The ornamental design for a sample tray assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the sample tray assembly showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1;

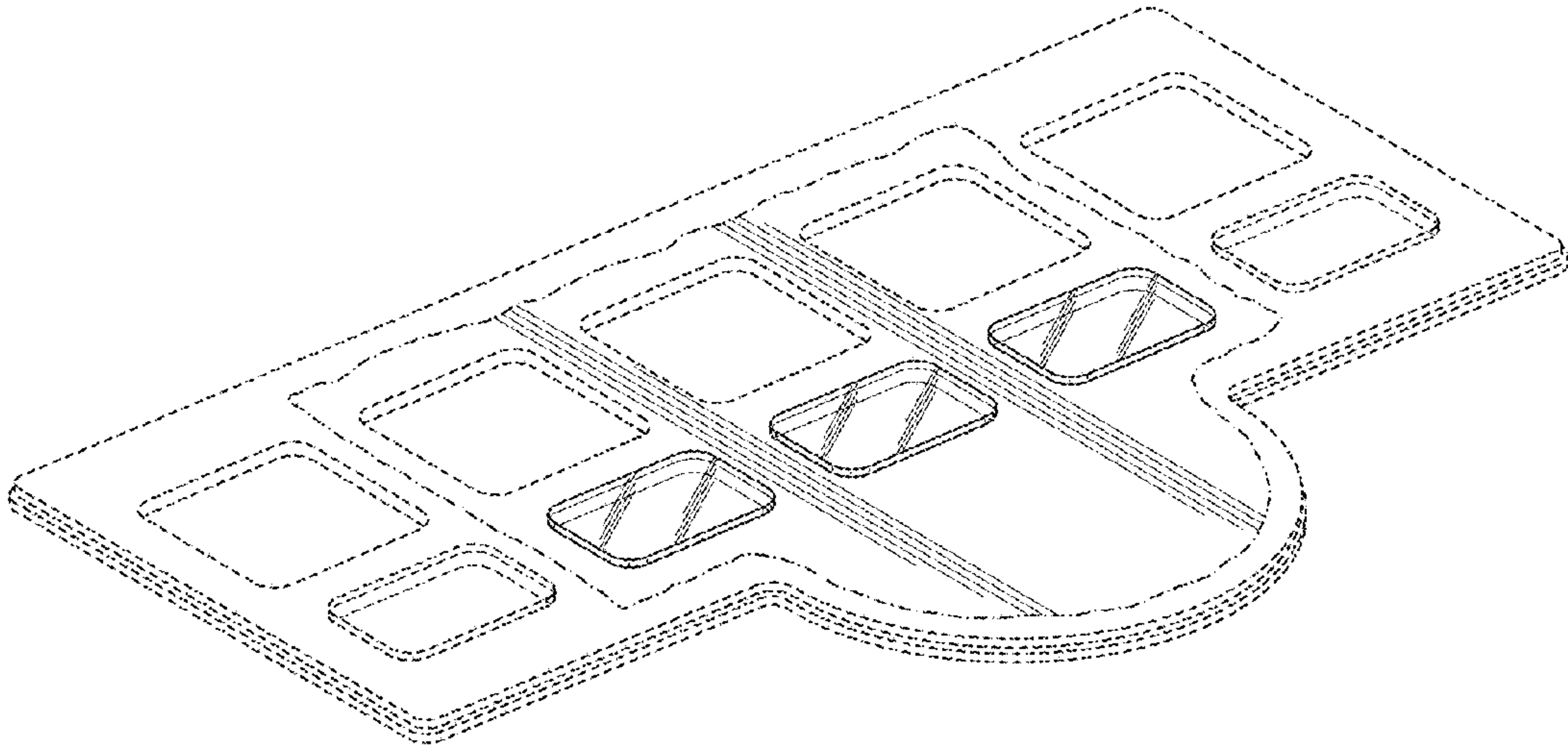
FIG. 6 is a right side view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a left side view of the sample tray assembly shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the sample tray assembly of FIG. 1 shown in an alternate configuration of use and in an environment of use.

