bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

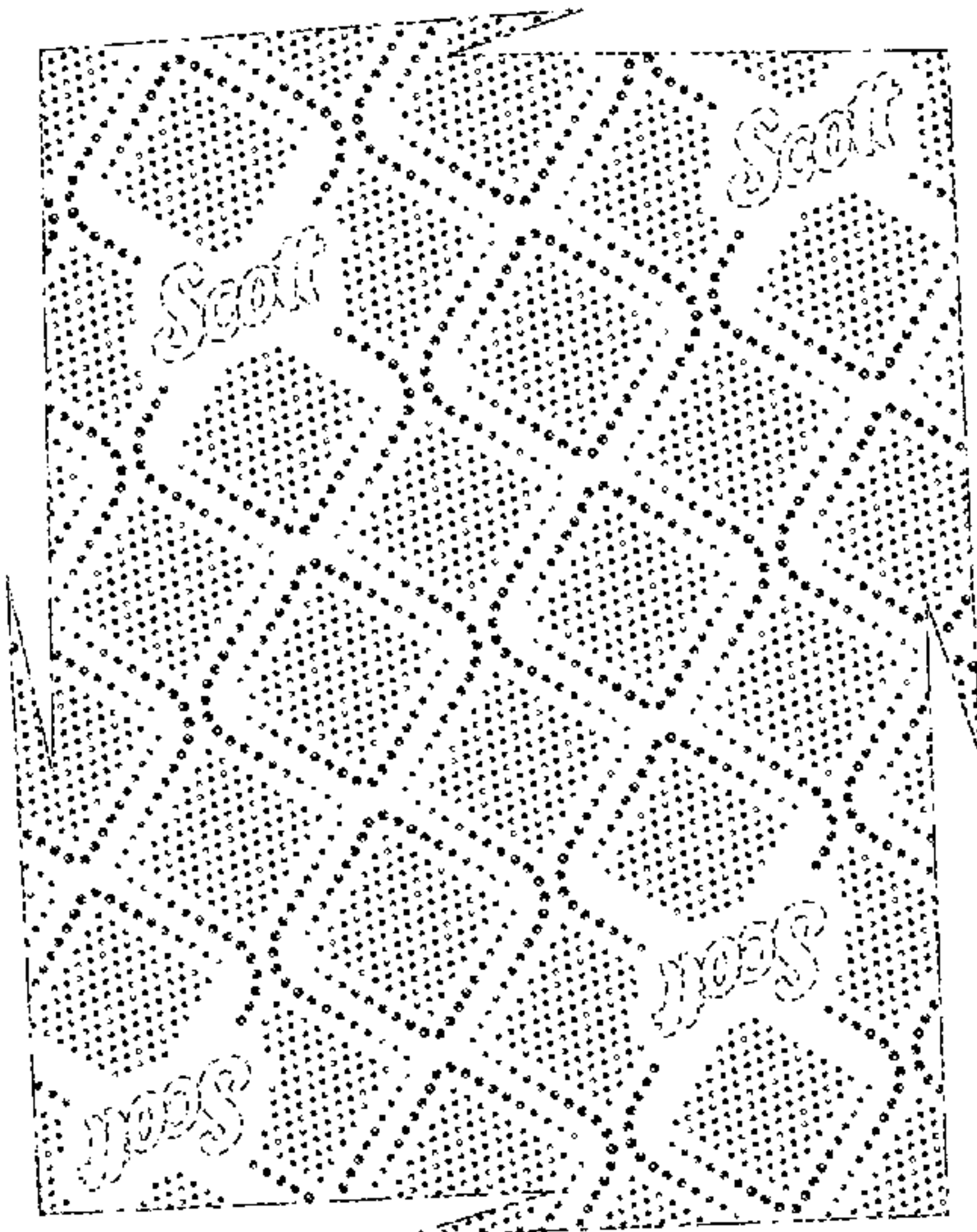

