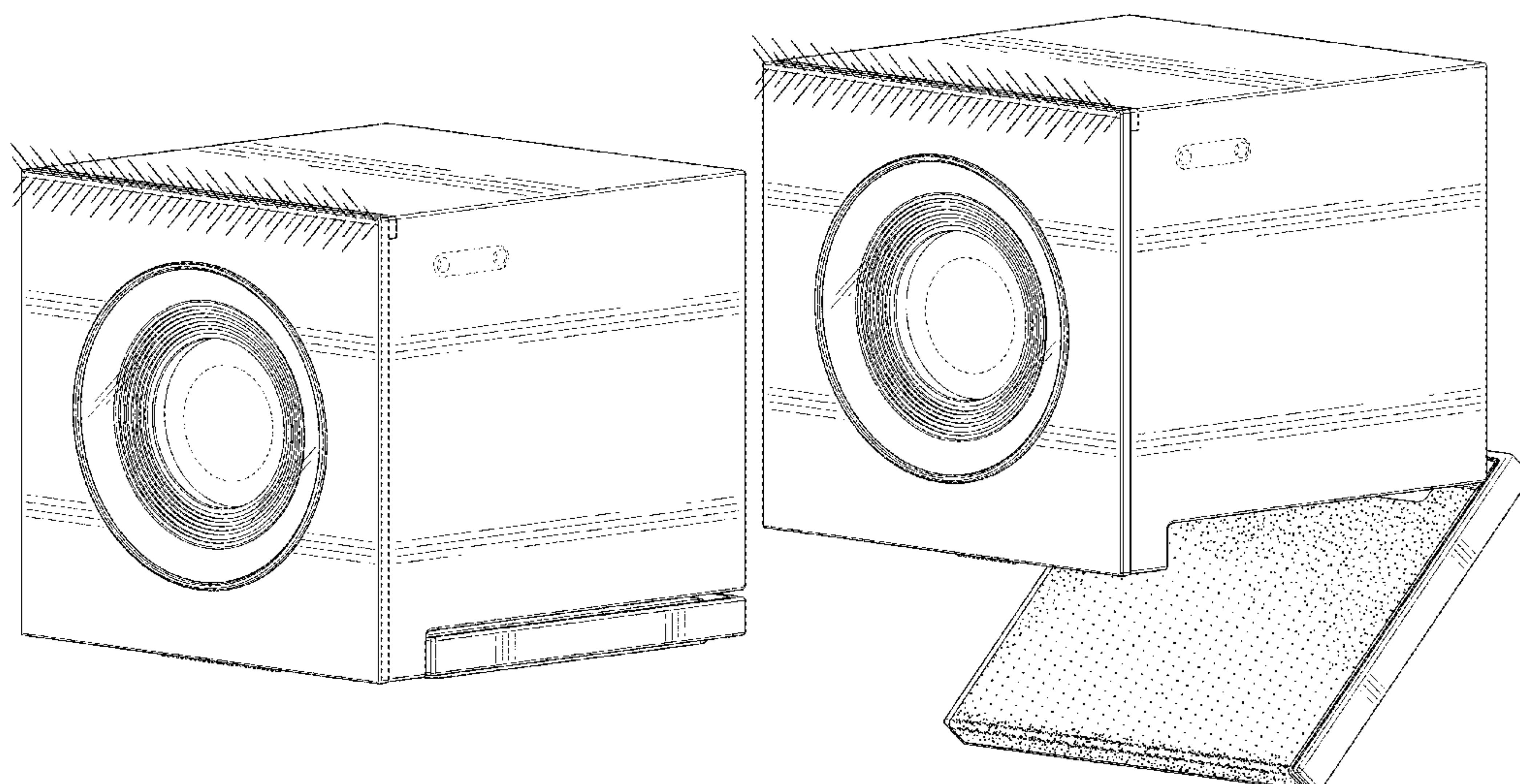
The ornamental design for a videoconferencing camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a videoconferencing camera showing our new design in a first configuration; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 8 is front perspective view thereof, shown in condition of use and mounted with a bracket disclosed in broken lines to illustrate an environment; FIG. 9 is a left side elevation view thereof, shown in condition of use with a bracket and a cable disclosed in broken lines to illustrate an environment; FIG. 10 is a front perspective view of the videoconferencing camera shown with the base pivoted in a second configuration; FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 15 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 16 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 17 is a front perspective view thereof, shown in condition of use and mounted with a bracket disclosed in broken lines to illustrate an environment; and, FIG. 18 is a left side elevation view thereof, shown in condition of use with a bracket and a cable disclosed in broken lines to illustrate an environment.

The broken lines depict portion of the videoconferencing camera that form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines showing a bracket and cable in FIGS. 8-9, and 17-18 represent environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design. The radiating lines shown on the top-front portion of the videoconferencing camera in FIGS. 1-2, 4, 6-11, 13, and 15-18 illustrate the glowing visual effect of illumination created by light emanating from the light part of the videoconferencing camera, and form no part of the claimed design.

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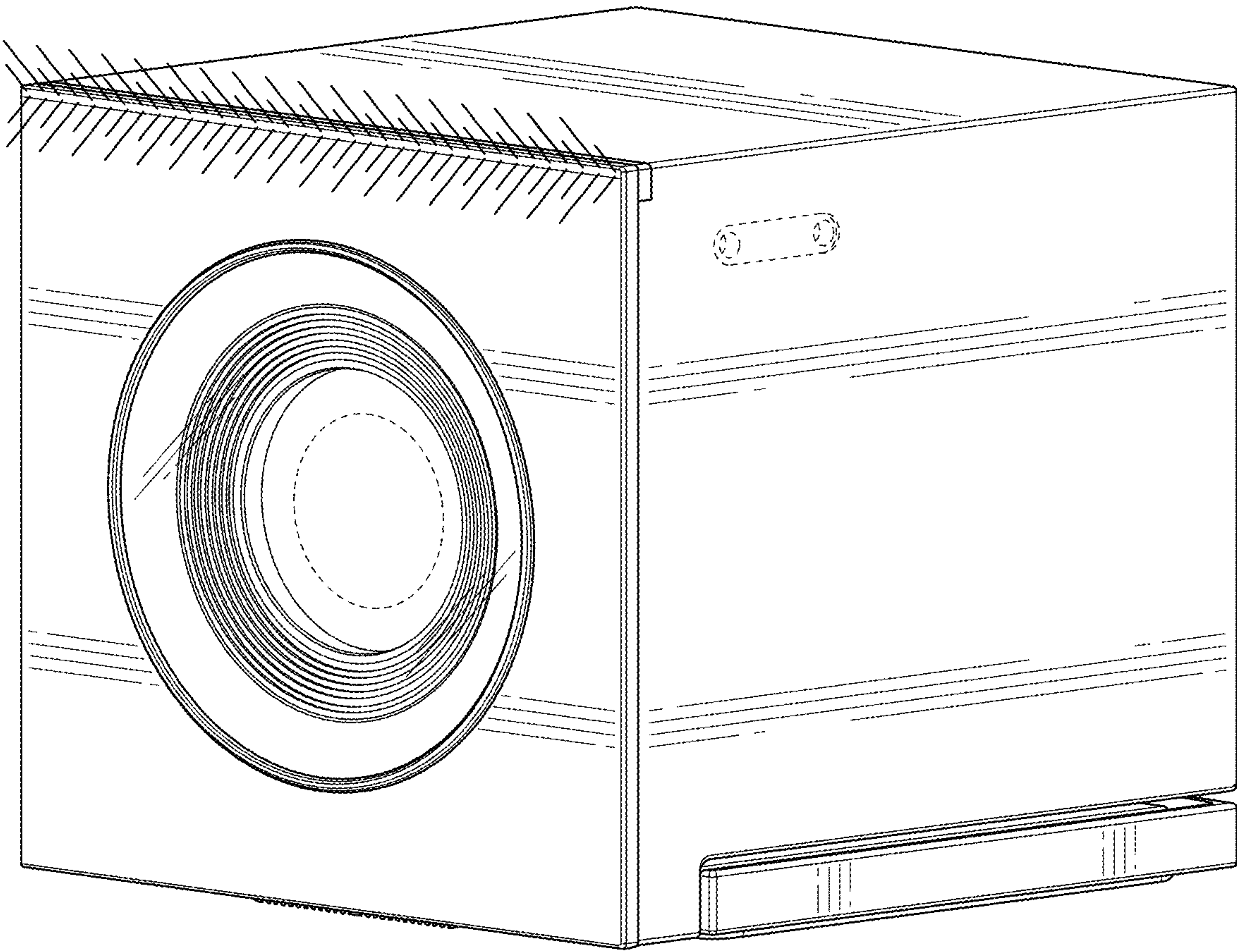

