FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the optical sight mount shown in FIG. 1;

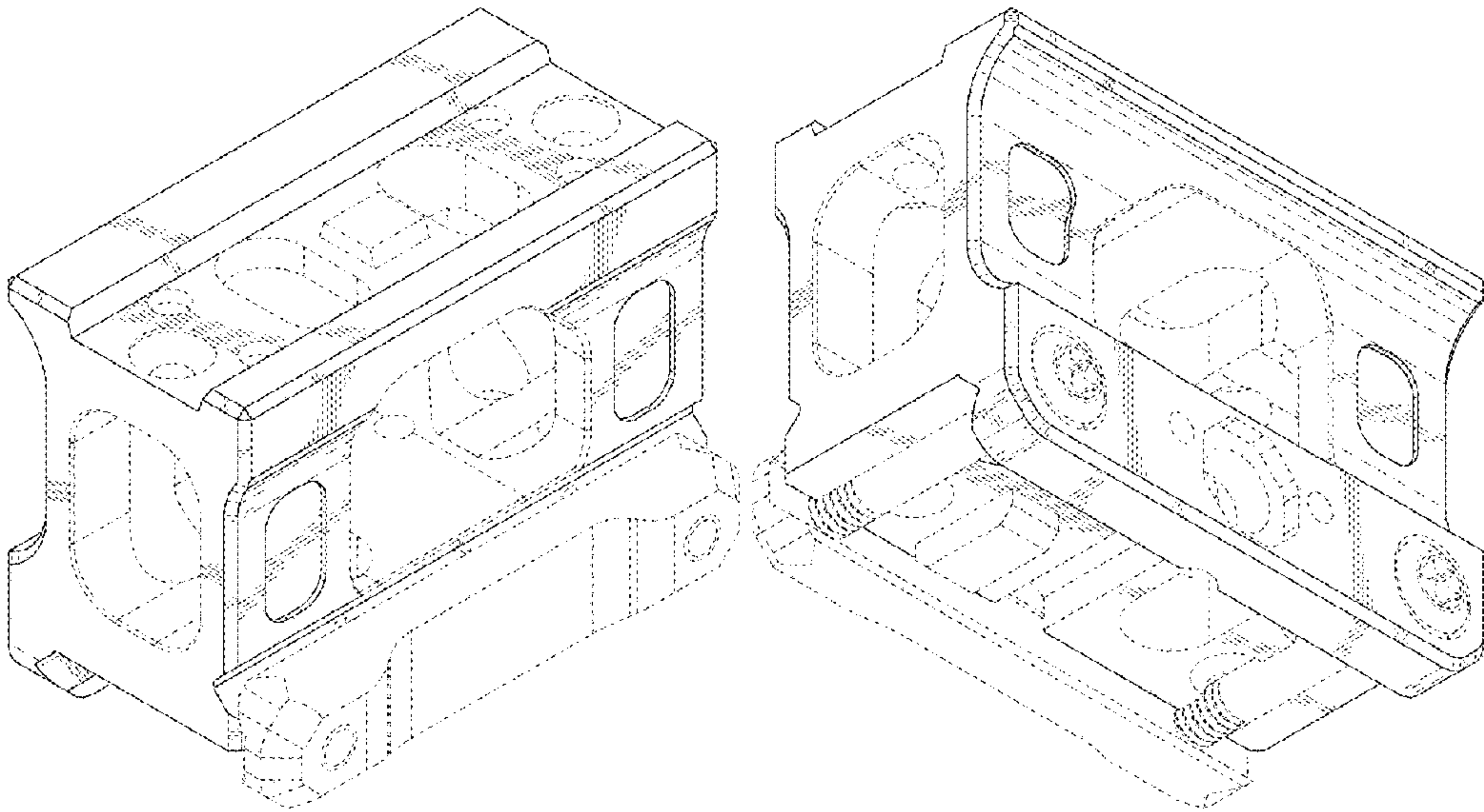
