FIG. 14 is a left-side view of the construction block.

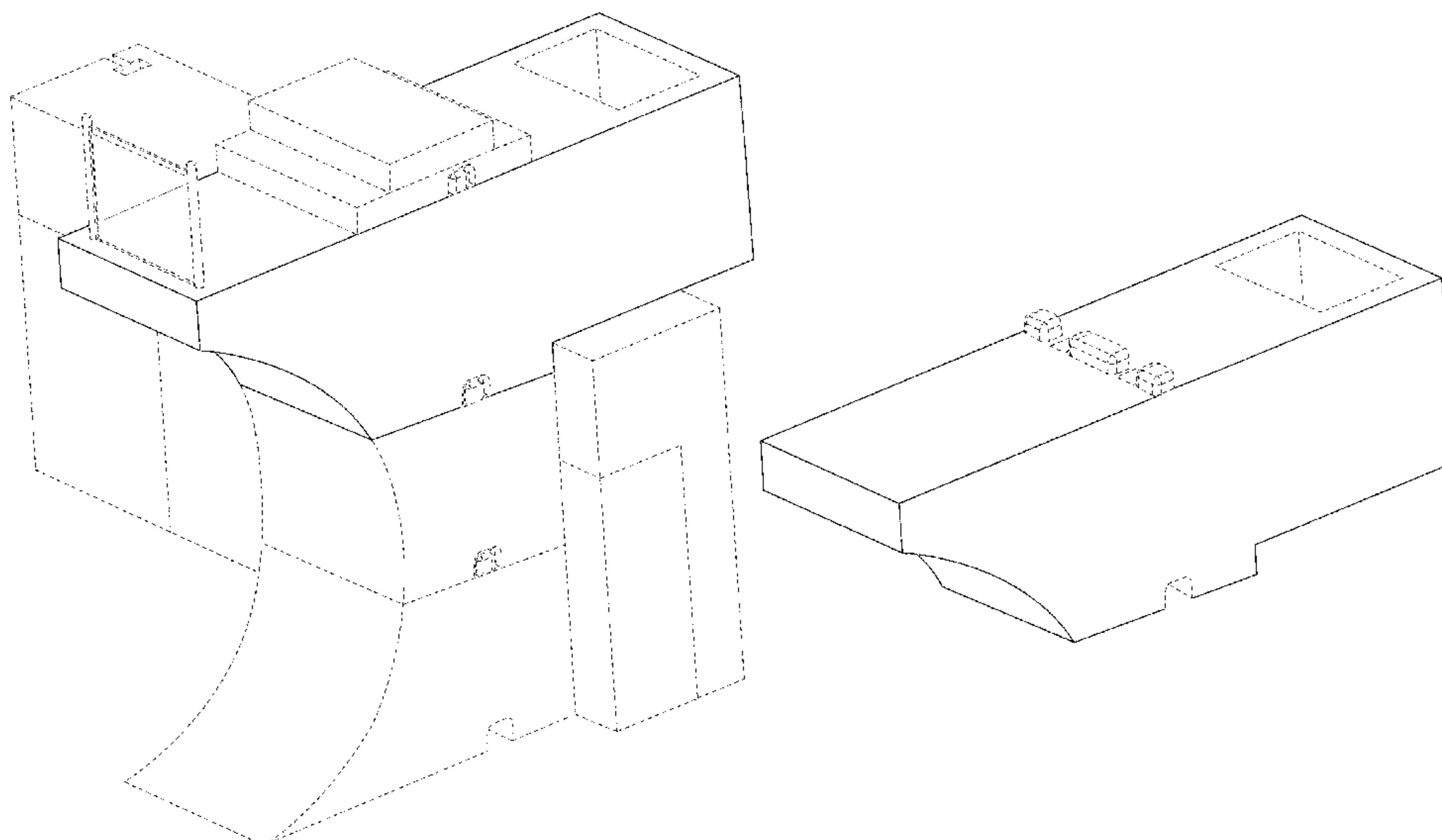
FIG. 15 is a front view of the construction block; and,

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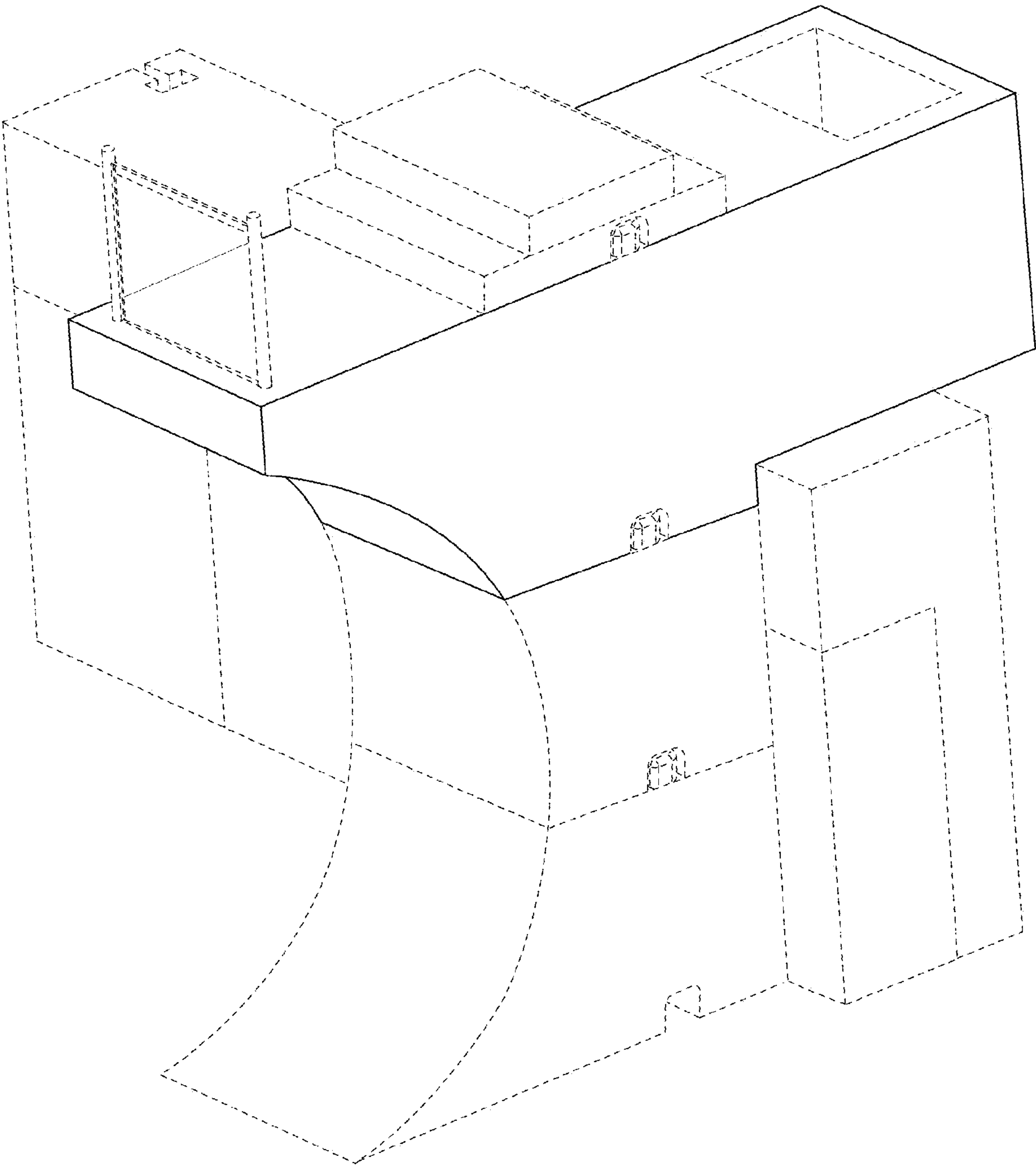

