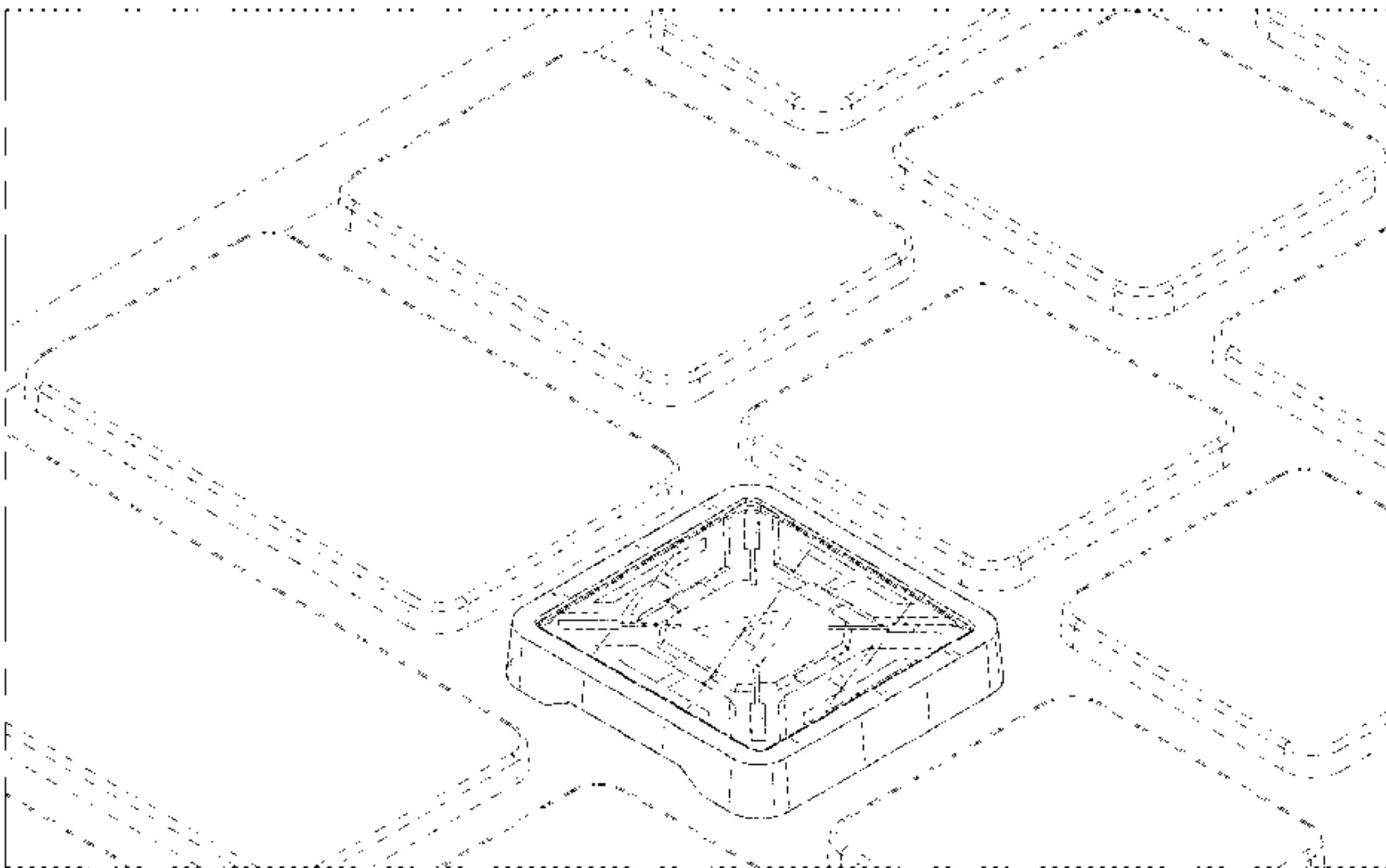
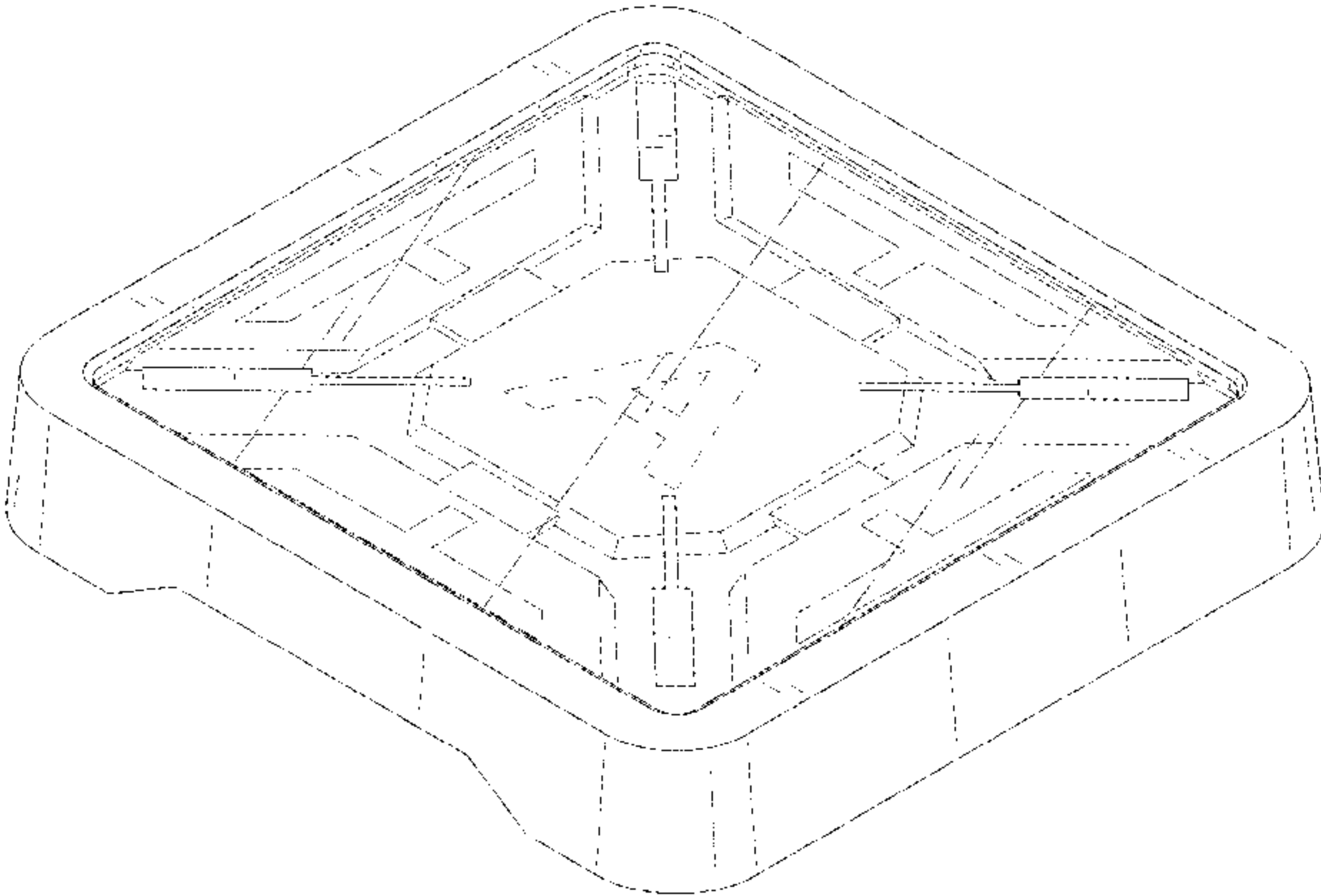
The ornamental design for a keycap as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a keycap showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 8 is an exploded view thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a perspective view showing the keycap in the state of use.

The evenly-dashed broken lines illustrate portions of the keycap that form no part of the claimed design. The oblique line shading used in the drawings indicates that the surface is transparent. In FIG. 8, the lid is disassembled from the keycap. The evenly-dashed broken lines in FIG. 9 are for the purpose of depicting environment and form no part of the claimed design.

