DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an instrument panel for a motor vehicle showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

A mirror image of the instrument panel is claimed but not shown.

The broken lines in FIGS. 1-7 depict boundaries around de-emphasized elements, which illustrate portions of the instrument panel for a motor vehicle that form no part of the claimed design.

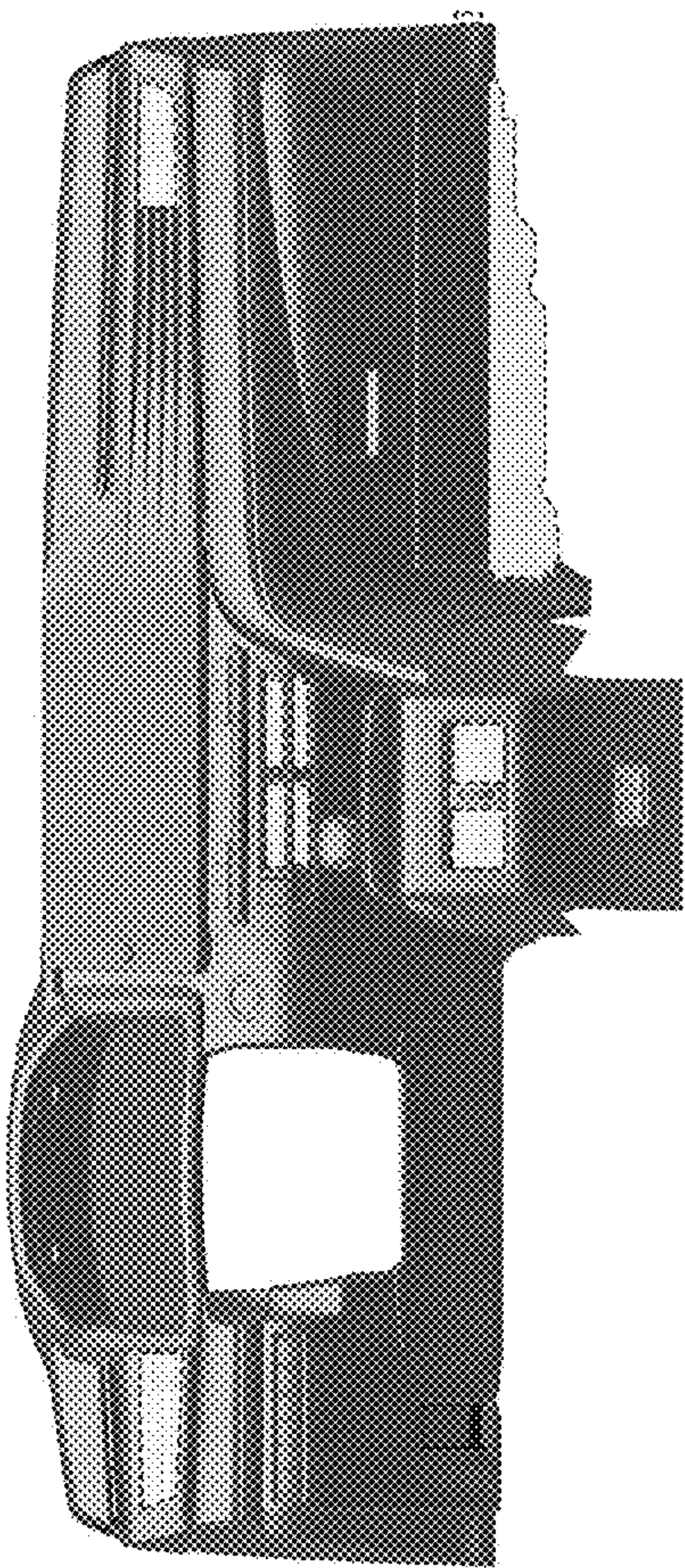

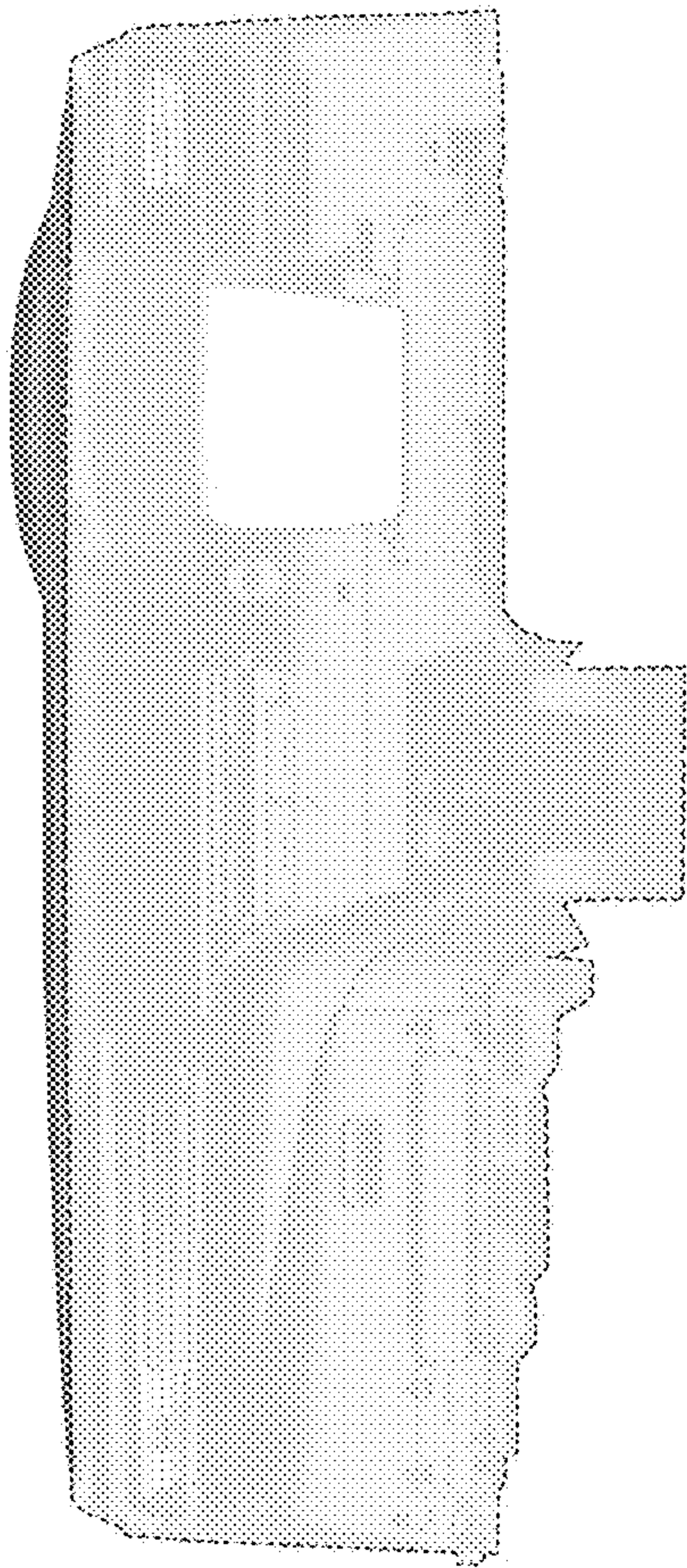

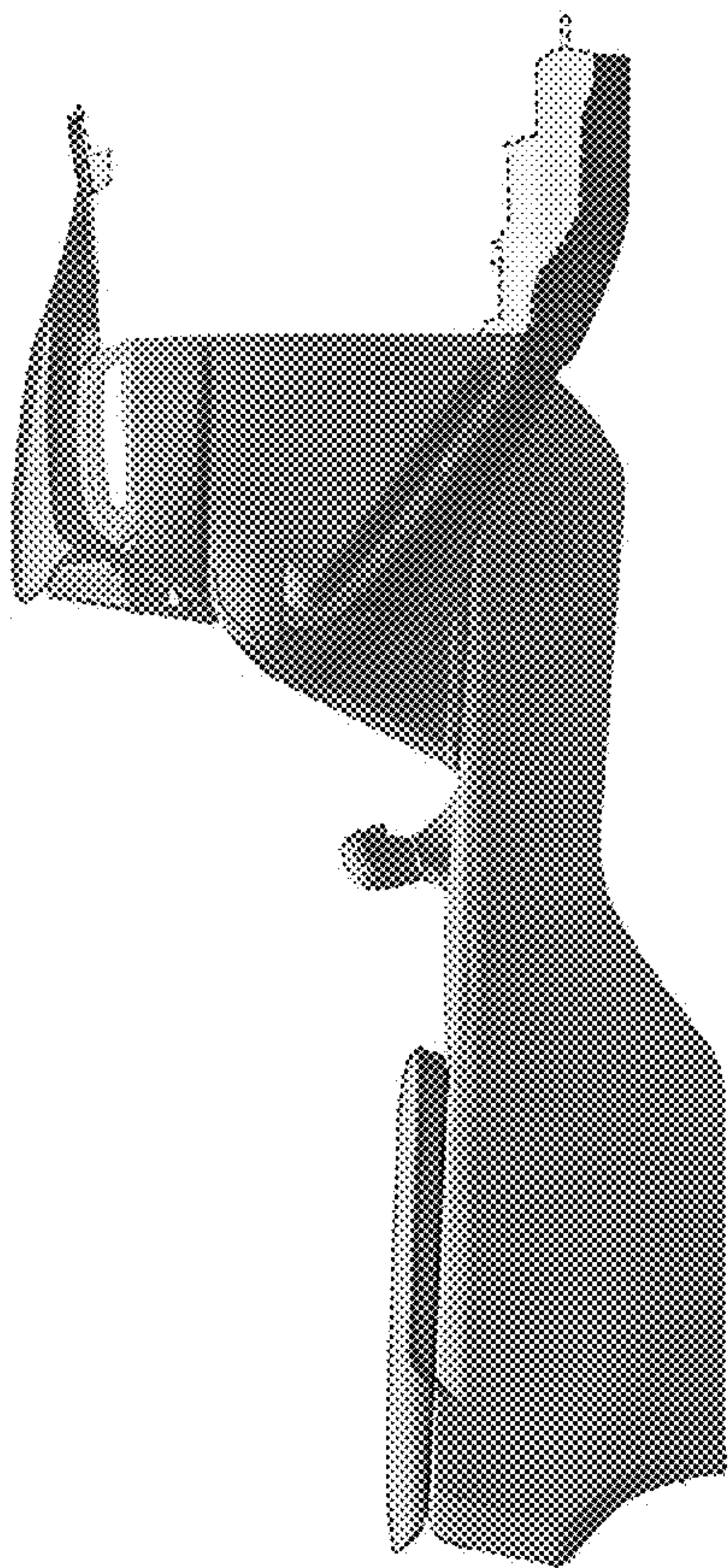

