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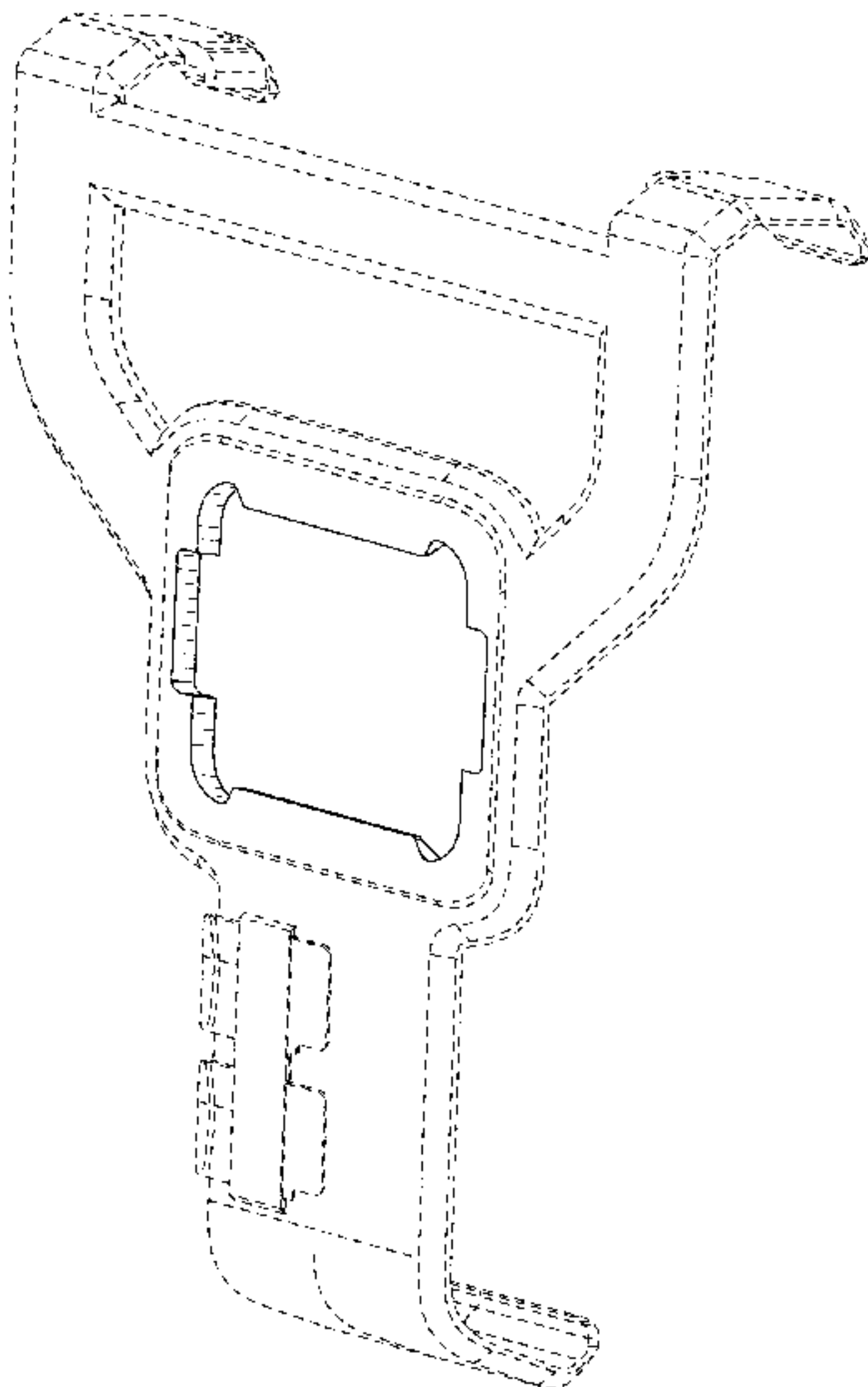