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the optical sight mount shown in FIG. 1;

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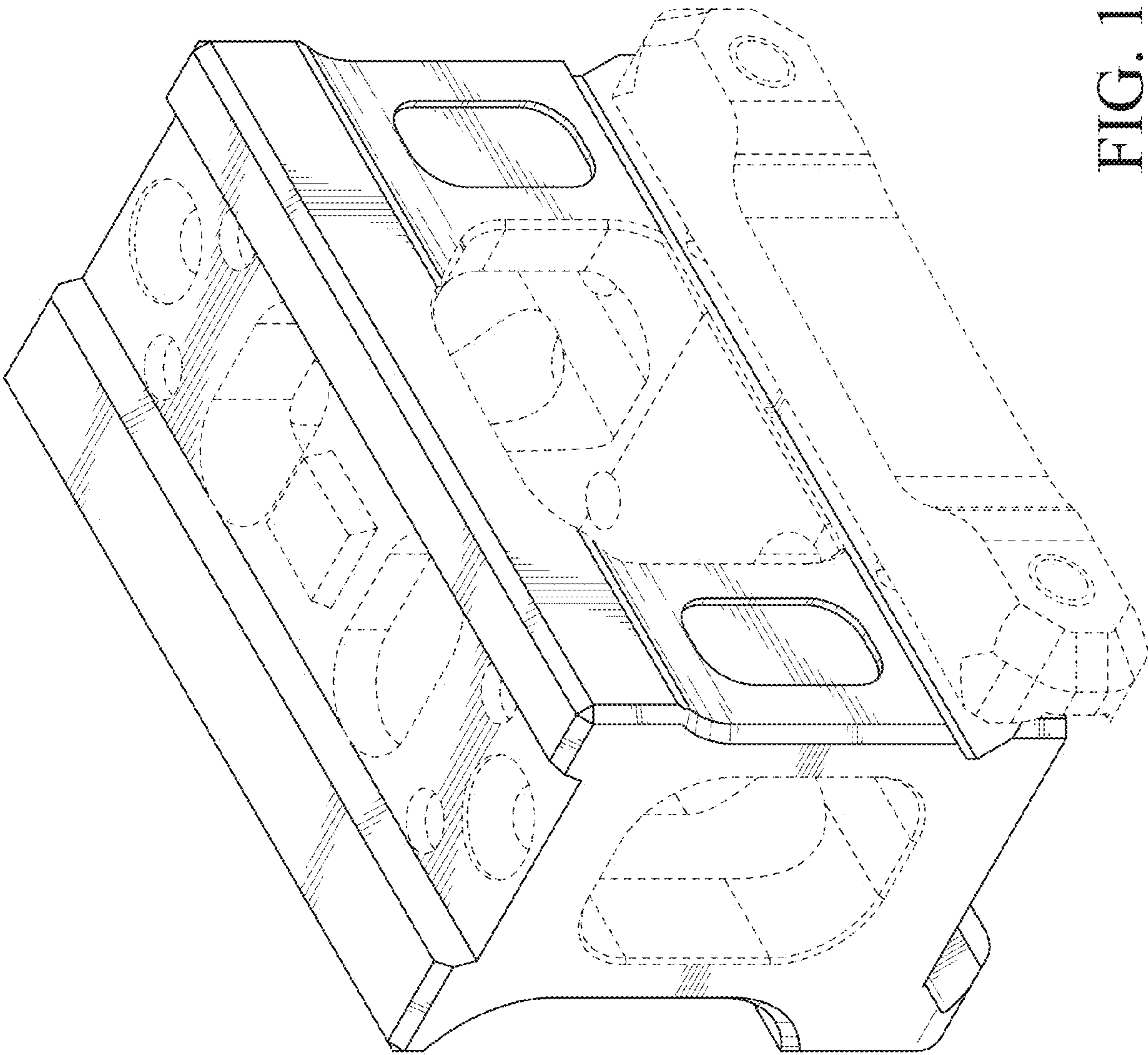

