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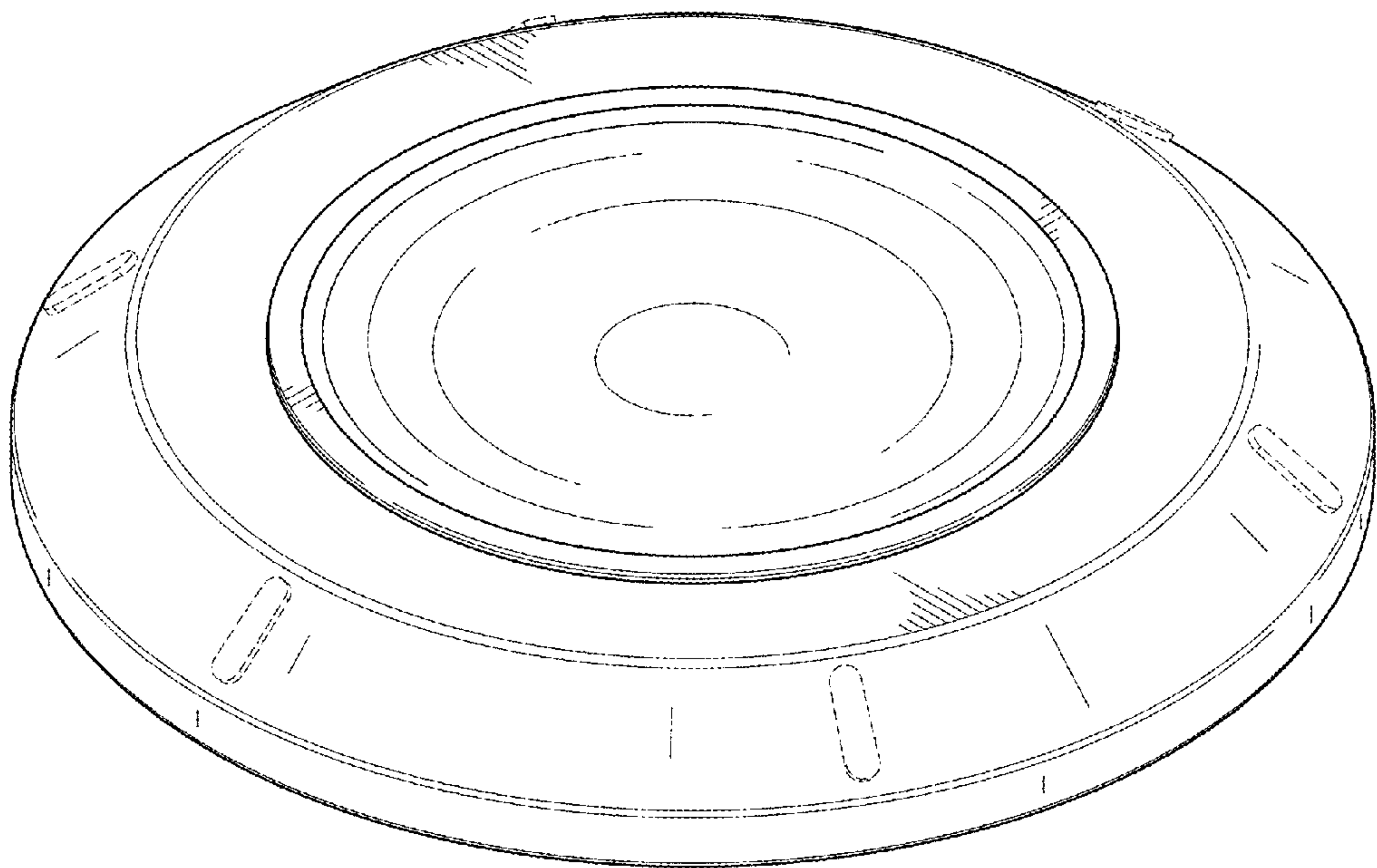
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a poker chip as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a poker chip showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the poker chip of FIG. 1;
FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the poker chip of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view of the poker chip of FIG. 8, shown with a second poker chip in an environment of use. The broken lines depict portions of the poker chip that form no part of the claimed design. The additional broken lines shown in FIG. 9 illustrate environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design.

