FIG. 4 is a right-side view of the scoop of FIG. 1.

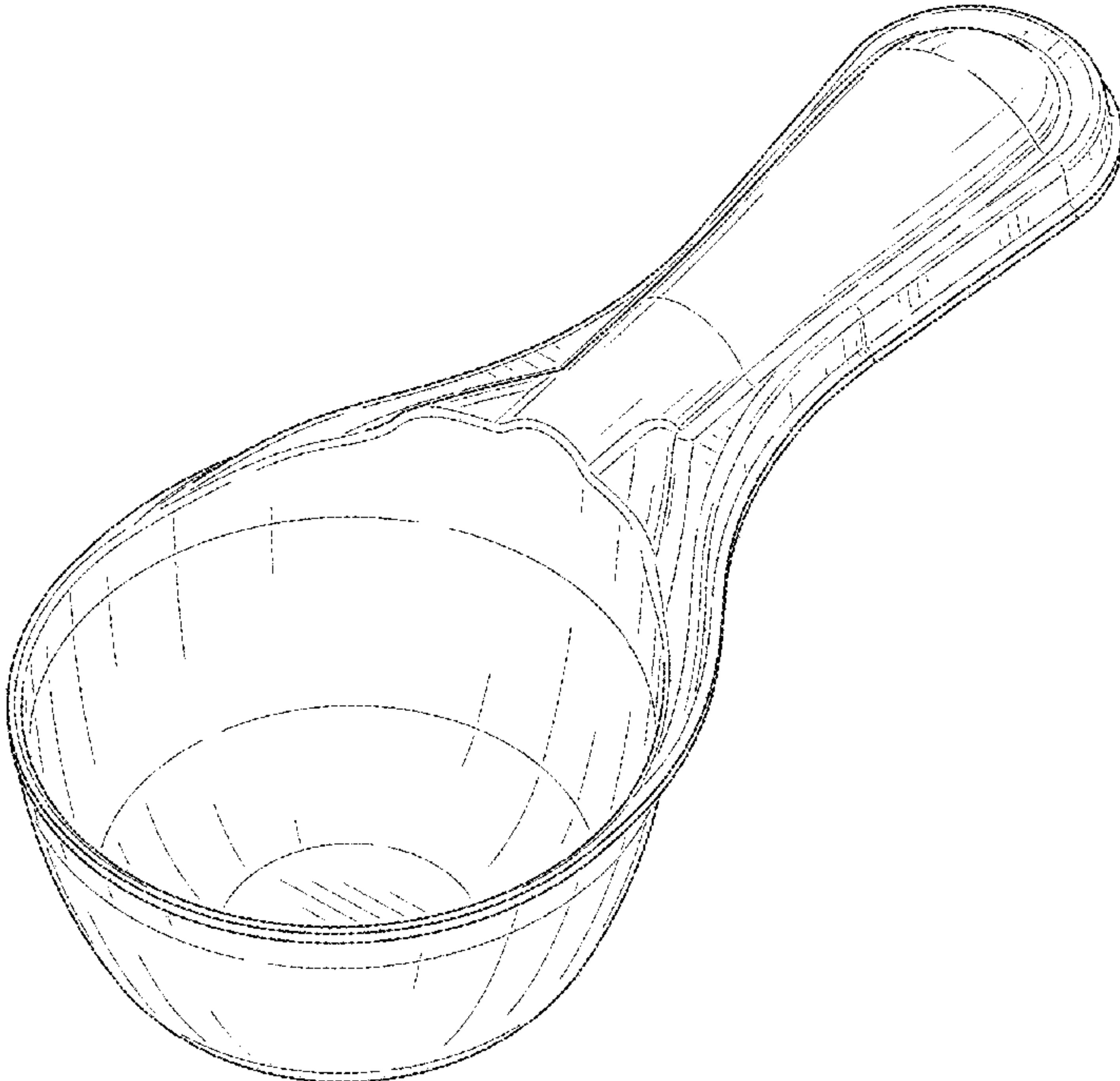
FIG. 5 is a left-side view of the scoop of FIG. 1.

