FIG. 5 is a side view thereof, opposite that of FIG. 4;

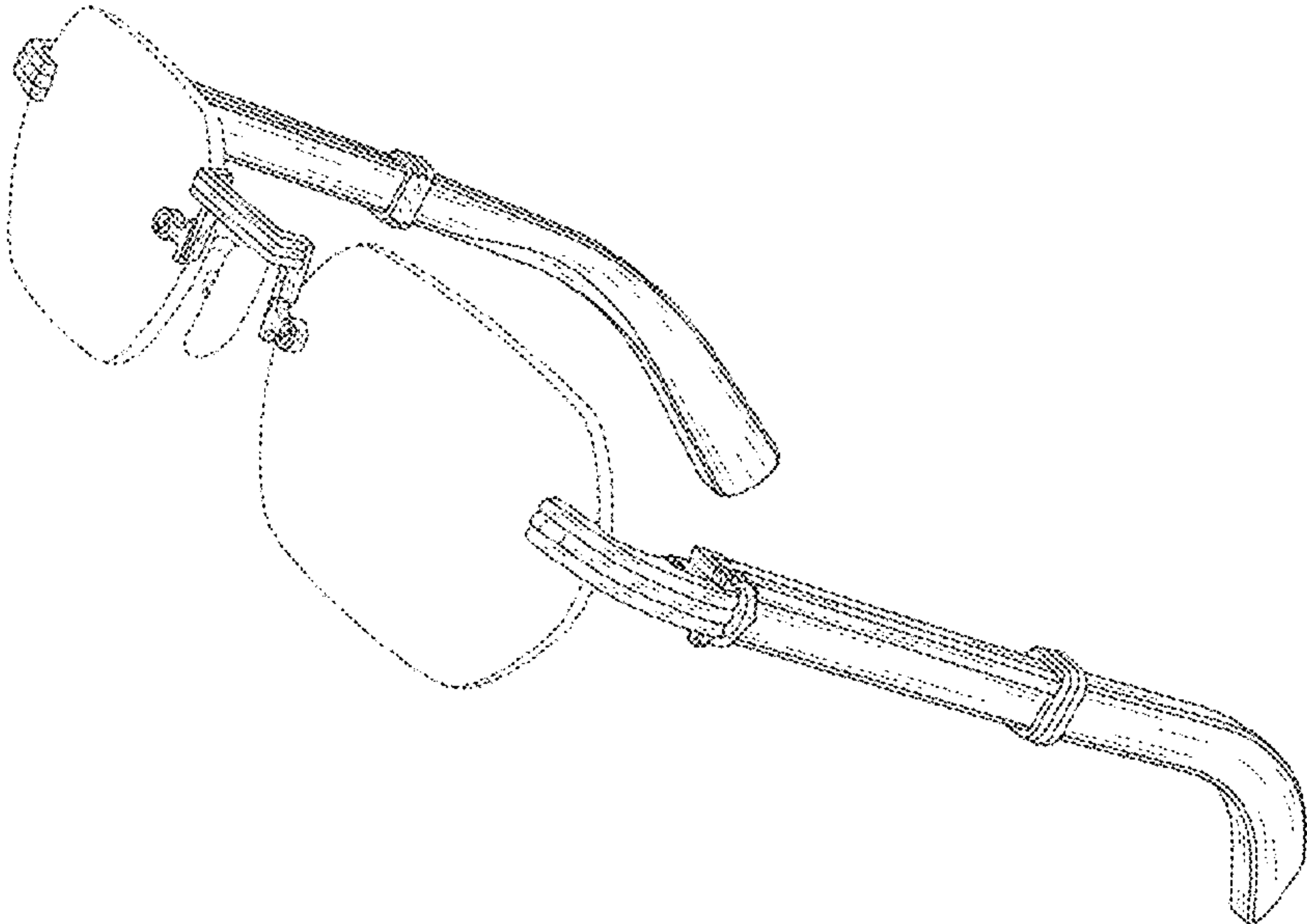
