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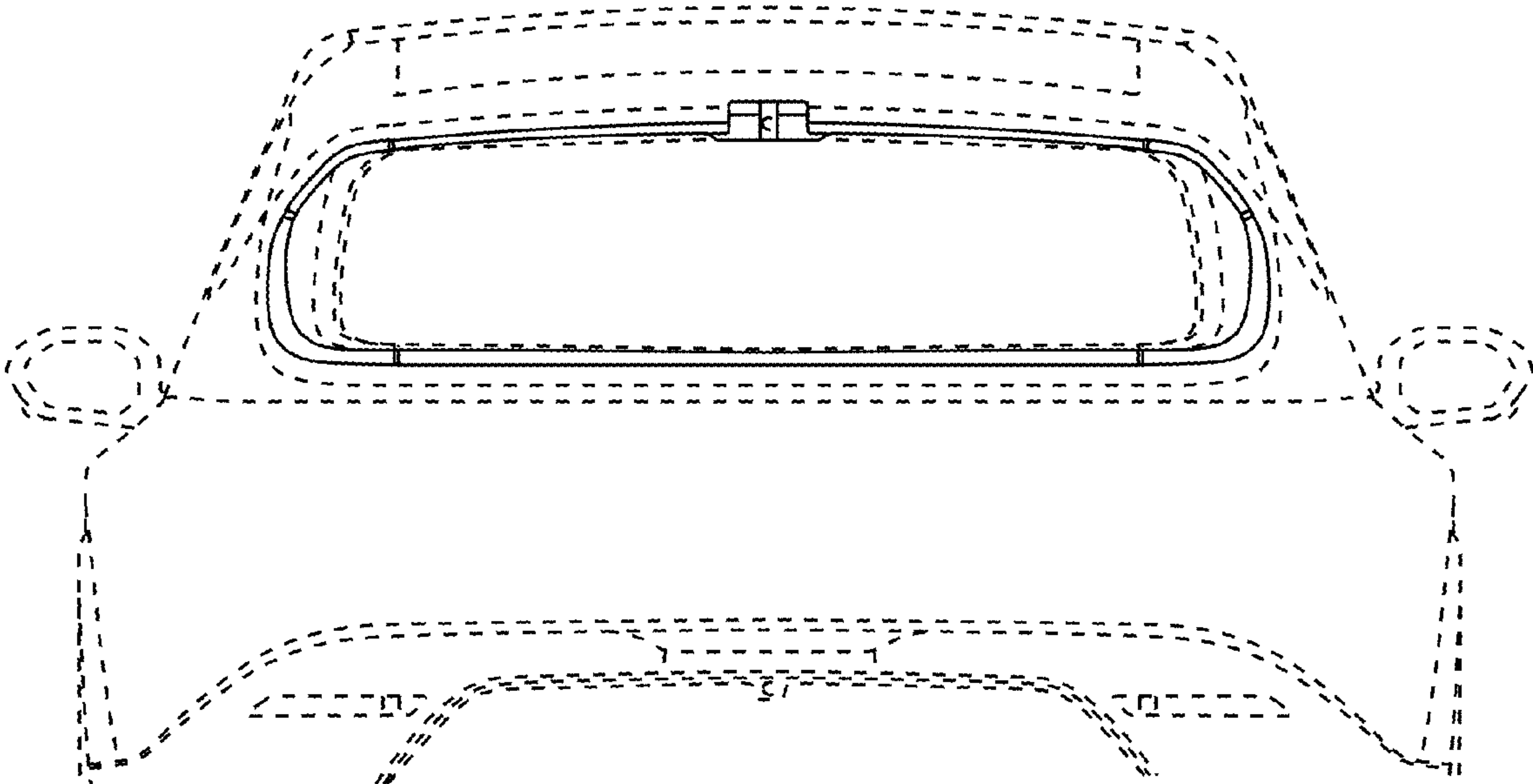
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vehicle light pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a vehicle light pattern in a first stage, showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof in a second stage;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof in a third stage;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof in a fourth stage; and,
FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear, top, left perspective view thereof in the fourth stage.
The broken lines of uneven length illustrate the boundary of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The broken lines of even length depict portions of the vehicle light pattern that form no part of the claimed design. Contrast in brightness of the light is shown by stipple shading.