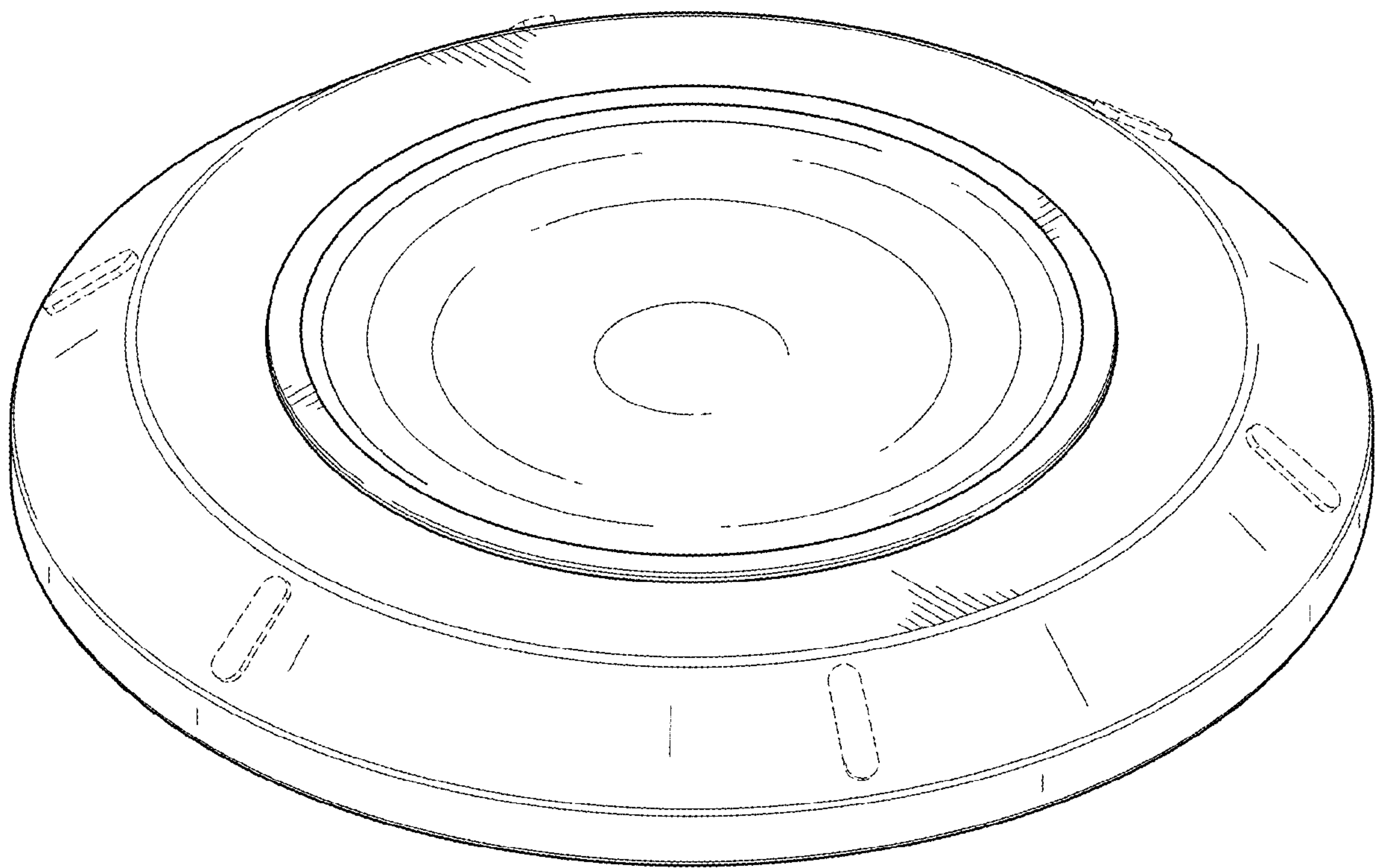