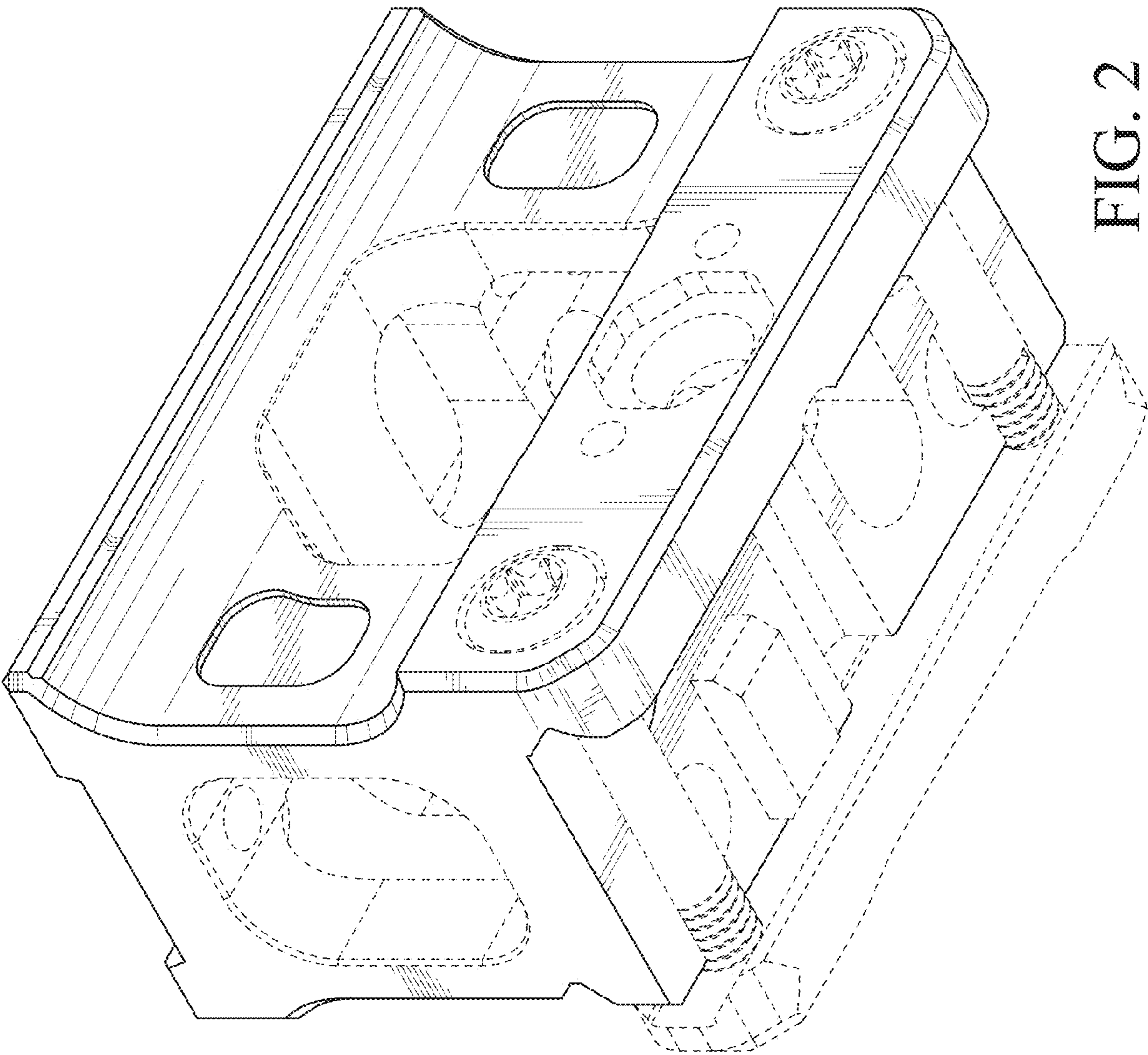

