(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a souvenir ball holder as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the souvenir ball holder embodied in the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the souvenir ball holder from FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the souvenir ball holder from FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the souvenir ball holder from FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the souvenir ball holder of FIG. 1;

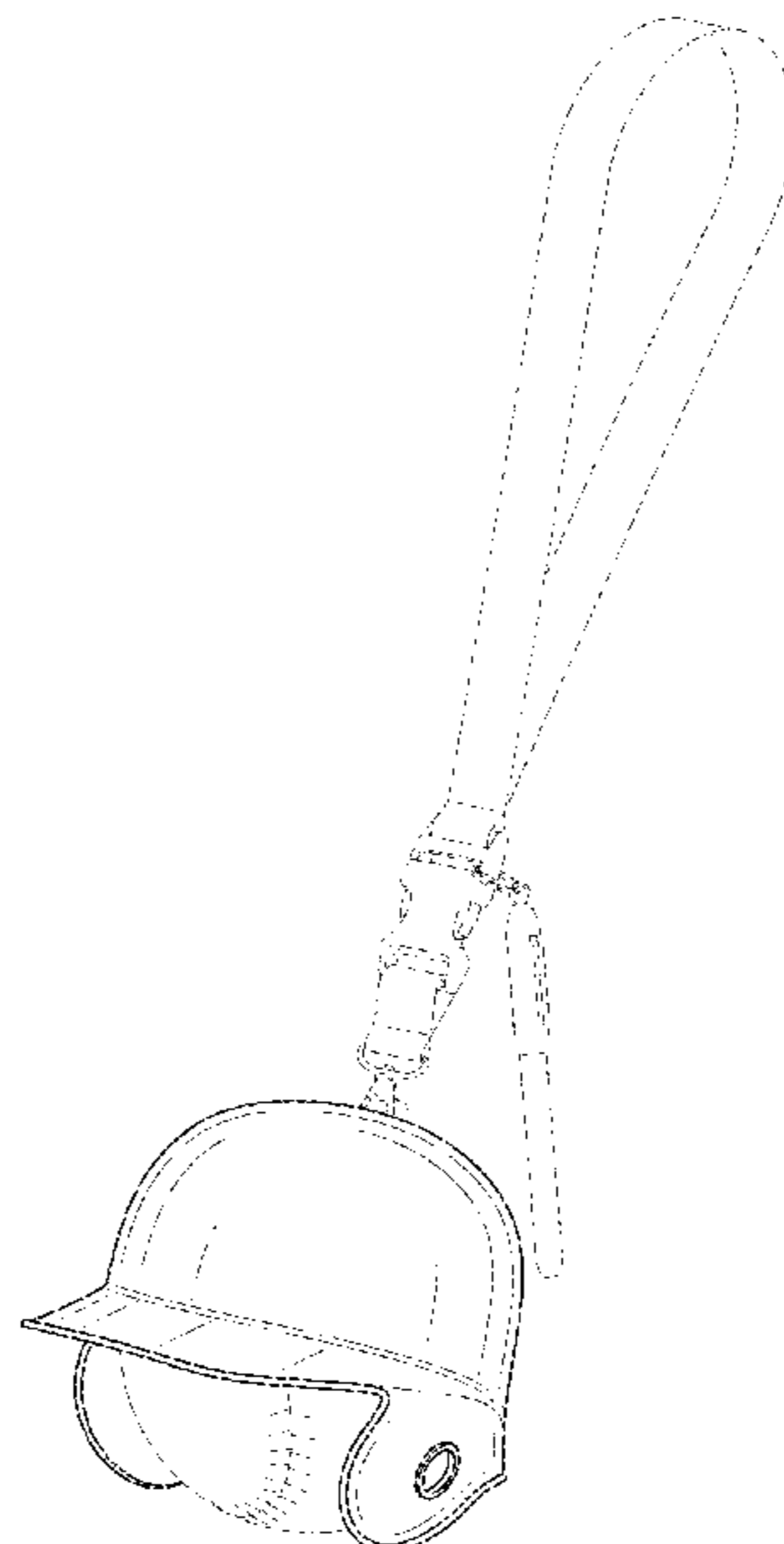
FIG. 6 is a top view of the souvenir ball holder of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the souvenir ball holder of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is rear view showing a second embodiment, the only difference being the shape of the hole at the top of the helmet, it being understood that all other surfaces are the same as FIGS. 1-2 and 6-7 of the first embodiment.