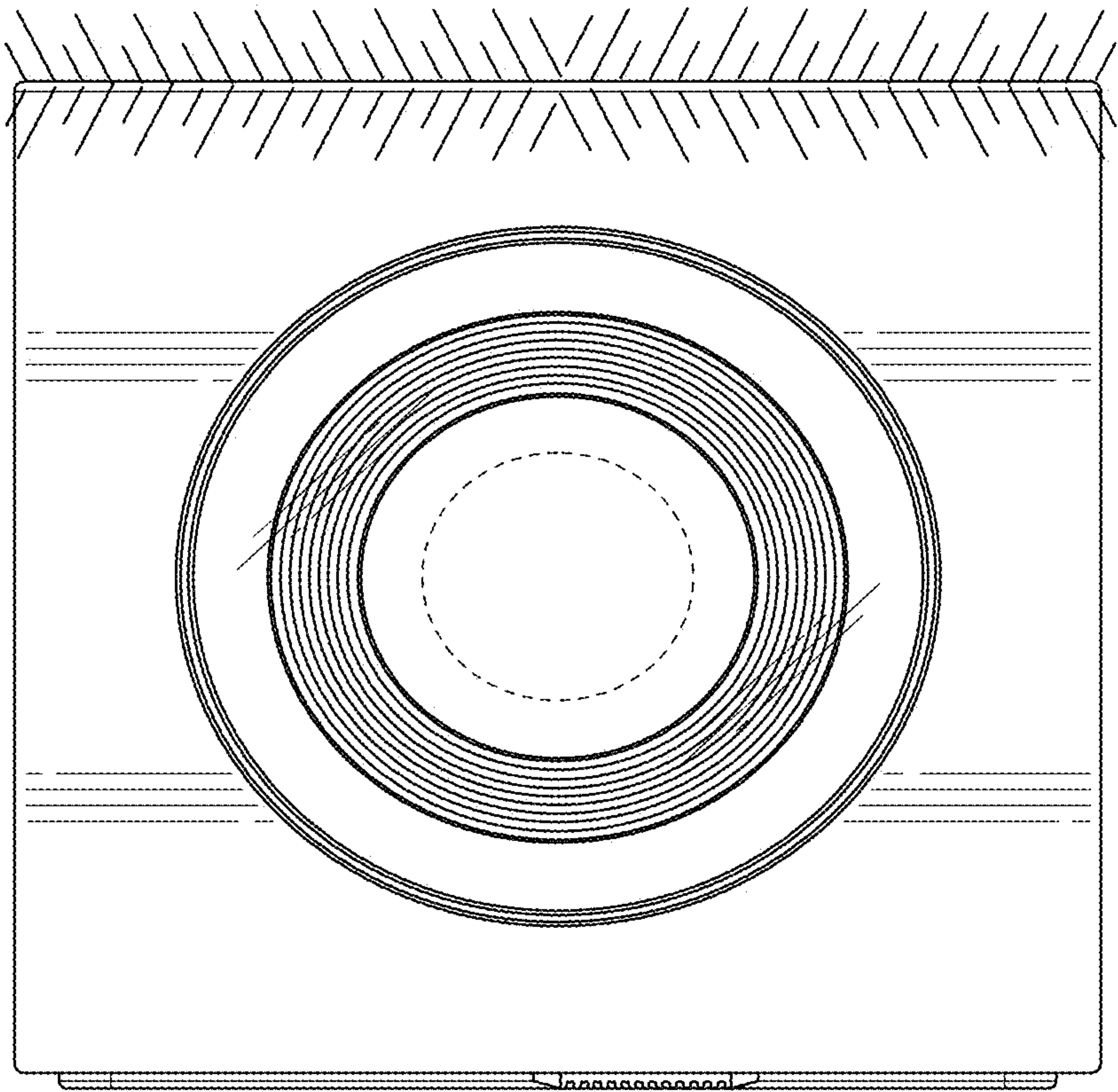

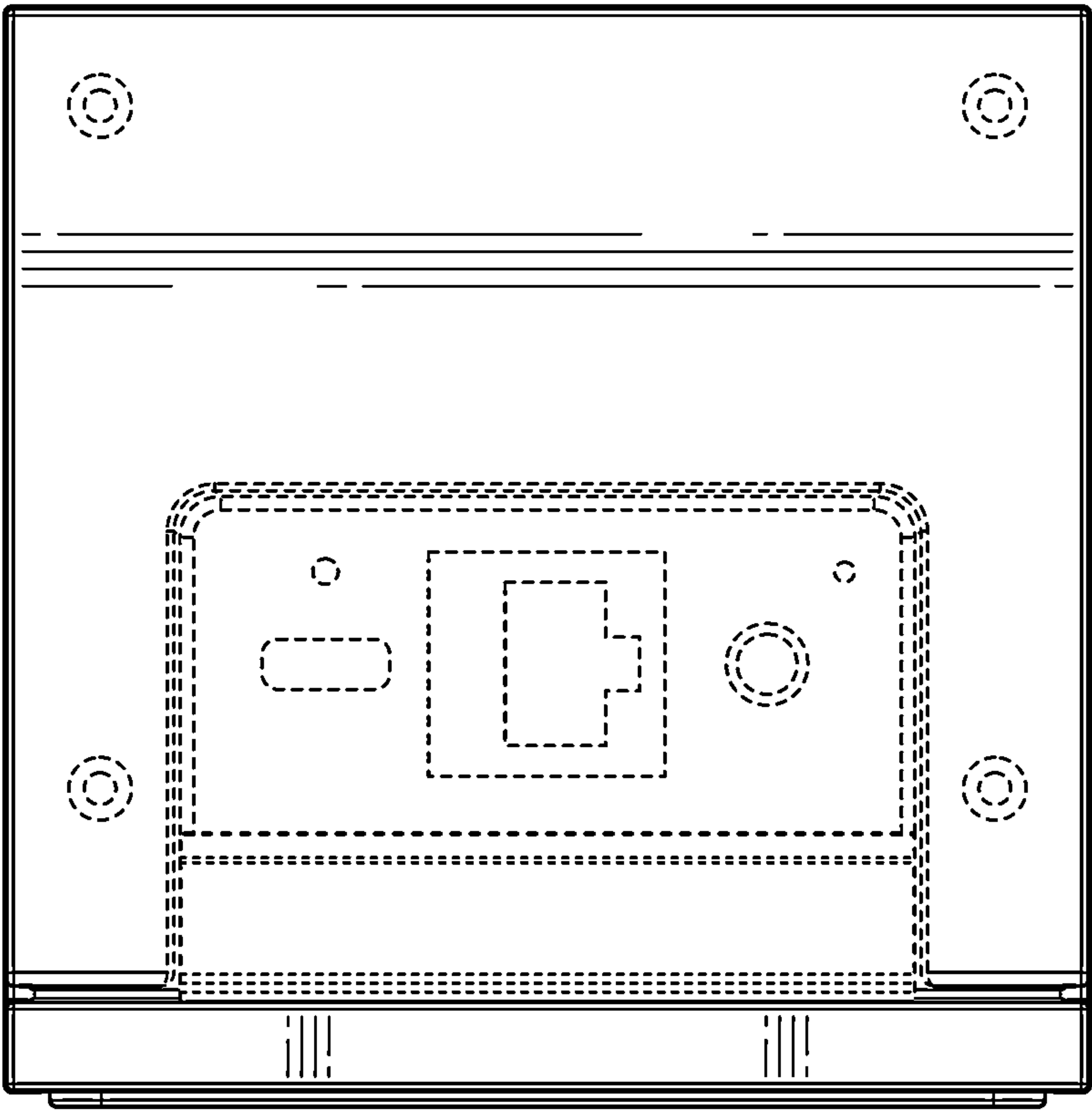