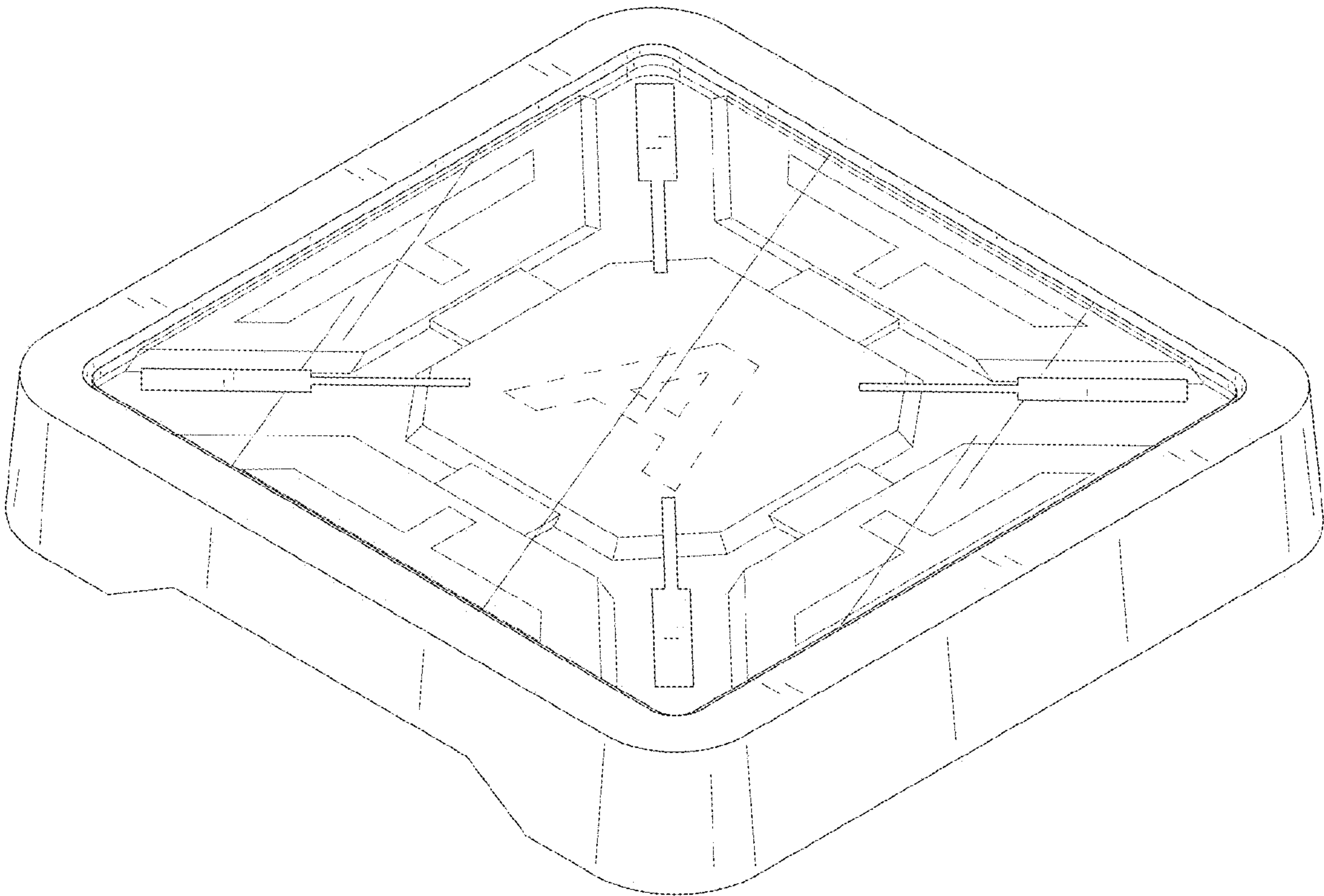

