FIG. 5 is a right-side view thereof;

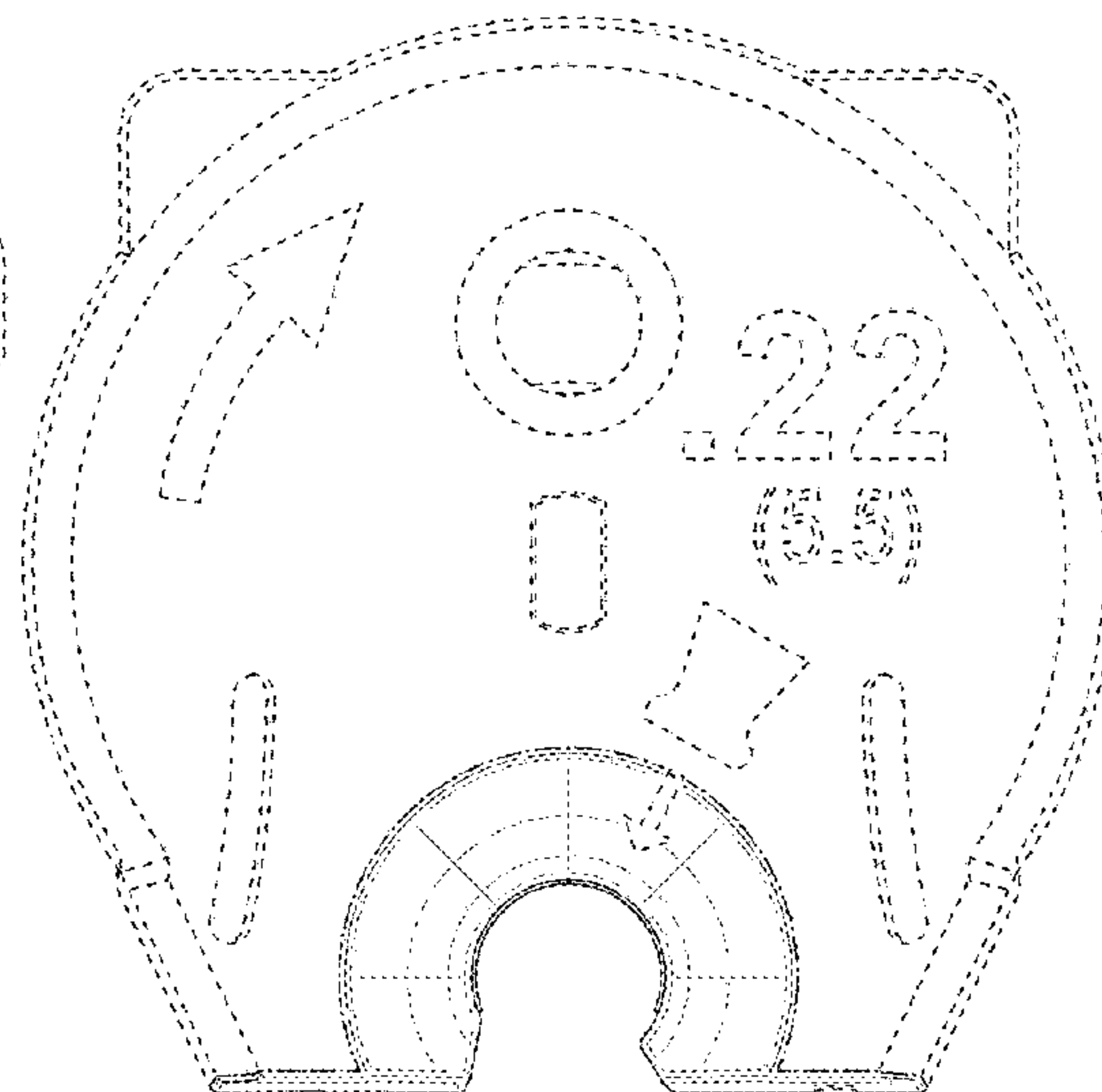
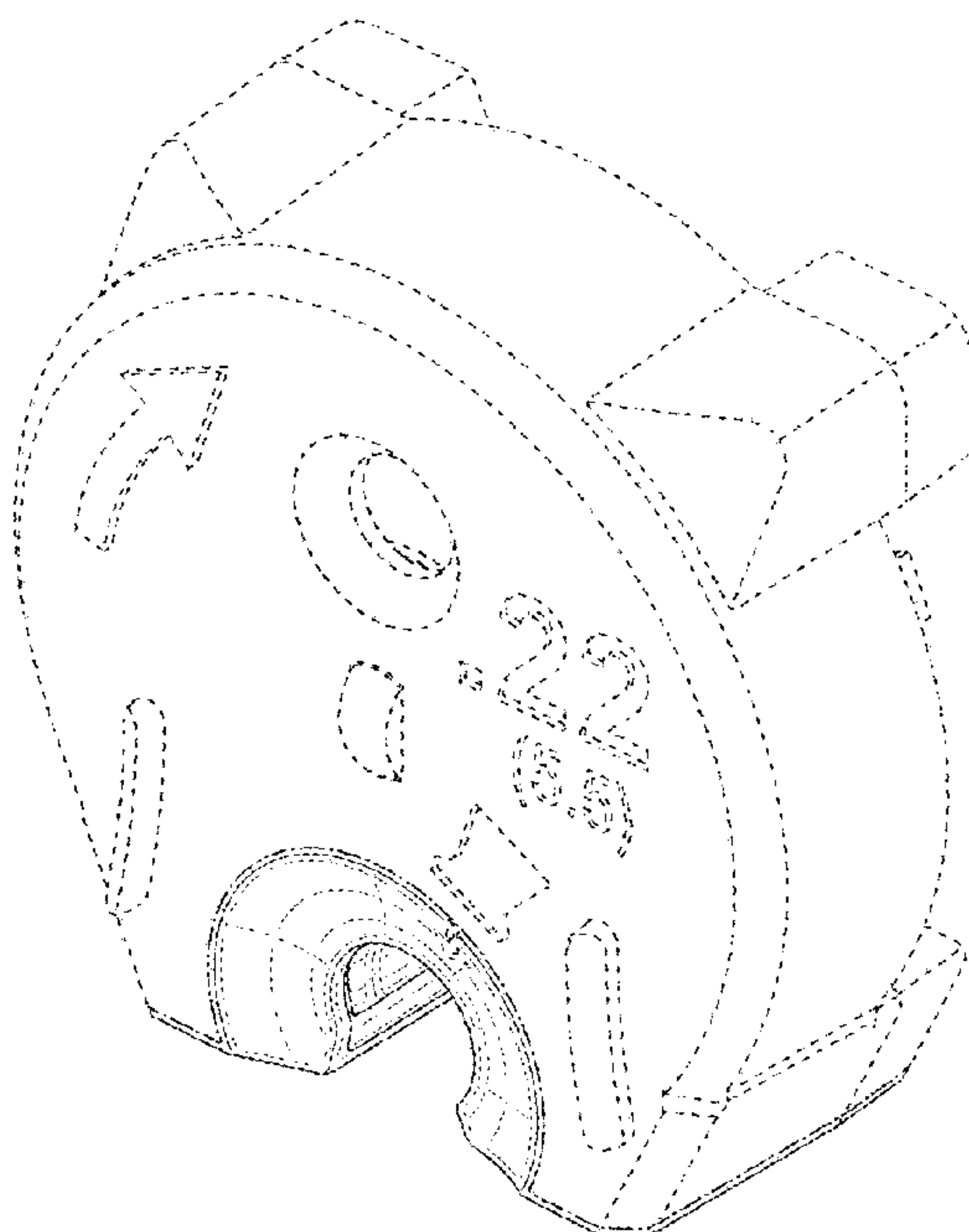
FIG. 6 is a left-side view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof.