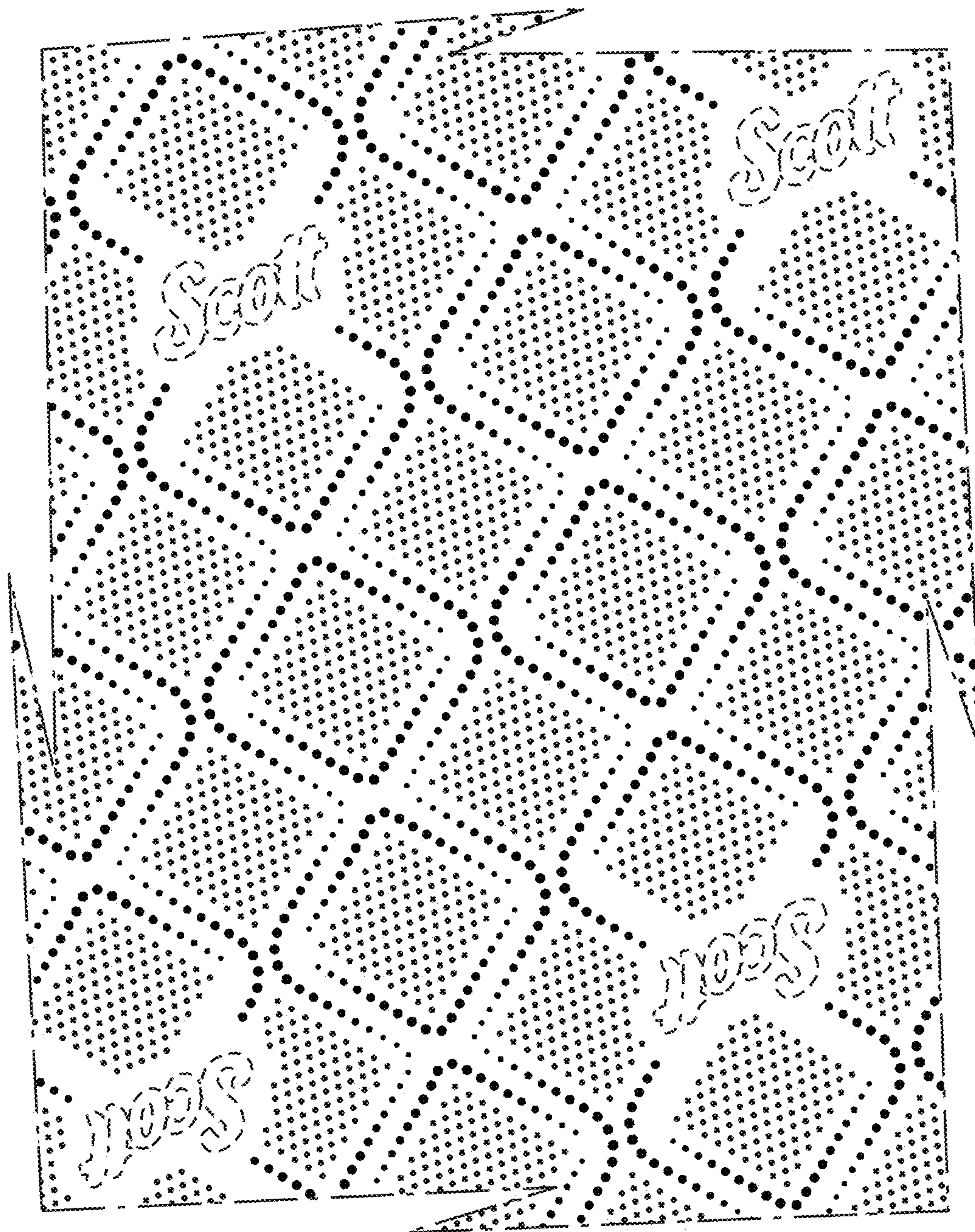

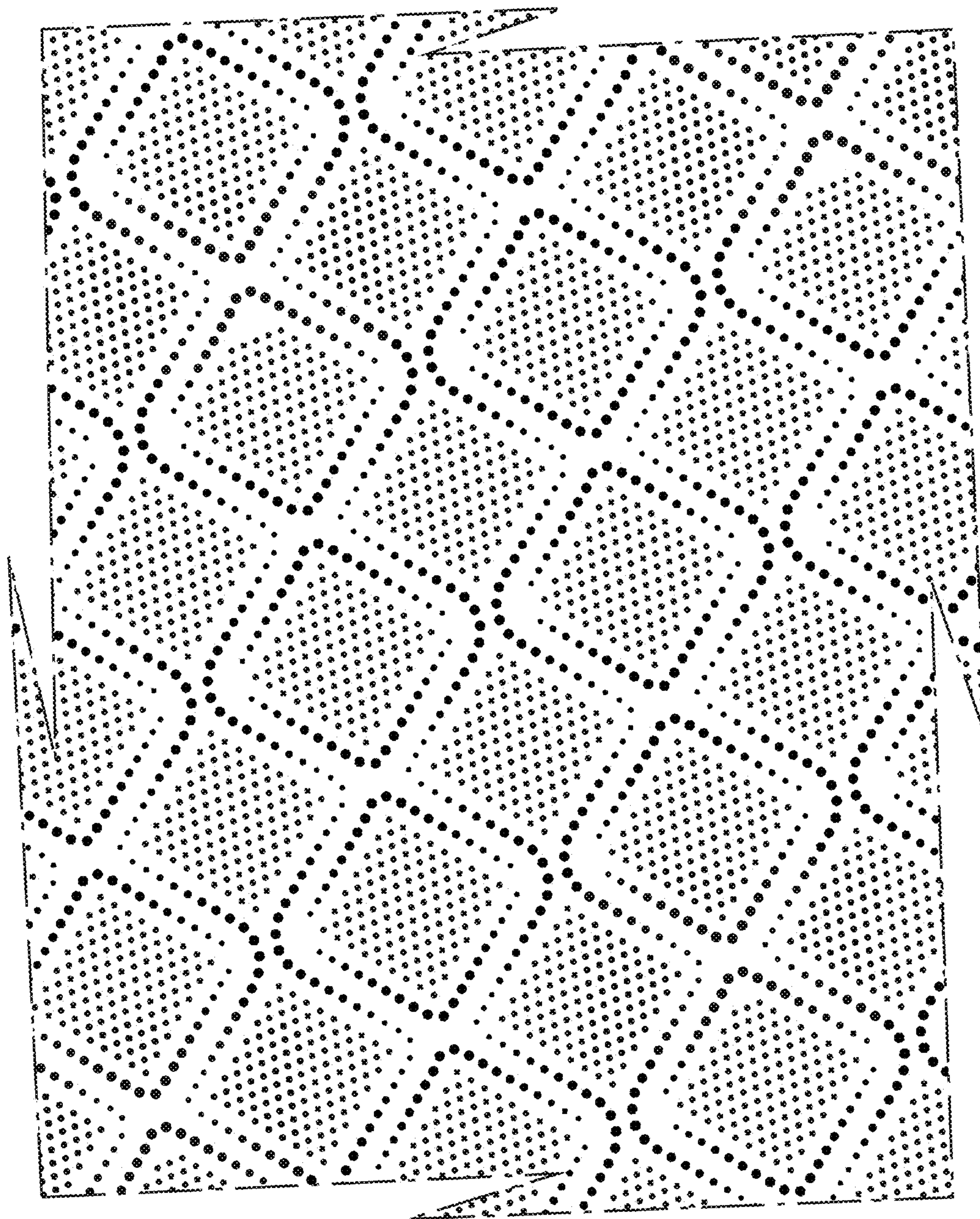

