DESCRIPTION

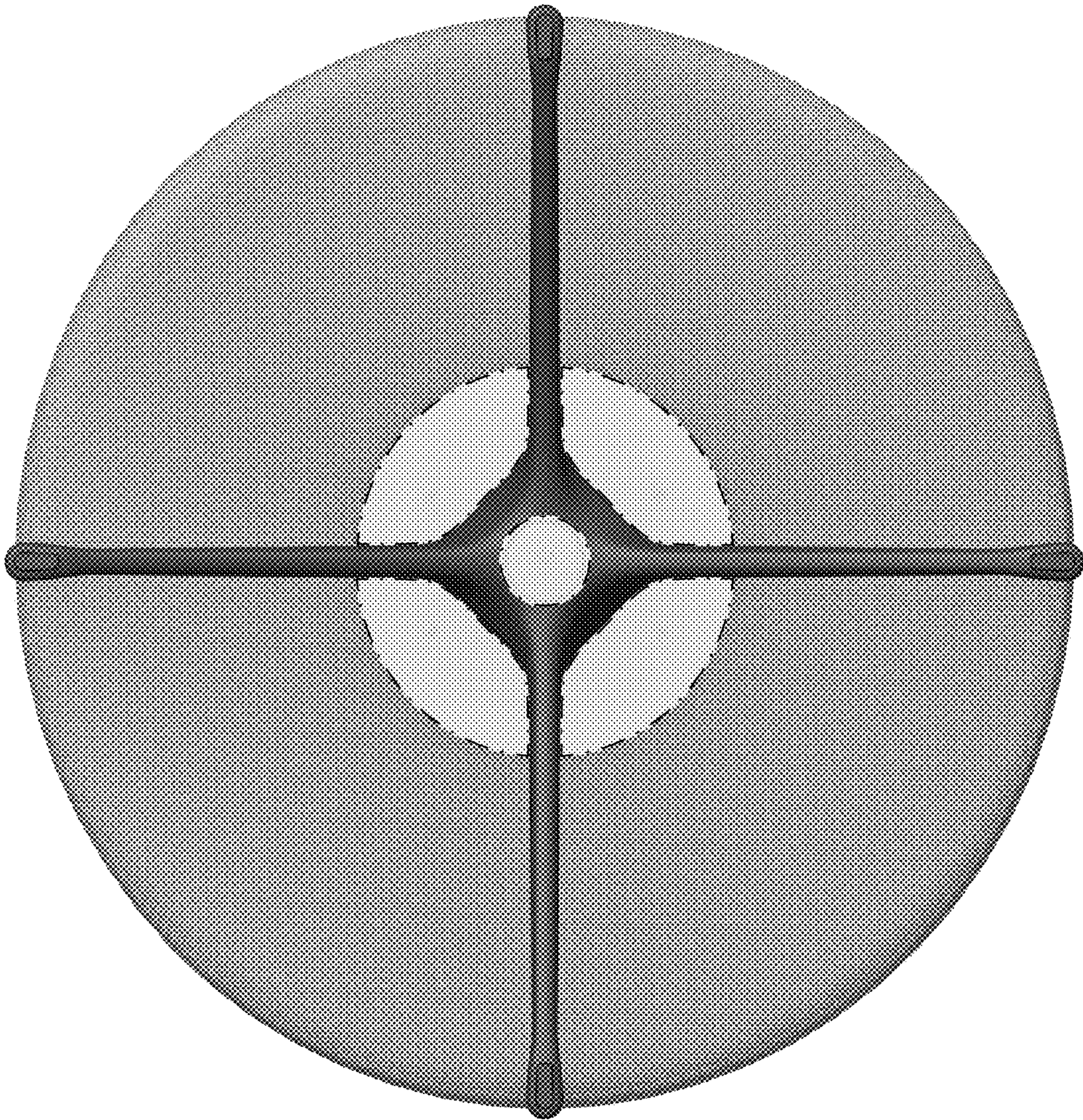
