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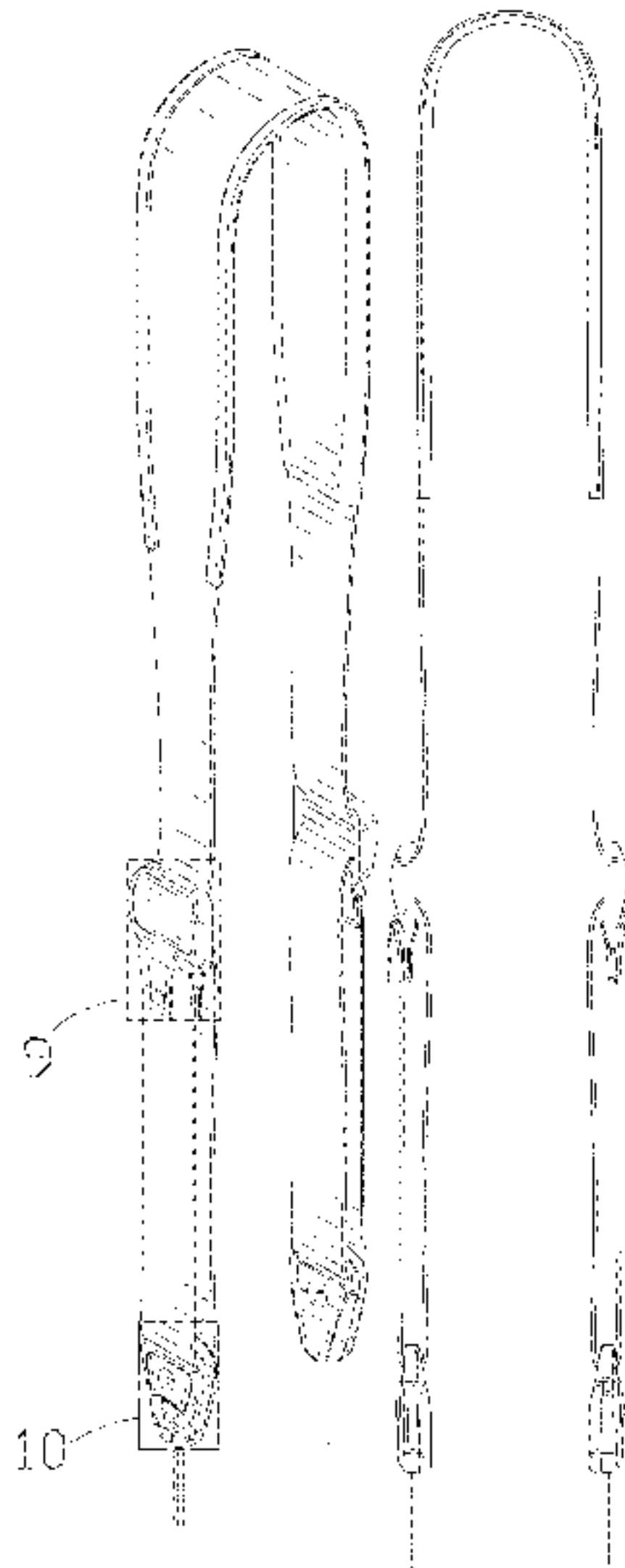
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a strap for camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left, and top perspective view of a strap for camera showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear, right, and bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 9 is an enlarged view of the portion marked ‘9’ of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 10 is an enlarged view of the portion marked ‘10’ of FIG. 1.
The broken lines shown in the drawings represent portions of the strap for camera that form no part of the claimed design.
The dot-dash-broken lines encircling portions of the strap for camera in FIG. 1 and illustrated in enlarged views in FIGS. 9 and 10 form no part of the claimed design.

