FIG. 13 is a front elevation view of the clip of FIG. 9;

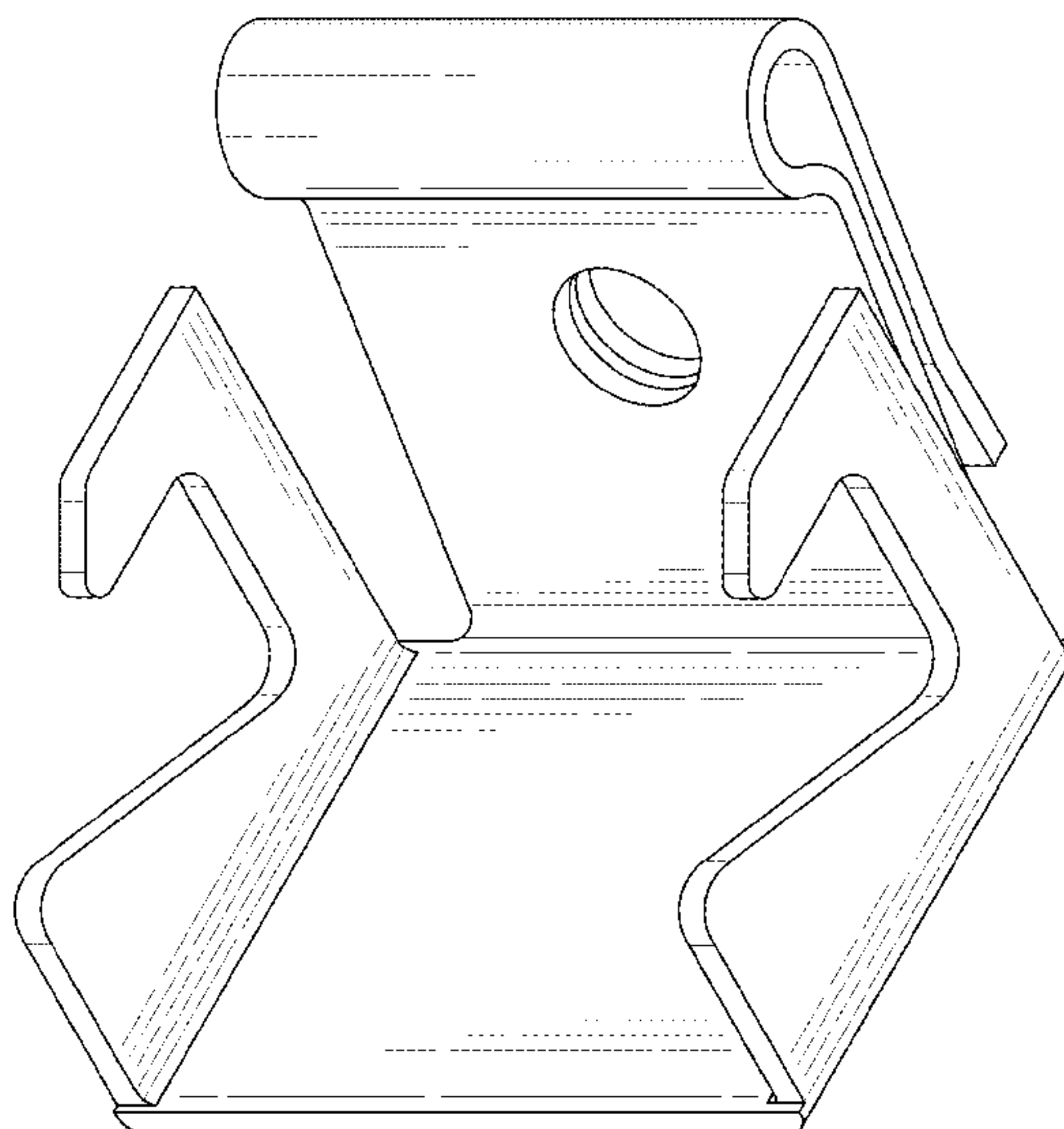
FIG. 14 is a rear elevation view of the clip of FIG. 9;

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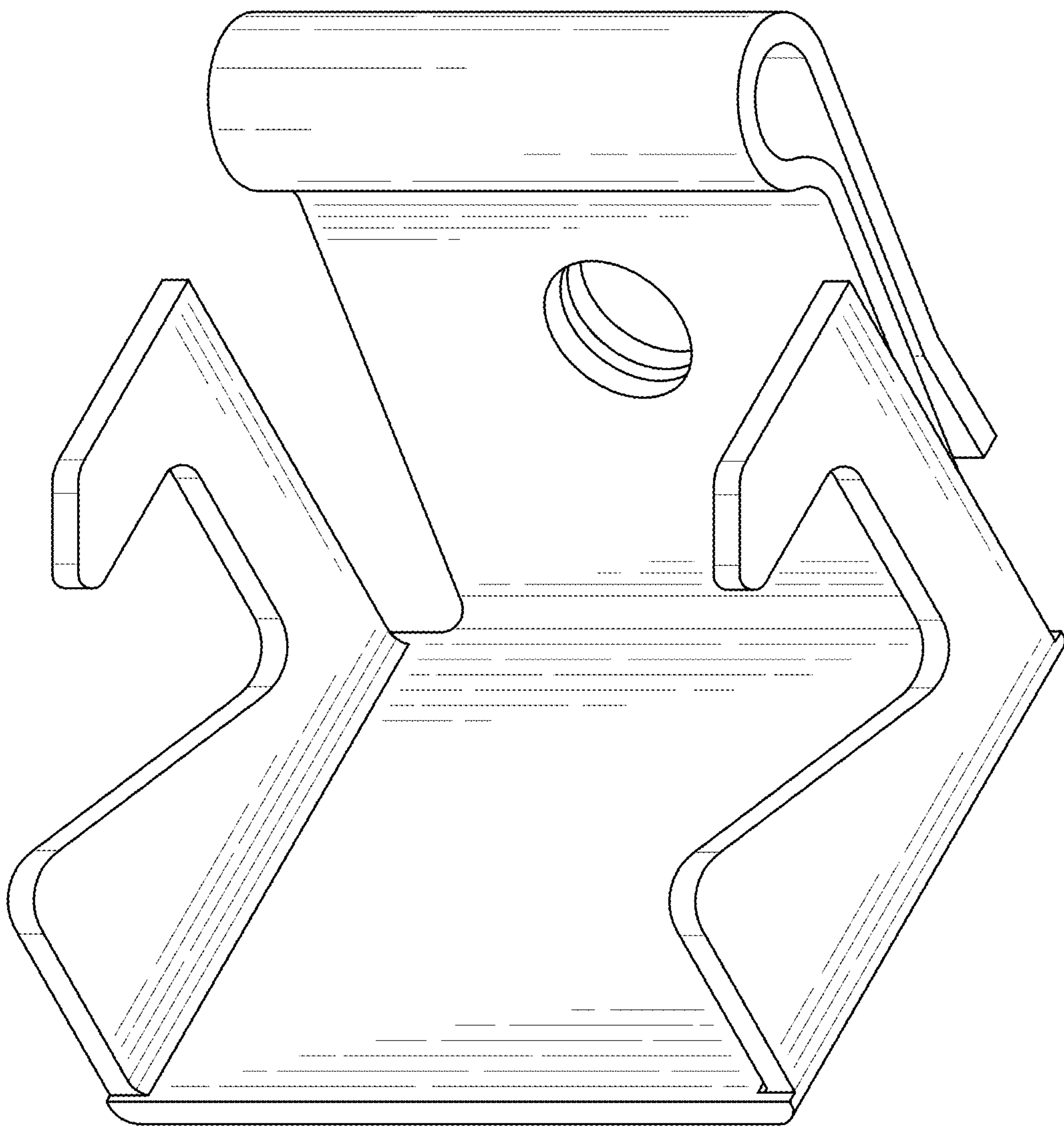

