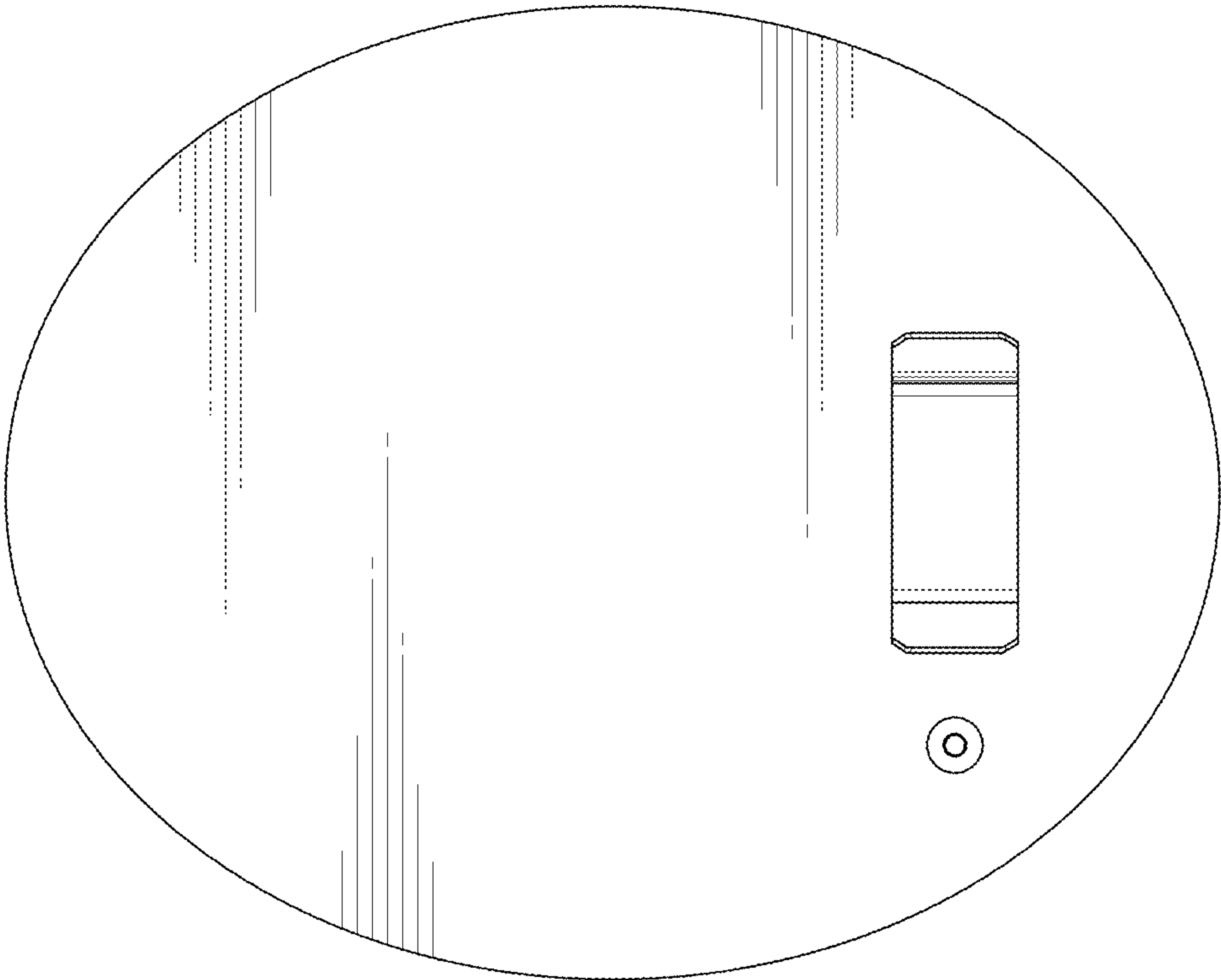

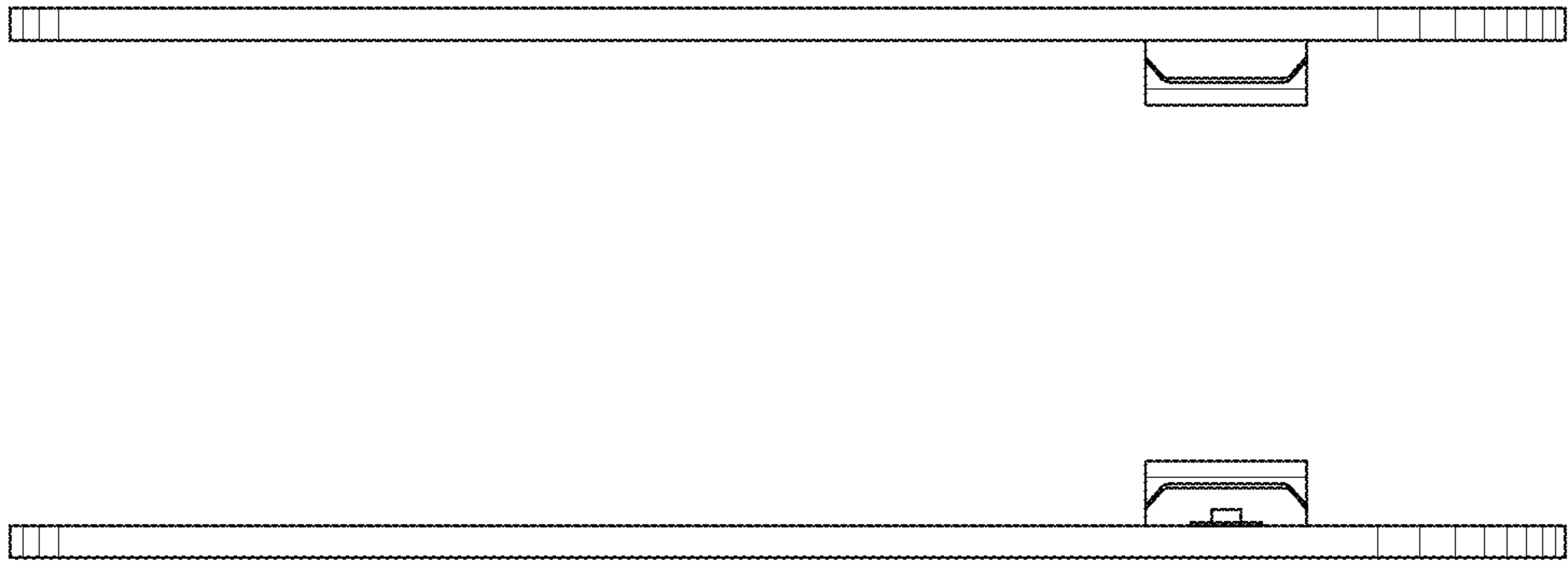