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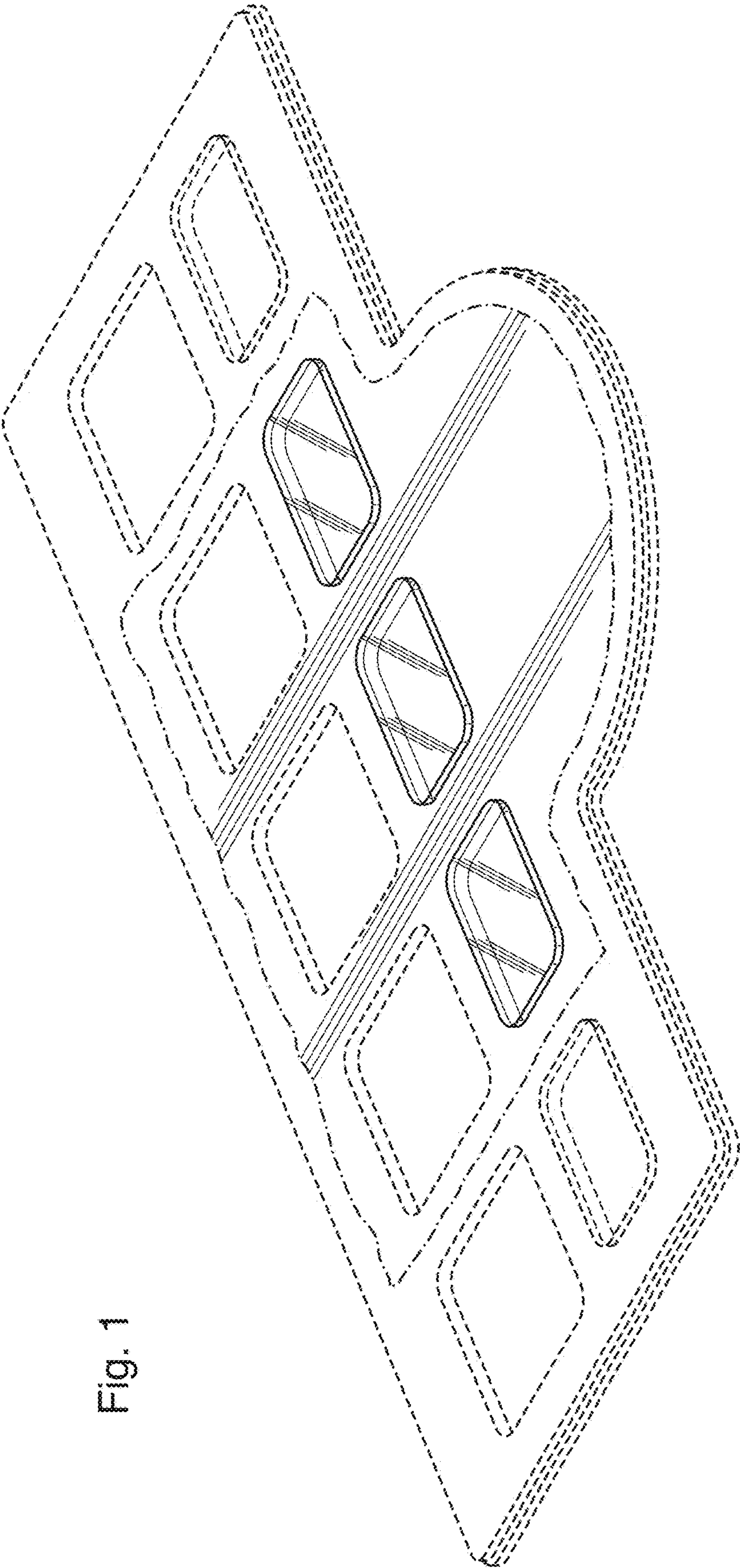

