DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, heel-side, bottom perspective view of a golf club head, showing the new design;

FIG. 5 is a toe-side elevational view thereof;

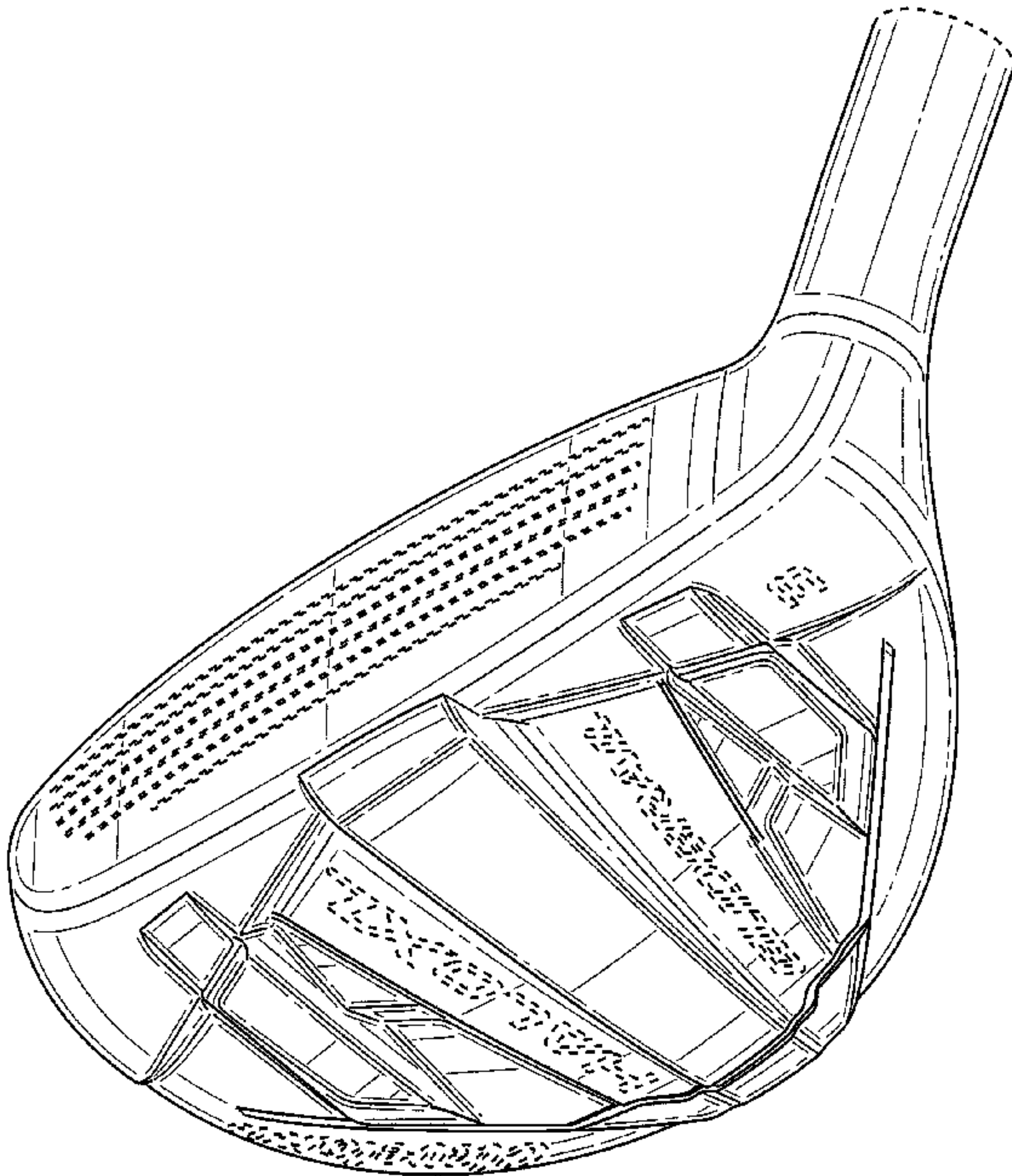