The dash-dash-dash broken line shown in FIG. 1-FIG. 8 is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental context and forms no part of the claimed design.

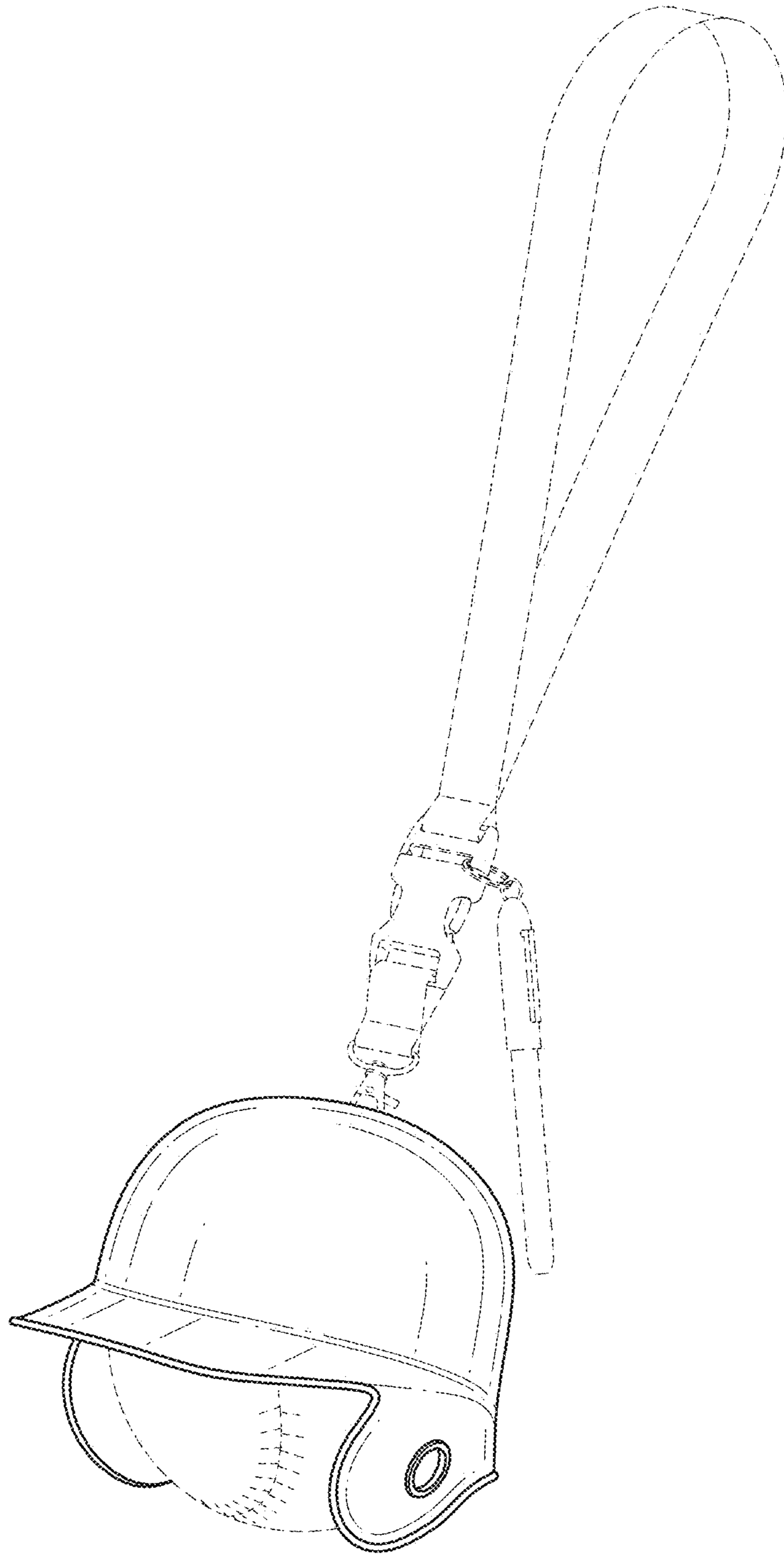

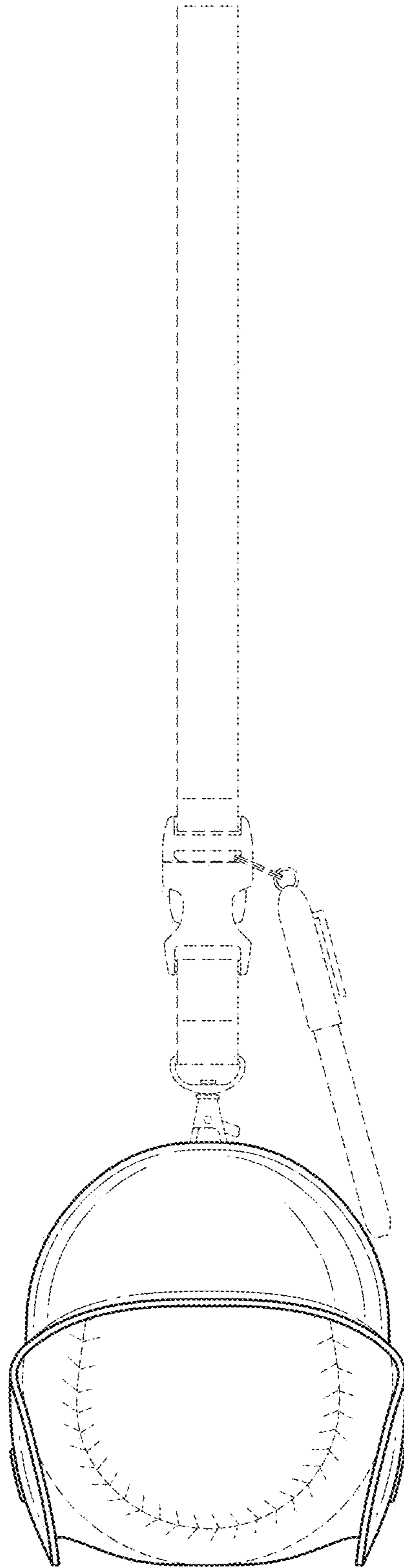

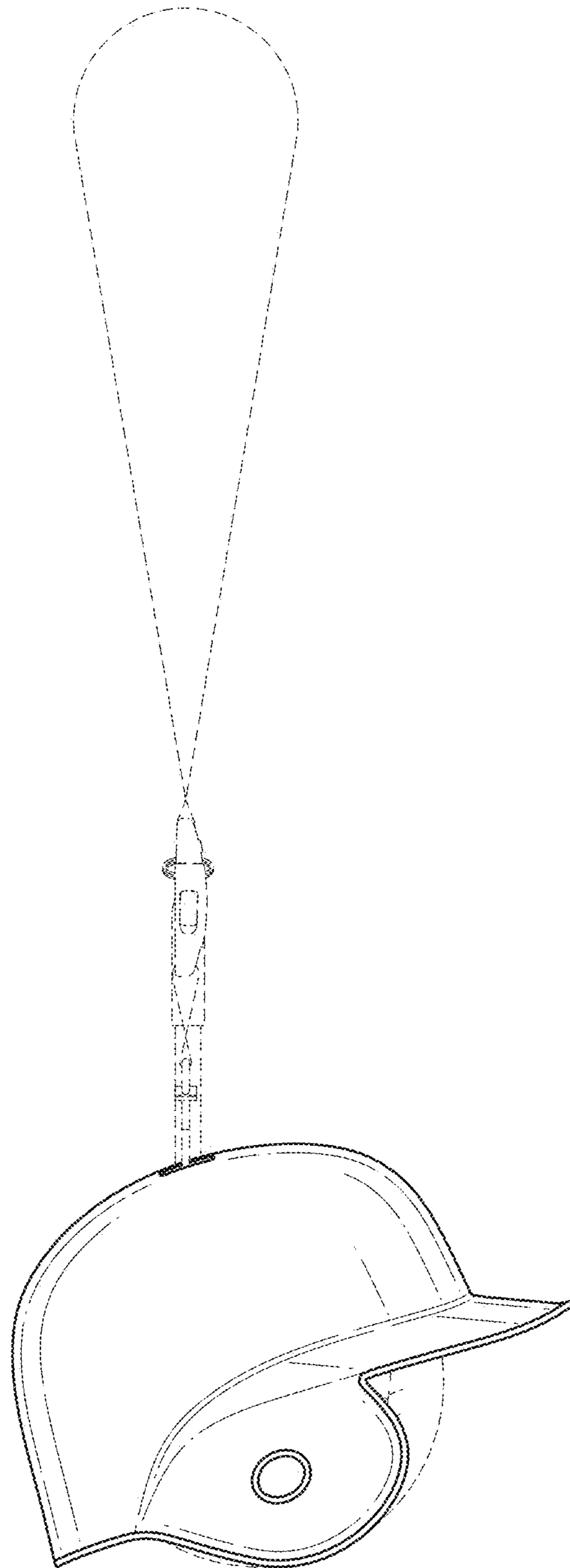