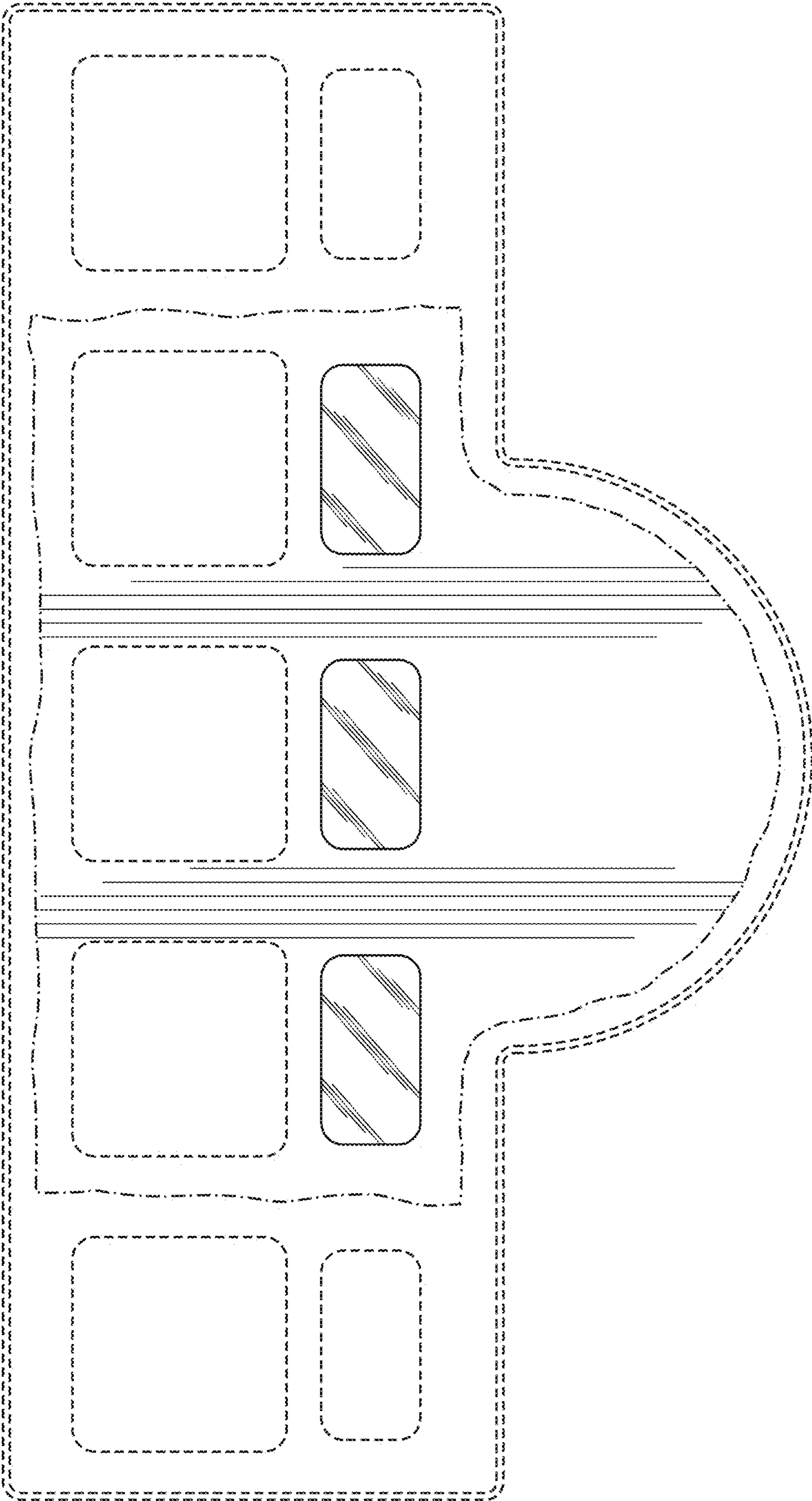

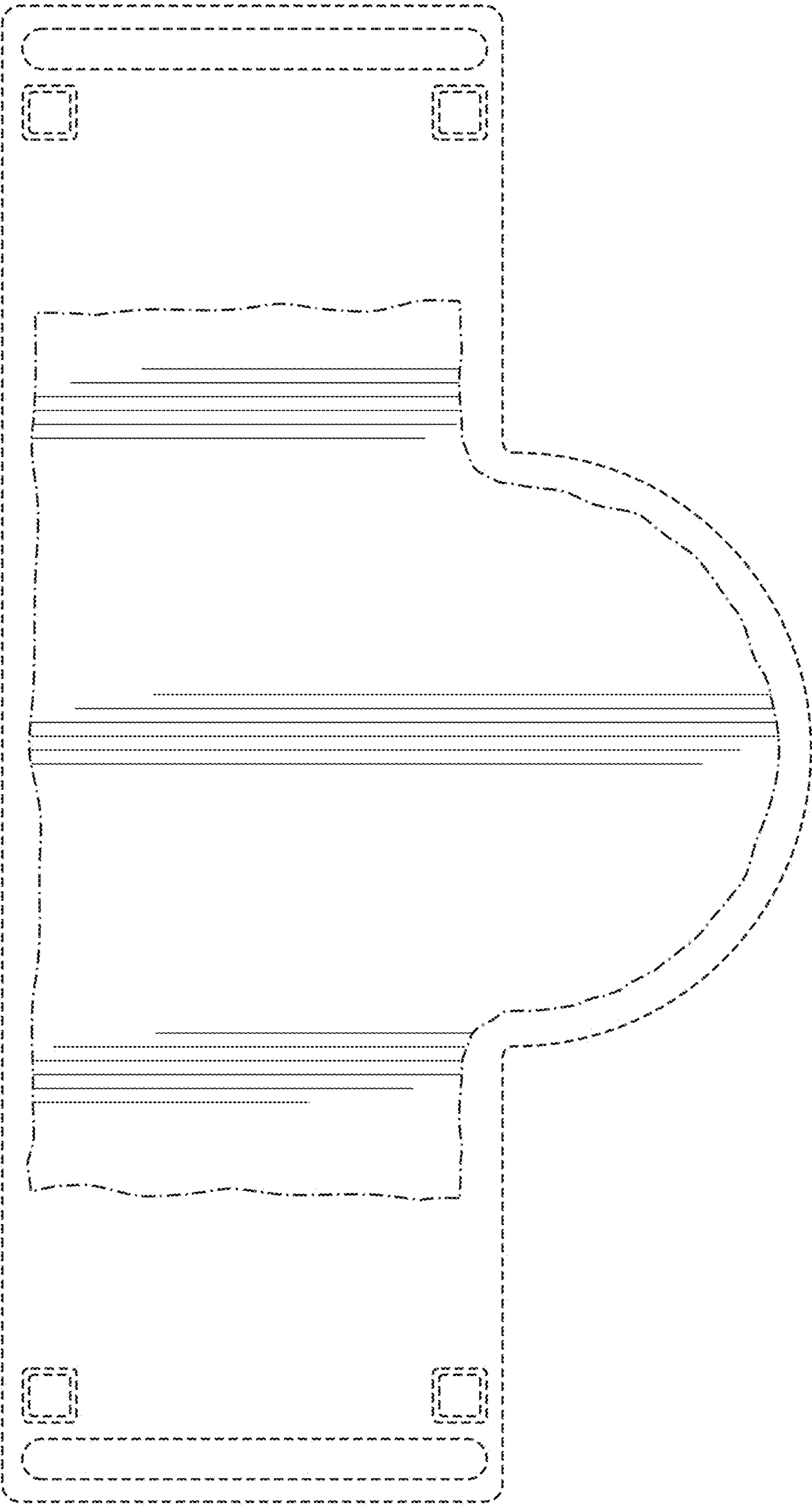