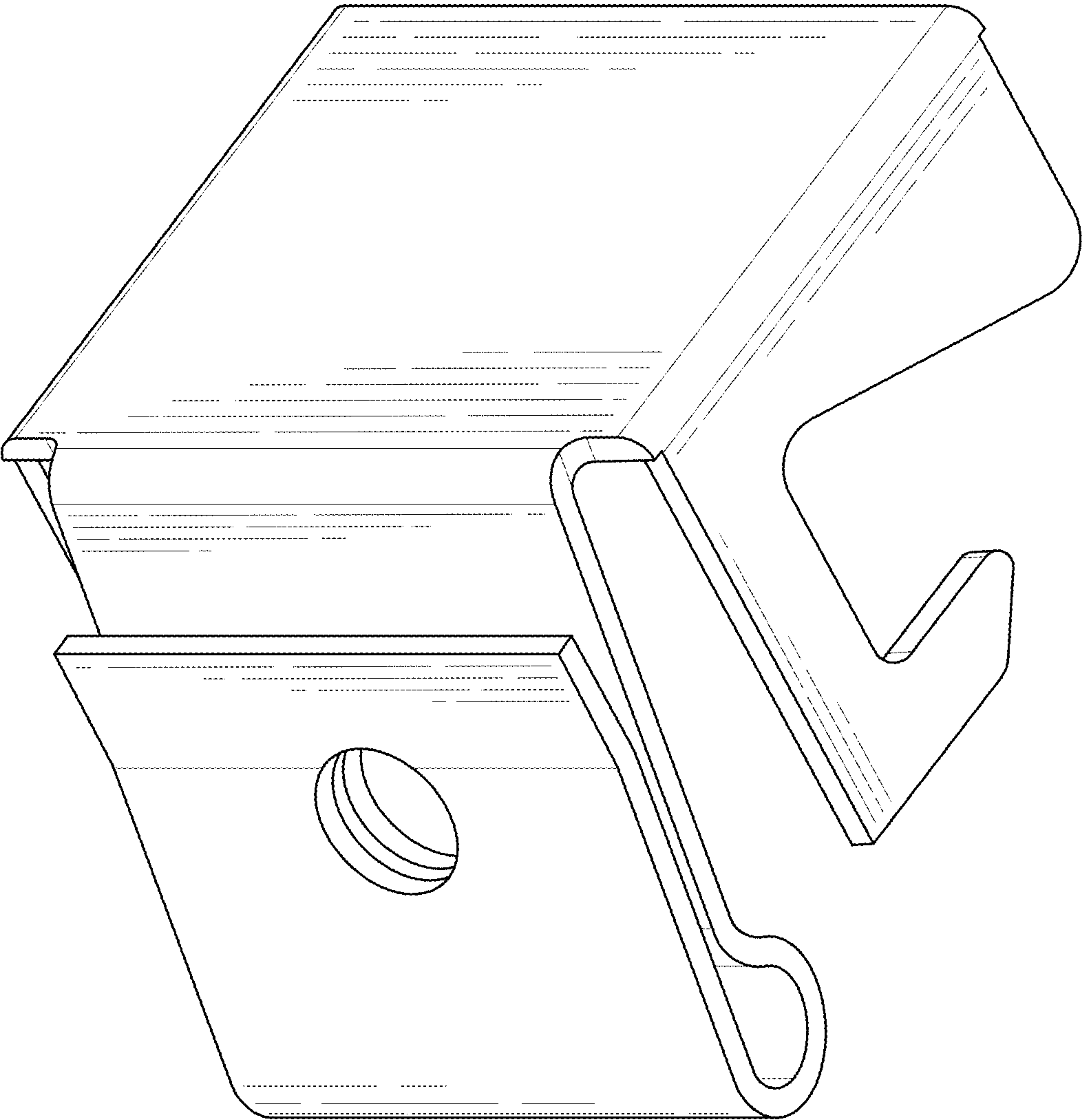

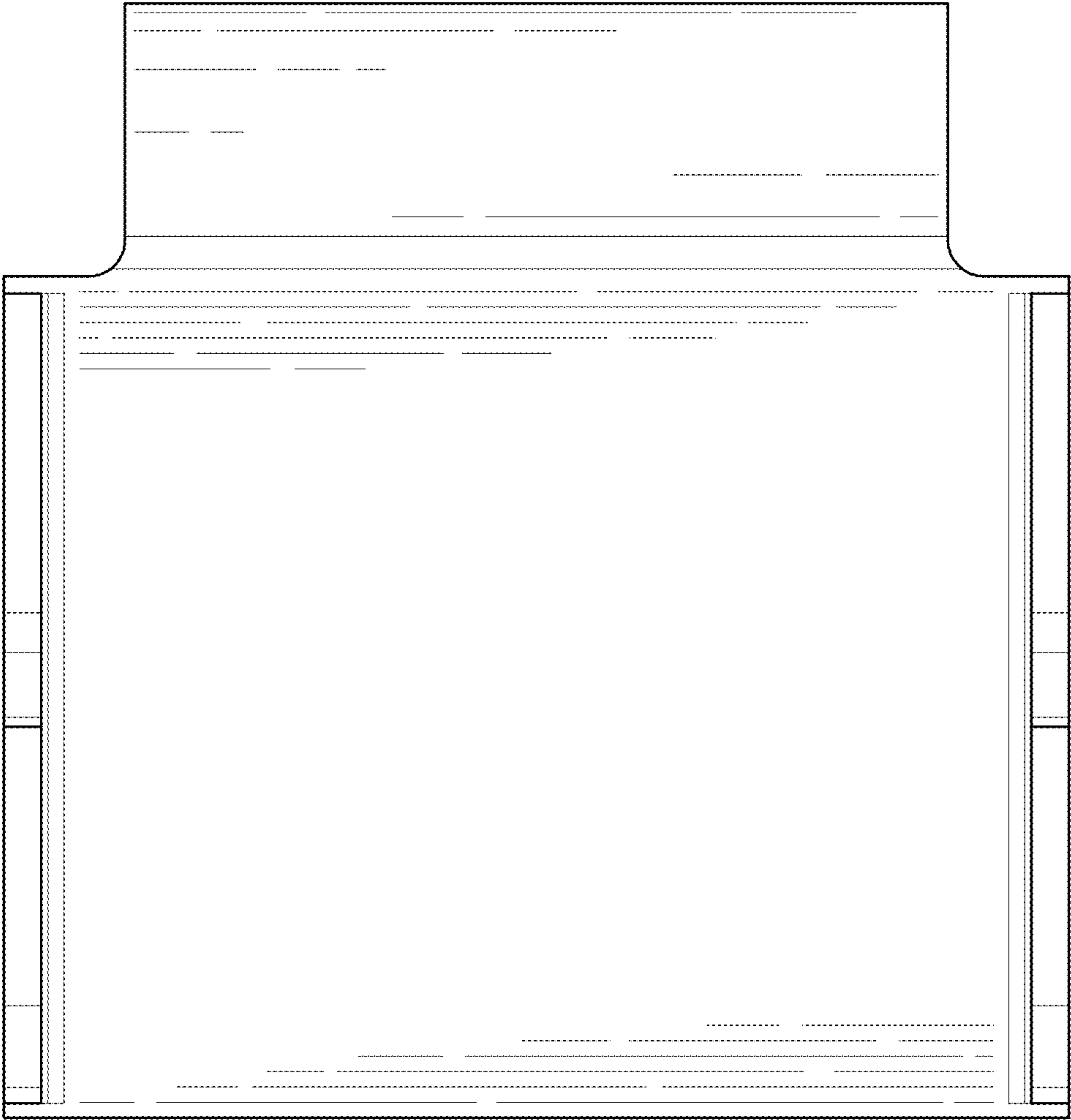

