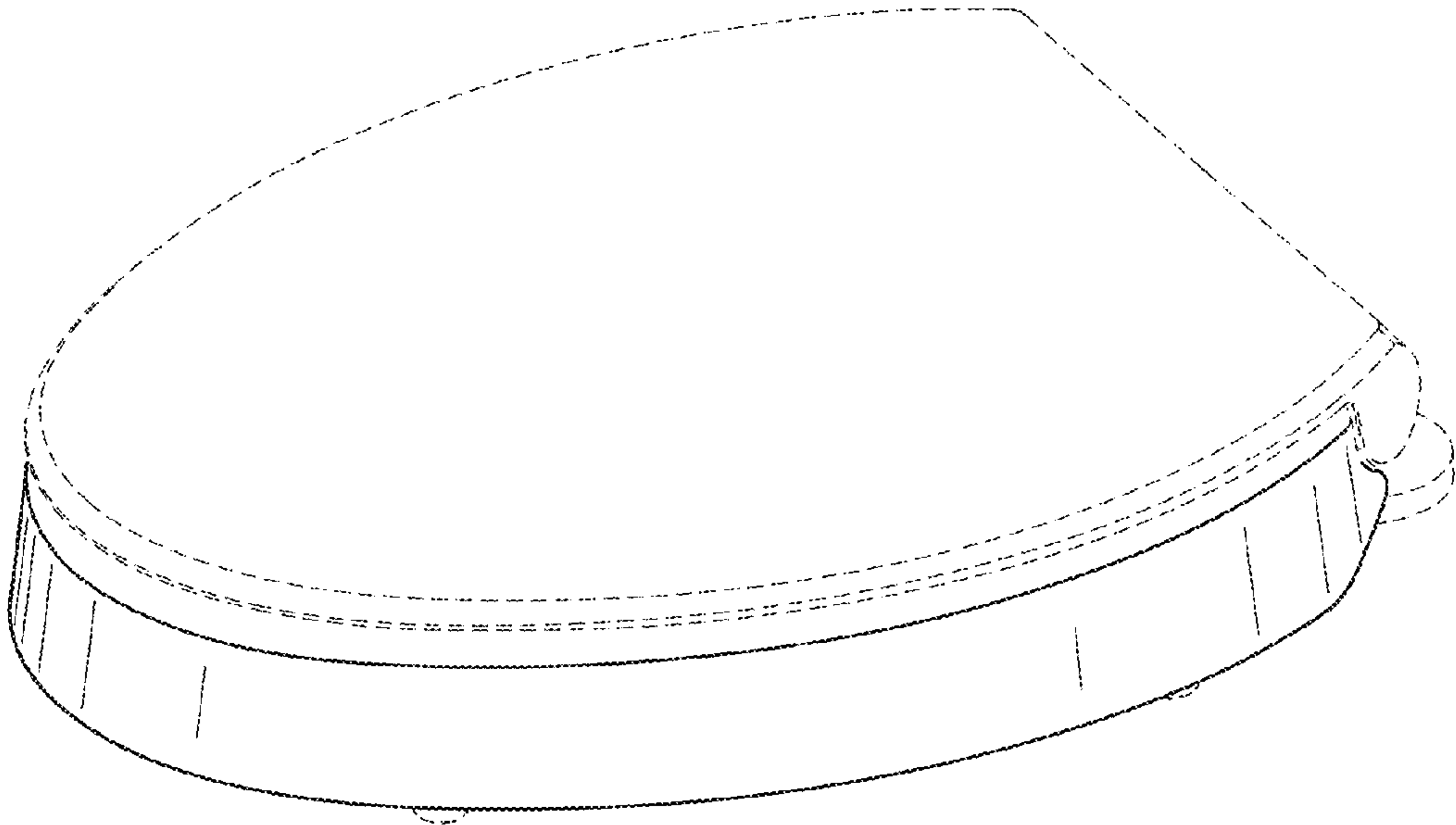
DESCRIPTION

