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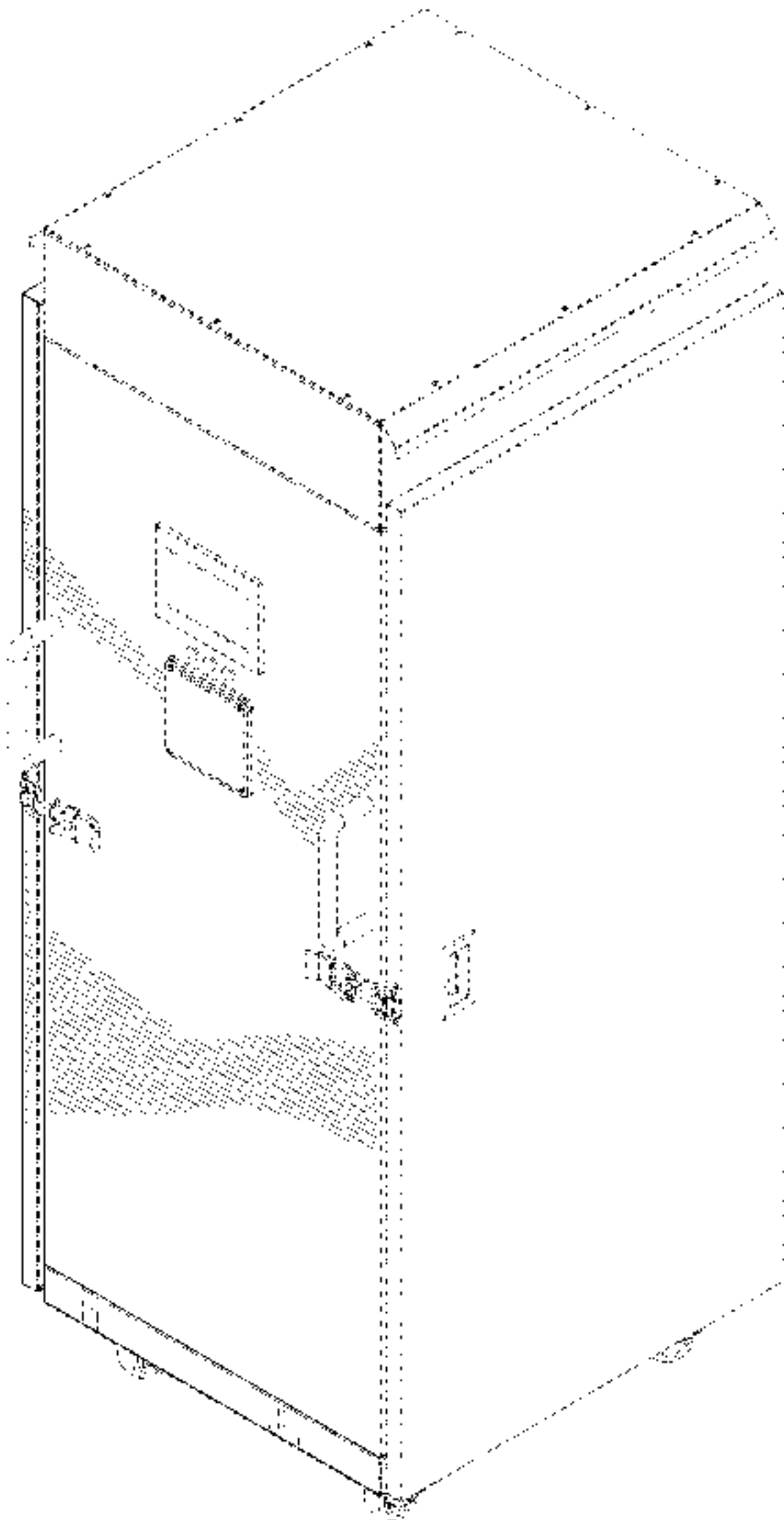
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right perspective view of the claimed design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is top plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
The ornamental design which is claimed is shown in solid lines in the drawings. Broken lines of equal or substantially equal length dashes in the Figures are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. Broken lines formed of unequal length dashes (i.e., dash-dot) show boundaries between claimed and unclaimed portions of the design. Oblique lines show a transparent, translucent, highly polished, or reflective surface, and not surface ornamentation. The shade lines in the Figures show contour and not surface ornamentation.

