DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a first side elevation view of the orthopaedic surgical reference instrument of FIG. 1;

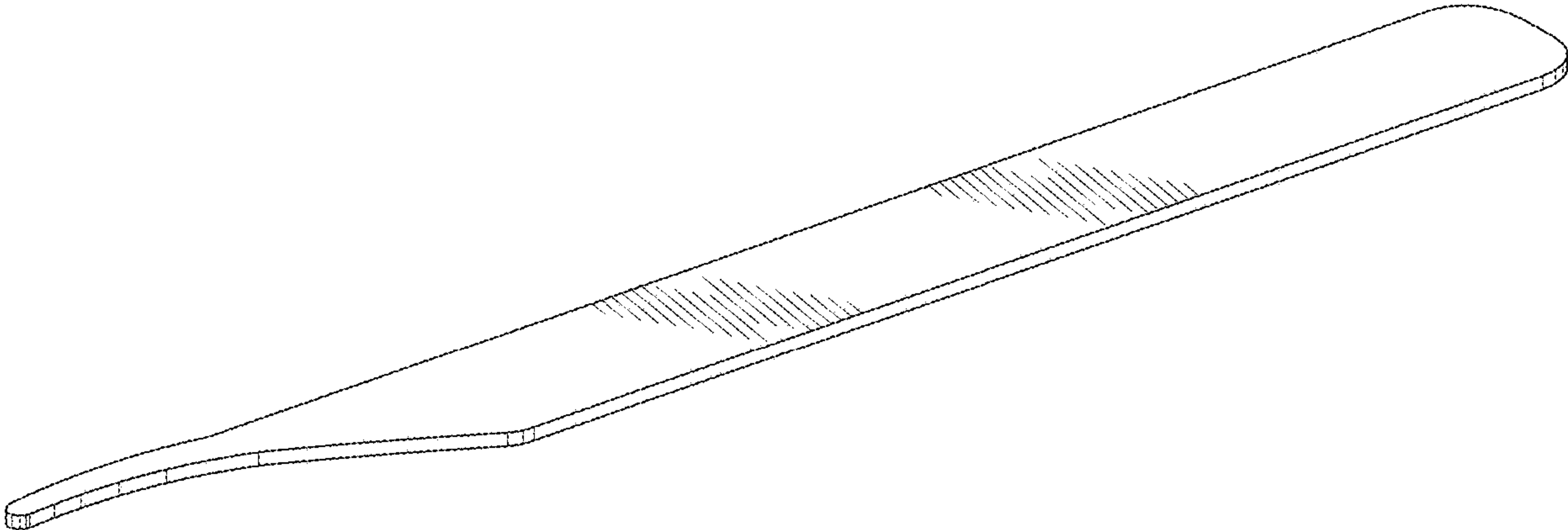
FIG. 6 is a second side elevation view of the orthopaedic surgical reference instrument of FIG. 1;