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic device mount adapter, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the electronic device mount adapter of FIG. 1, shown attached to an additional environmental electronic device;
FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a left side elevation view thereof;

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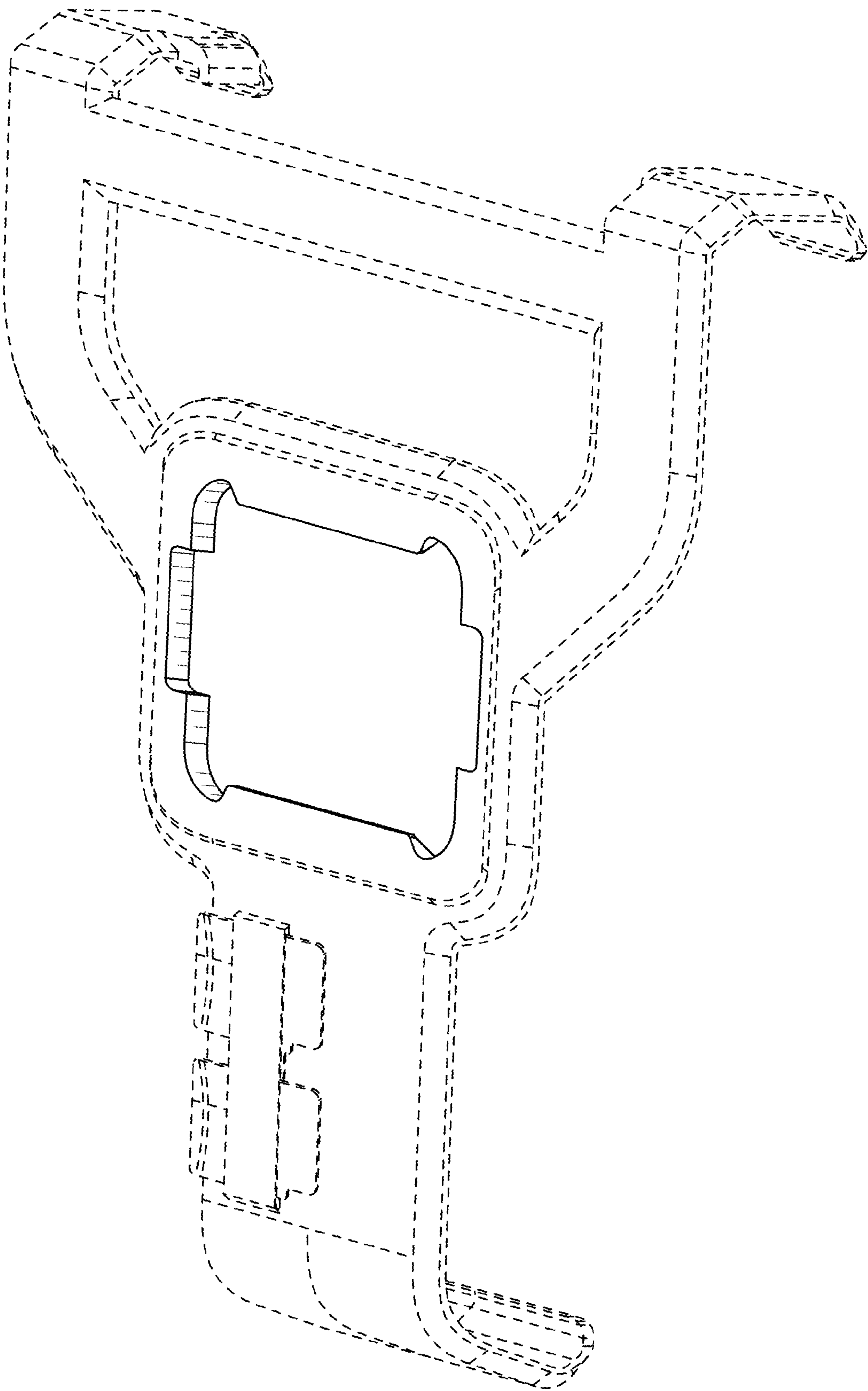

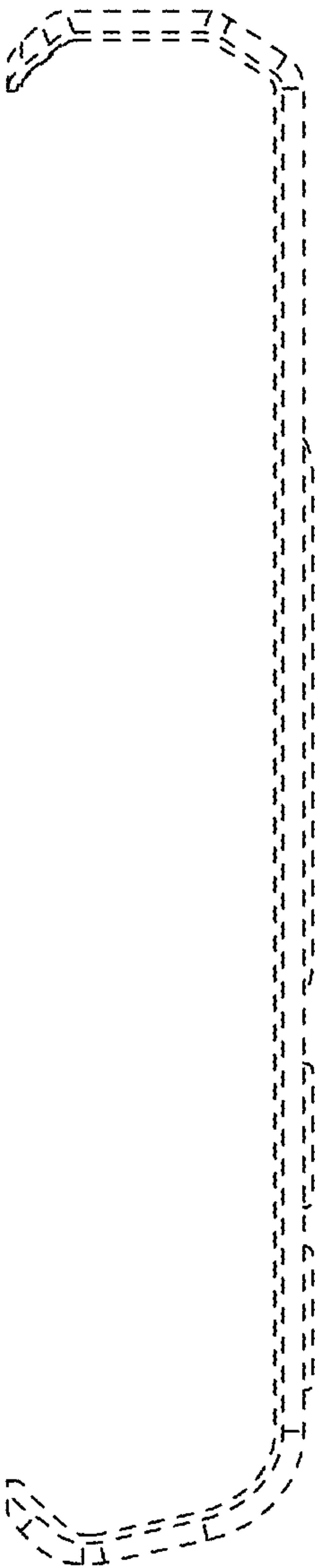

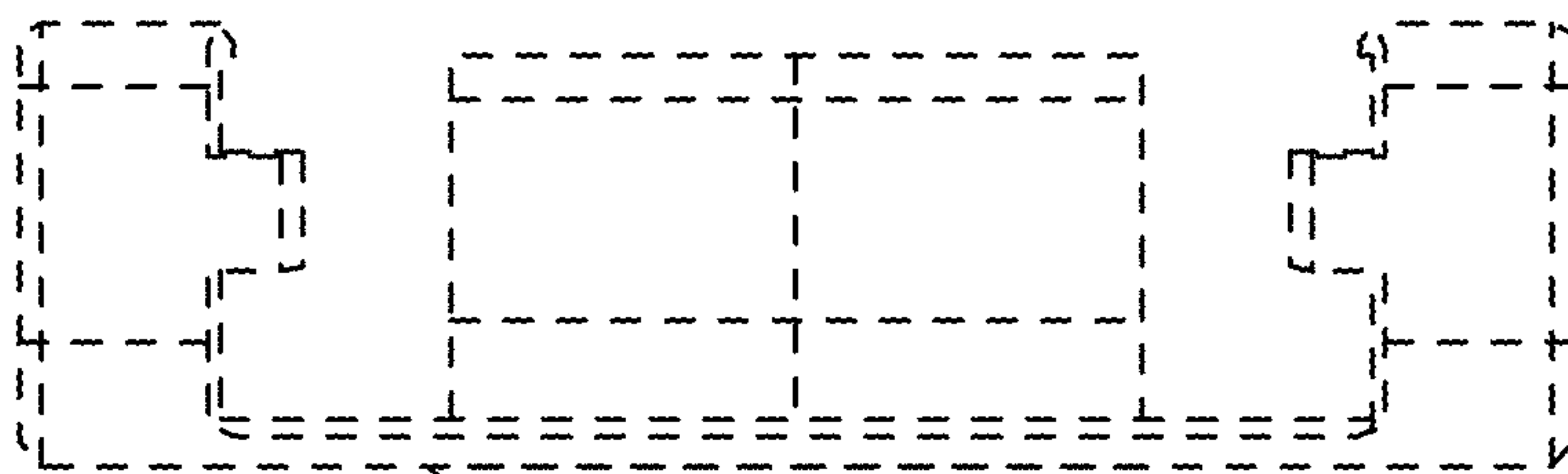

