The ornamental design for portions of a medical implant device as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top side isometric view of a medical implant device showing my new design, according to a first embodiment;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevation view thereof from the left side;

FIG. 5 is an elevation view thereof from the right side;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom side isometric view thereof.

FIG. 9 is a top side isometric view of a medical implant device showing my new design, according to a second embodiment;

FIG. 13 is an elevation view thereof from the right side;

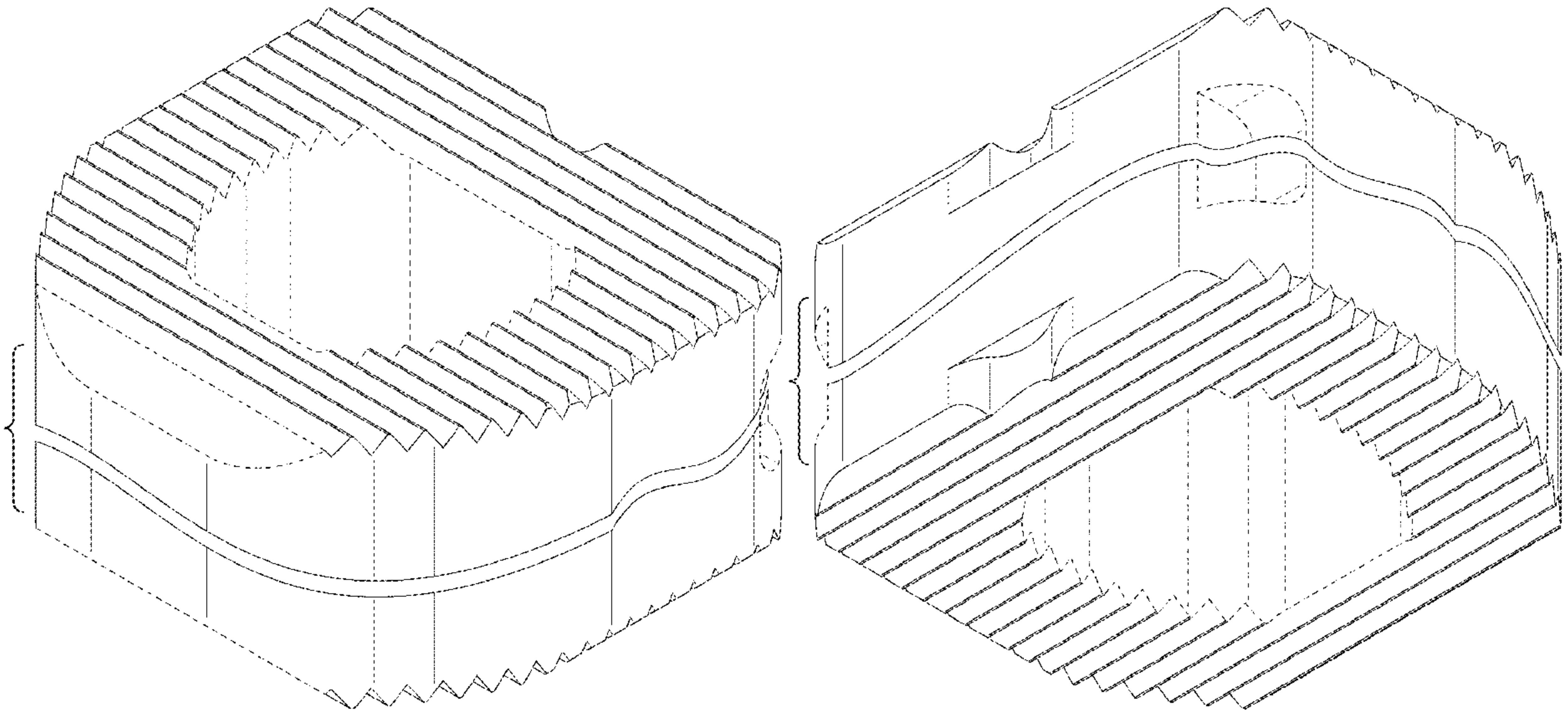
FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

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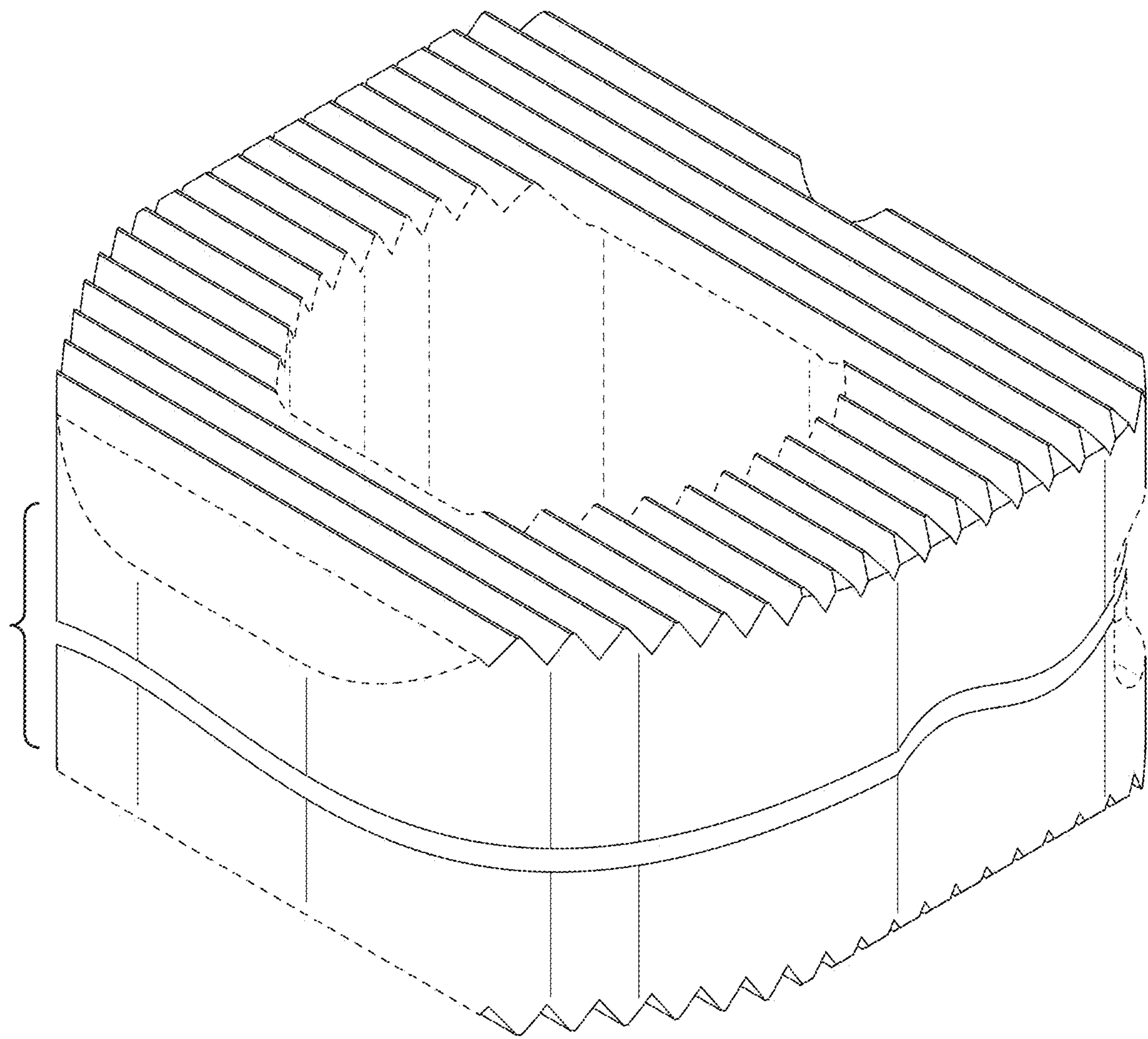