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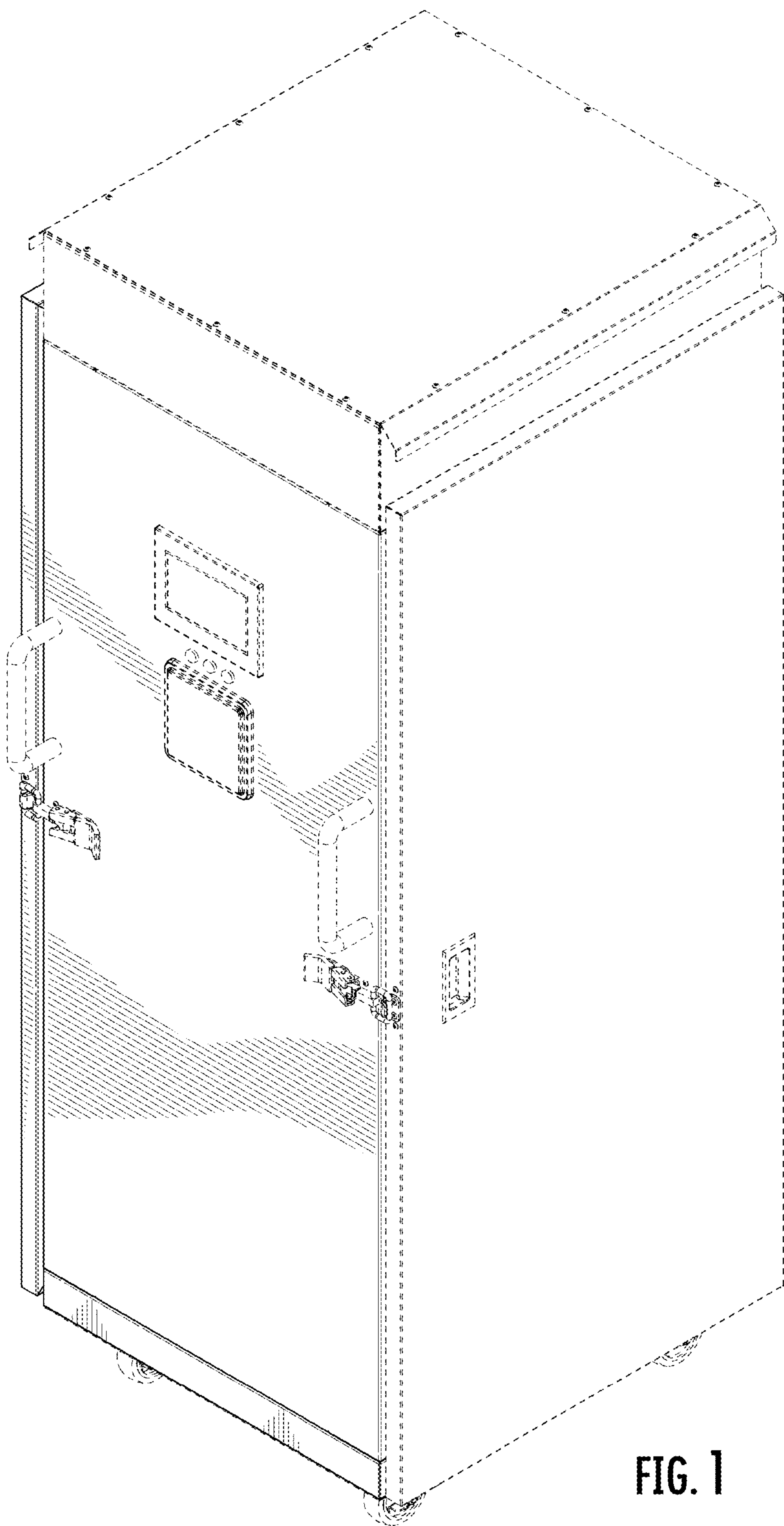
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