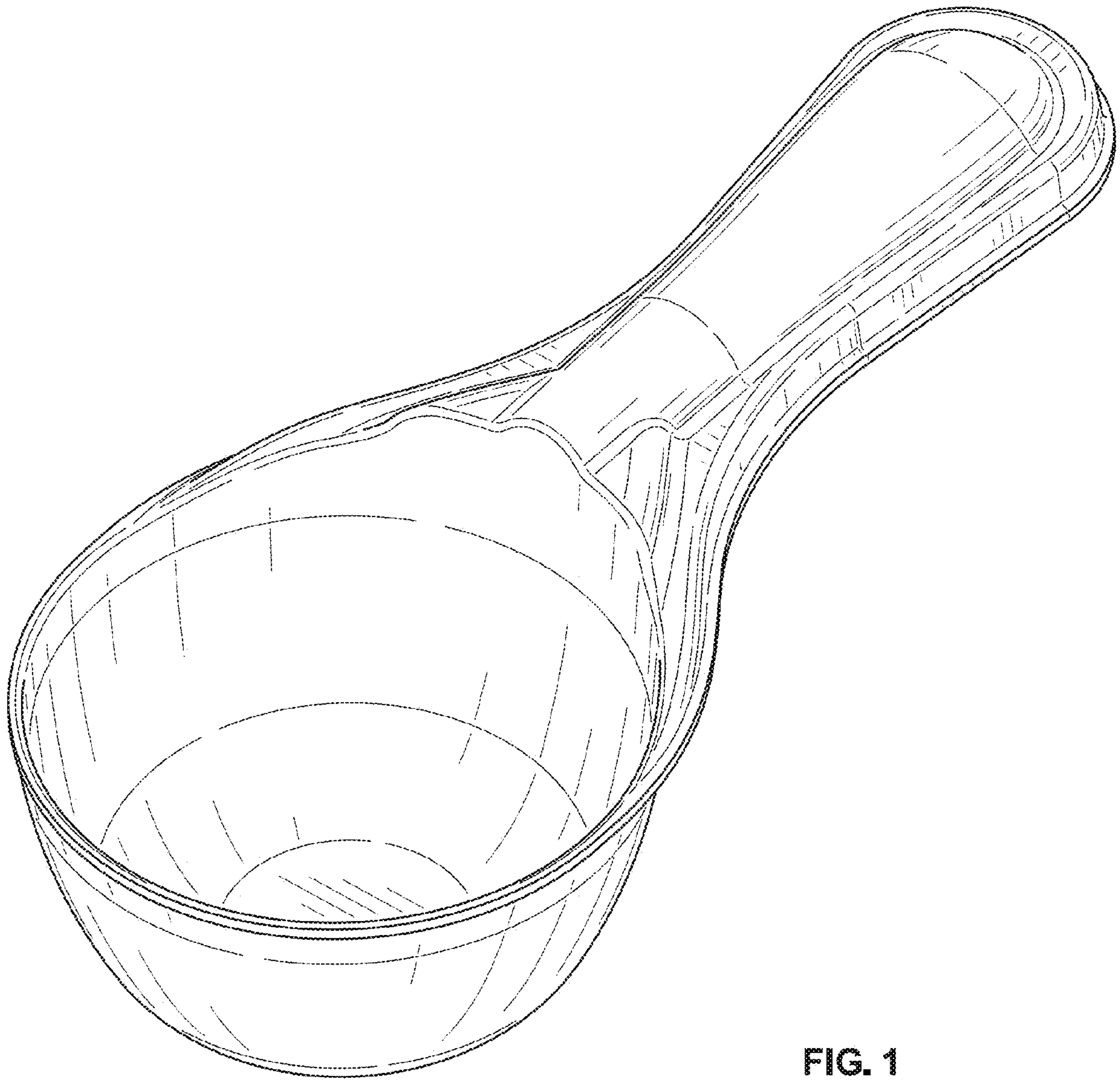
FIG. 6 is a top