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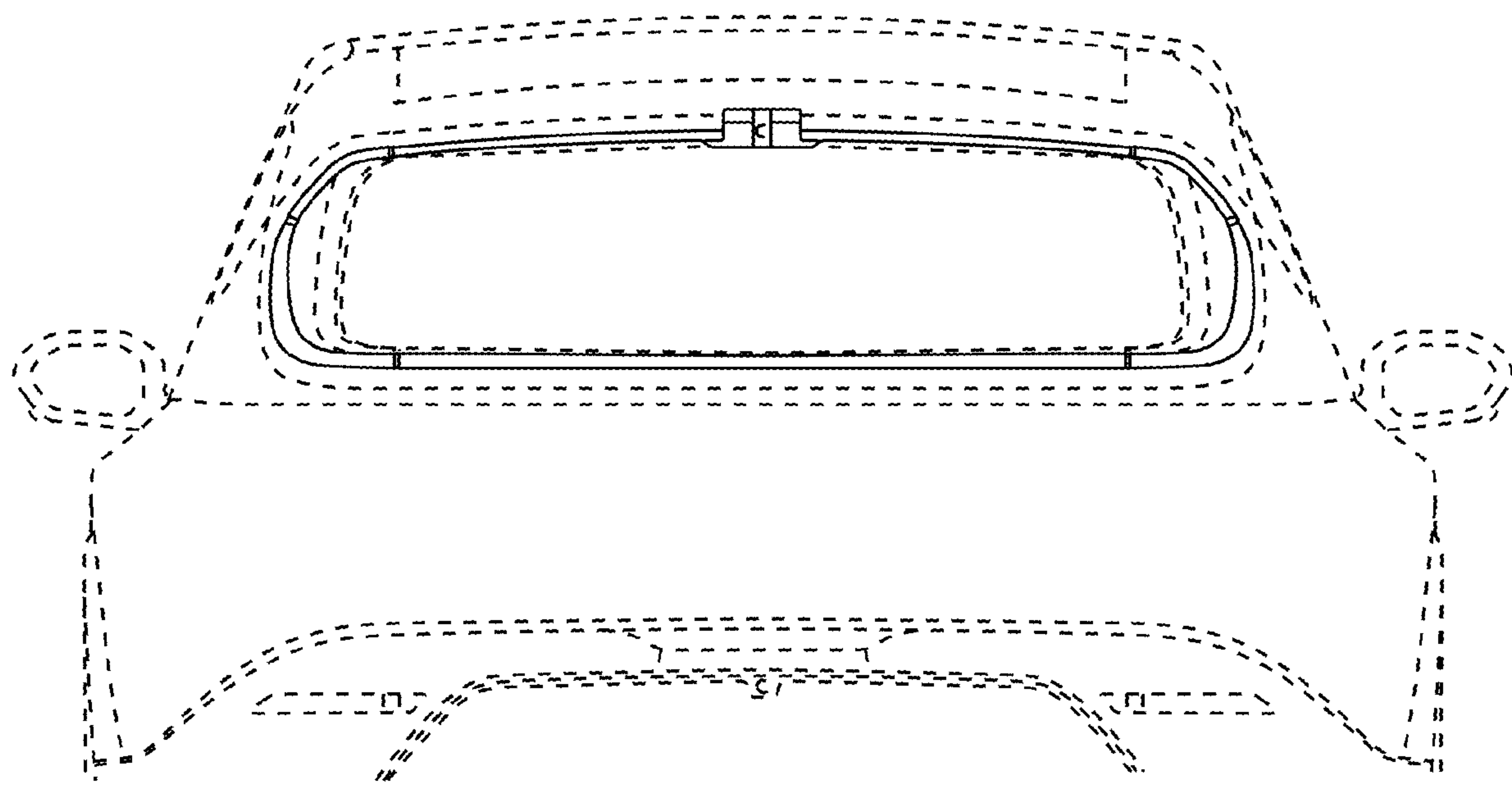

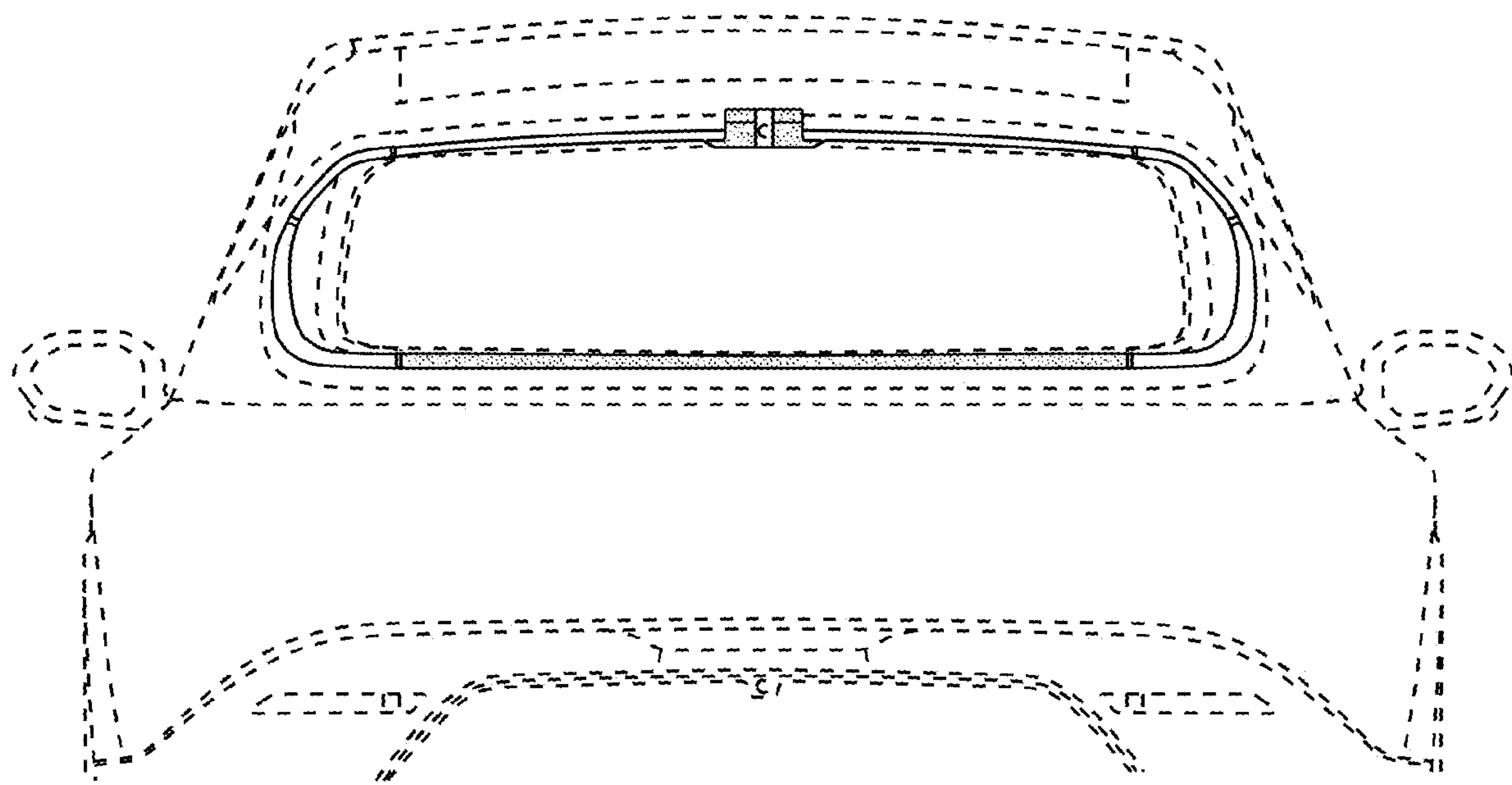