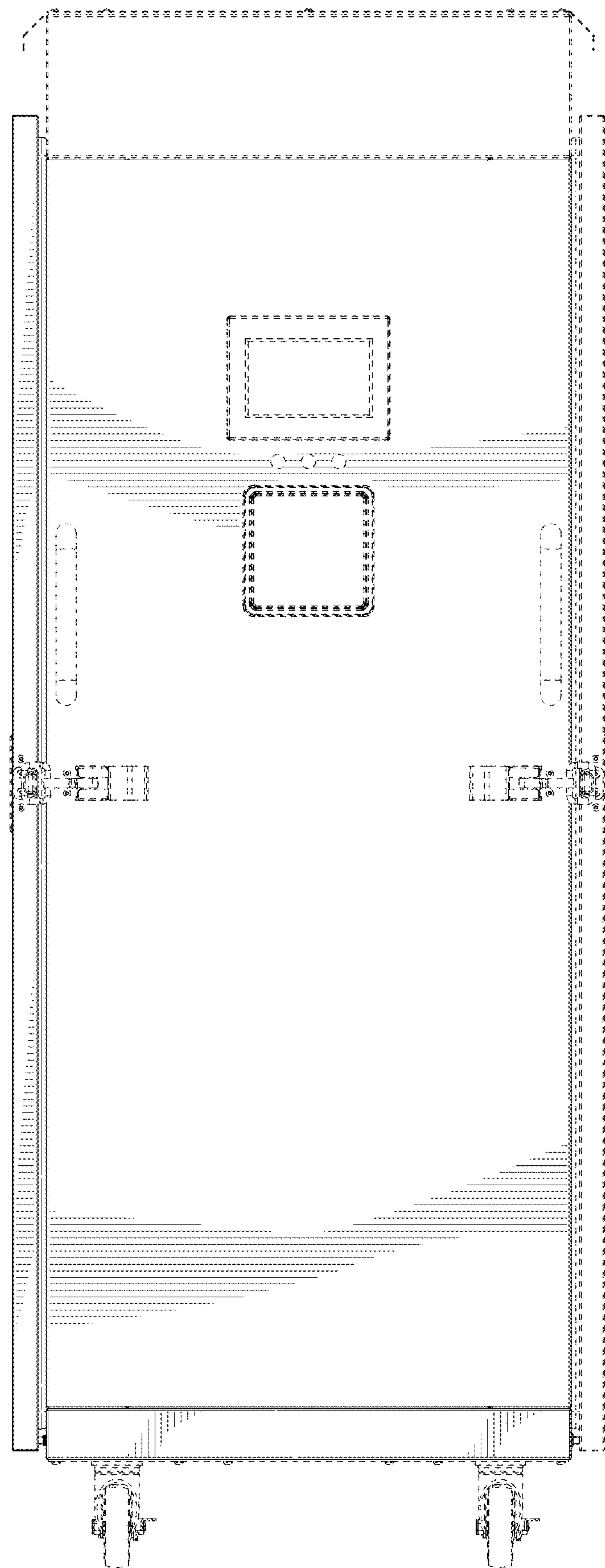