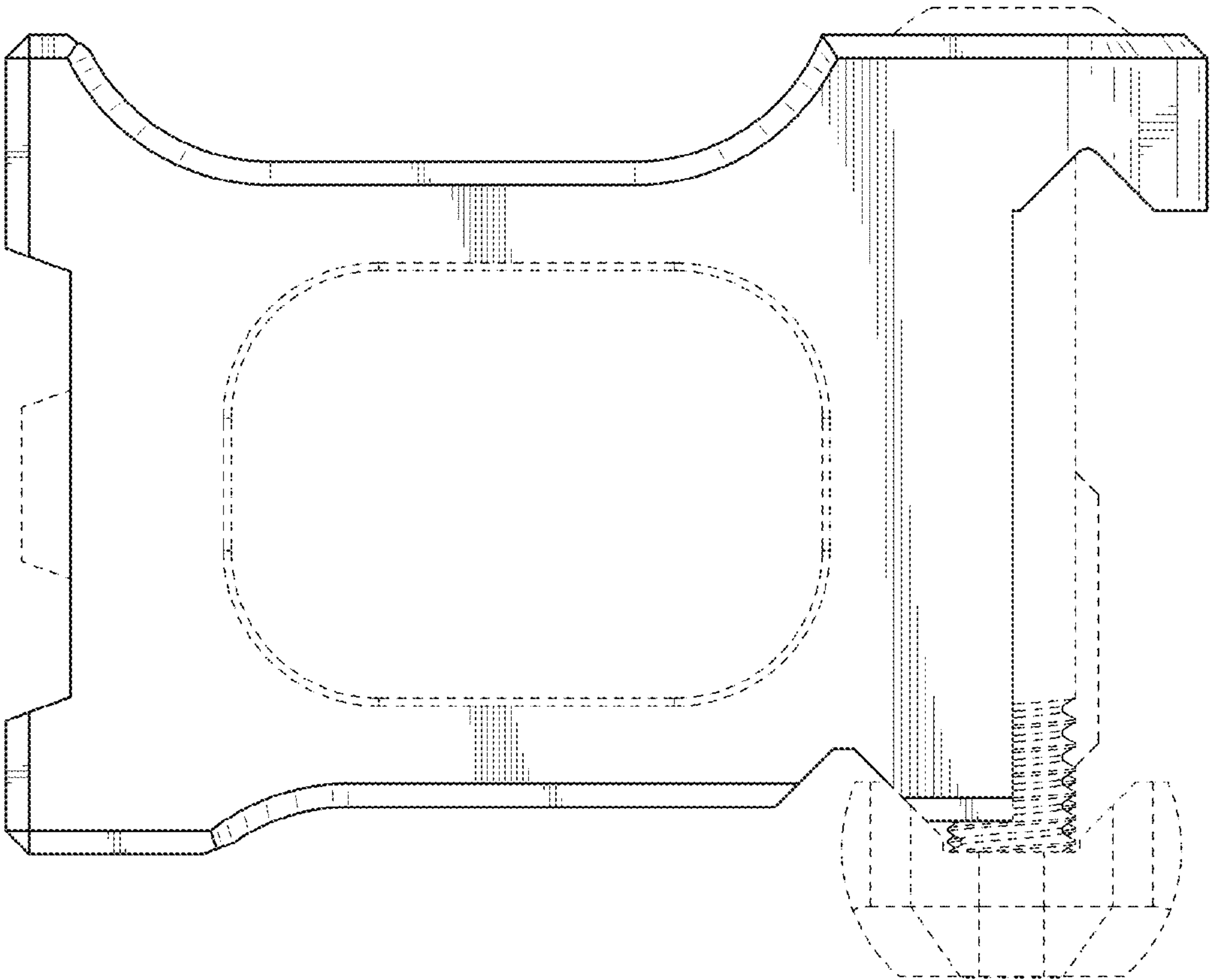

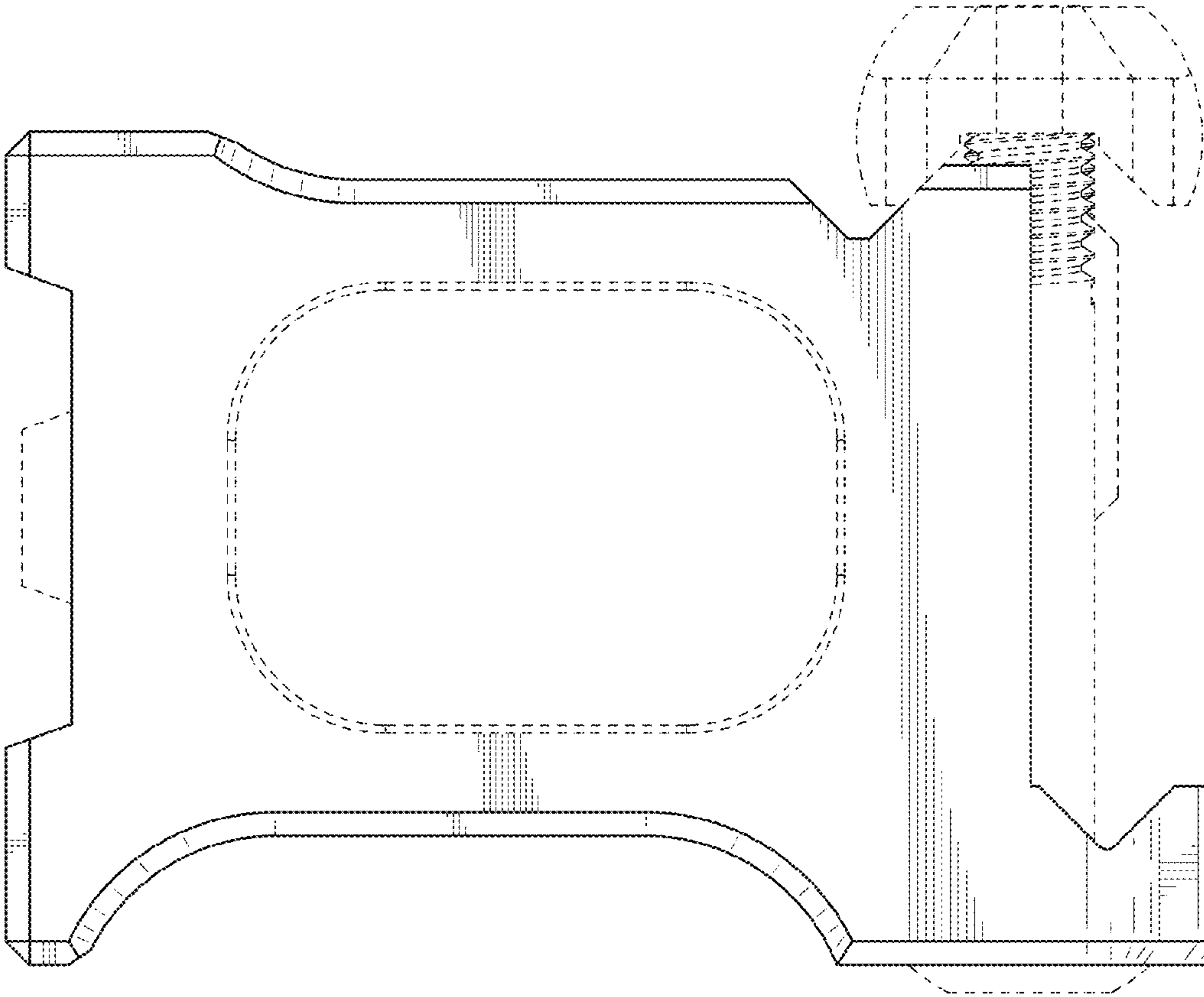

