(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a door shelf as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right perspective view of a door shelf showing our new design in an illustrative environment;

FIG. 2 is a top, front, right perspective view of a first embodiment of the door shelf of FIG. 1, where a non-transparent material, as indicated by surface shading, is different from a remainder of the door shelf;

FIG. 3 is a bottom, back, left perspective view of the door shelf of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the door shelf of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a back elevation view of the door shelf of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a left elevation view of the door shelf of FIG. 2;

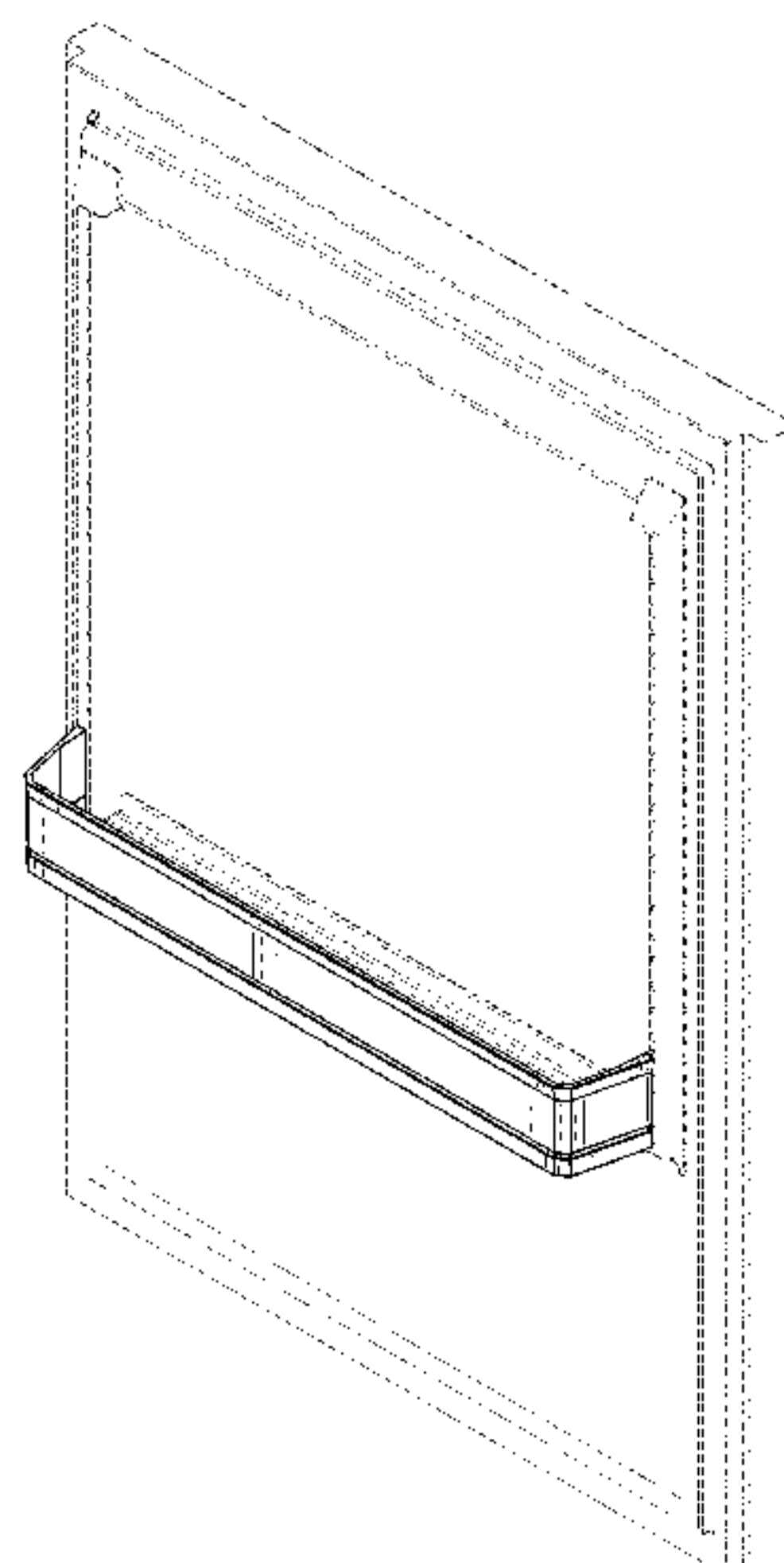

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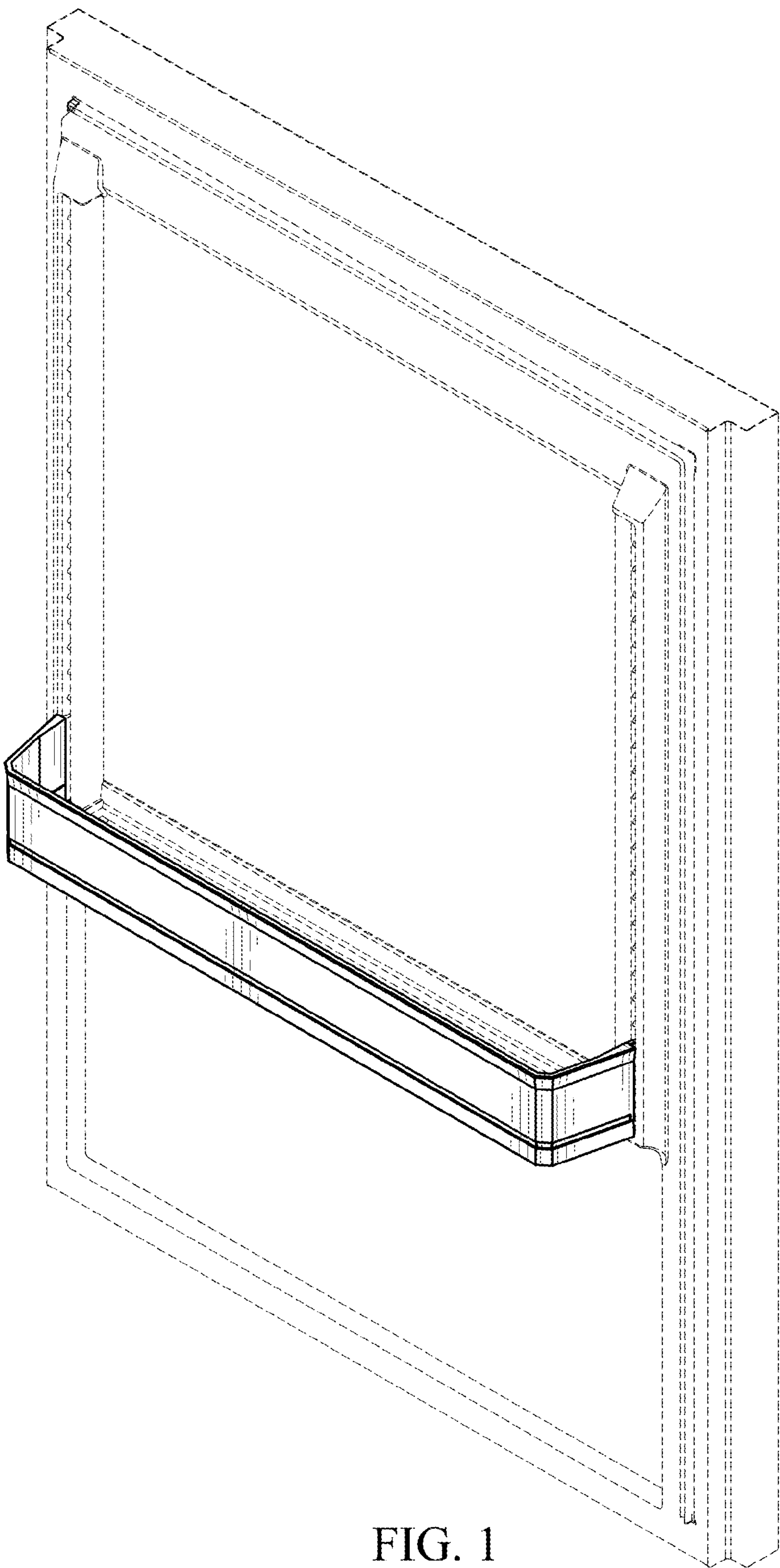