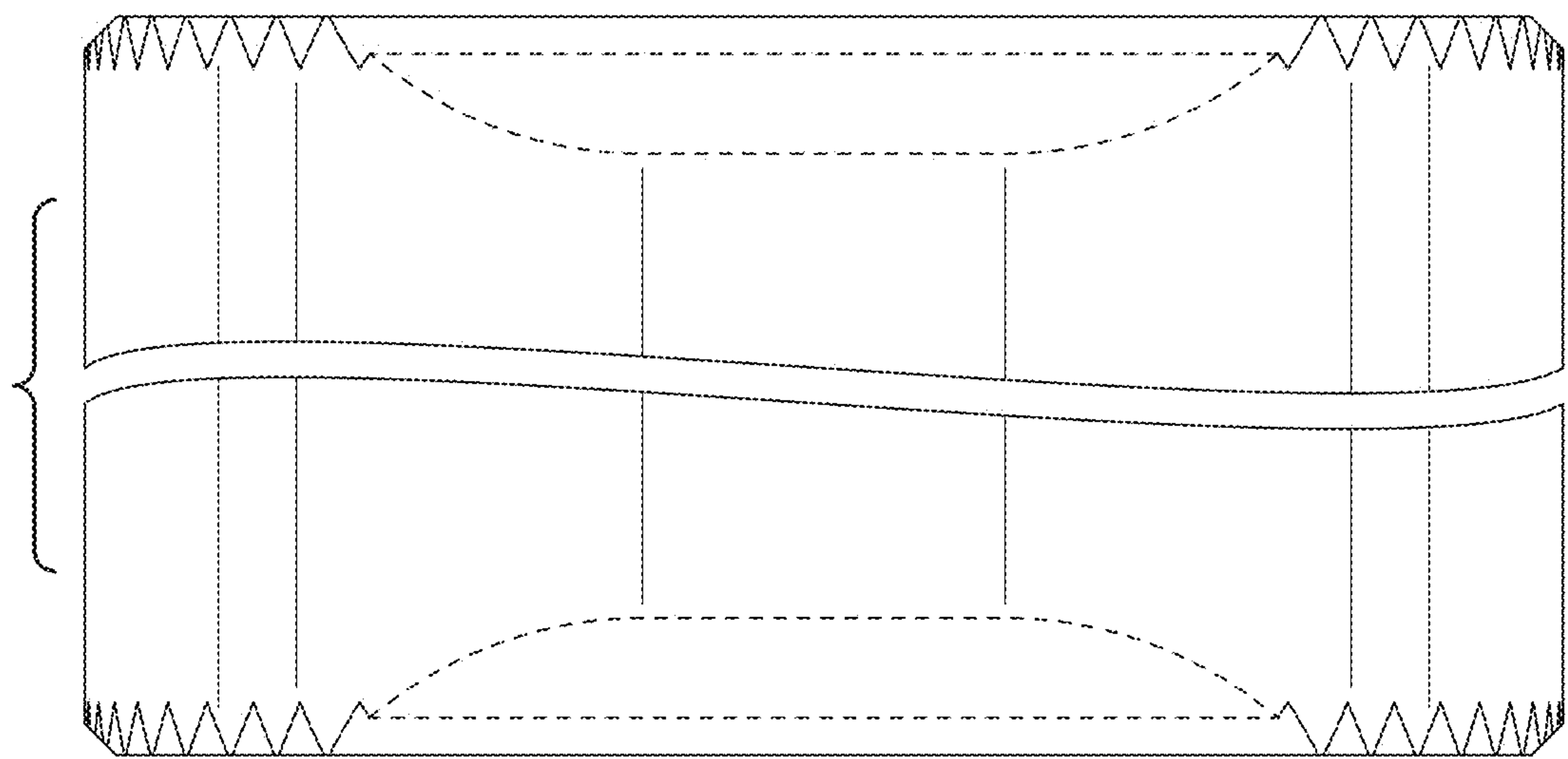

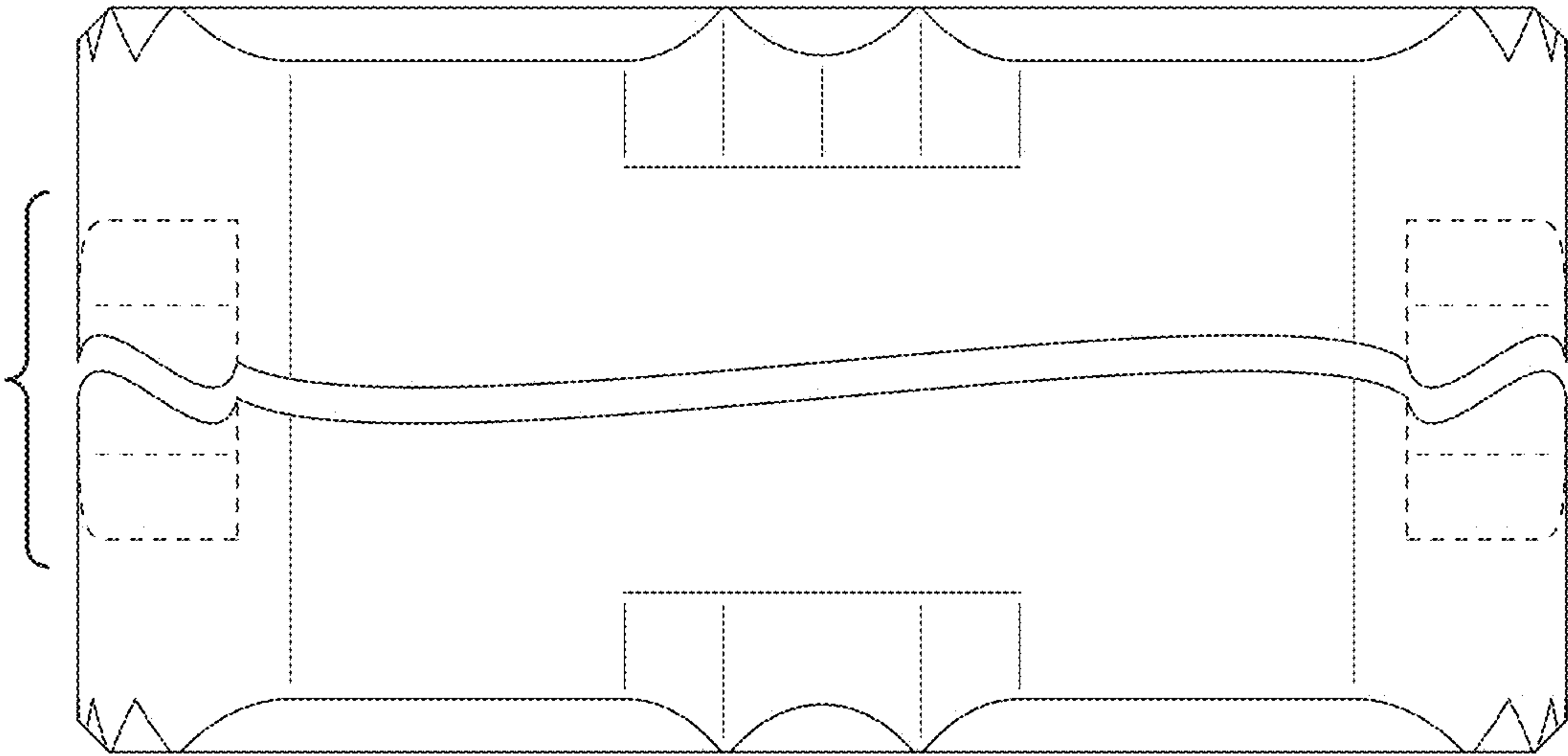