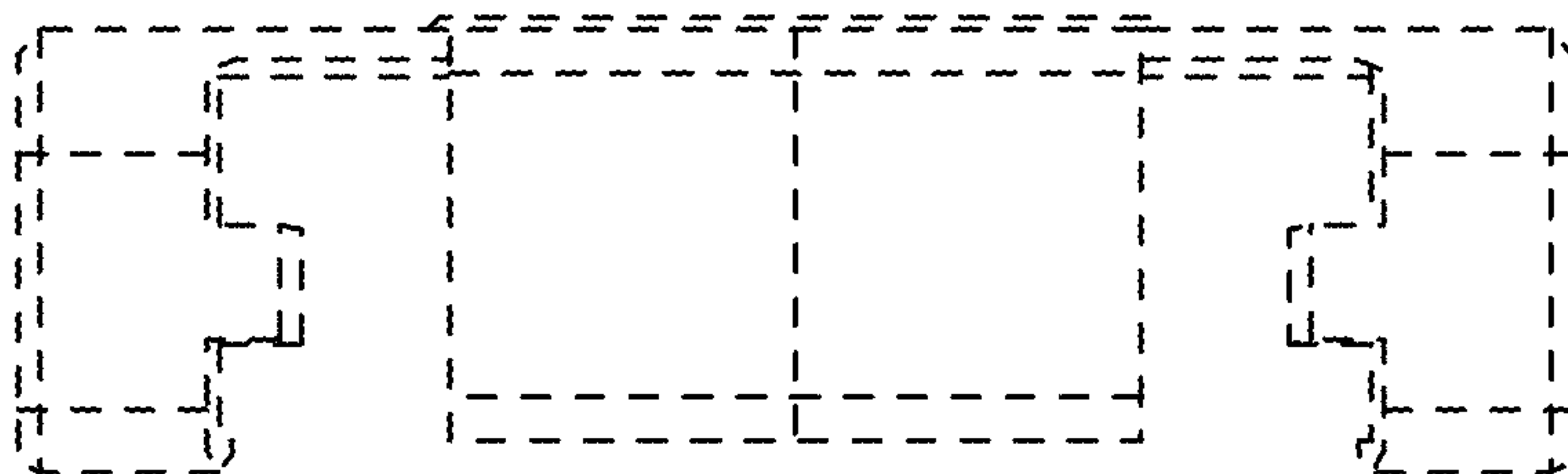

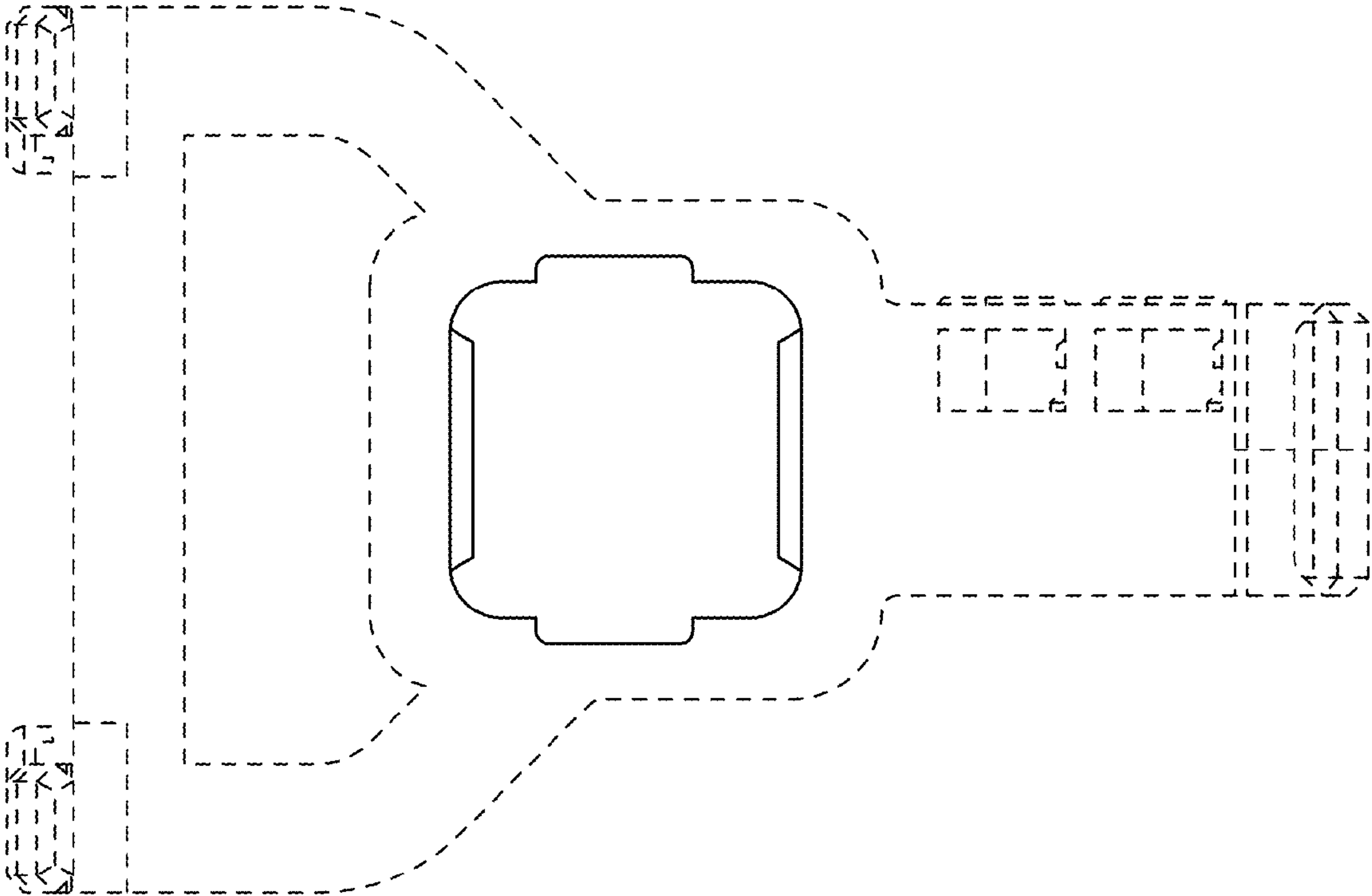