FIG. 6 is a heel-side elevational view thereof;

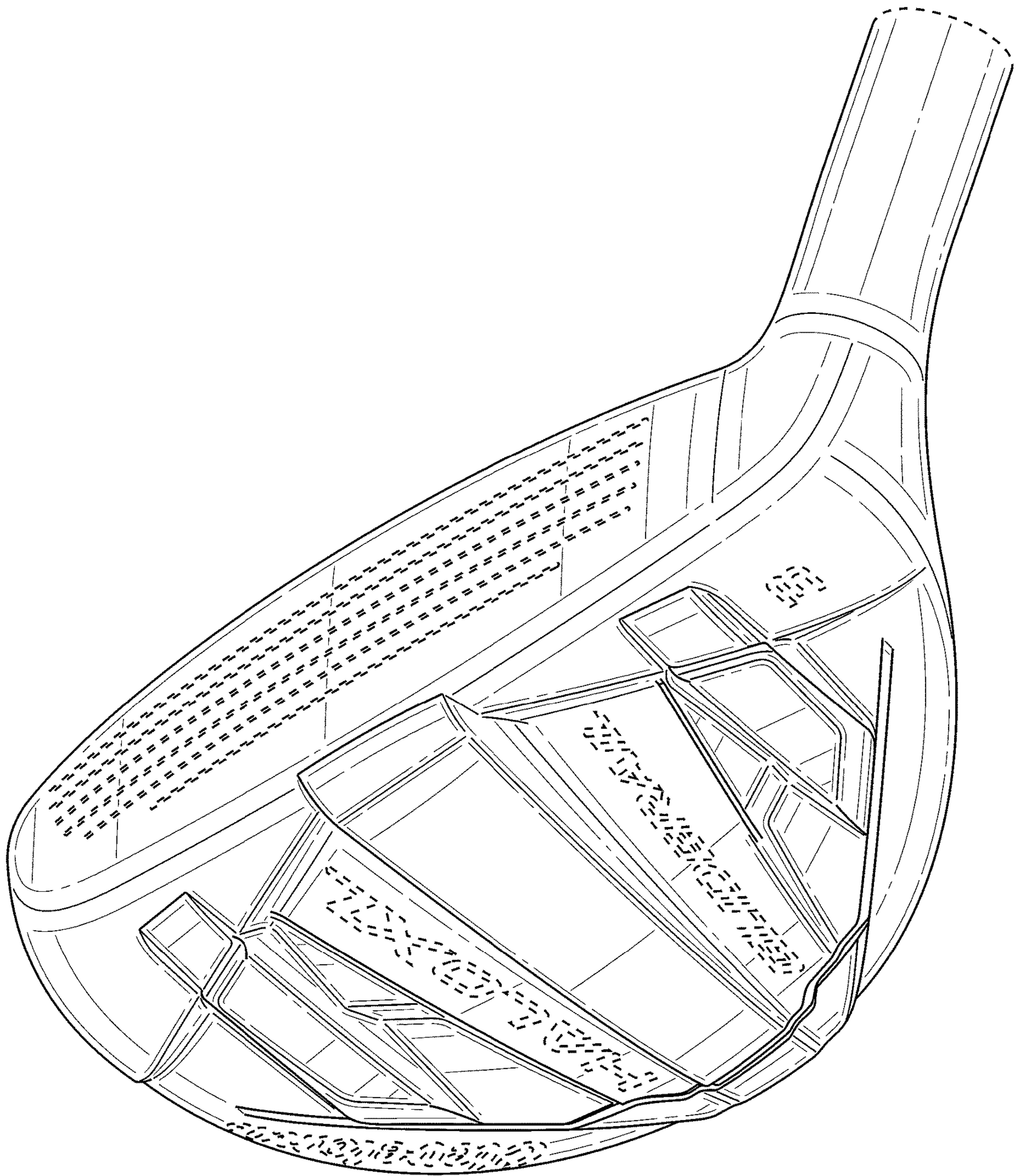