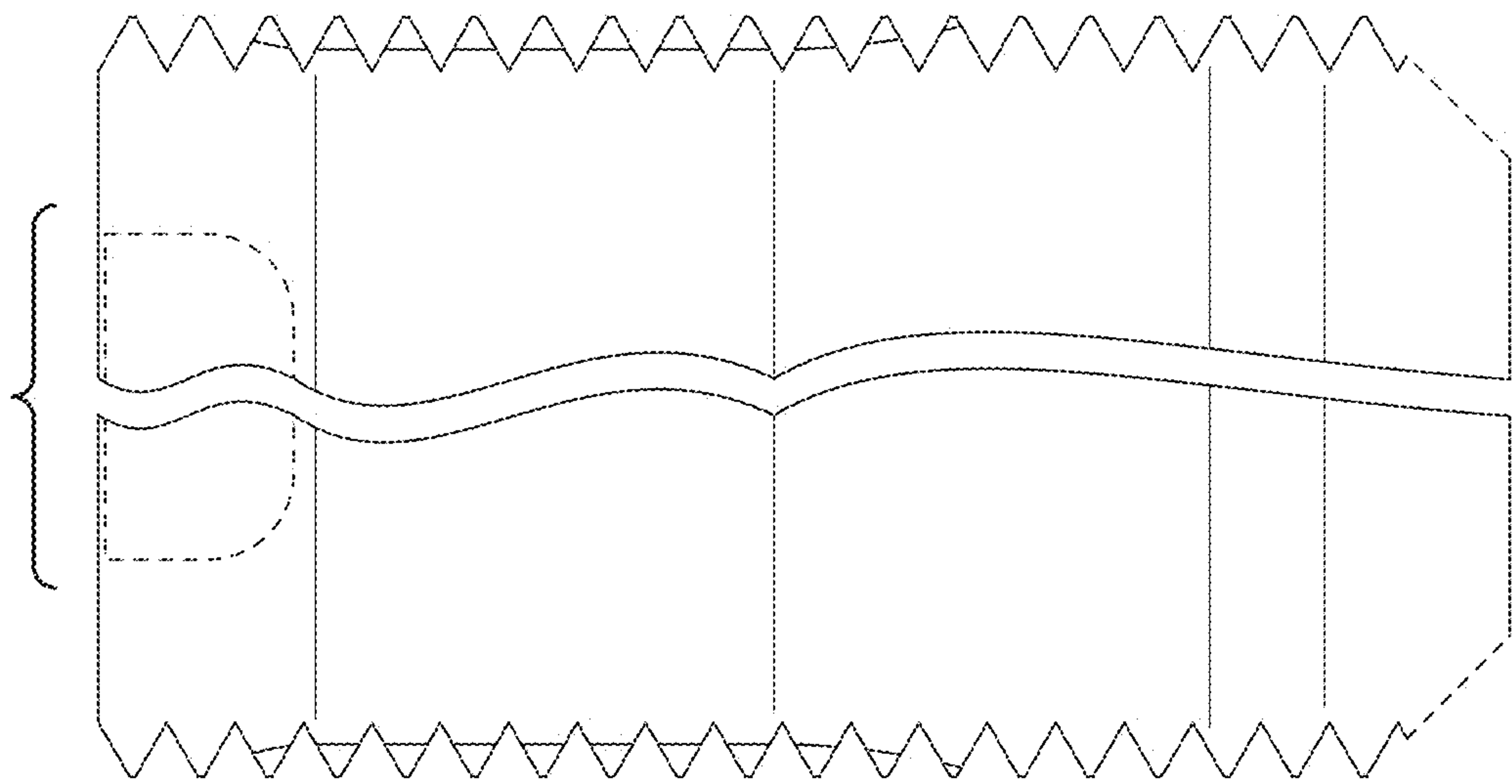

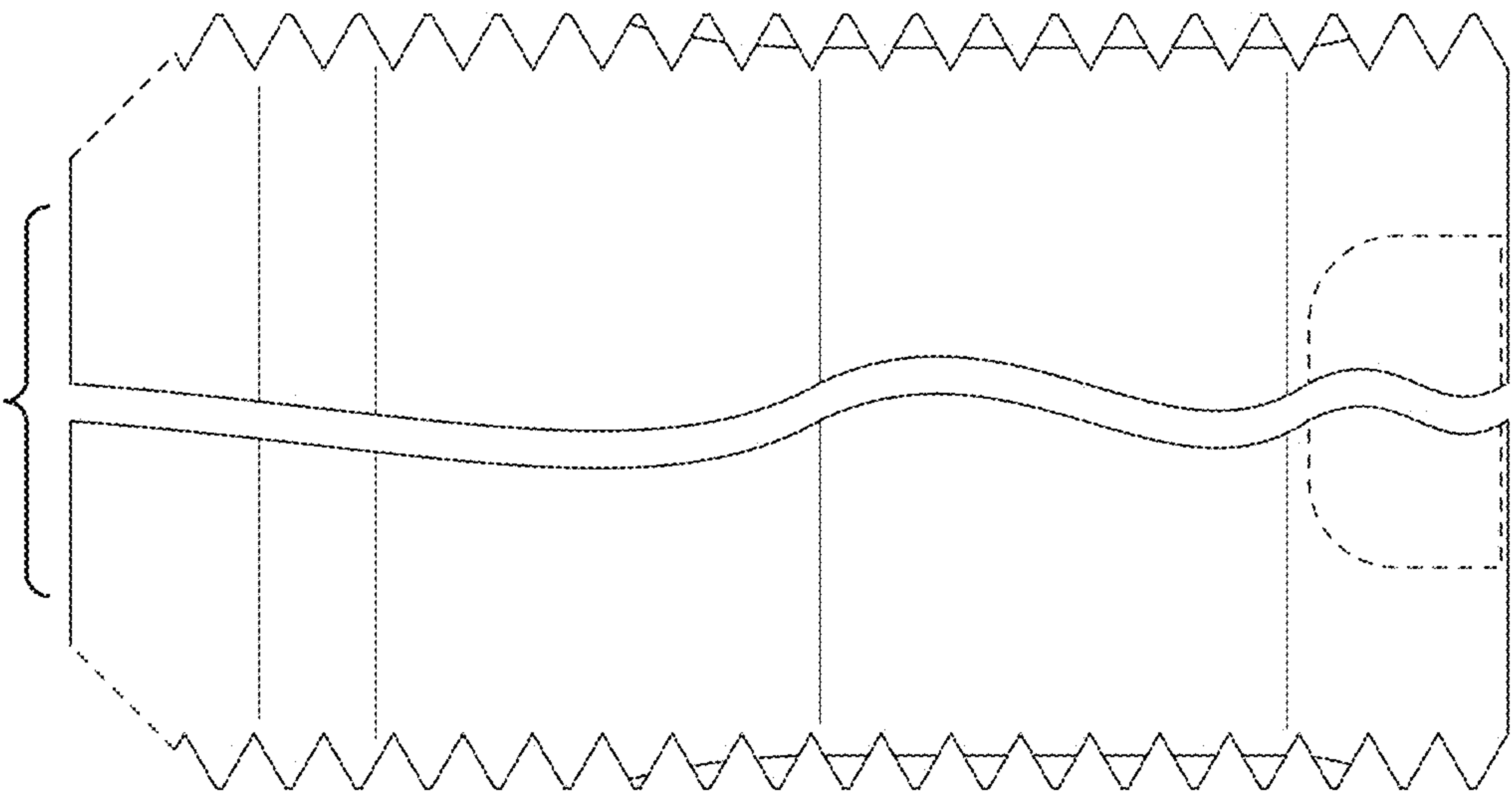