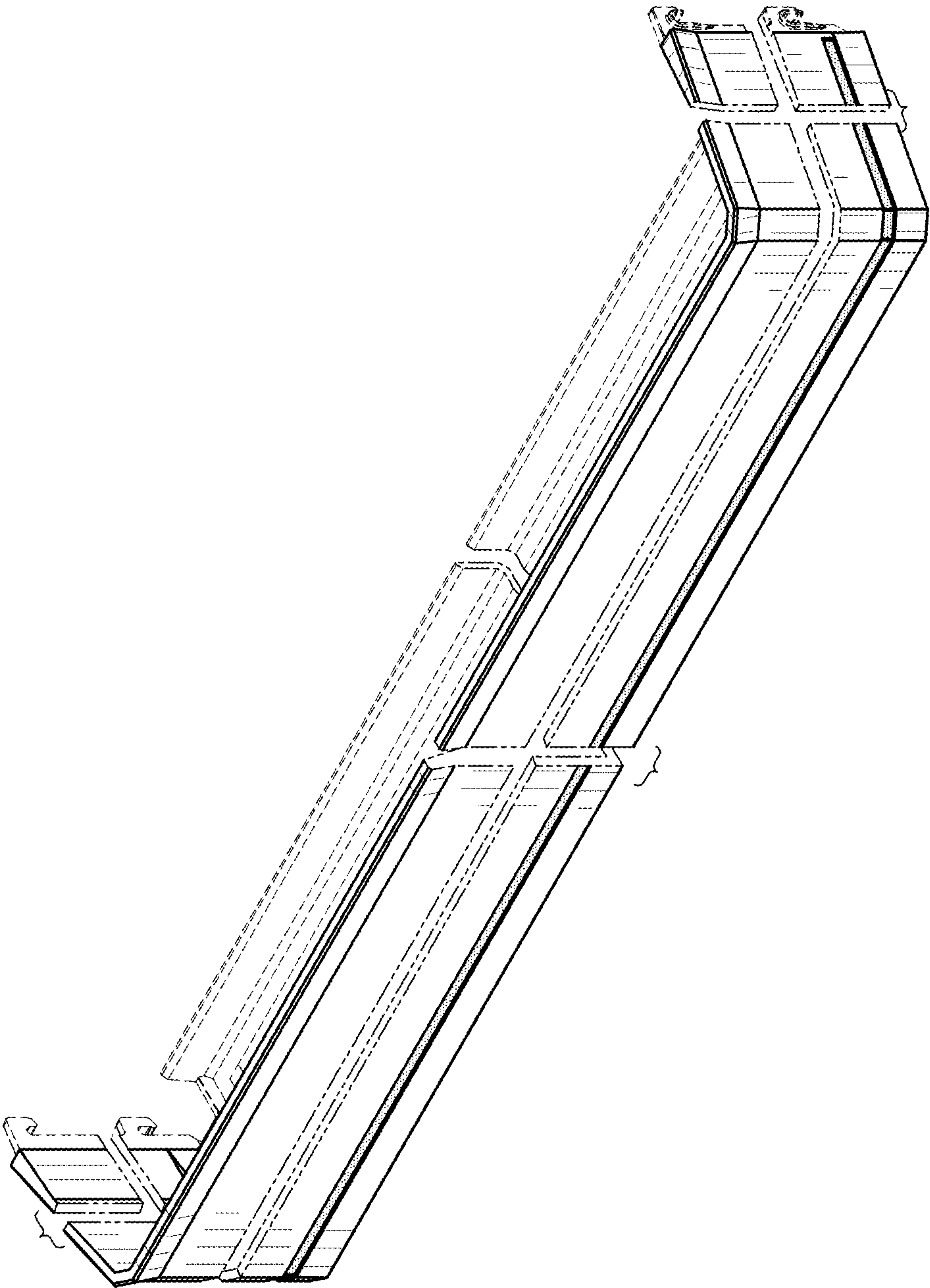

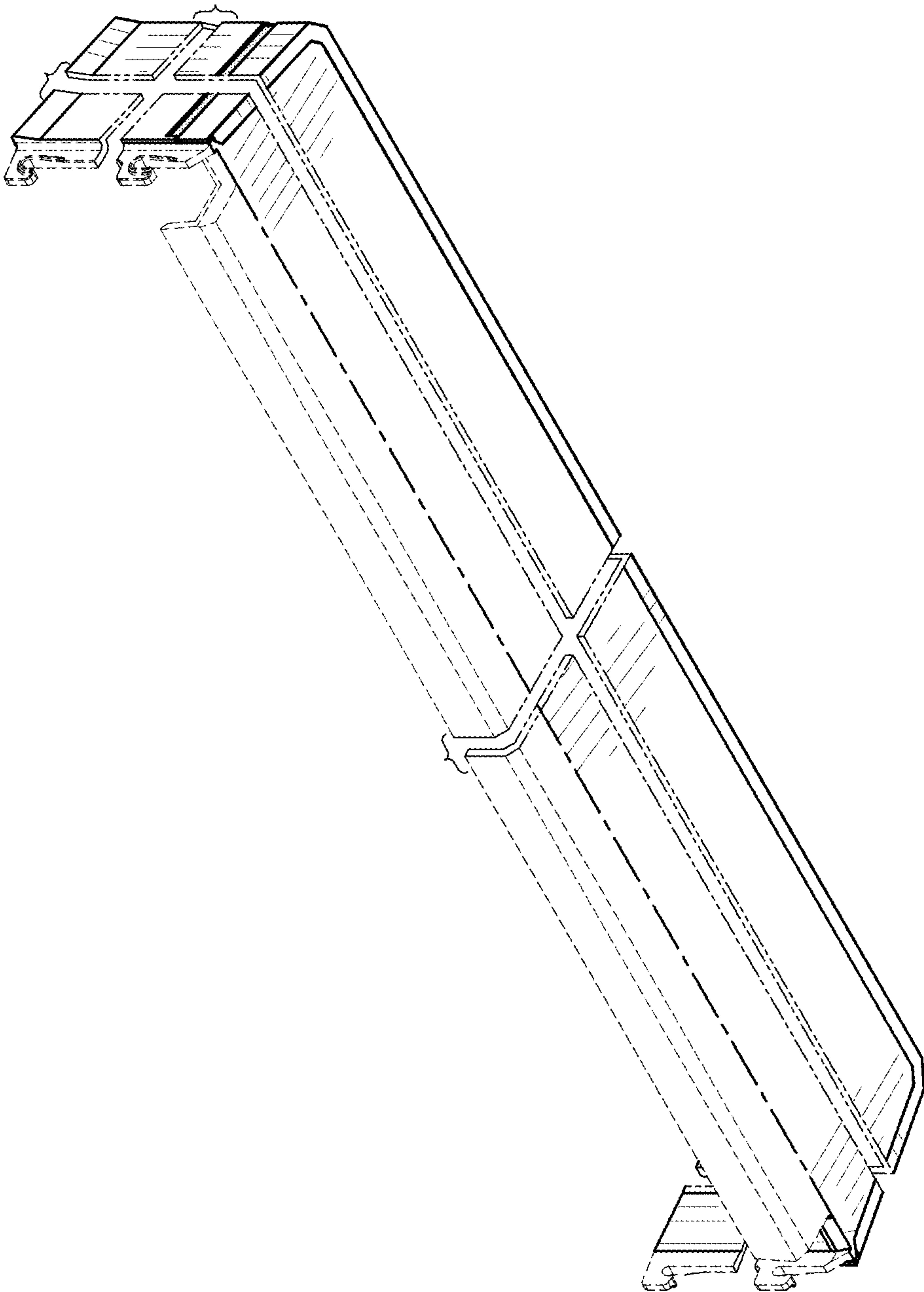

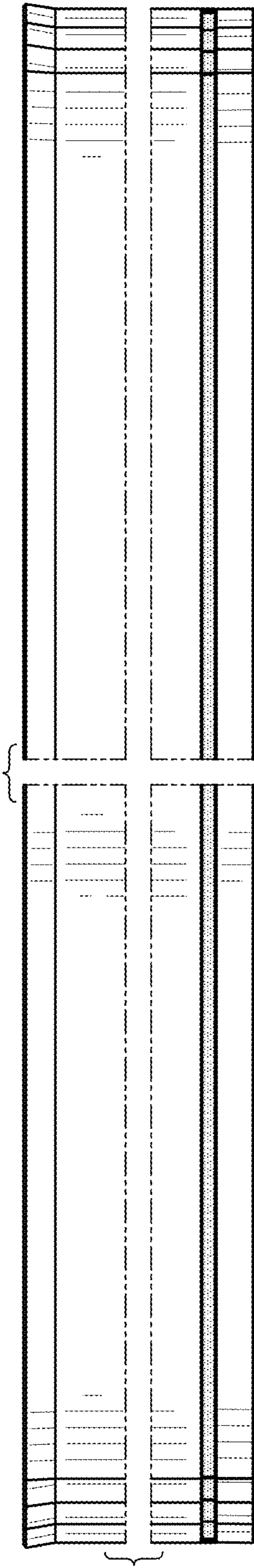

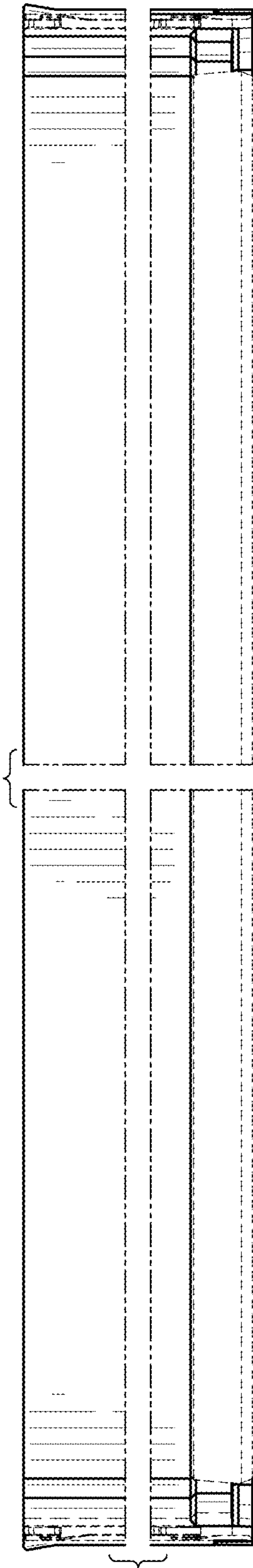

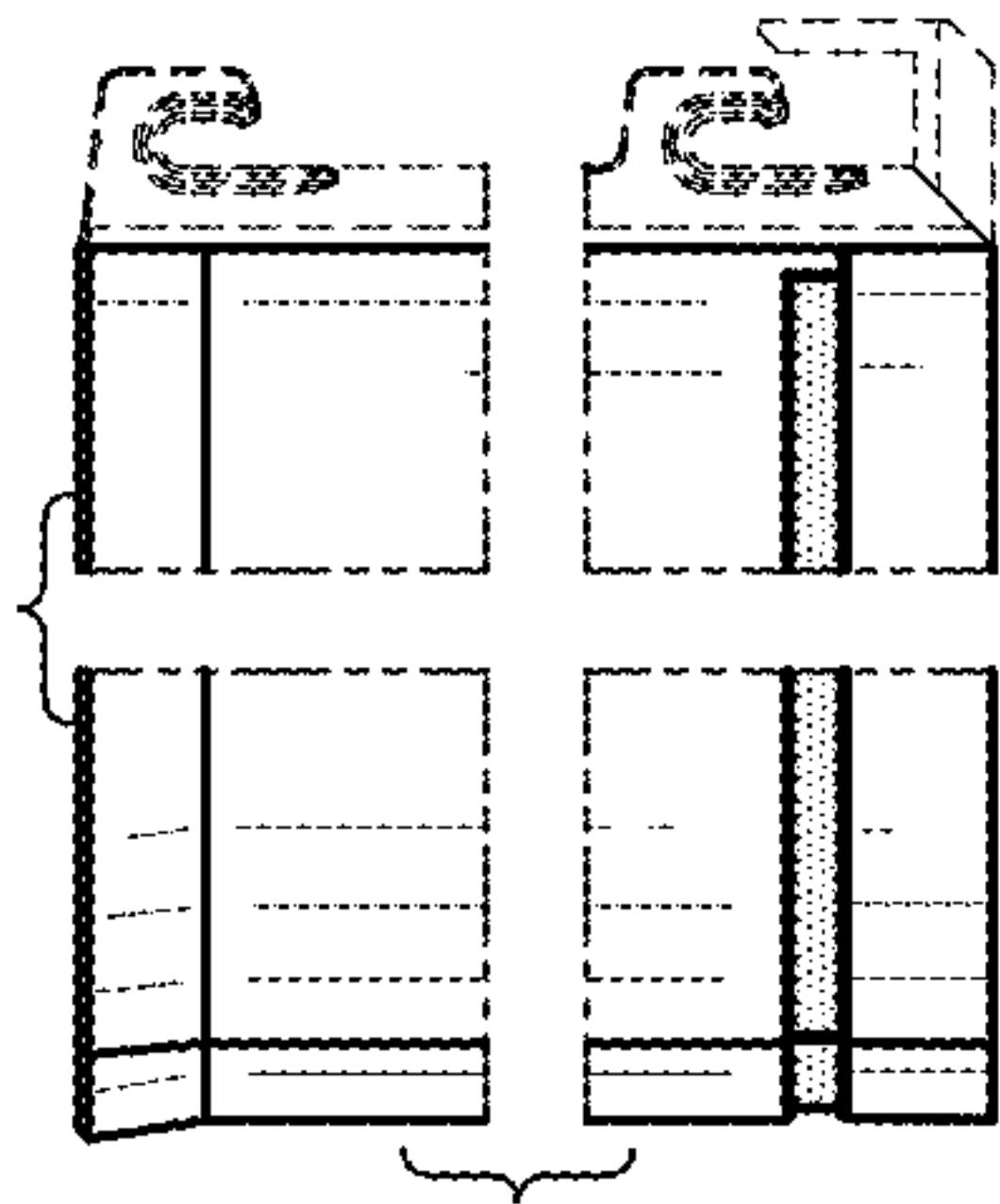

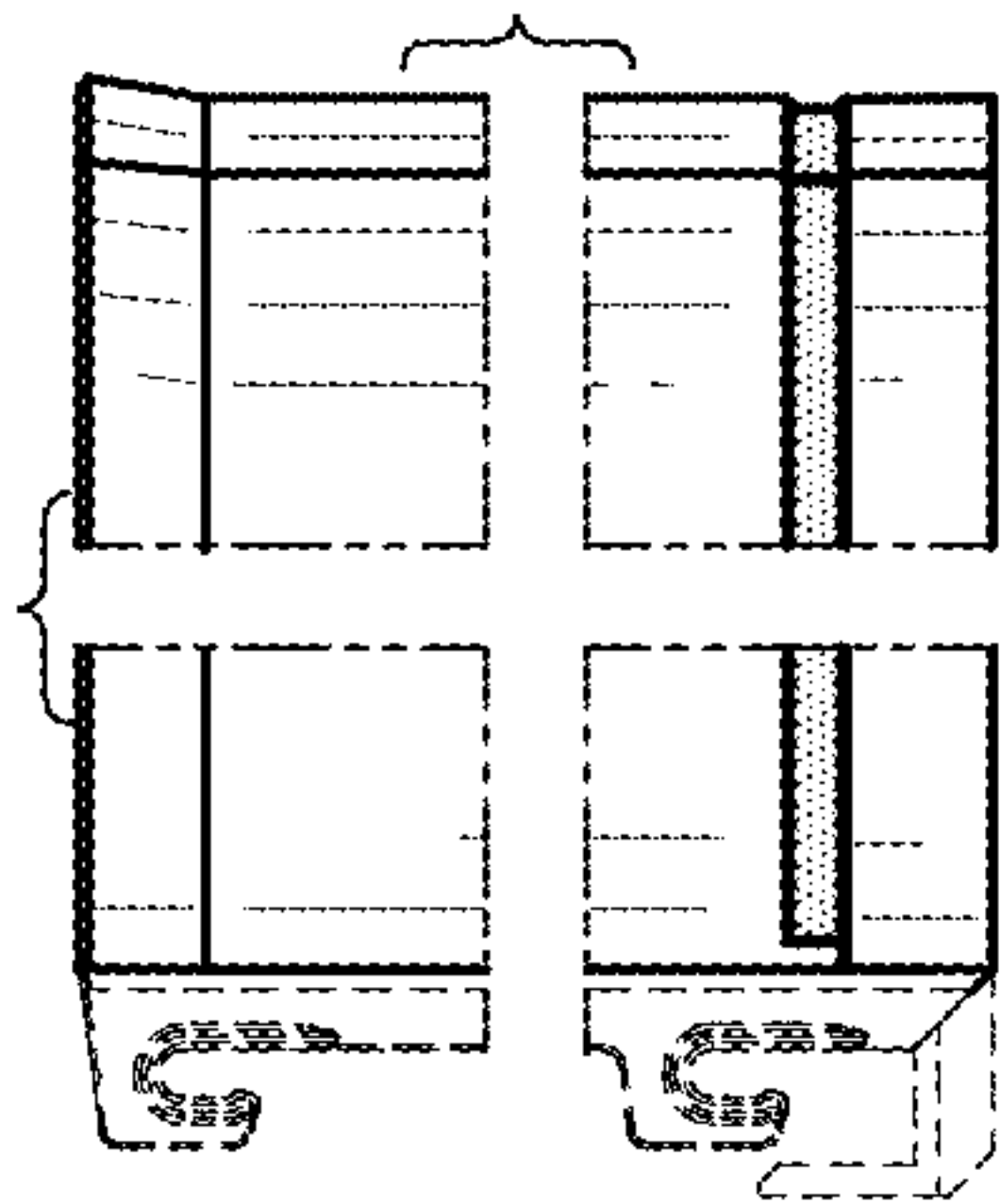