view of the scoop of FIG. 1; and,

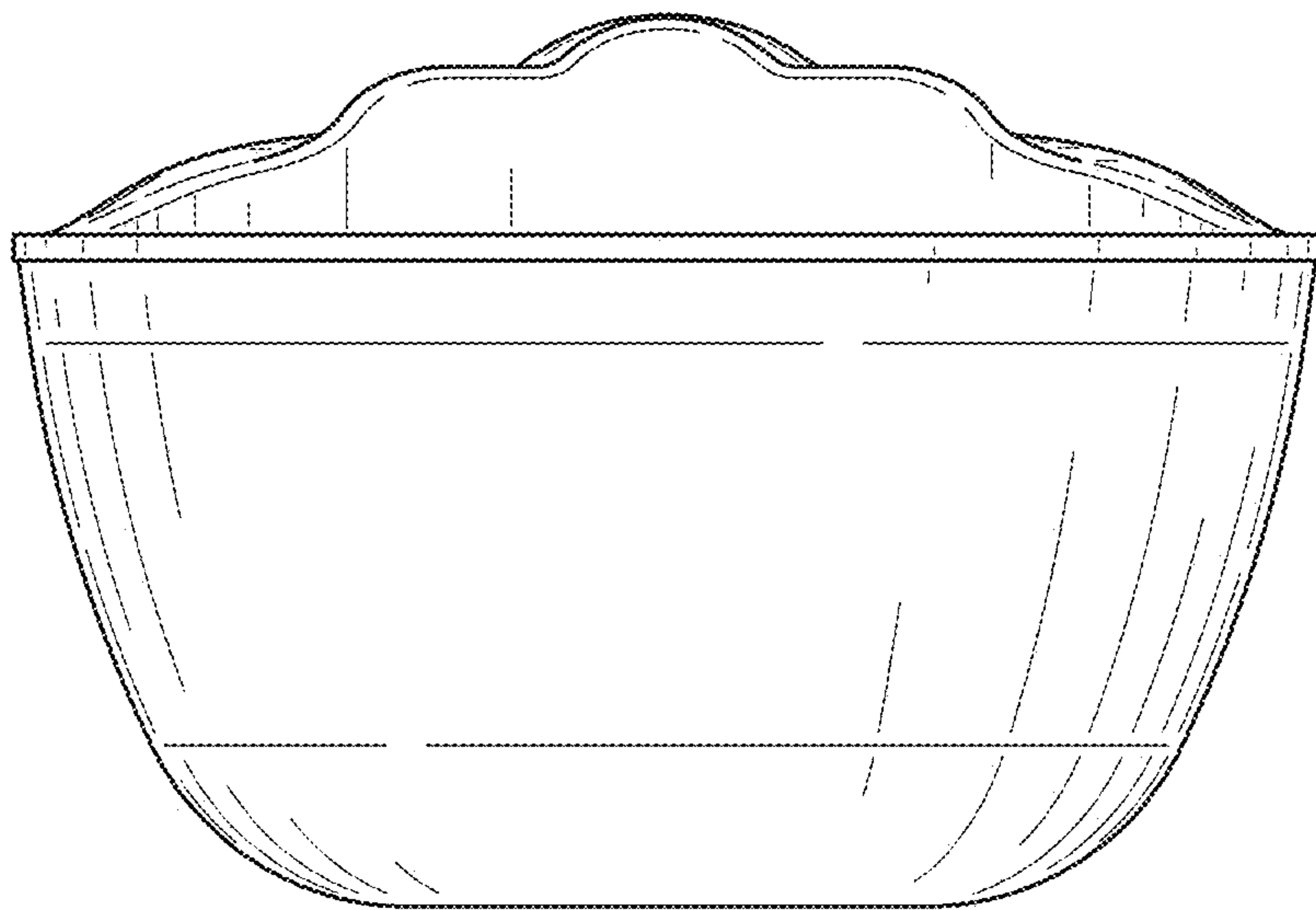