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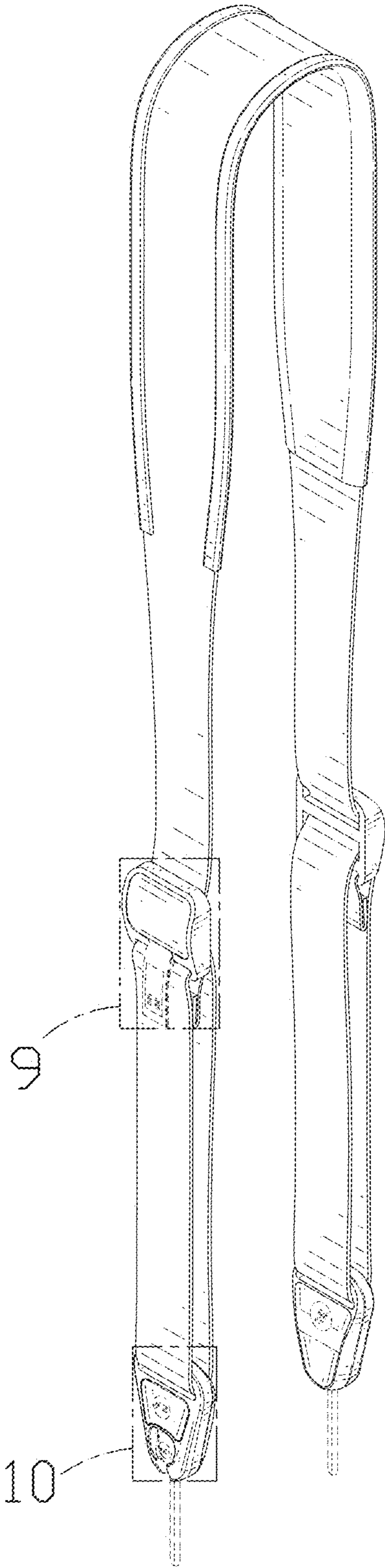