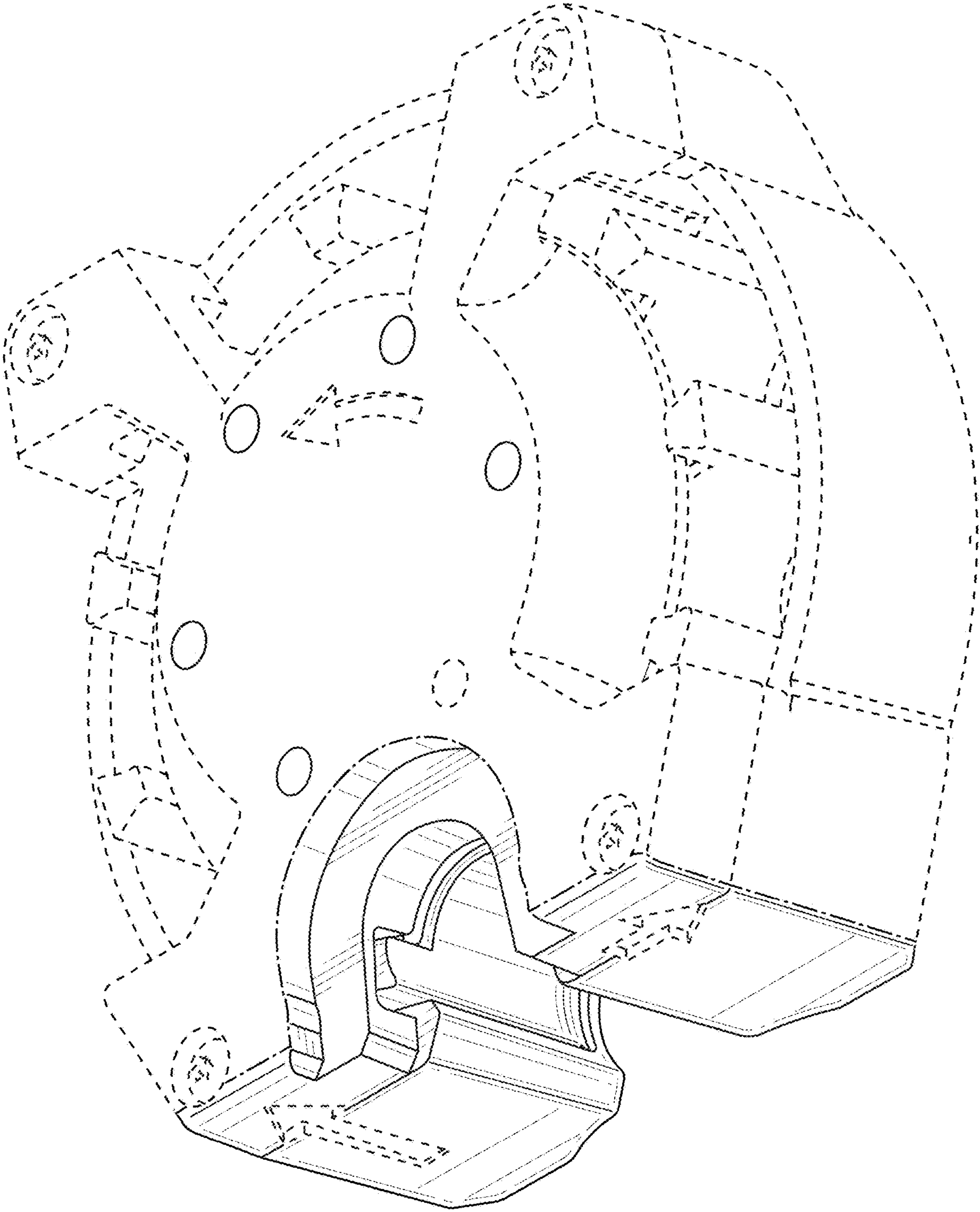