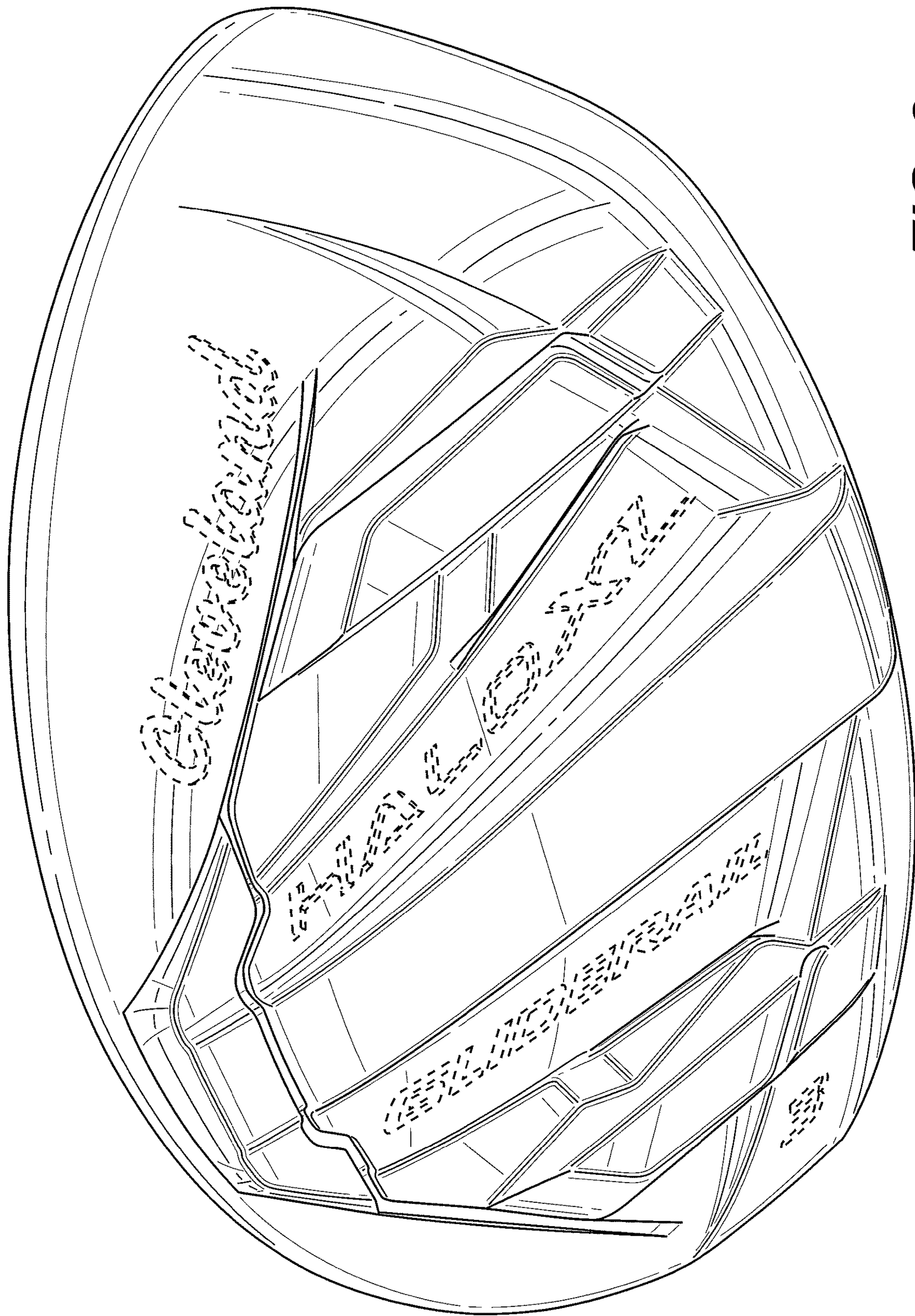

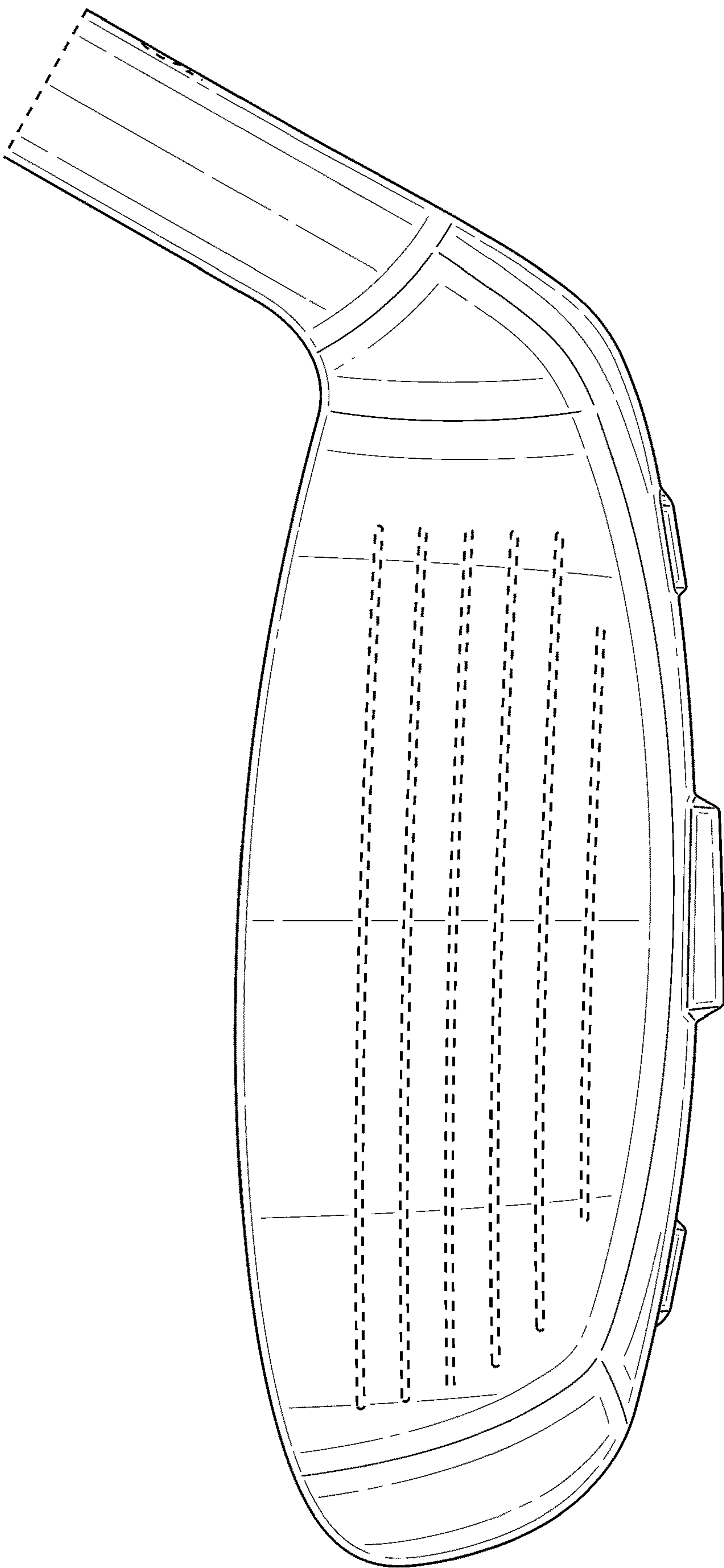

