DESCRIPTION

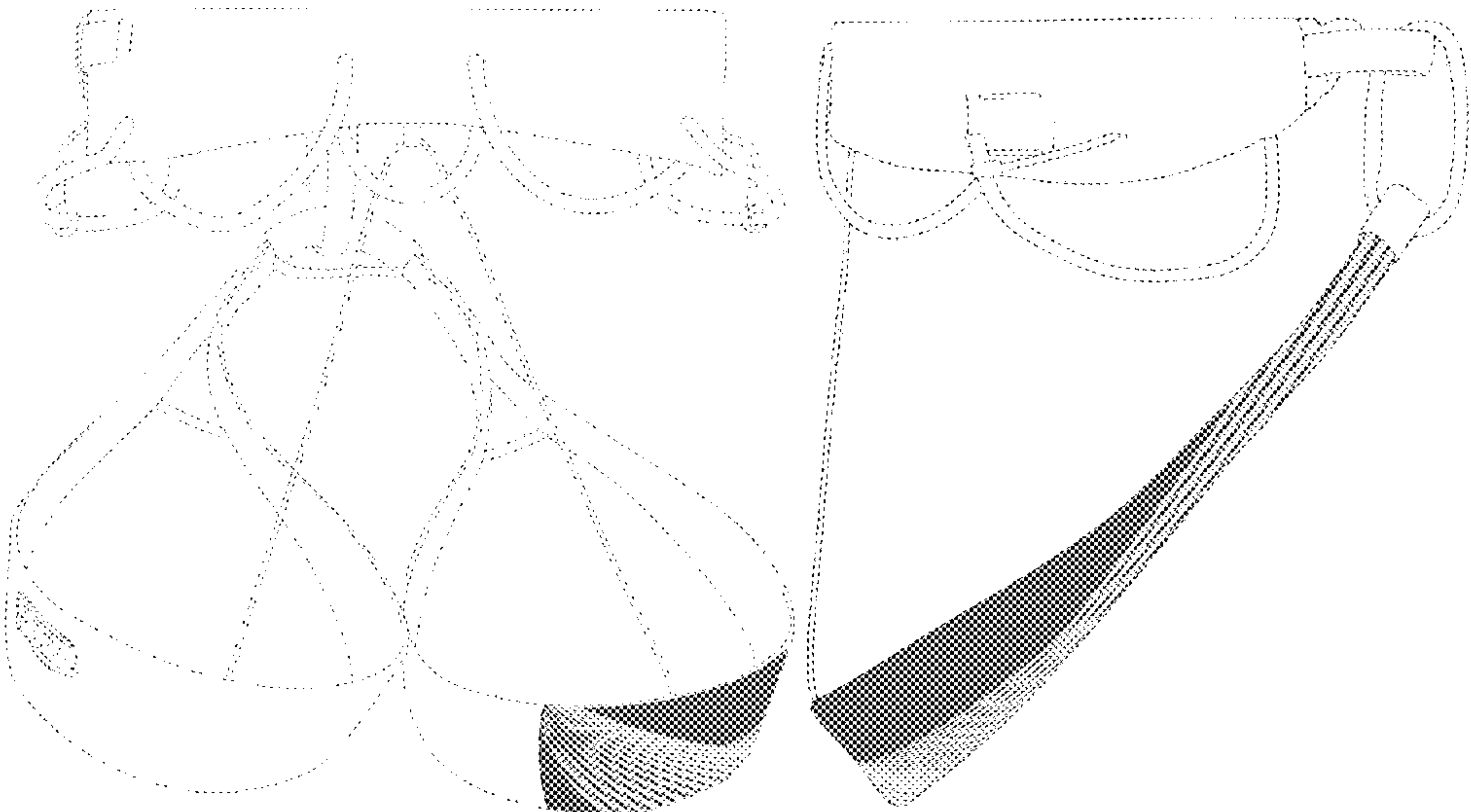
FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