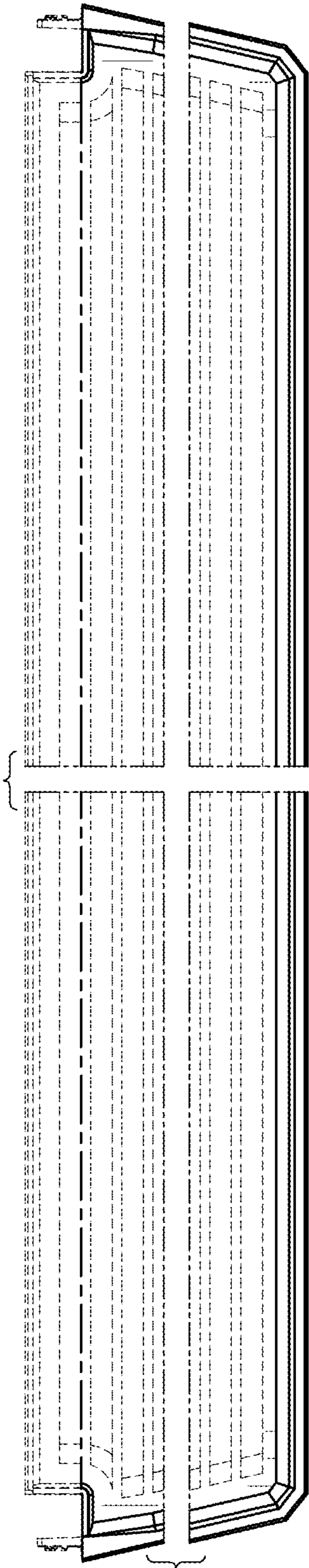

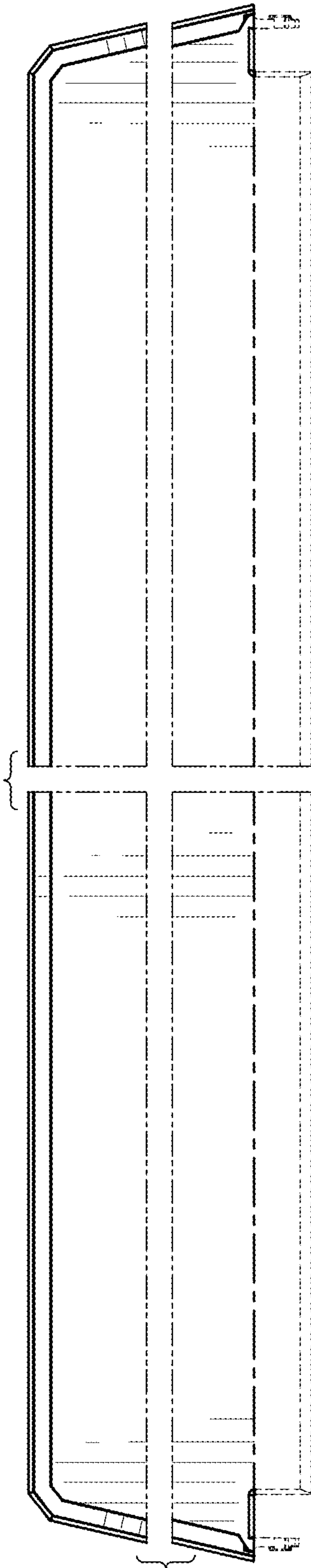

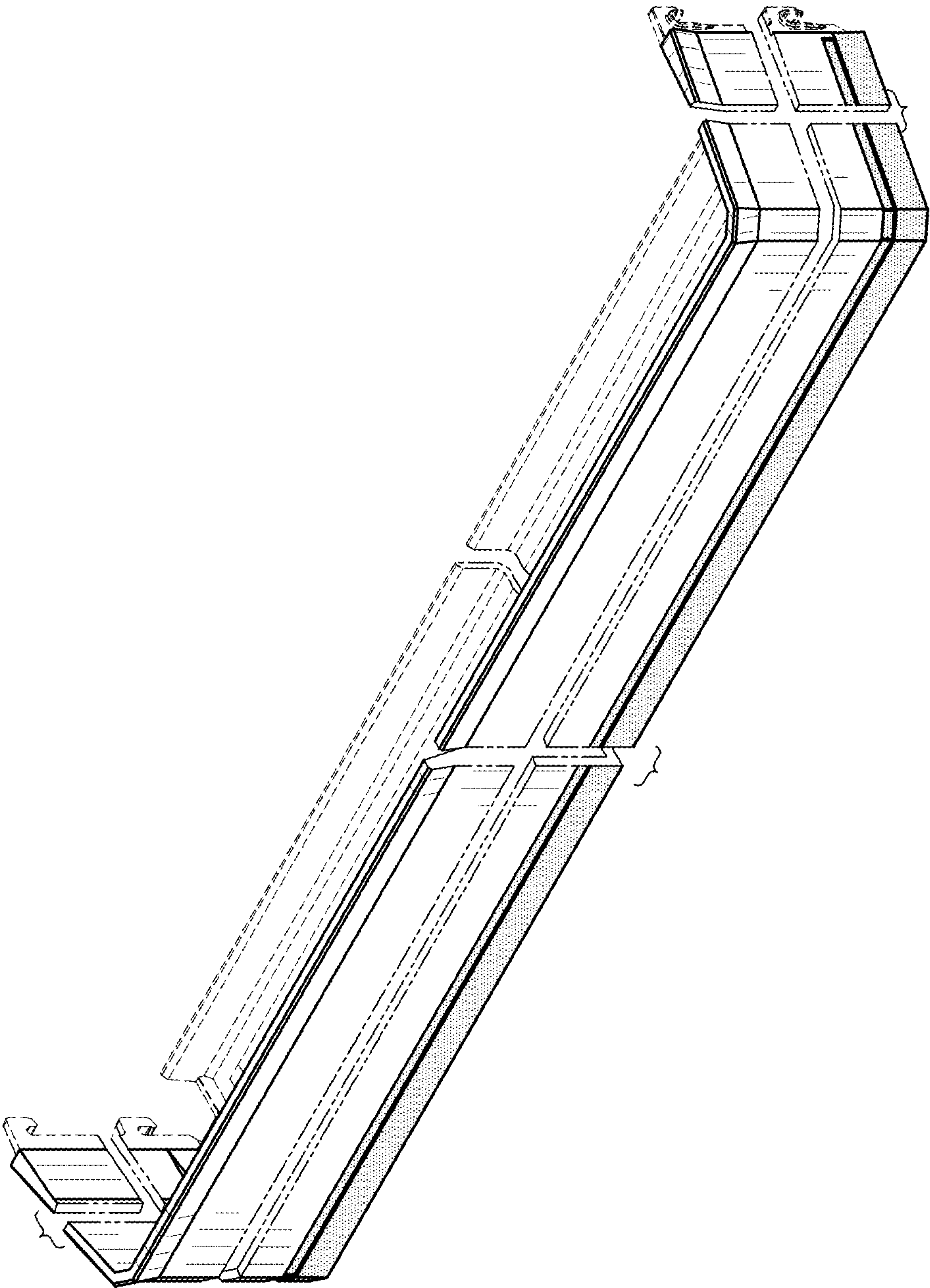

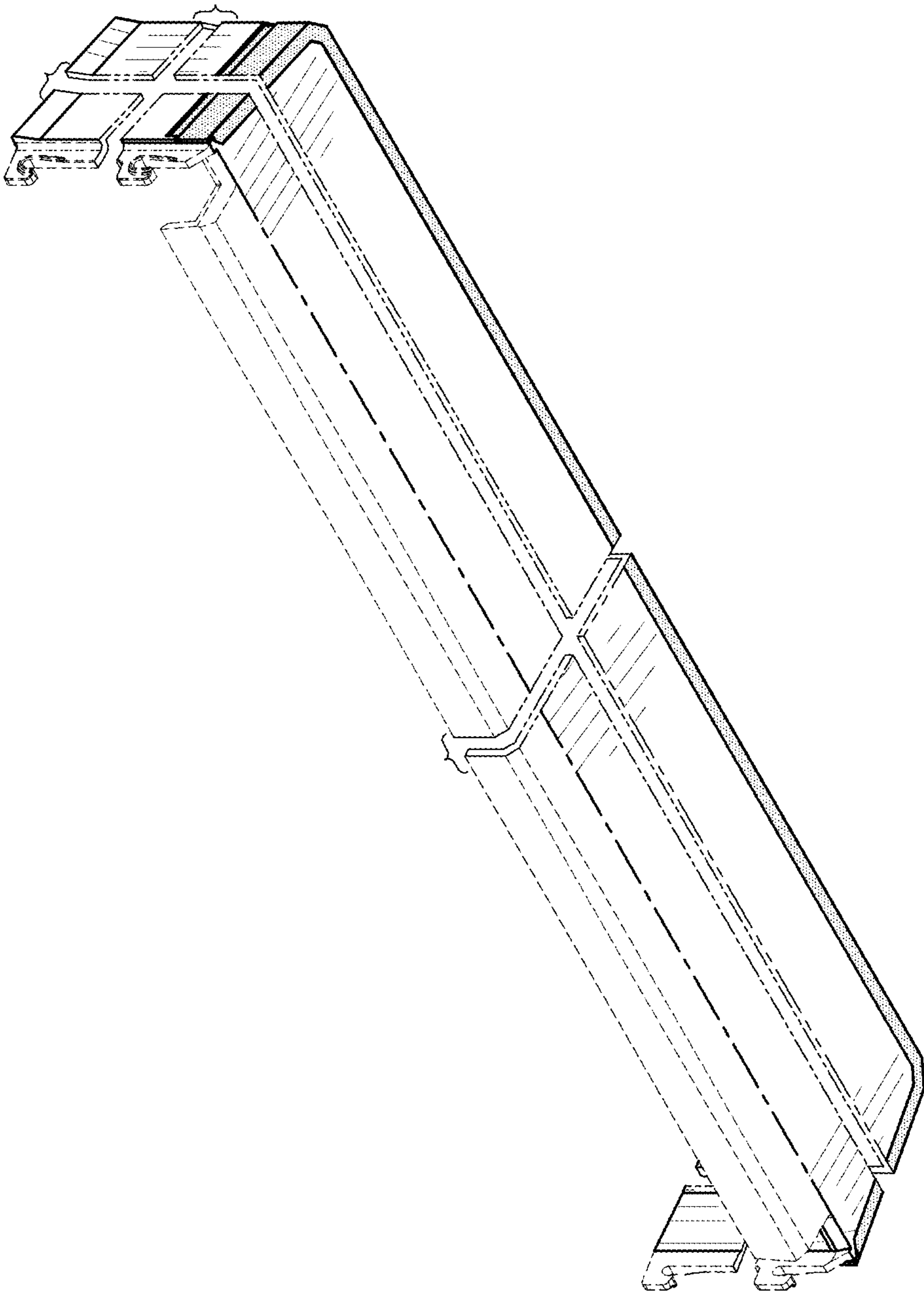

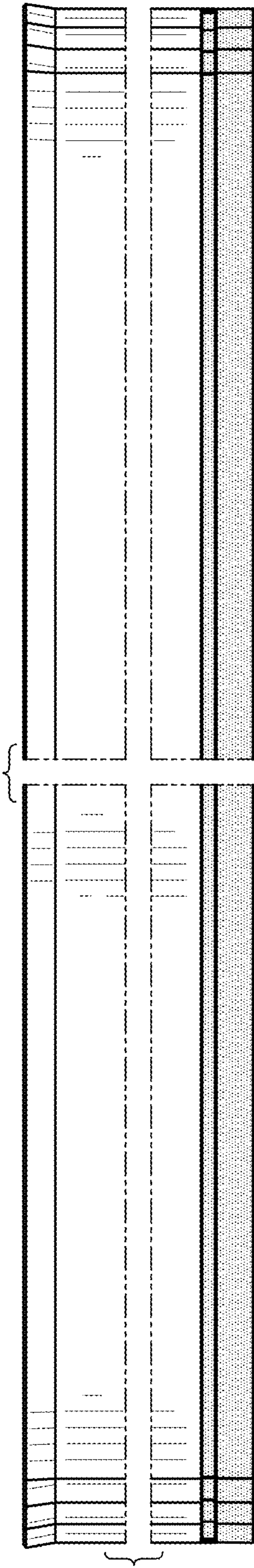