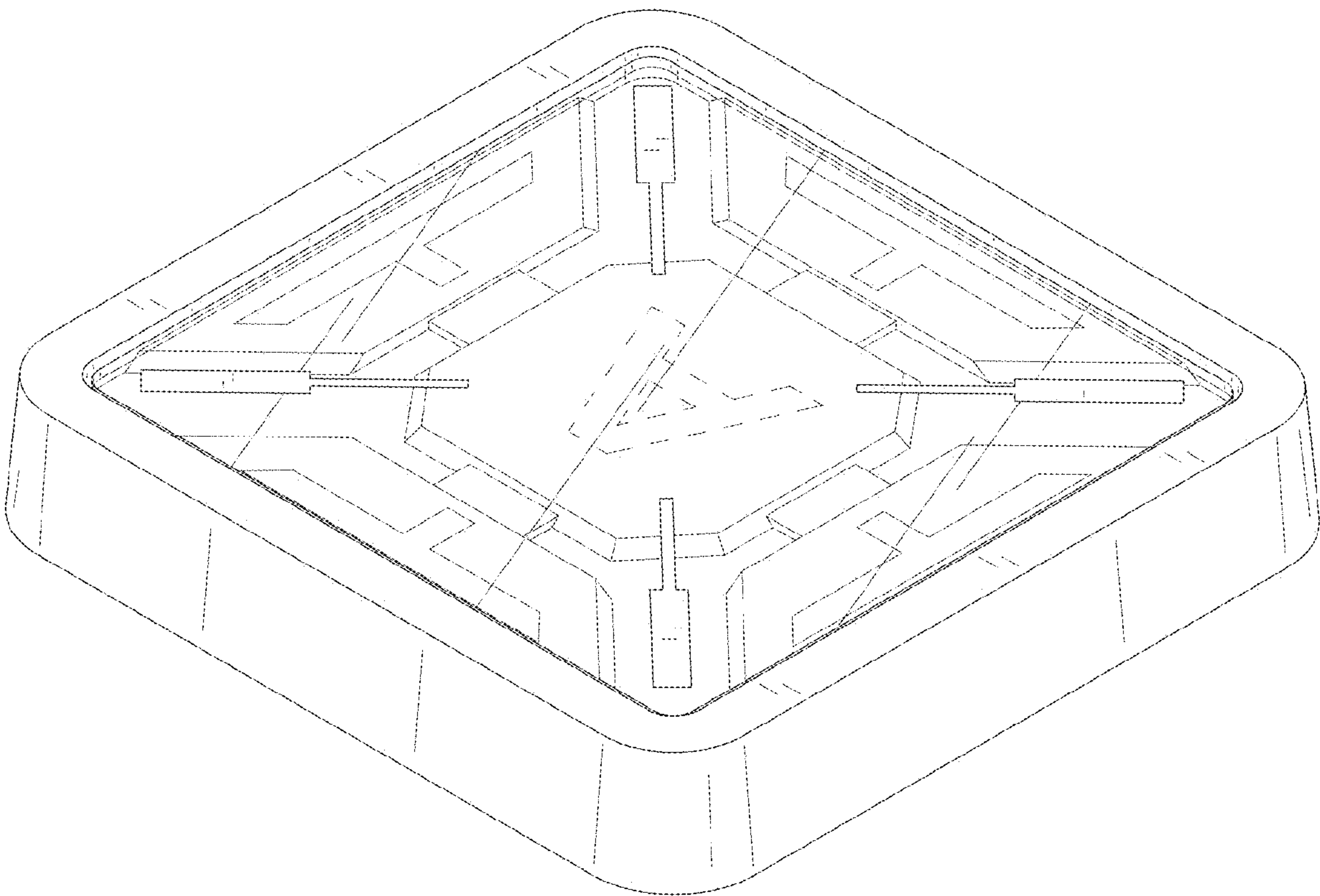

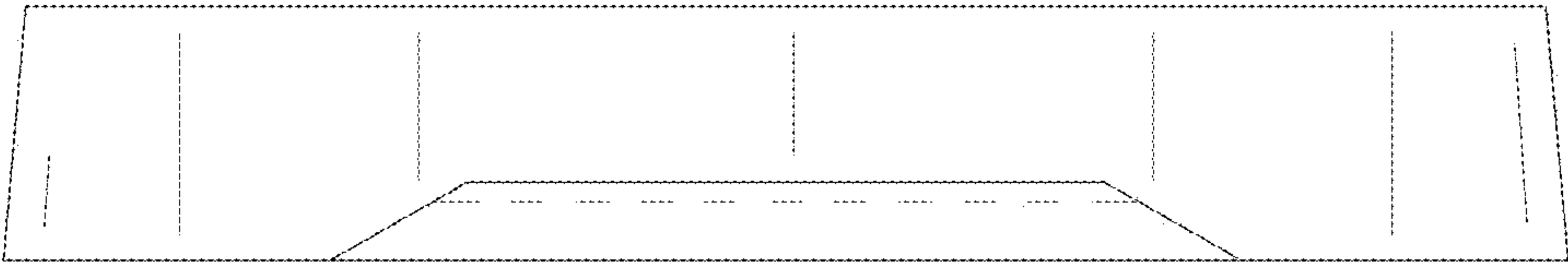