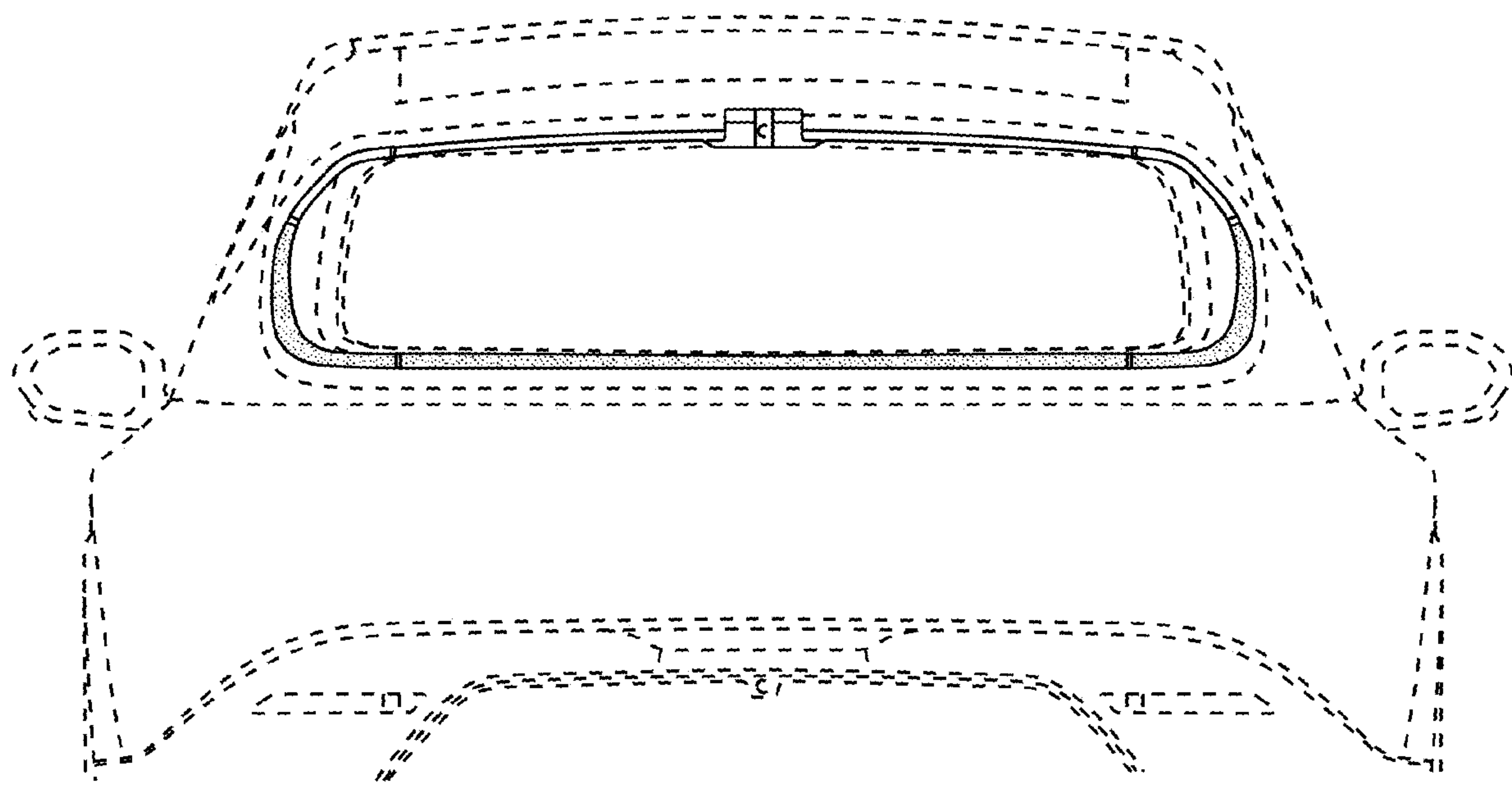