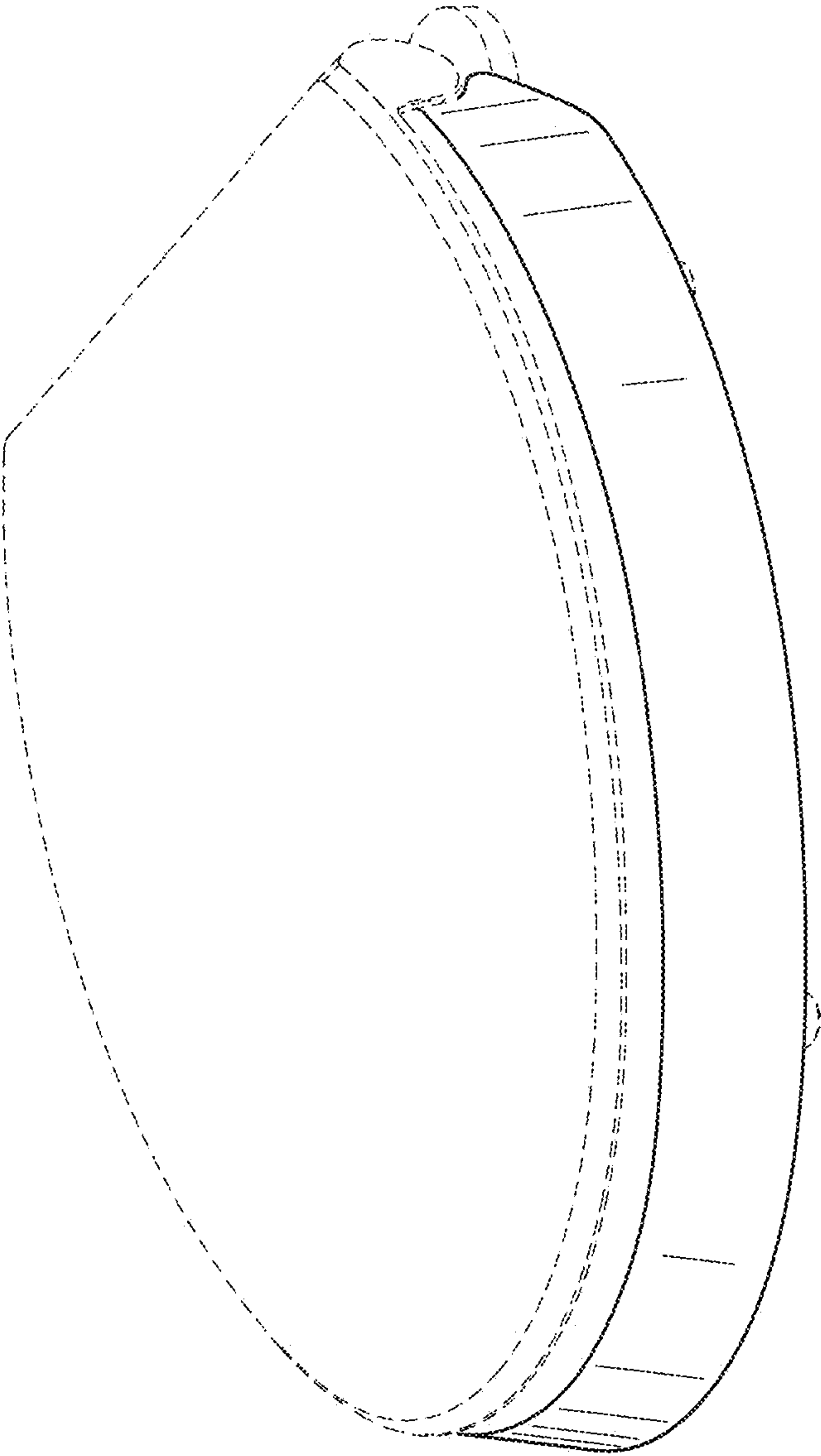

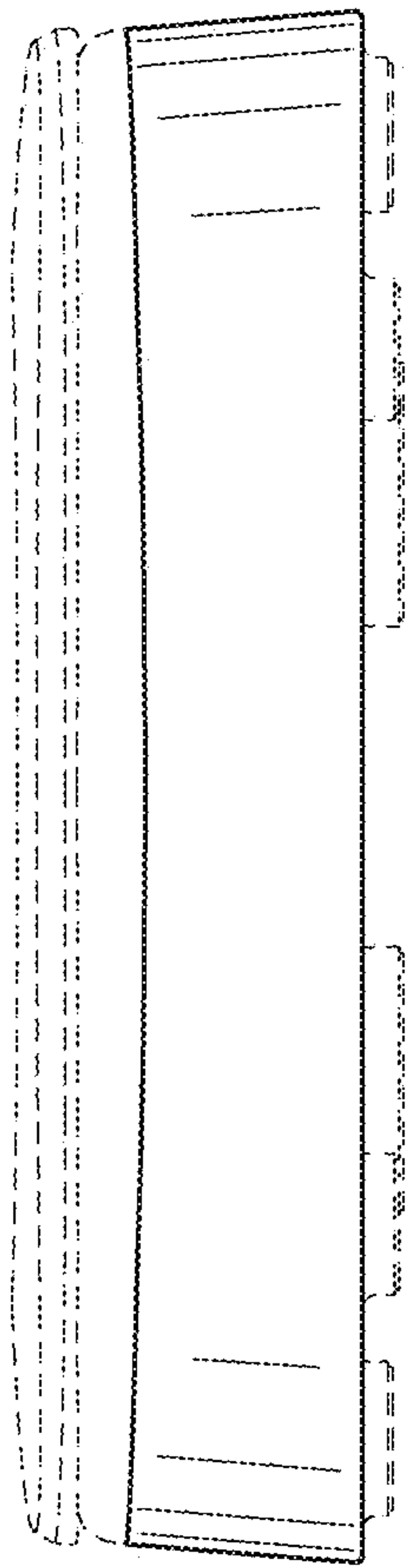