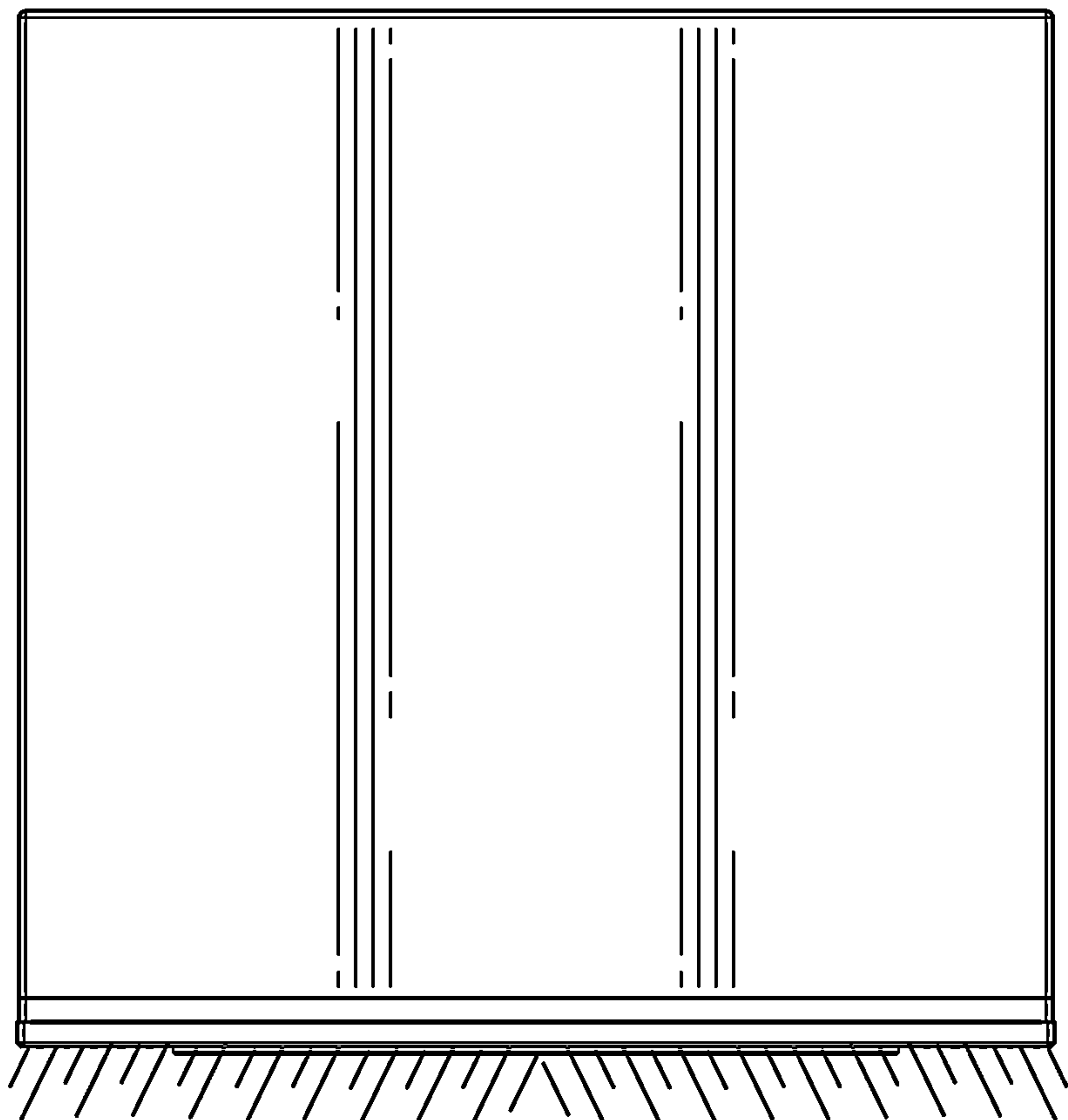

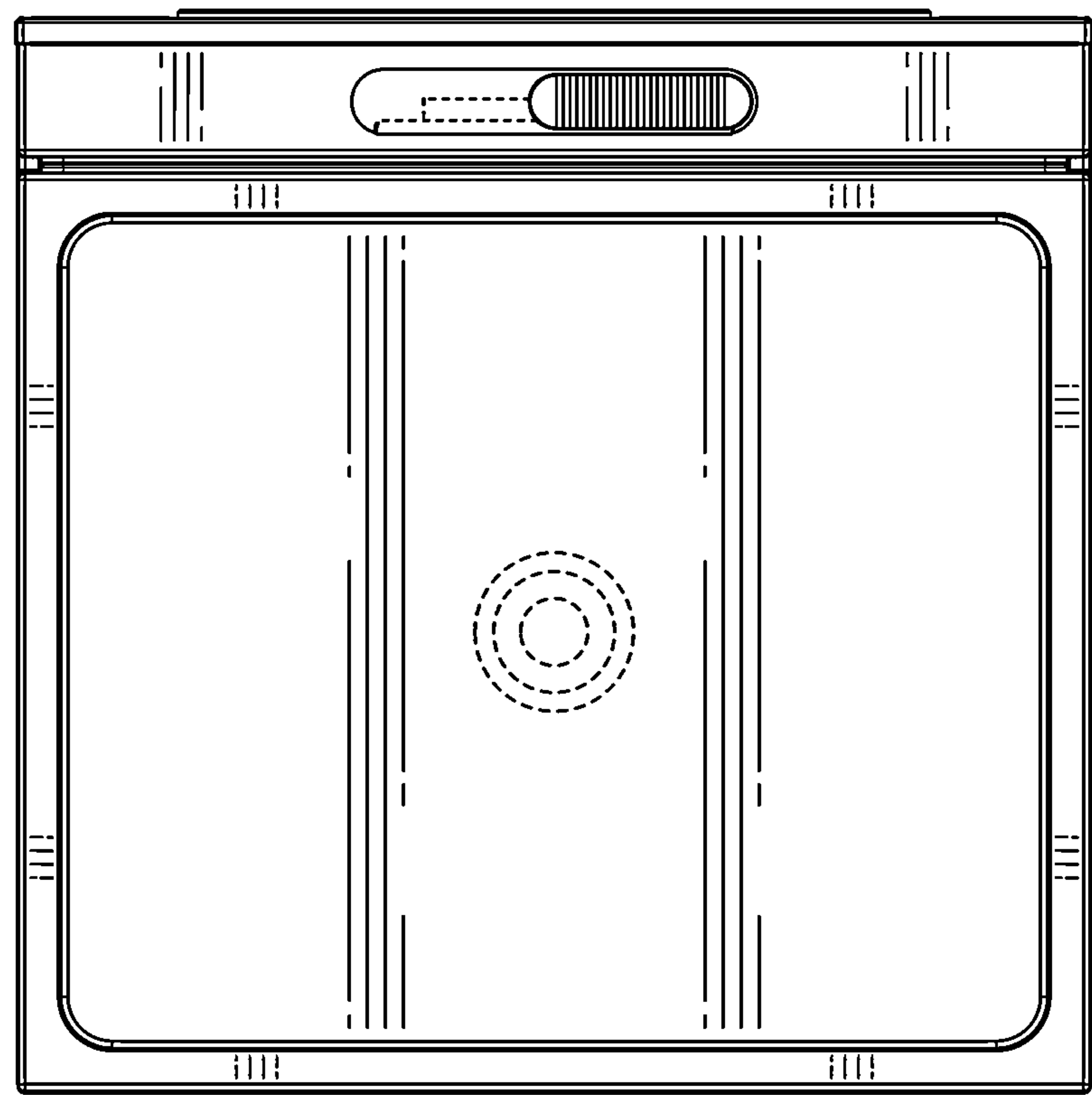

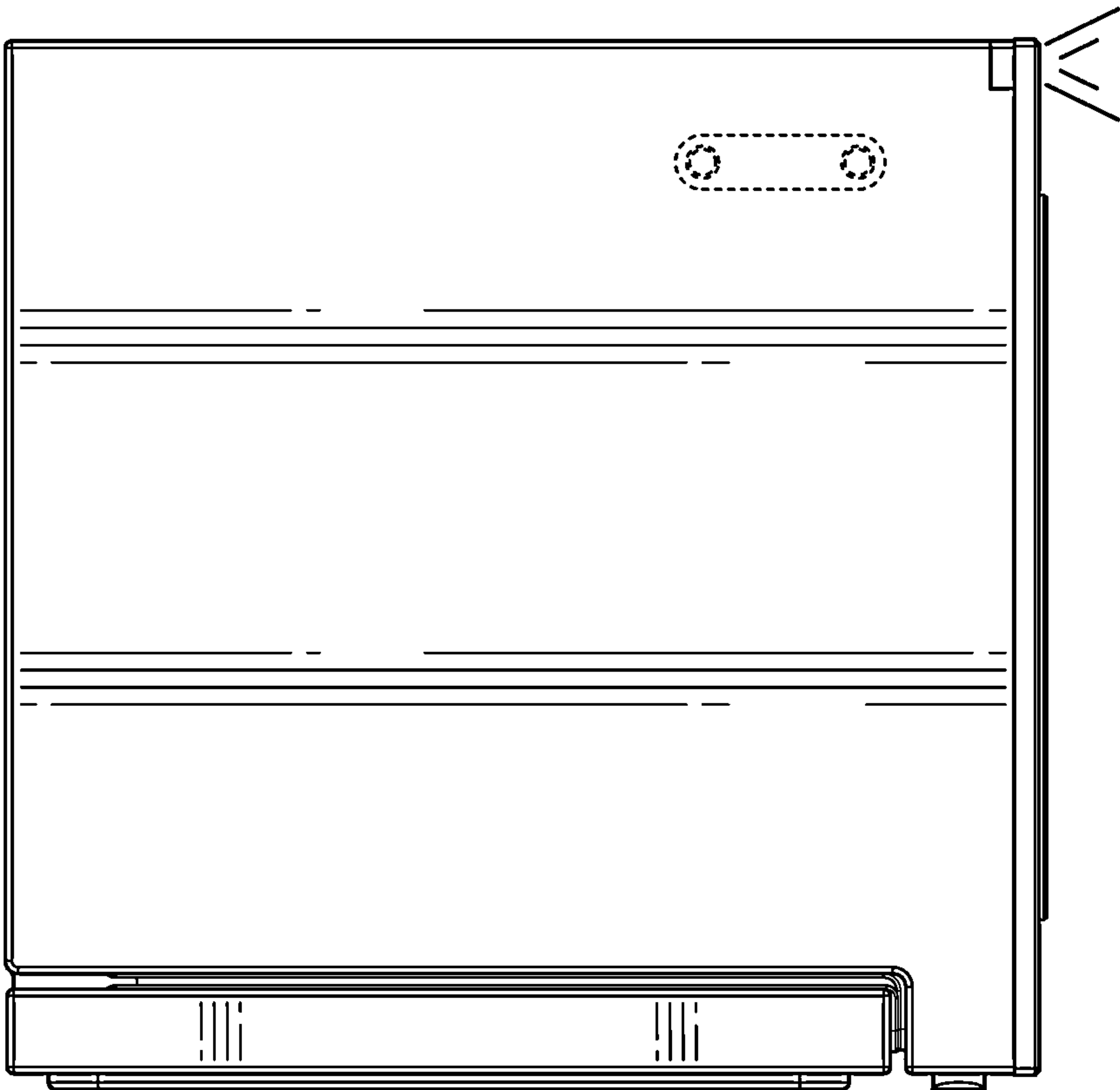