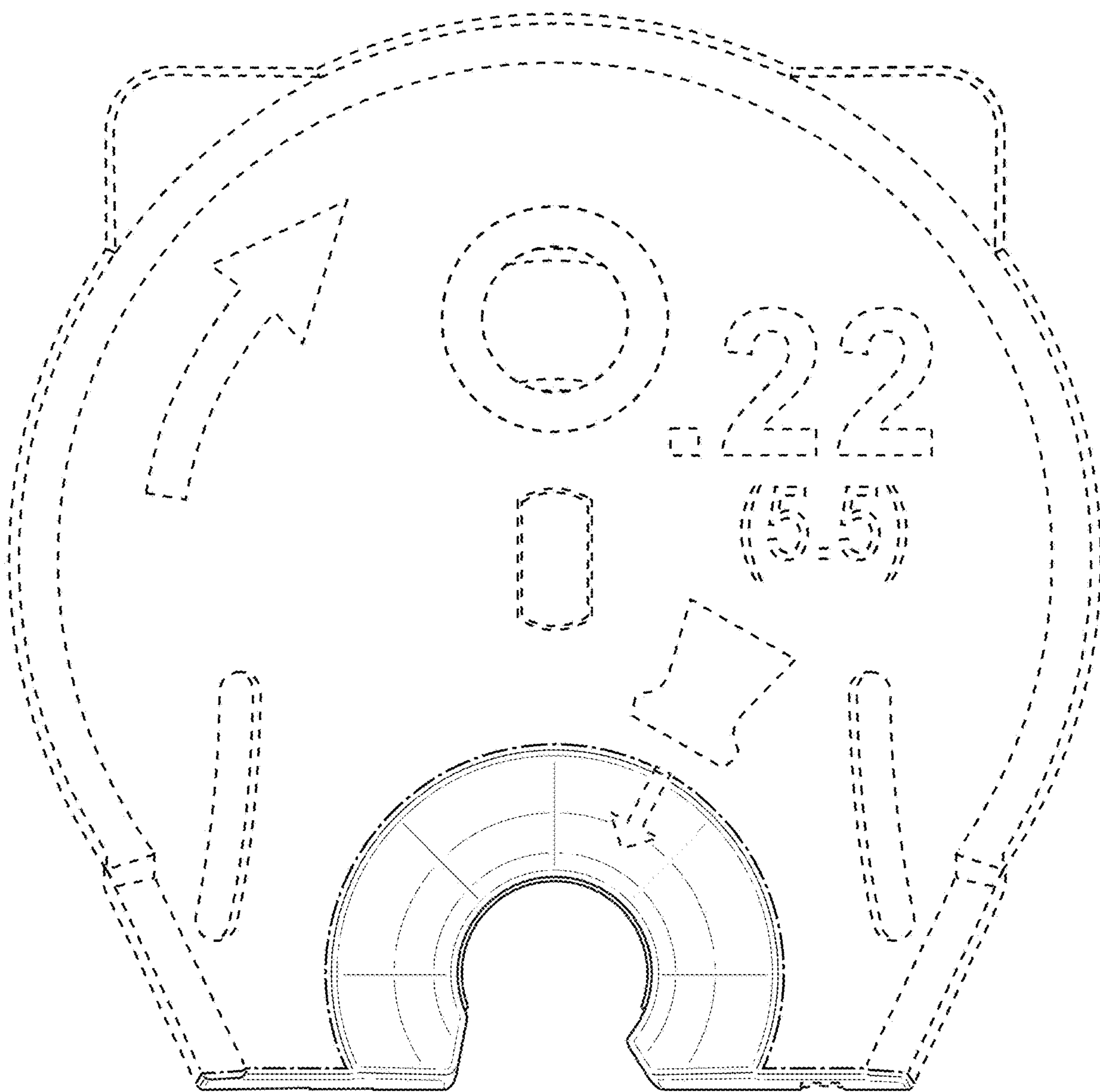