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

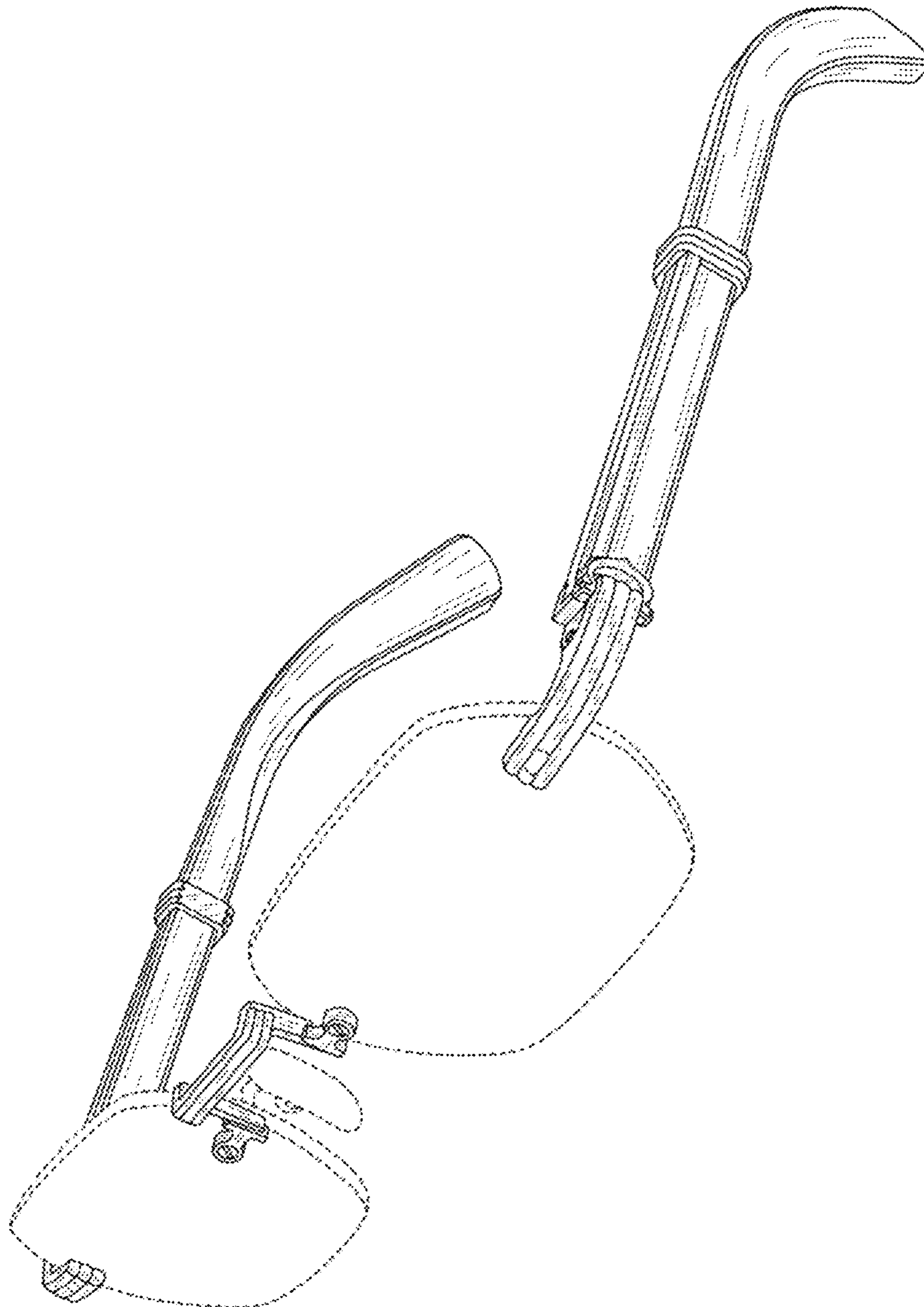