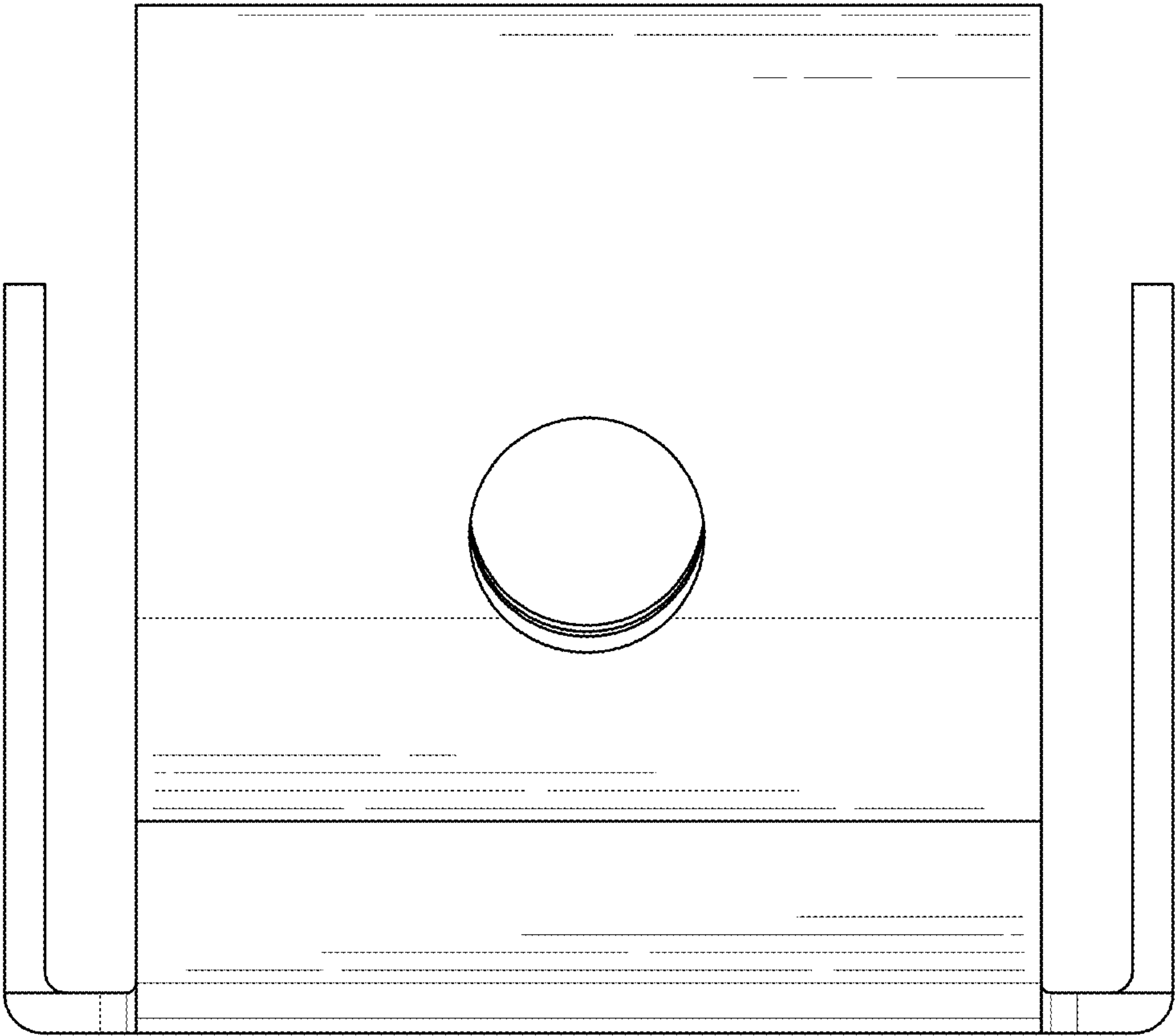

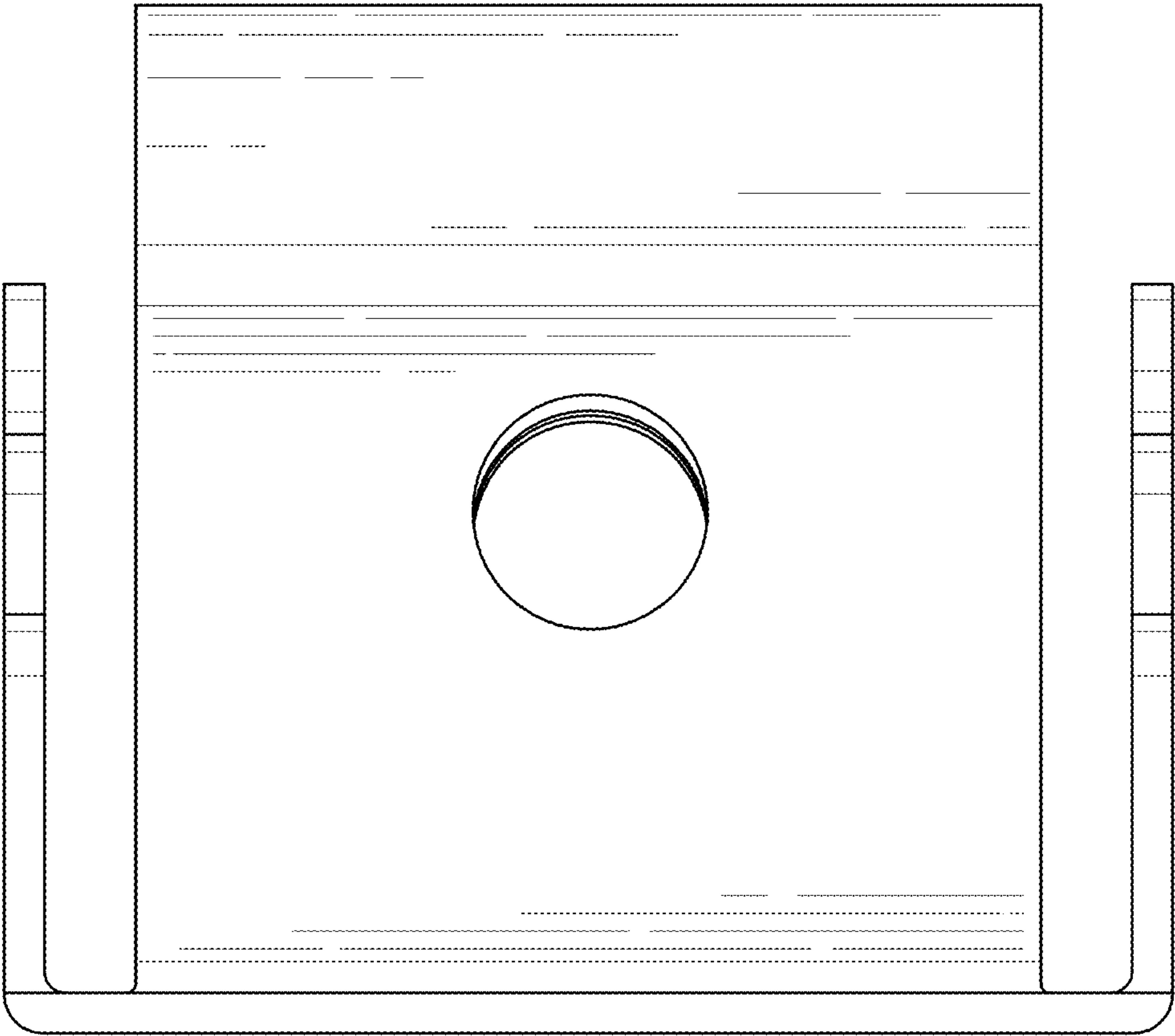