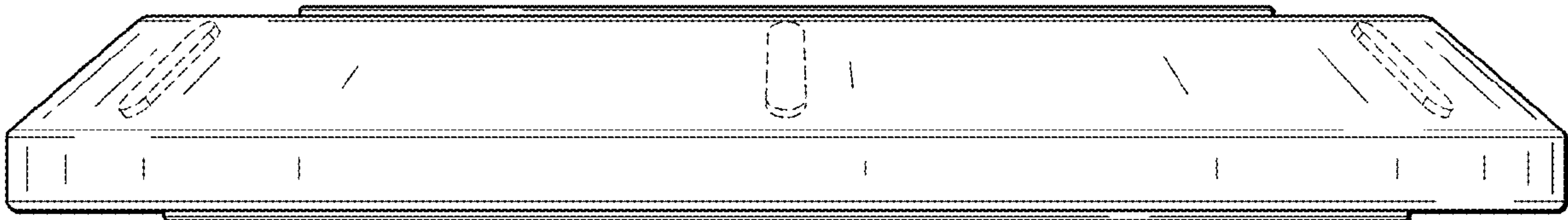

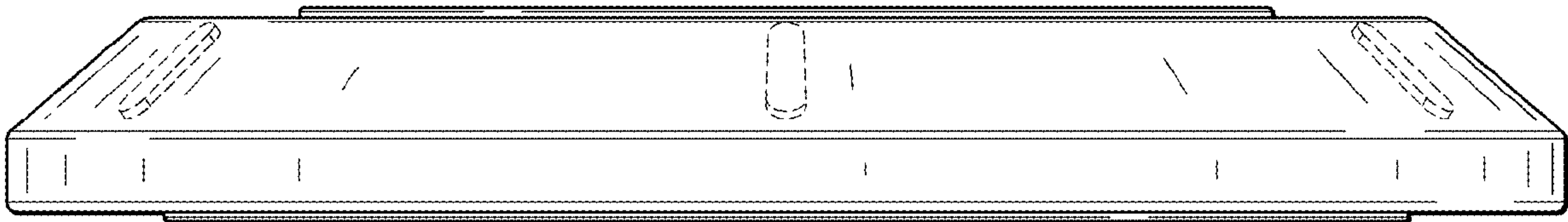