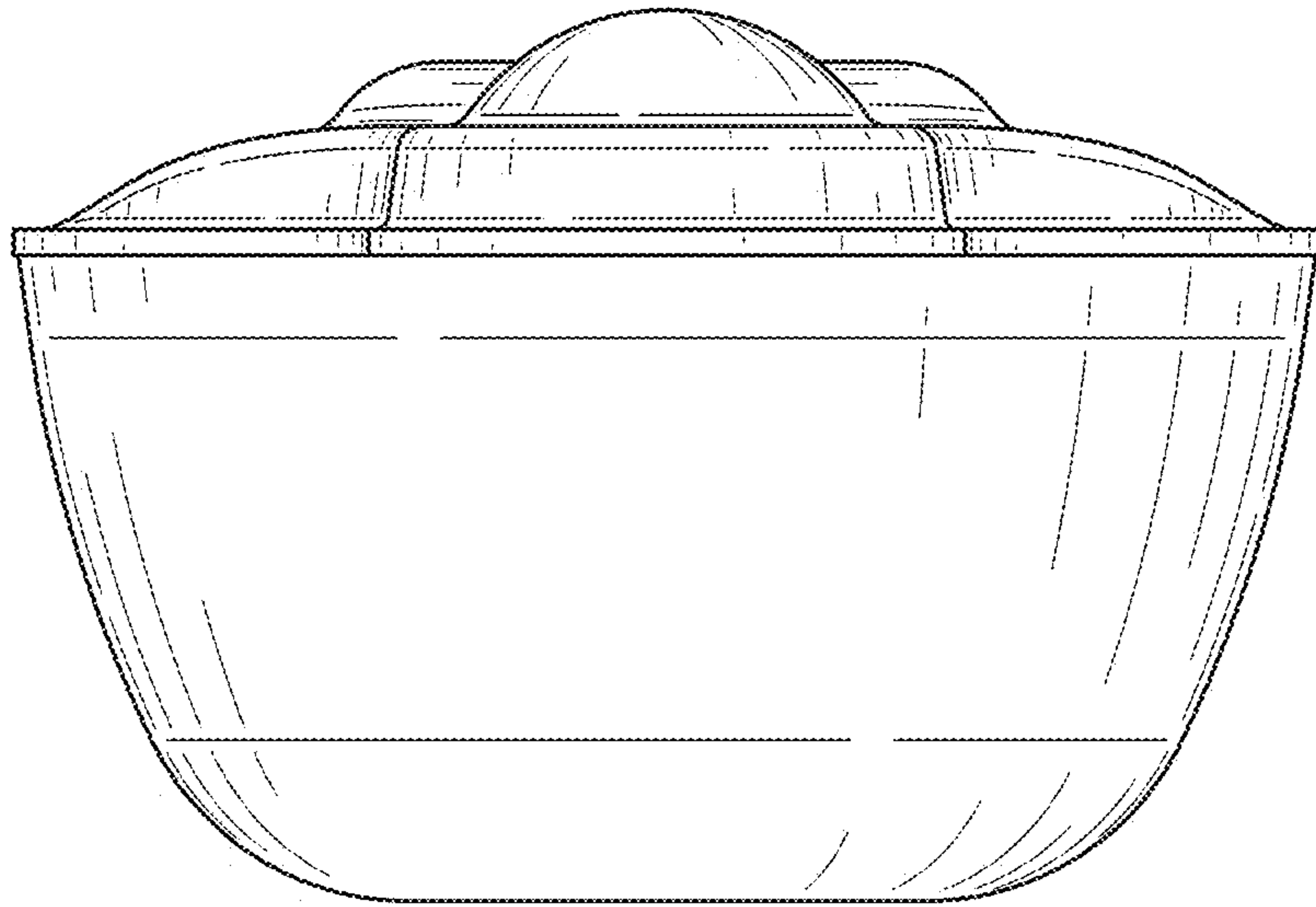