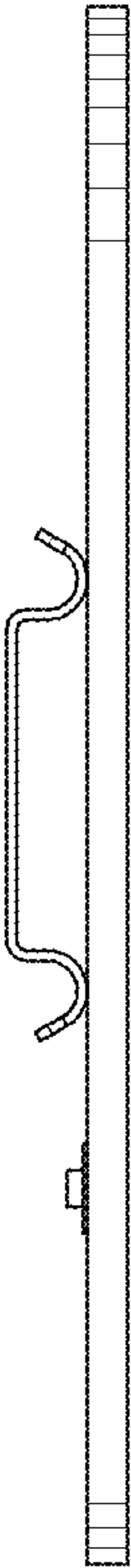

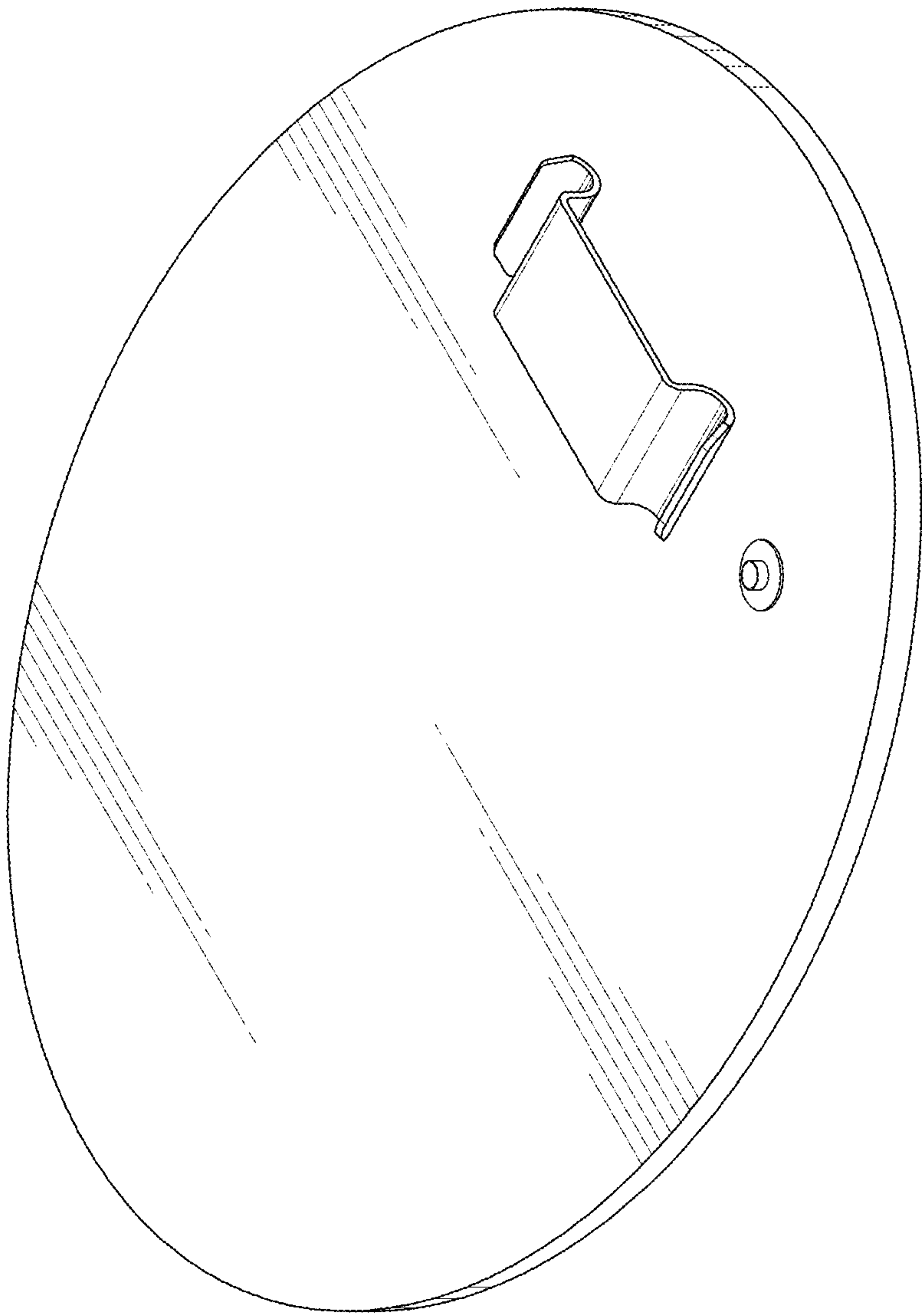