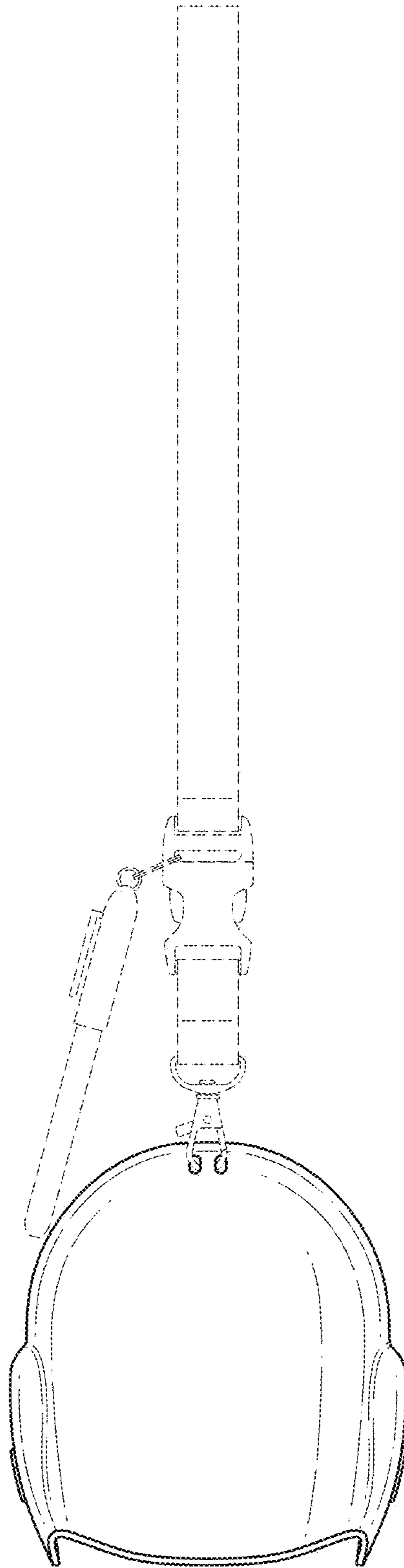

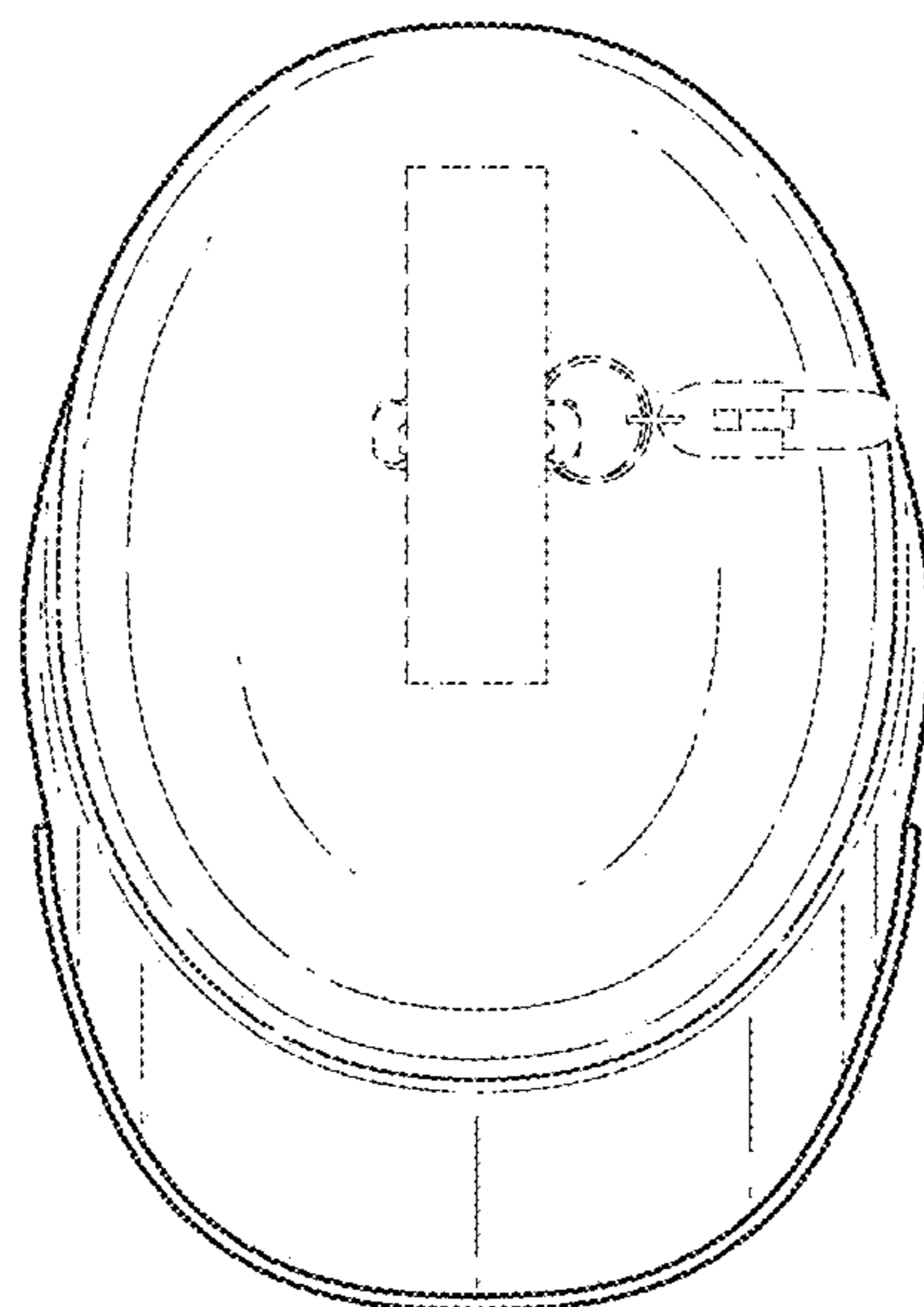