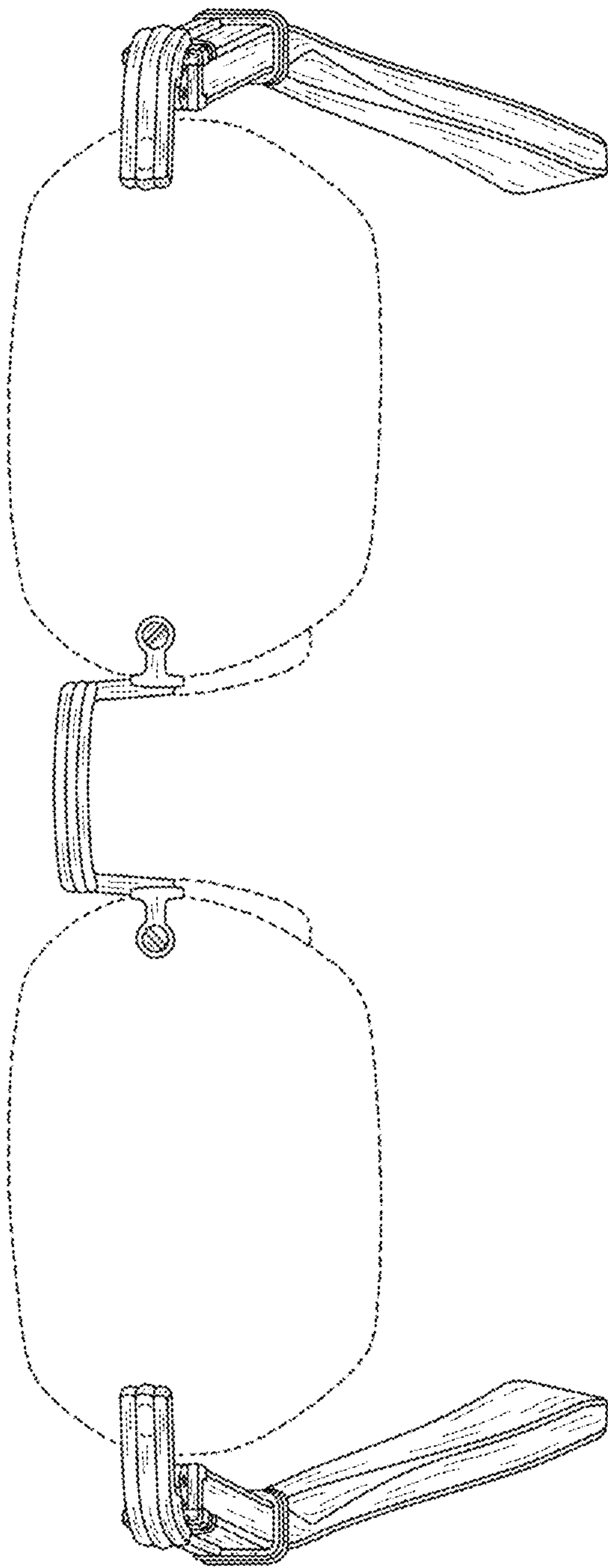