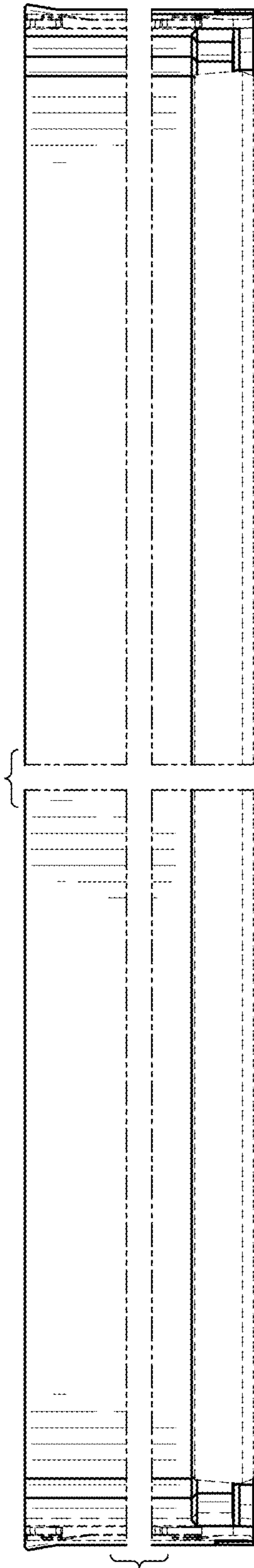

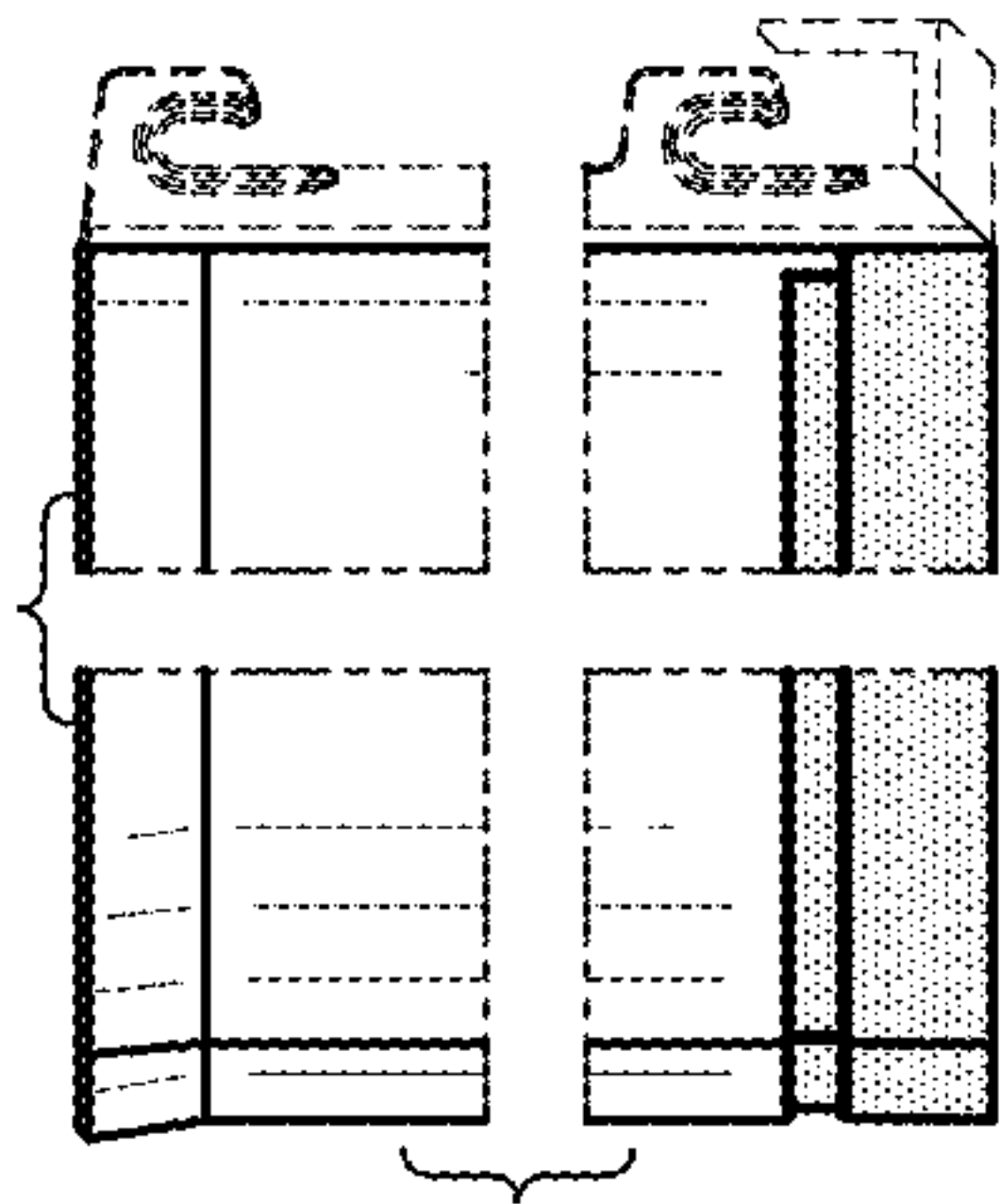

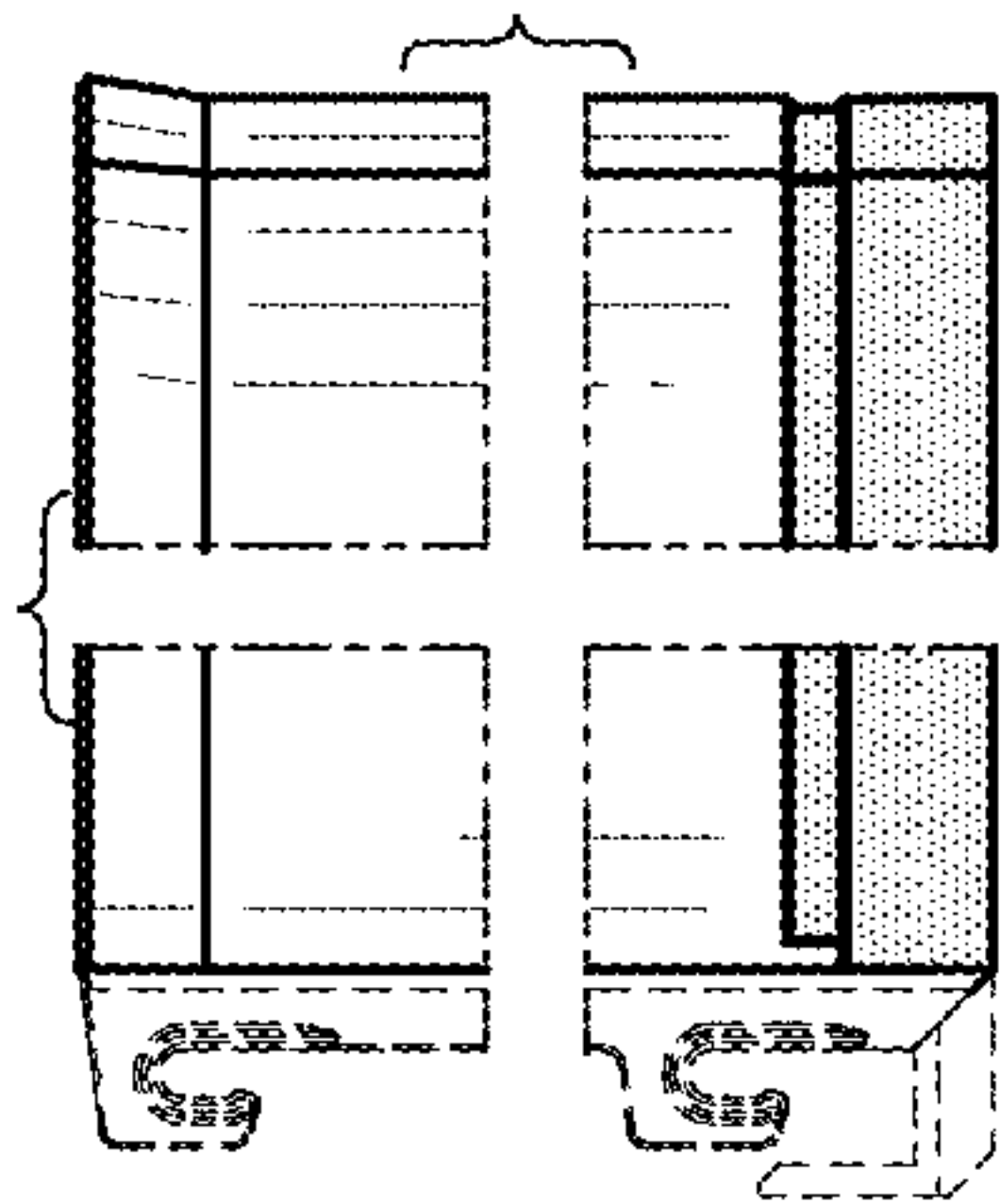

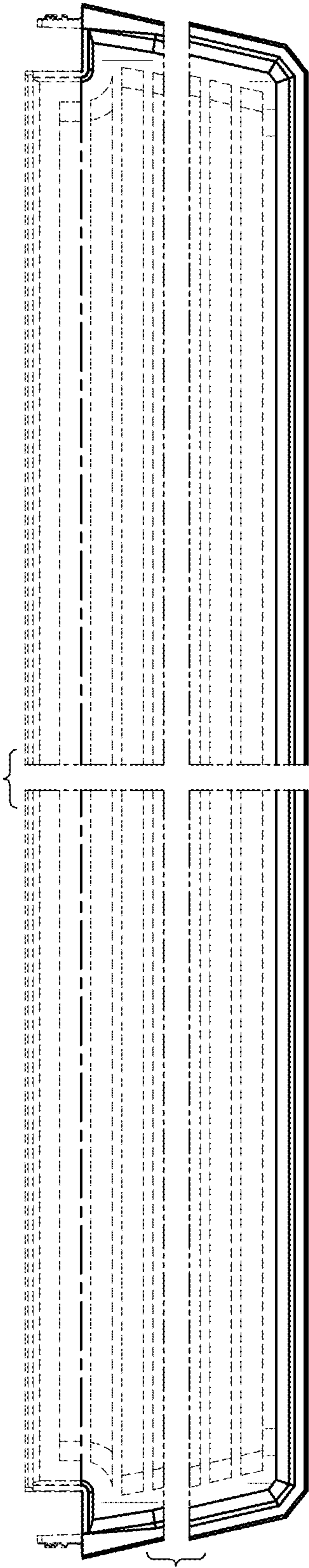

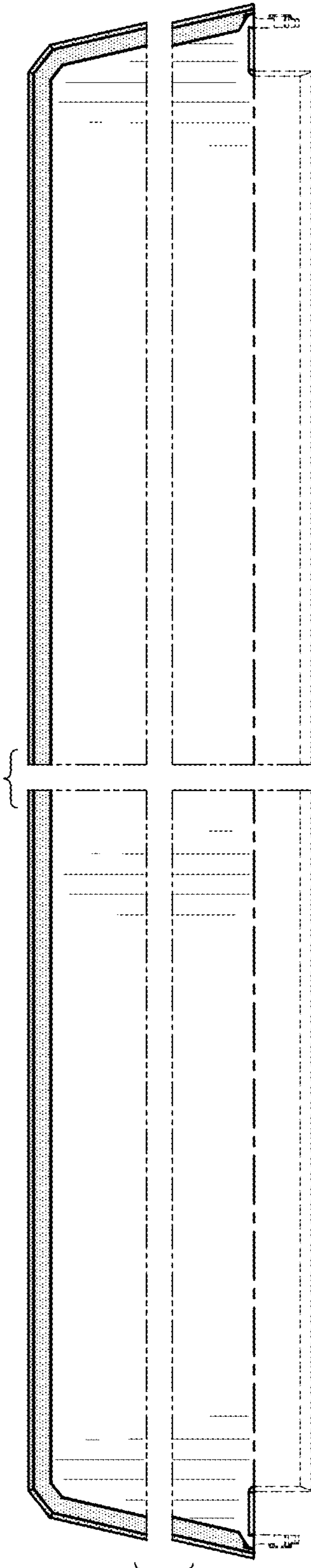

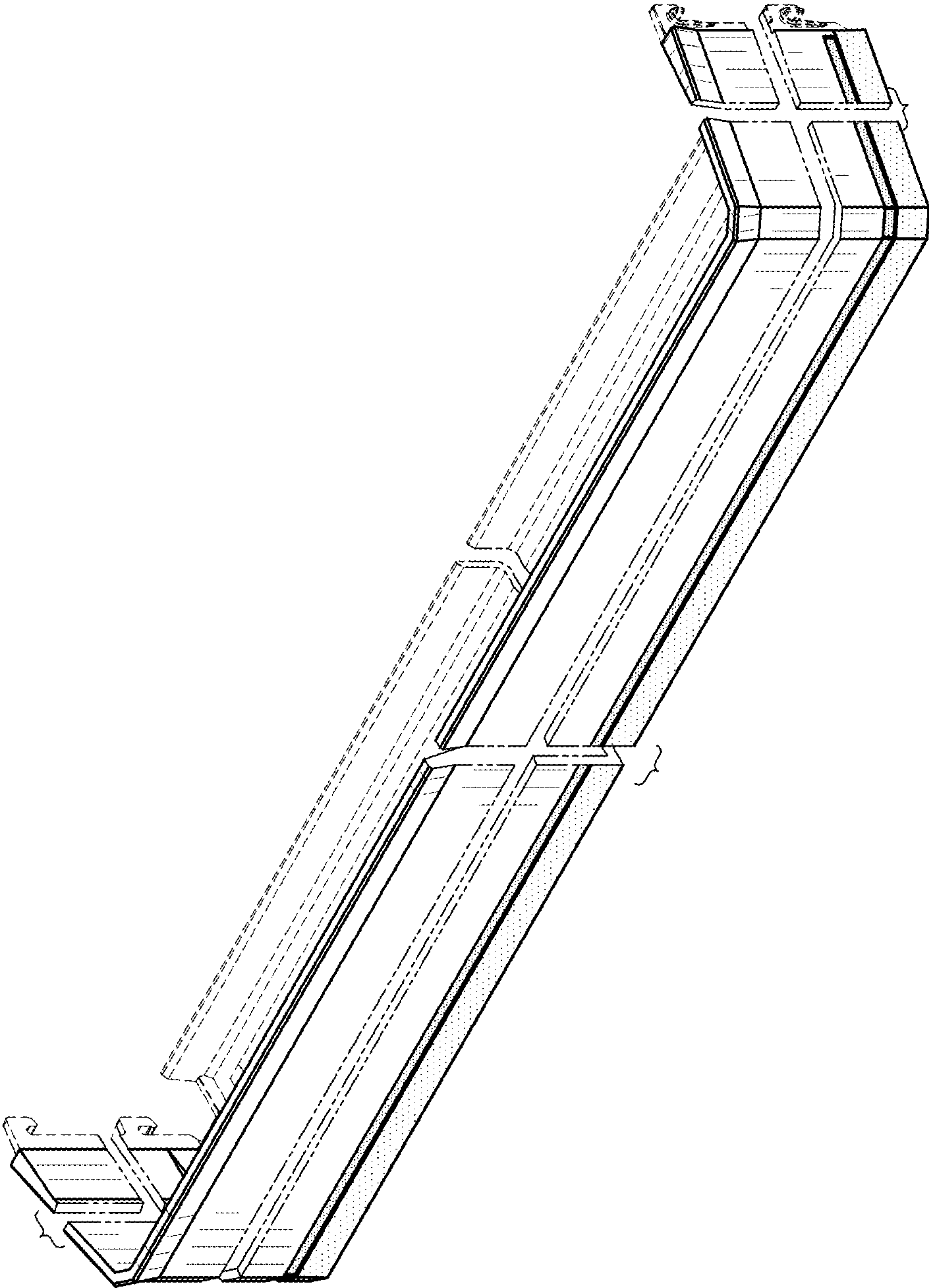