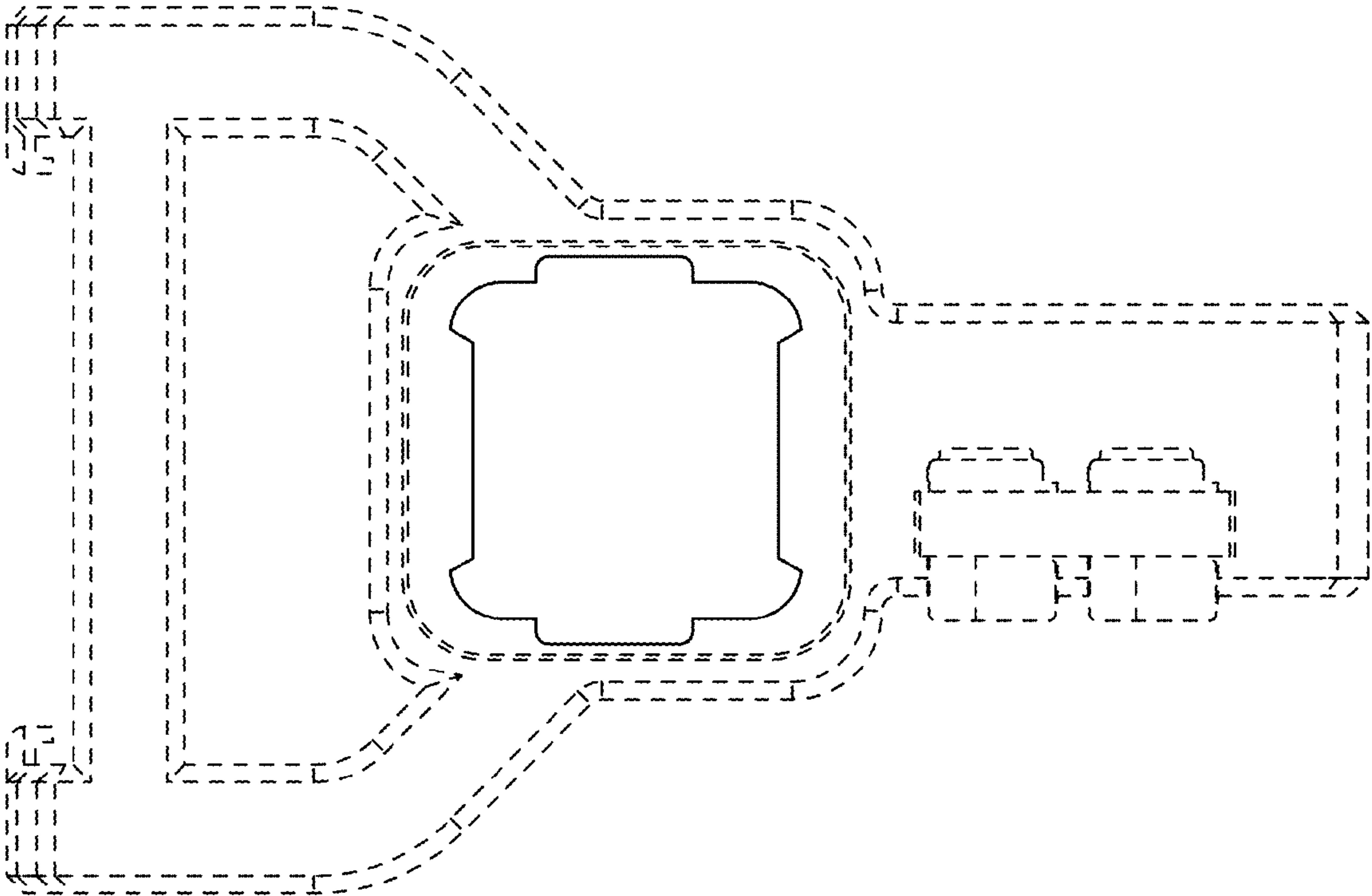

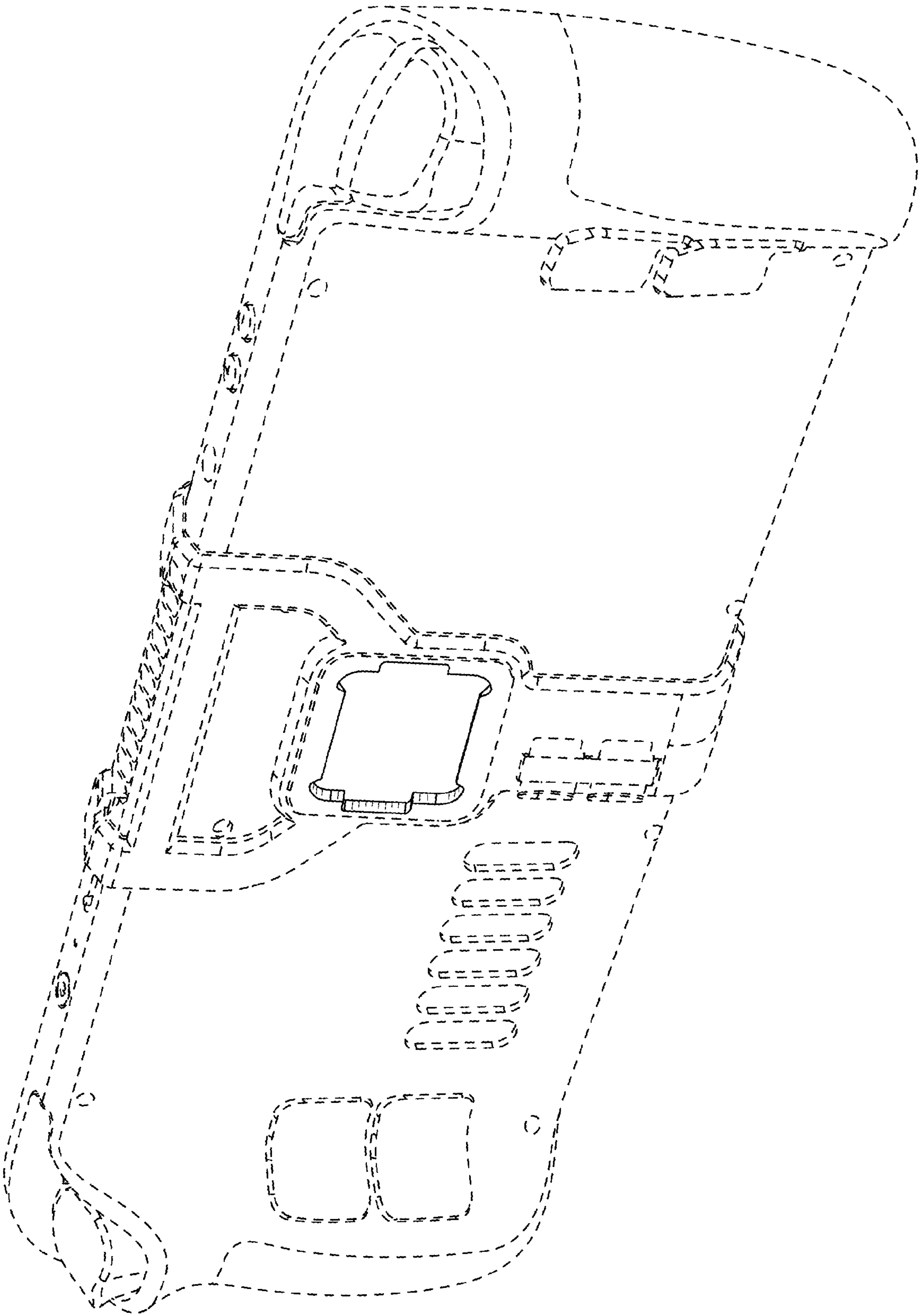

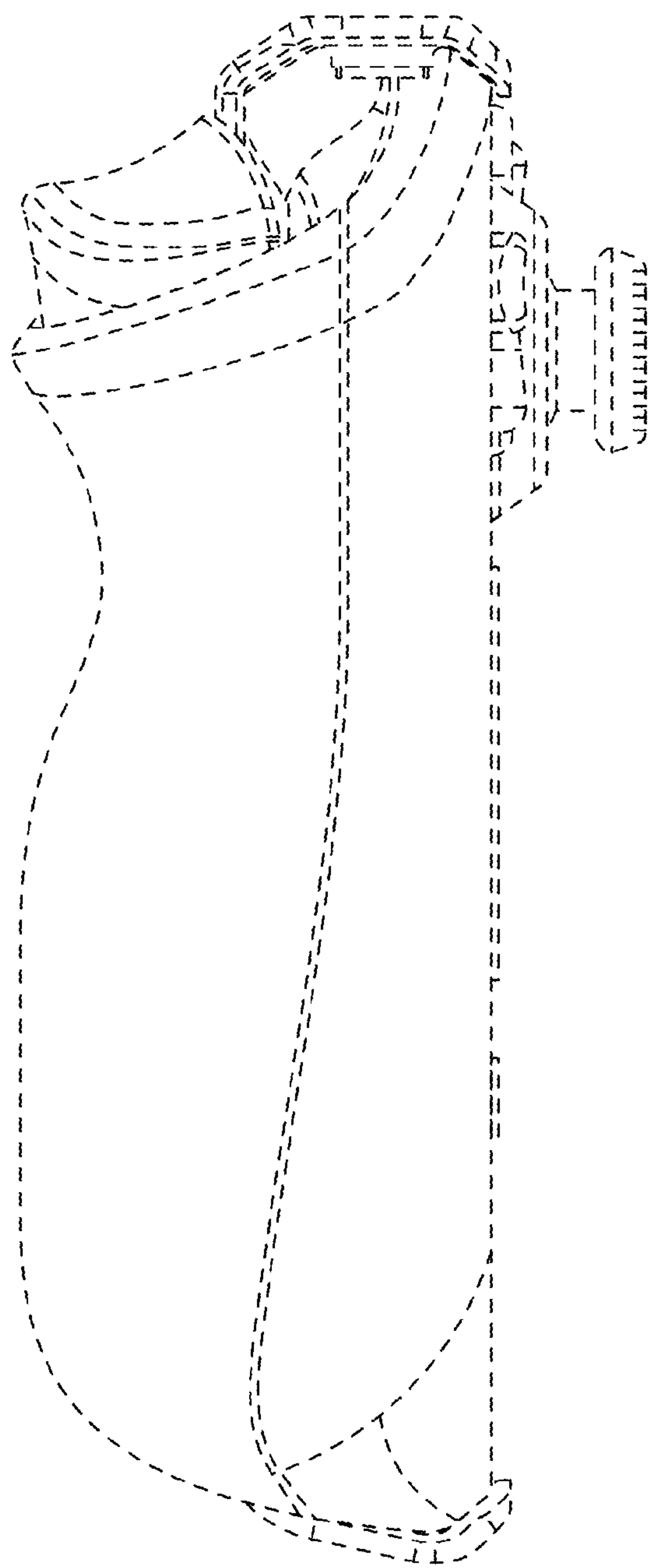