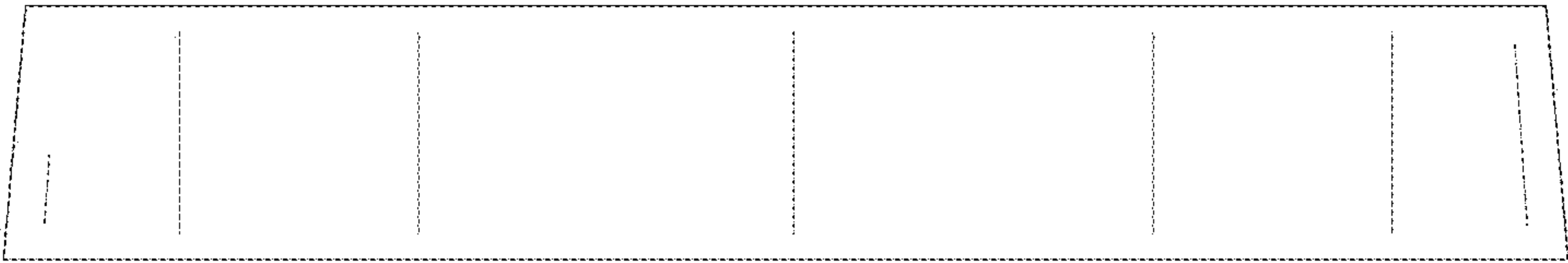