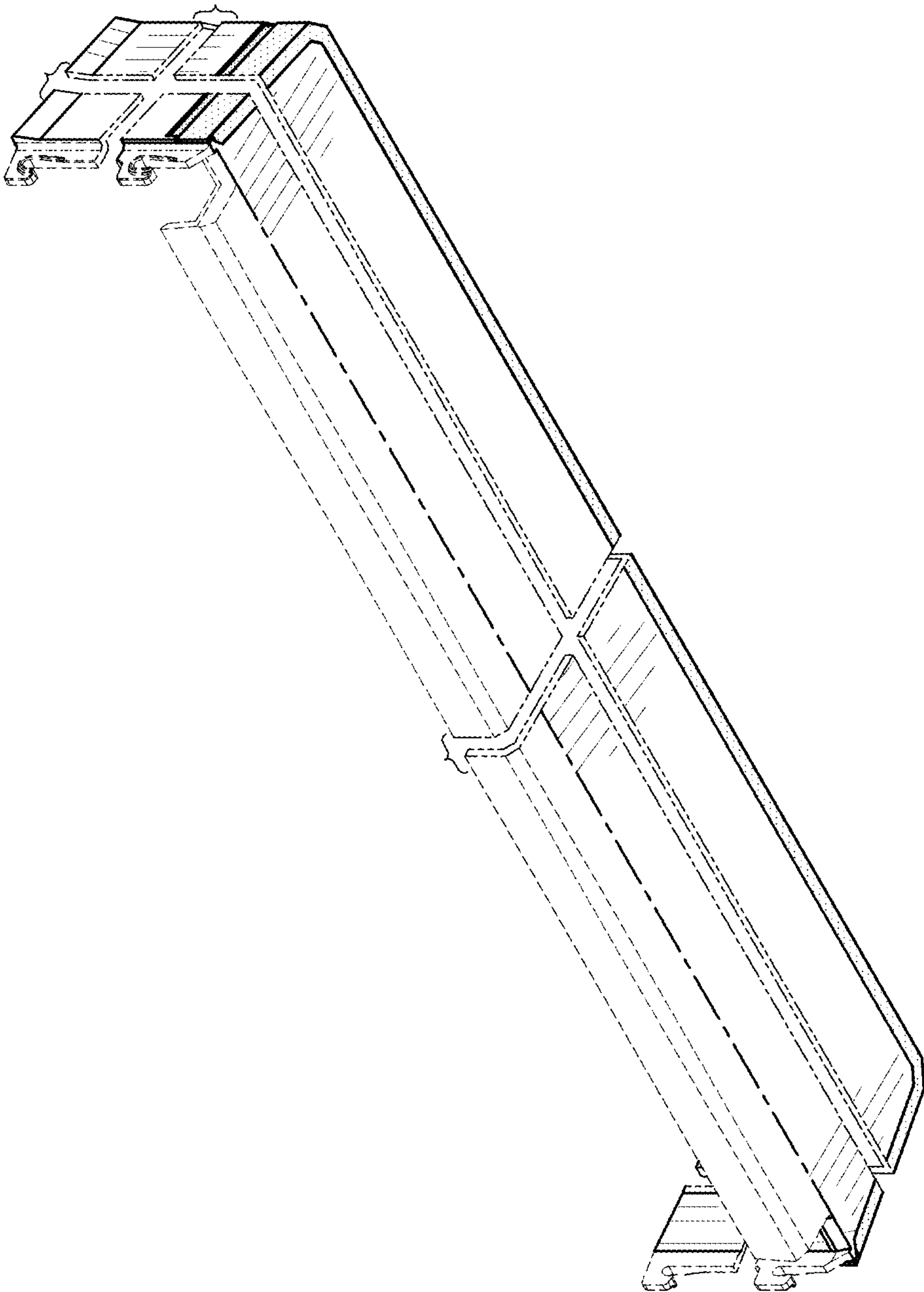

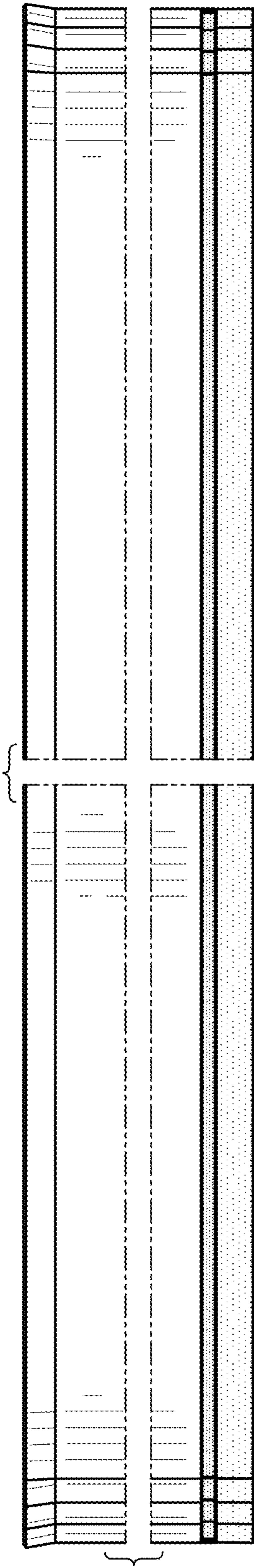

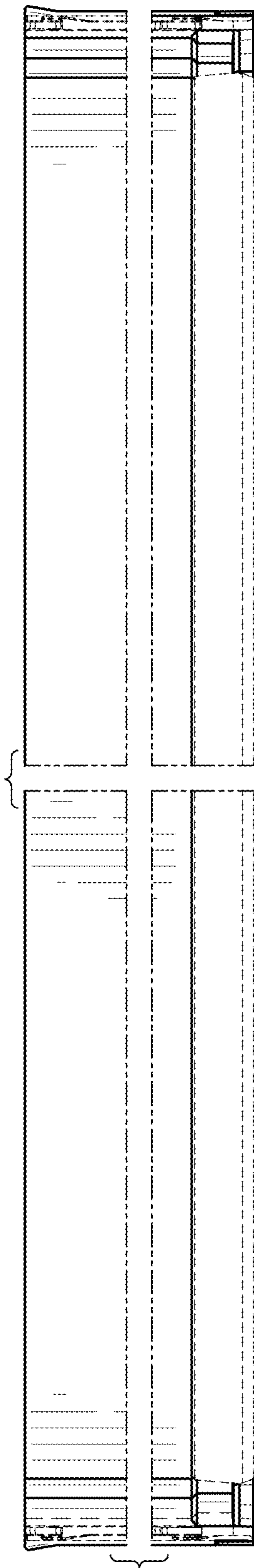

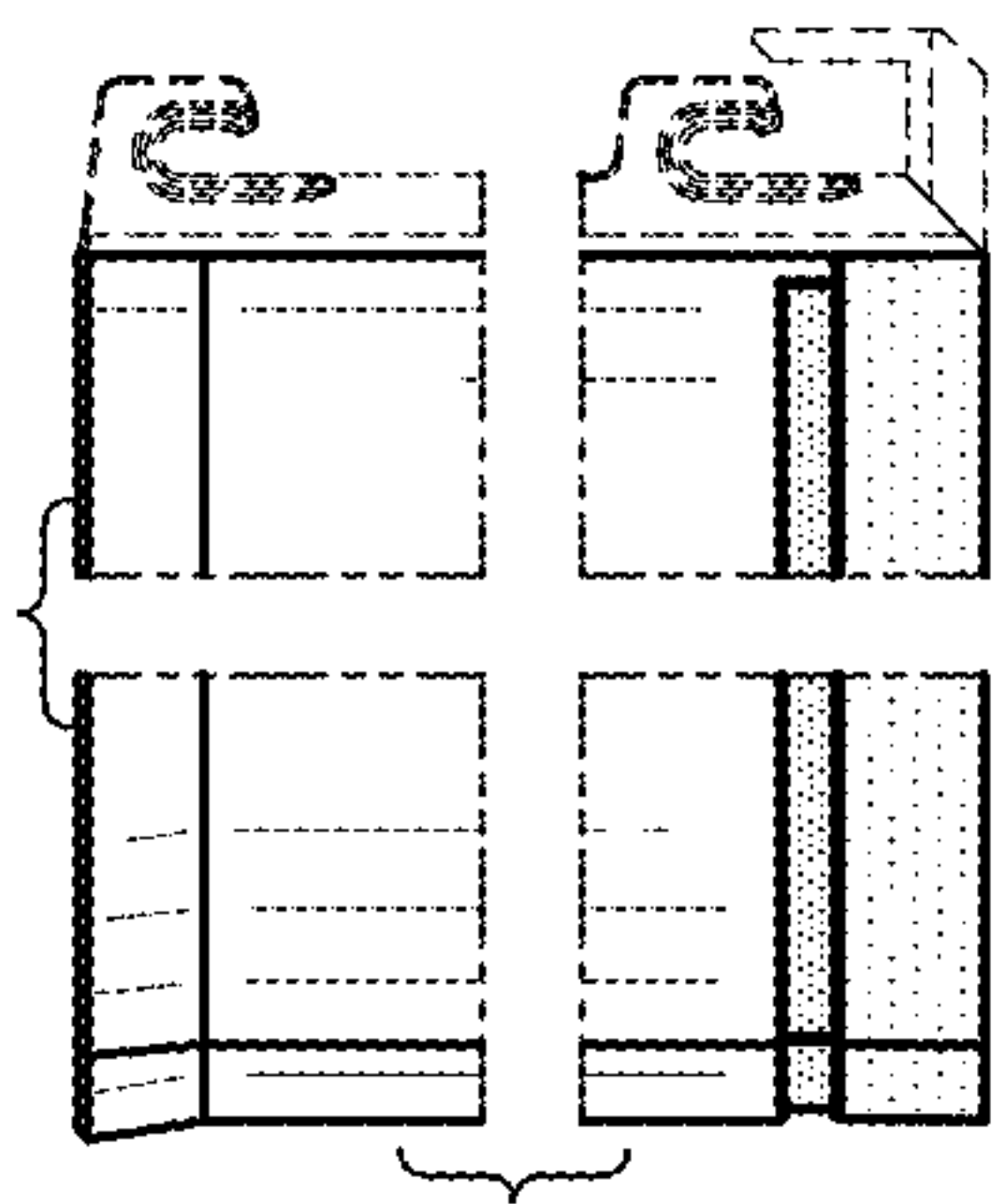

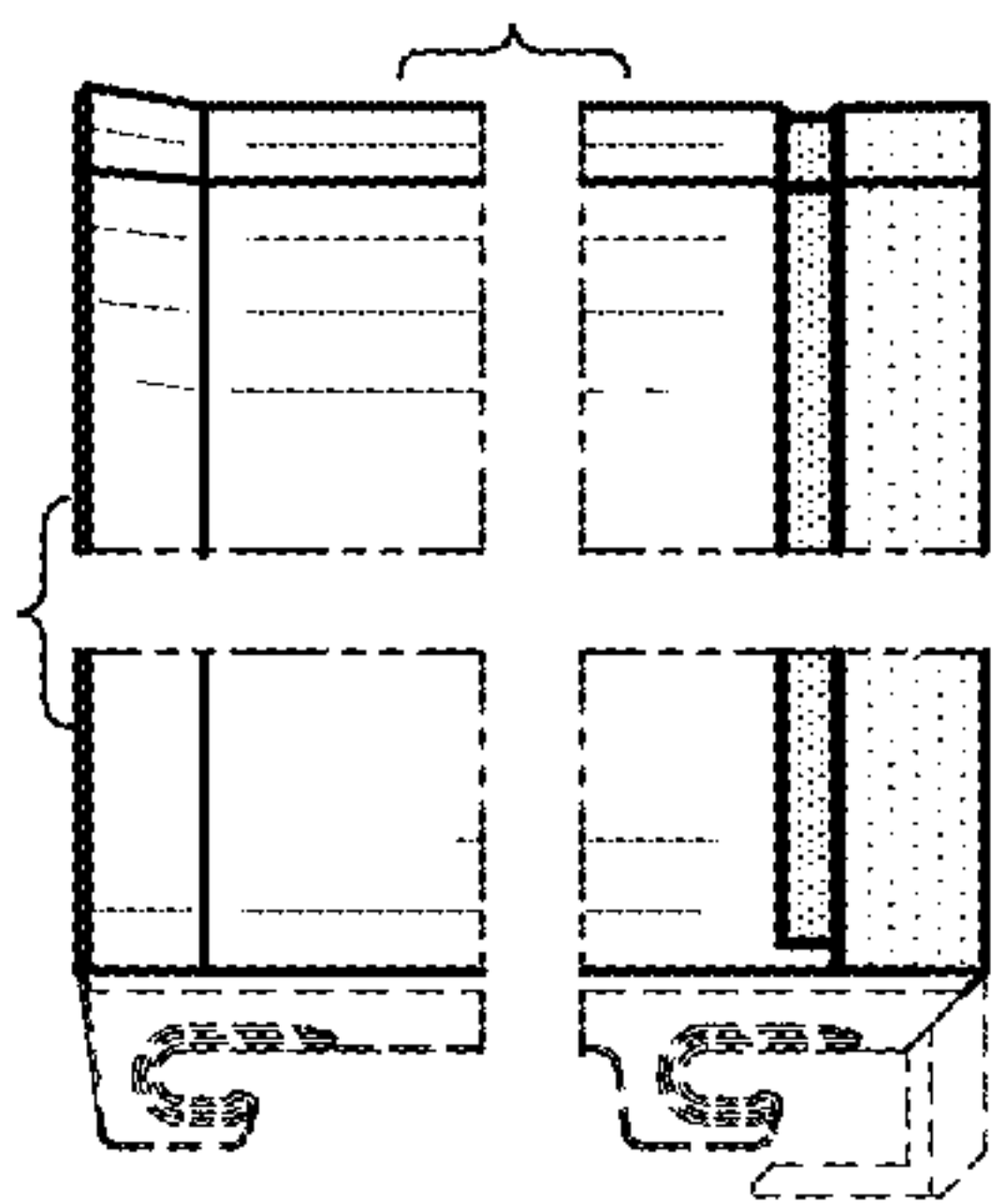

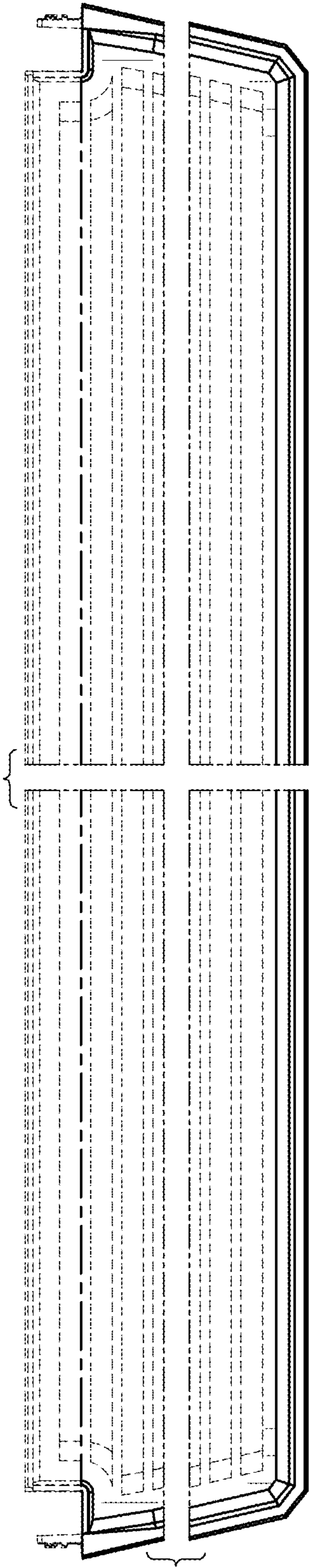