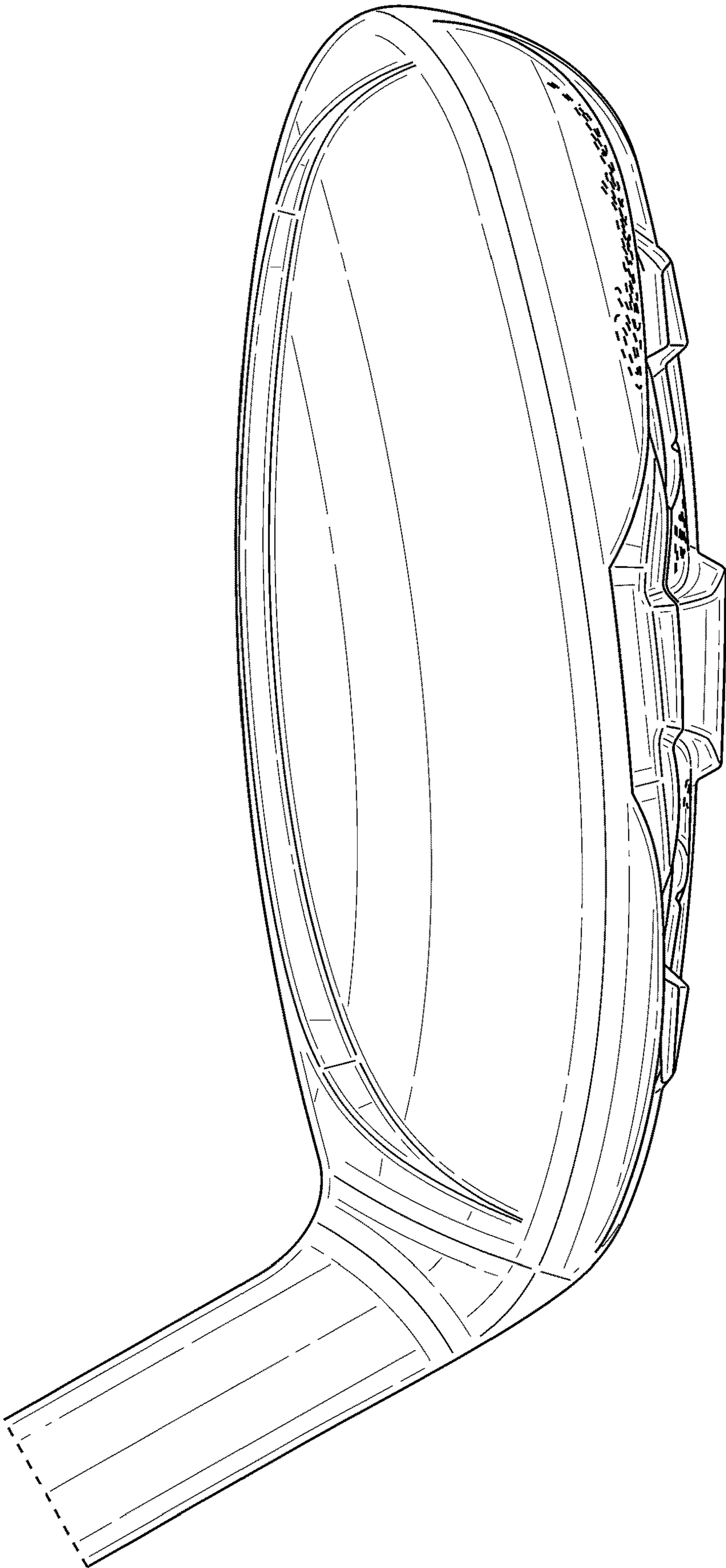

