




To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John R. Morgan, a citizen of the Republic of Guatemala, residing at Oak Park, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Line Guide for a Fishing Rod, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a line guide for a fishing rod embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same. Fig. 3 is an end elevational view of the same. Fig. 4 is a top plan view of the same.