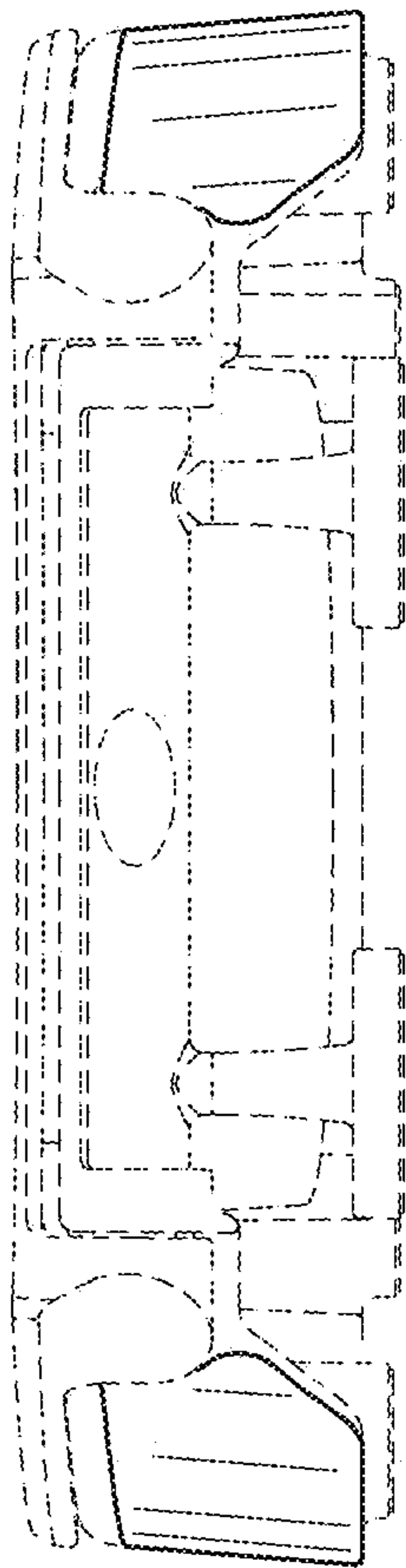

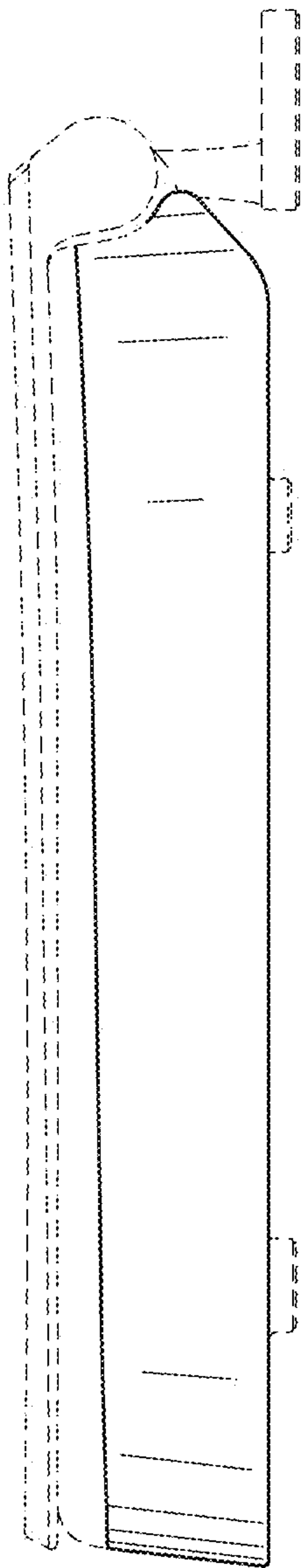