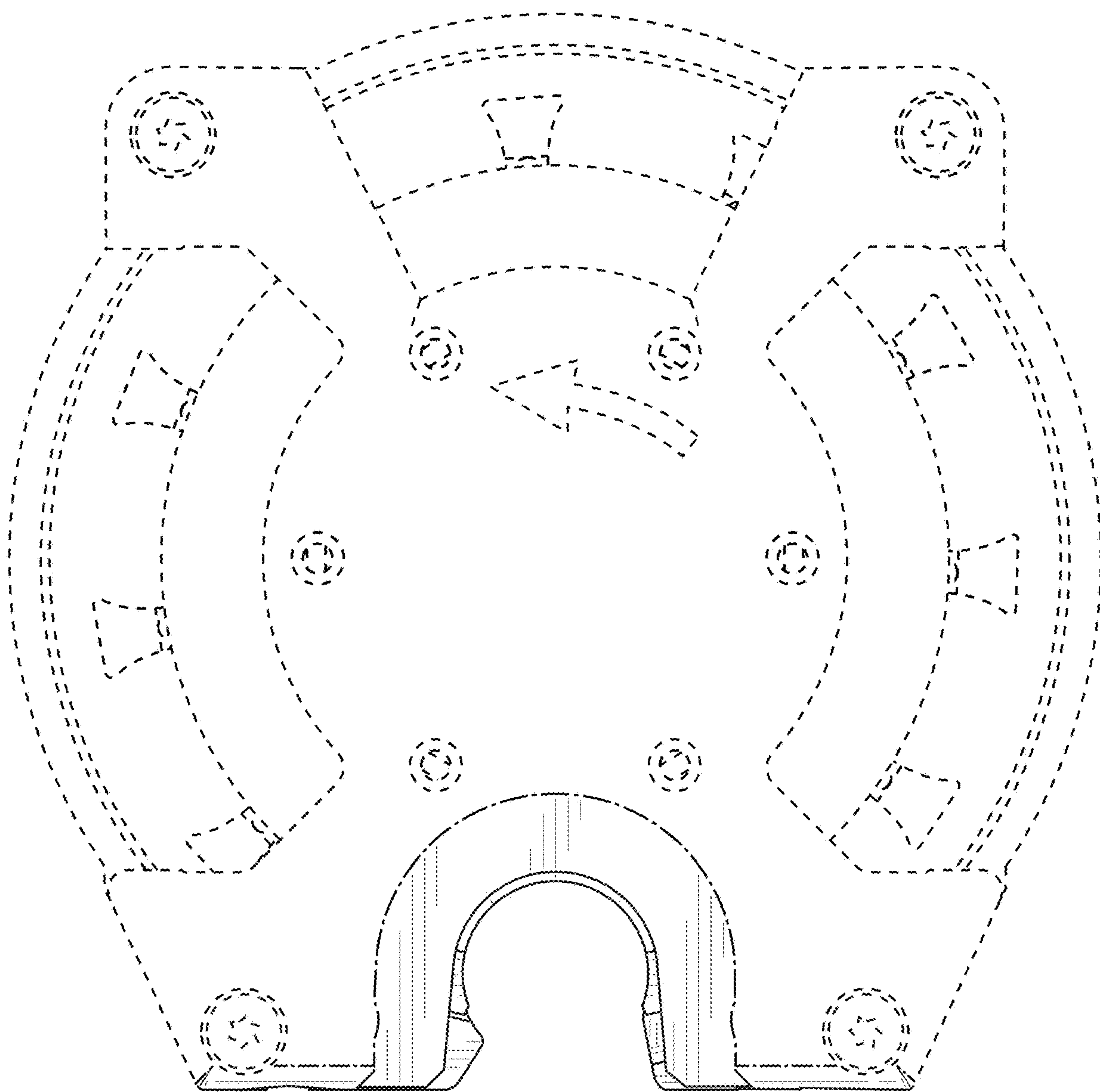