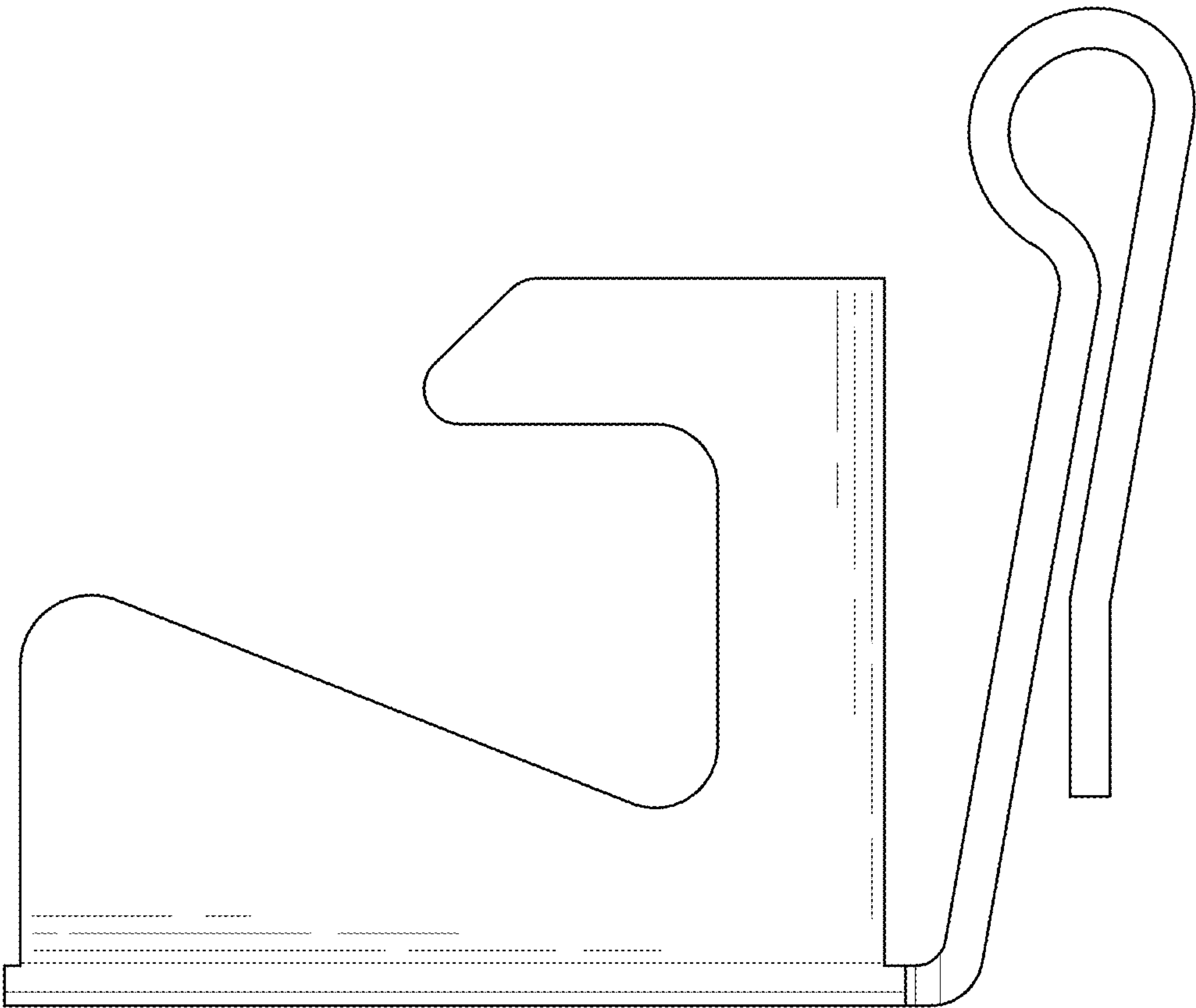

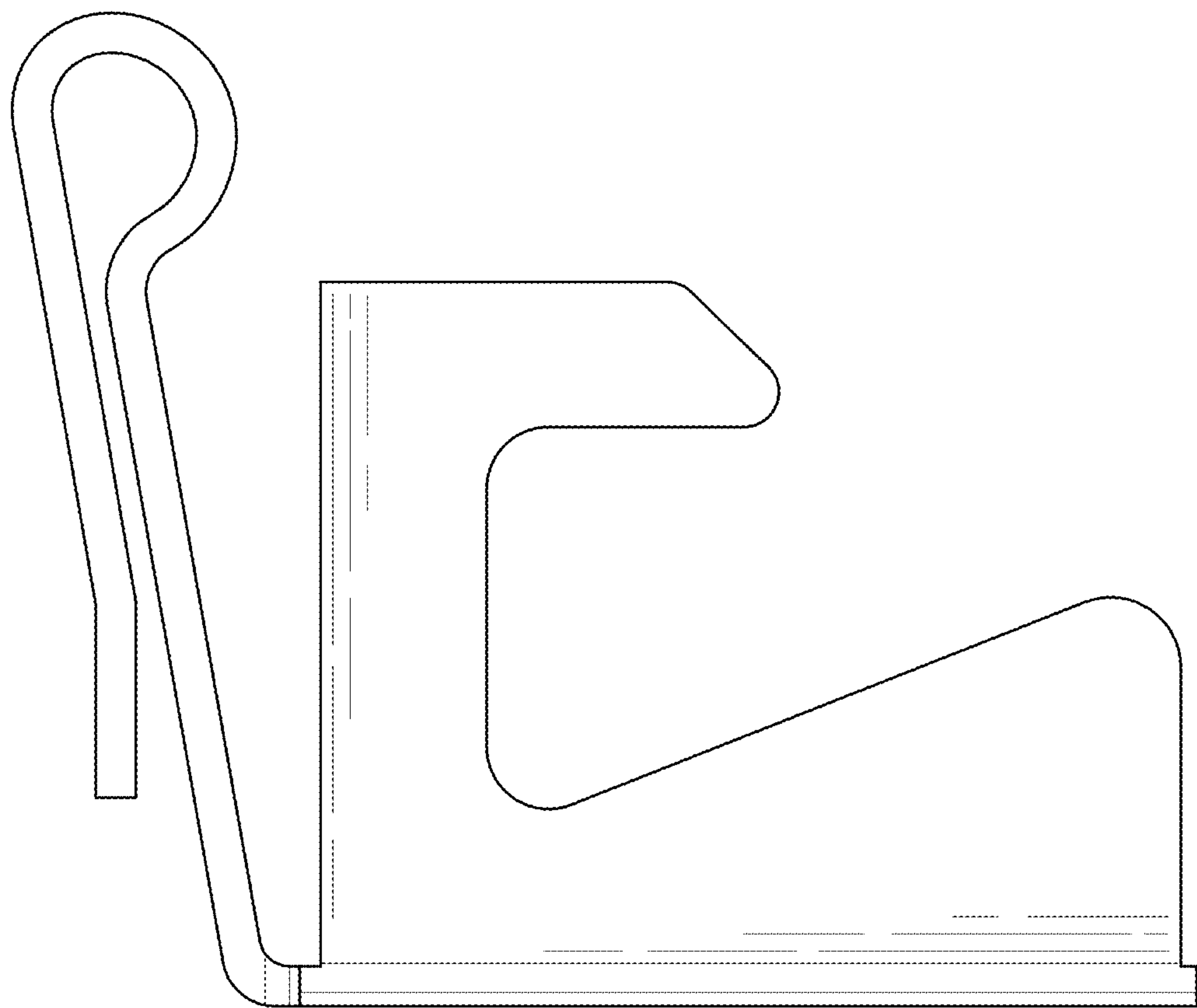