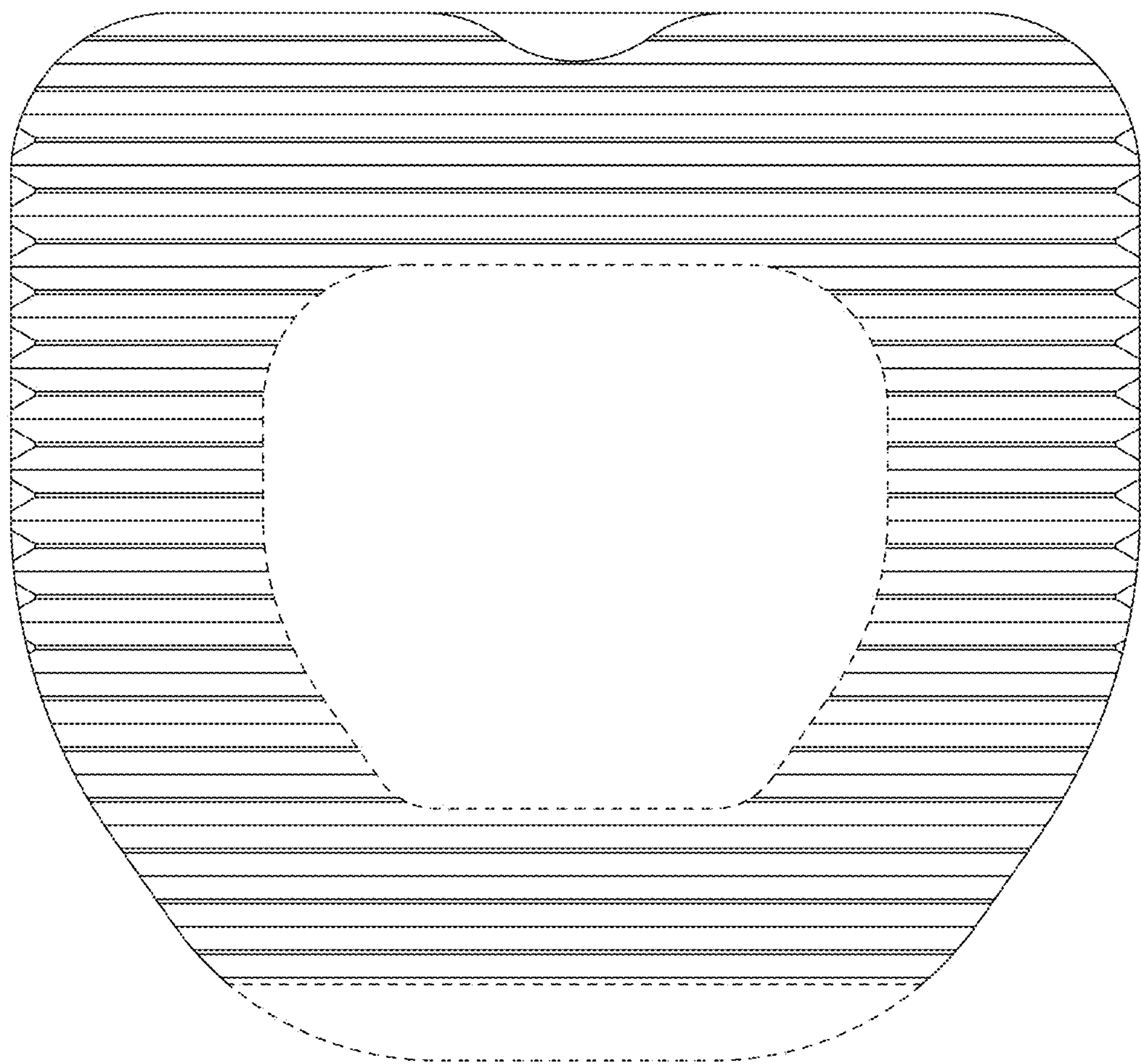

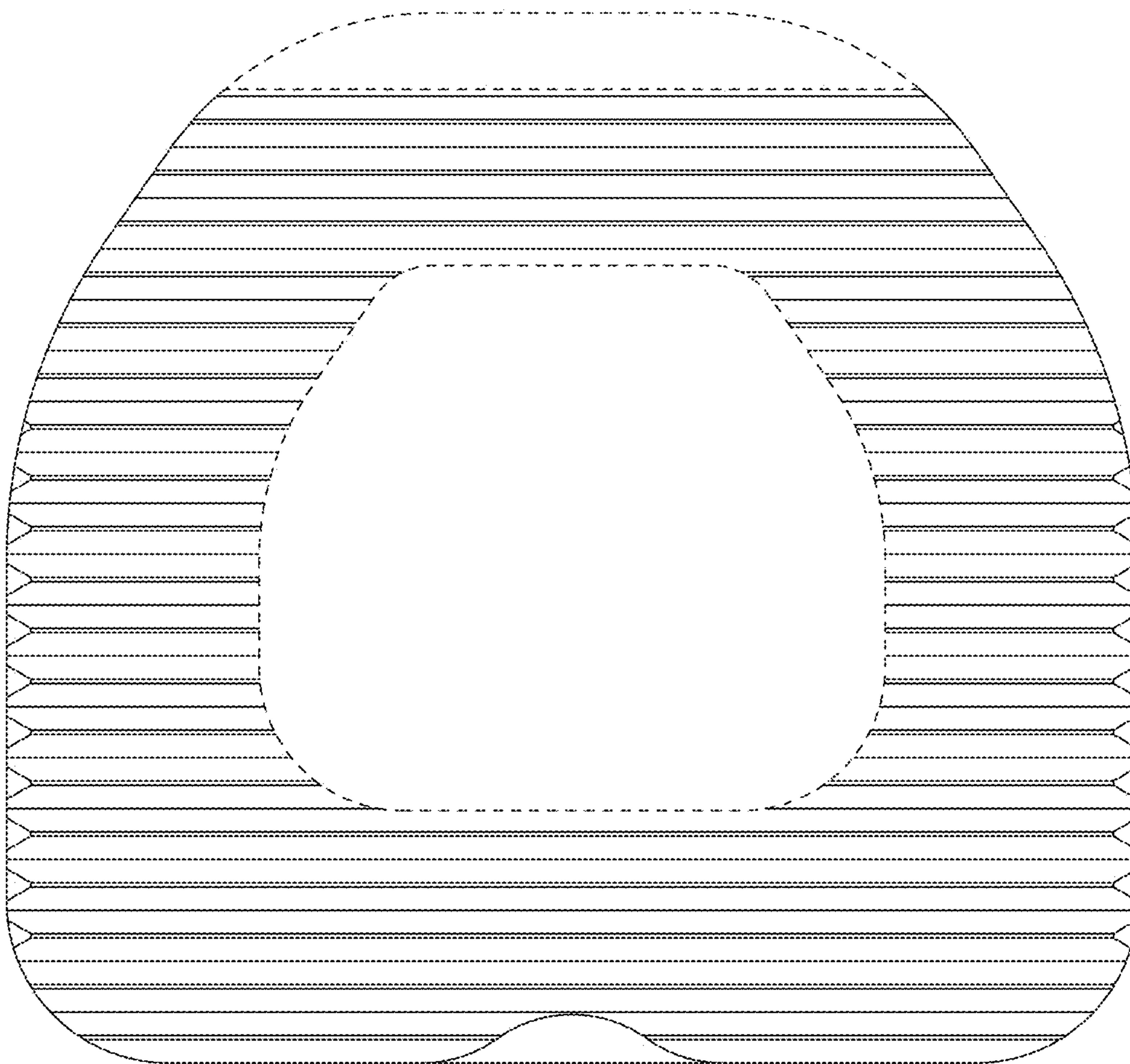