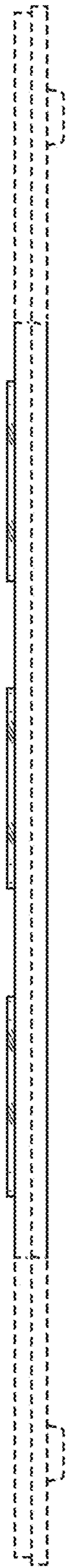

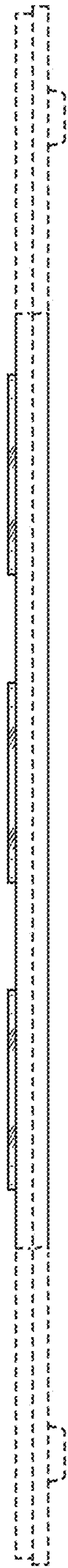

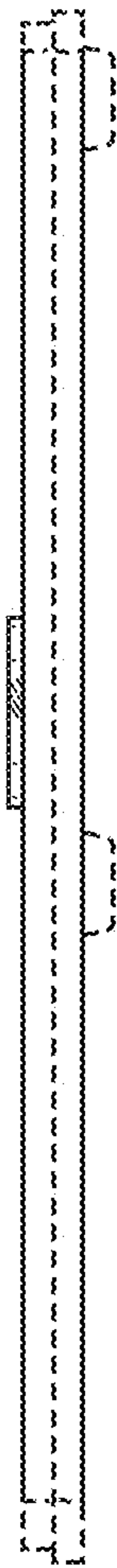

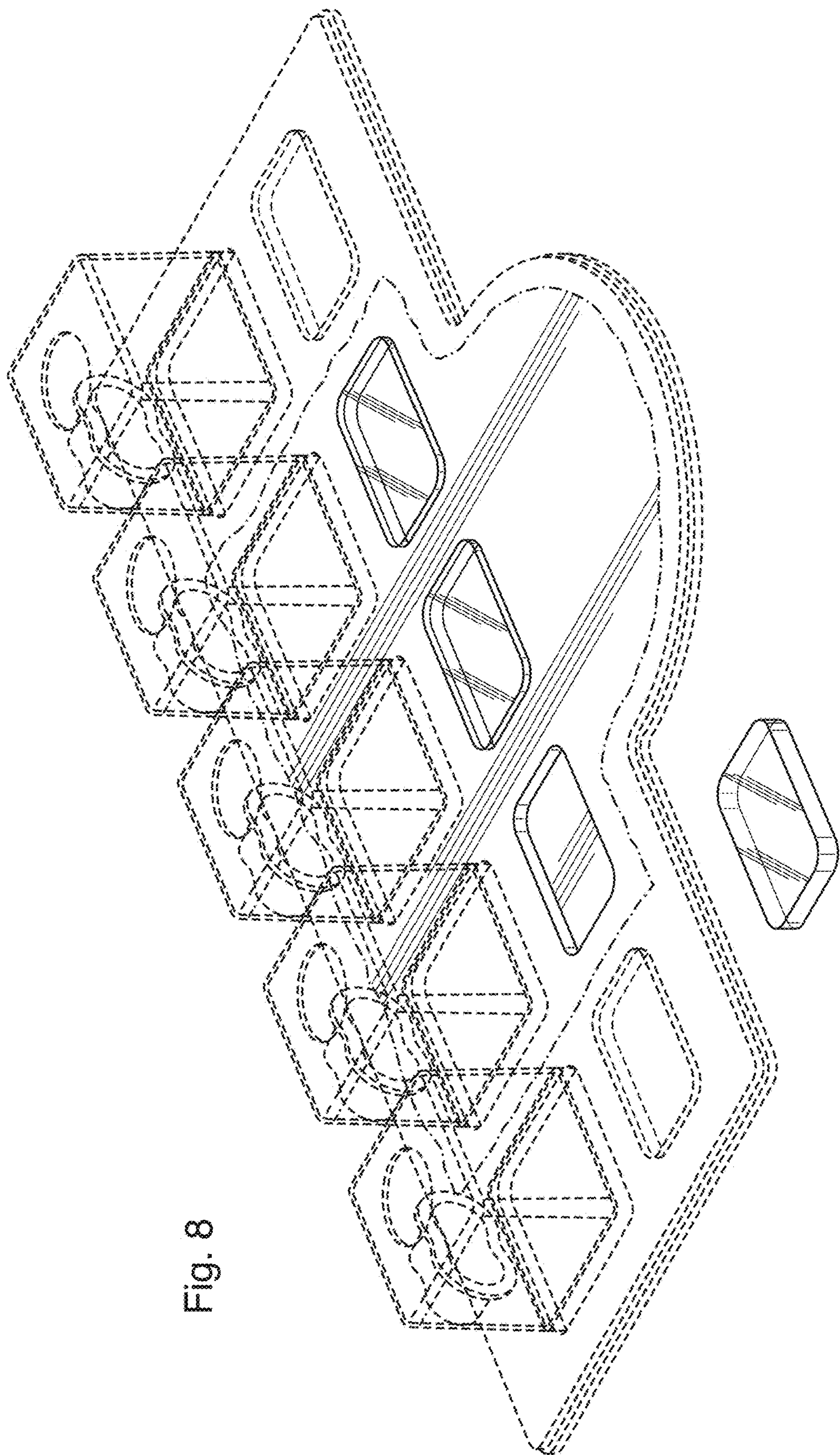
