The ornamental design for a shoe as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;

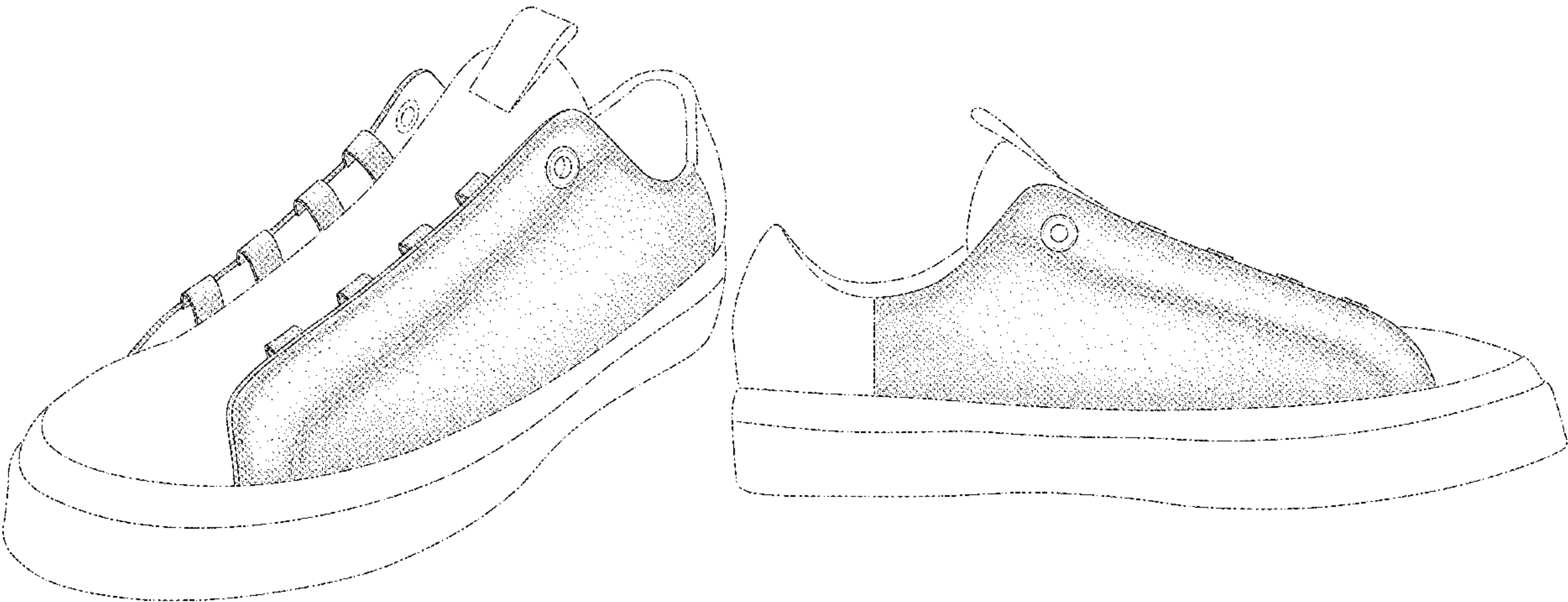
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an opposite side front perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is an opposite side view thereof.

The uneven-length broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded areas define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The even-length broken lines within the shaded areas represent stitching that forms no part of the claimed design. The uneven-length broken lines and unshaded regions depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

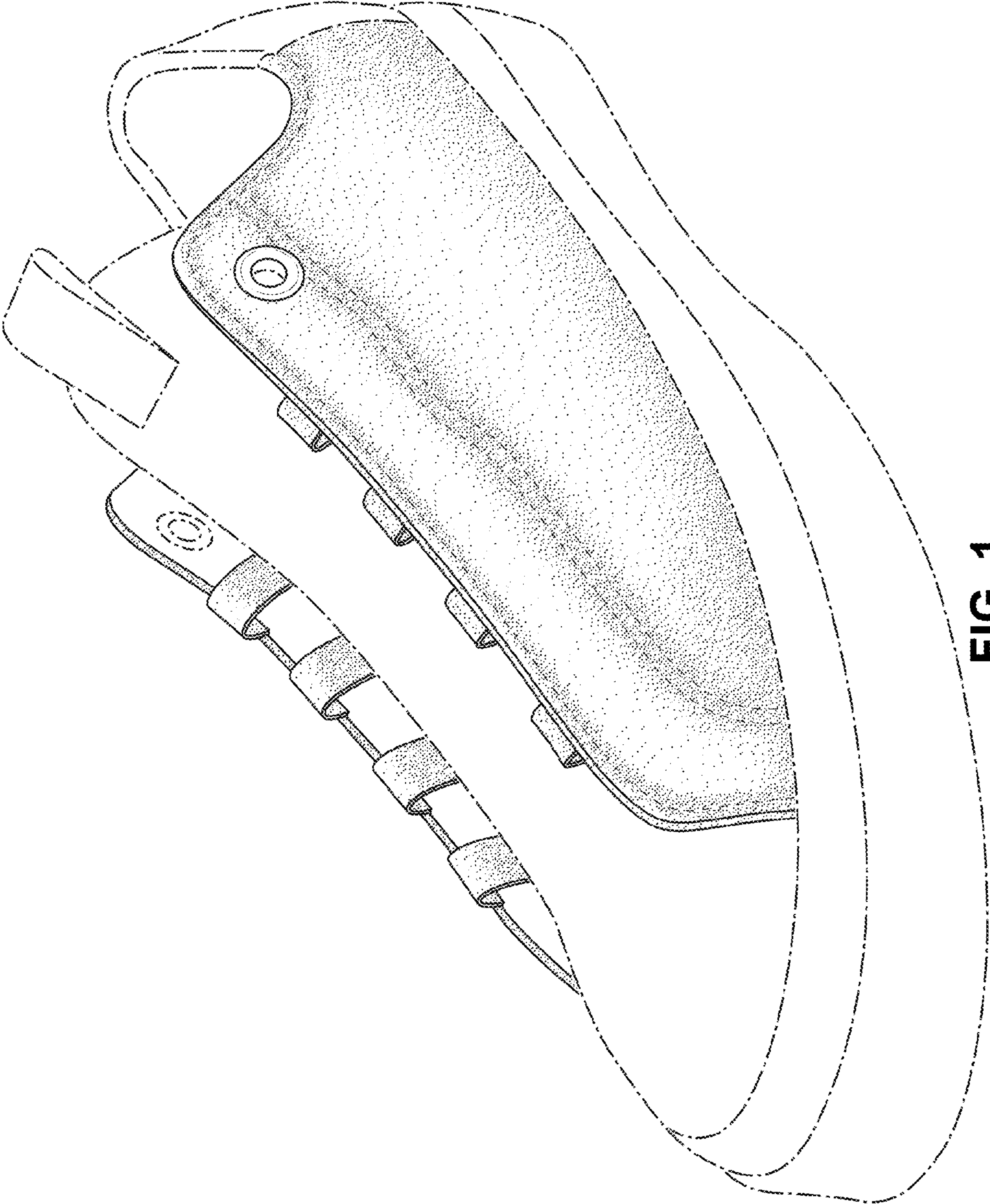

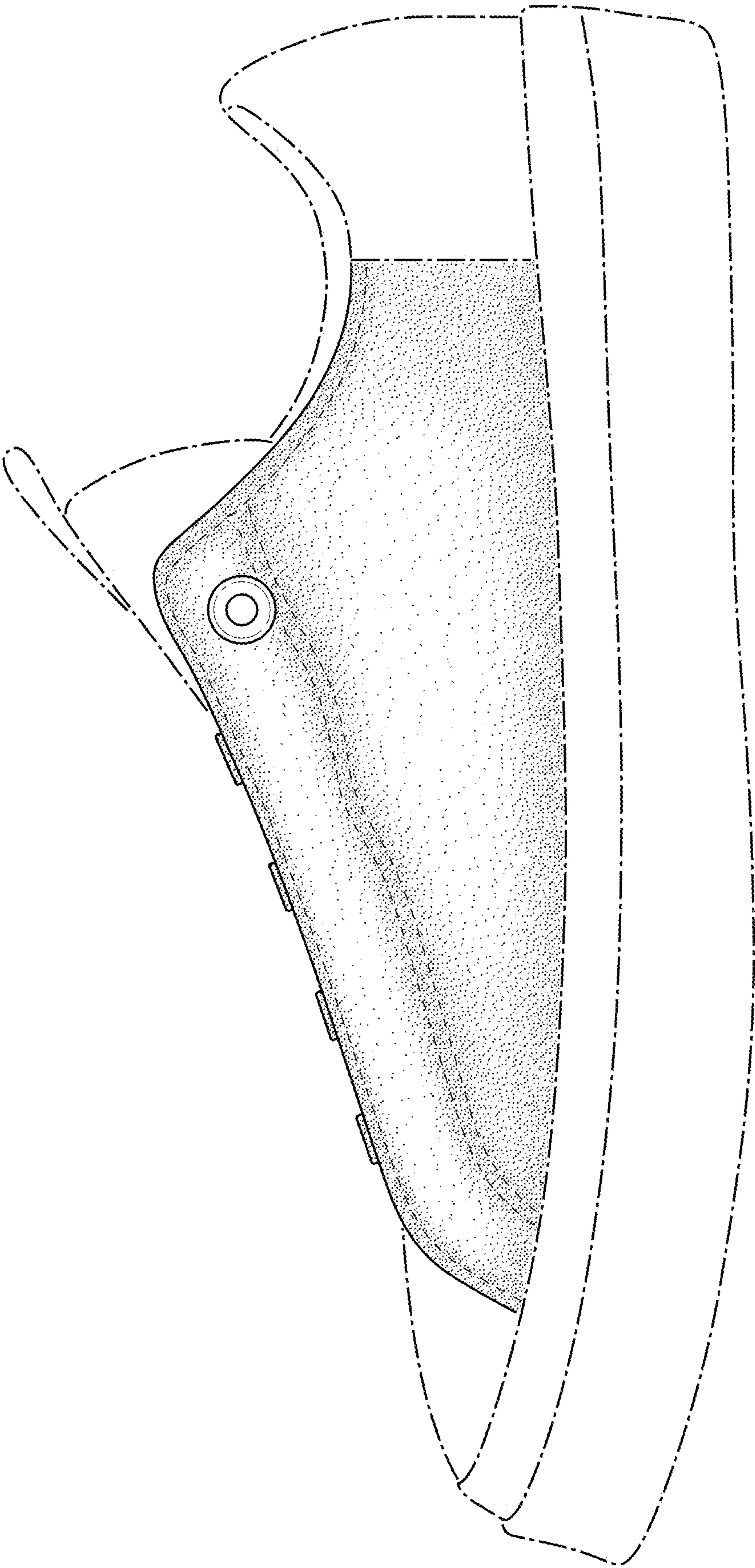

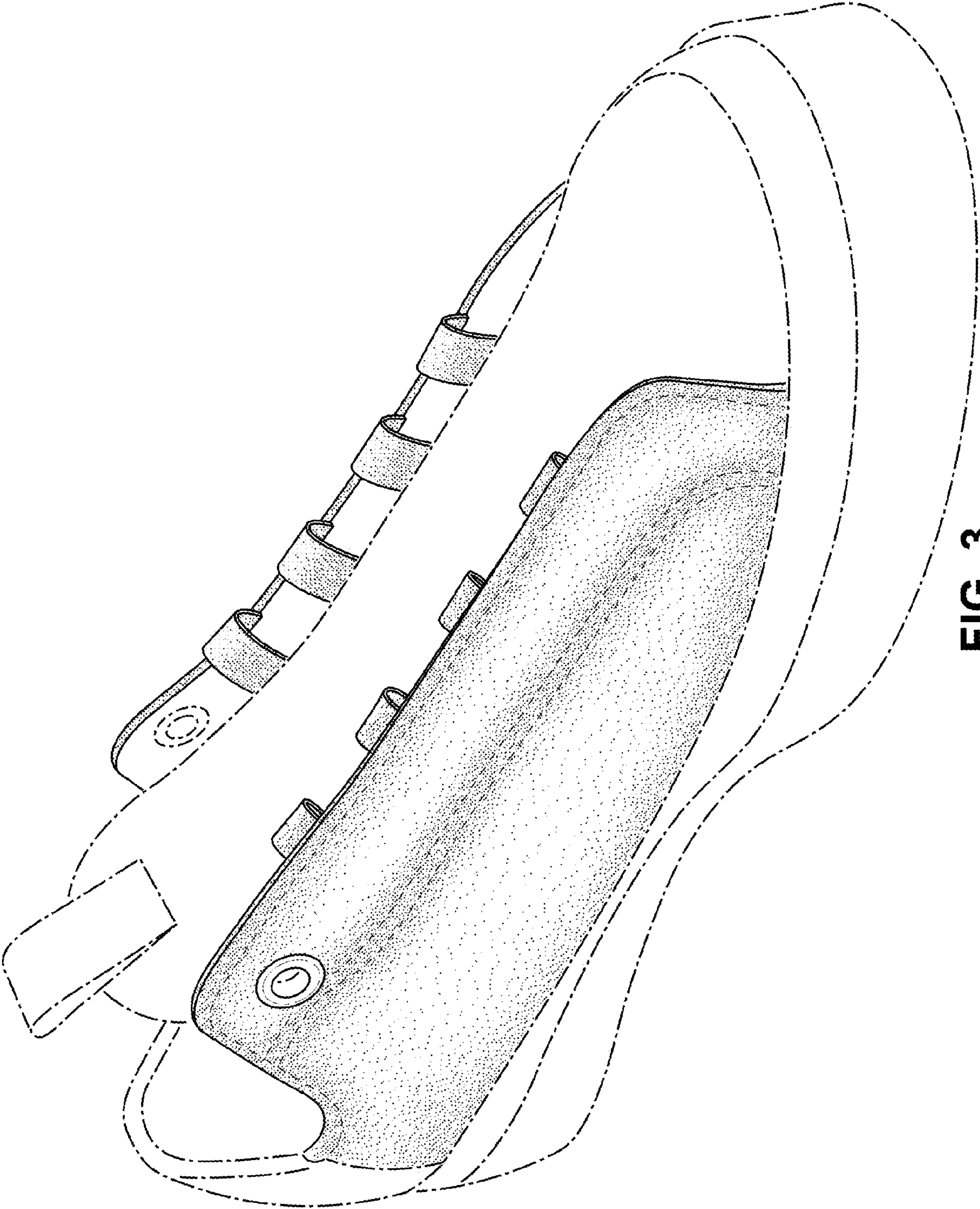

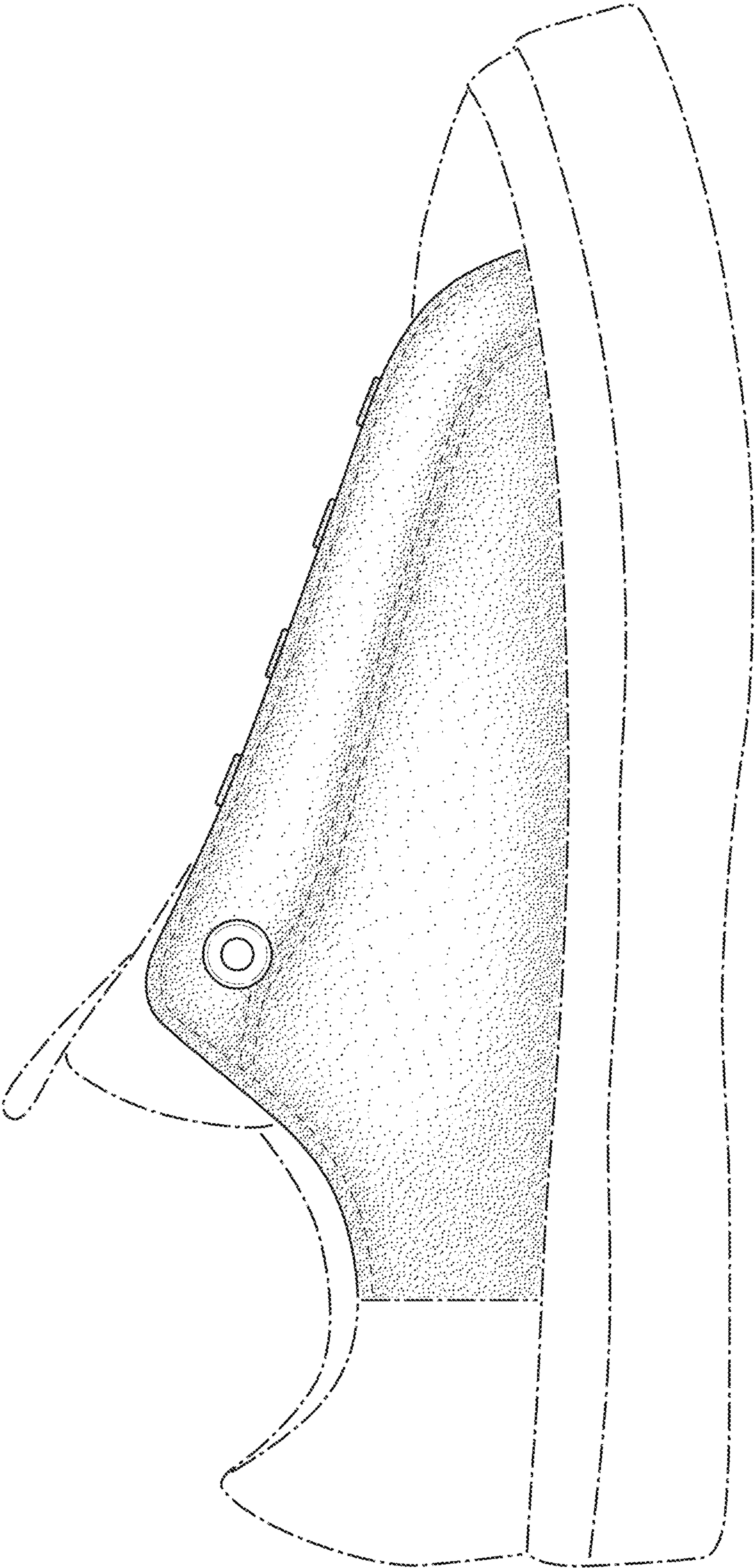