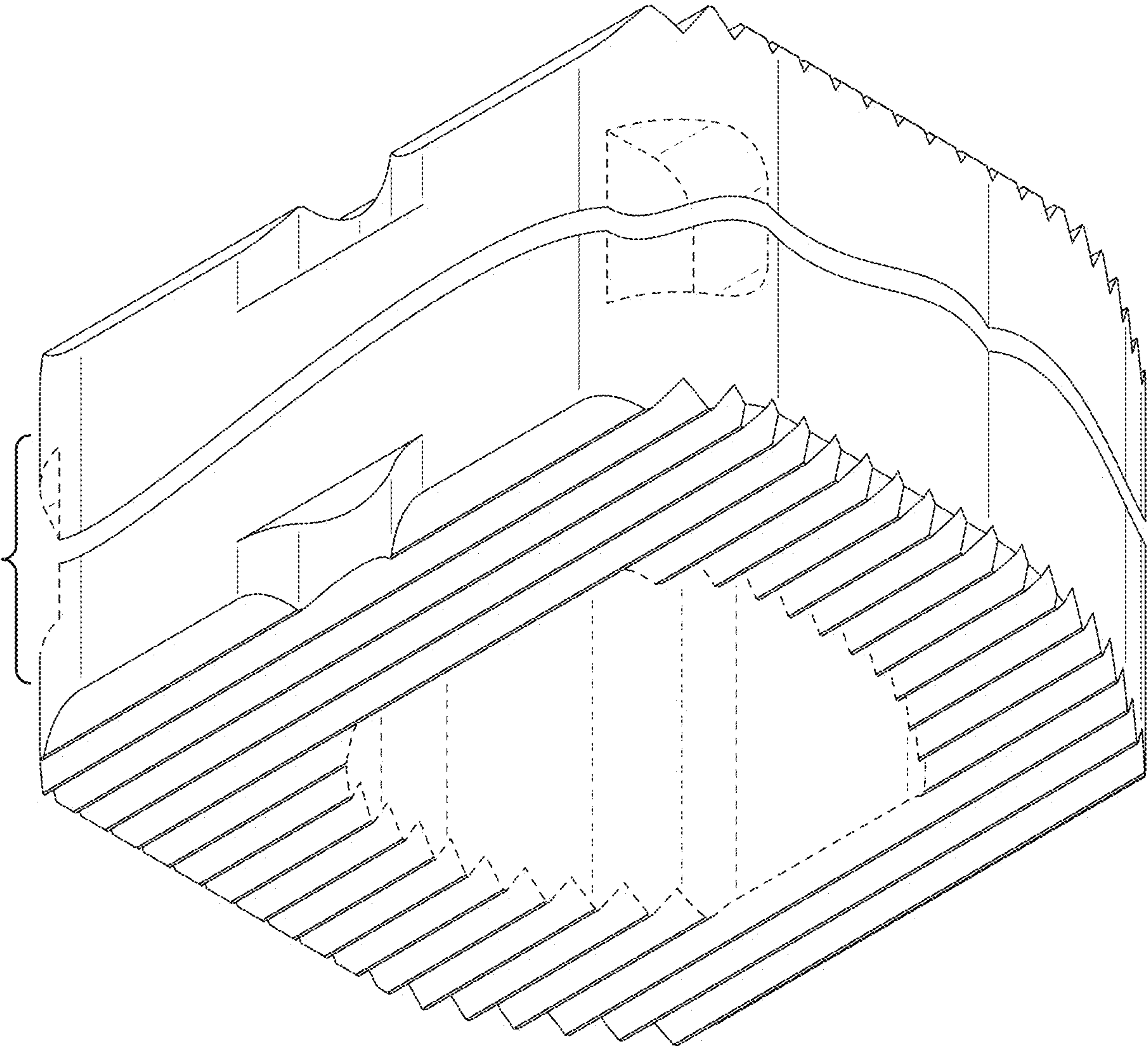

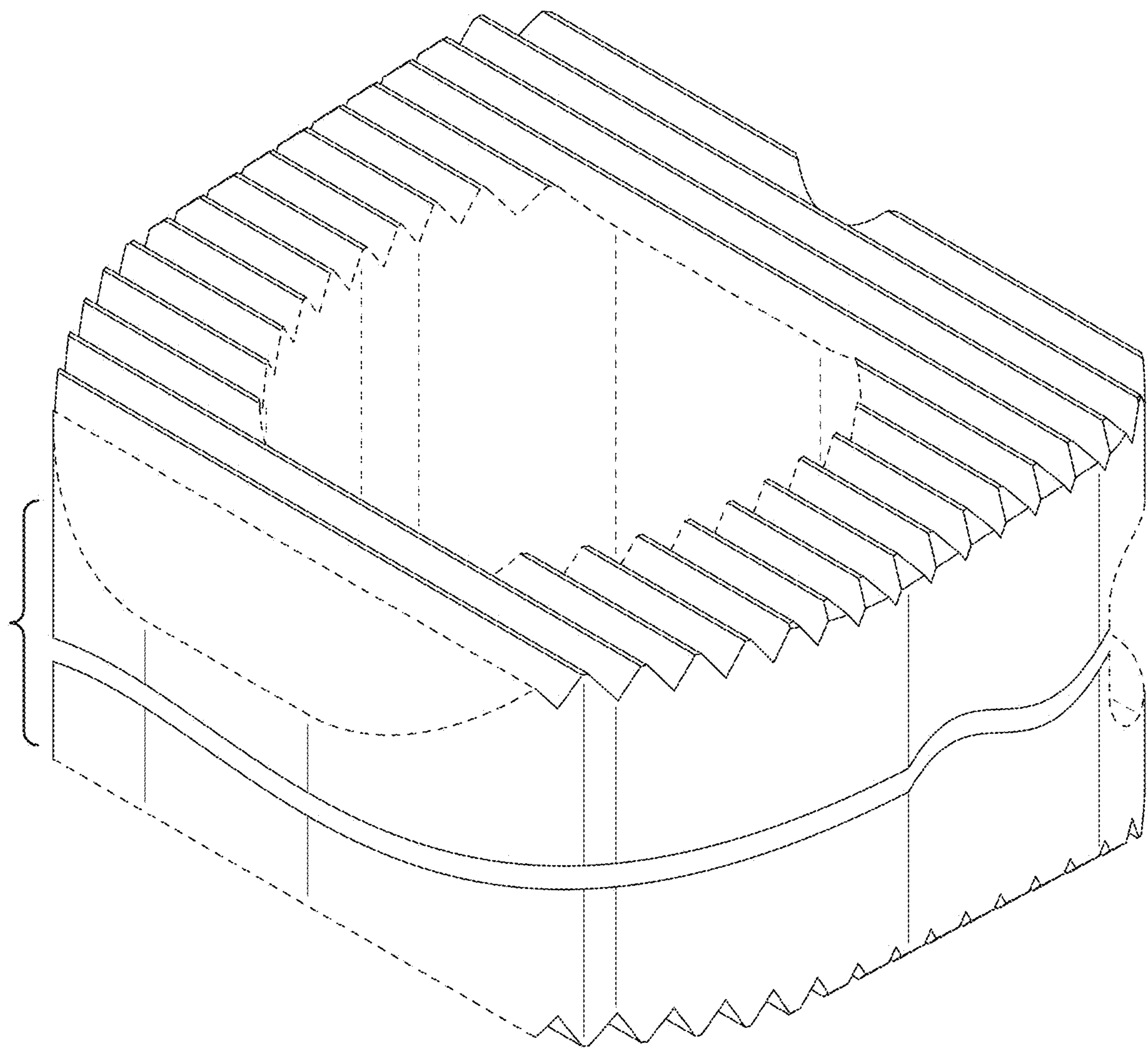

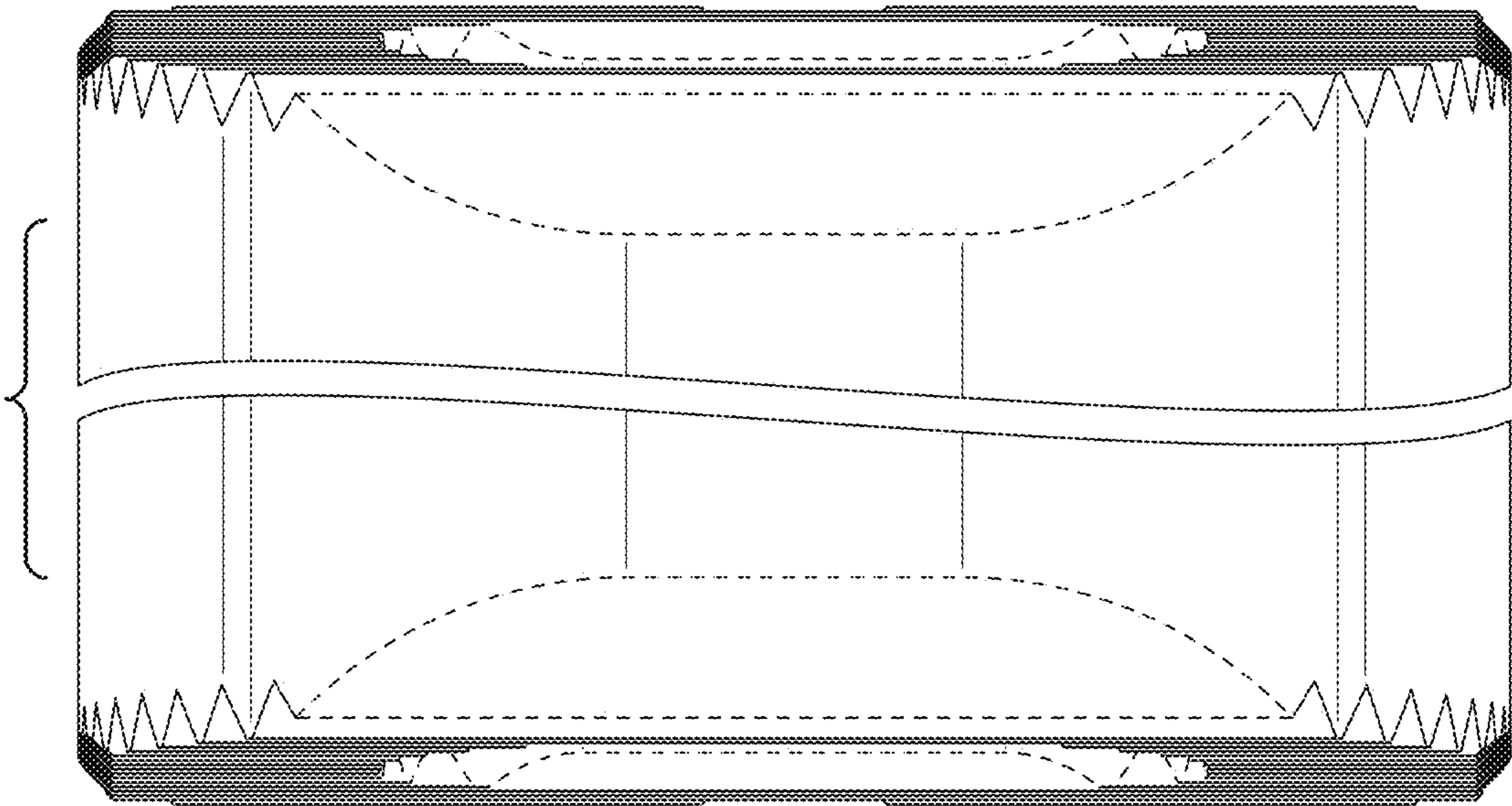