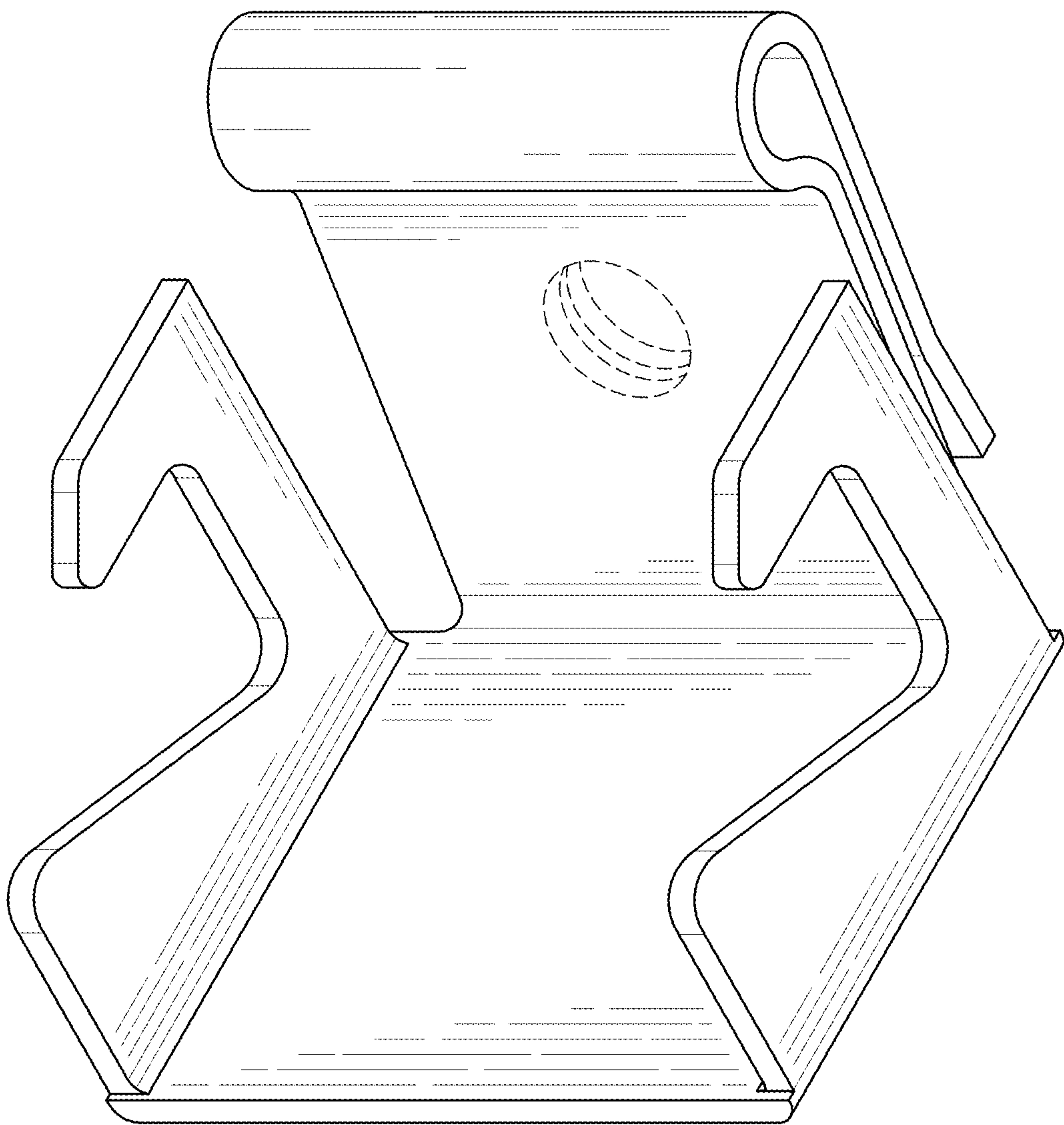

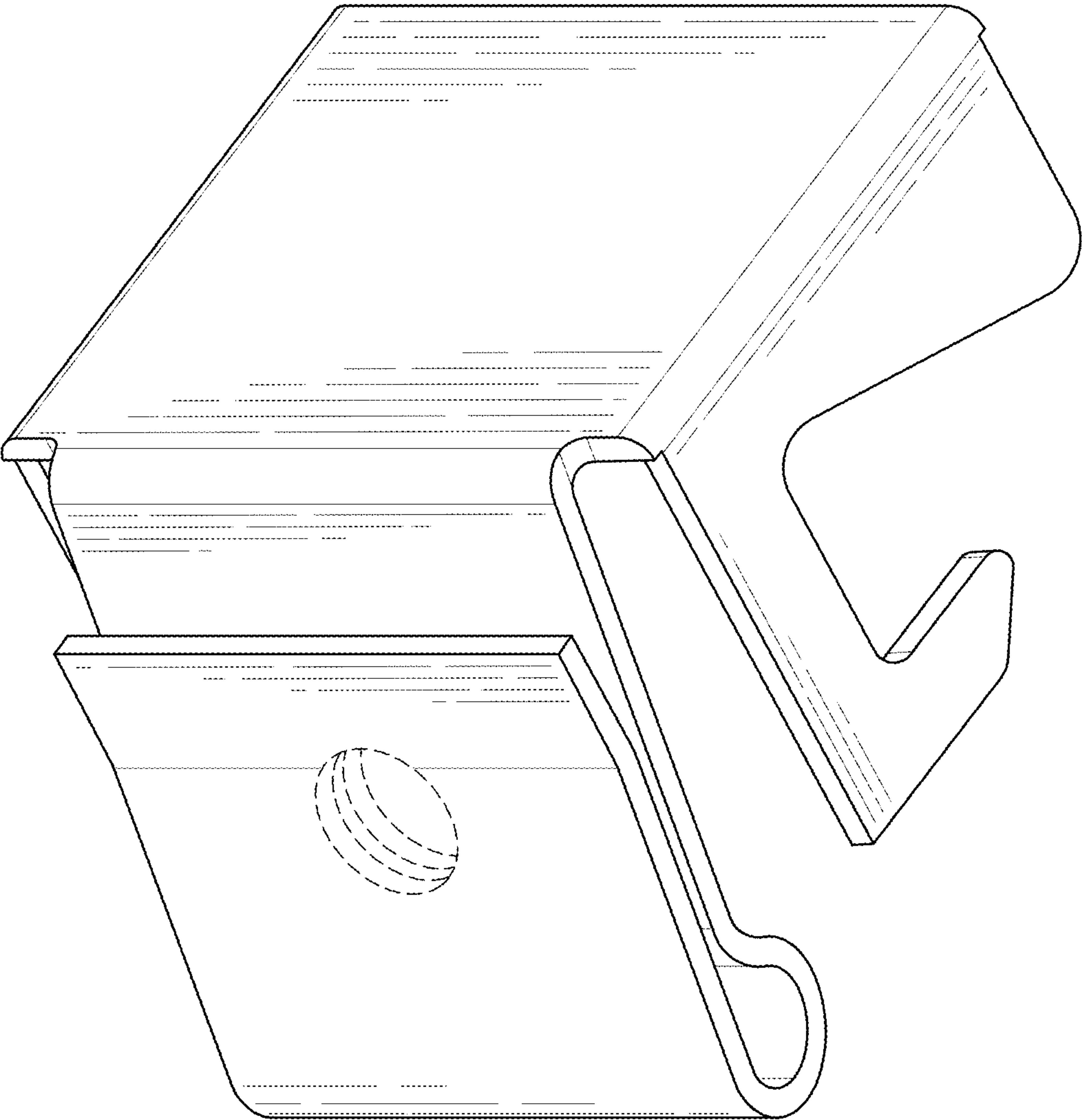