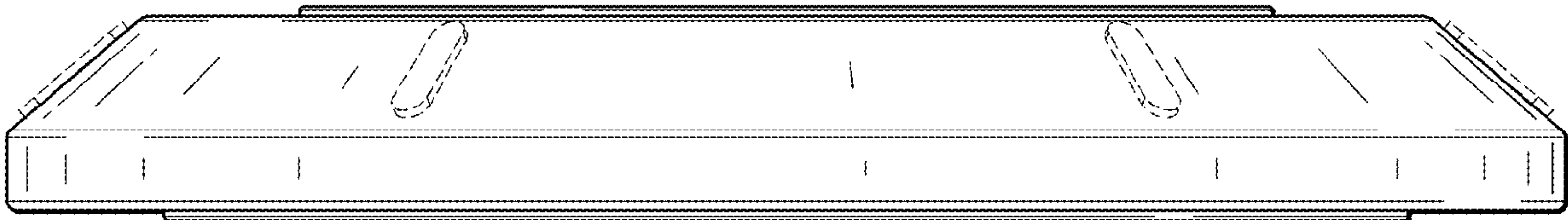

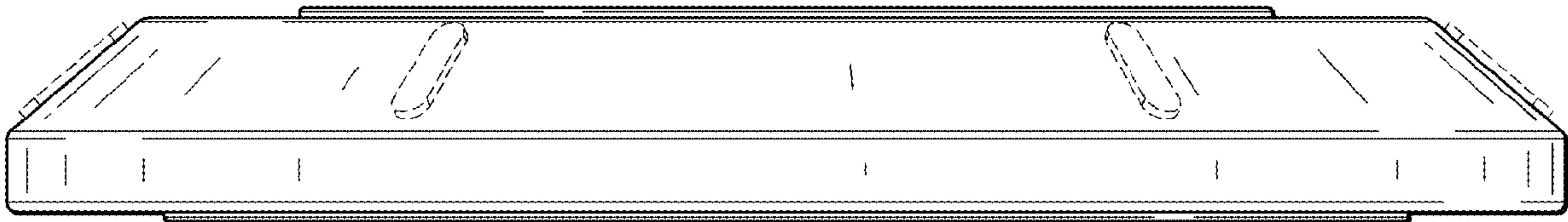

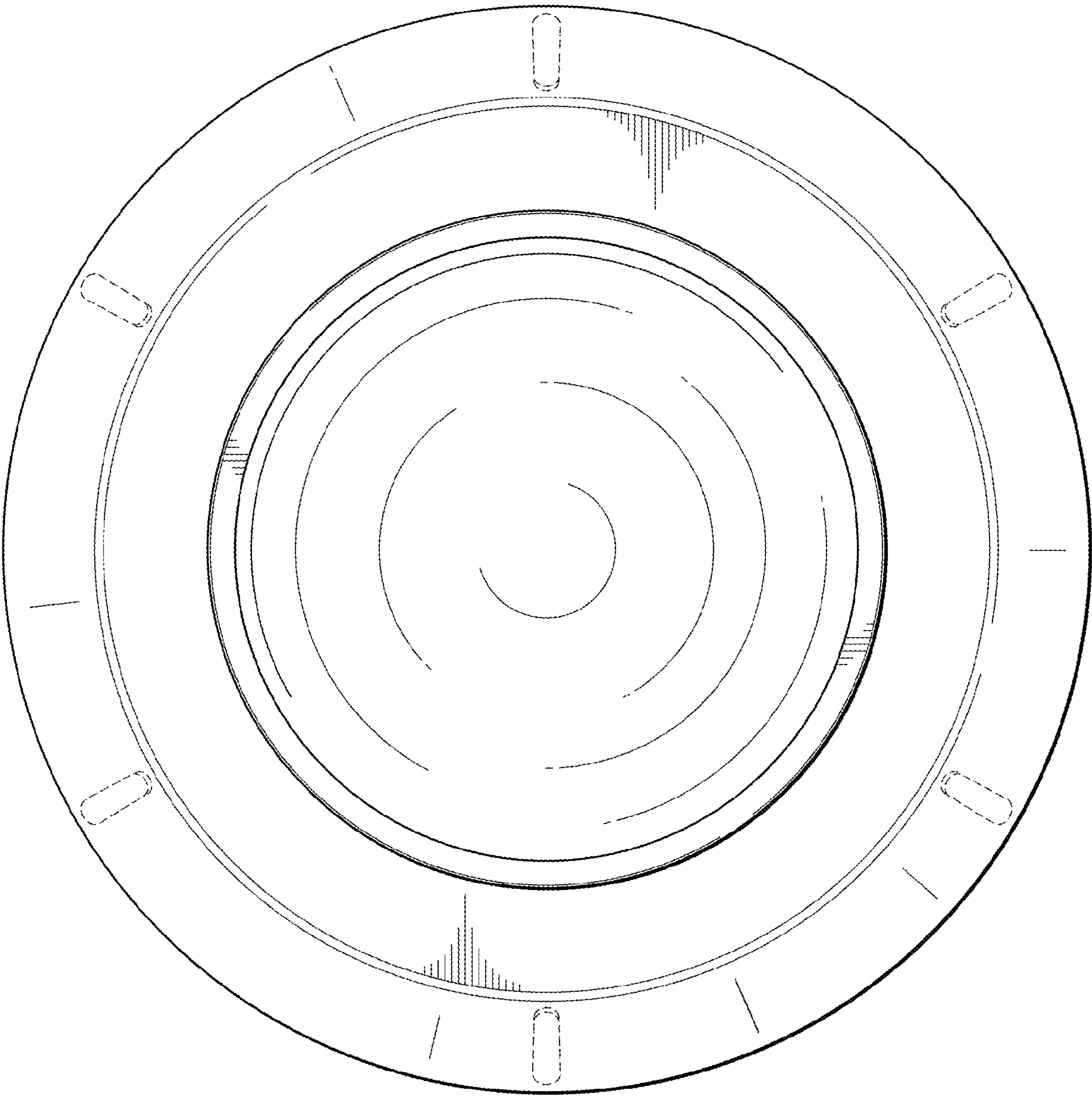