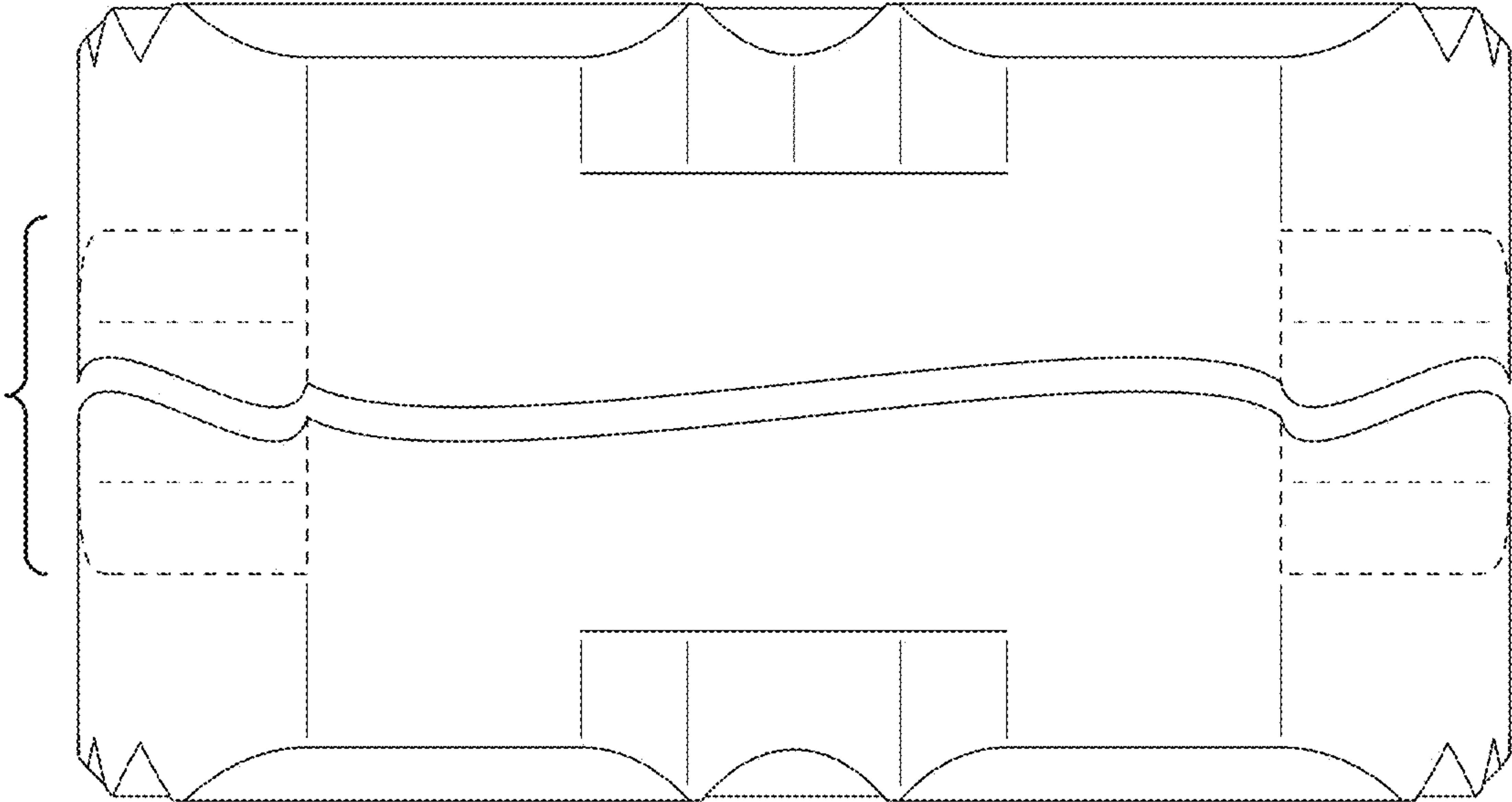

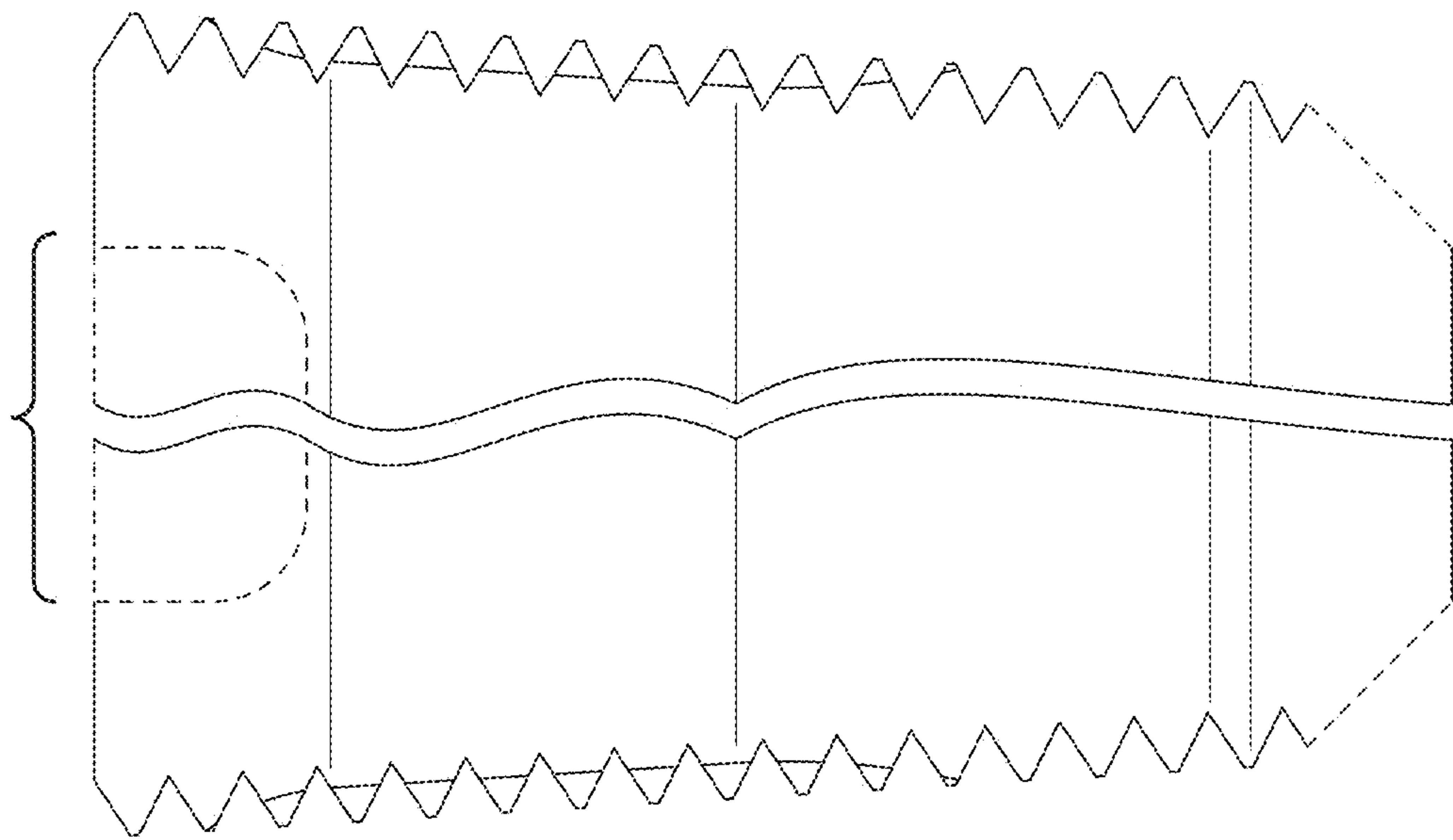