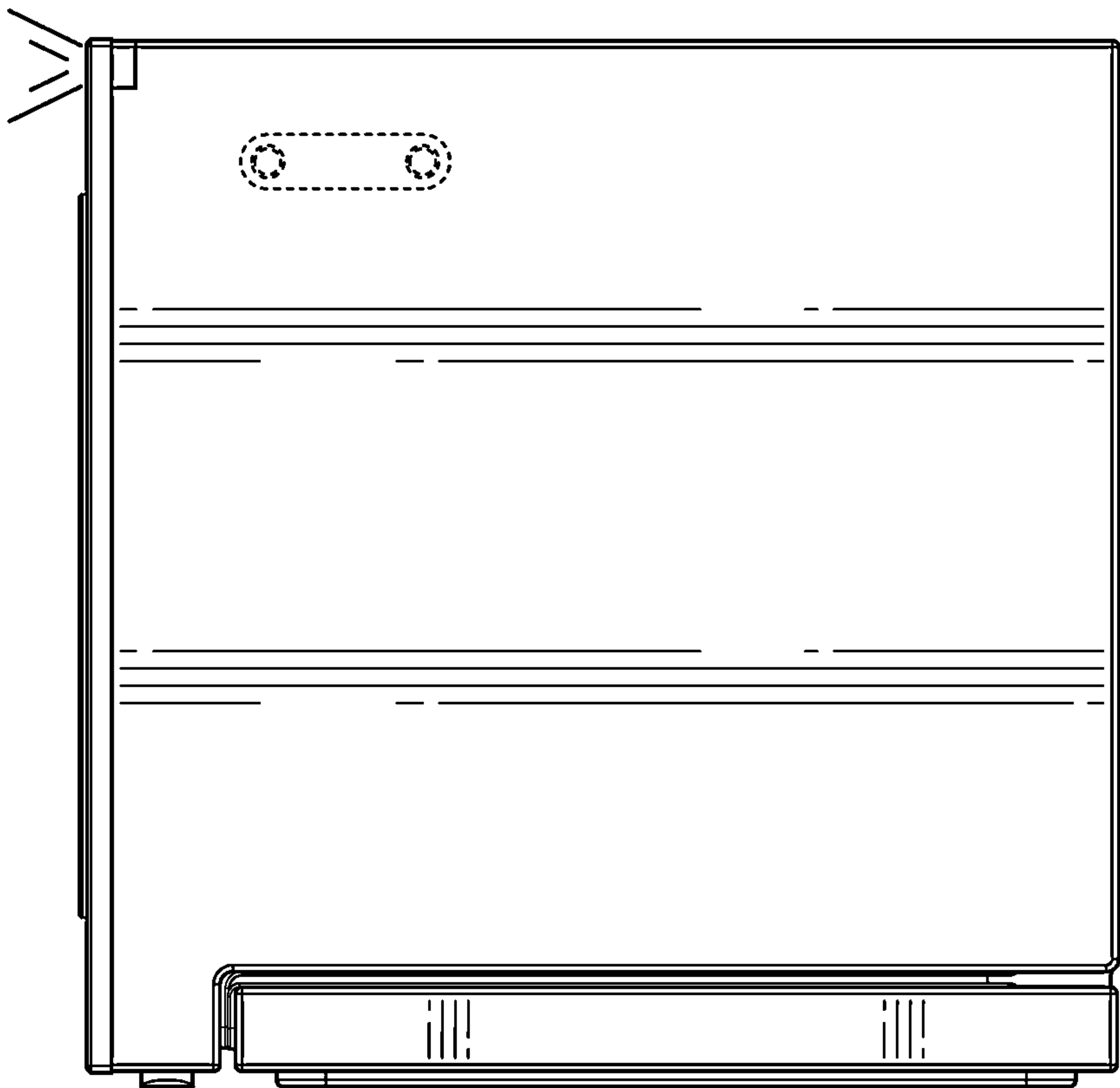

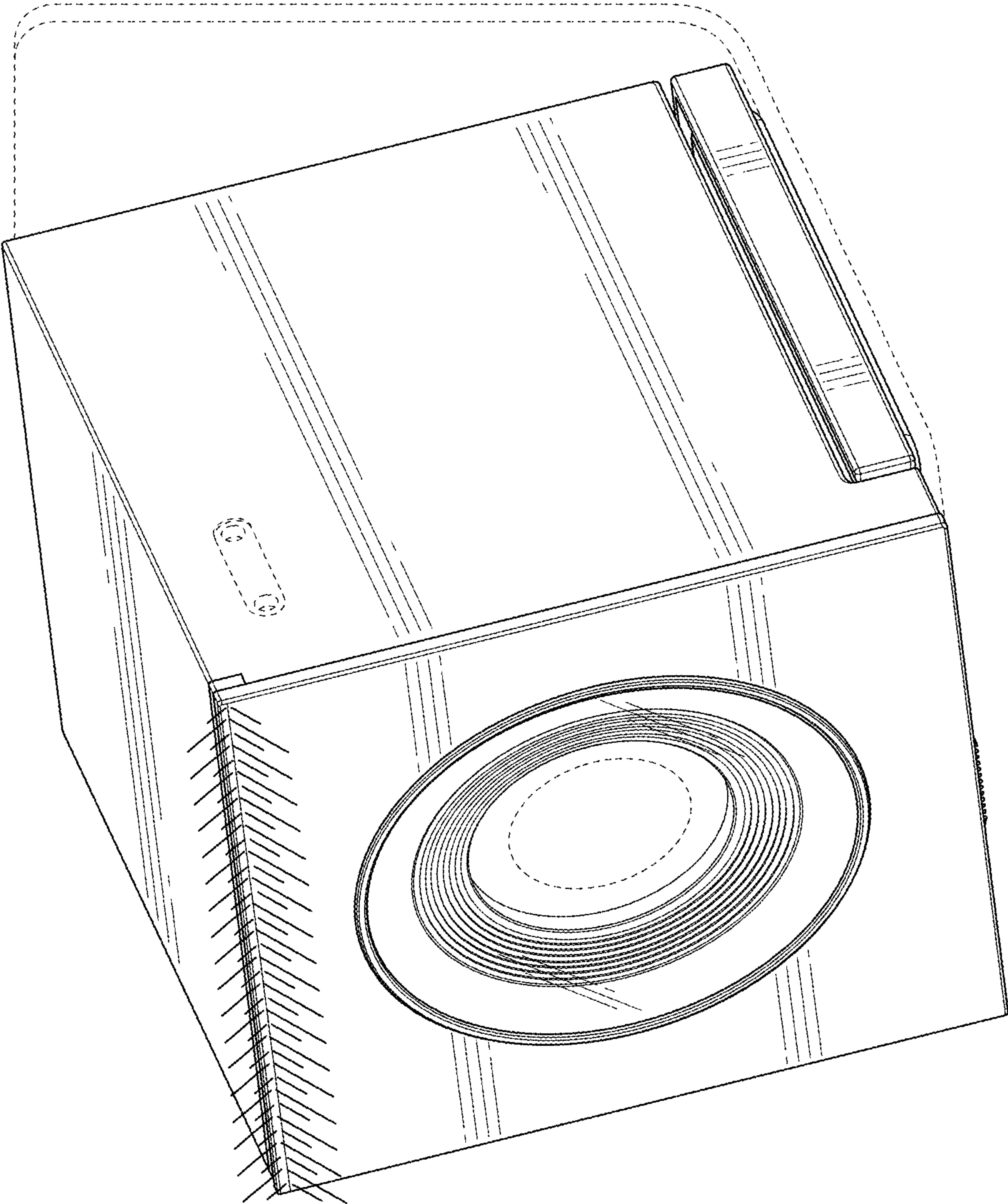