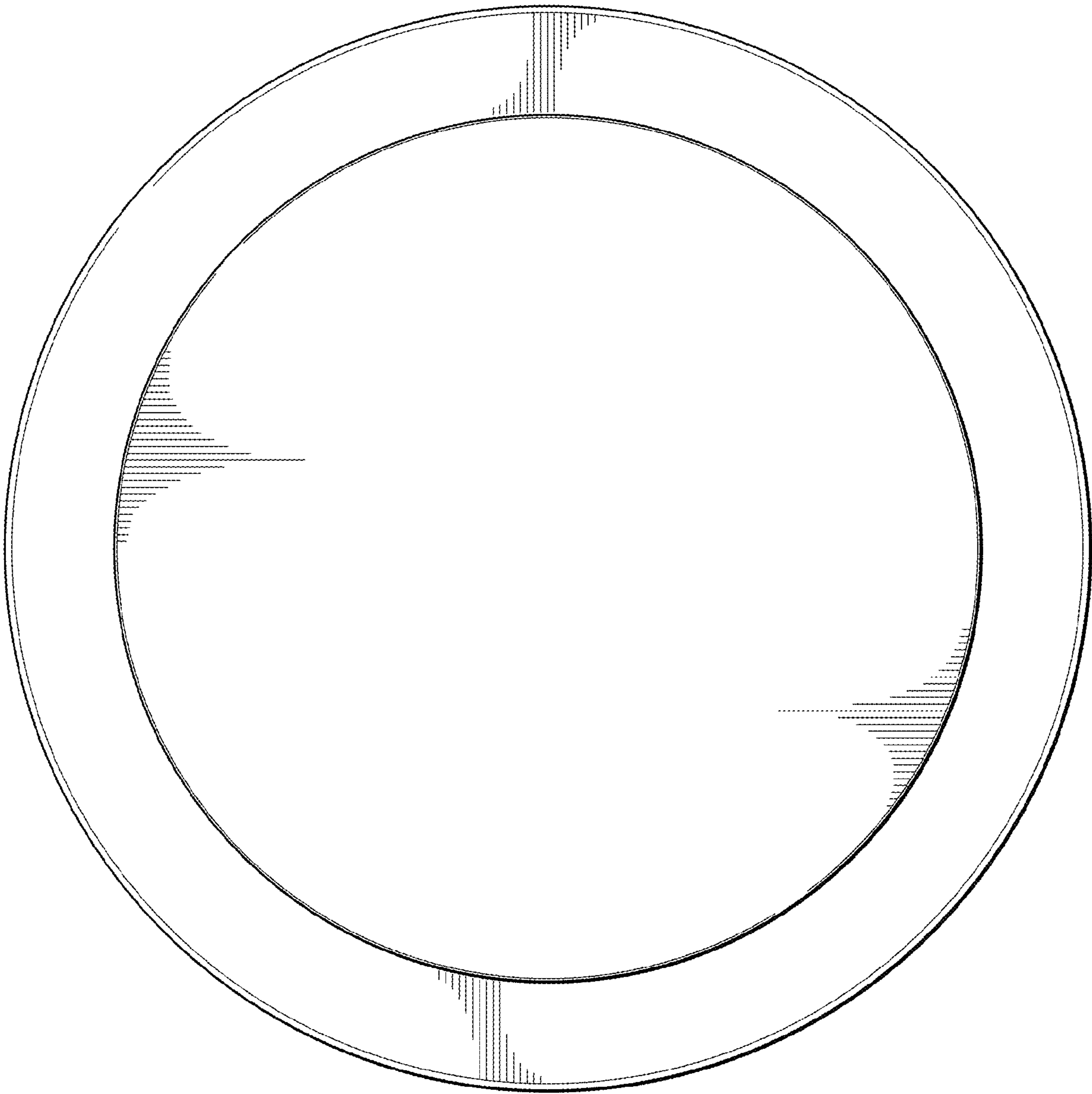