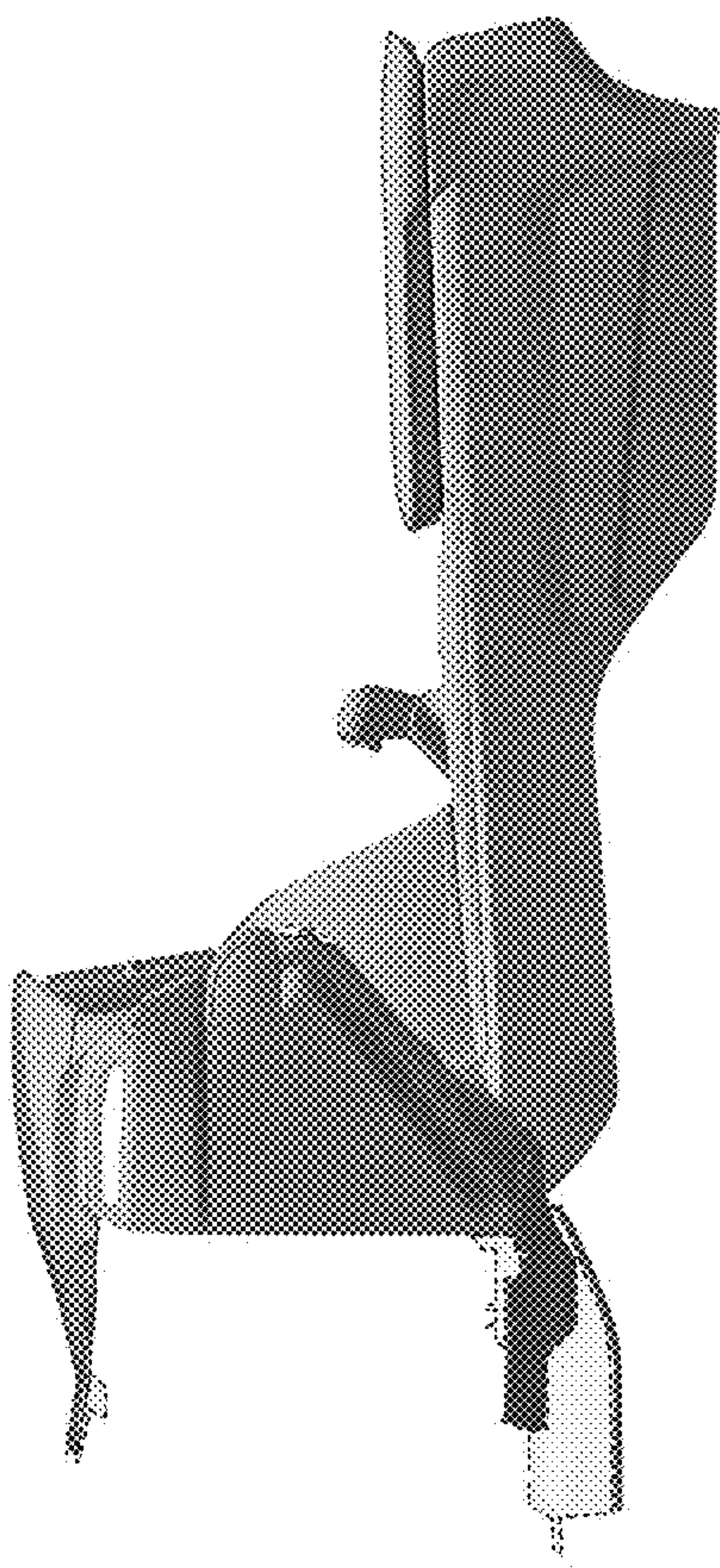

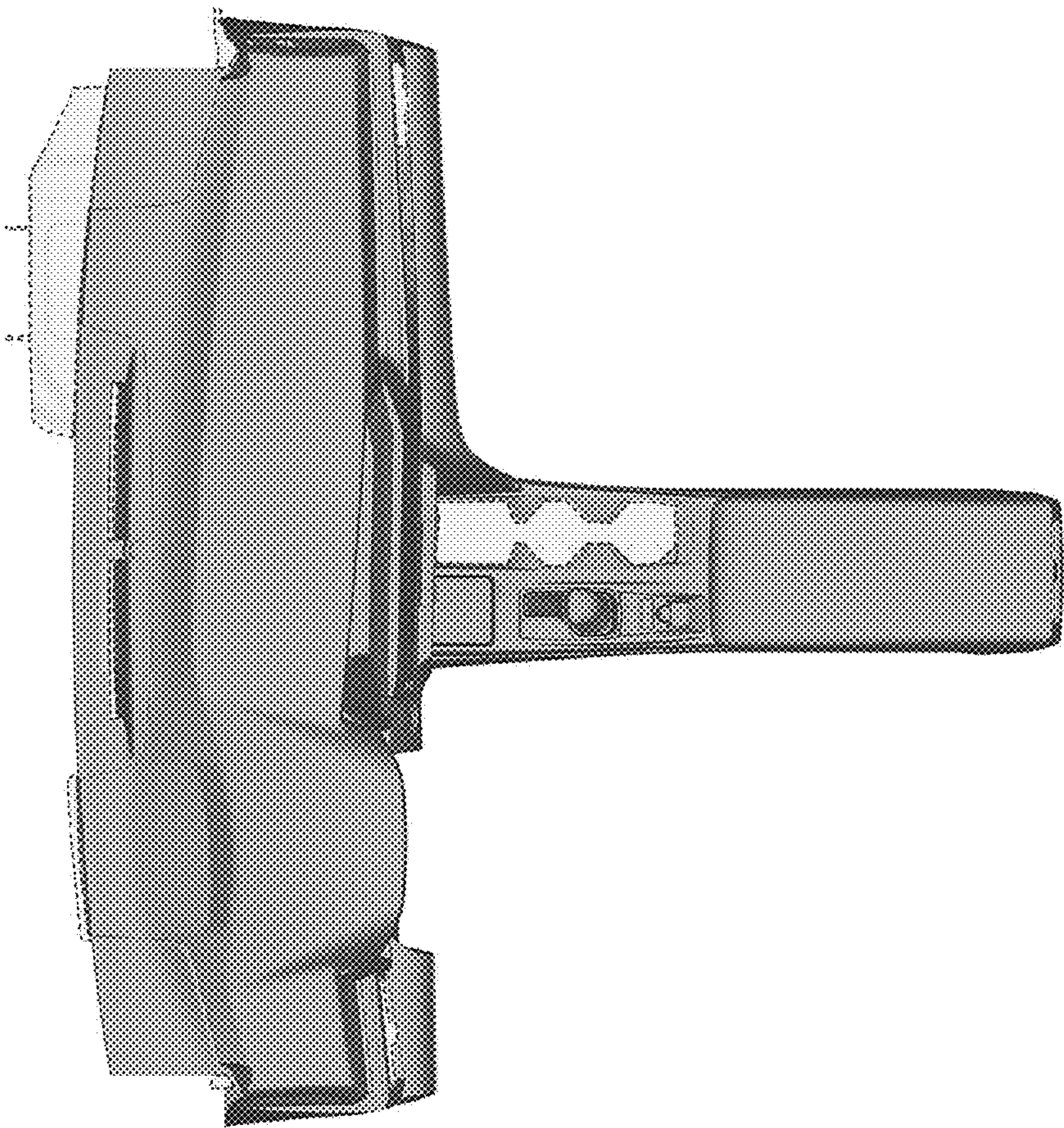

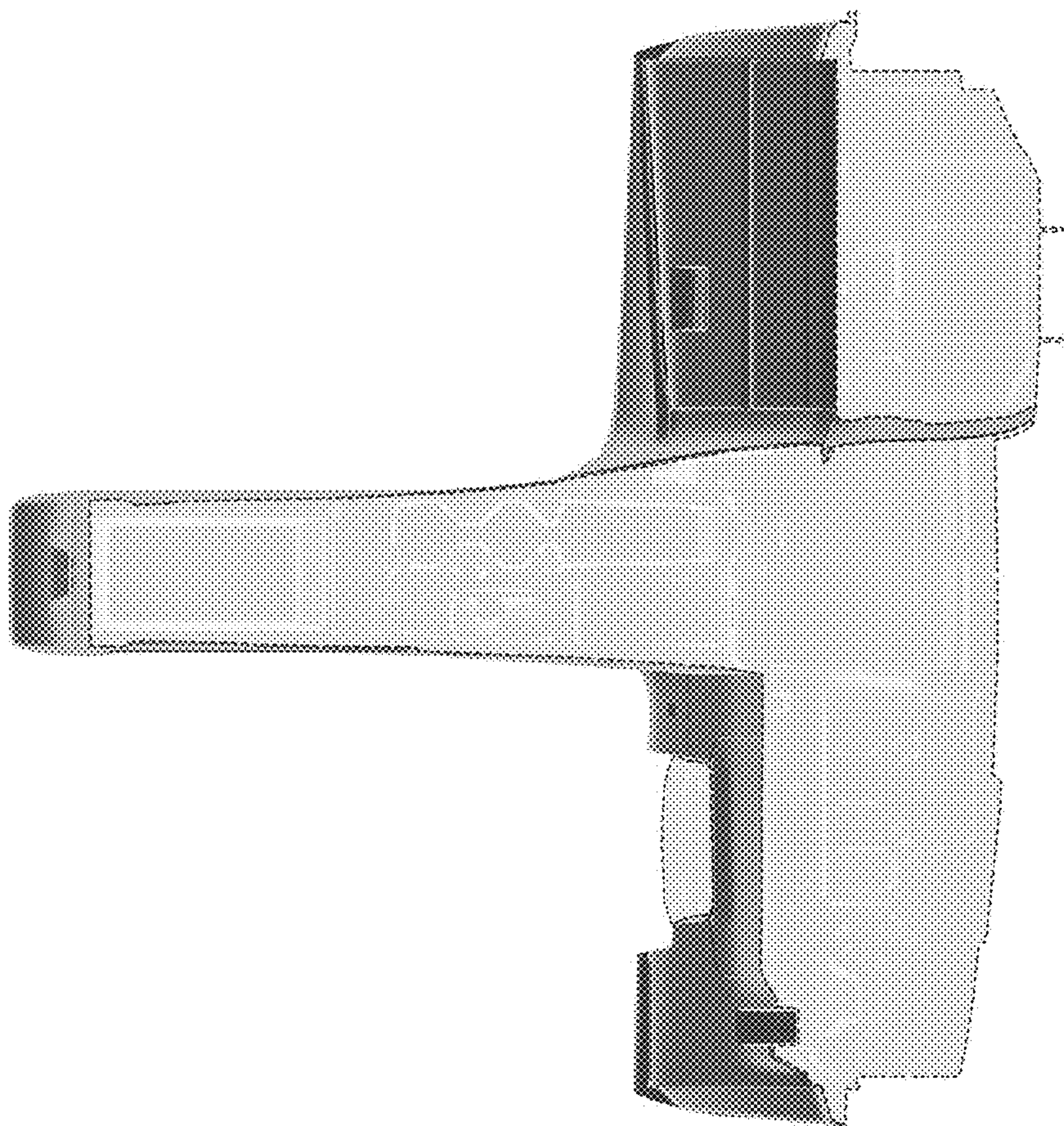