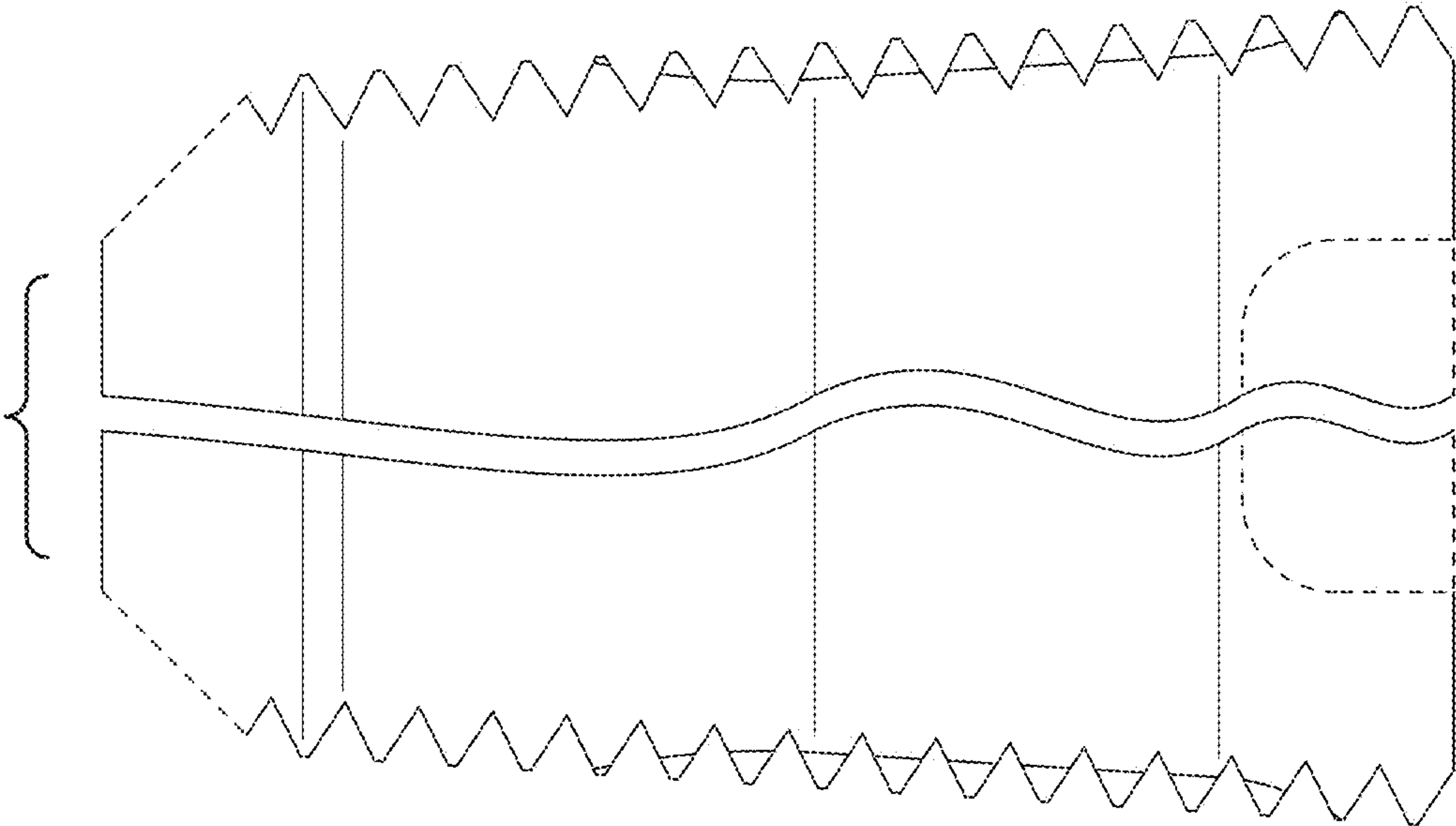

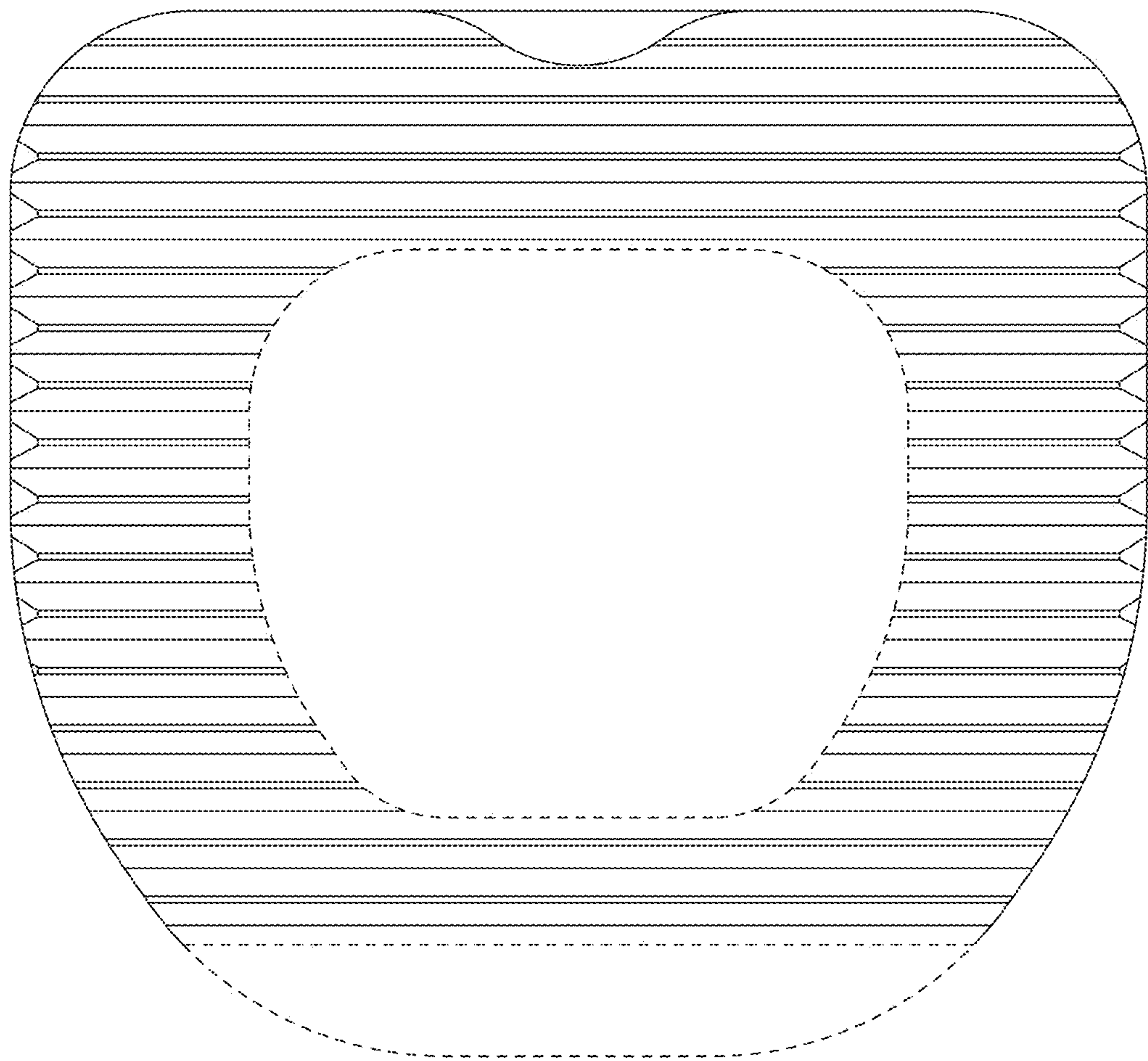