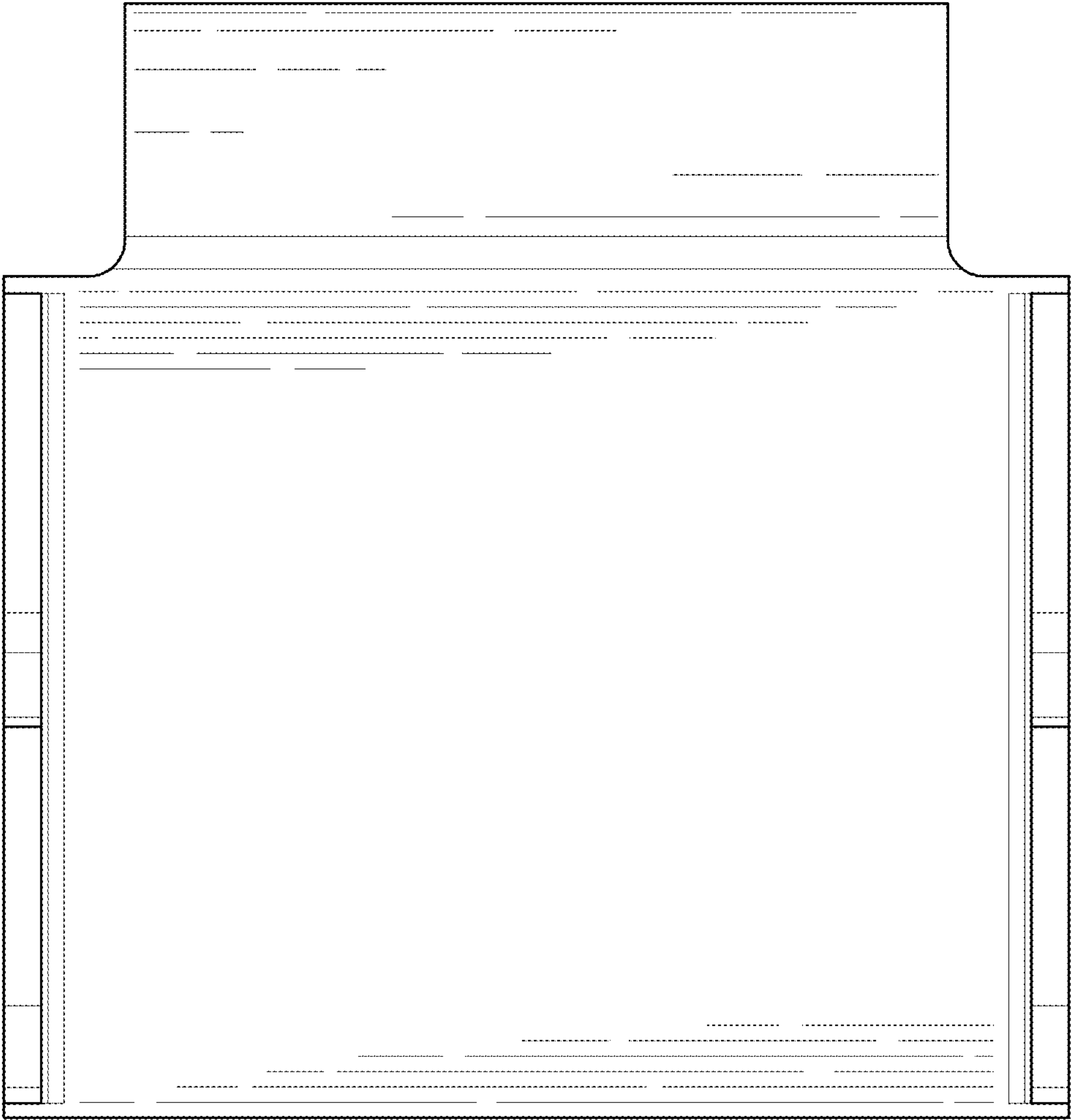

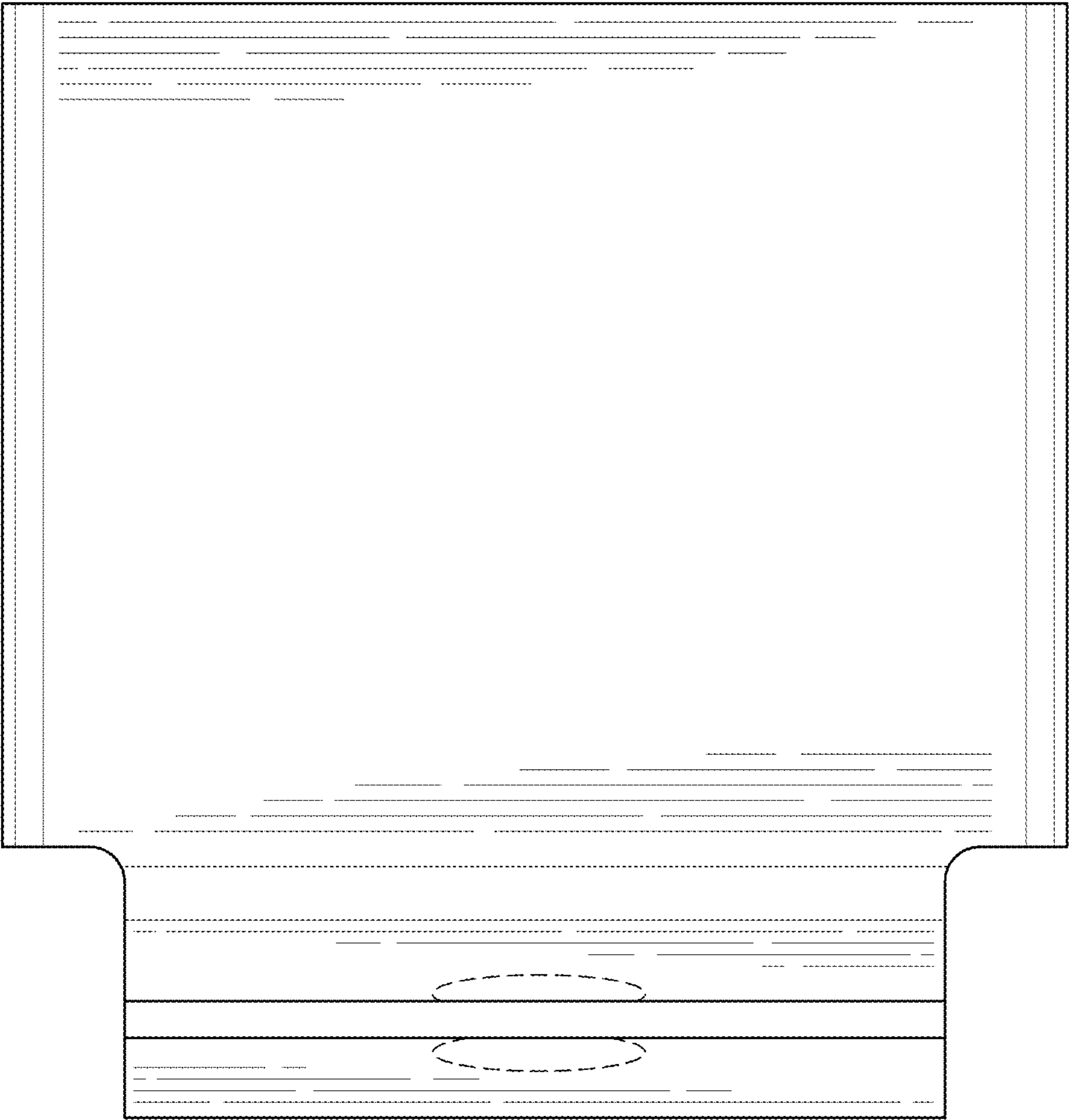