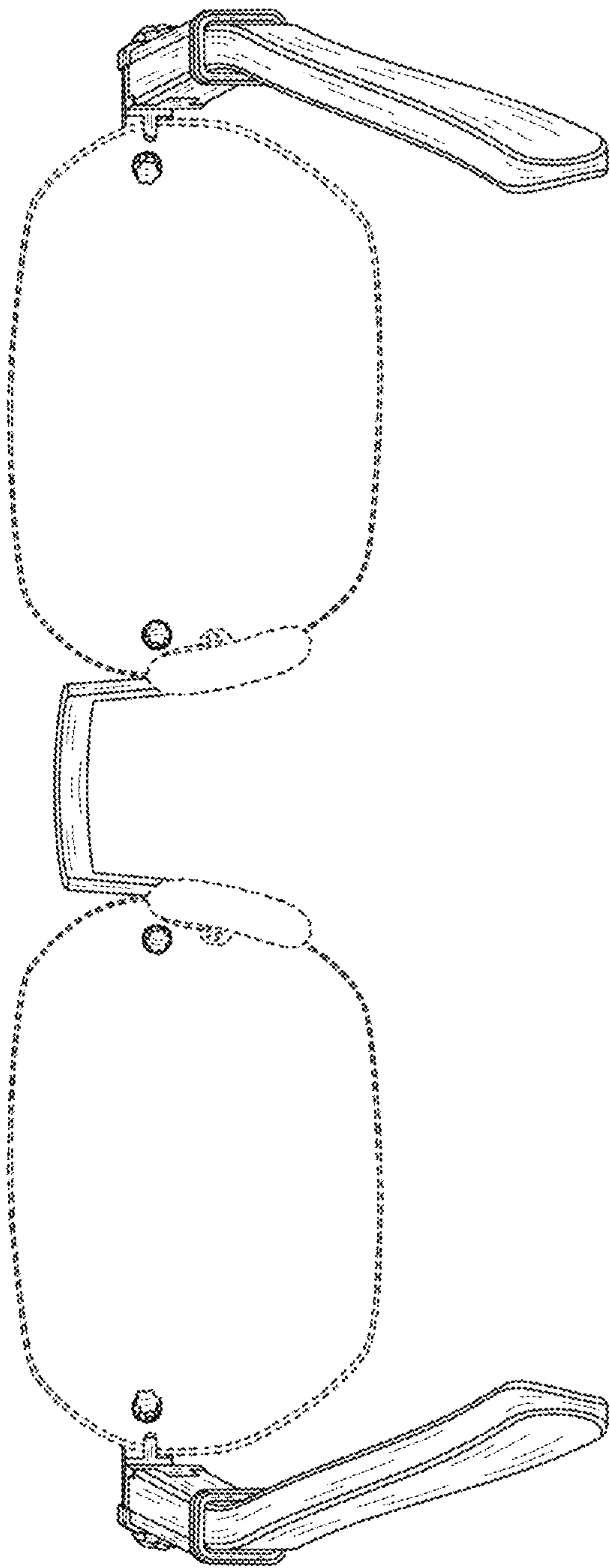

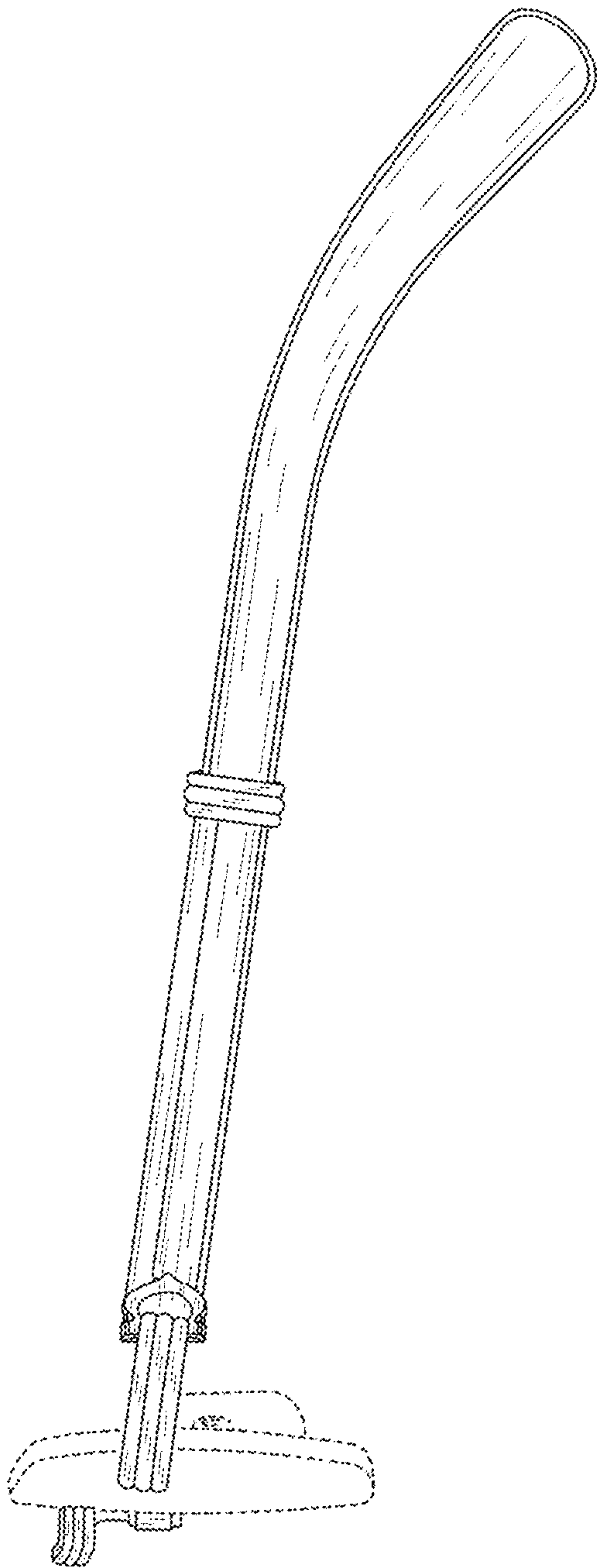