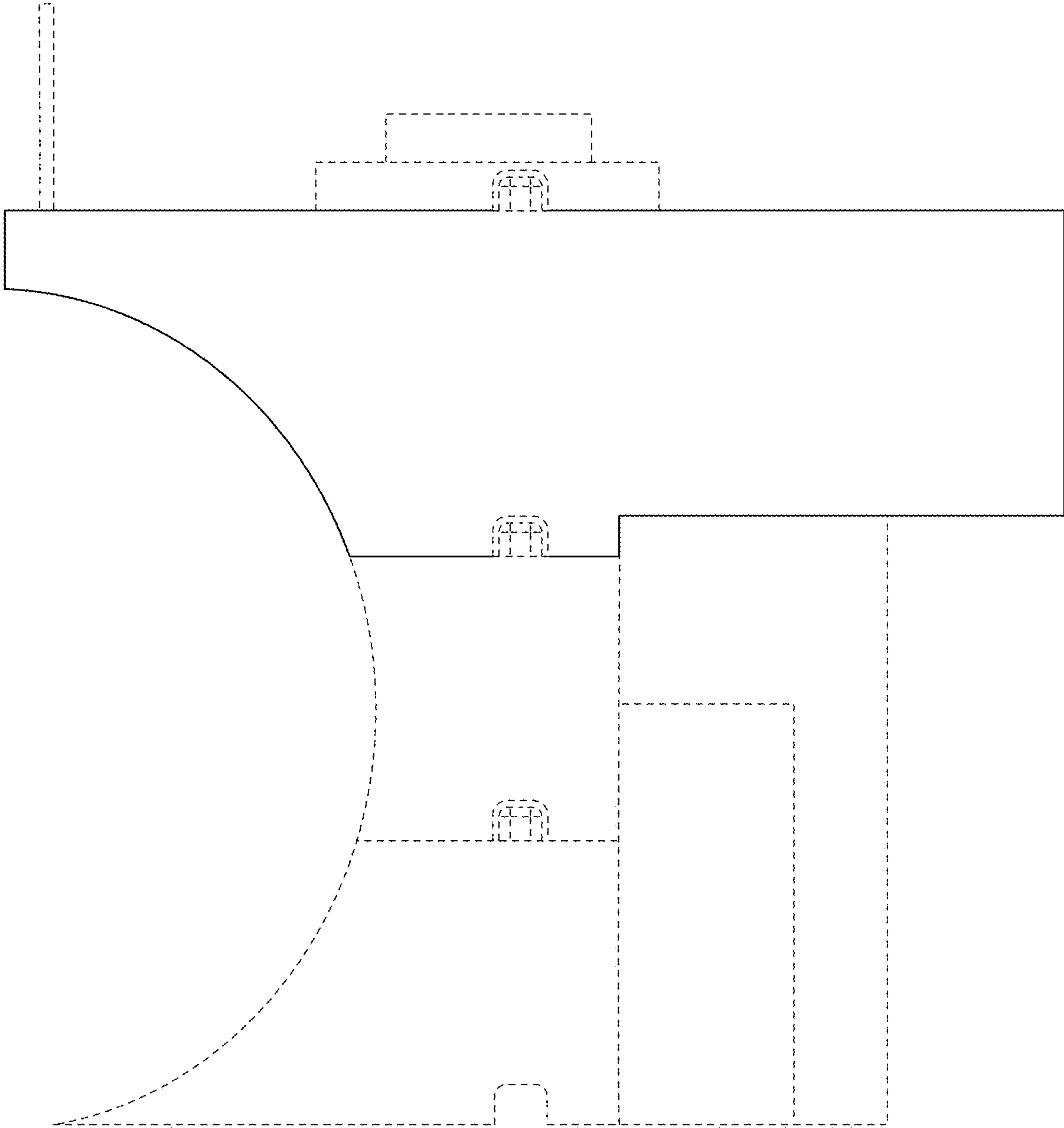

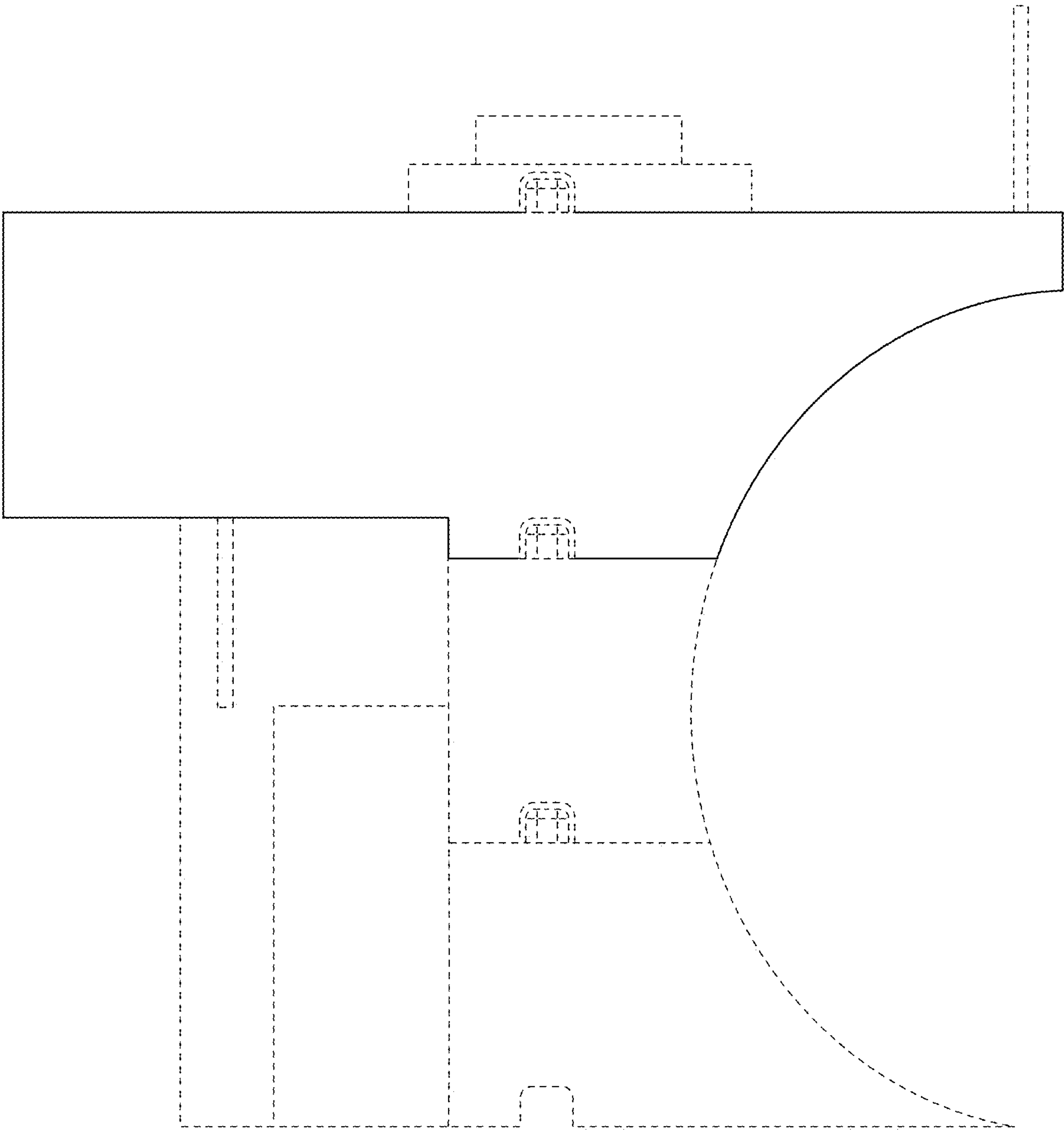