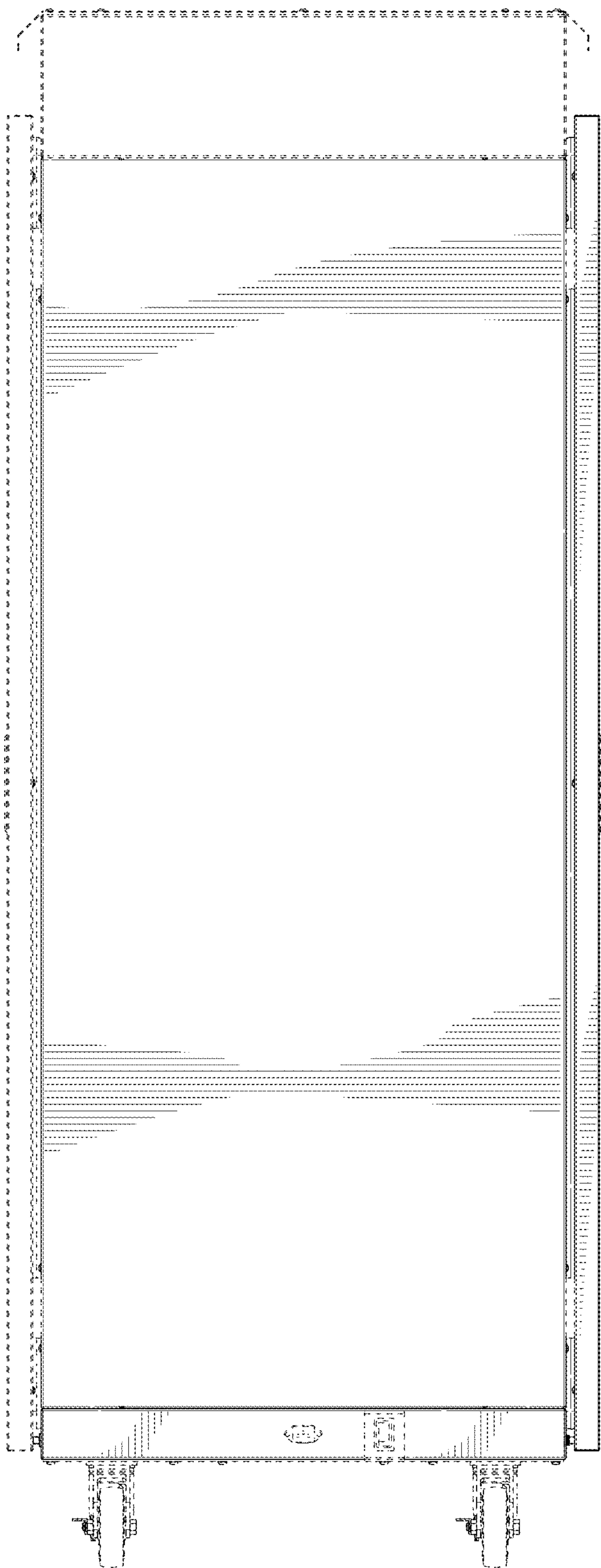

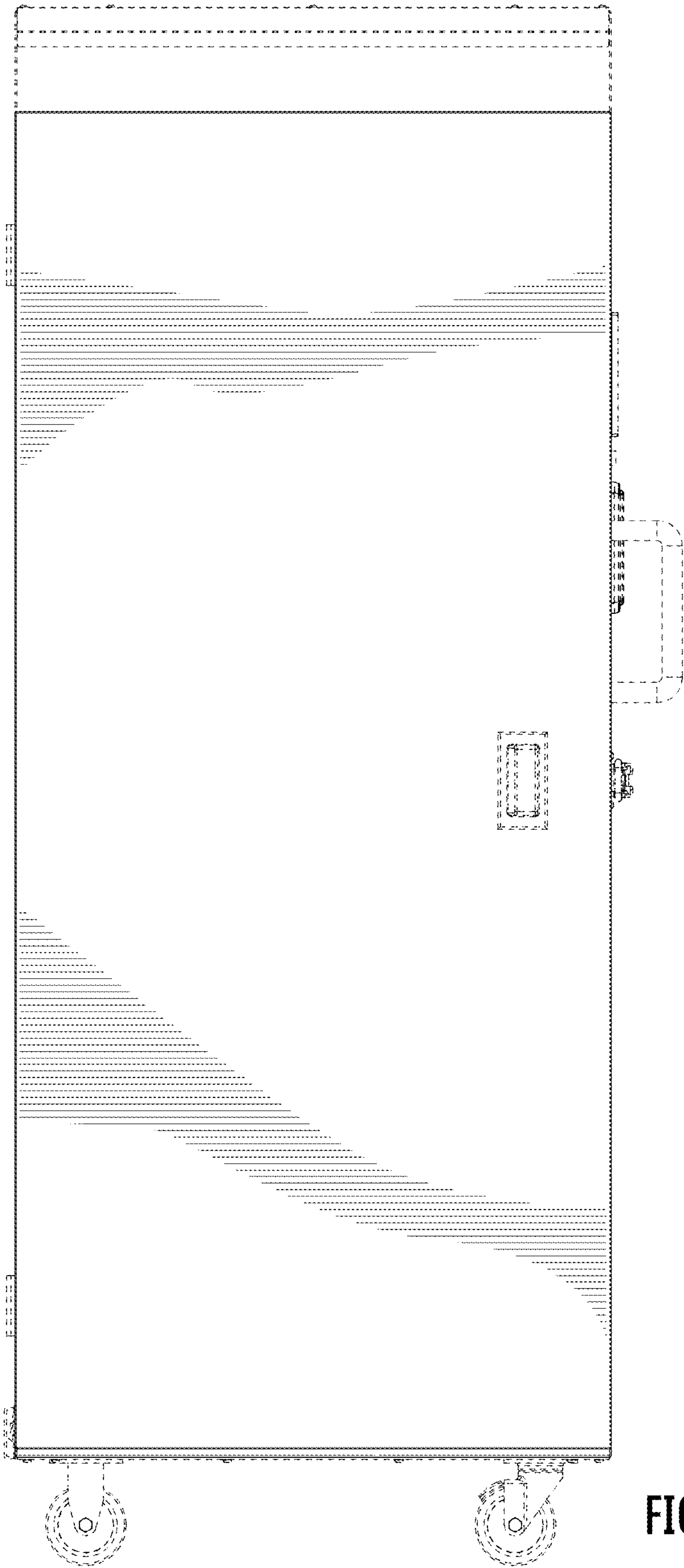