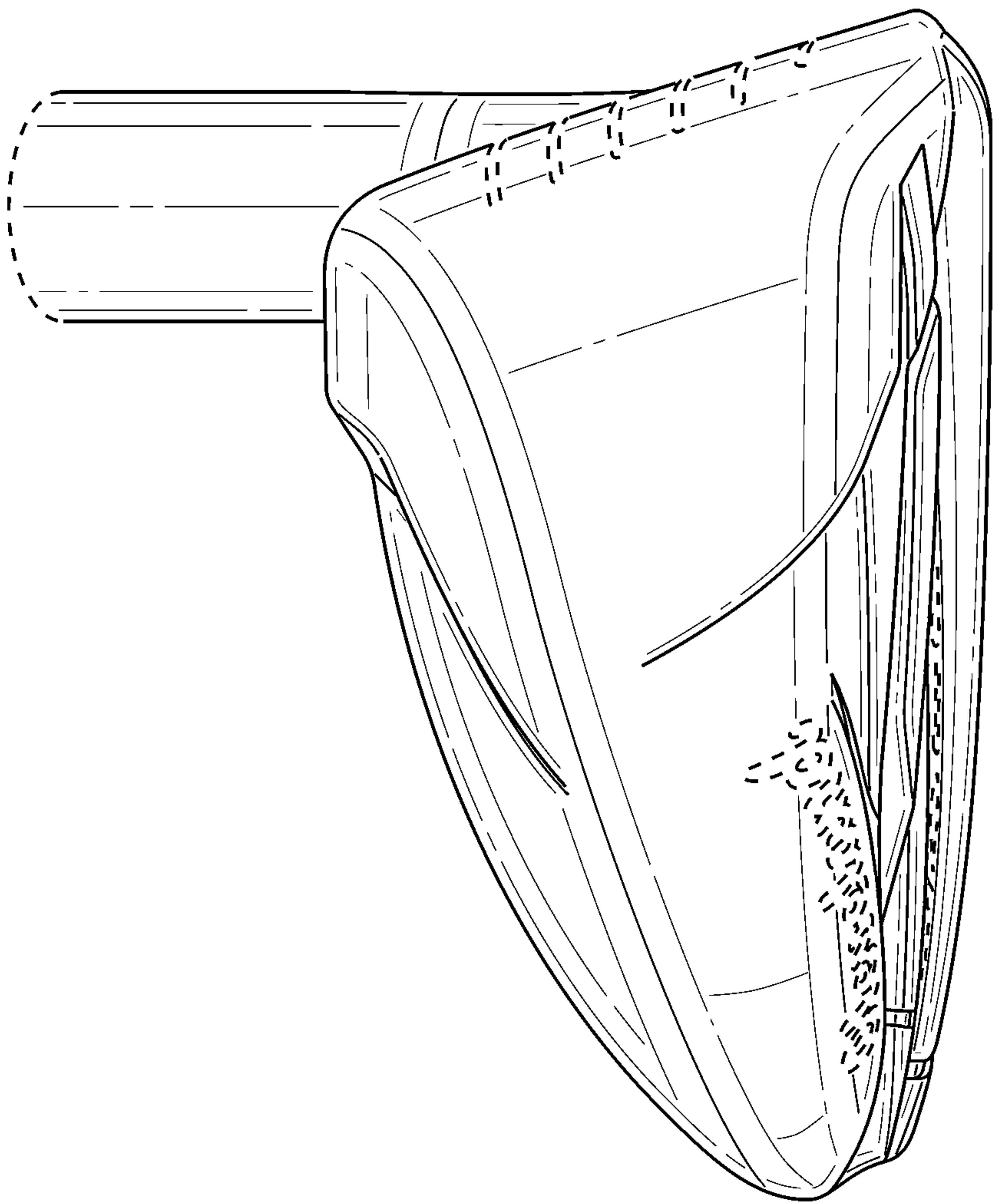

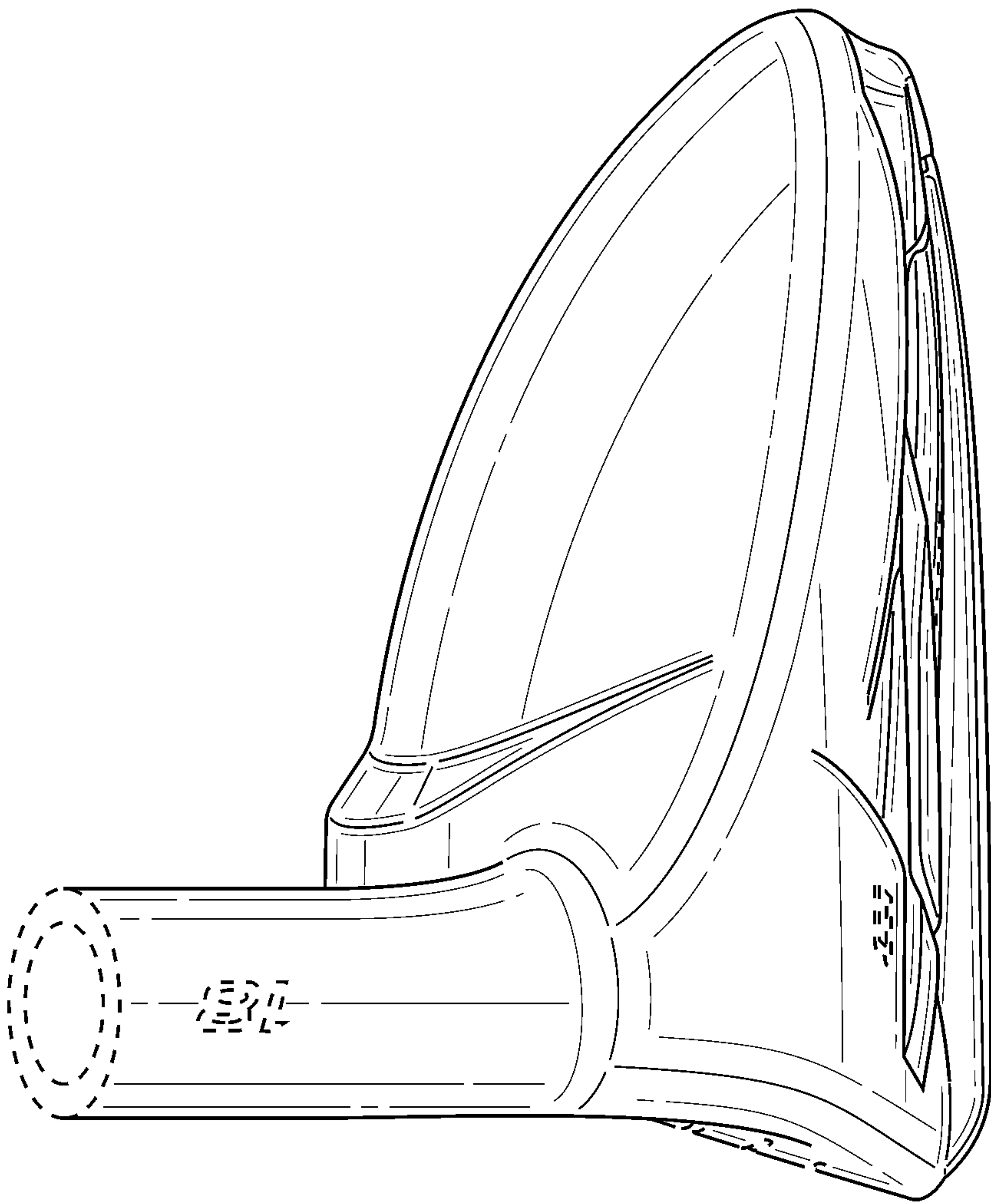