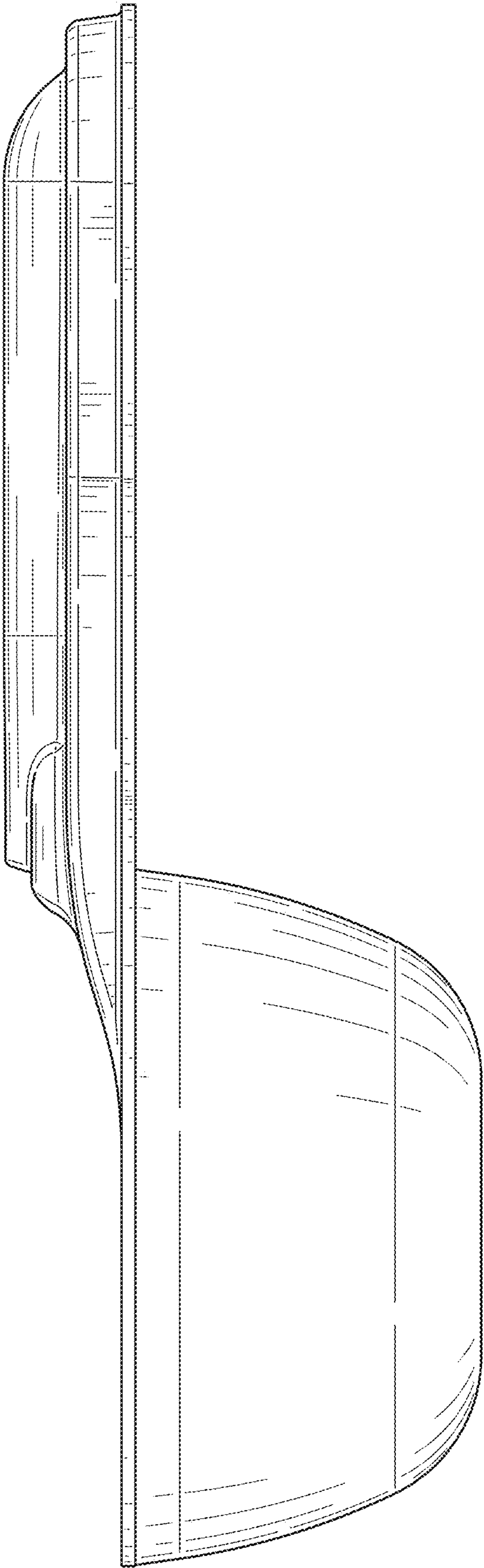