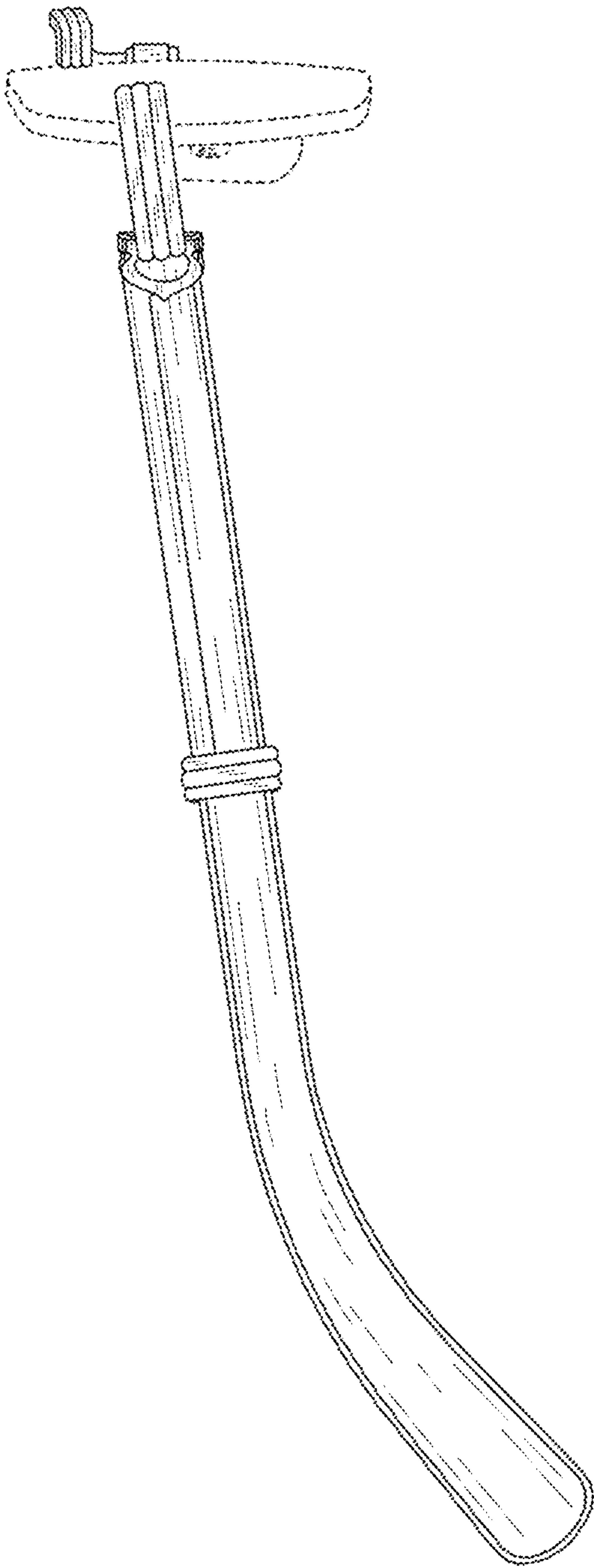