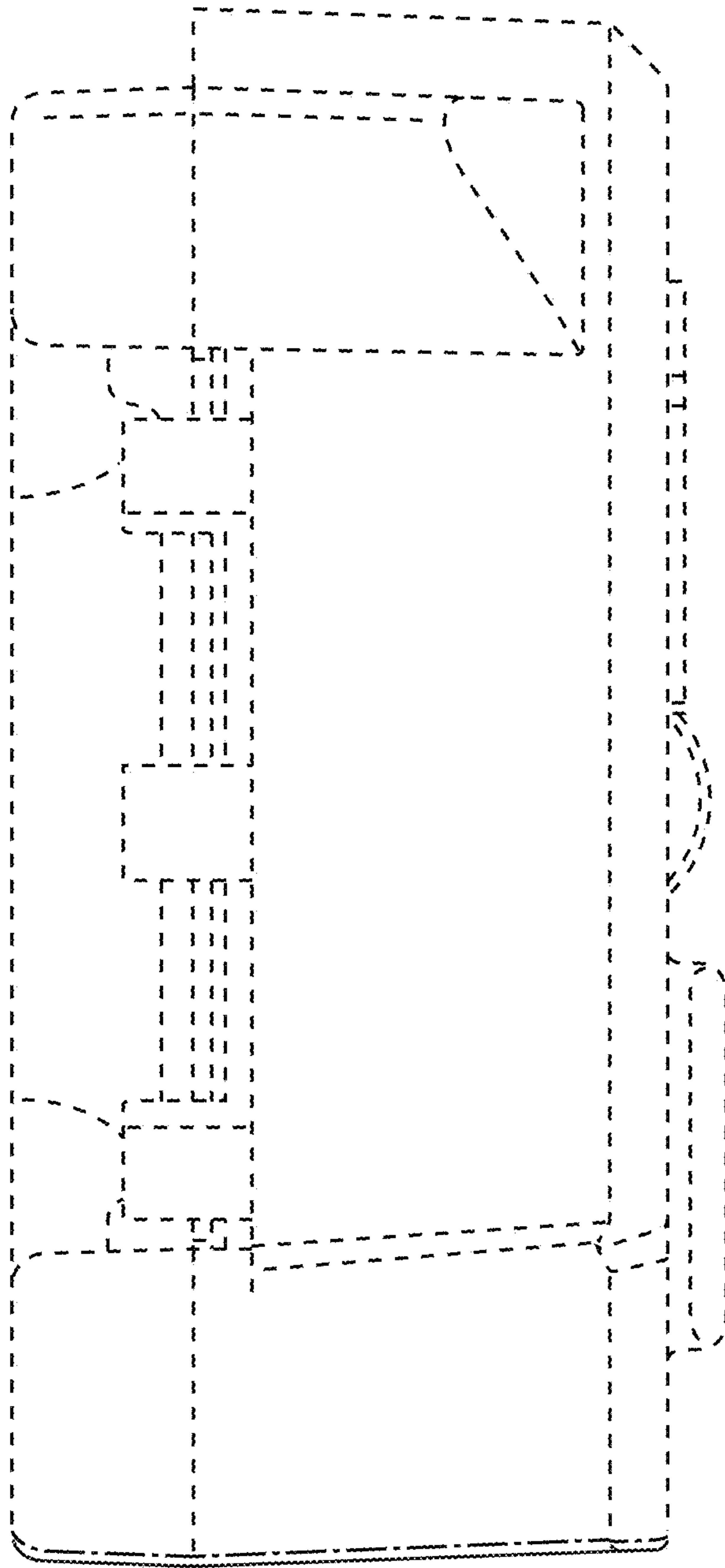

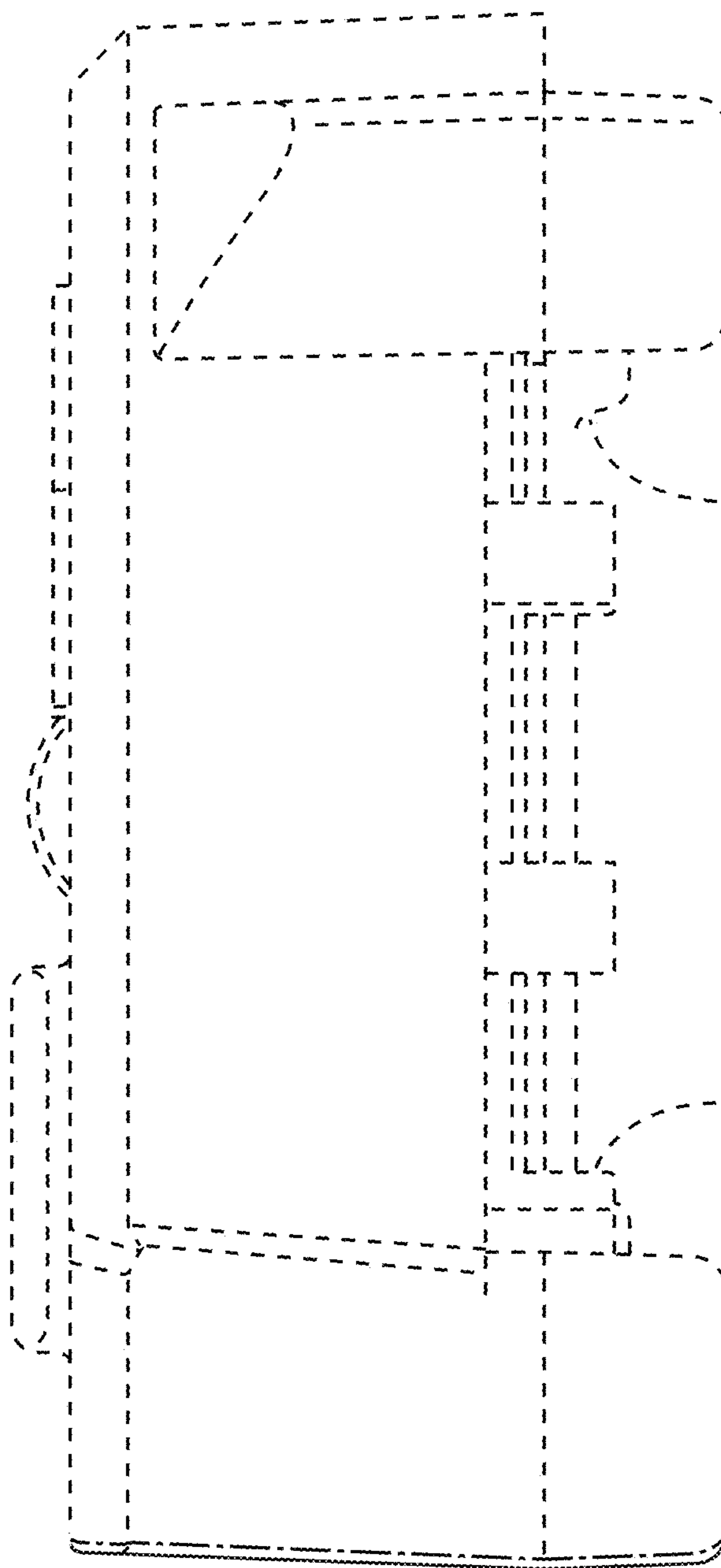