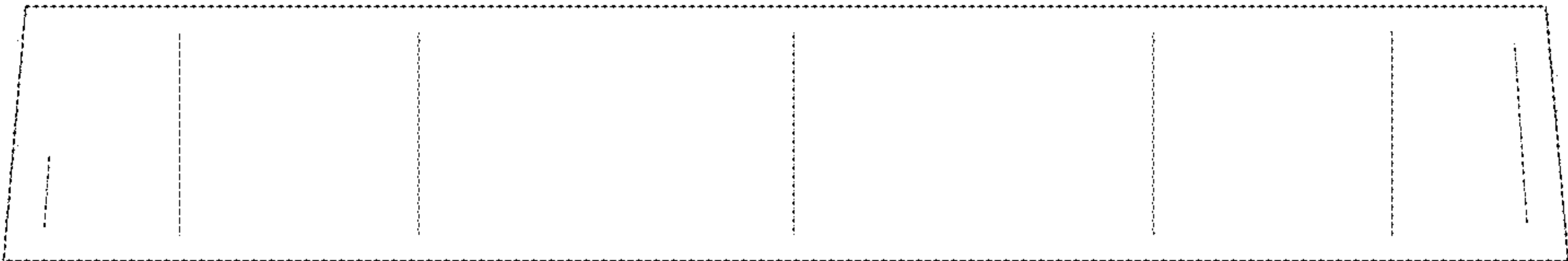

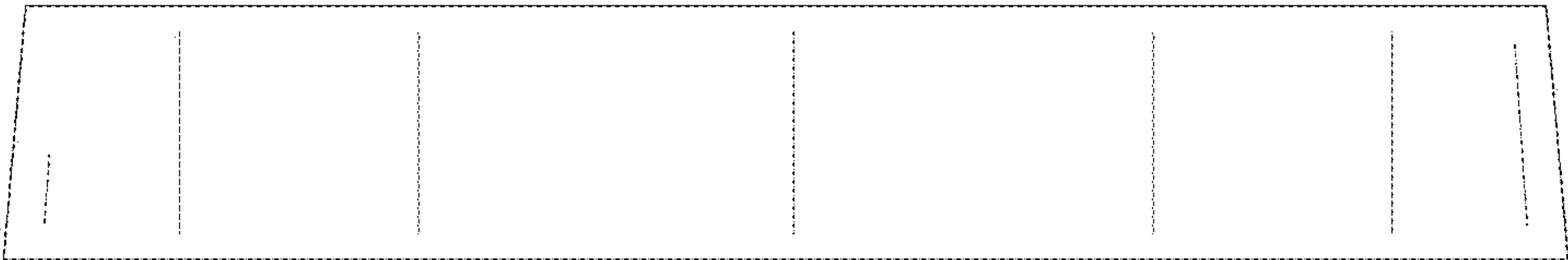