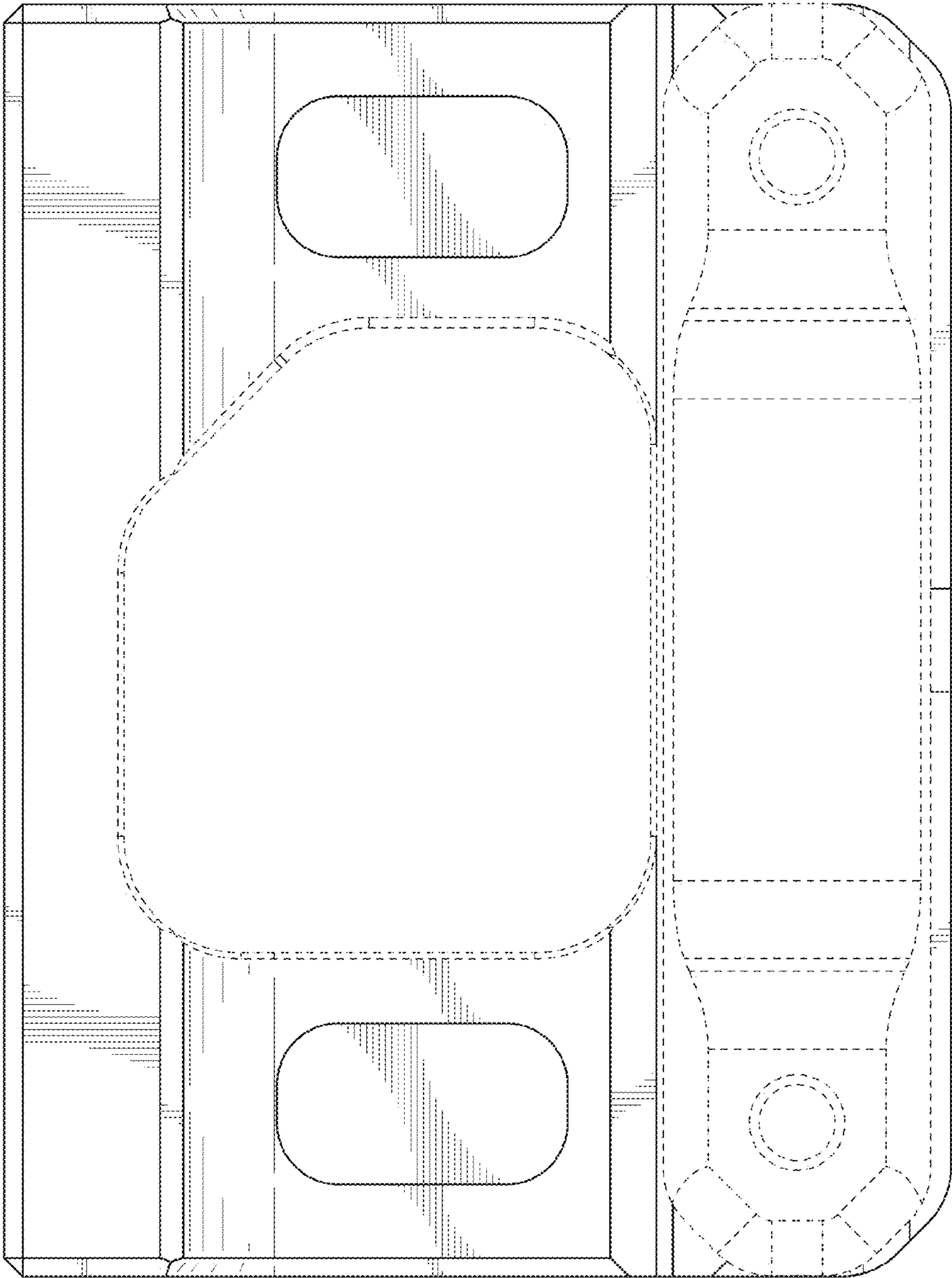

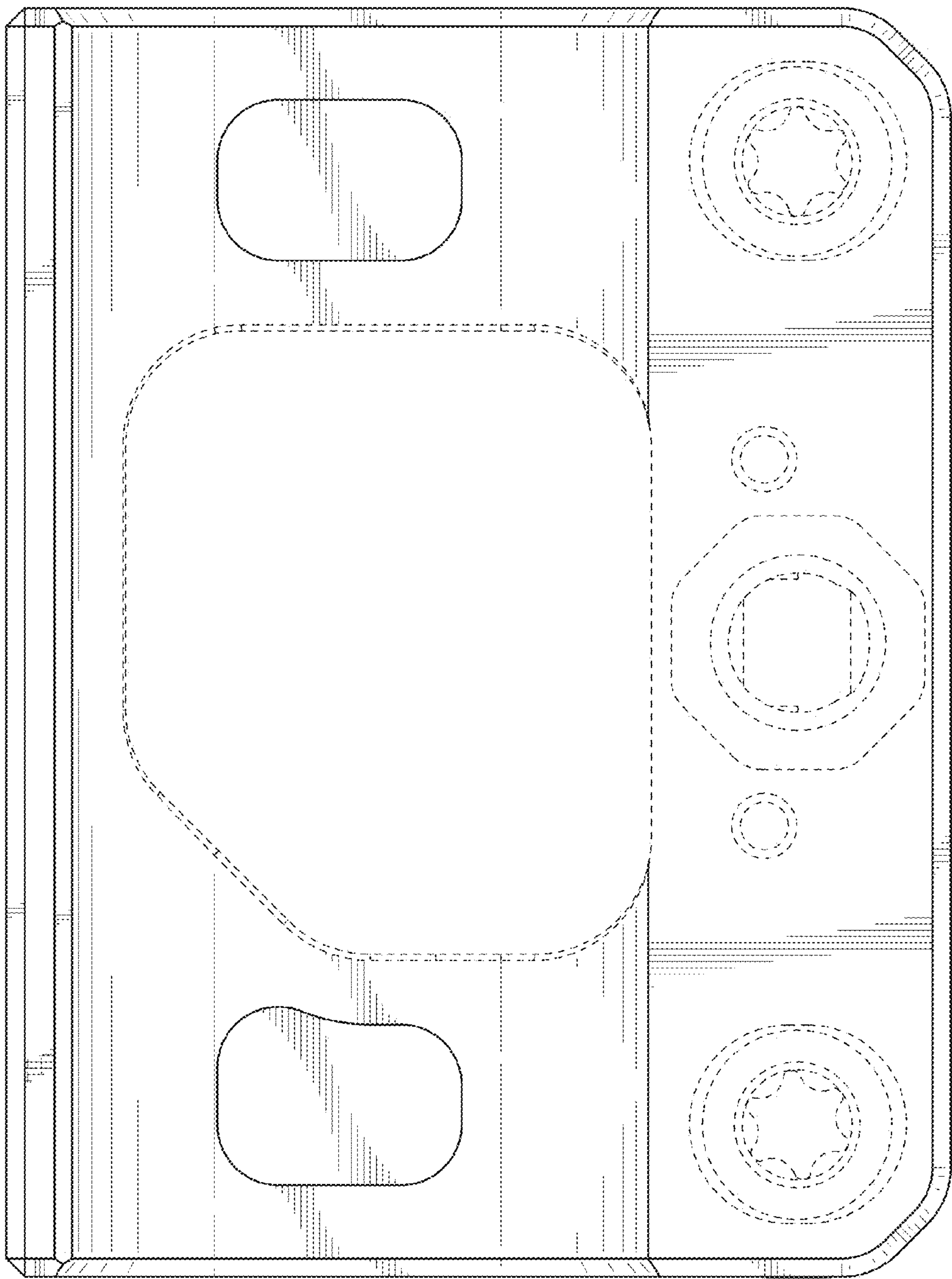

