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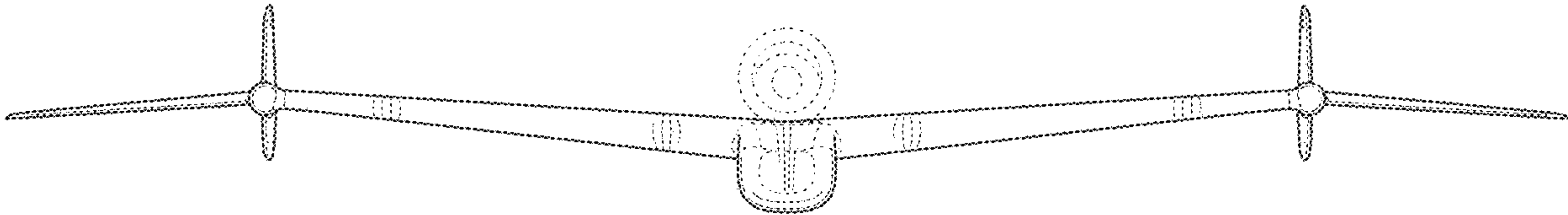
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a drone;
FIG. 2 is rear view of the drone;
FIG. 3 is a top view of the drone;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the drone;
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the drone, the right side view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the left side view and therefore not shown;
FIG. 6 is a right and front perspective view of the drone, the corresponding left and front perspective view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the right and front perspective view of the drone and therefore not shown;