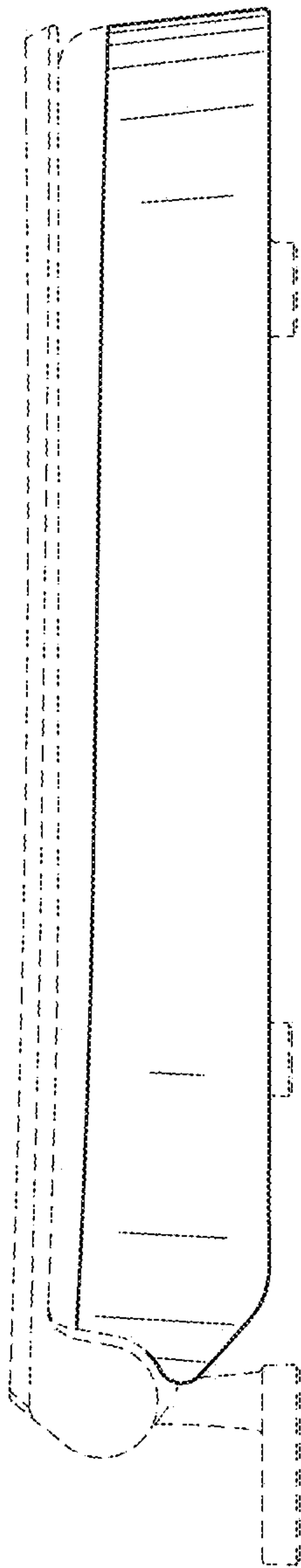