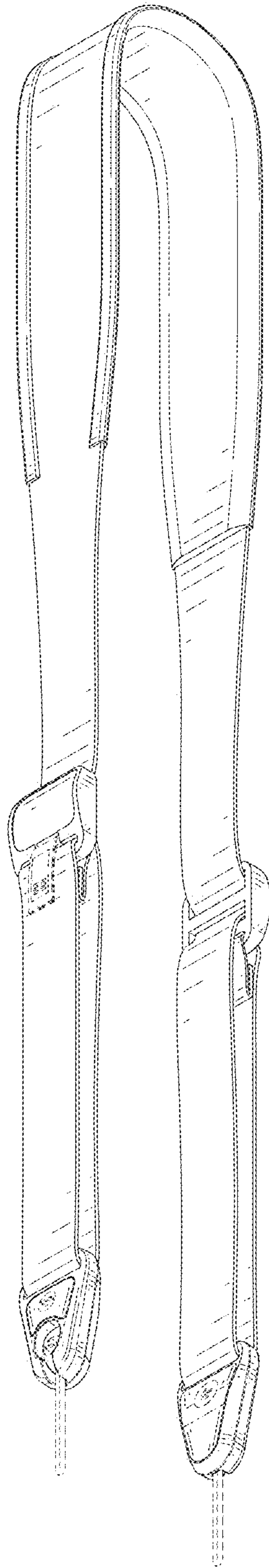

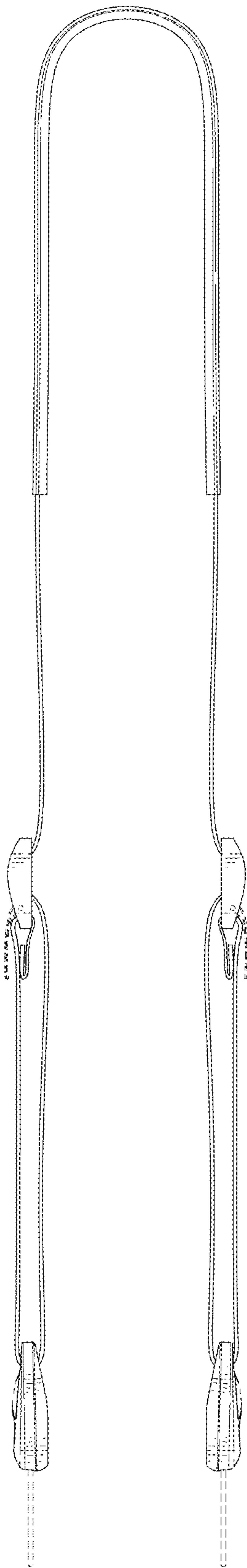

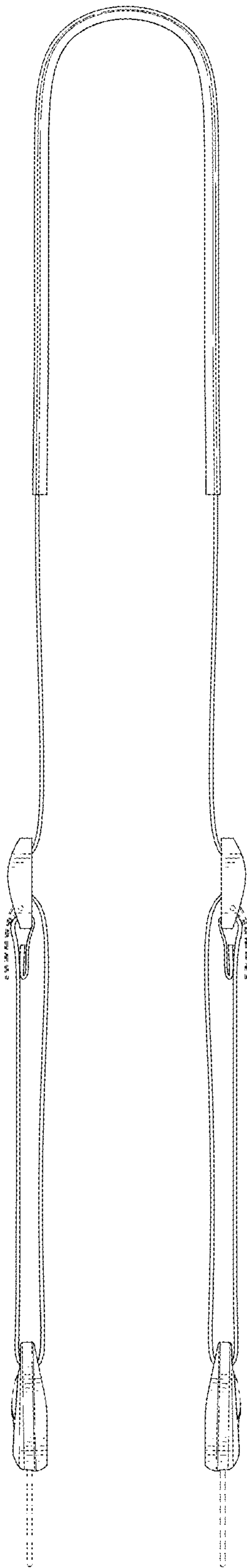