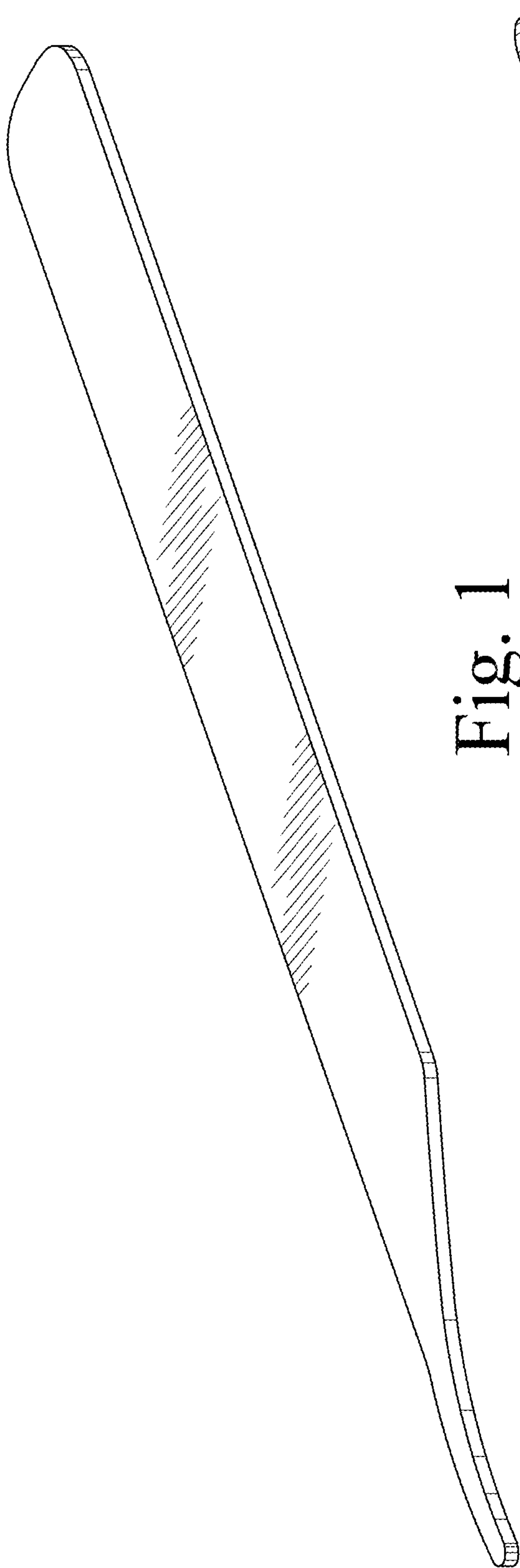

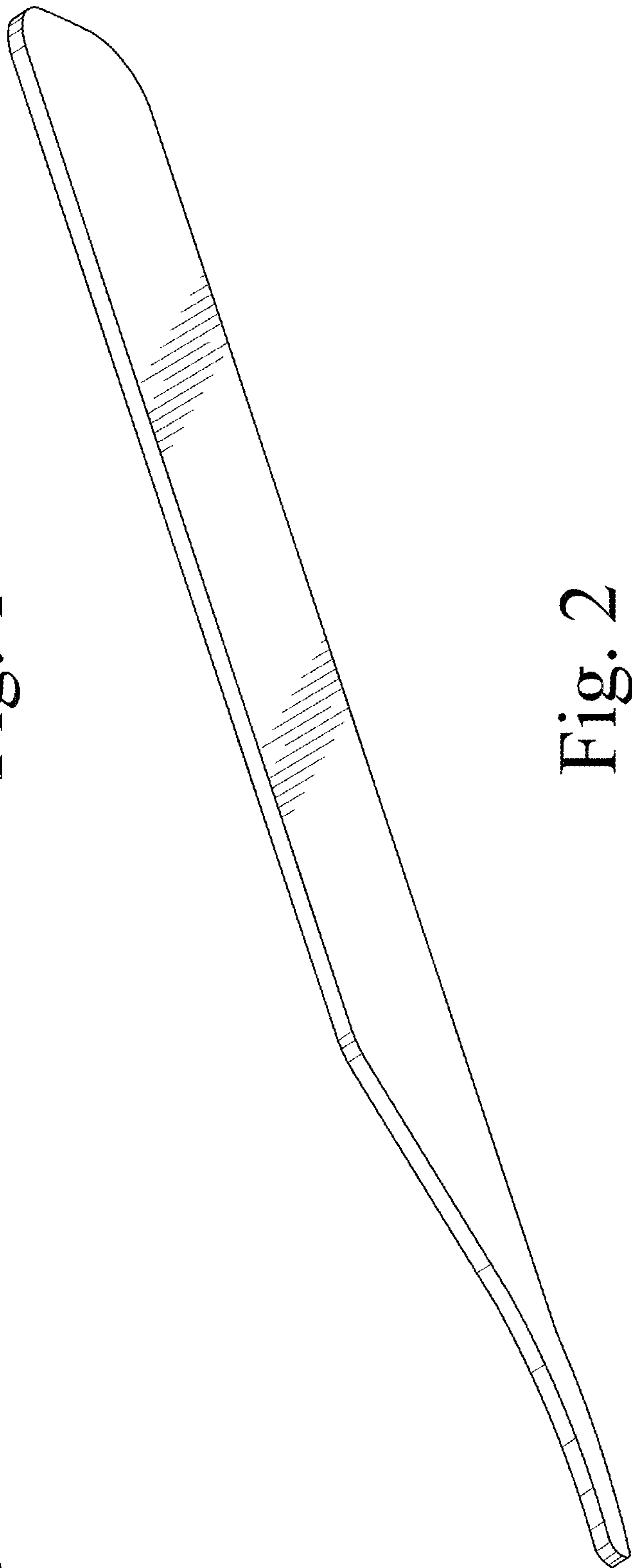

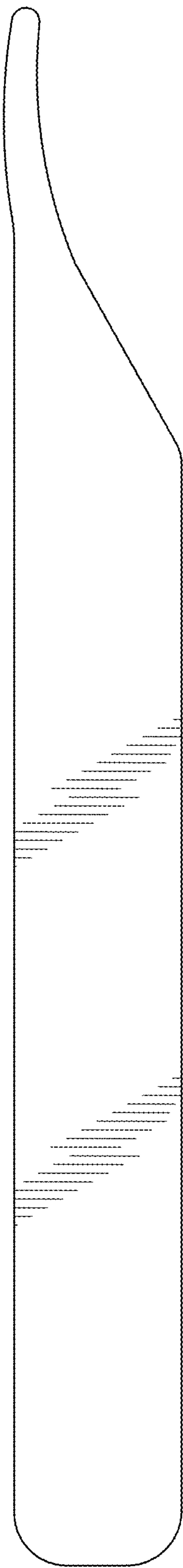

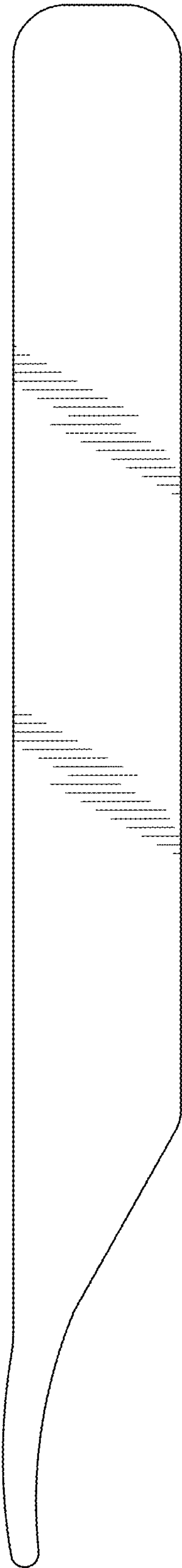