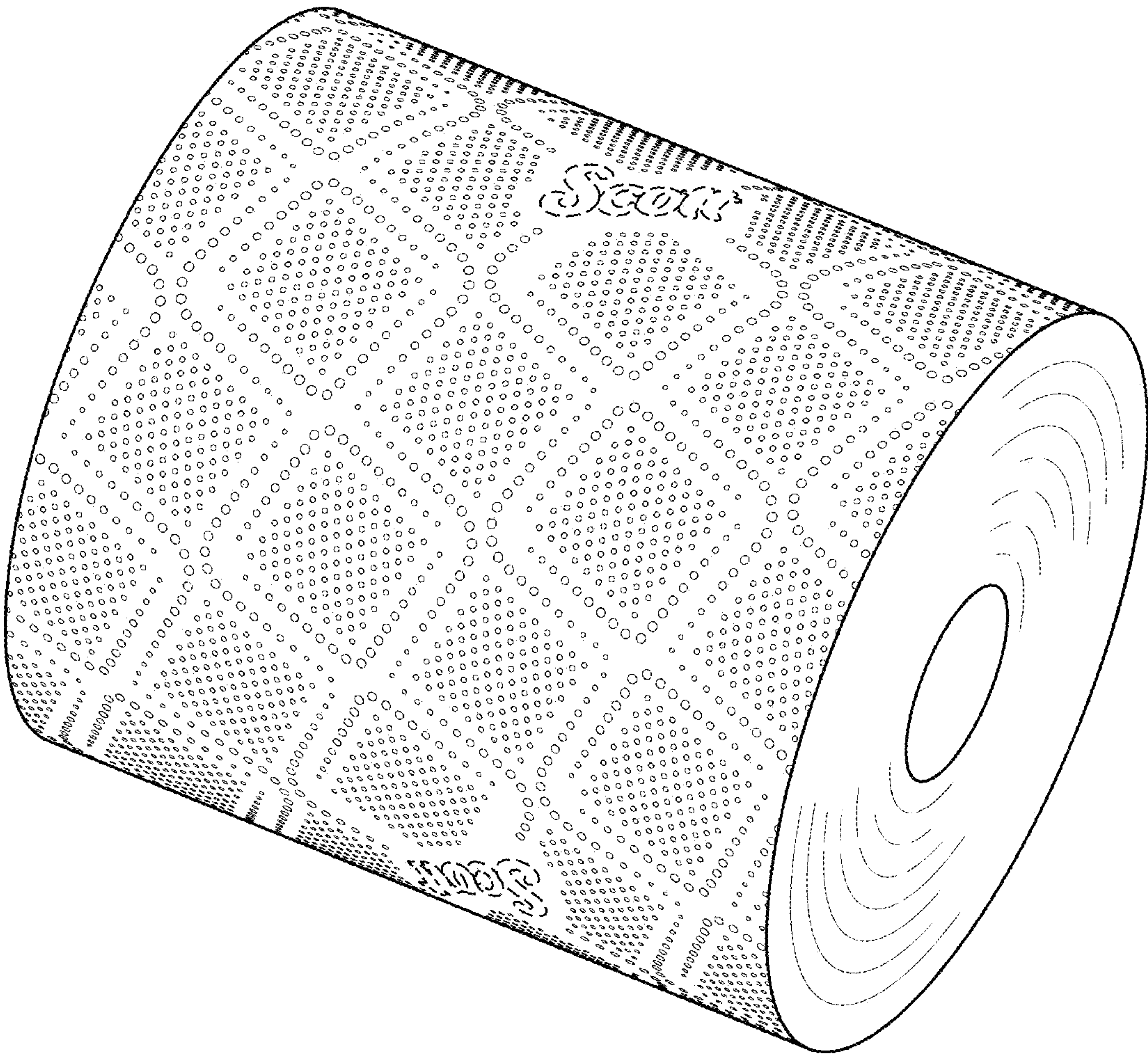