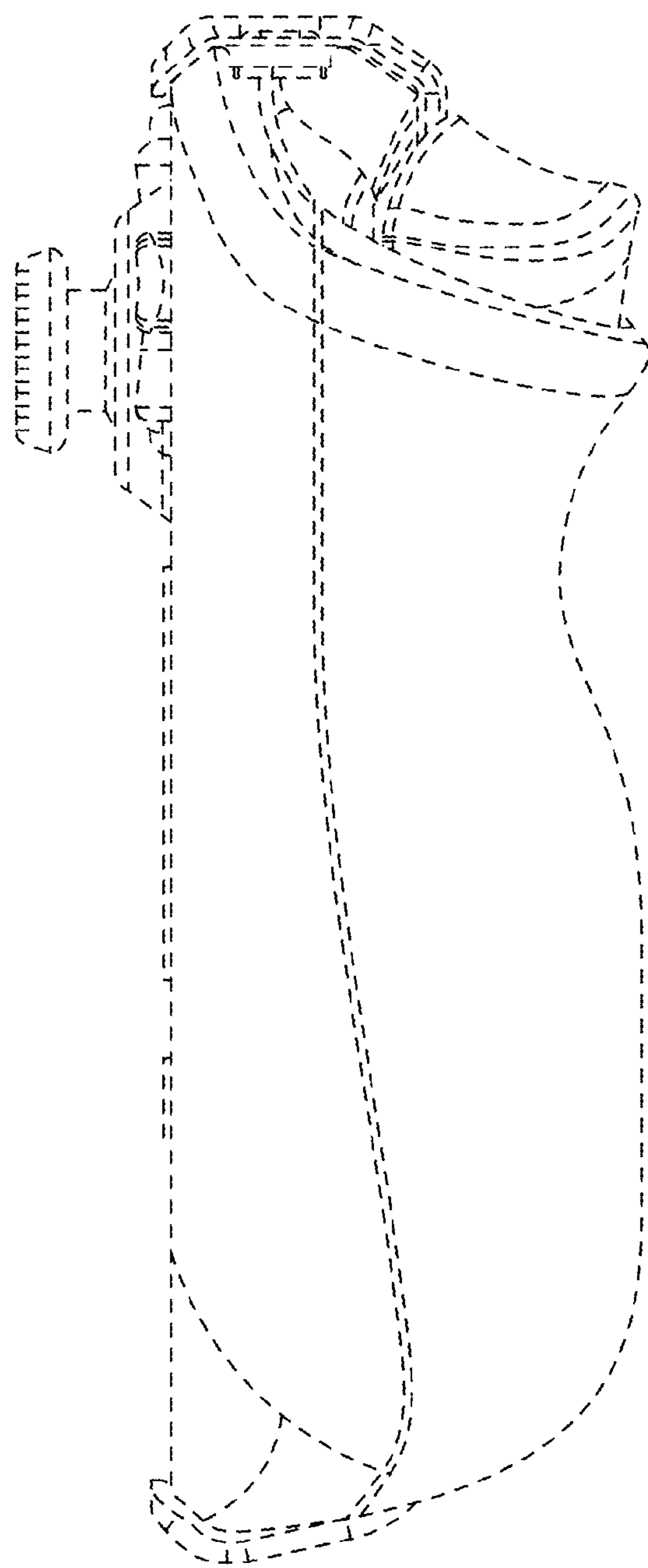

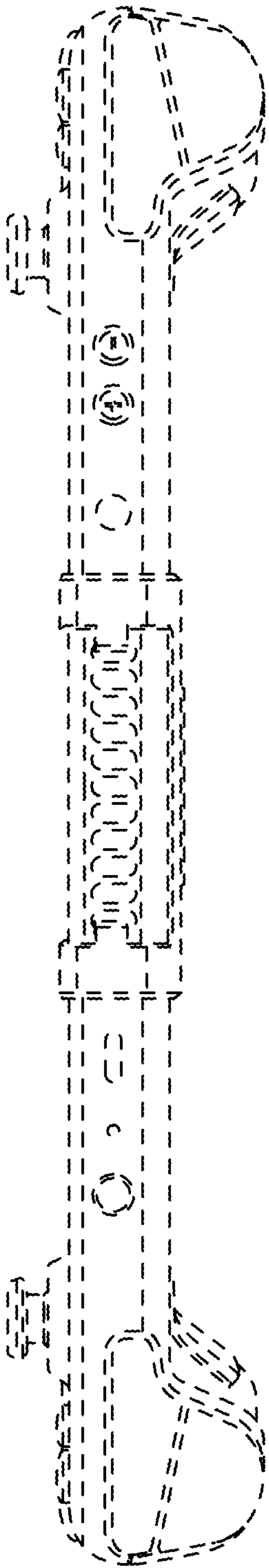

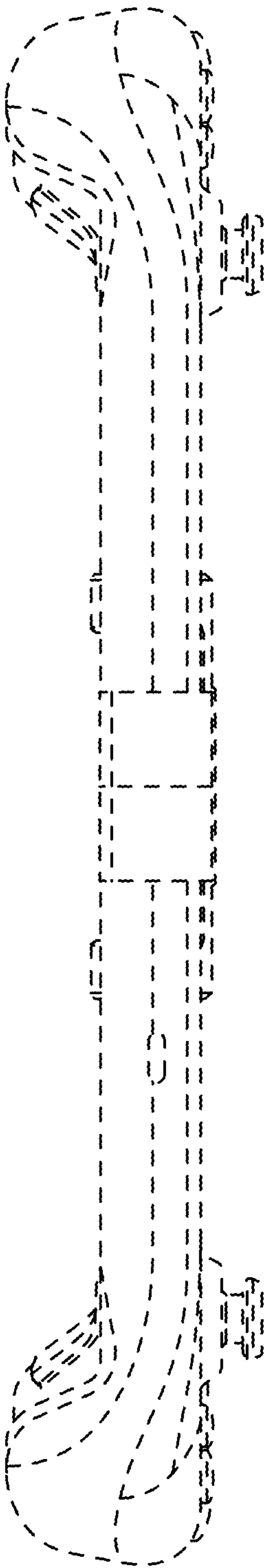