FIG. 7 is a top, front, and left perspective view of the drone, the corresponding top, front, and right perspective view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the top, front, and left perspective view of the drone and therefore not shown;
FIG. 8 is a bottom, front, and left perspective view of the drone, the corresponding bottom, front, and right perspective view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the bottom, front, and left perspective view of the drone and therefore not shown;
FIG. 9 is a bottom and right perspective view of the drone, the corresponding bottom and left perspective view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the bottom and right perspective view of the drone and therefore not shown; and,
FIG. 10 is a top, rear, and right perspective view of the drone, the corresponding top, rear, and left perspective view of the drone being an identical mirror image to the top, rear, and right perspective view of the drone and therefore not shown.
The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded surfaces depict the bounds of the claimed design, whereas all remaining broken lines depict portions of the drone, all of which form no part of the claimed design.

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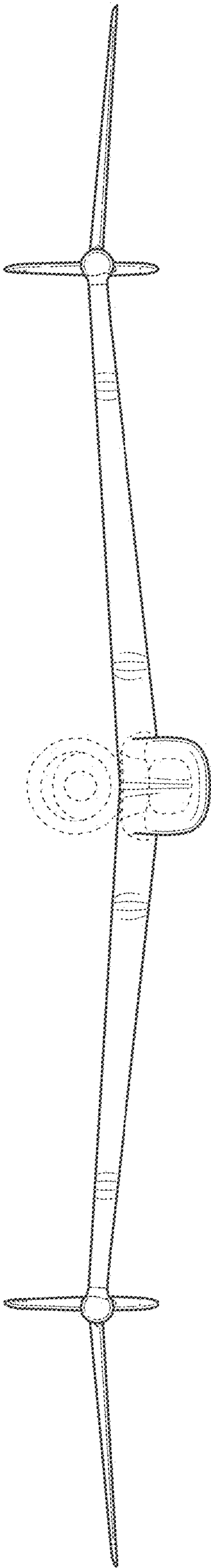

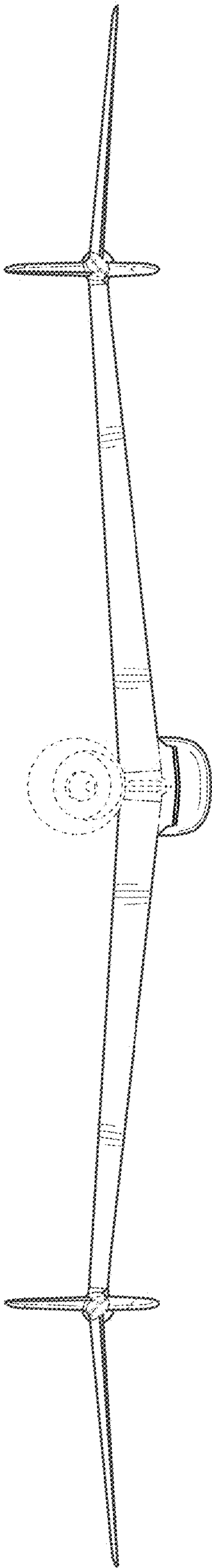