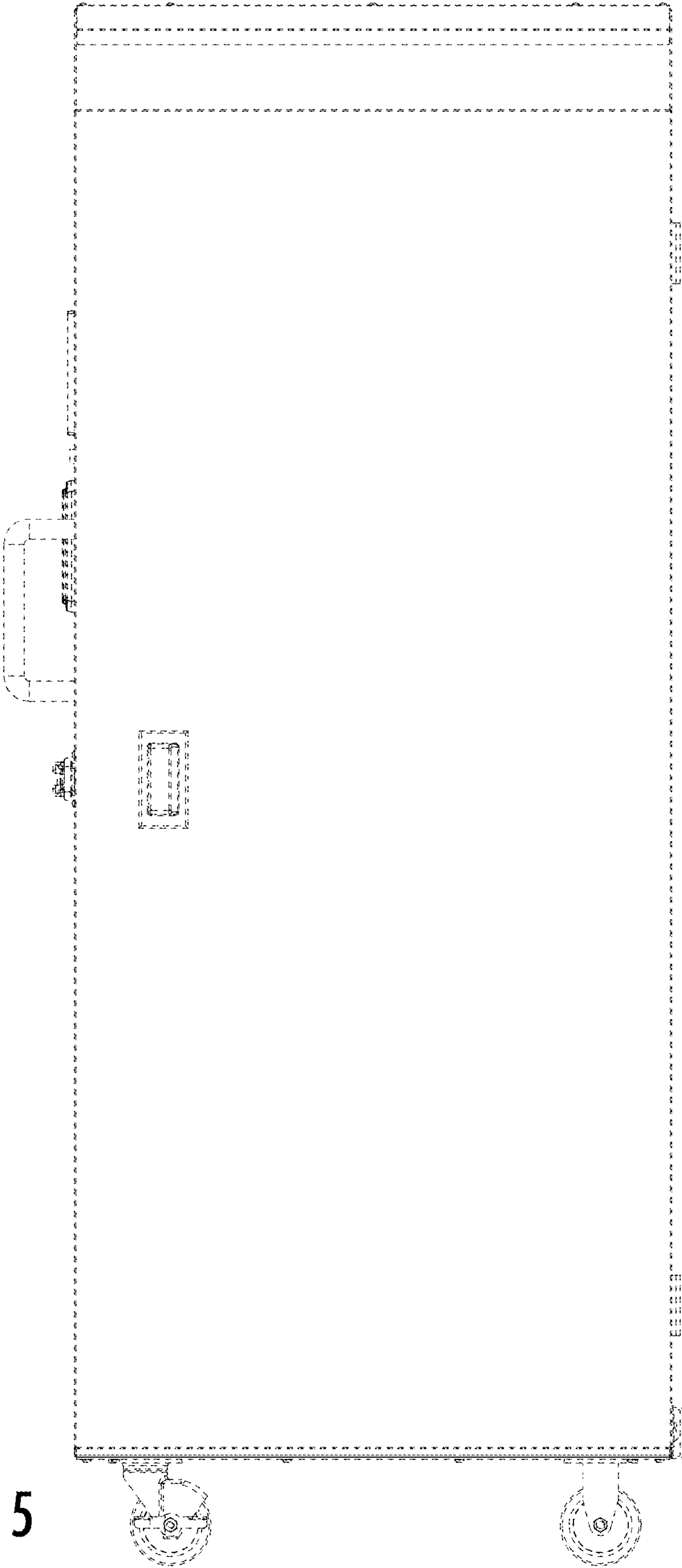