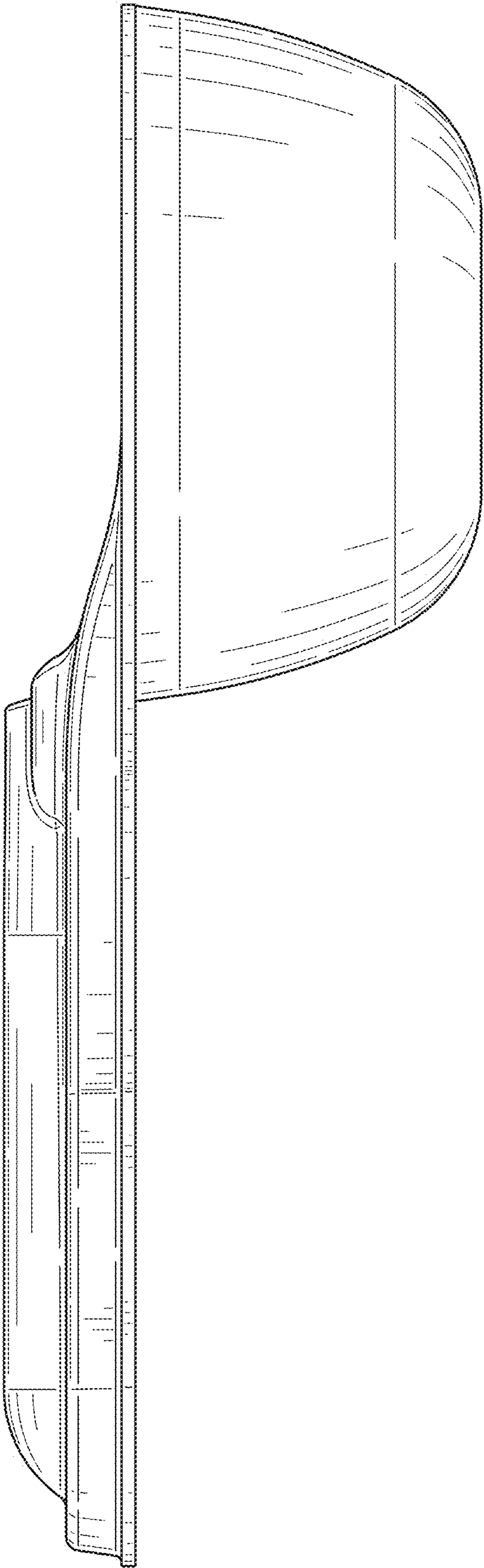

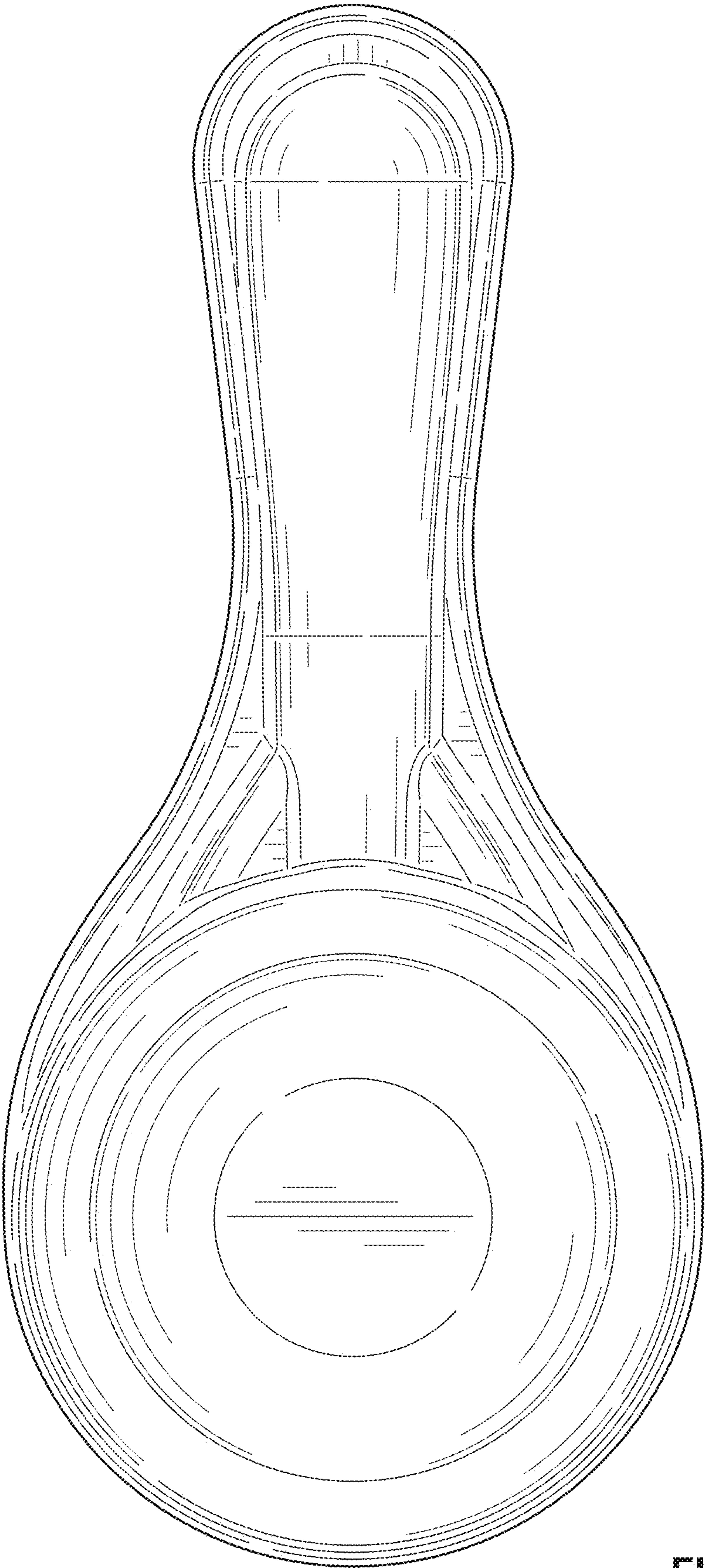