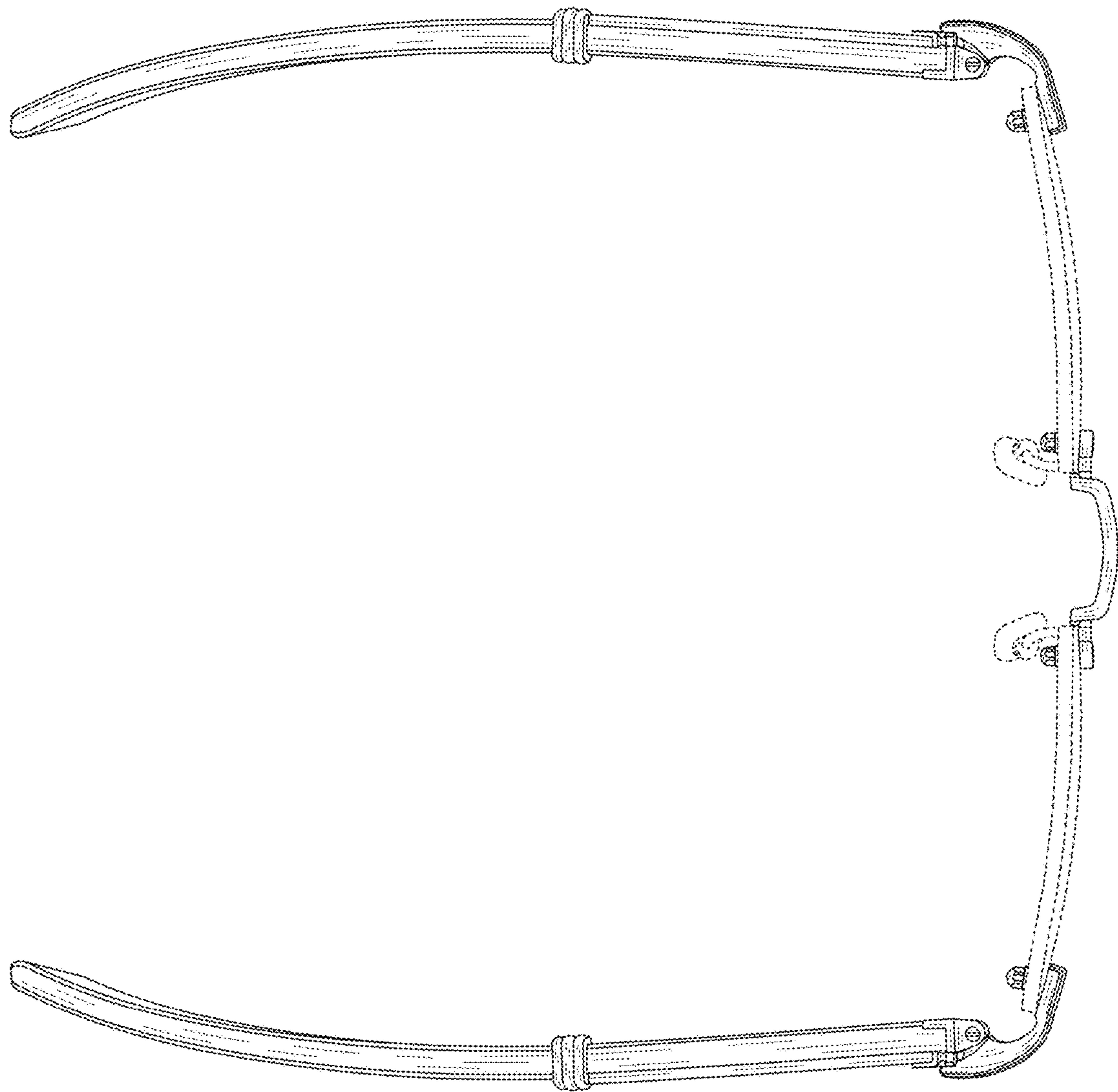

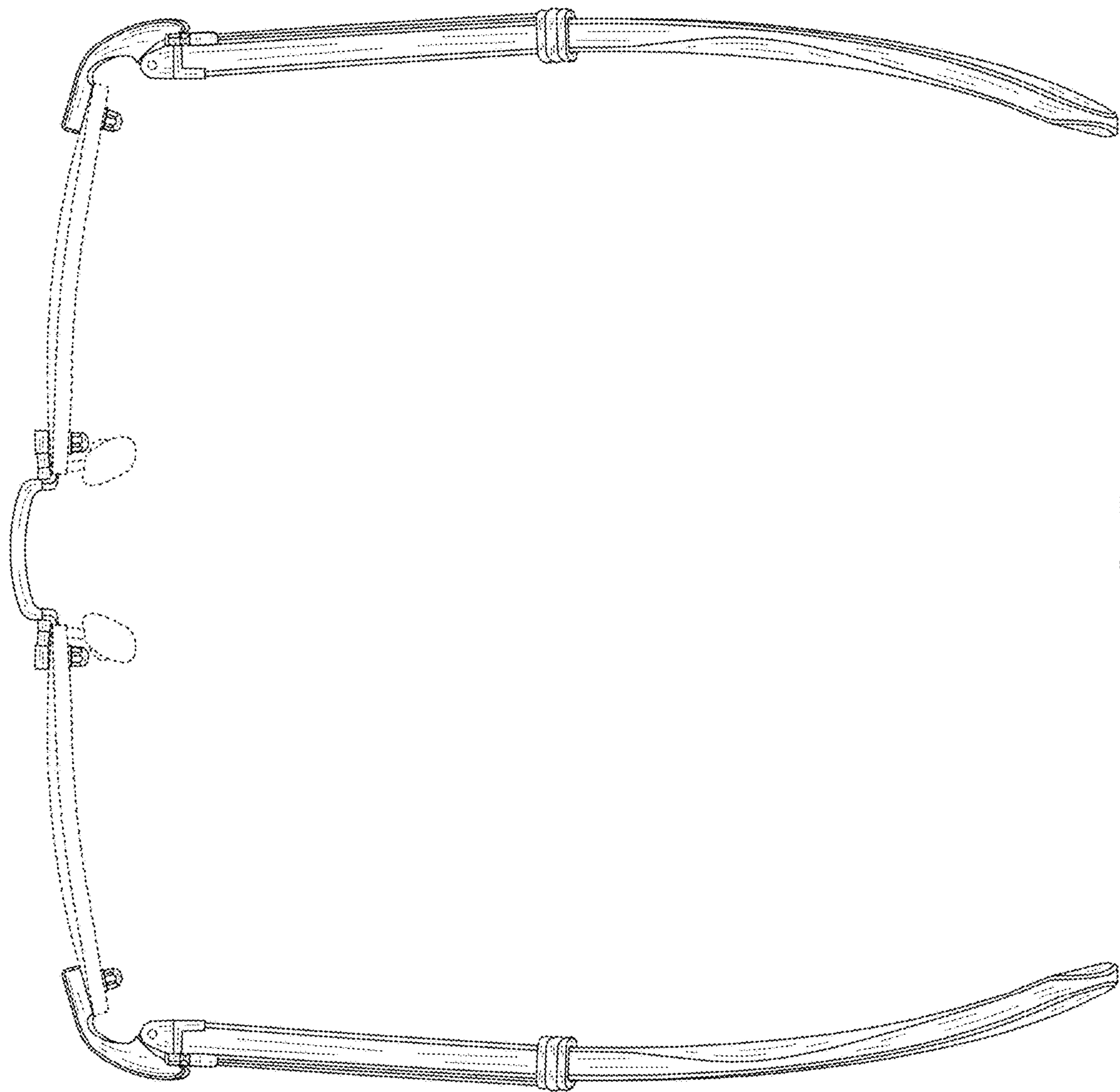