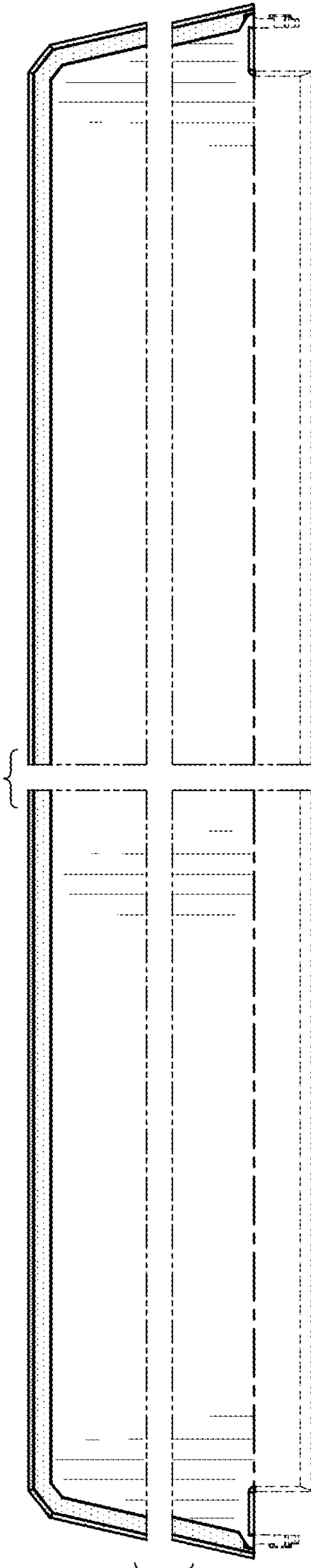

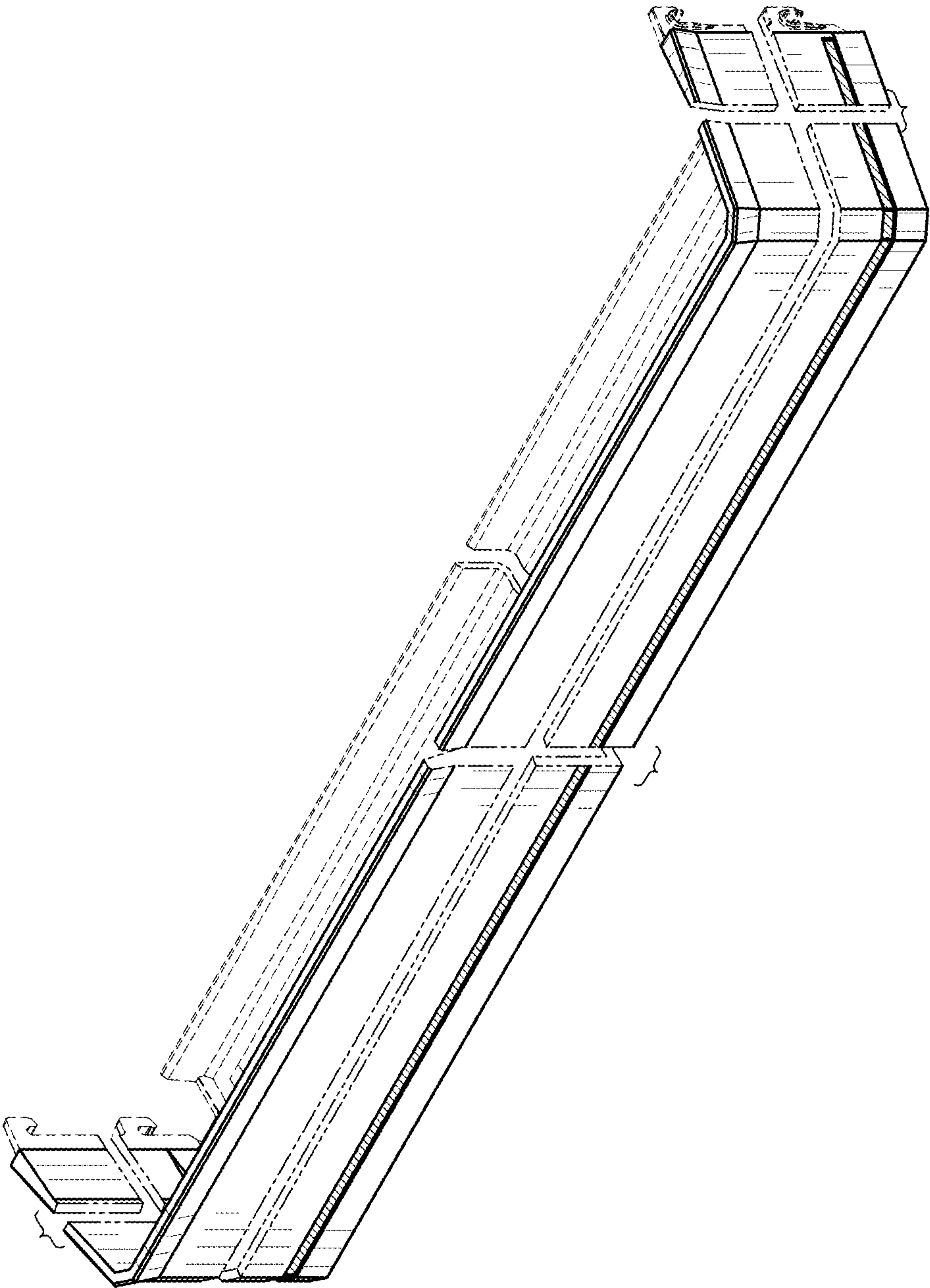

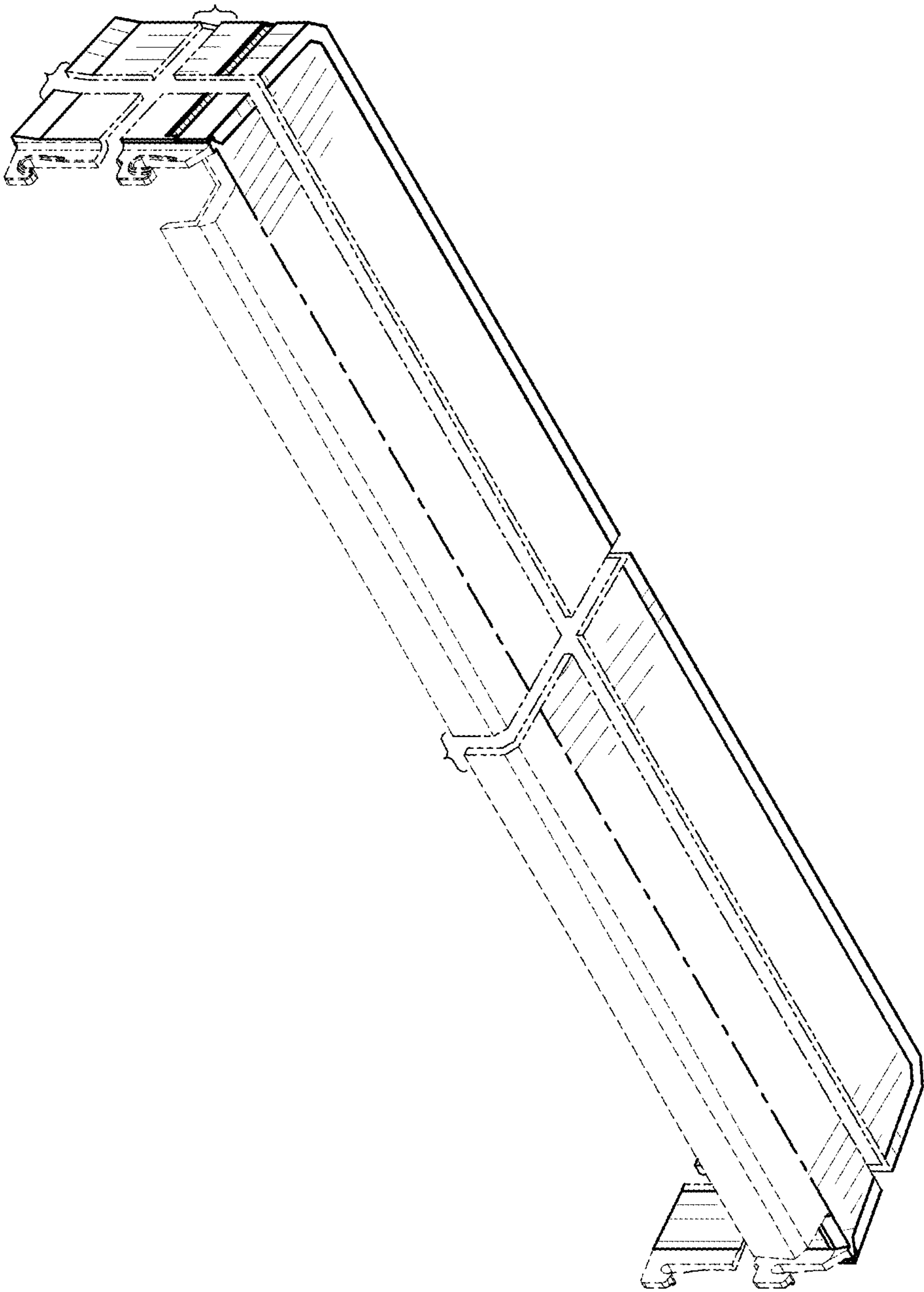

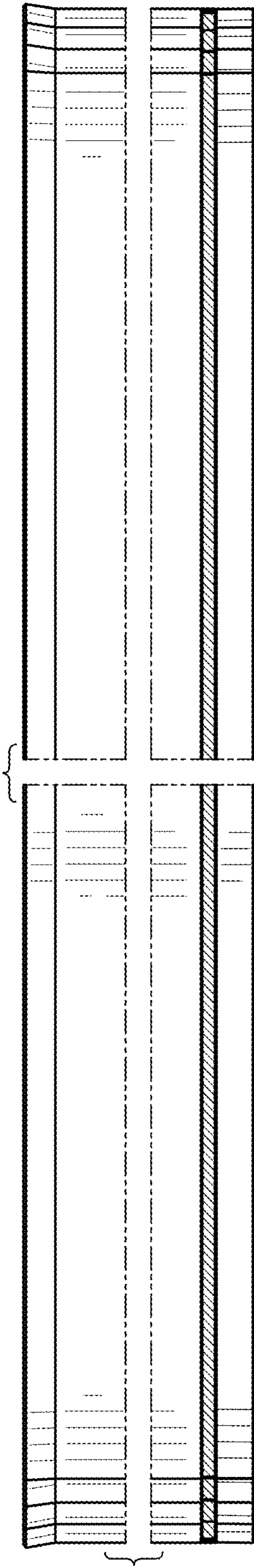

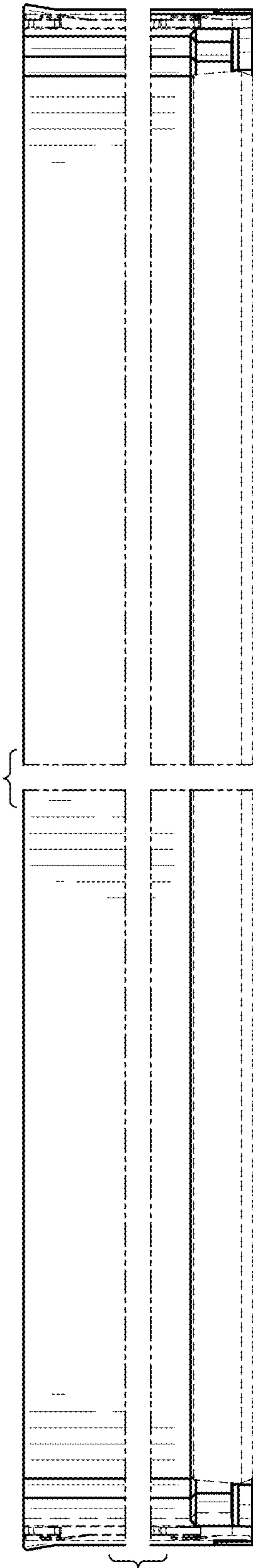

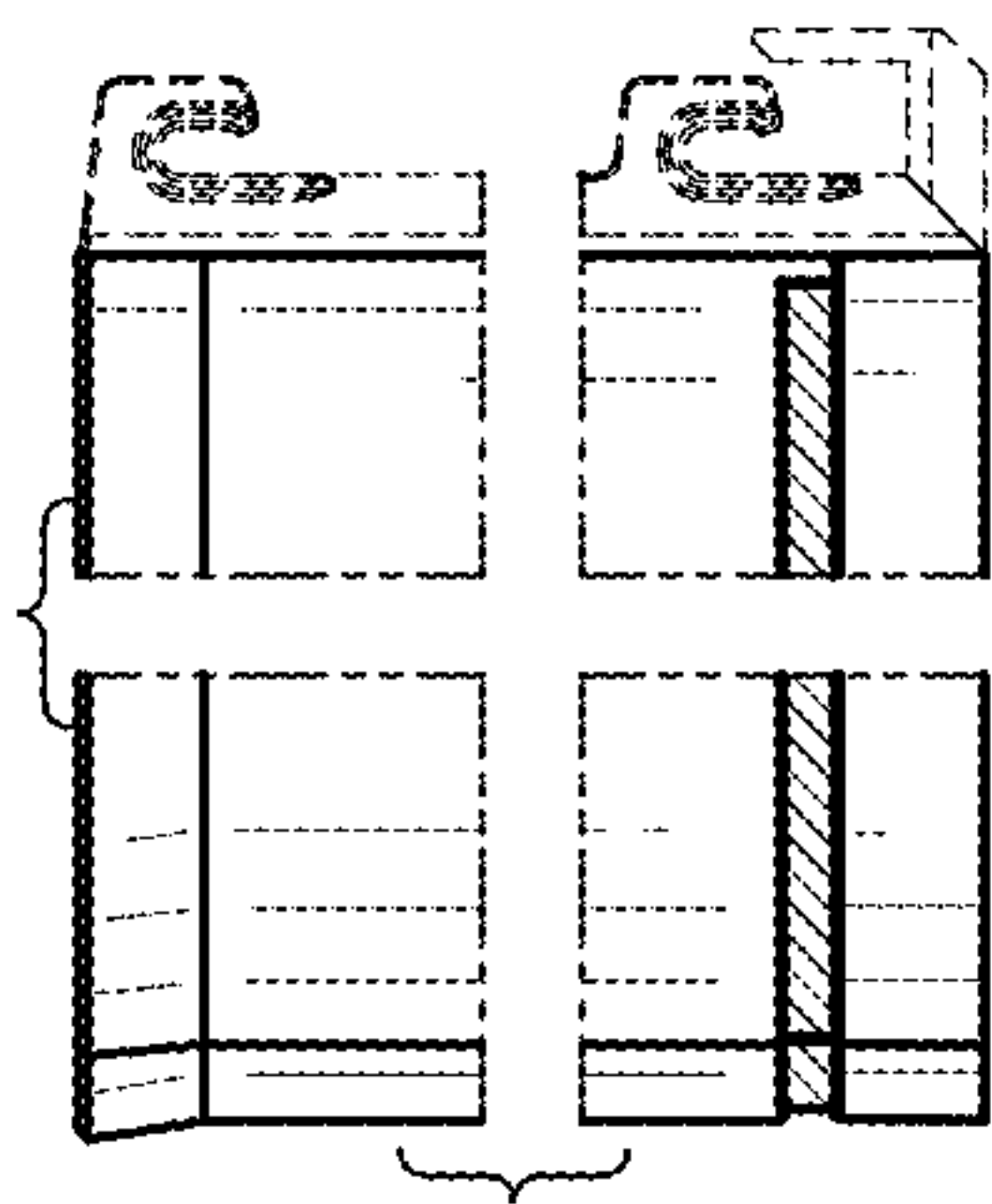