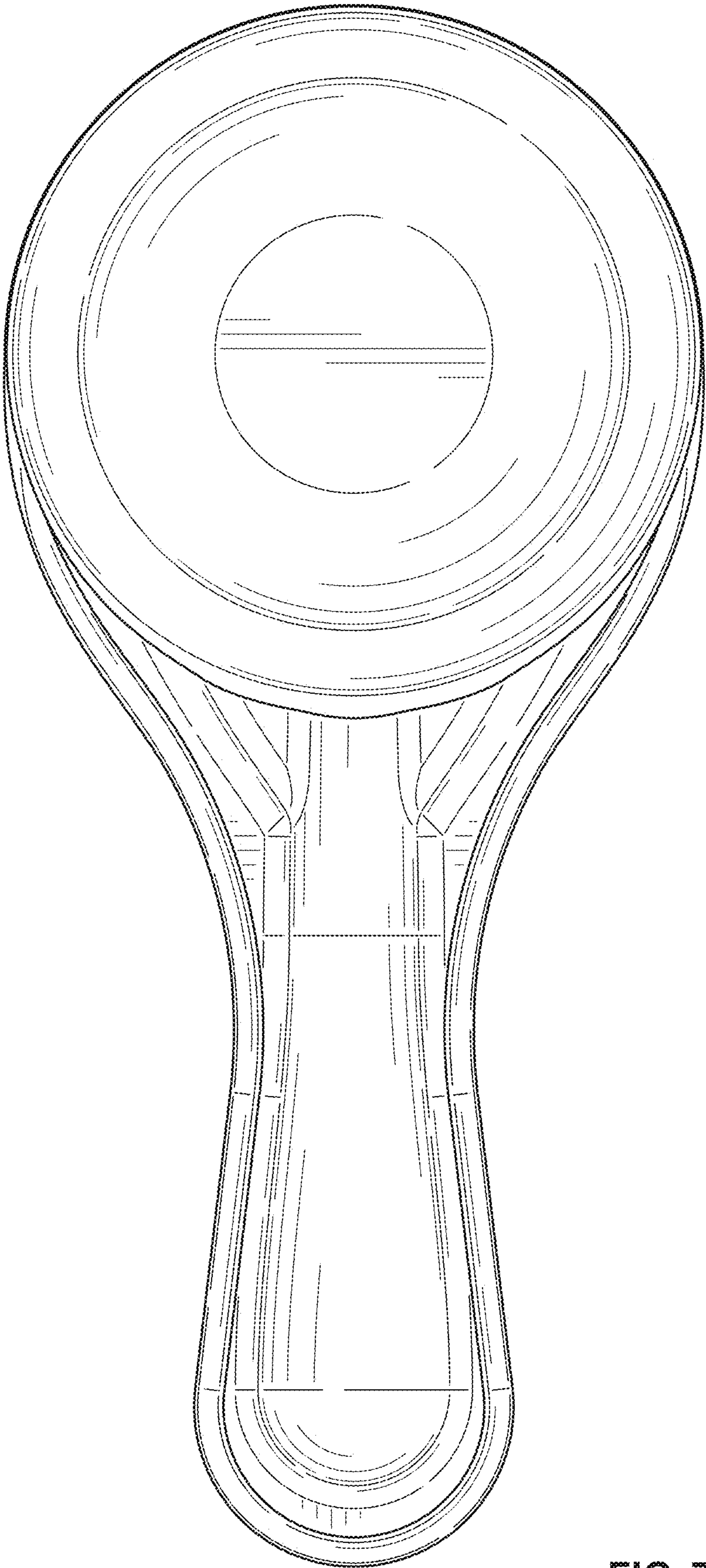
