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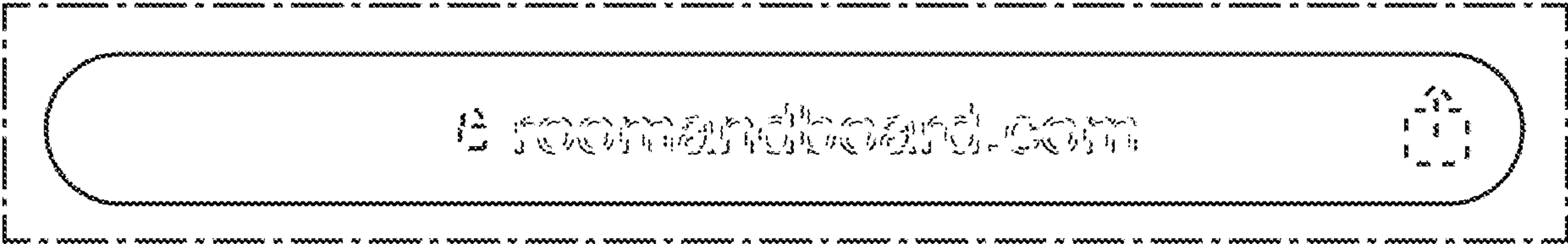
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with transitional graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a display screen or portion thereof with transitional graphical user interface showing a first image of the new design;
FIG. 2 is a second image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a third image thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a fourth image thereof.

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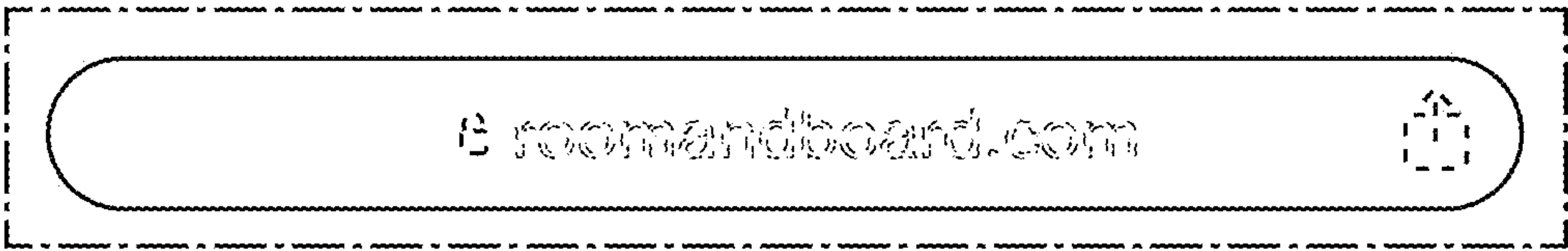

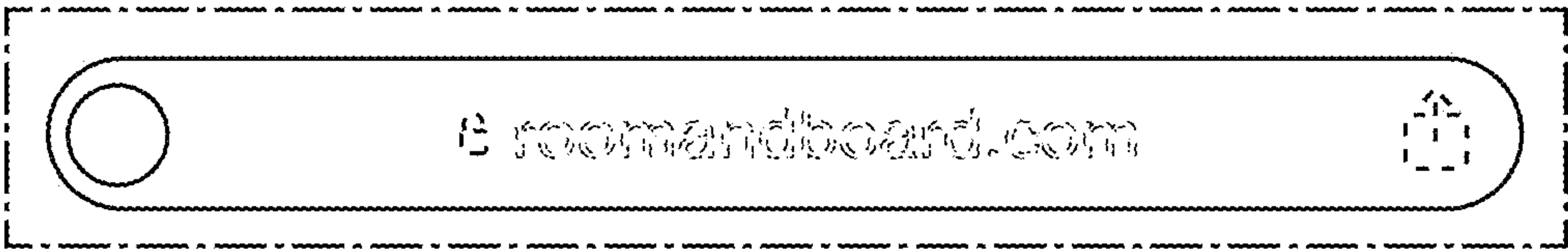

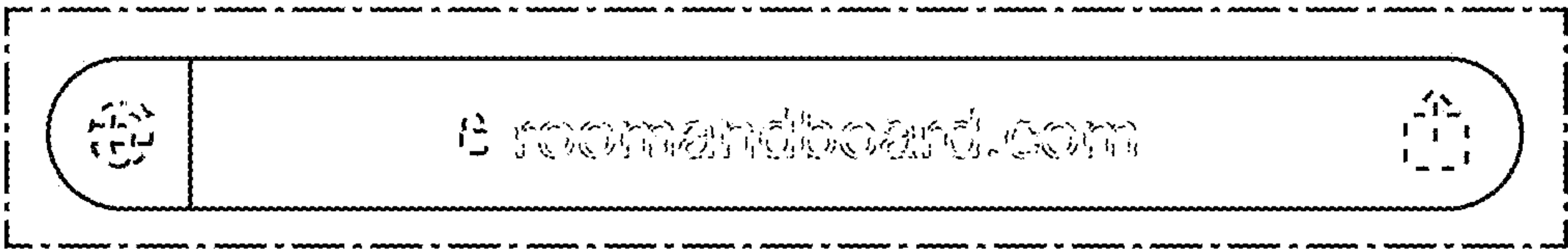

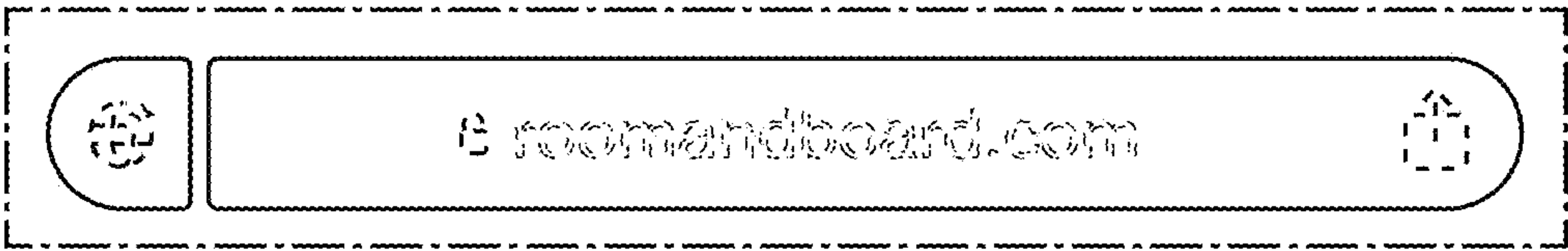