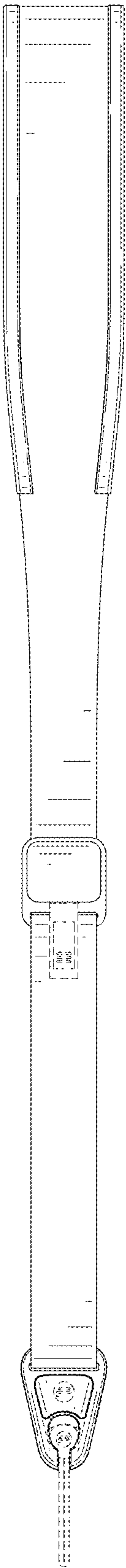

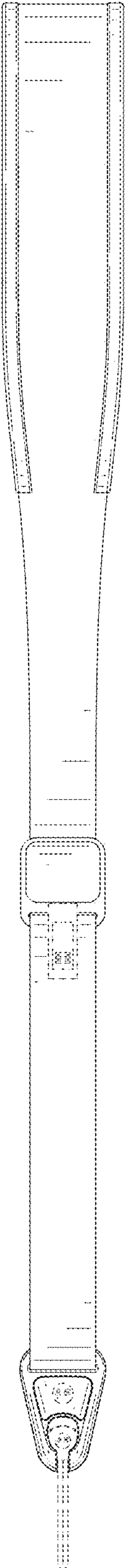

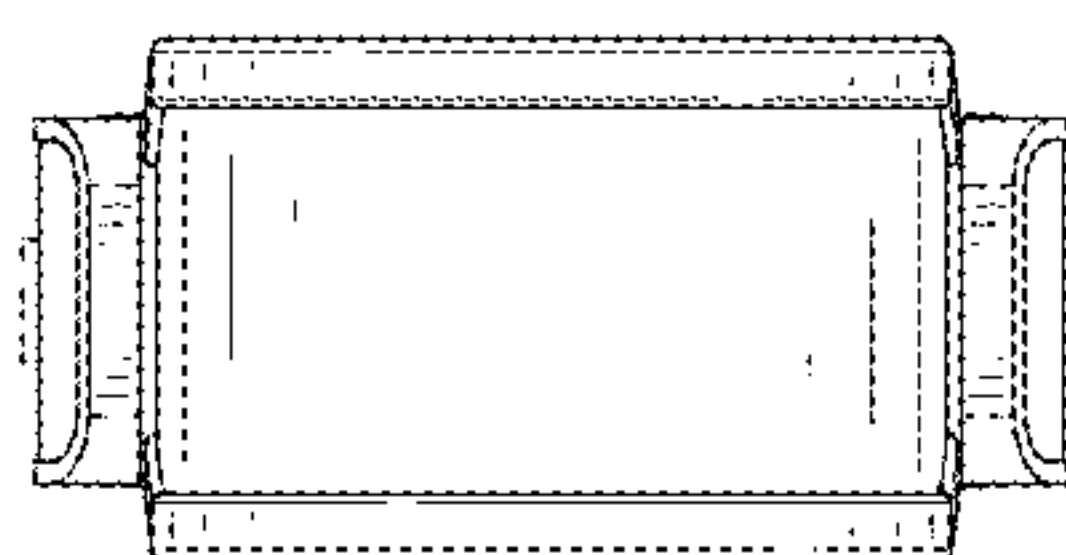