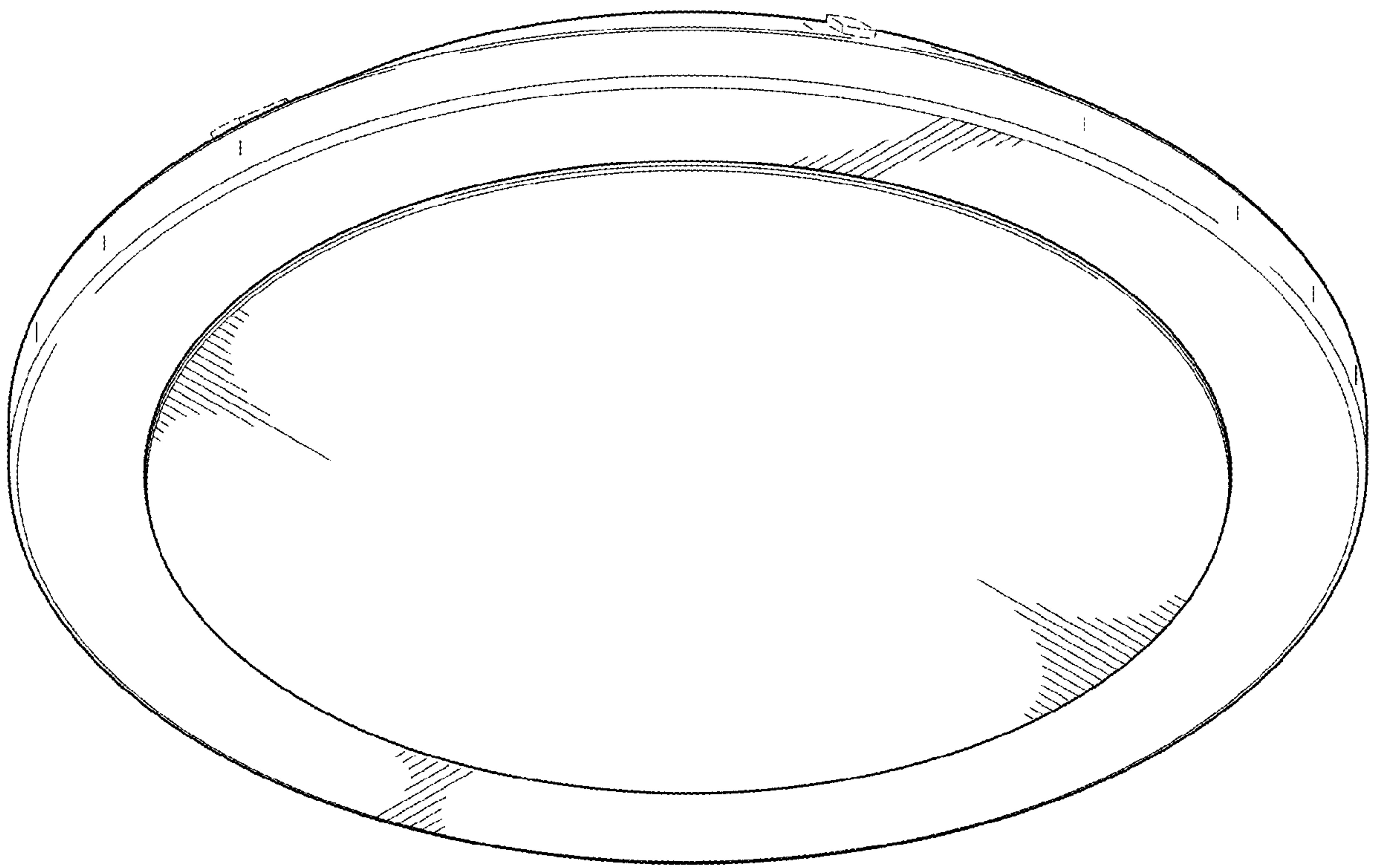

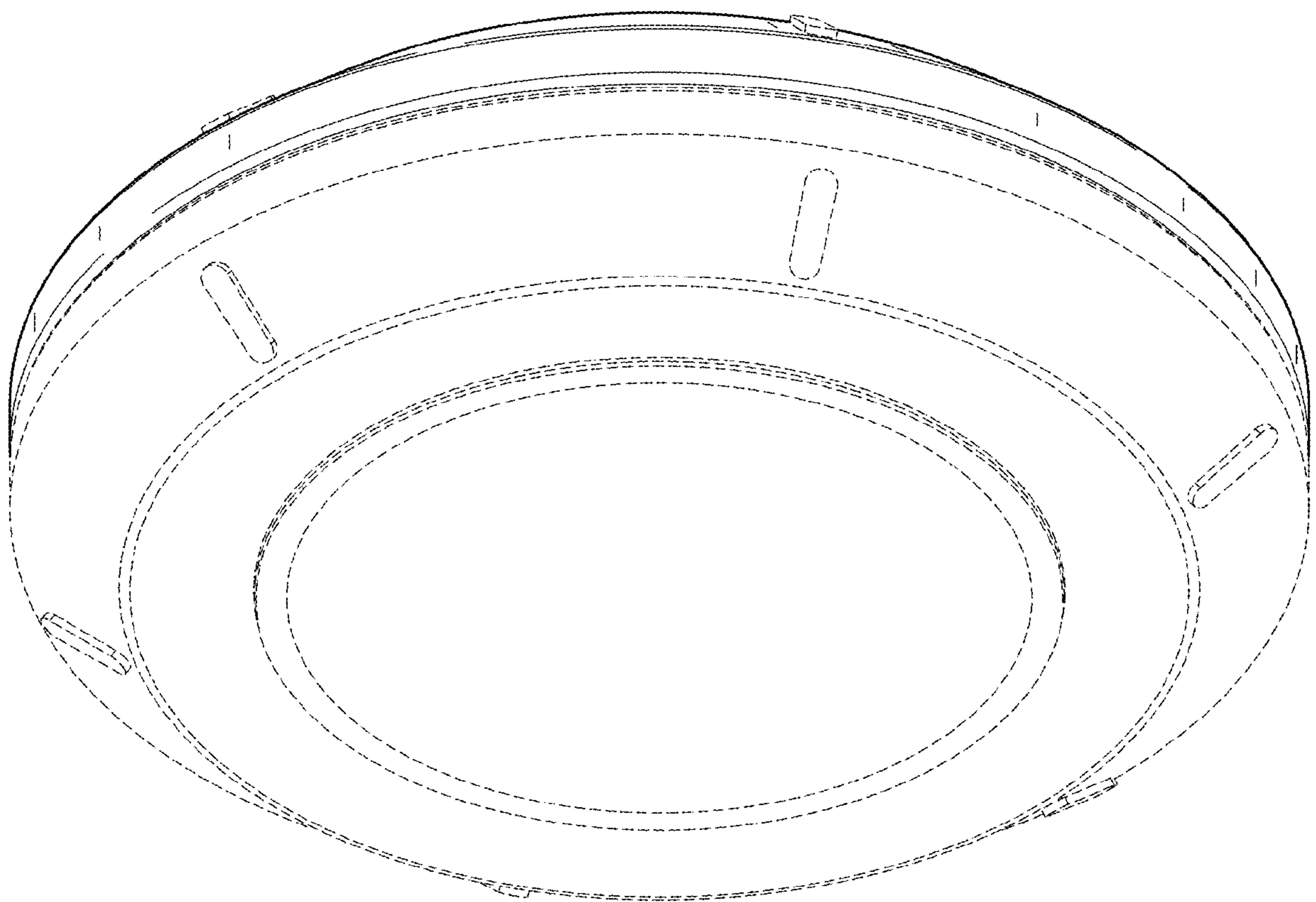