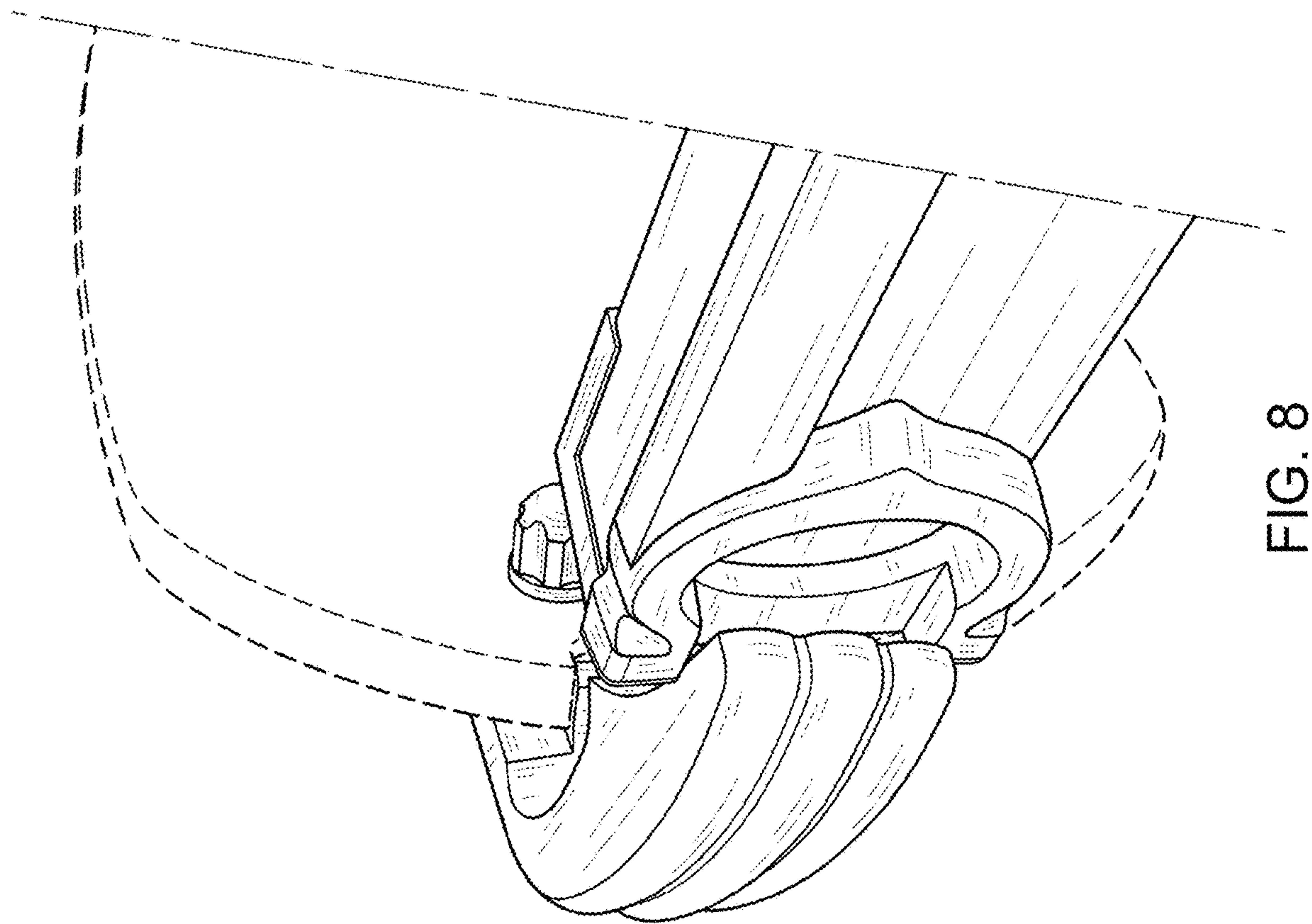