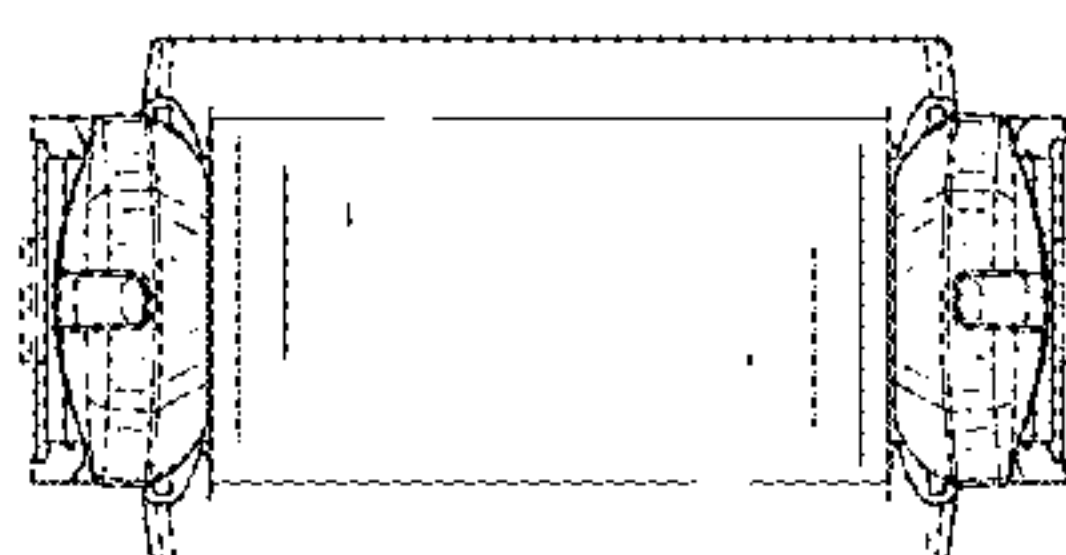

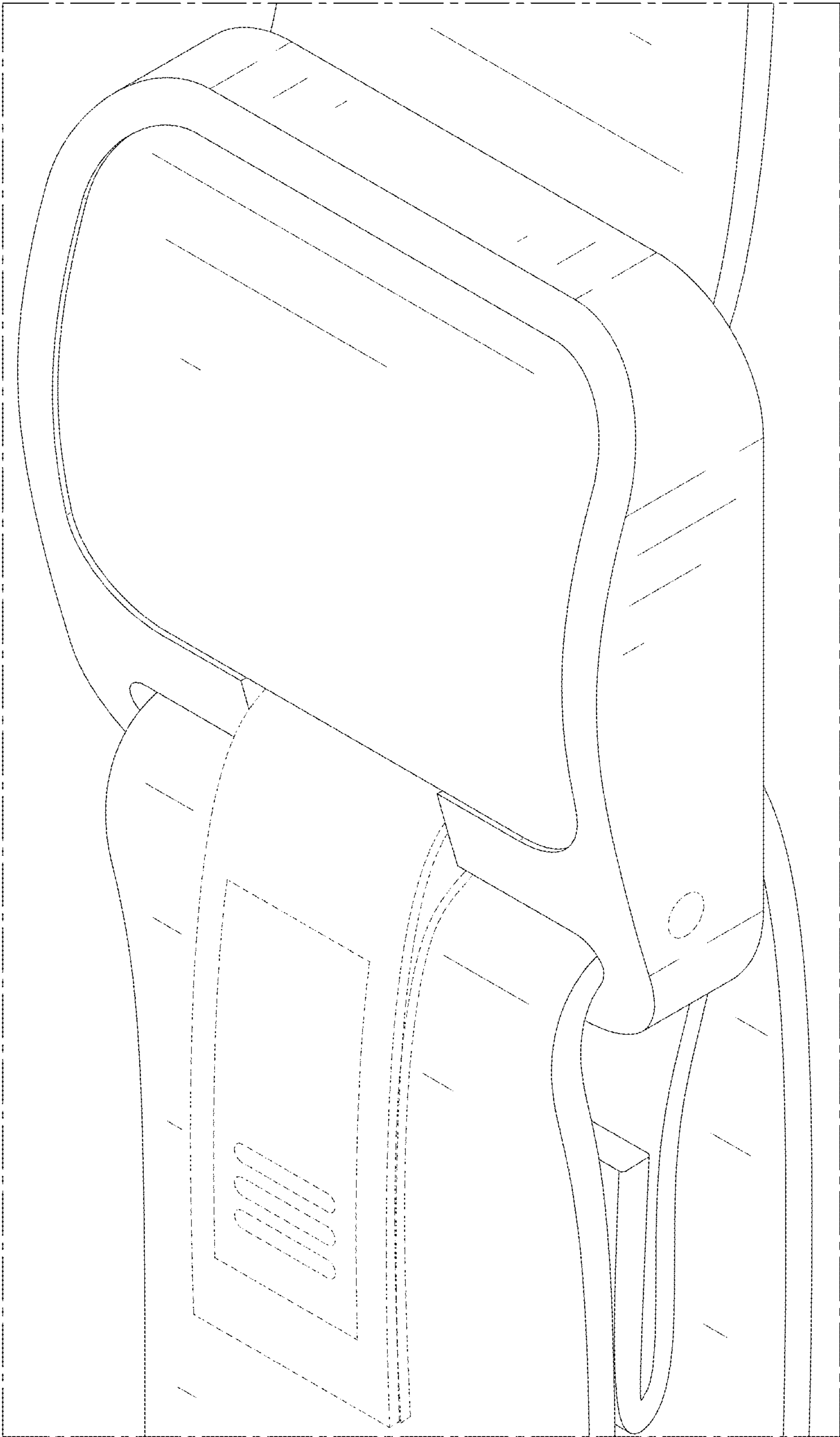

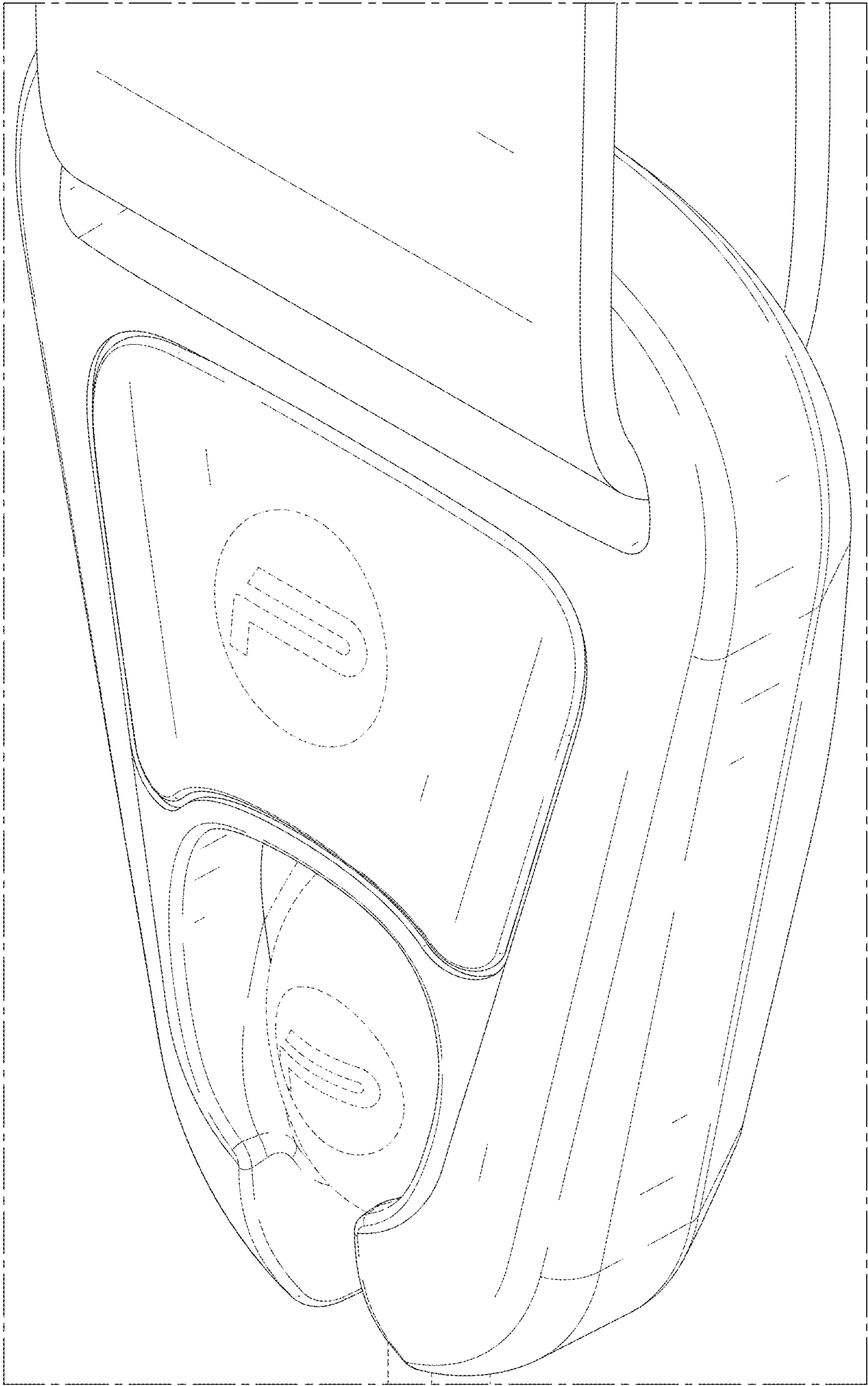