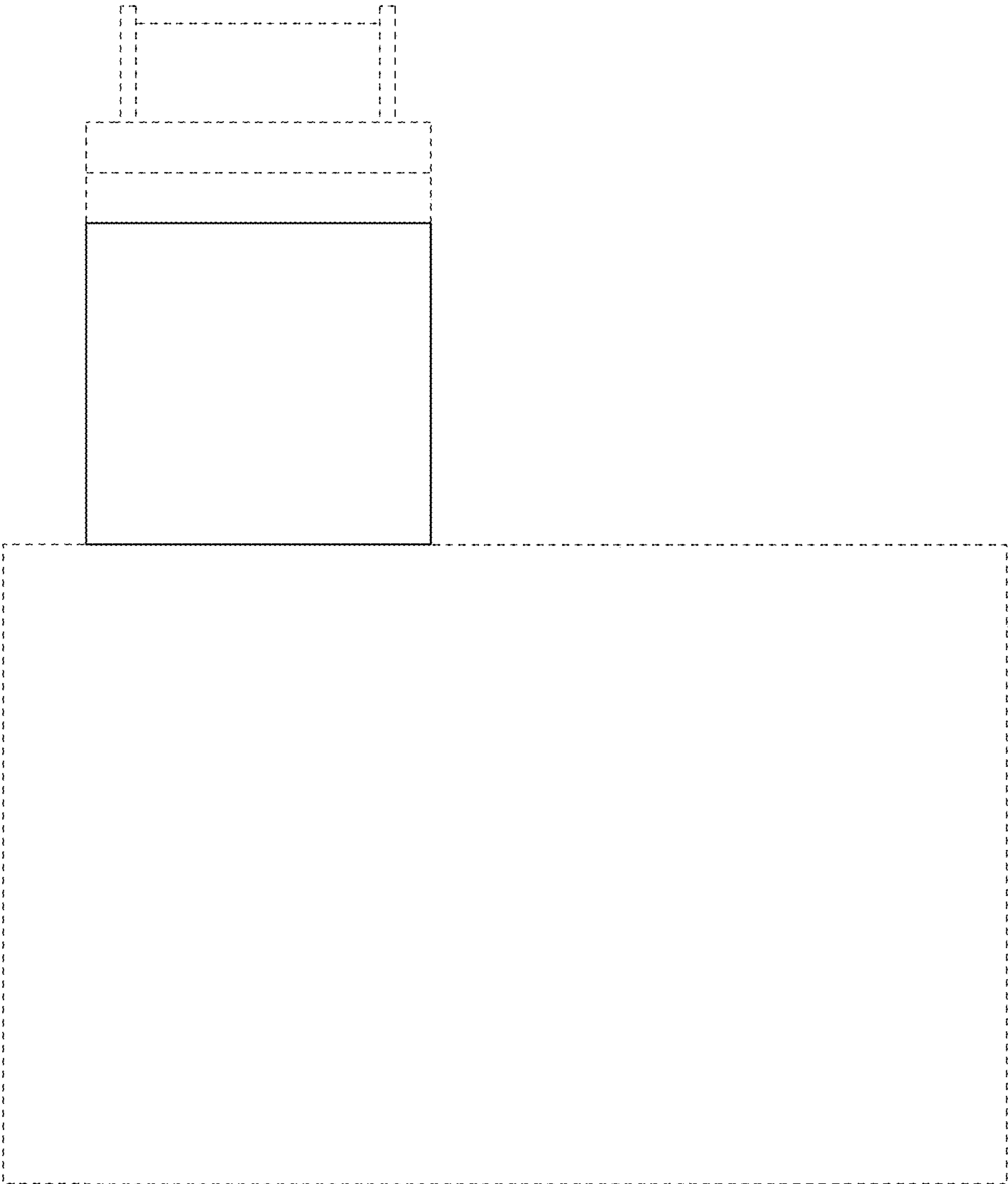

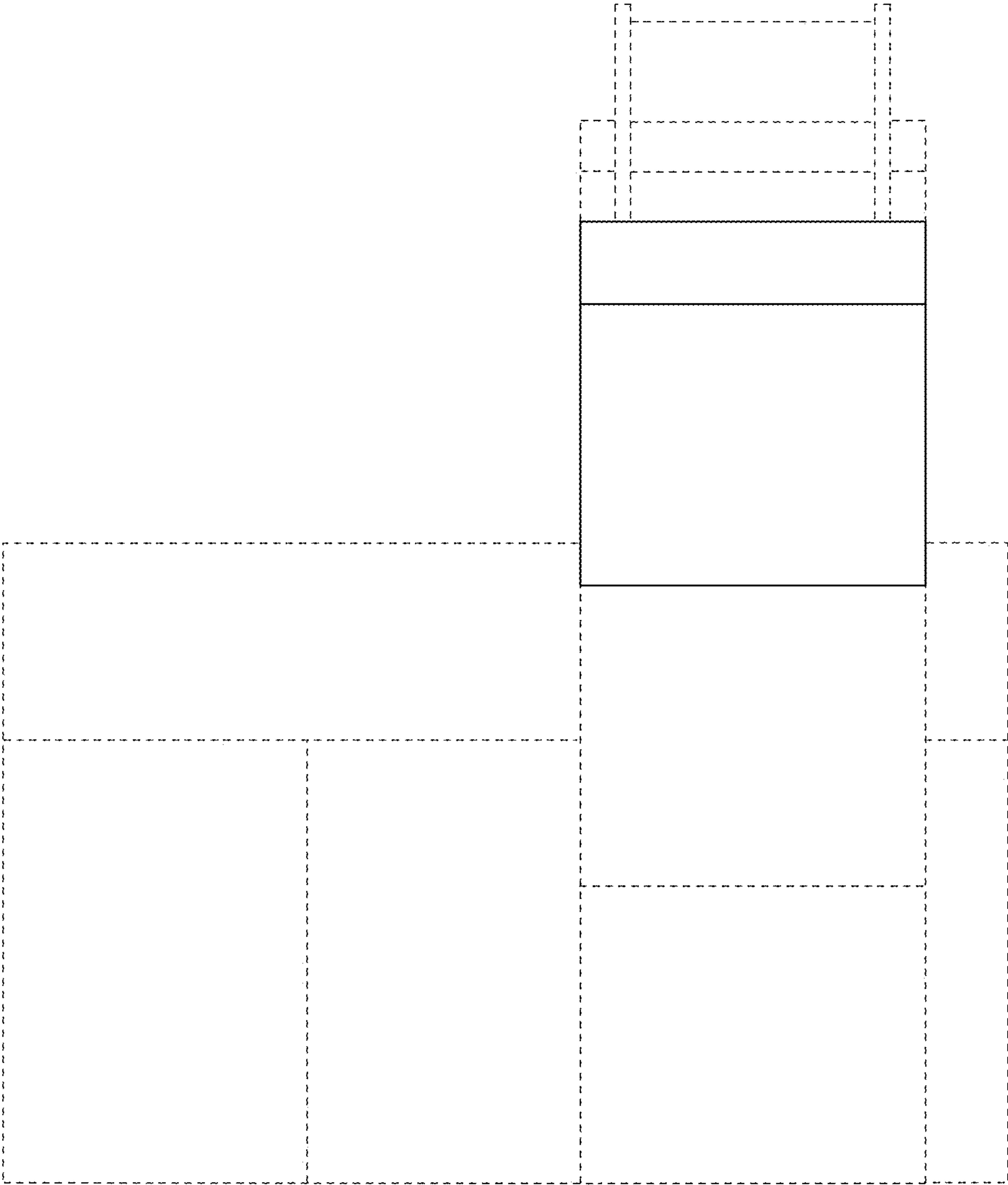