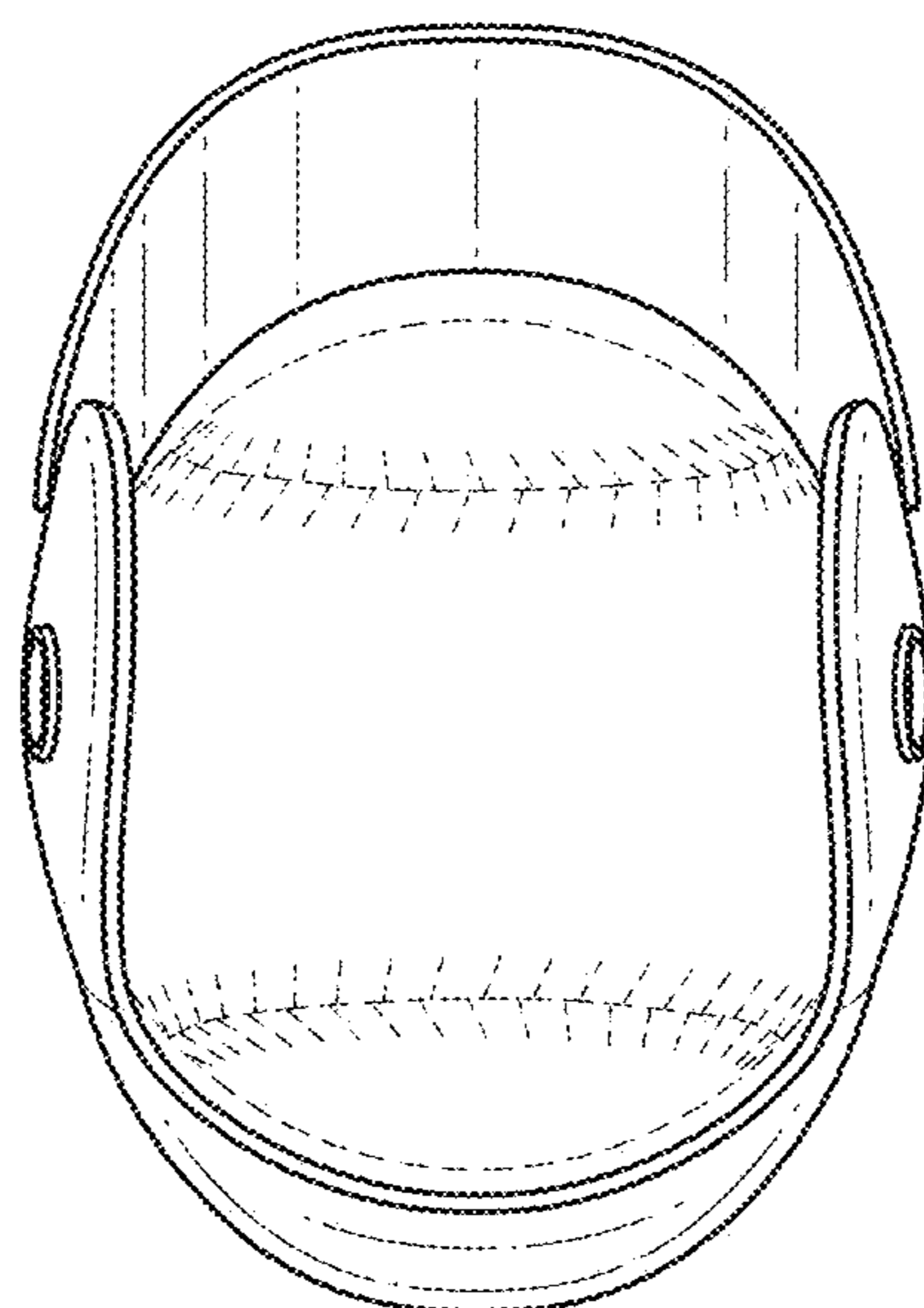

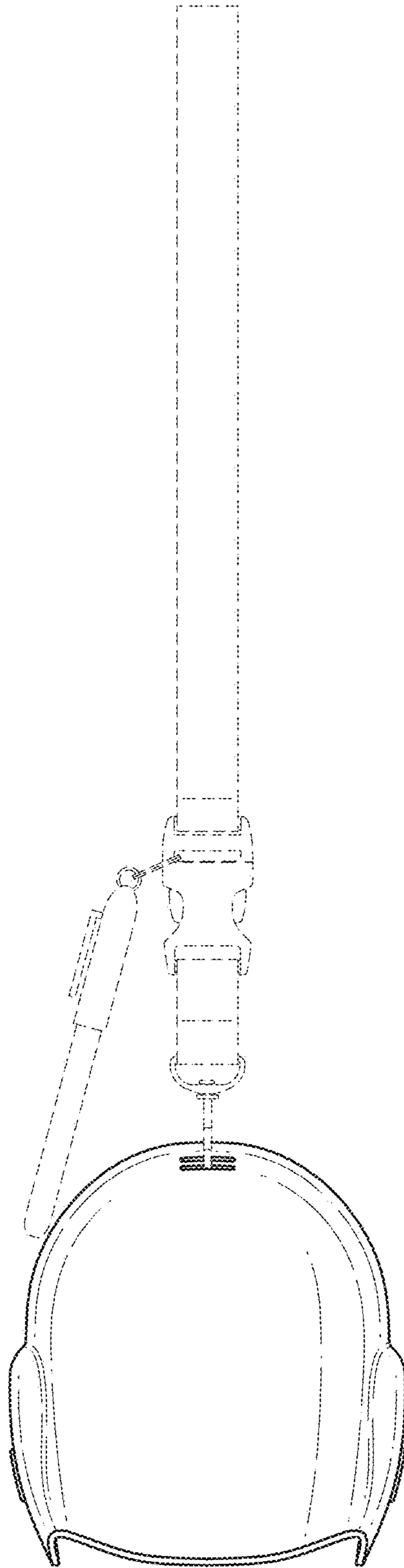