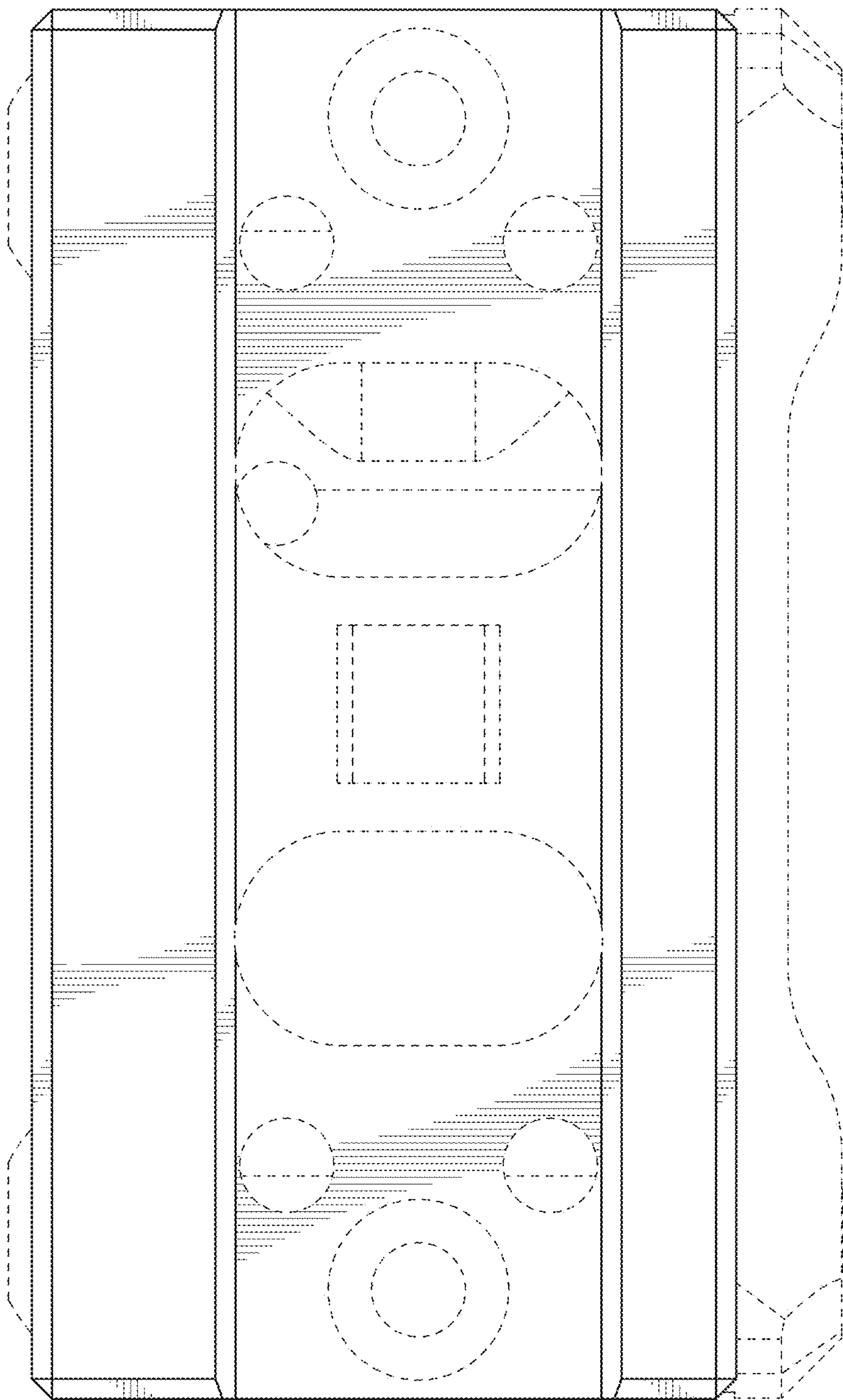

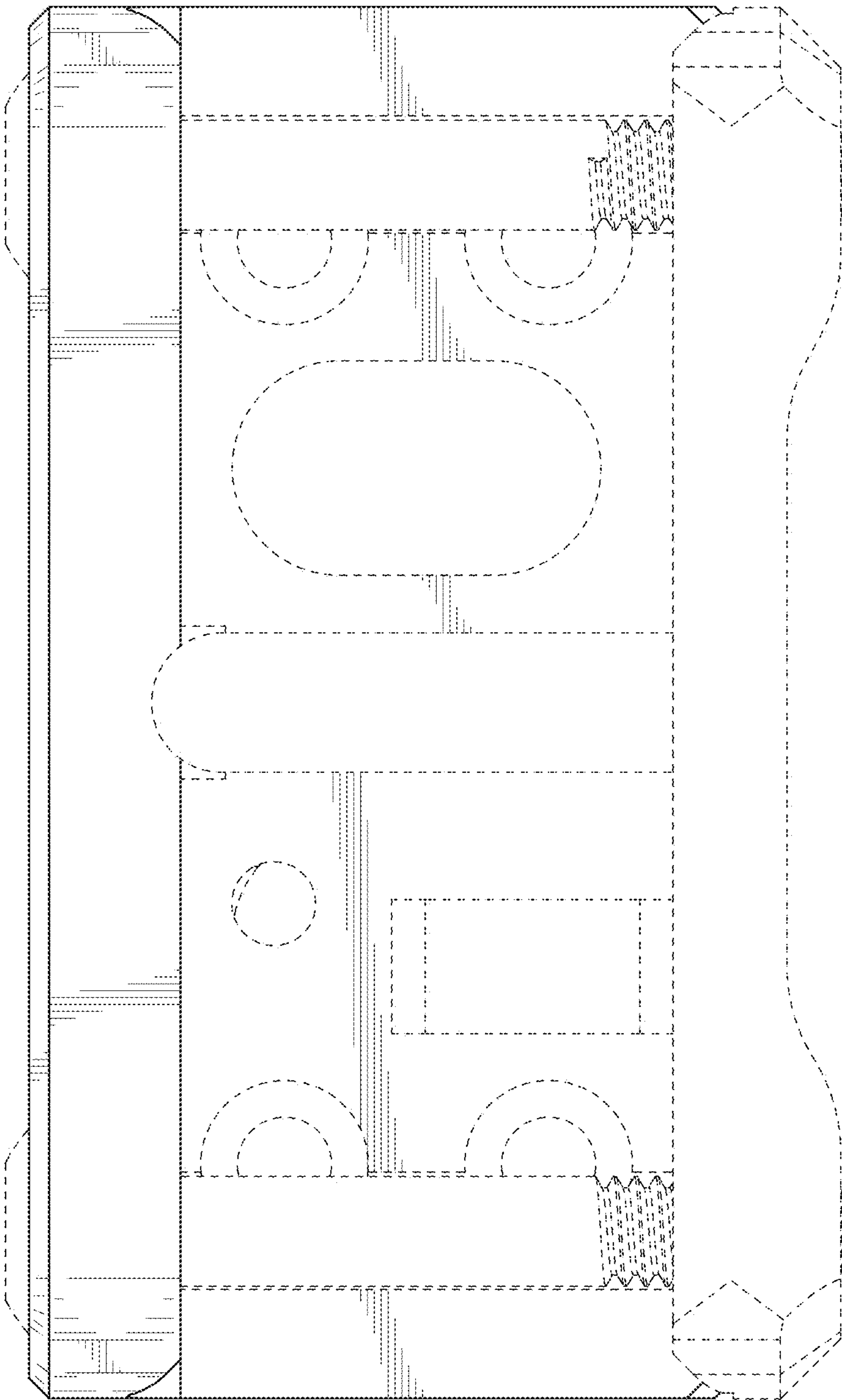