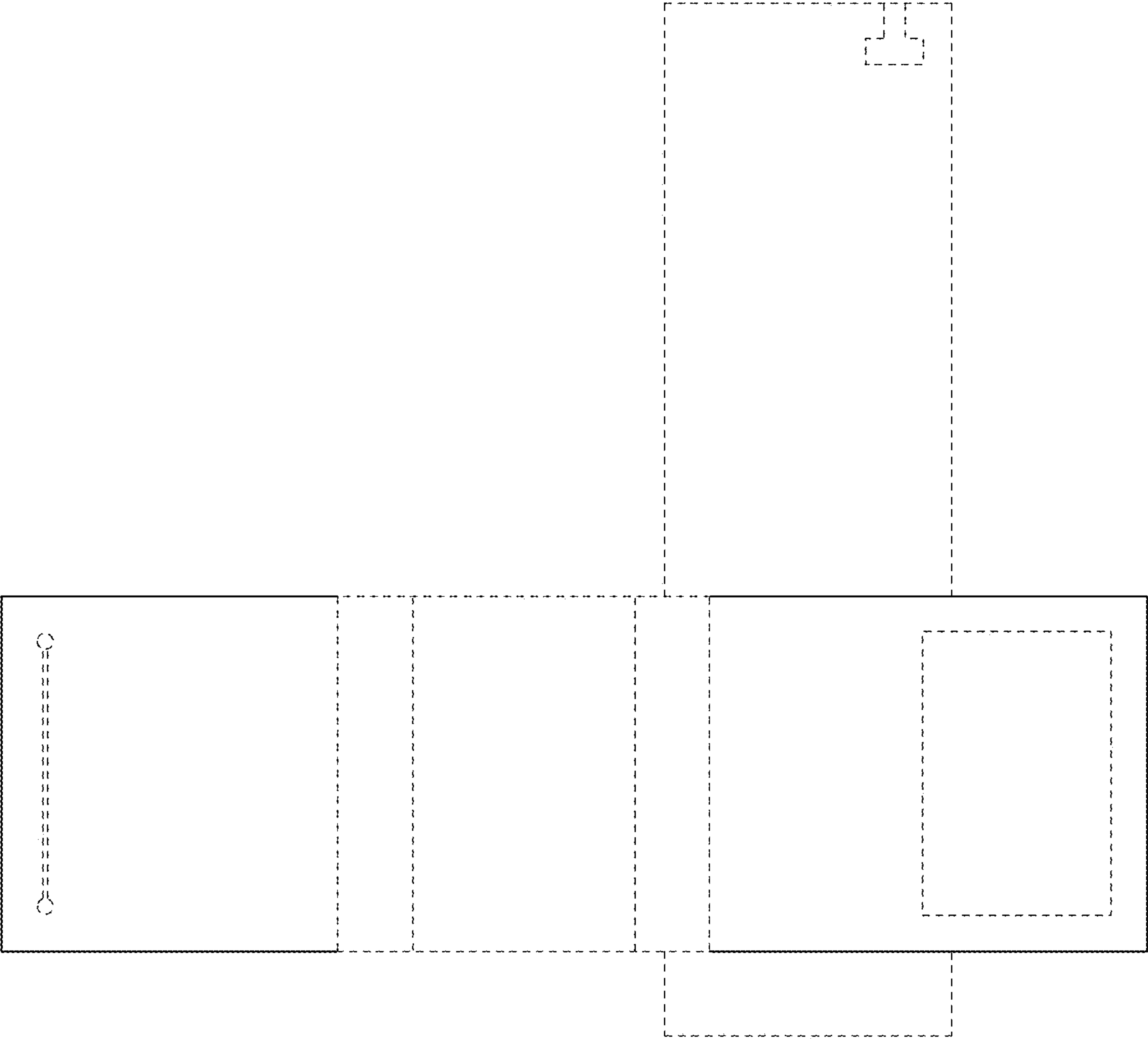

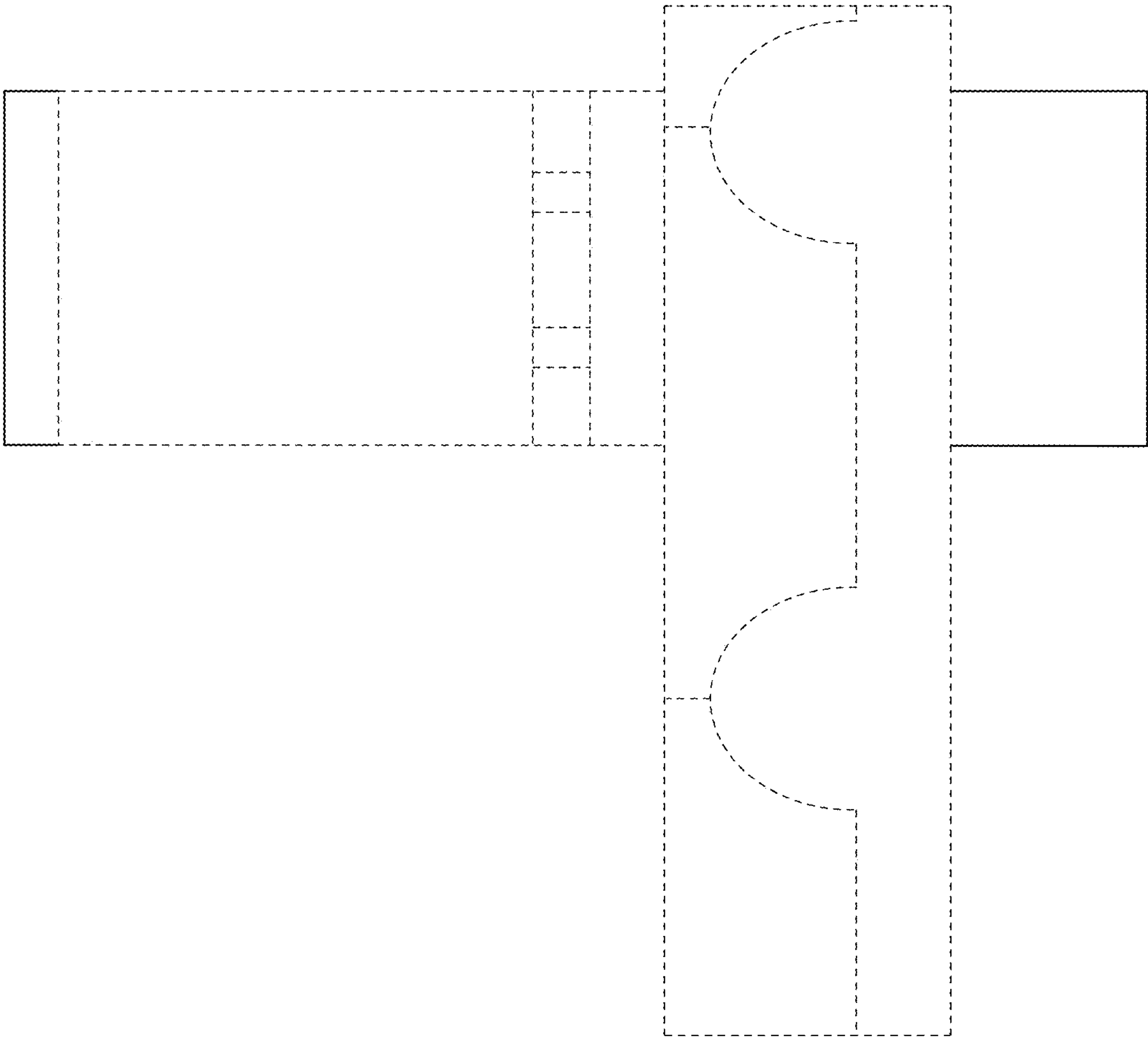