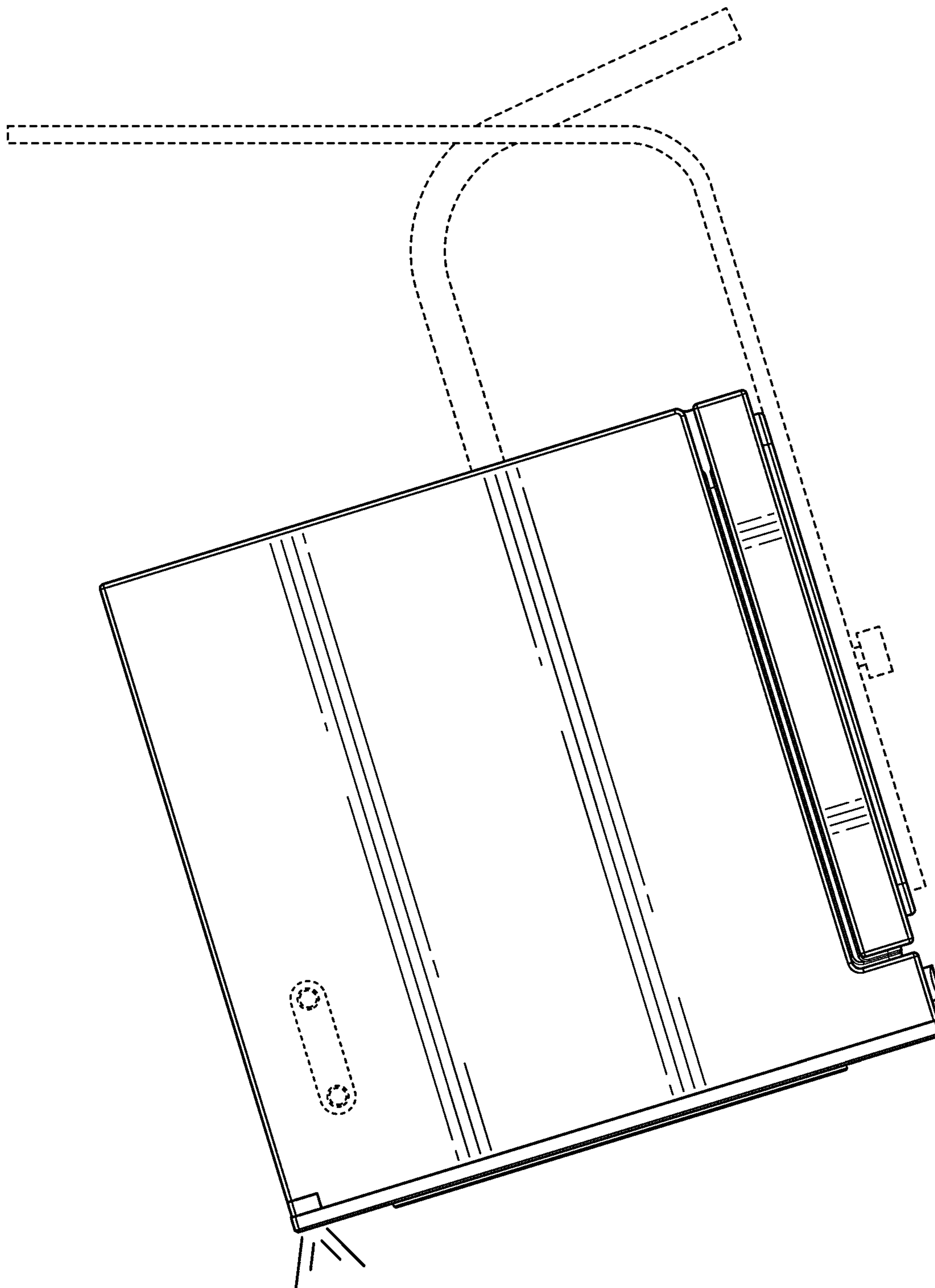

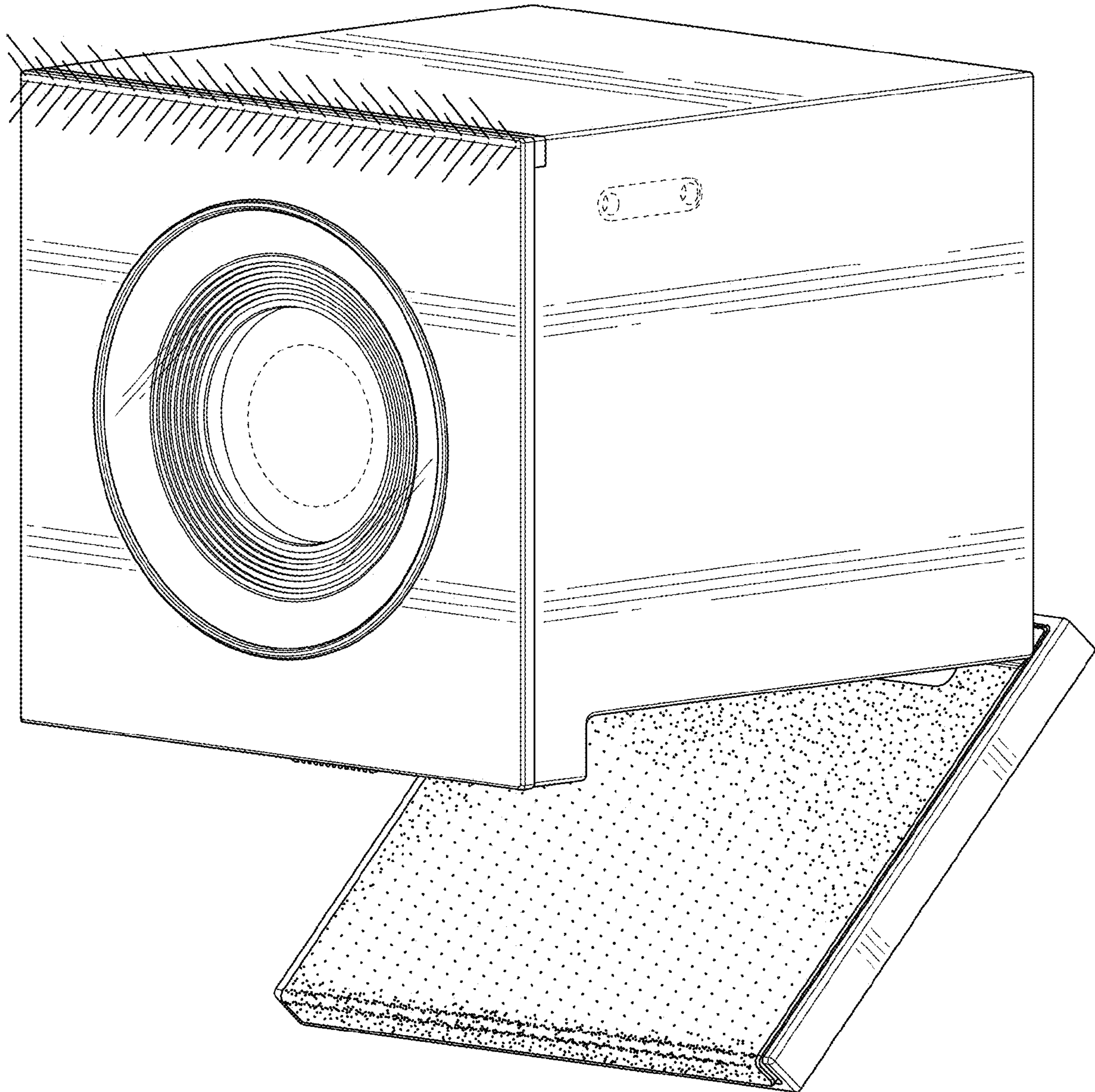

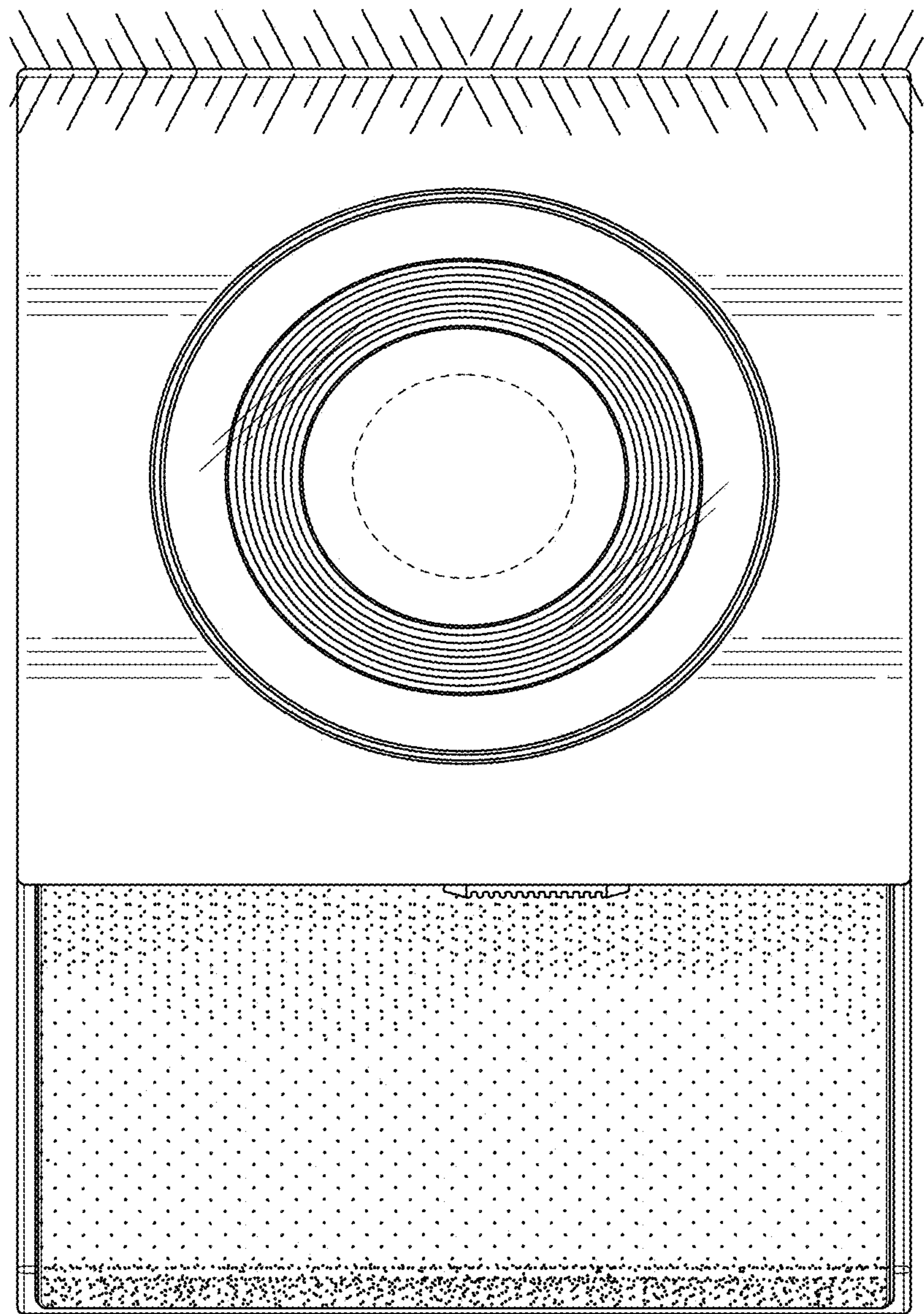