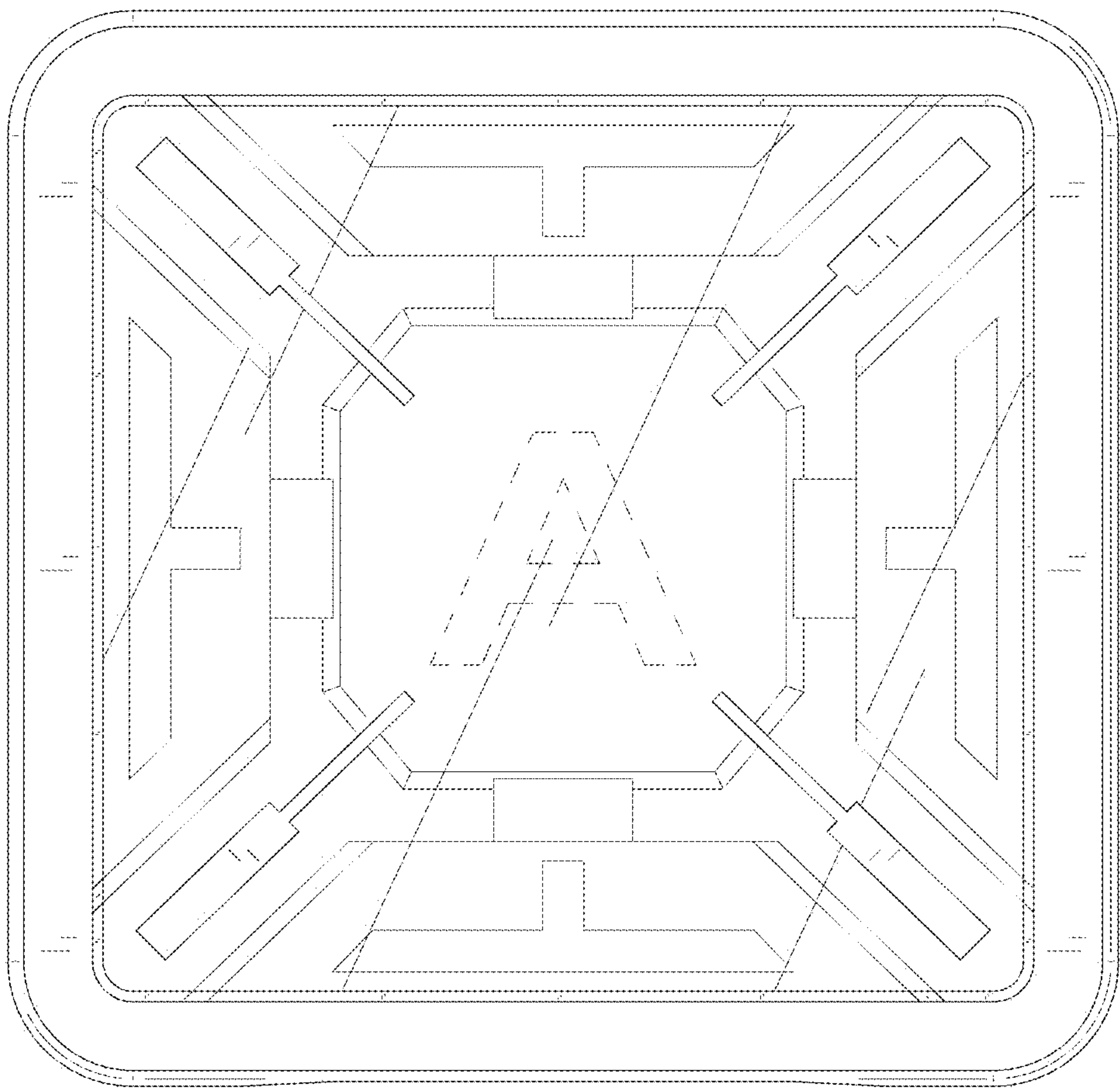