a harness leg strap, showing the new design;

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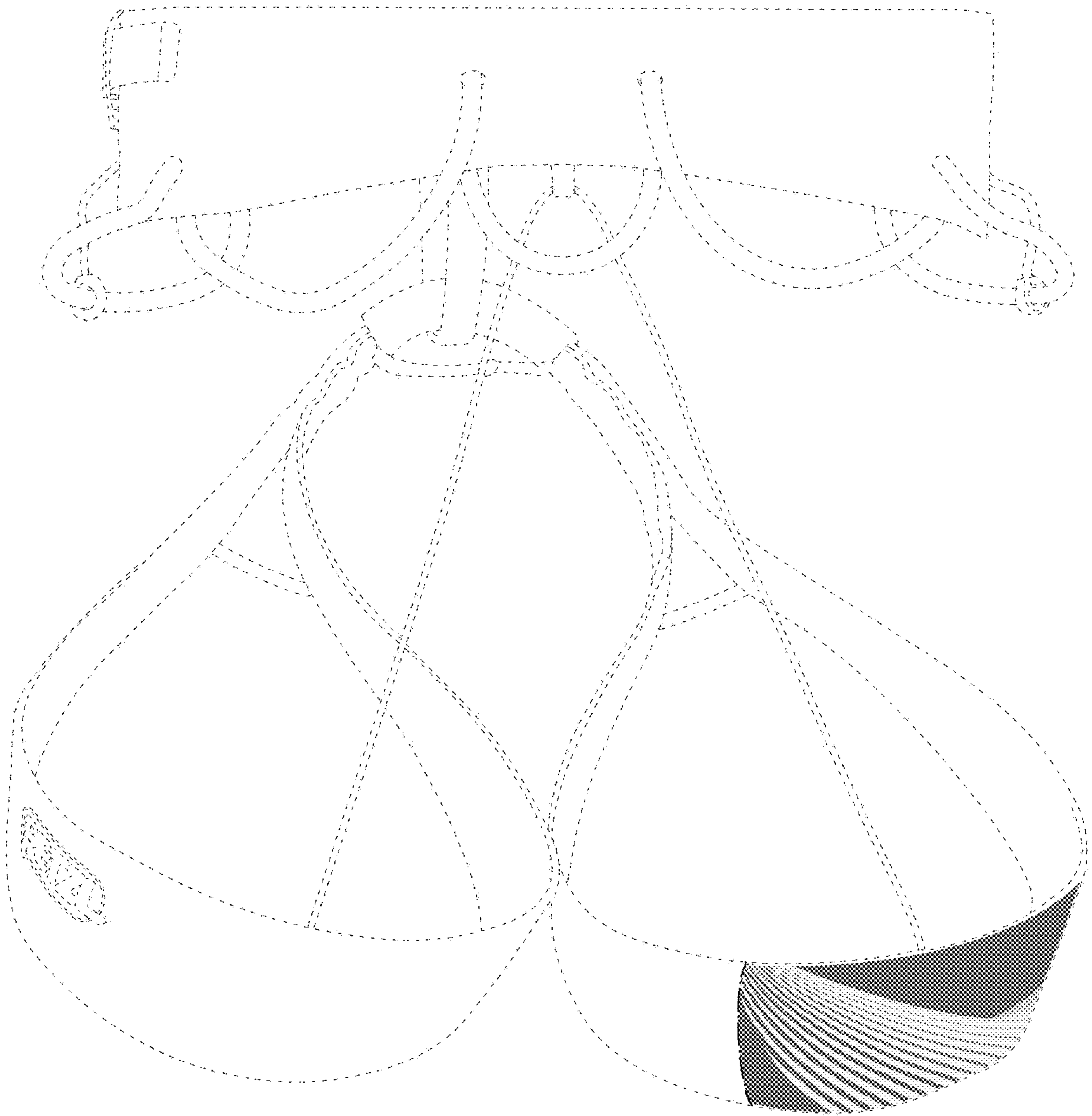