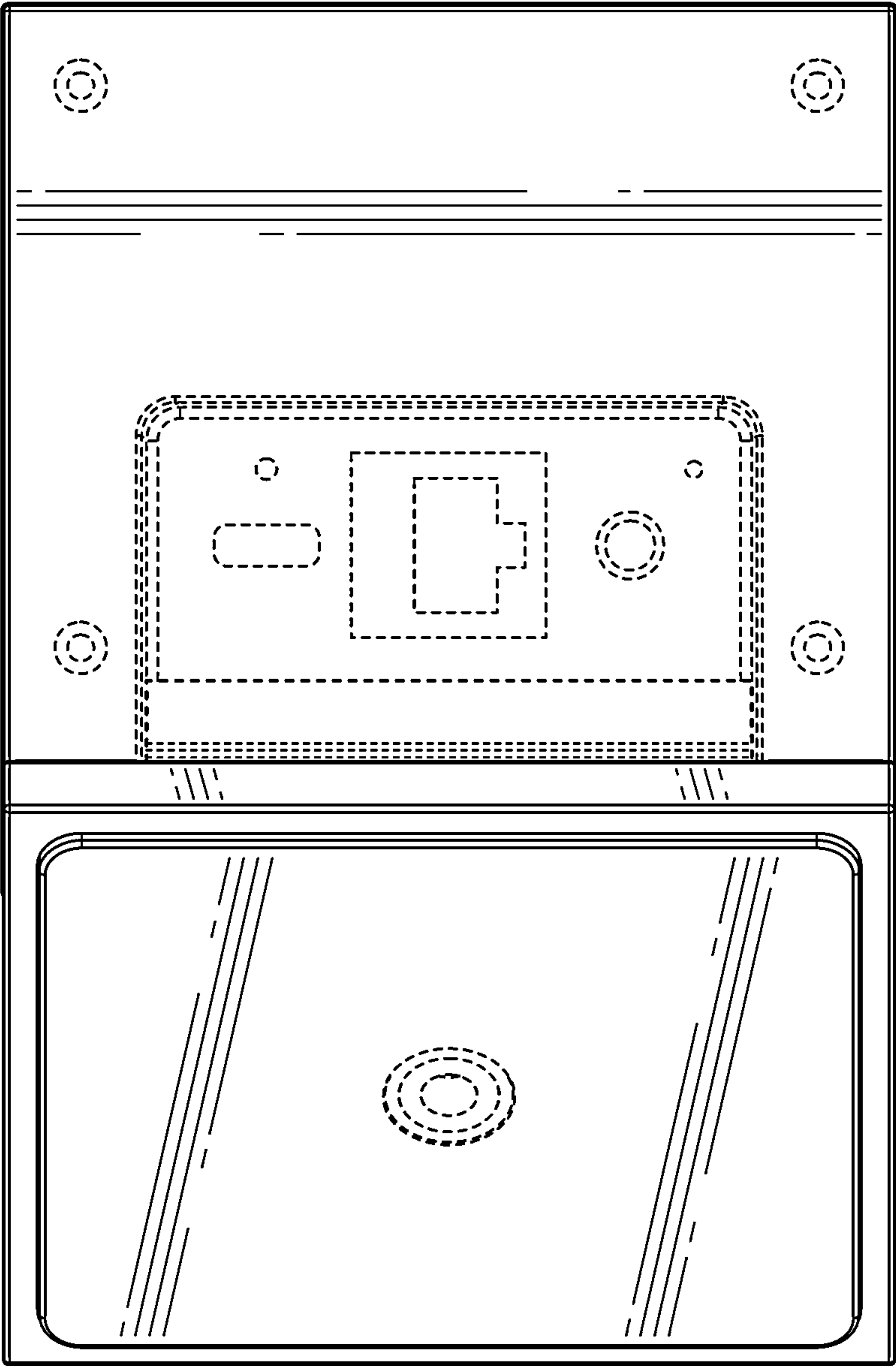

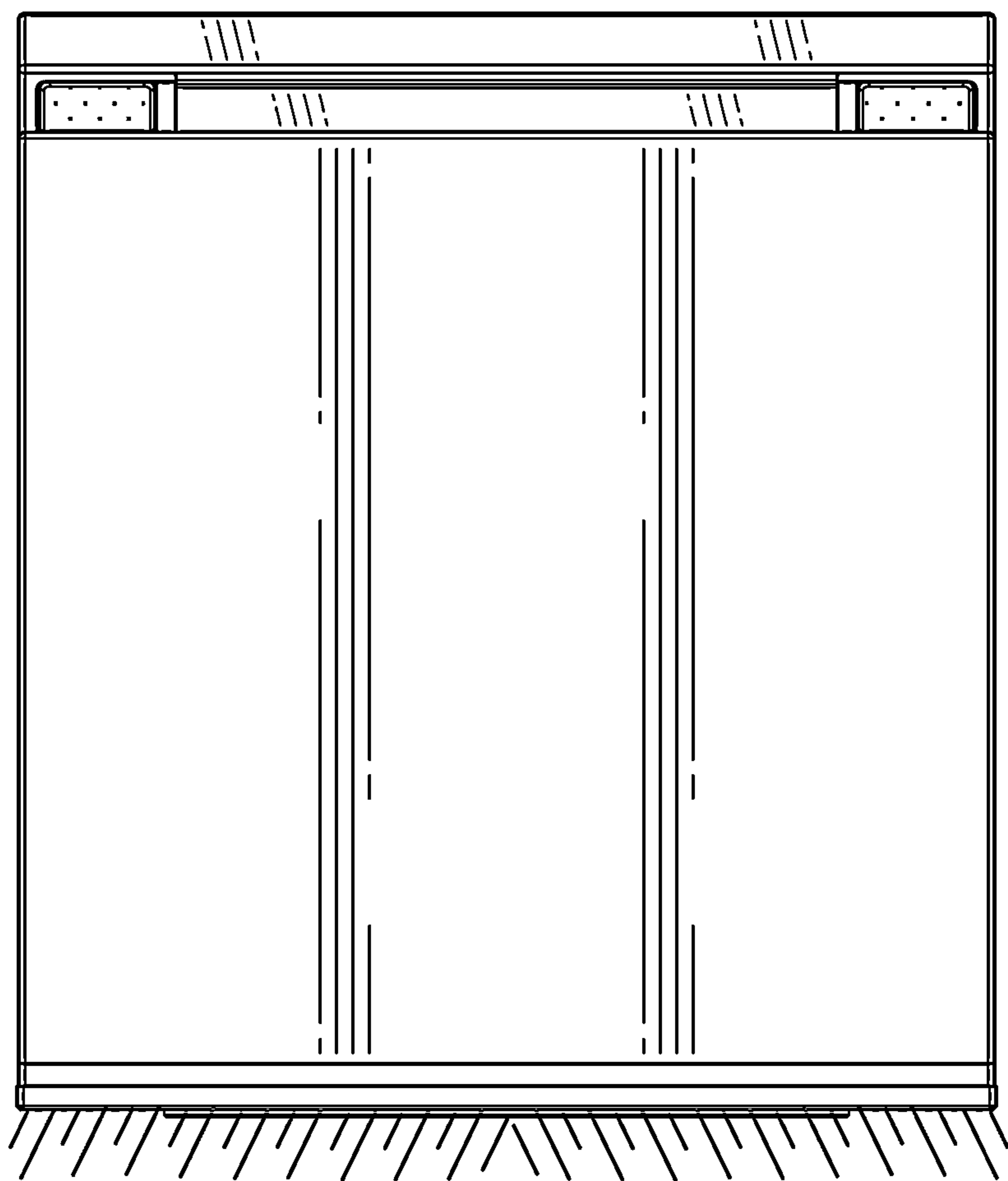