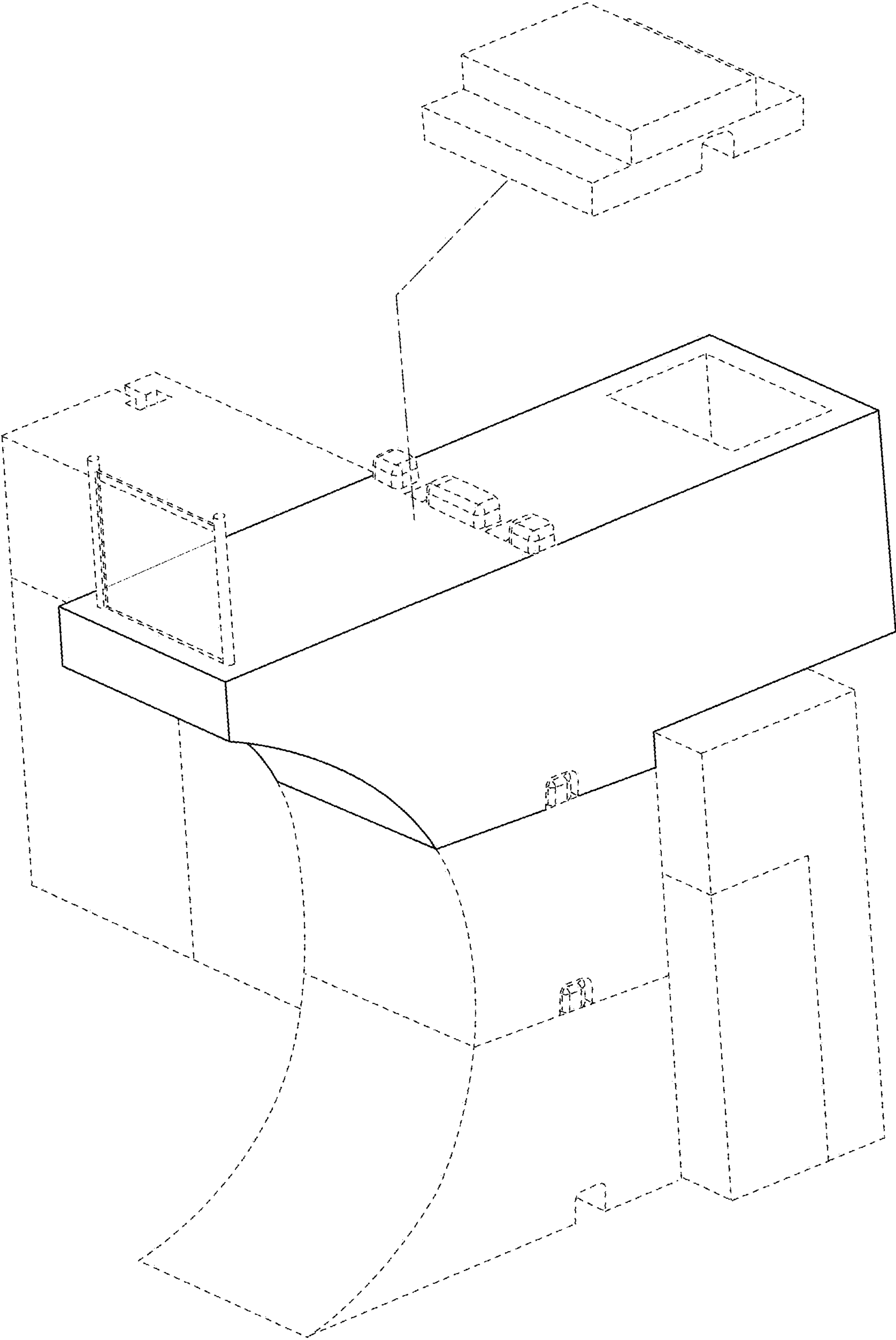

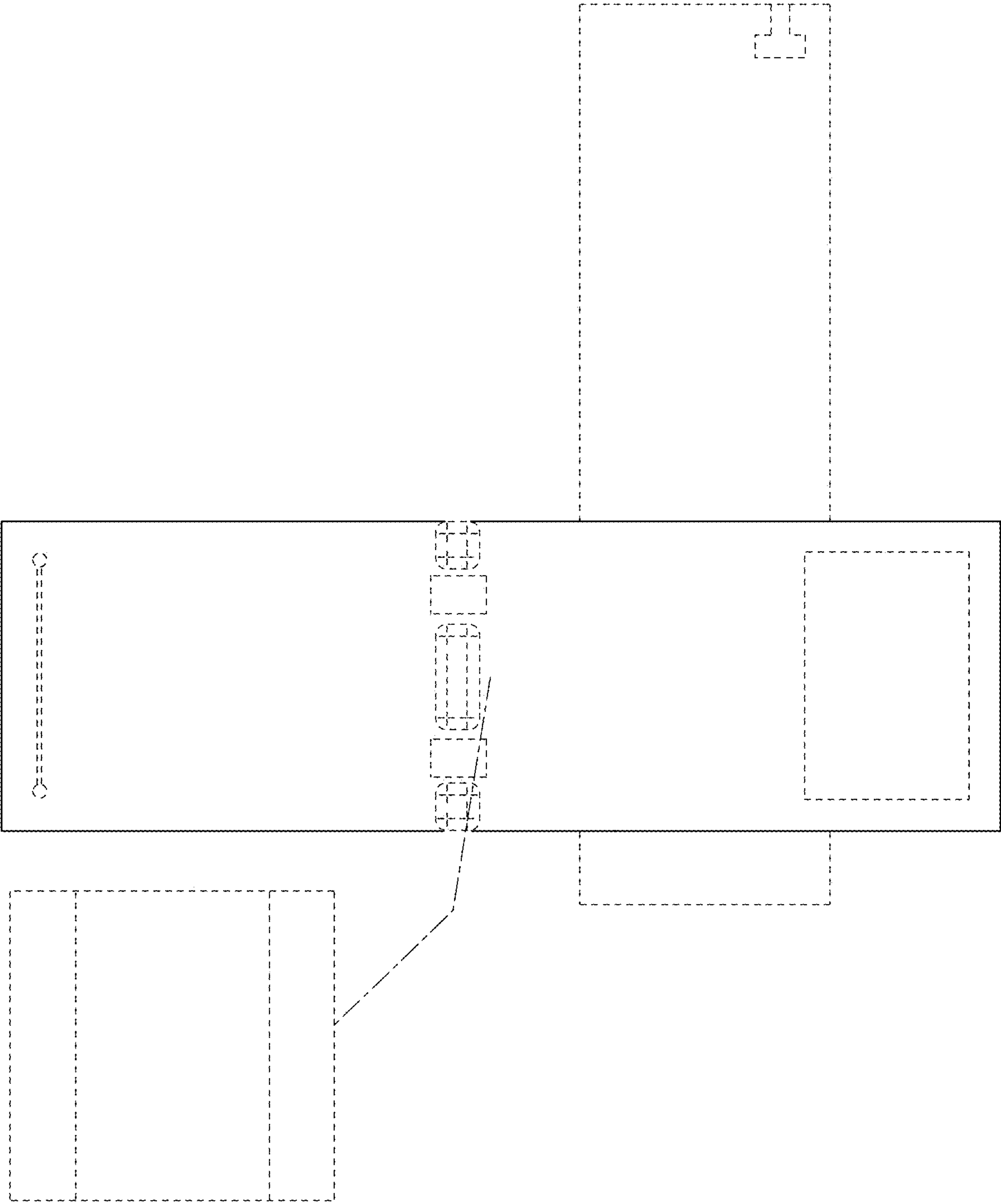

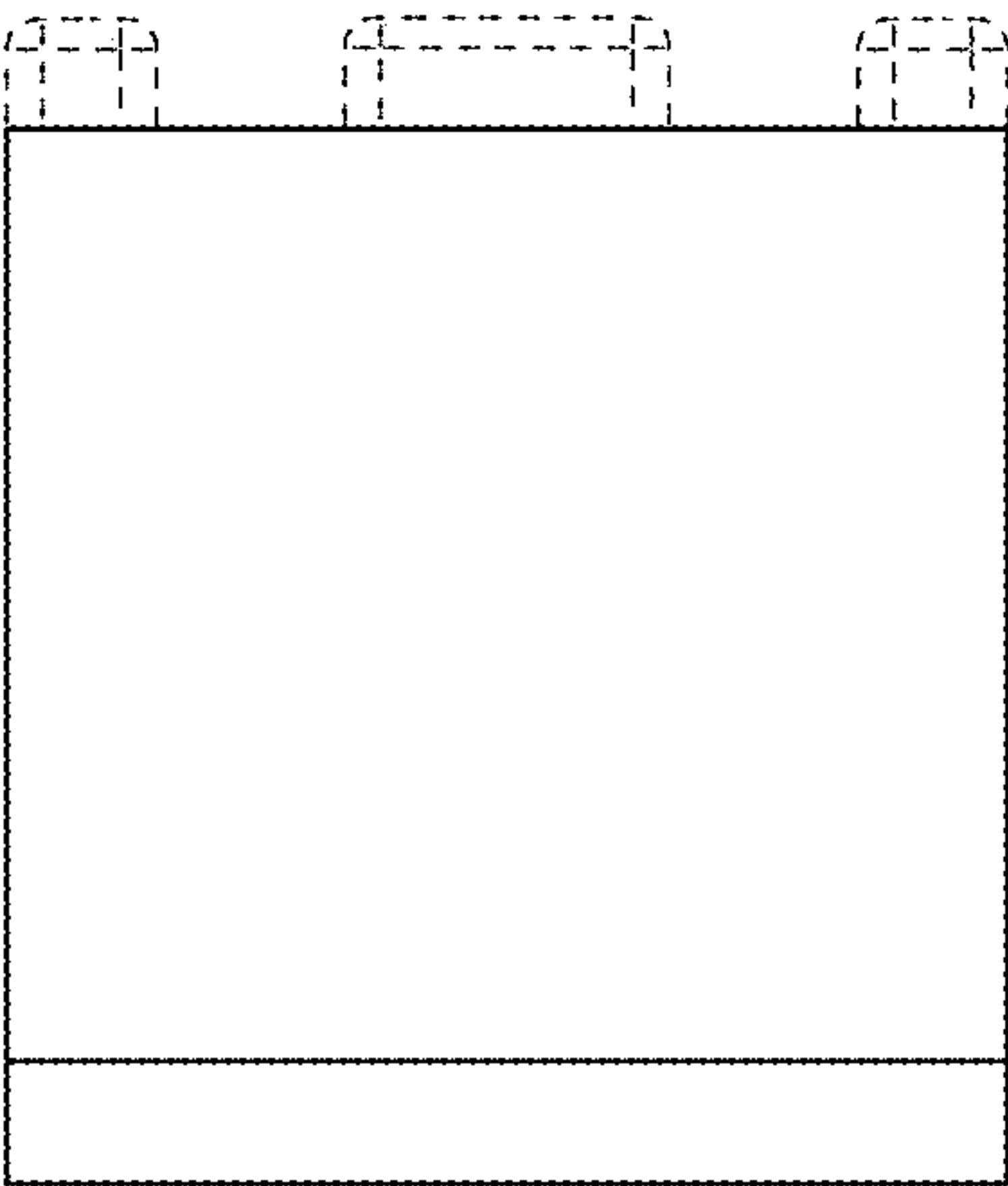