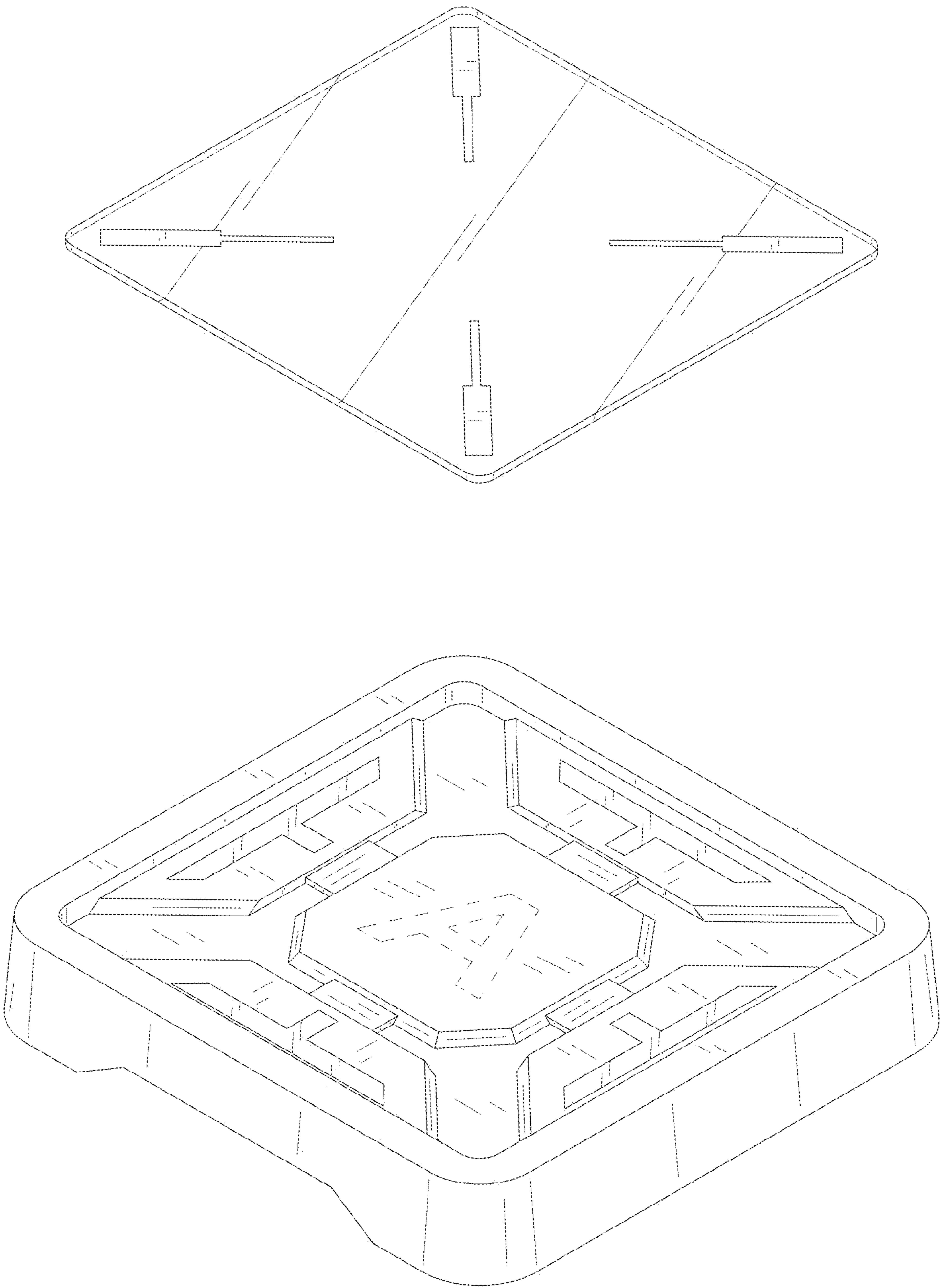

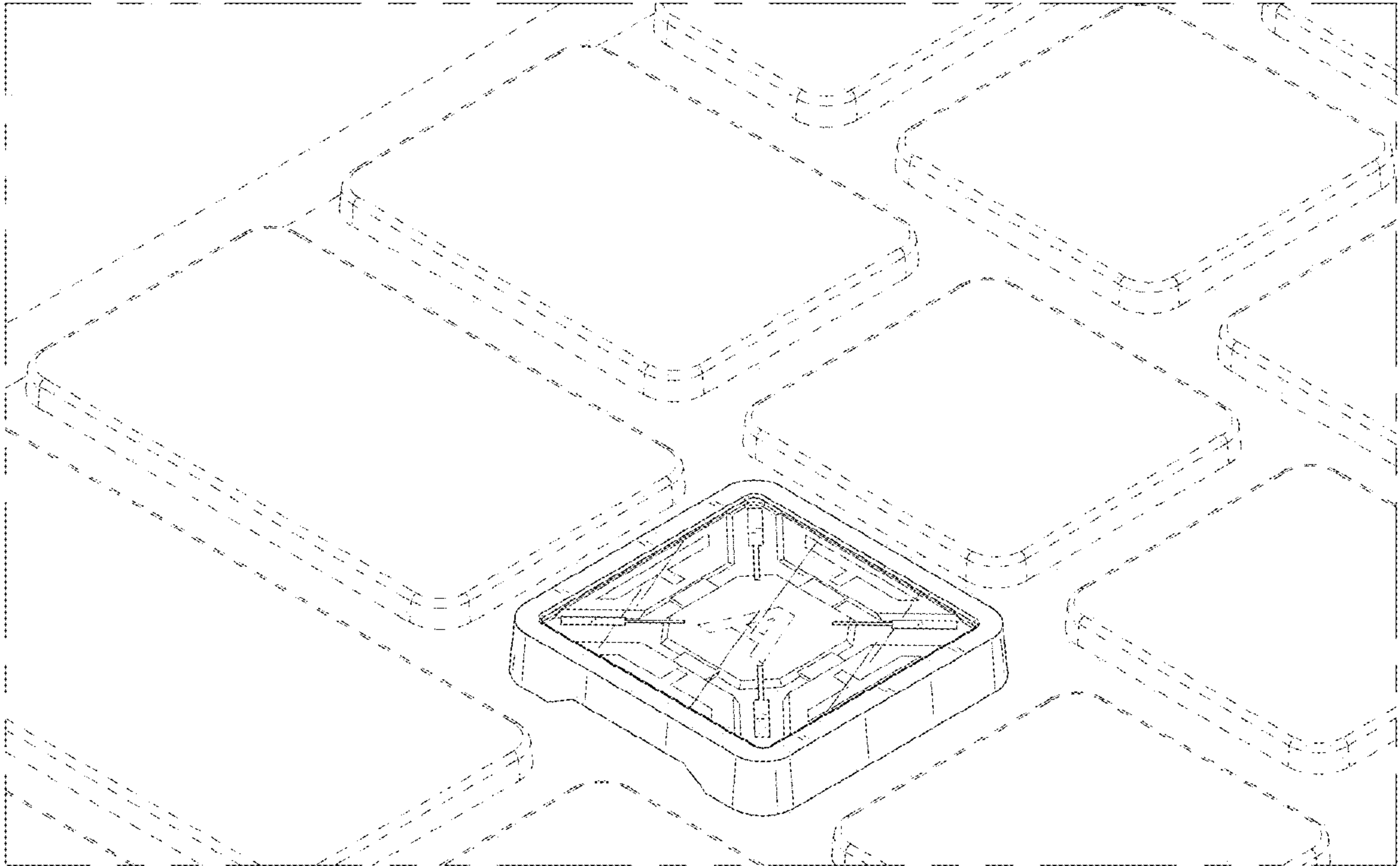