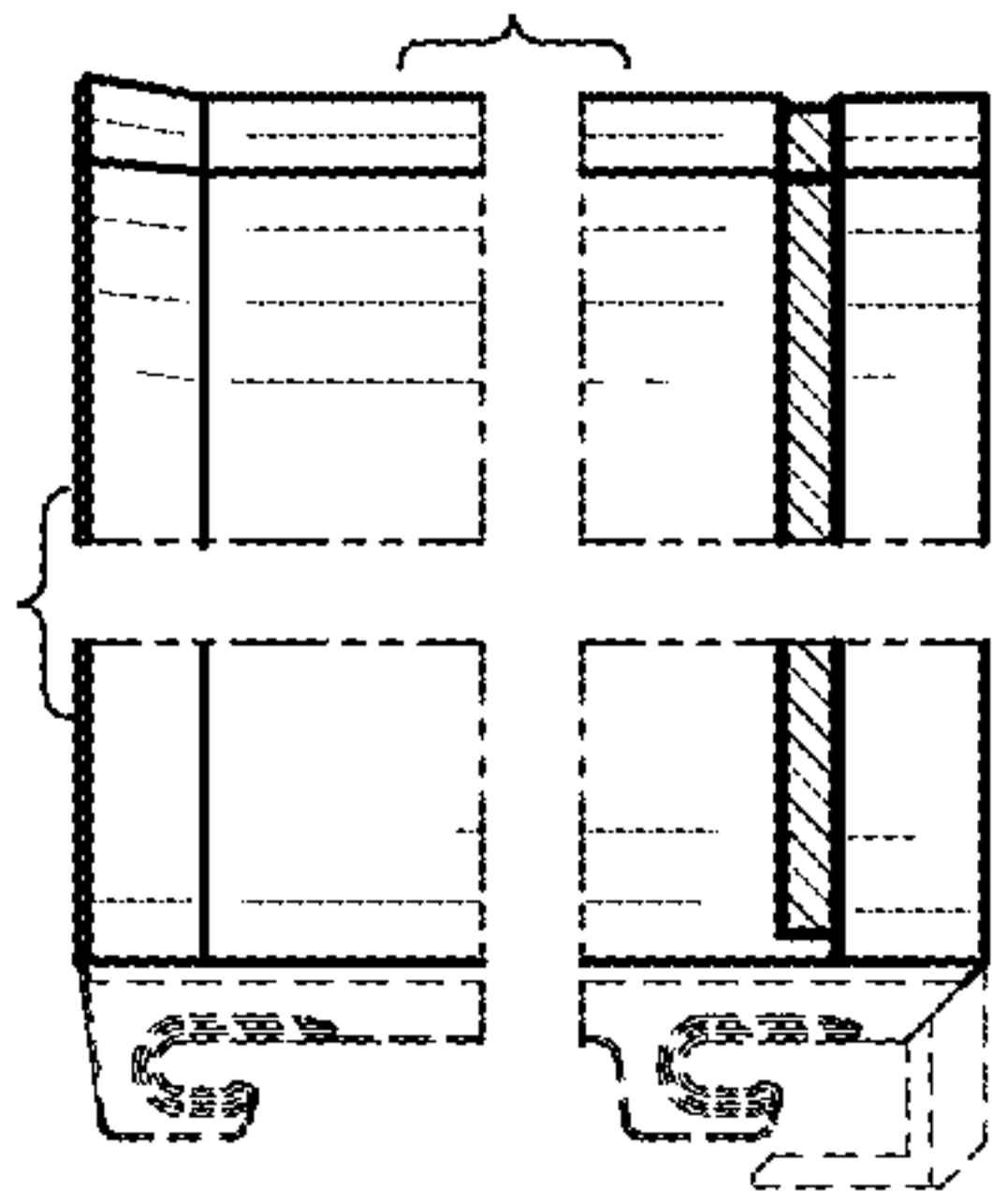

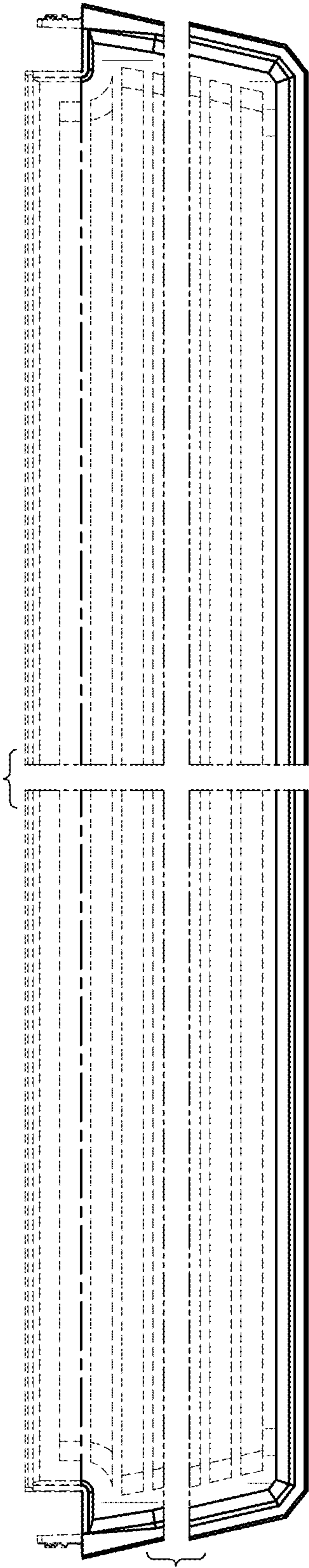

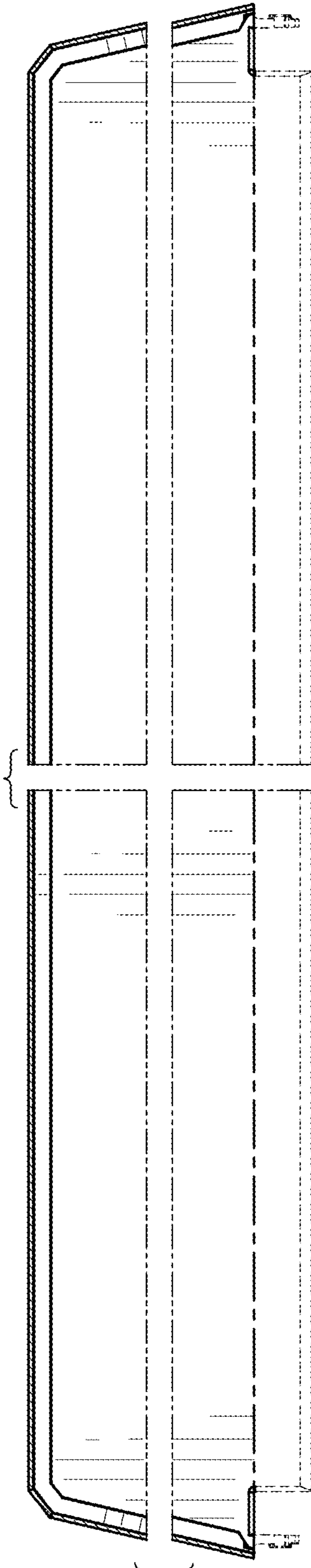

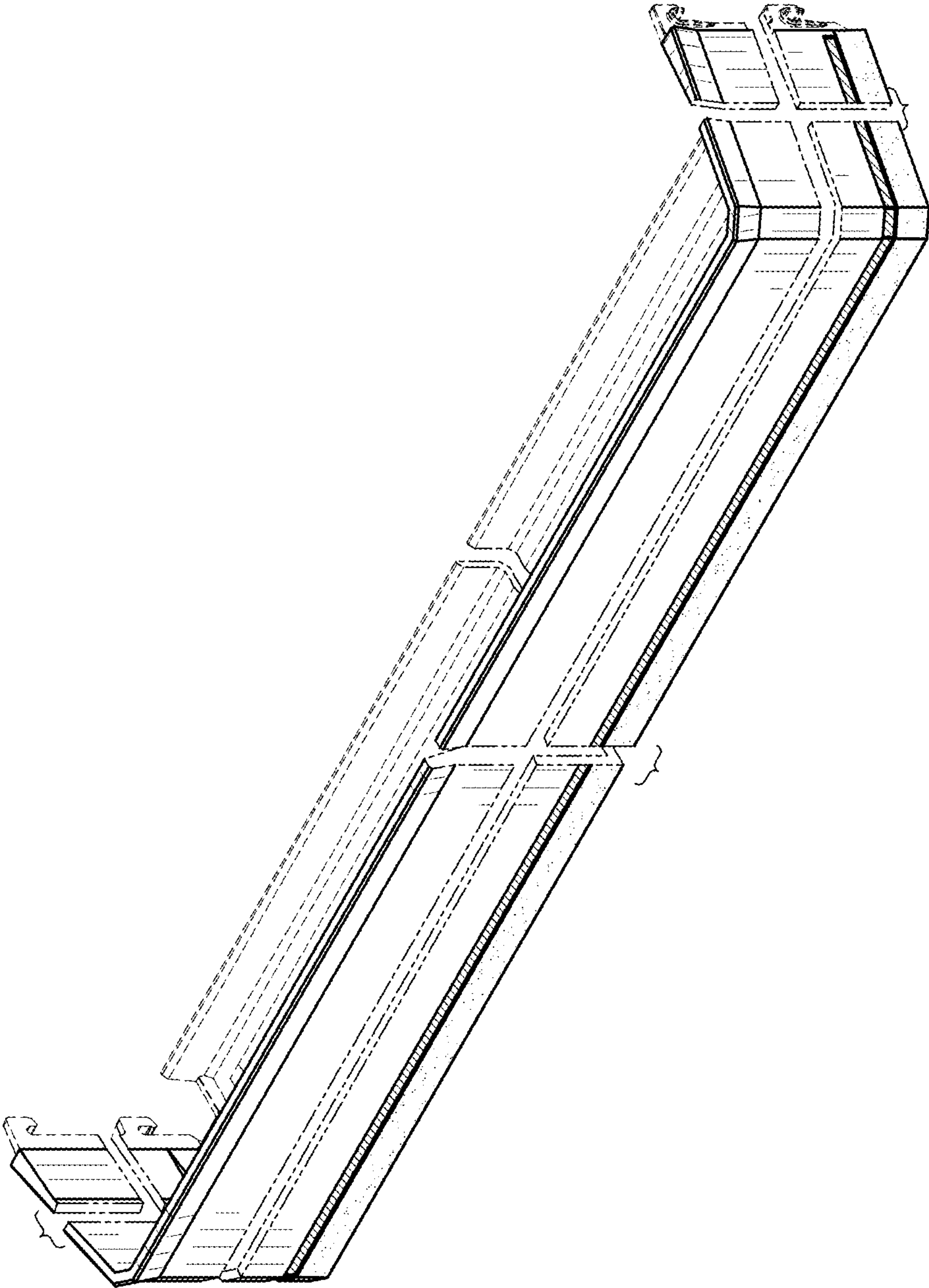

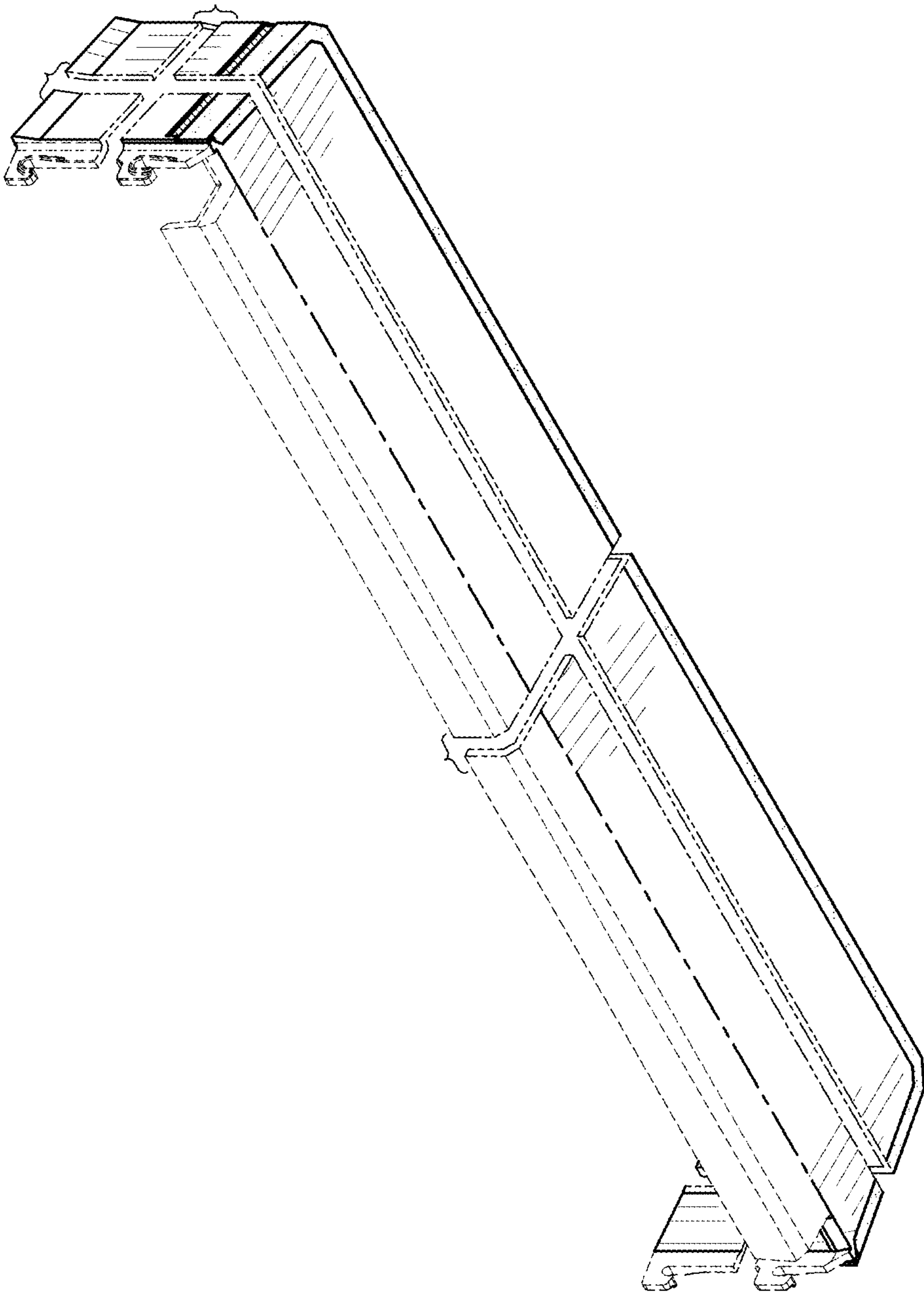