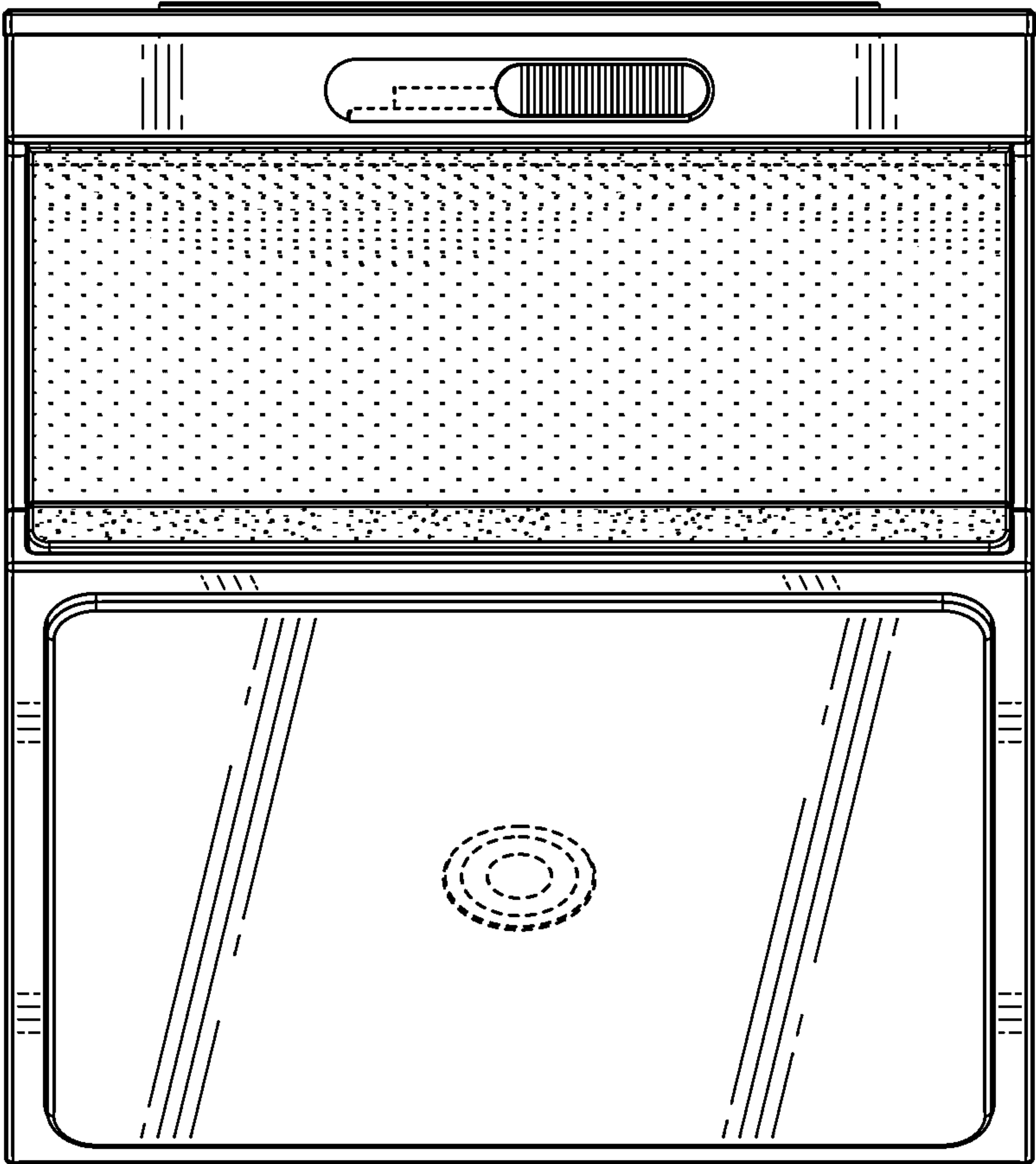

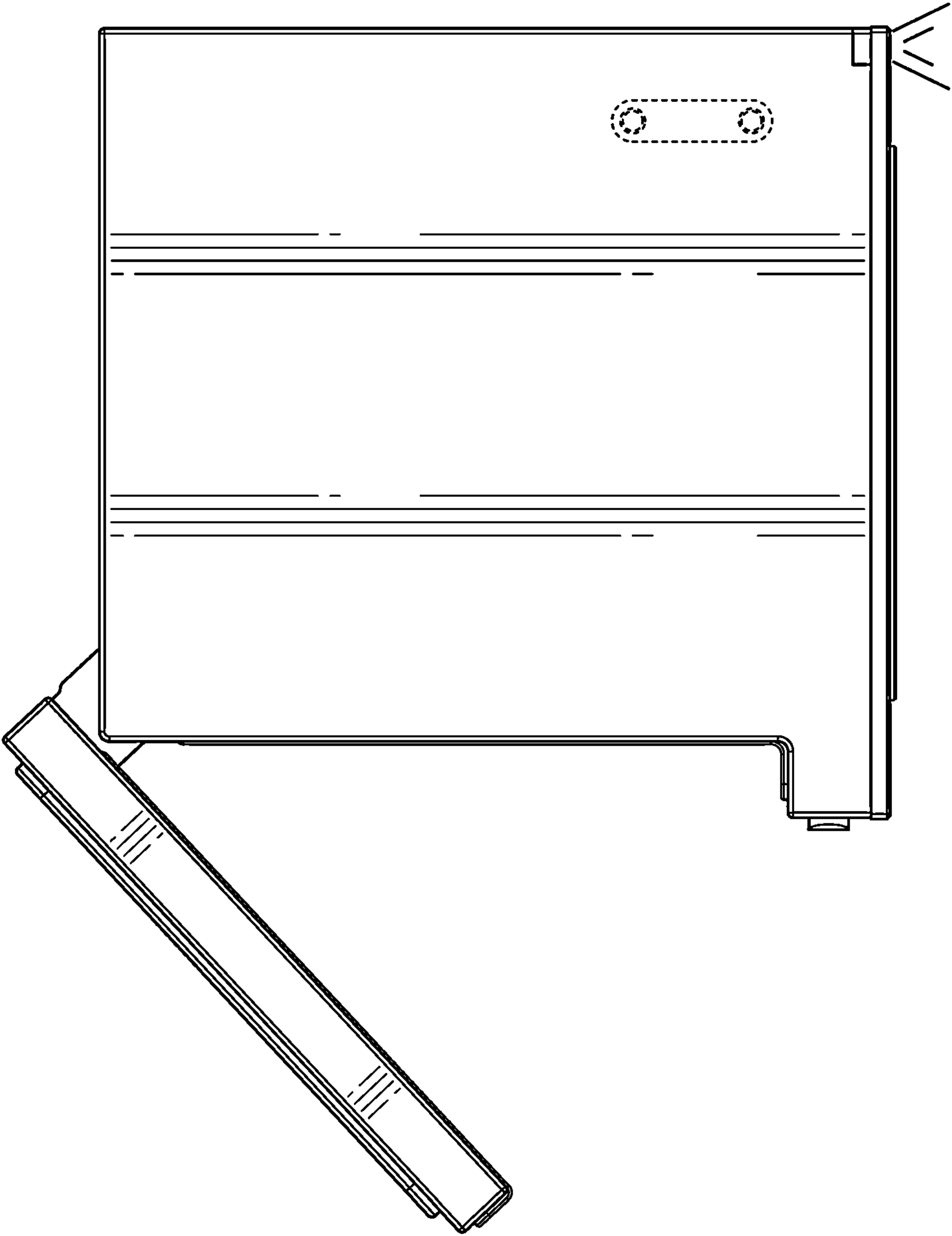

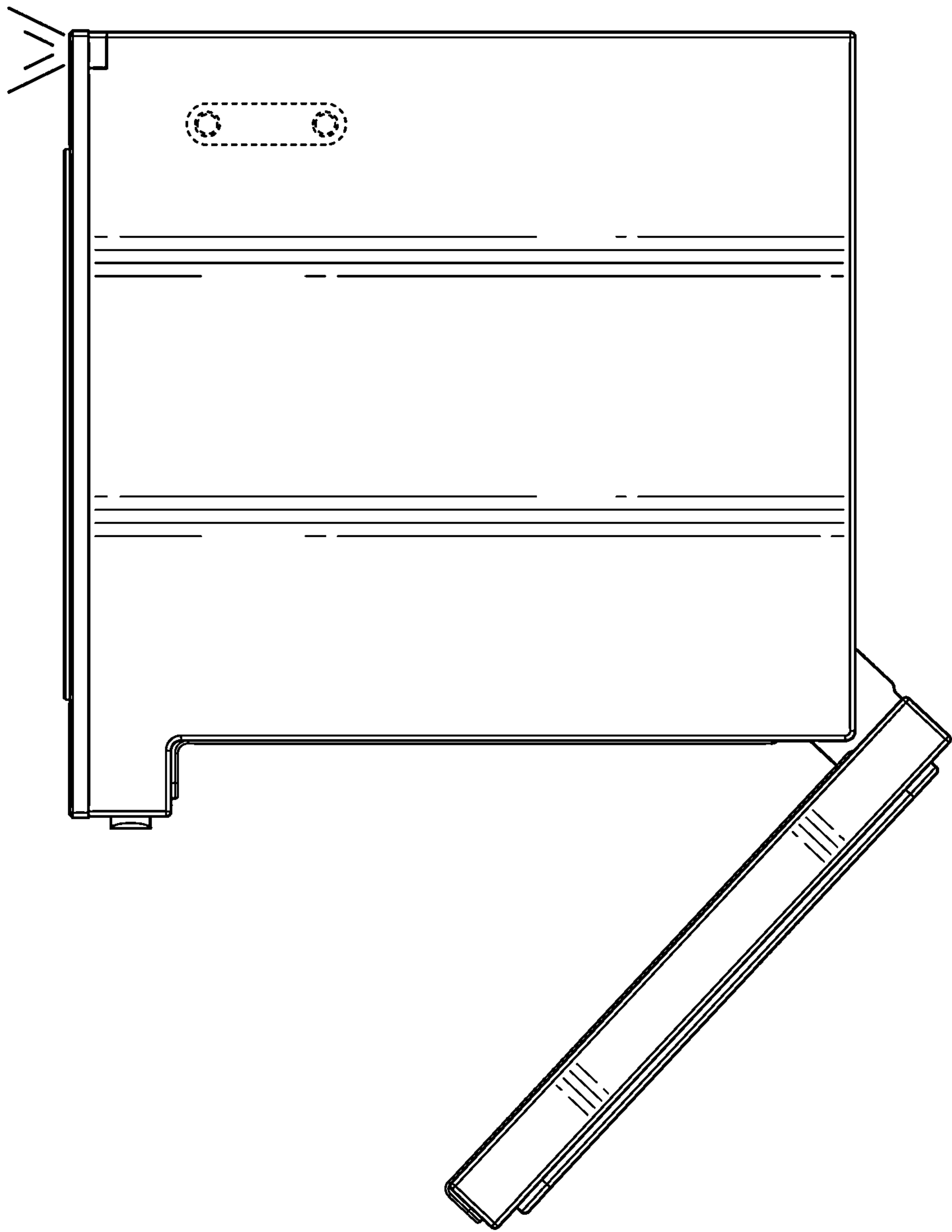