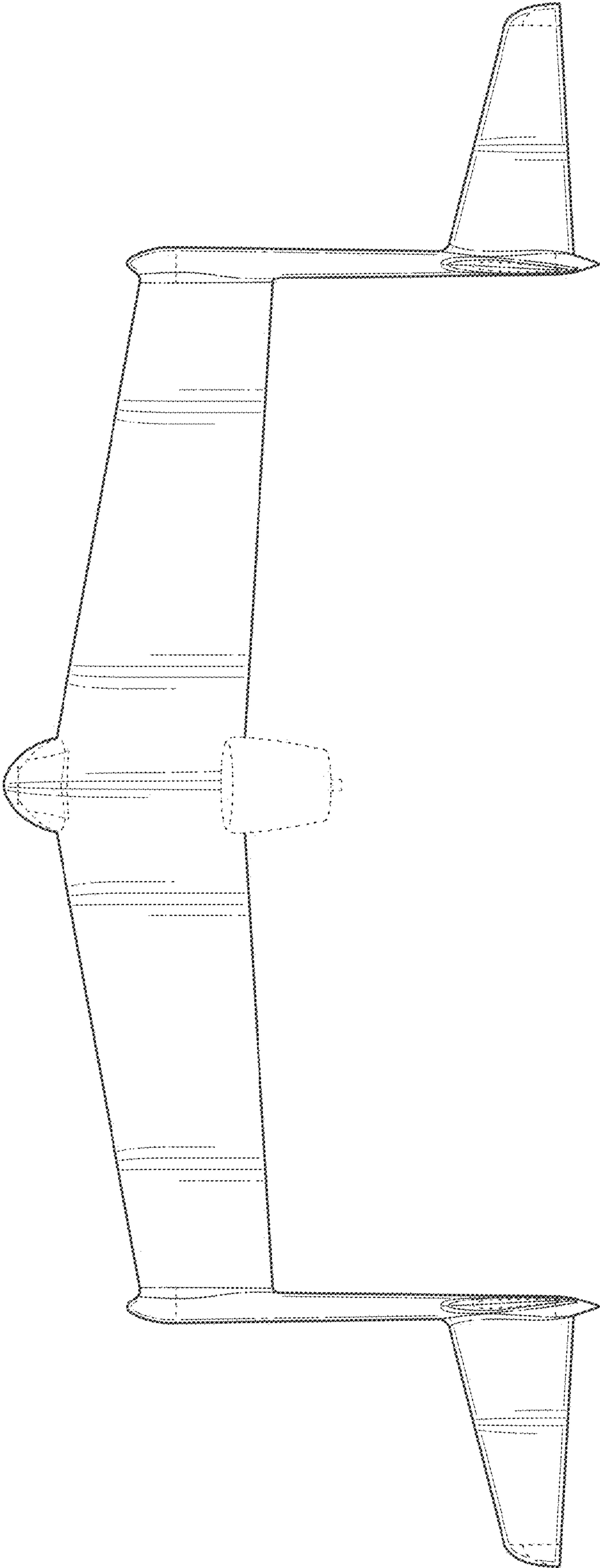

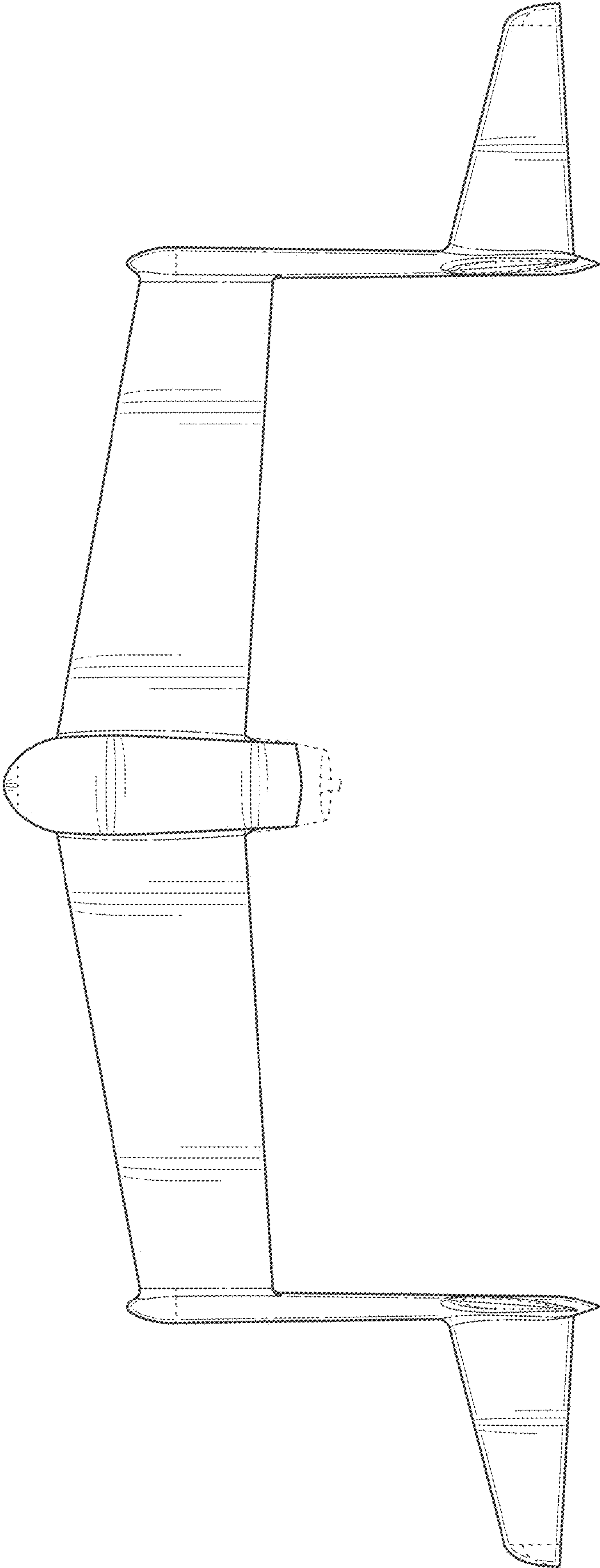

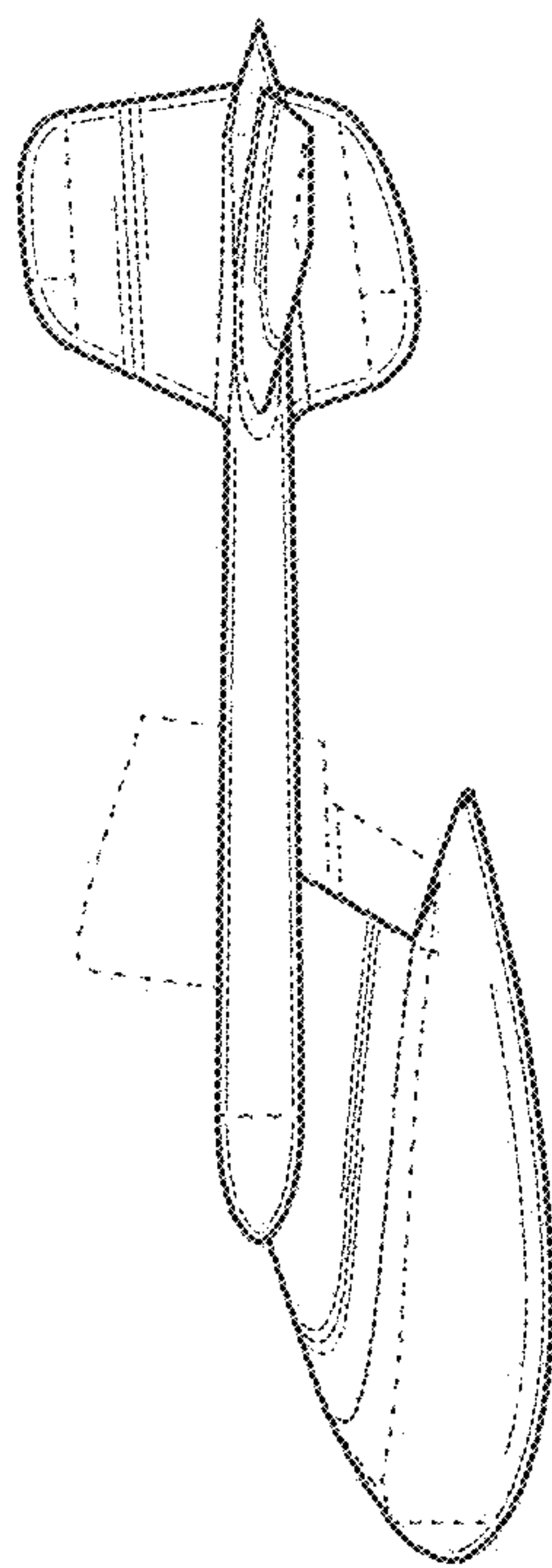

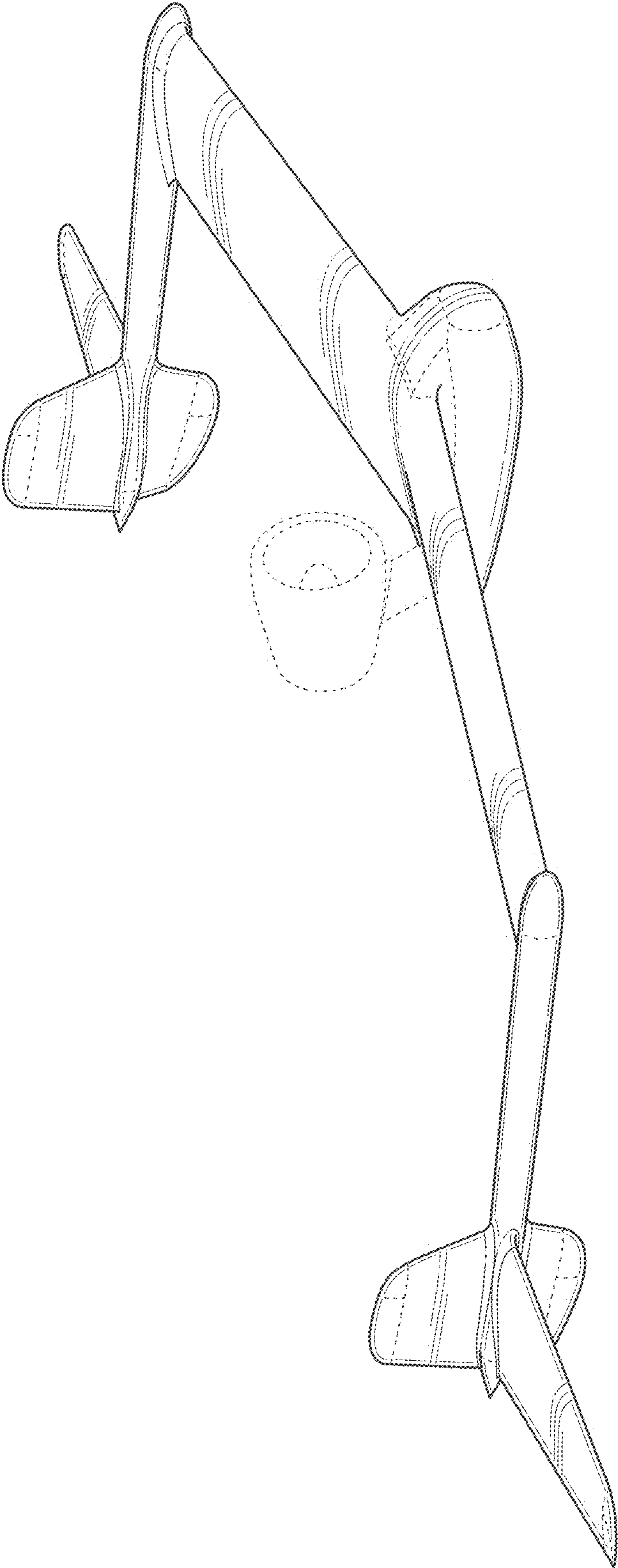

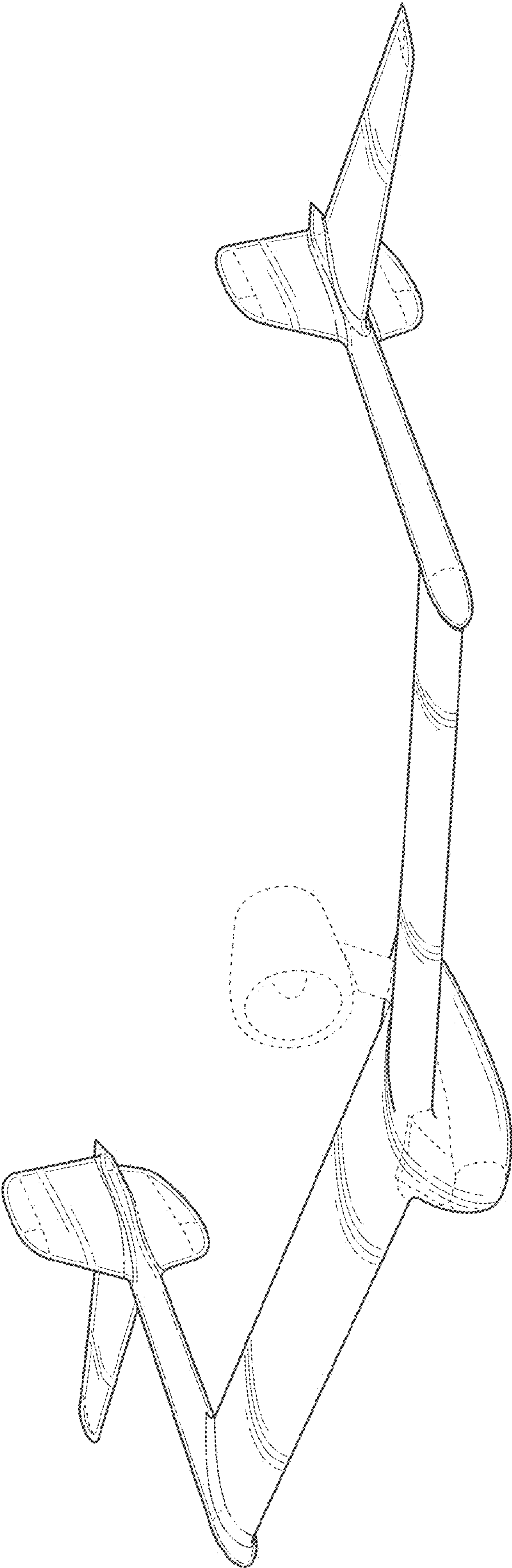

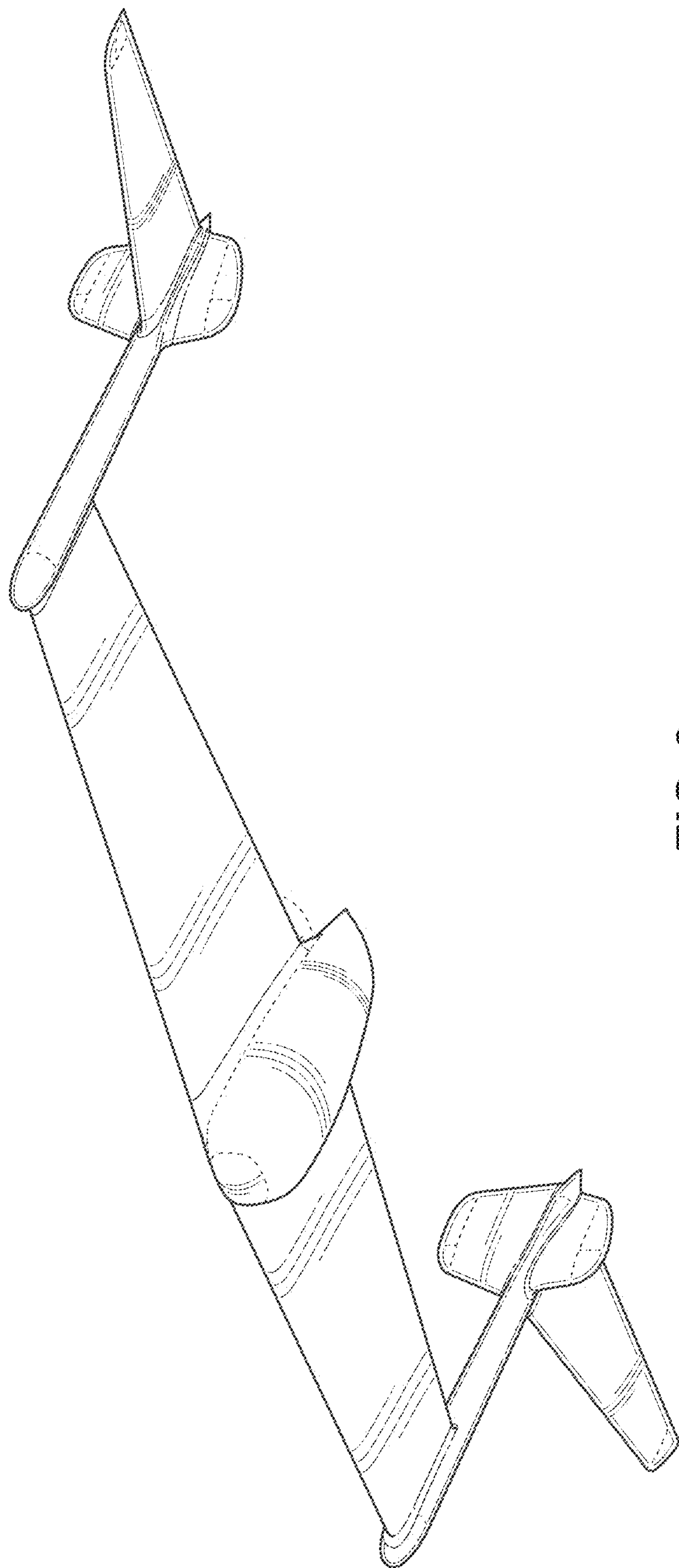

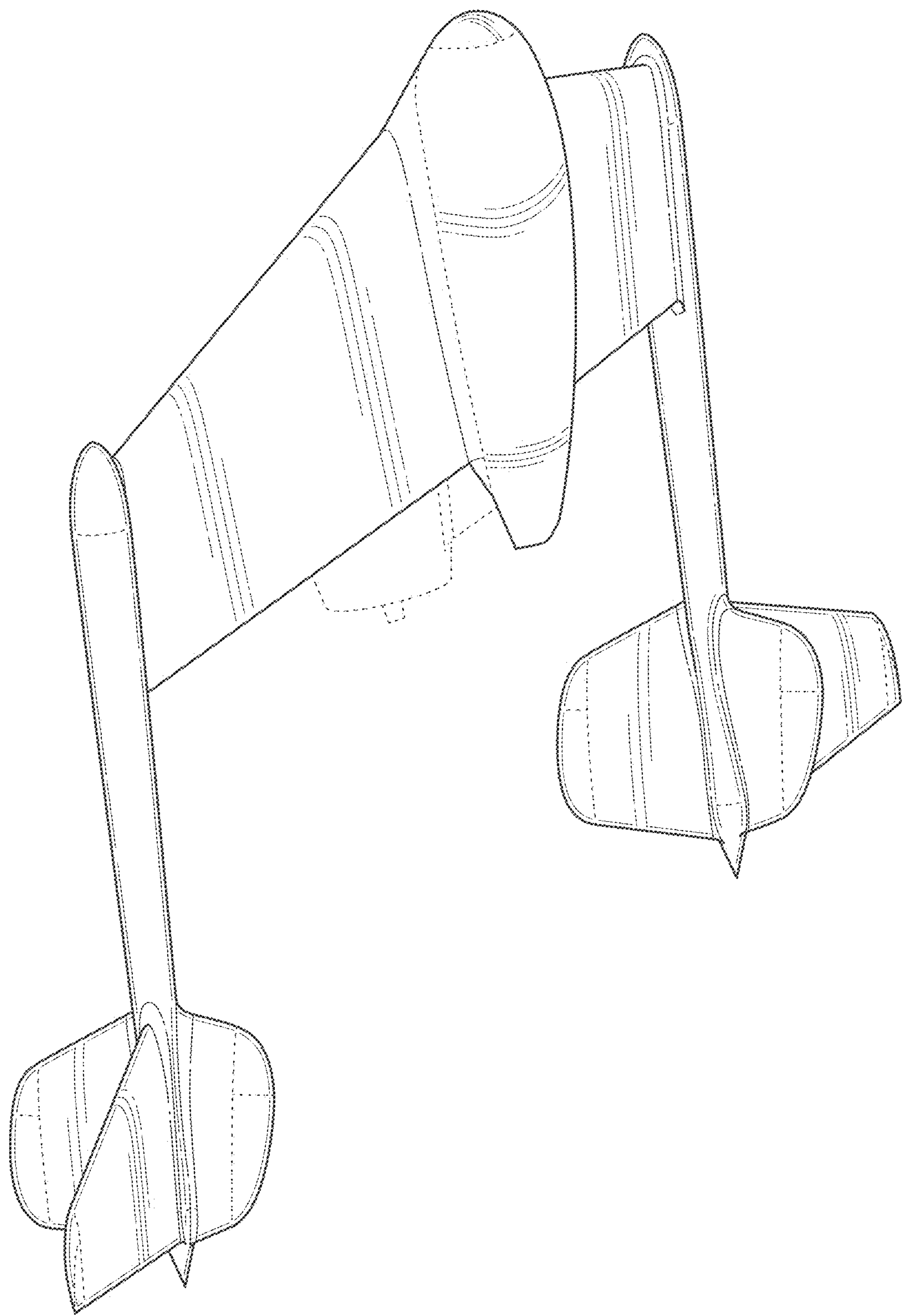

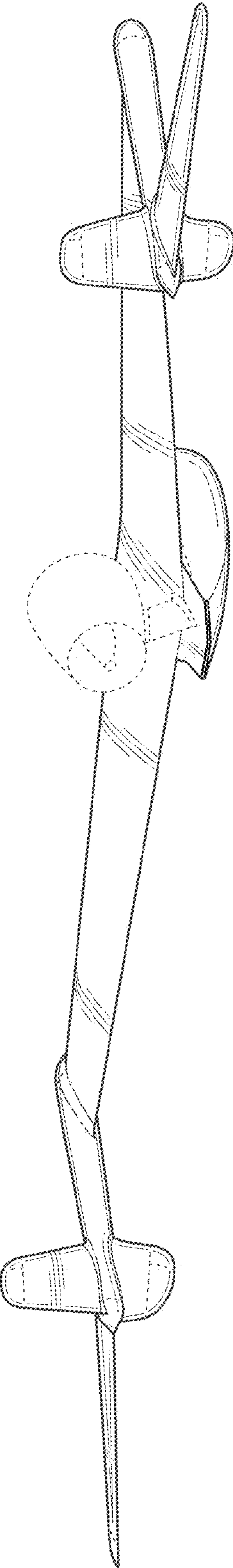