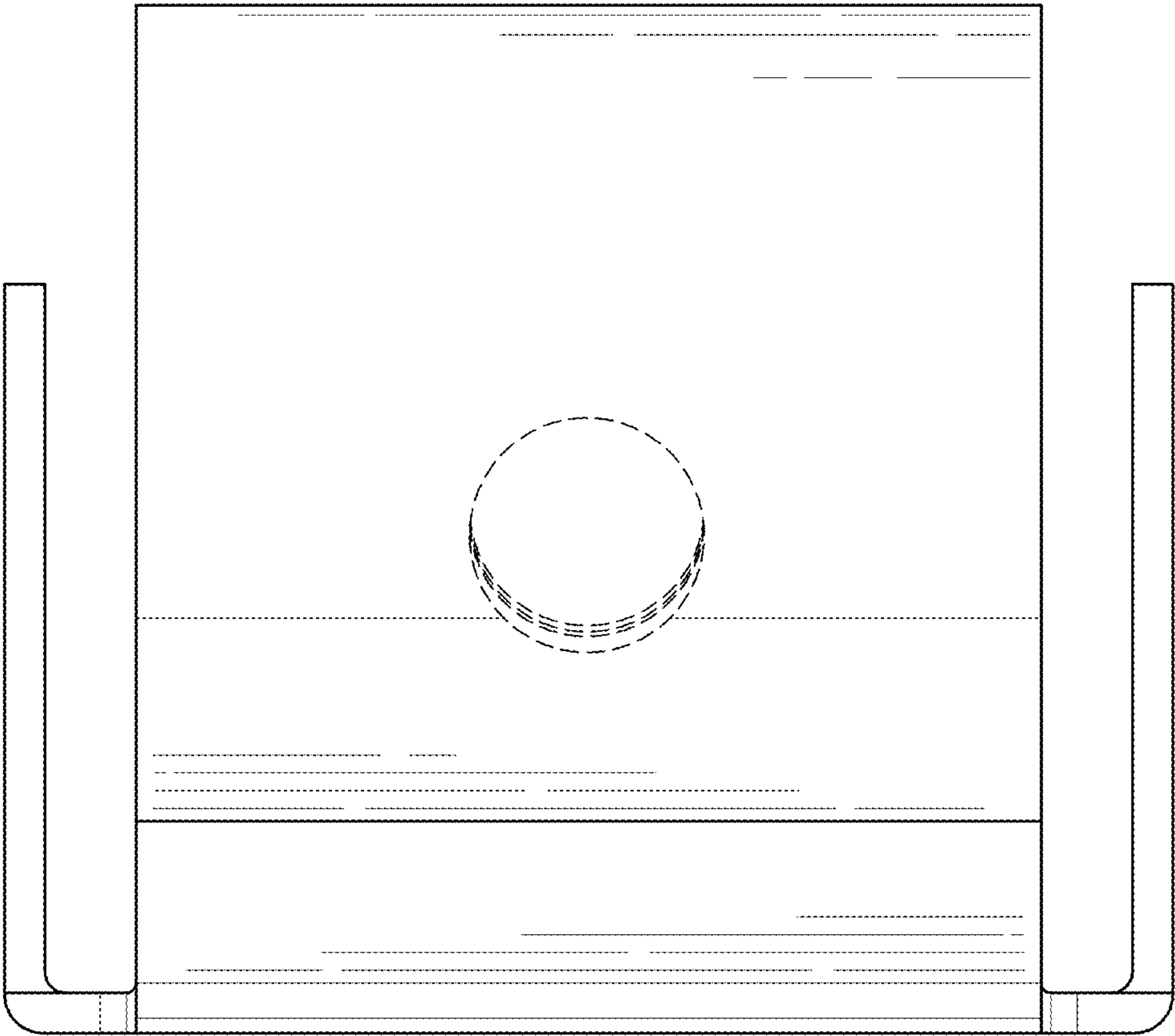

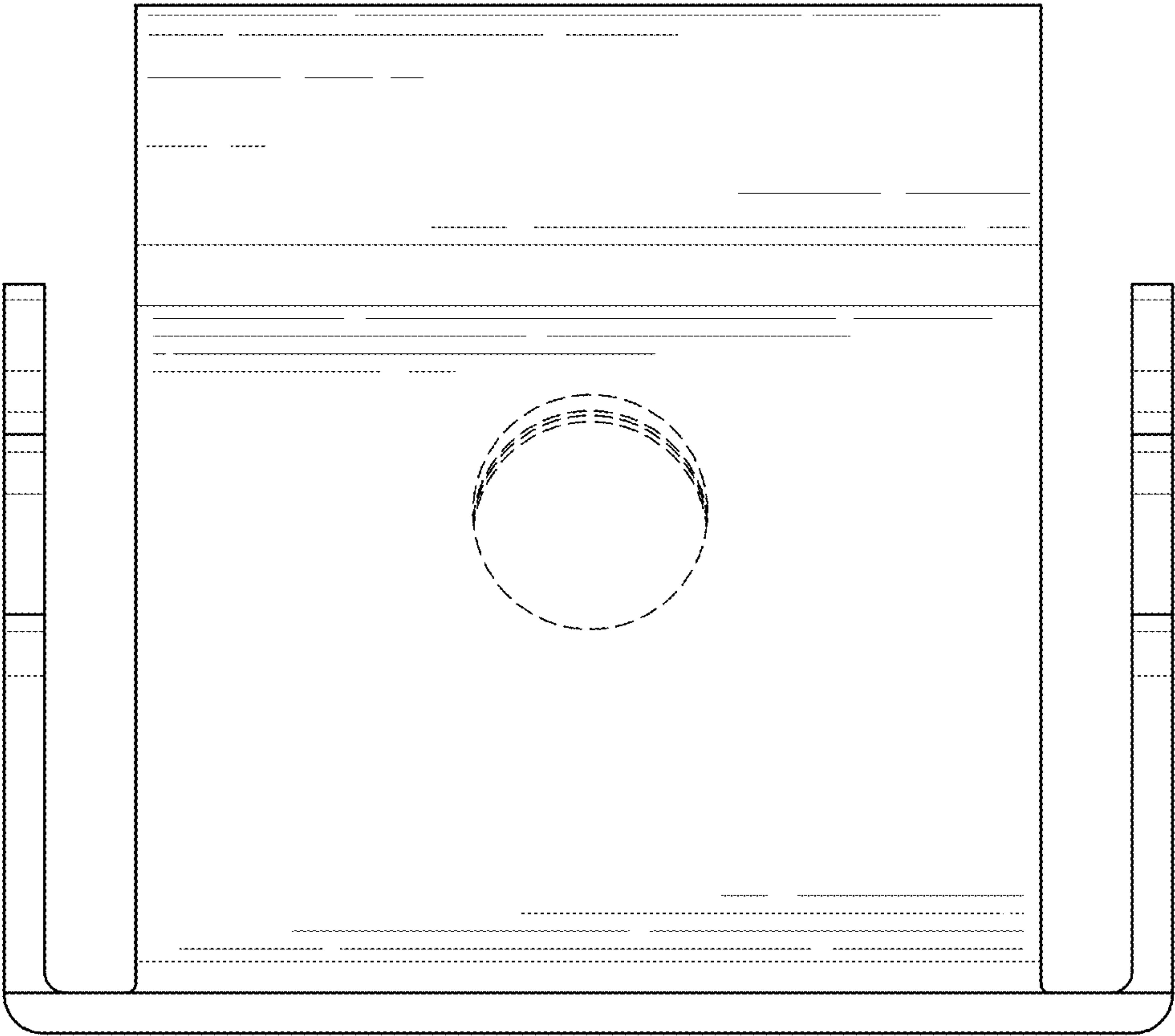