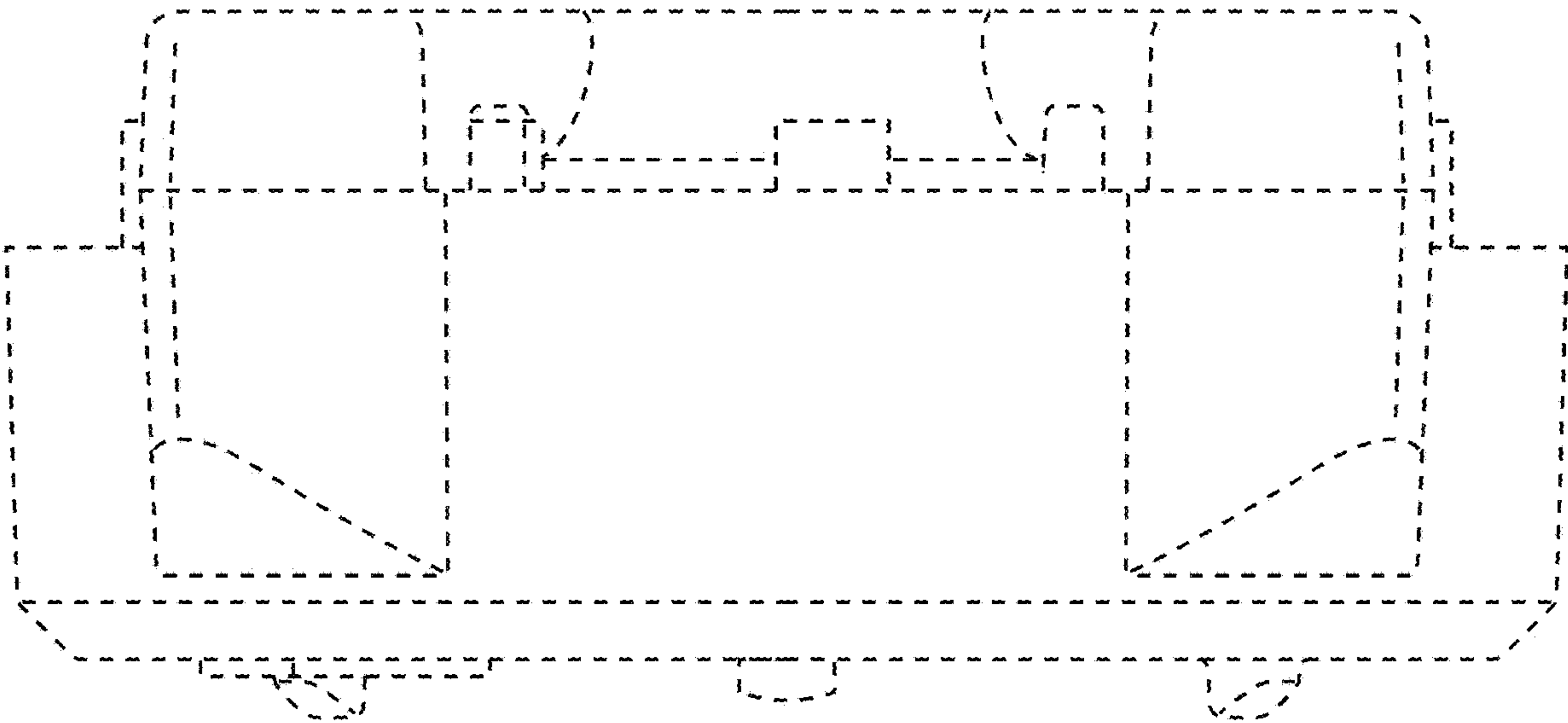