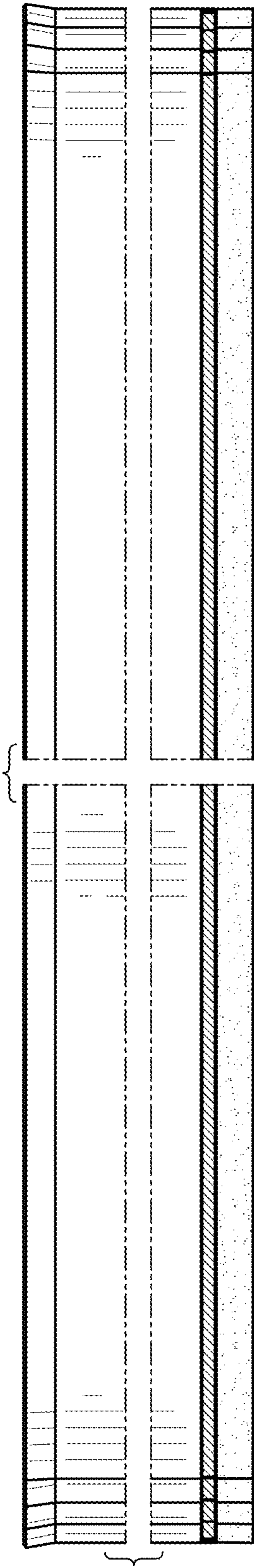

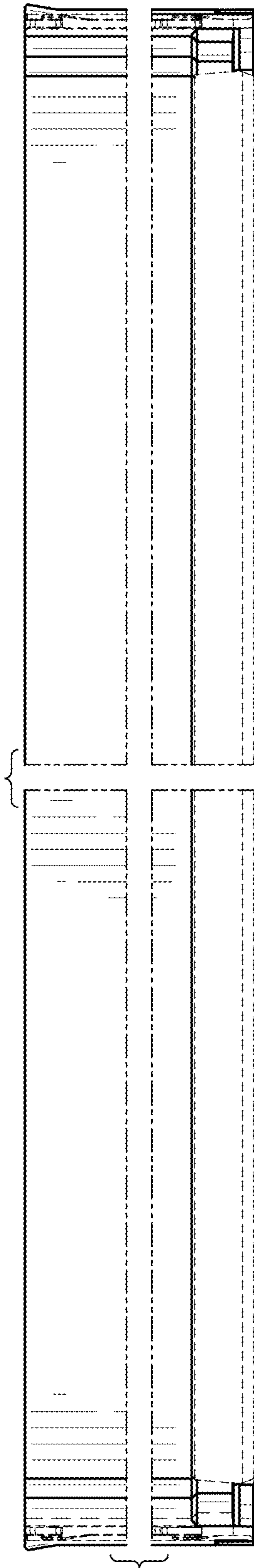

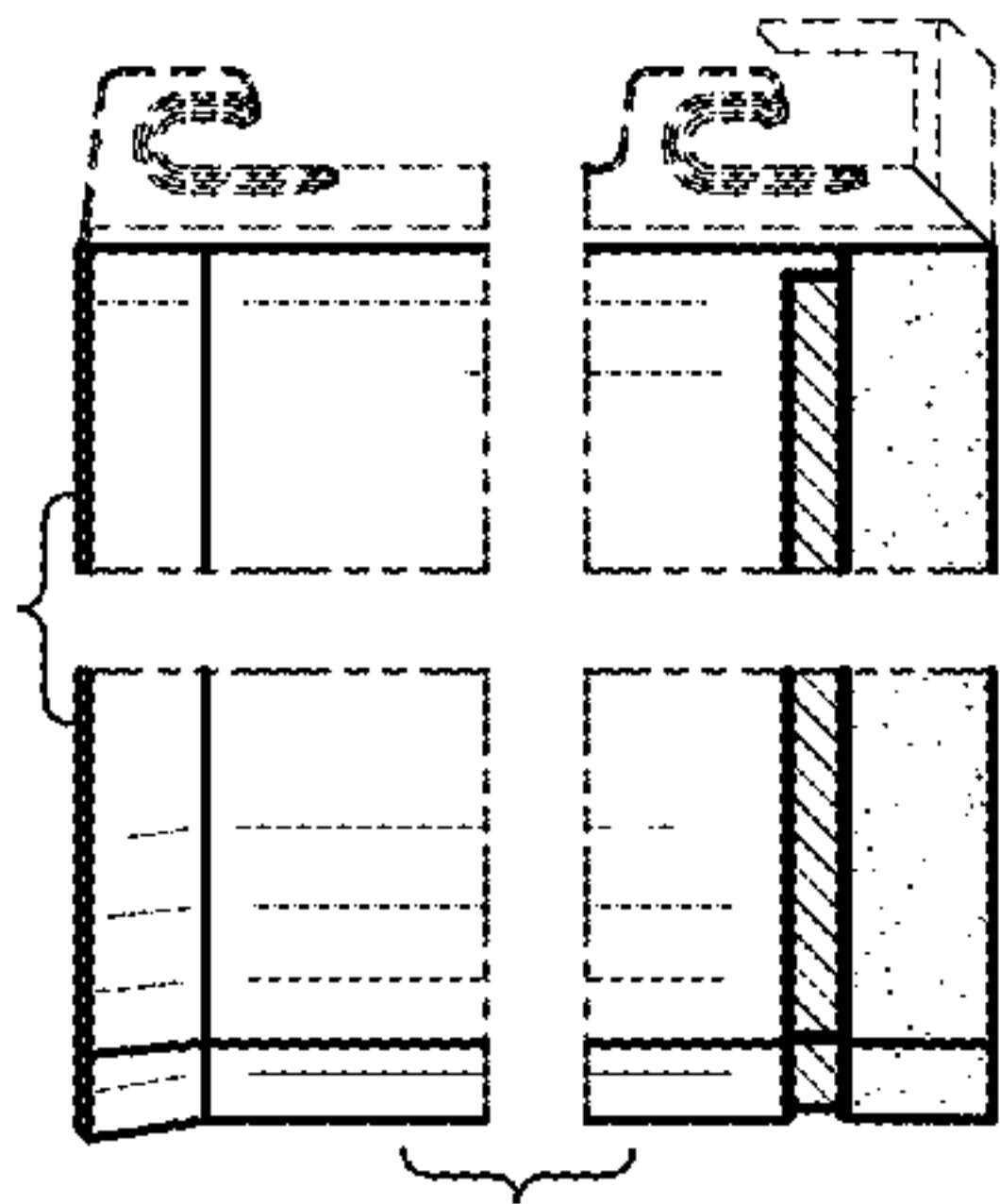

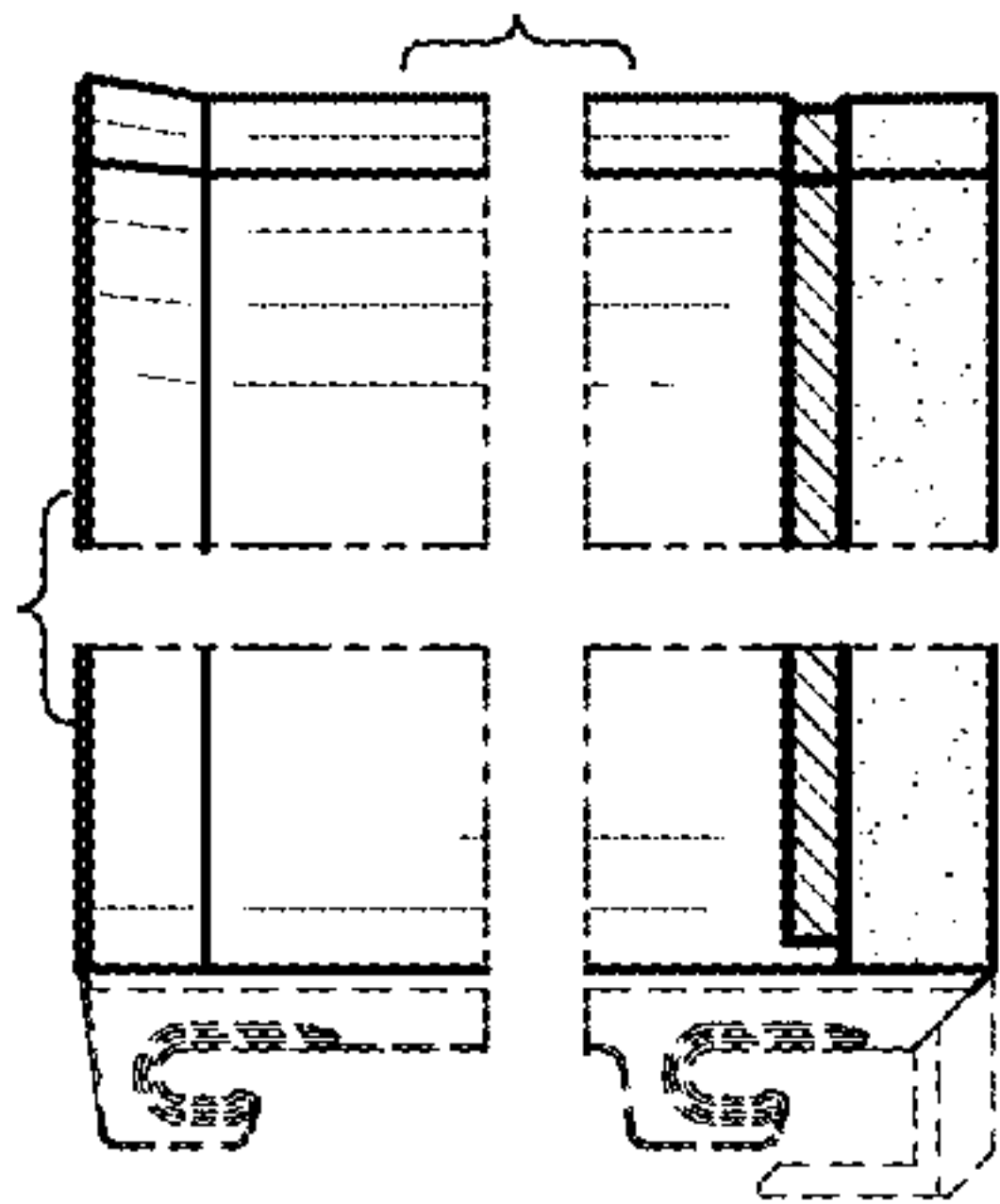

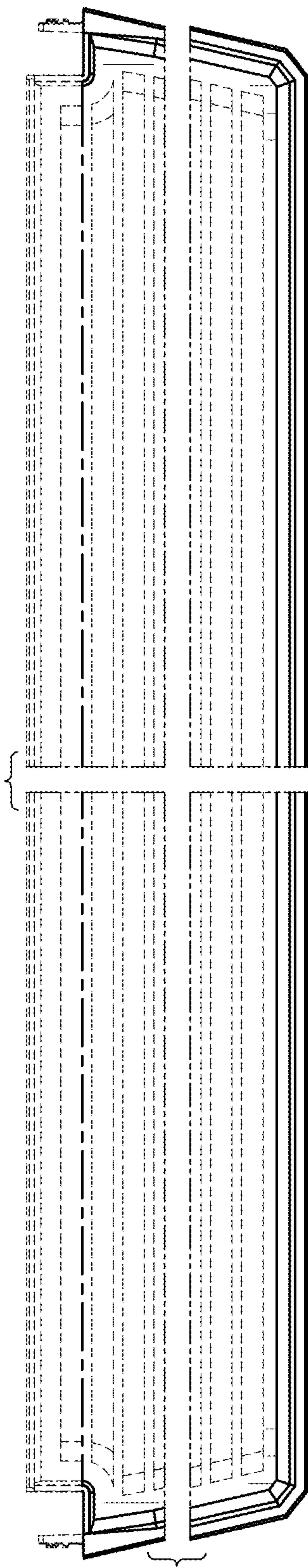

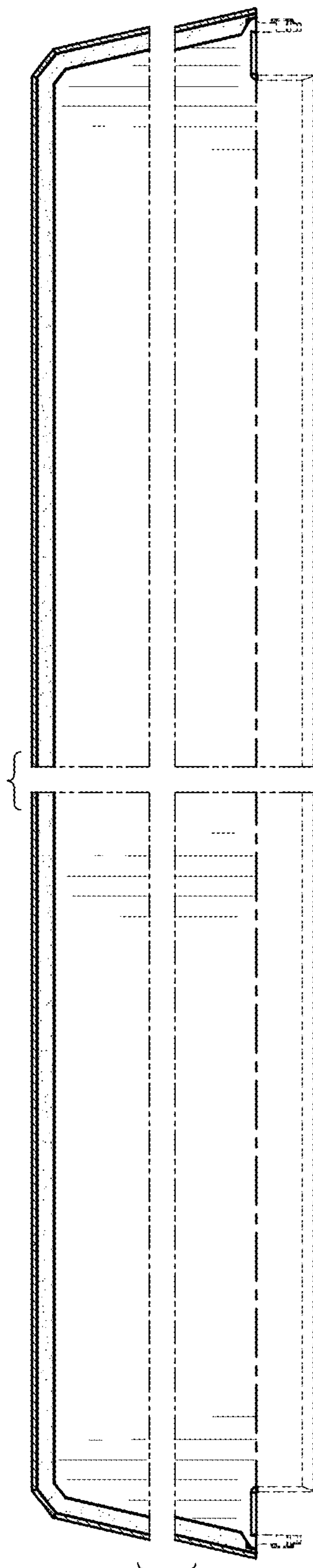