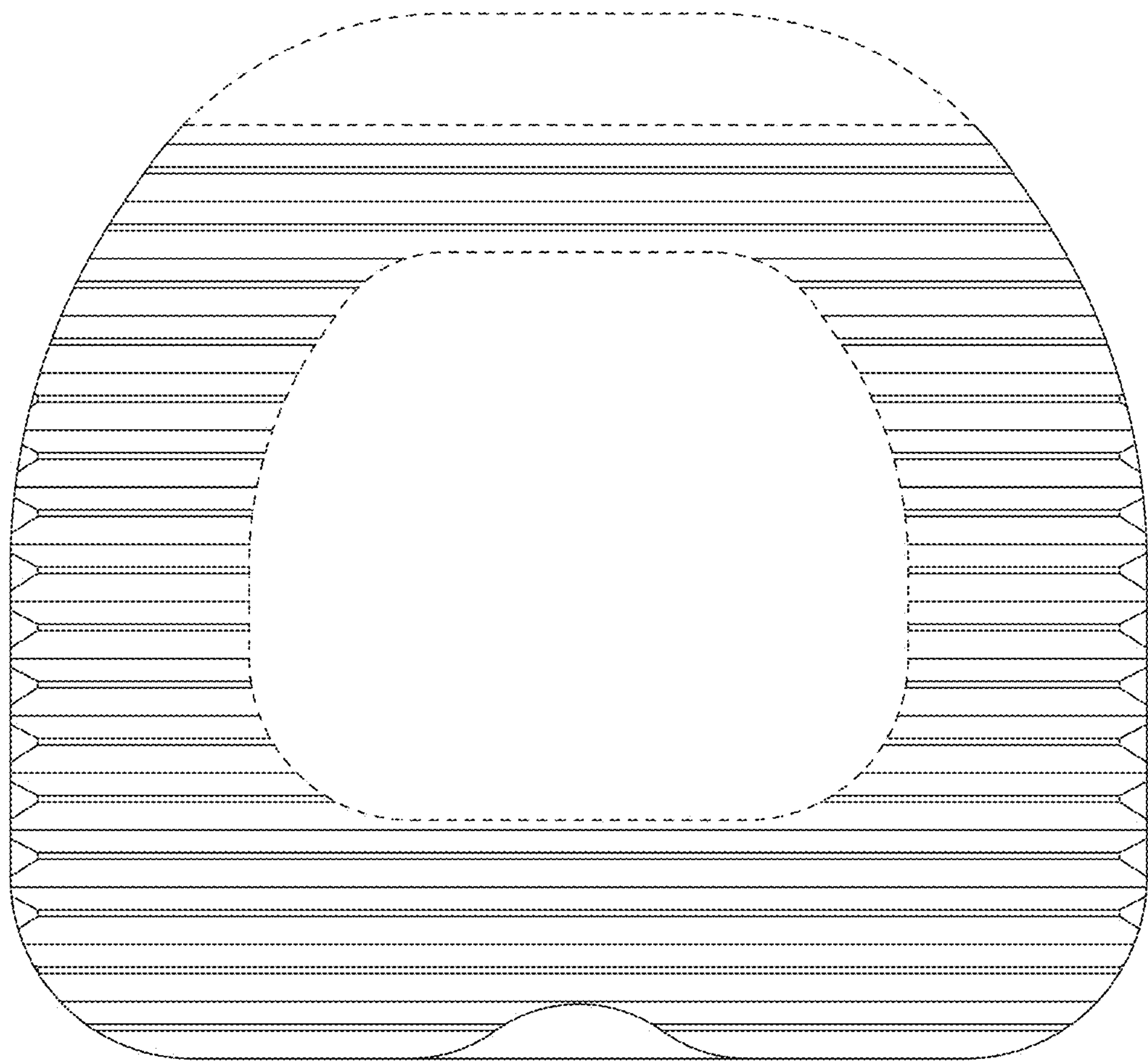

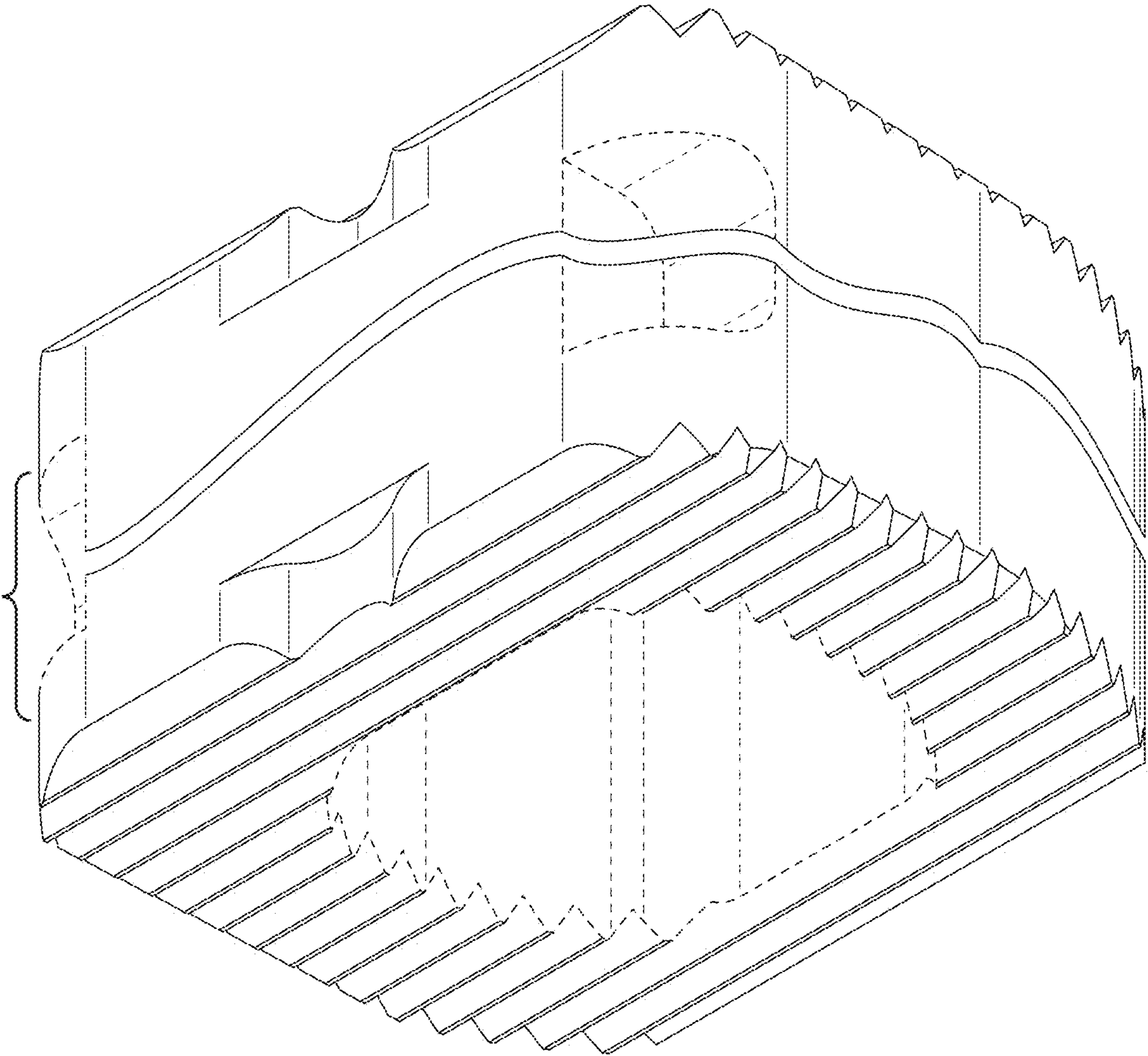