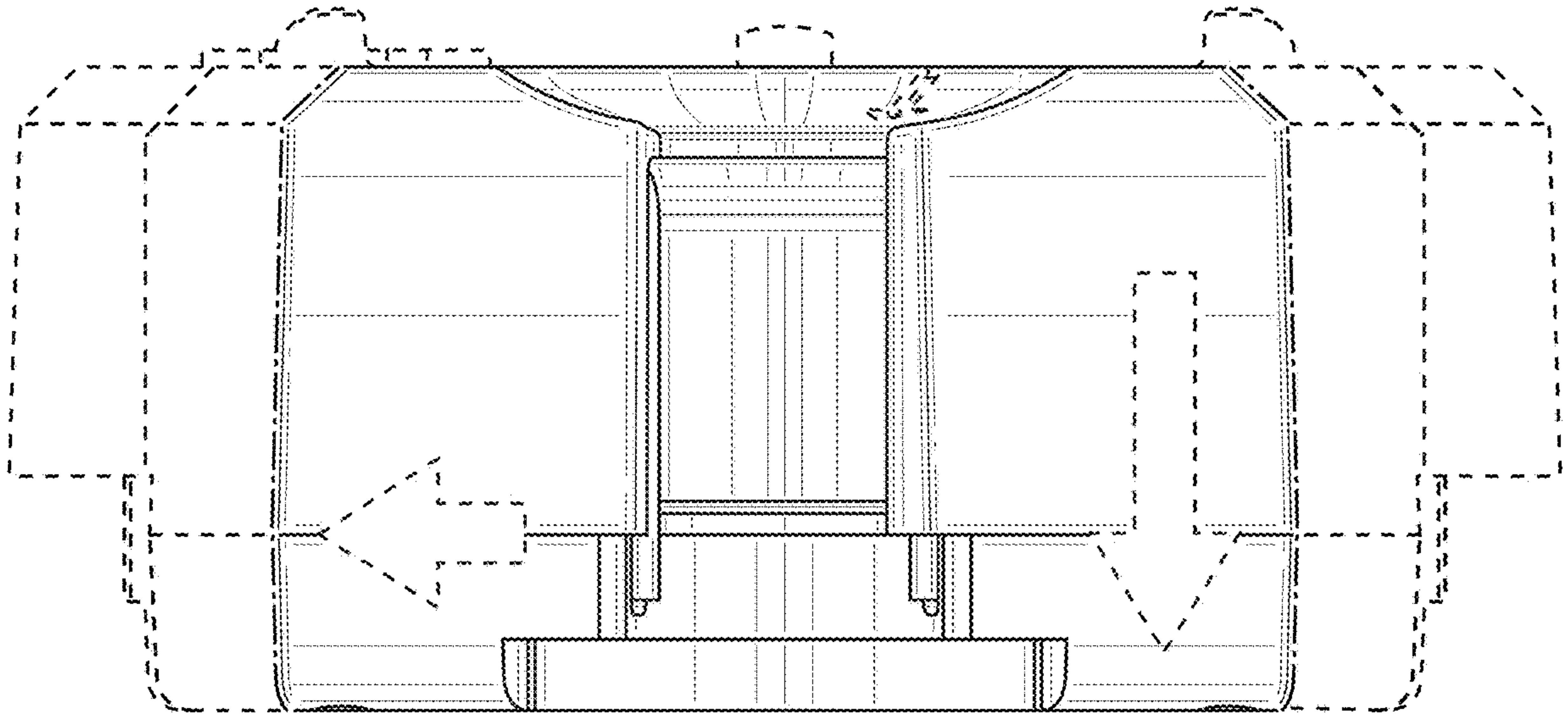