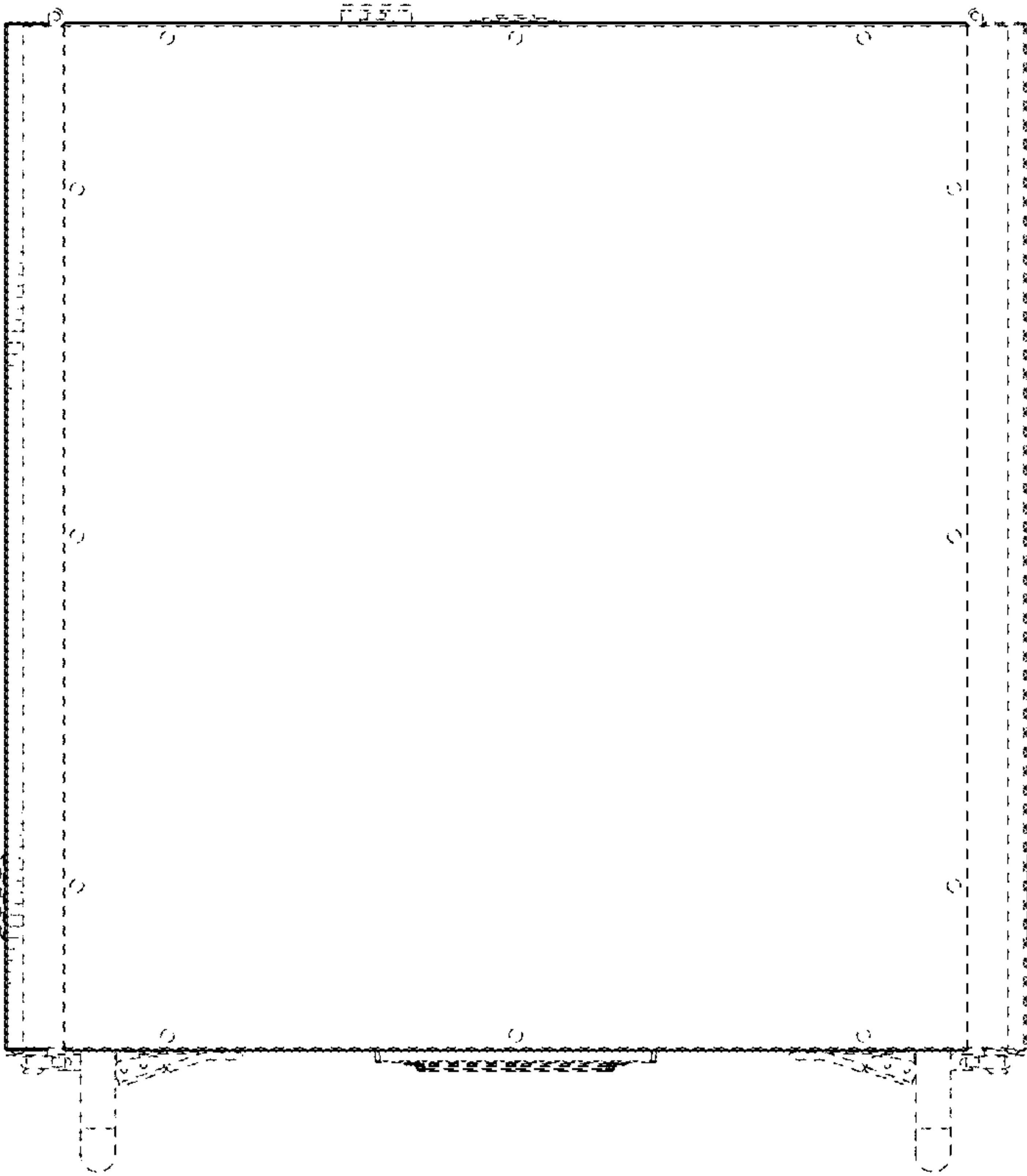

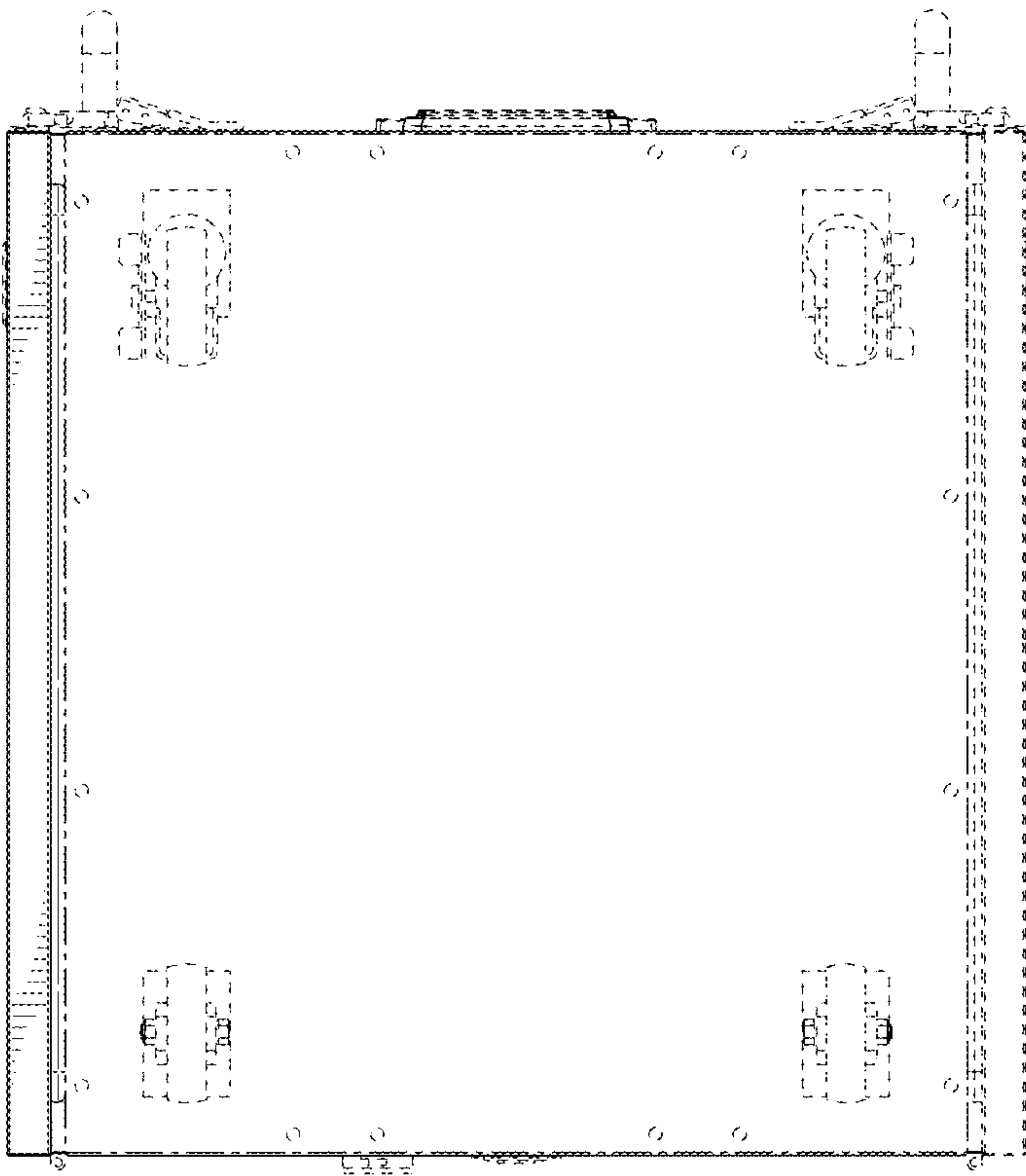