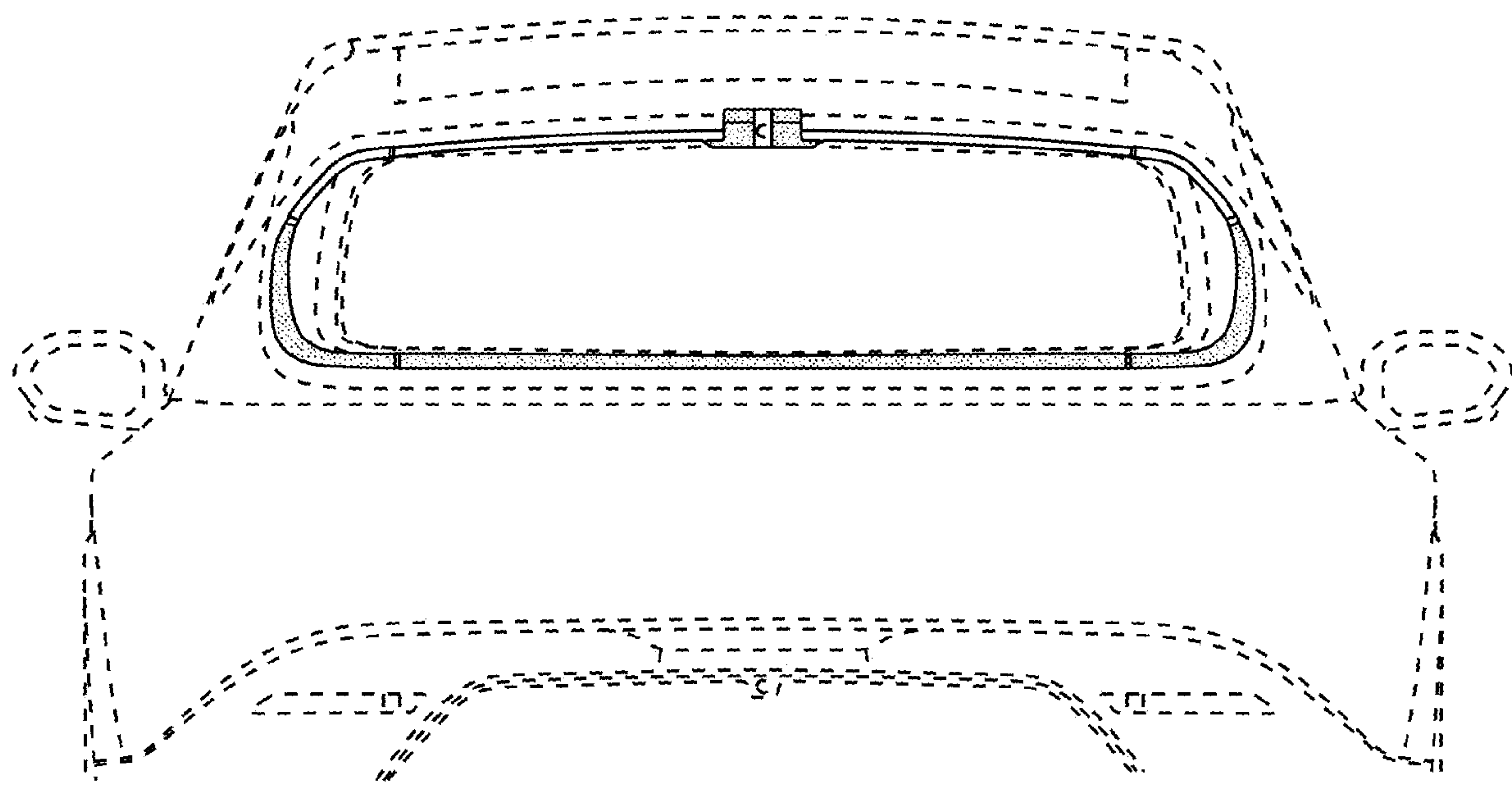

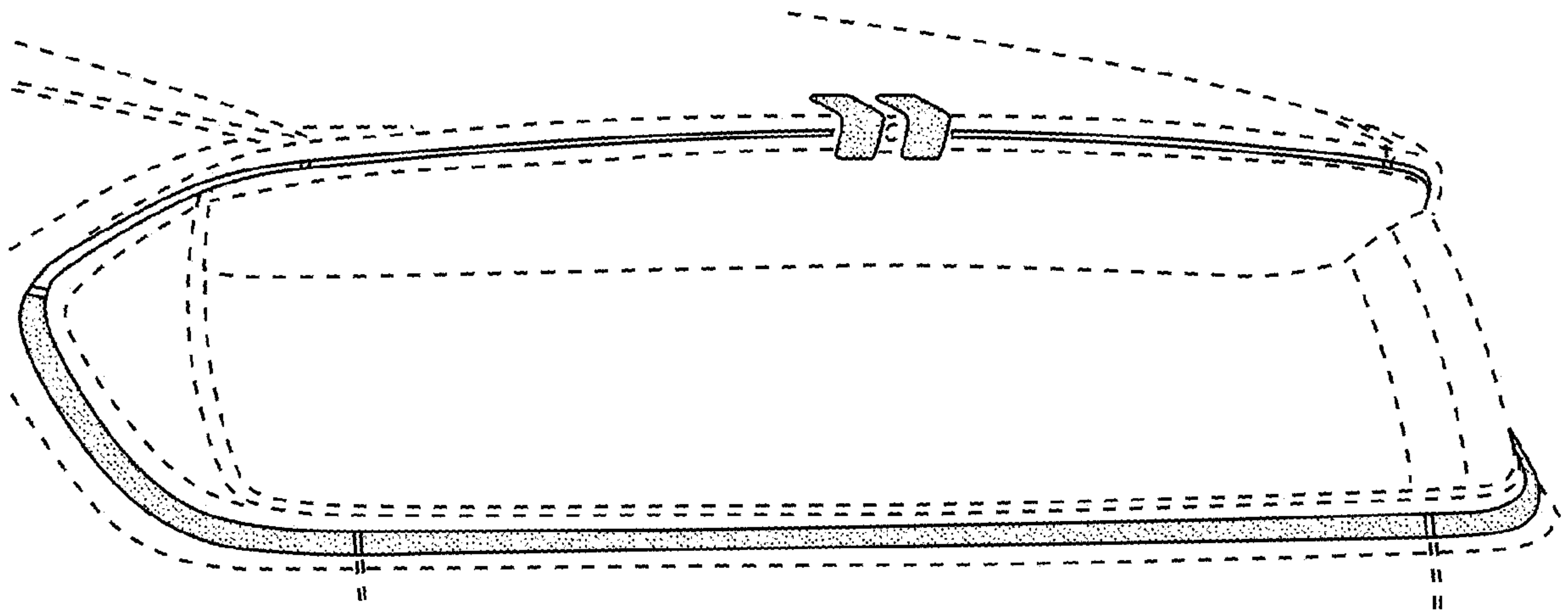