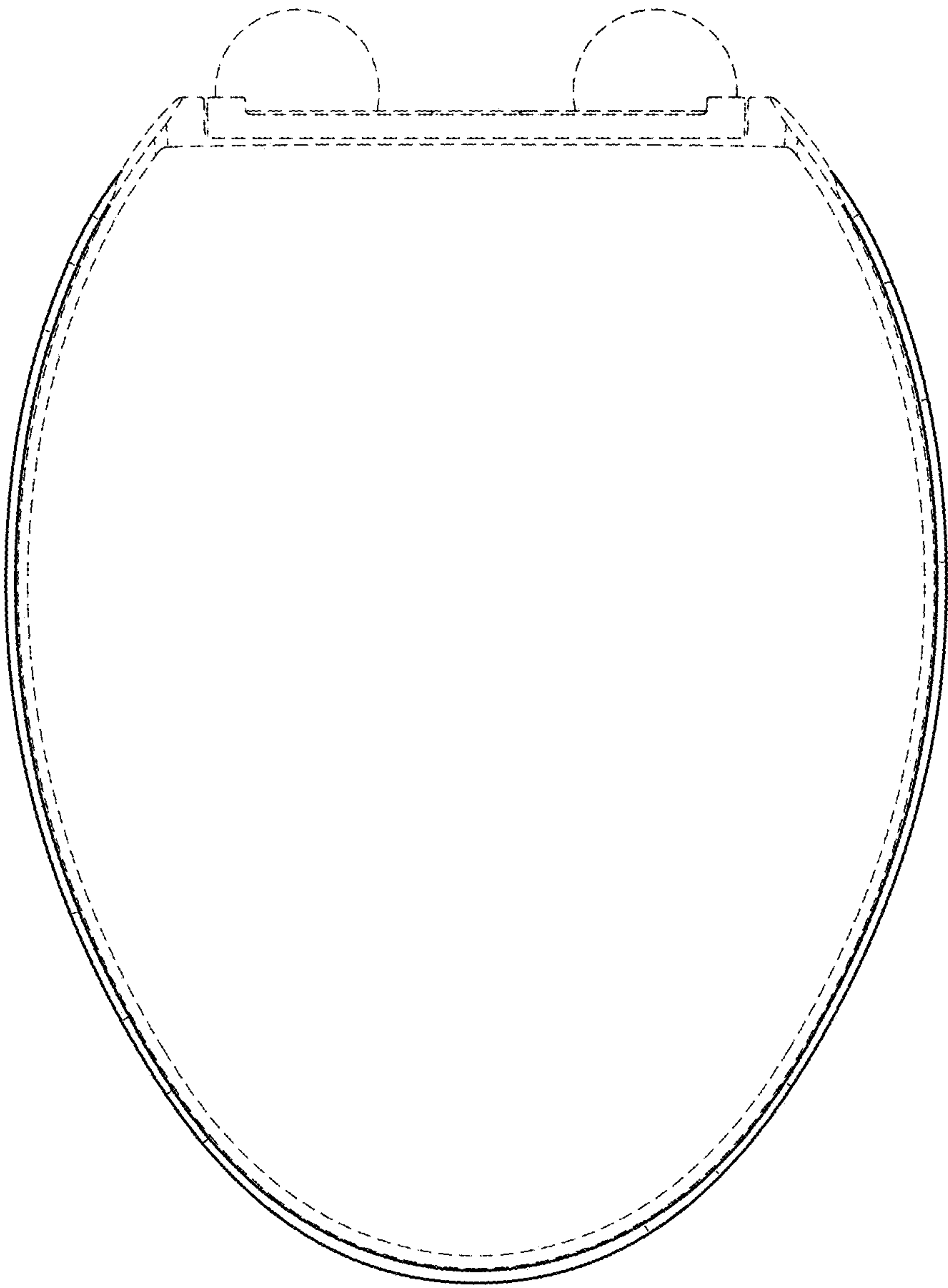

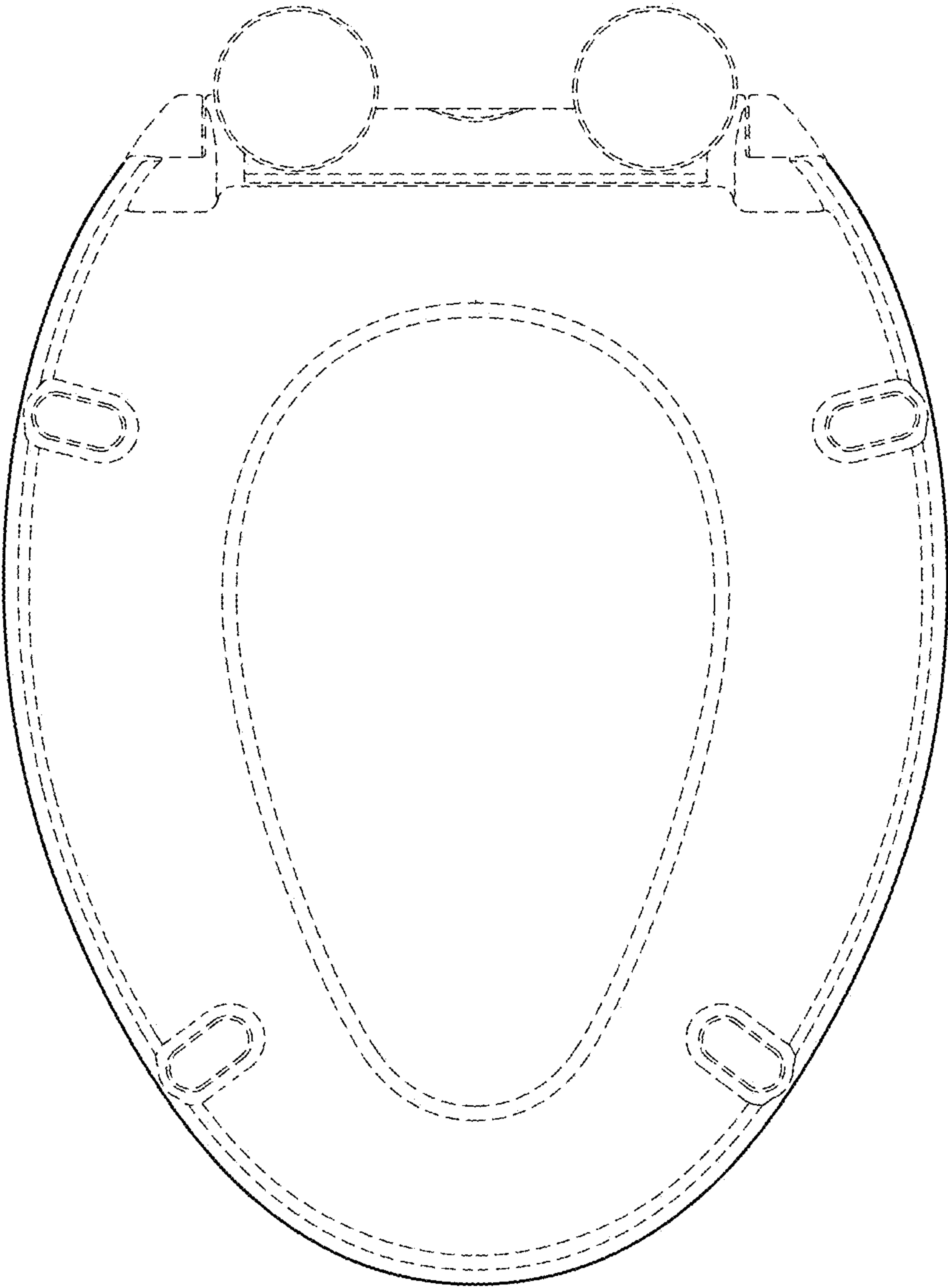