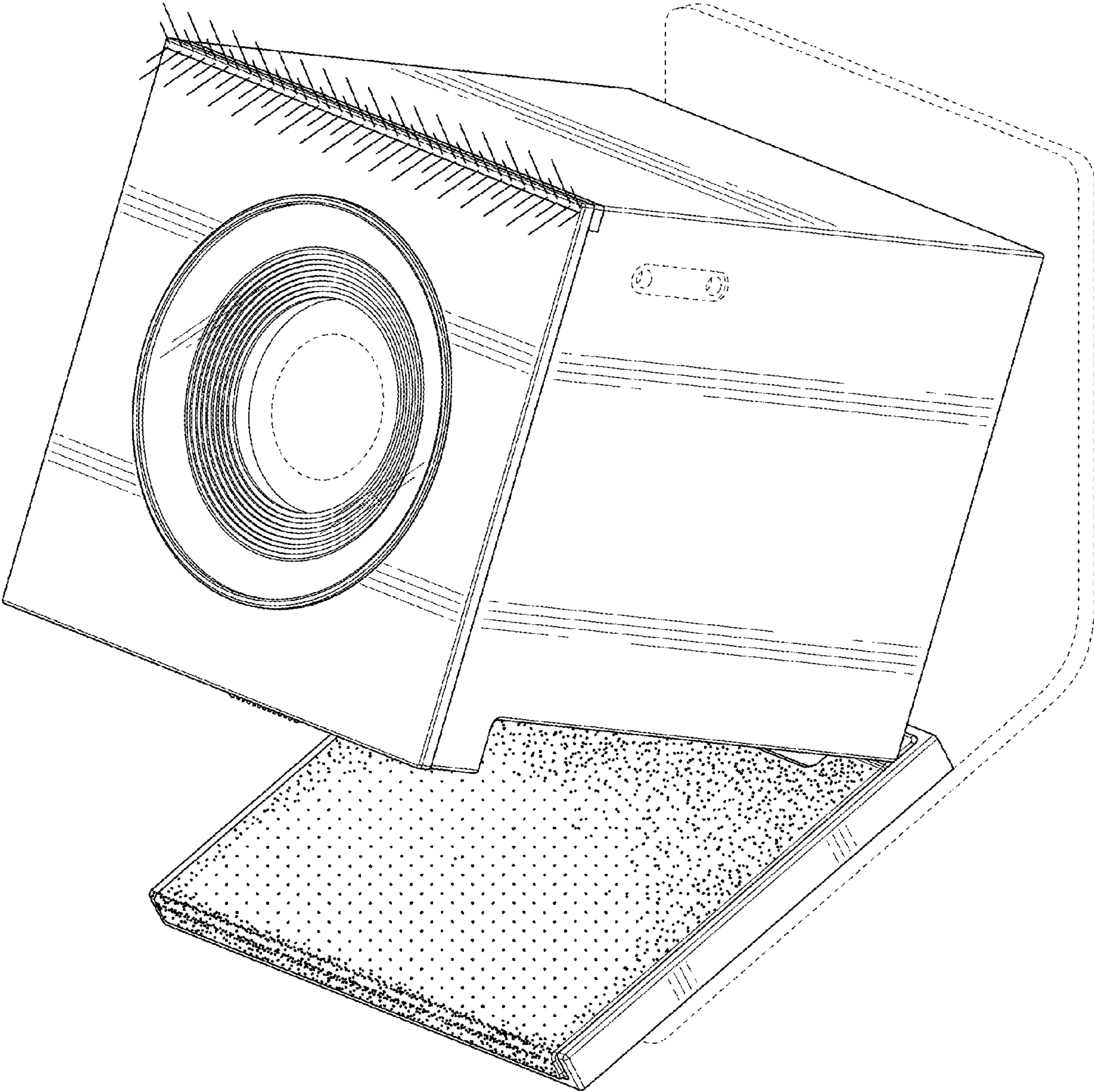

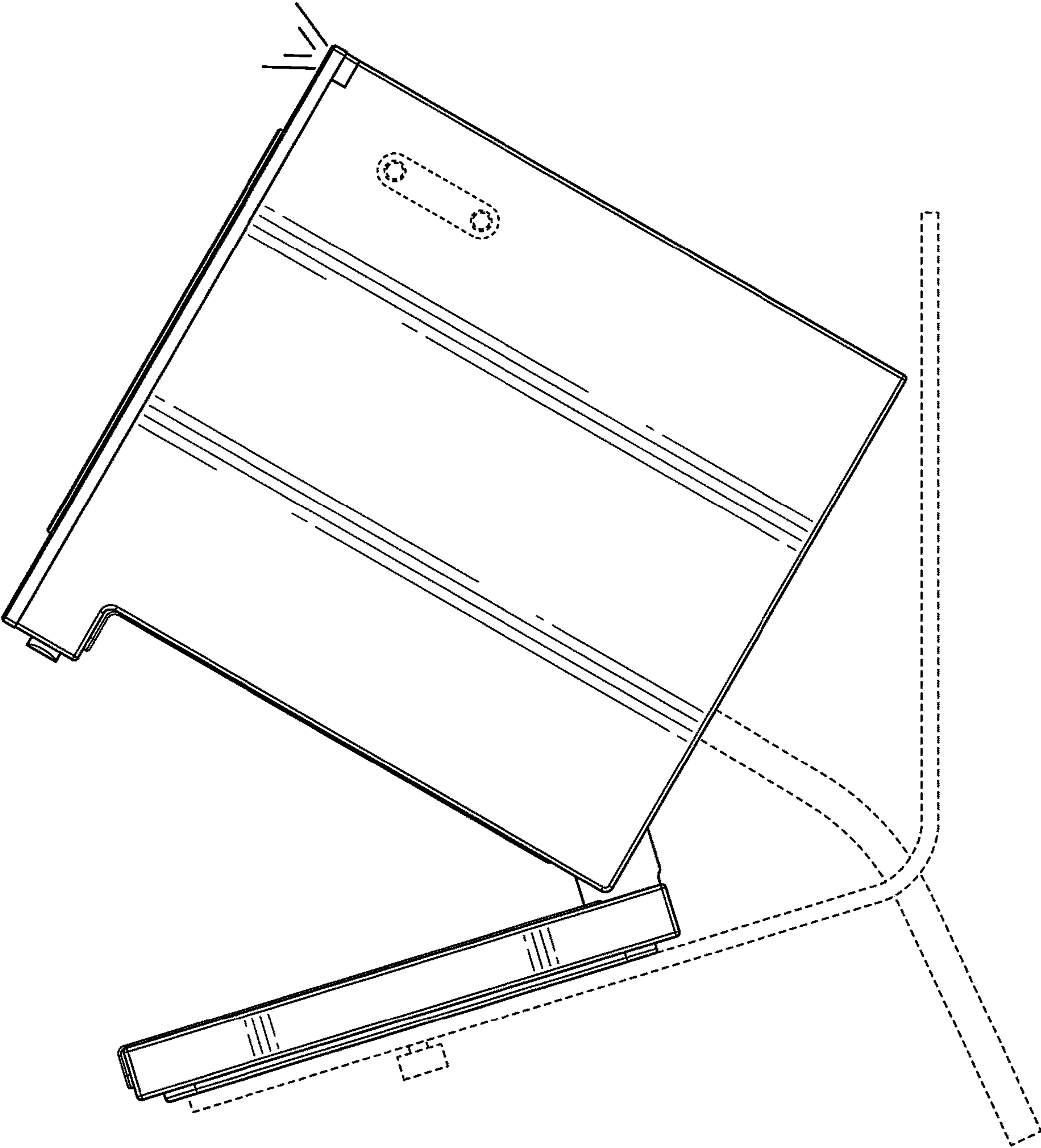