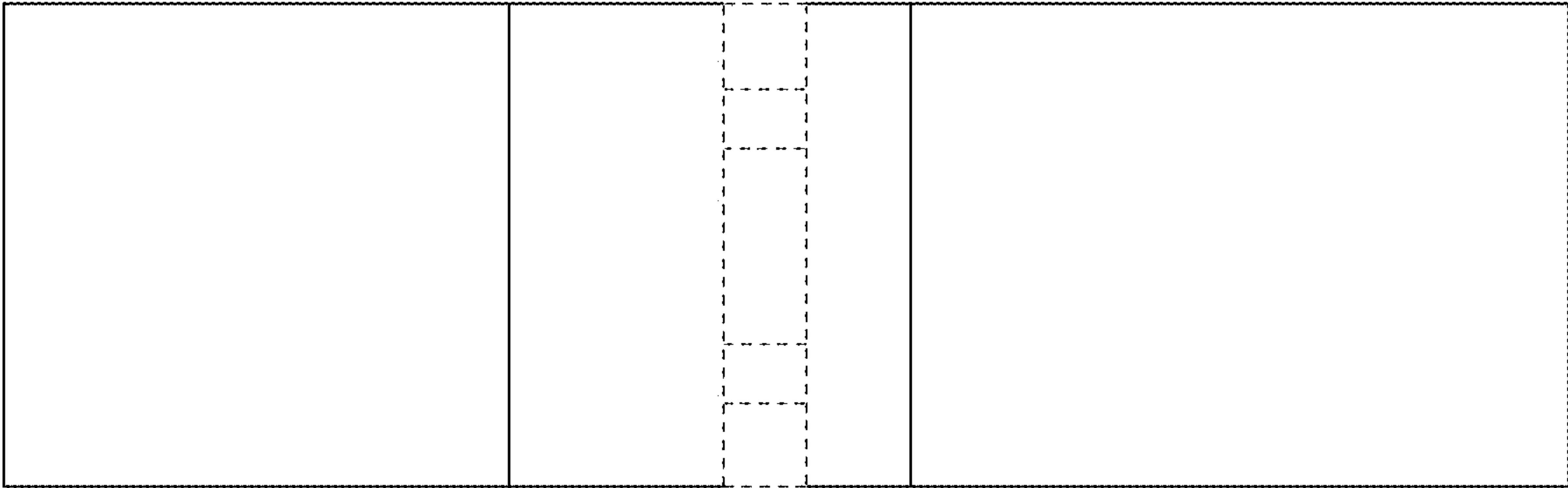

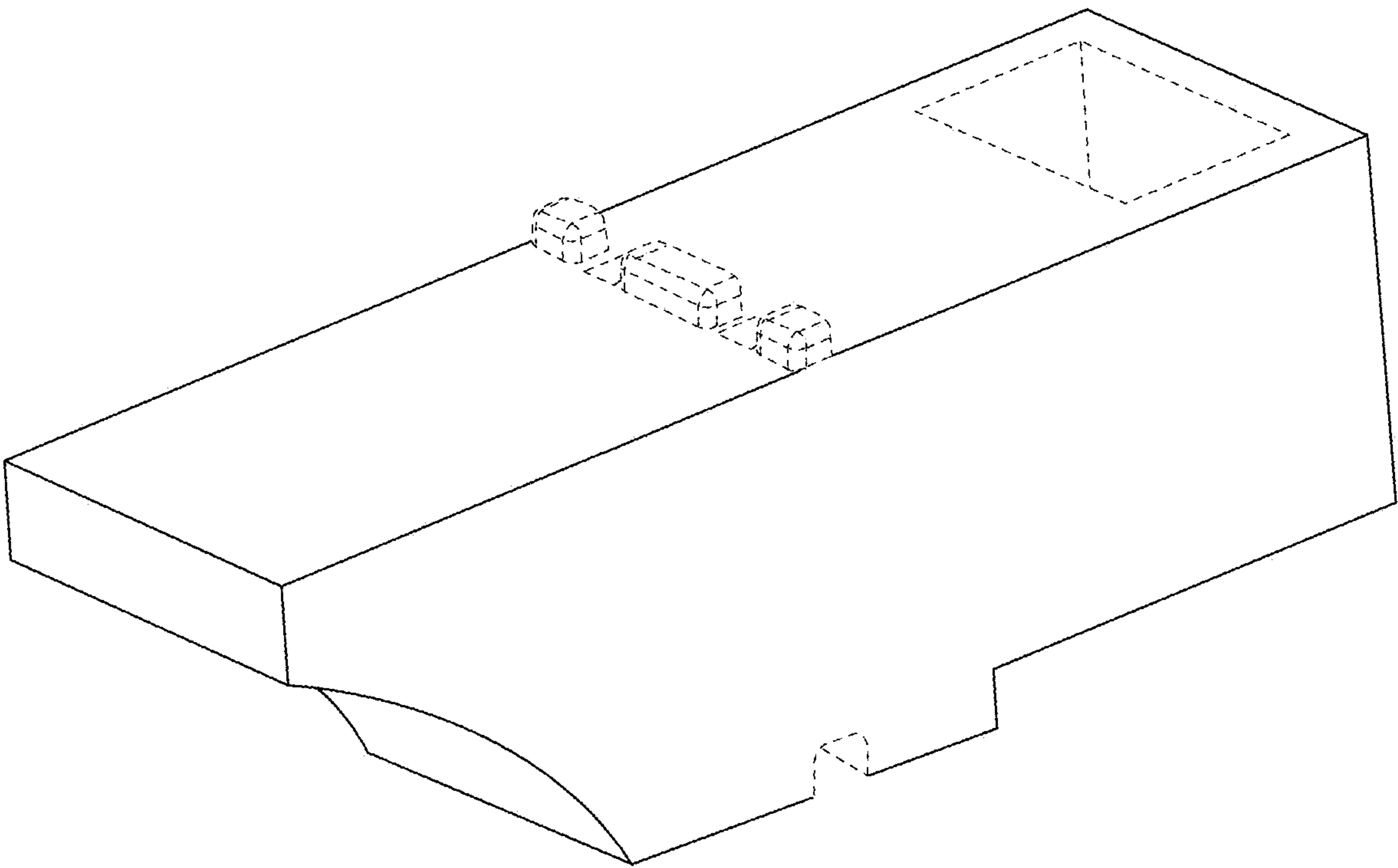