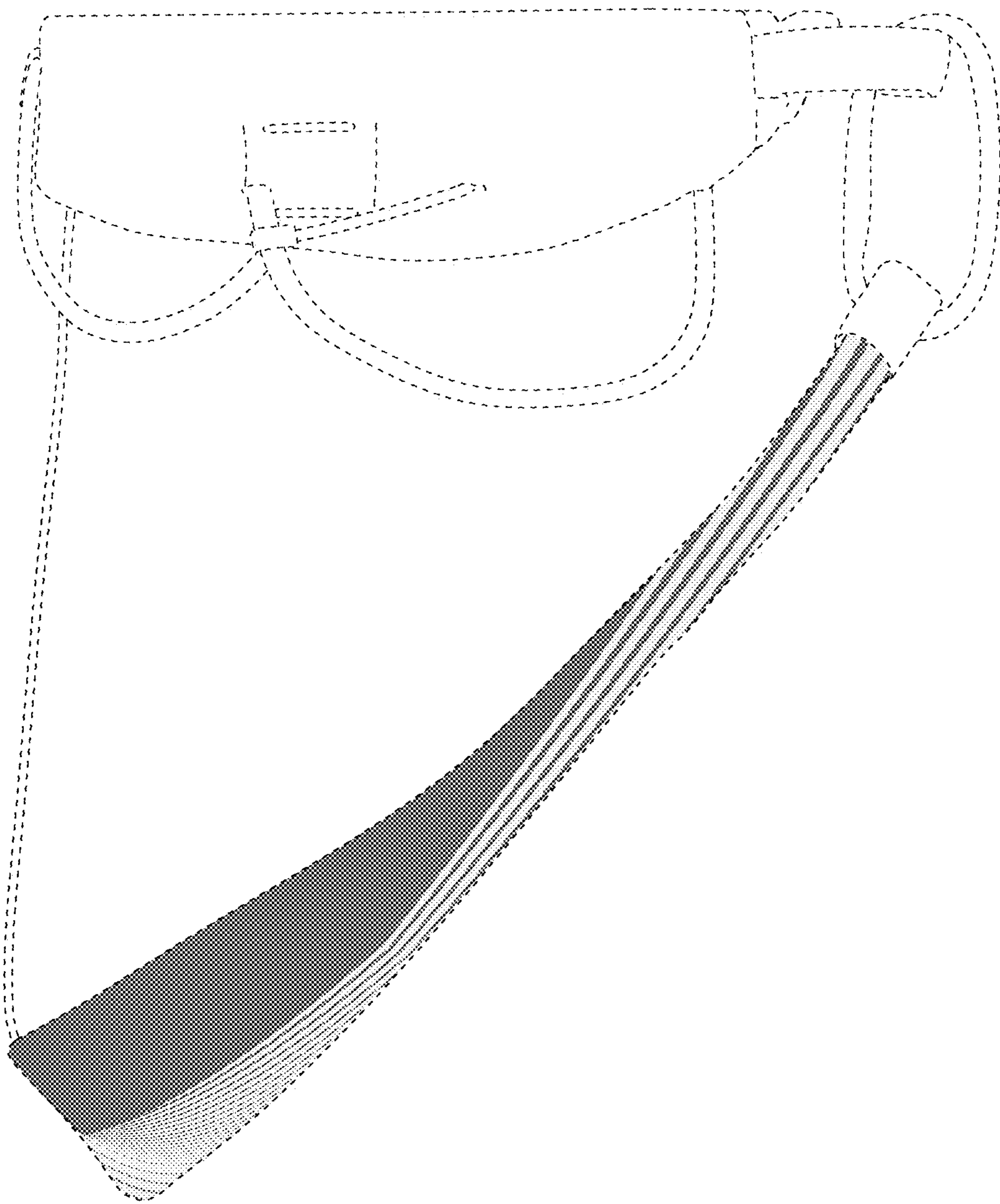

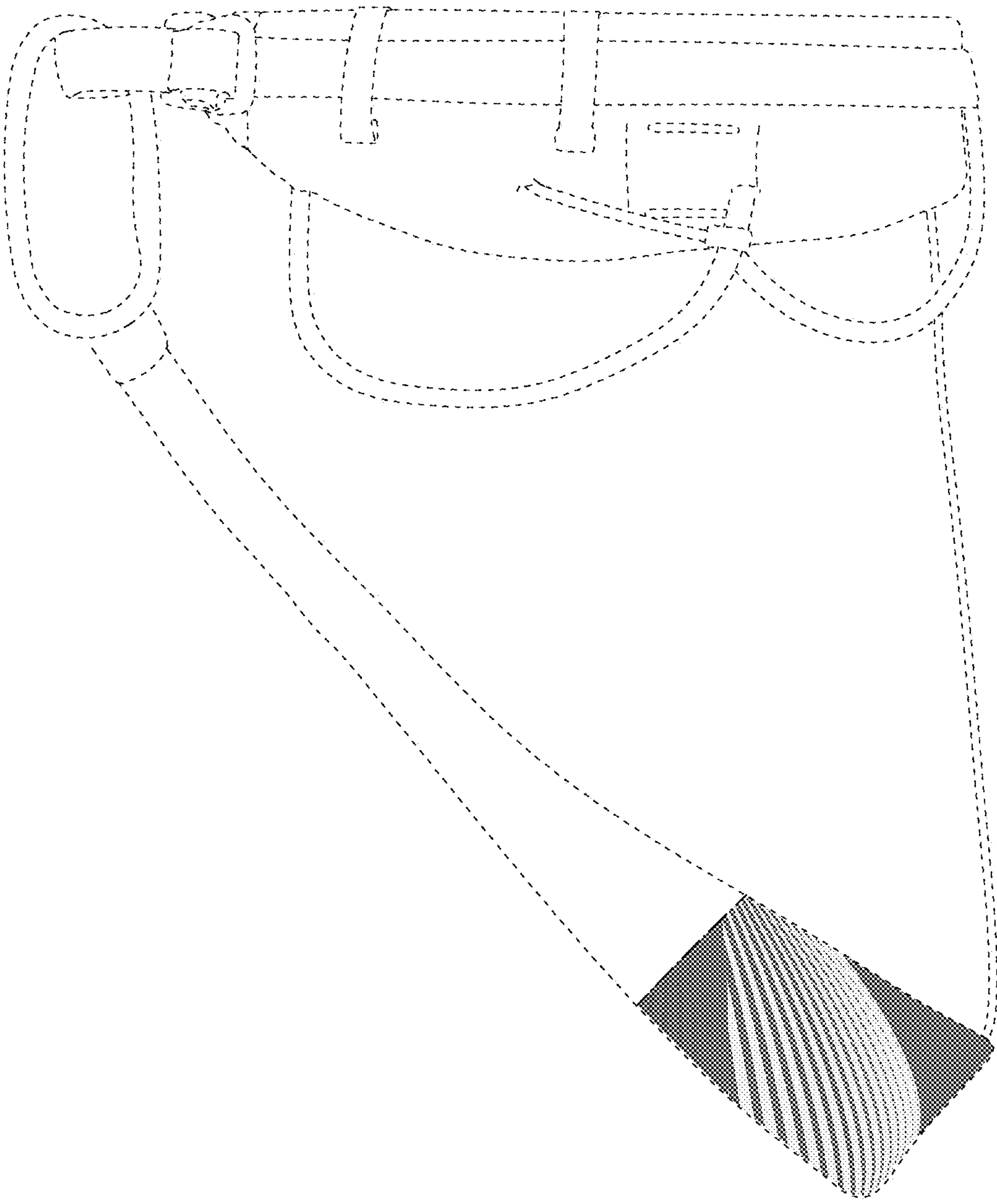