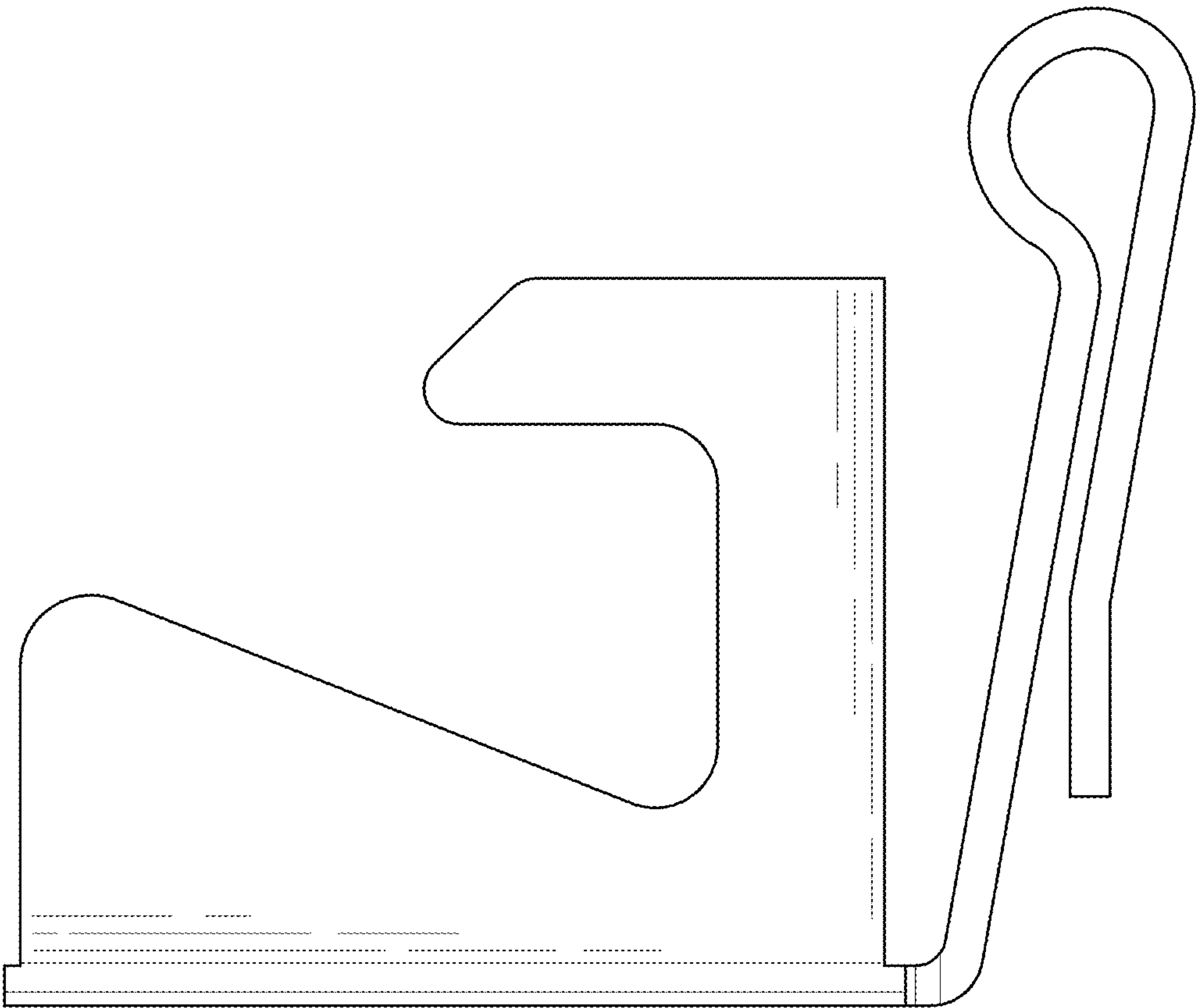

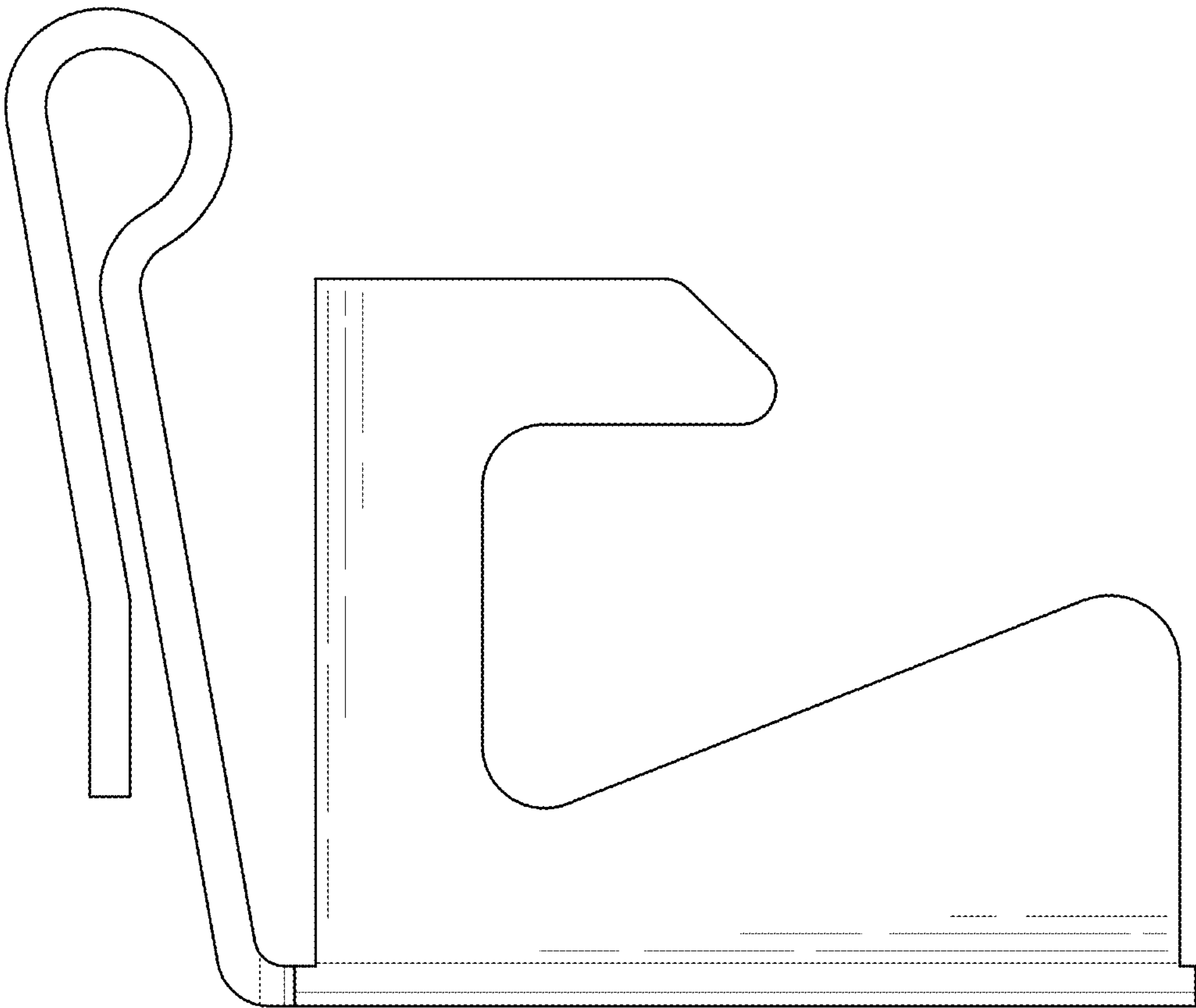