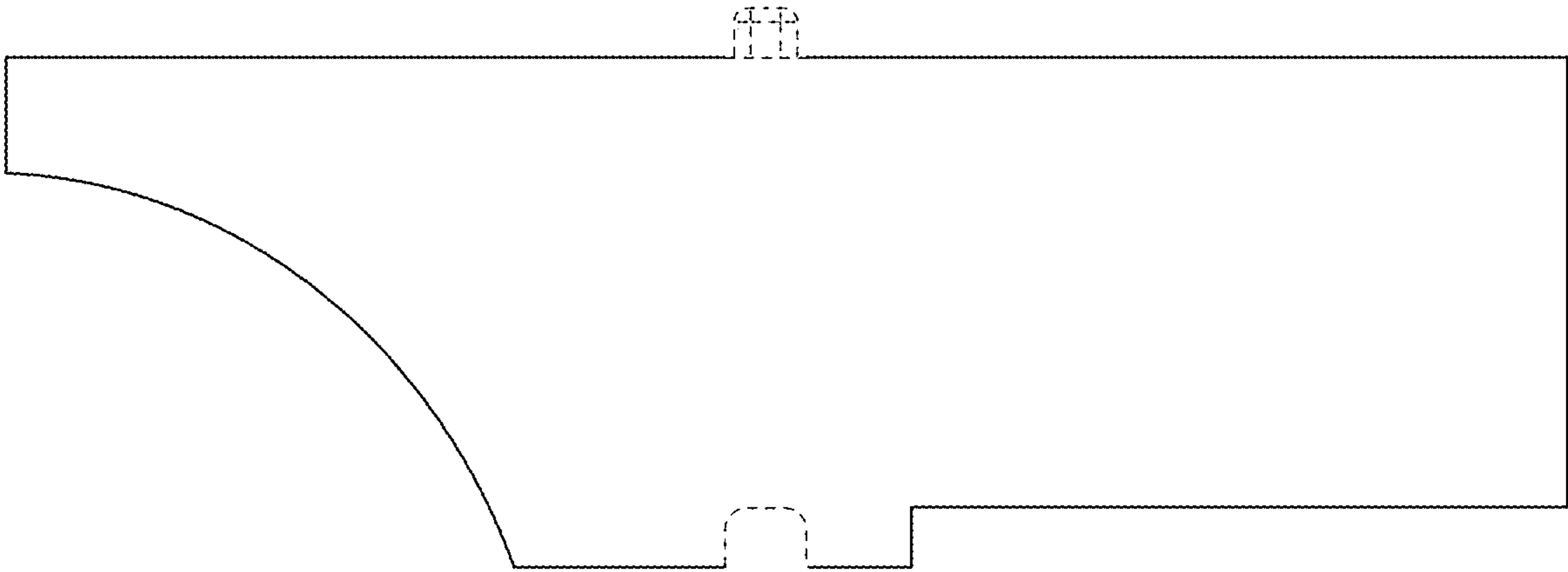

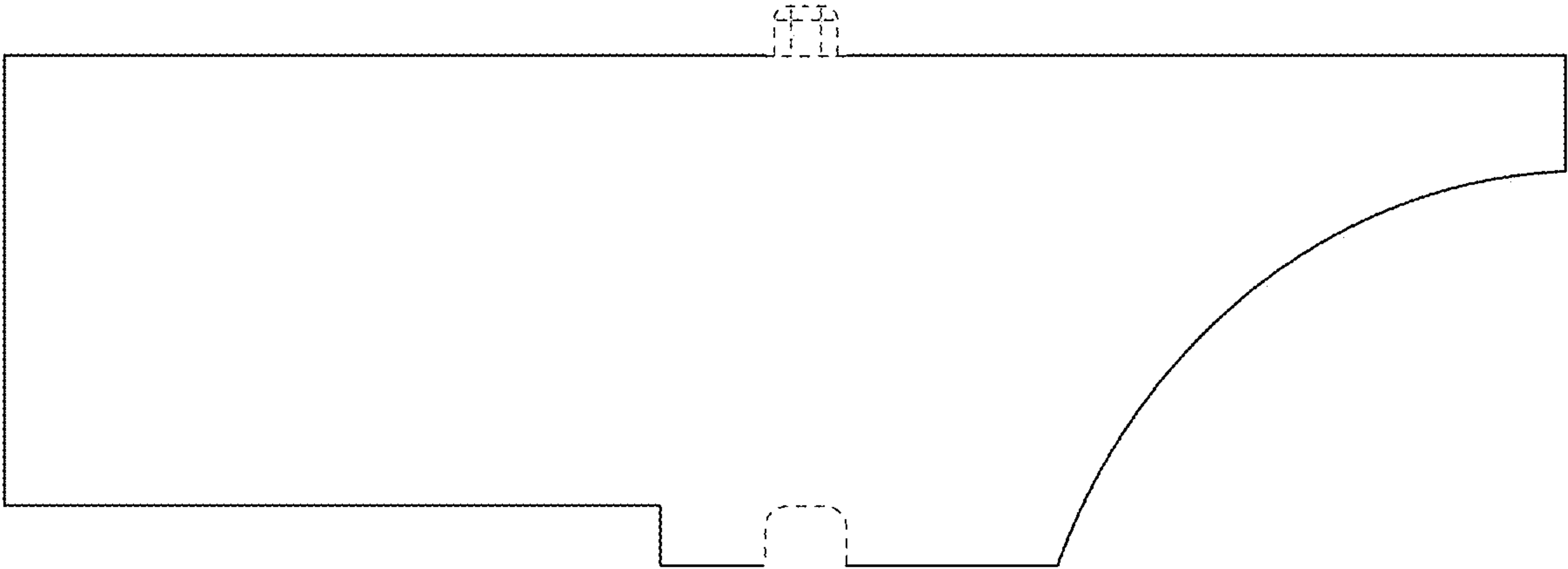