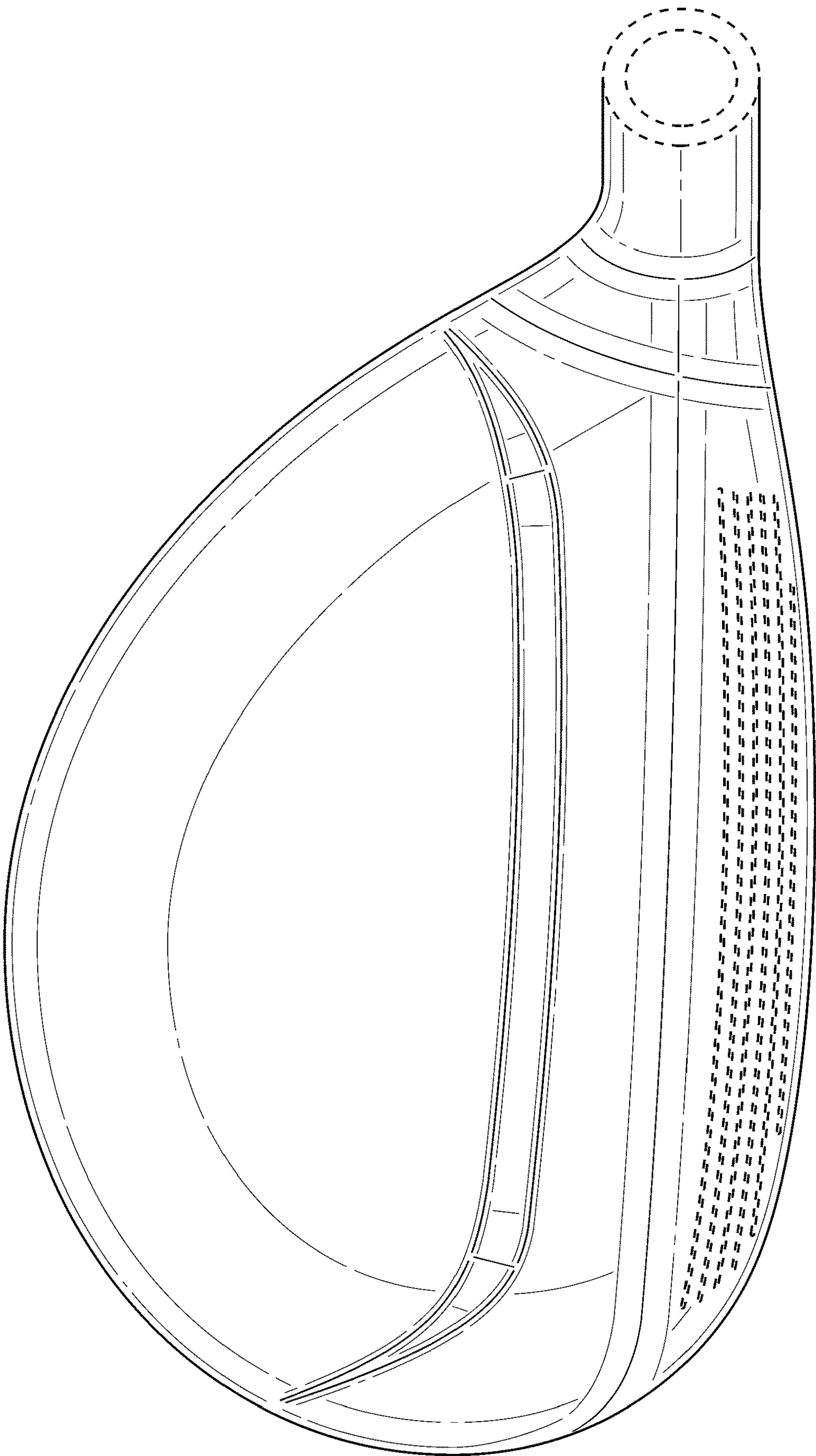

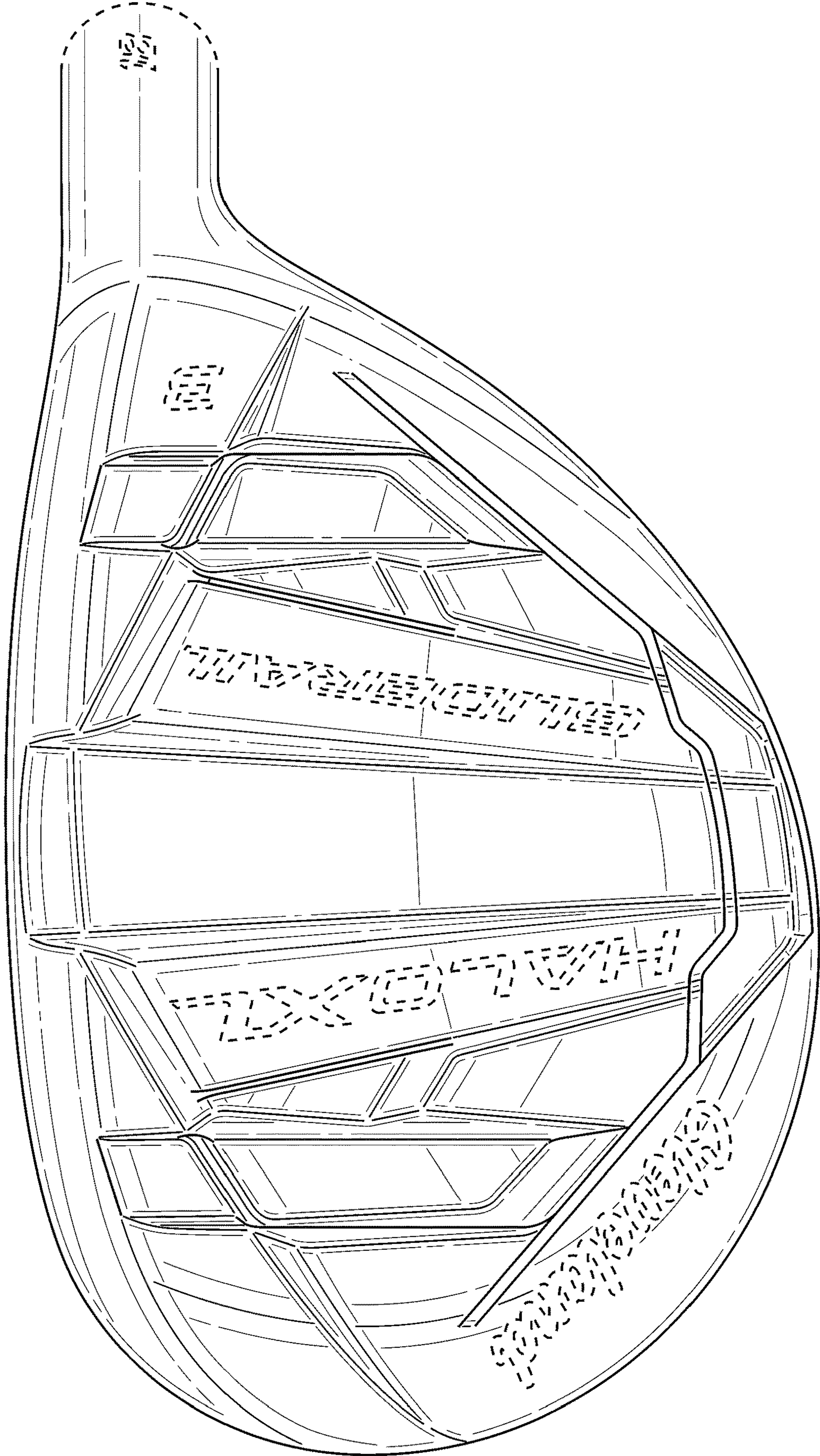