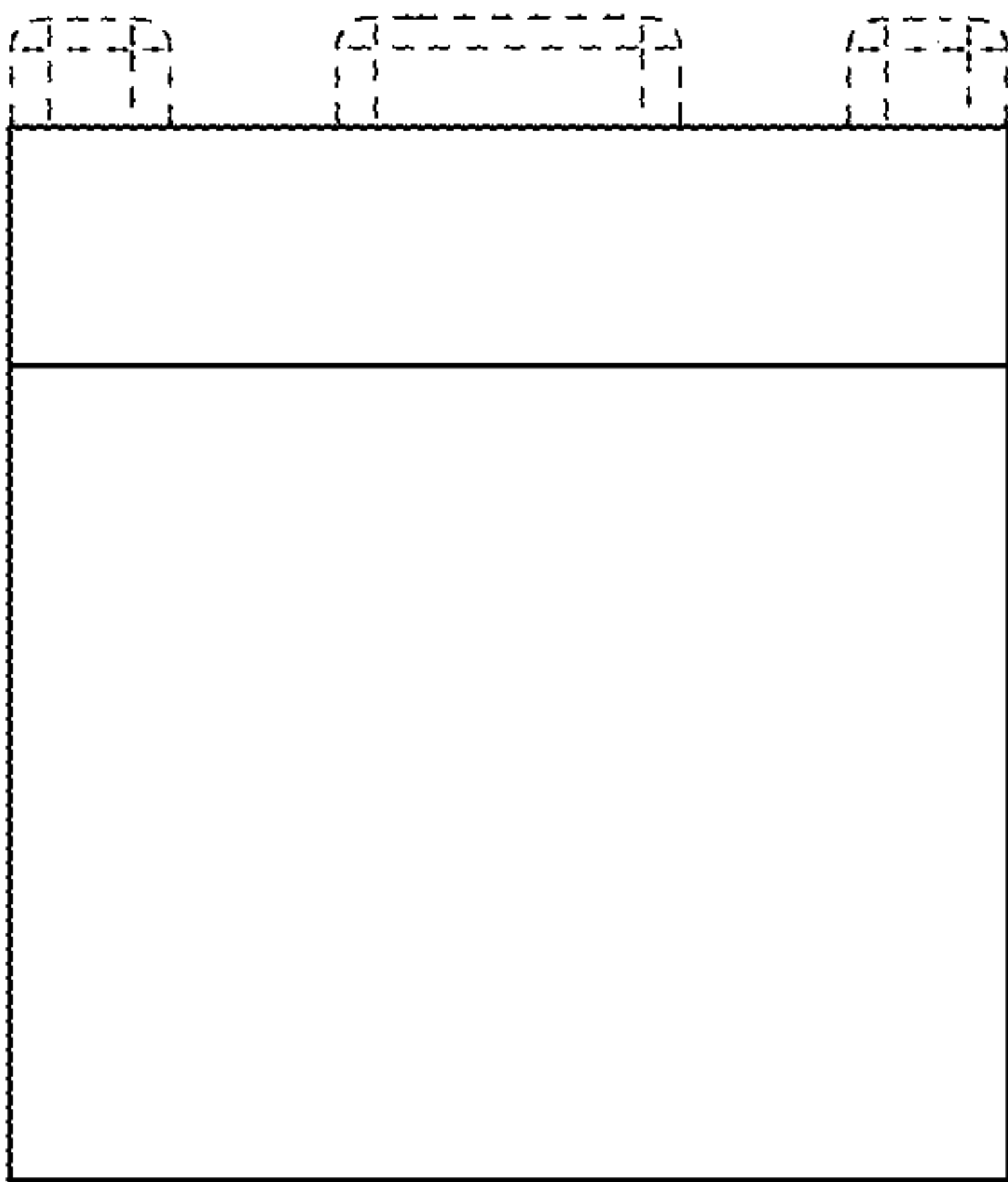

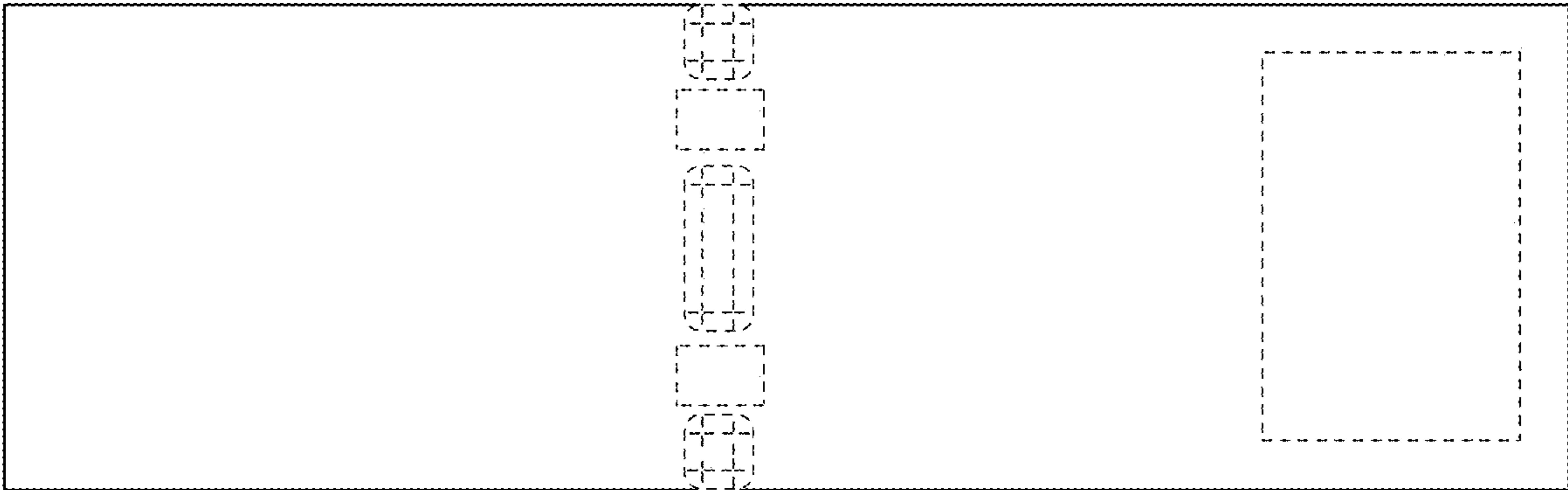
