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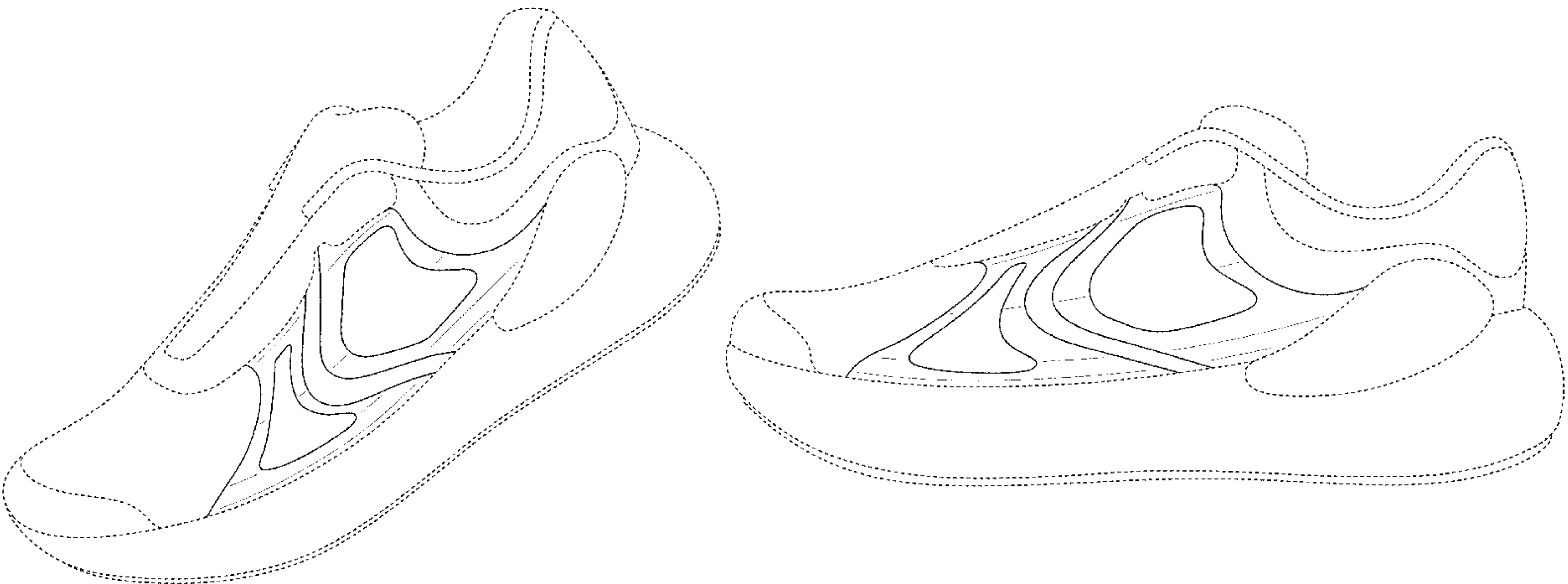
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe, showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a medial side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a lateral side view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.
The broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate portions of the shoe that form no part of the claimed design. The unshaded surfaces form no part of the claimed design. A left-foot shoe is illustrated in FIGS. 1-4. A second embodiment of the design includes a right-foot shoe, which is a mirror image of the views of the first embodiment.

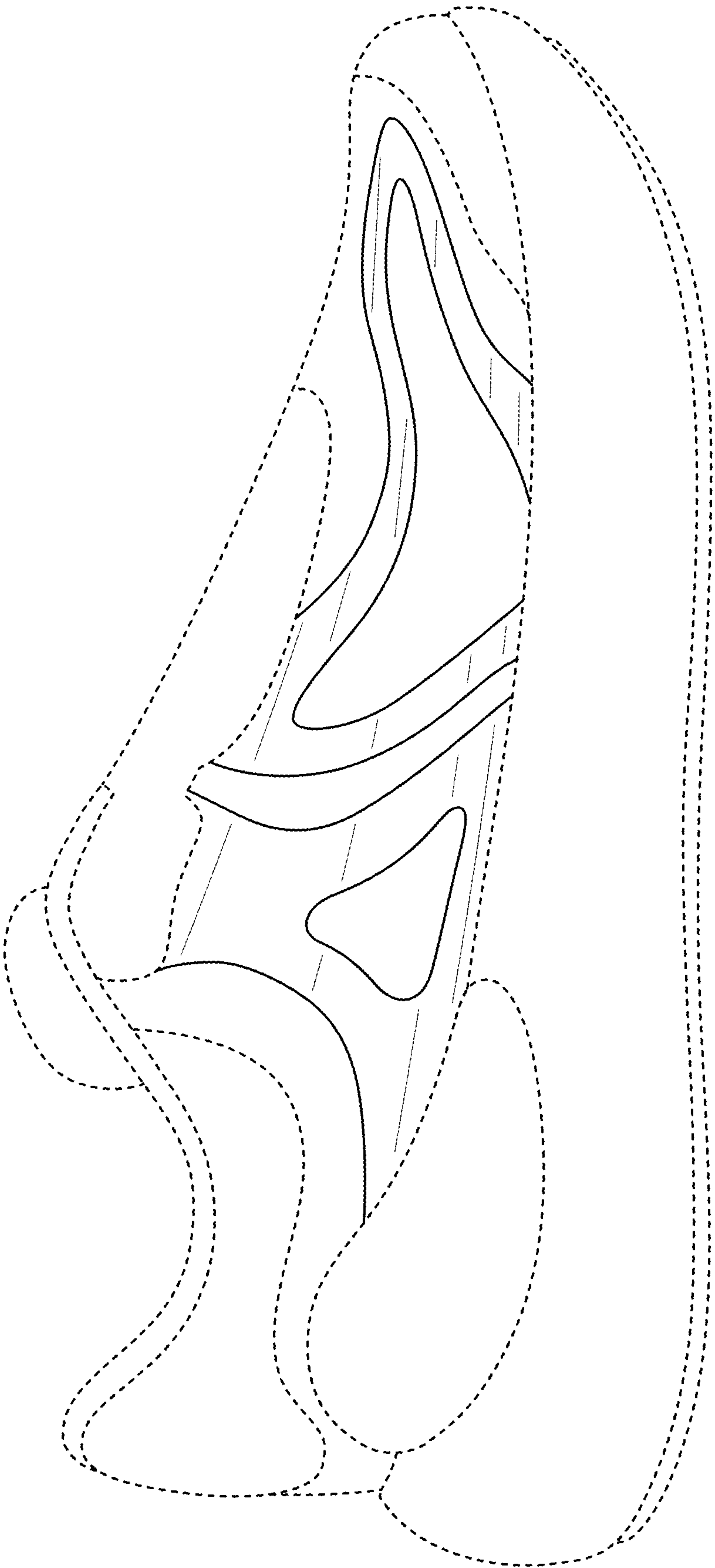

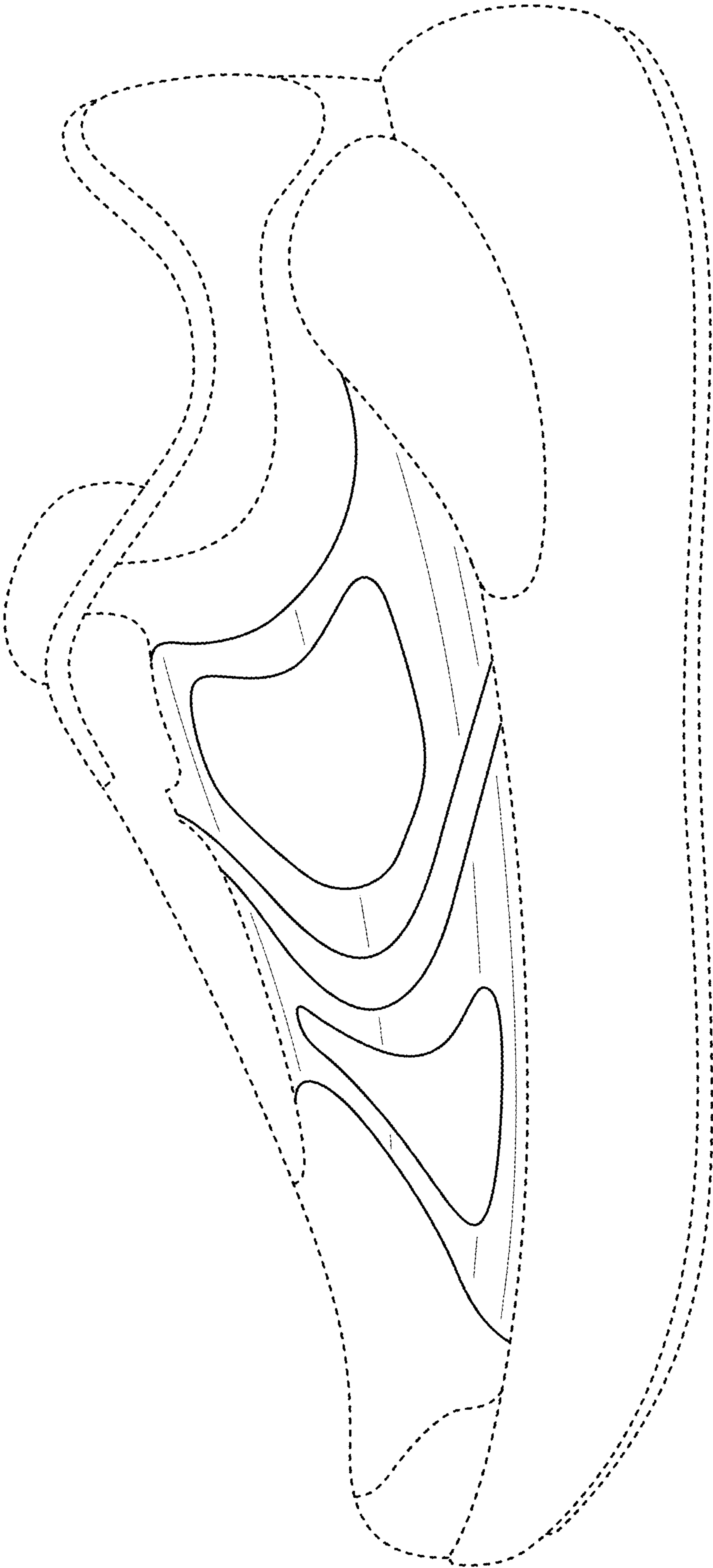

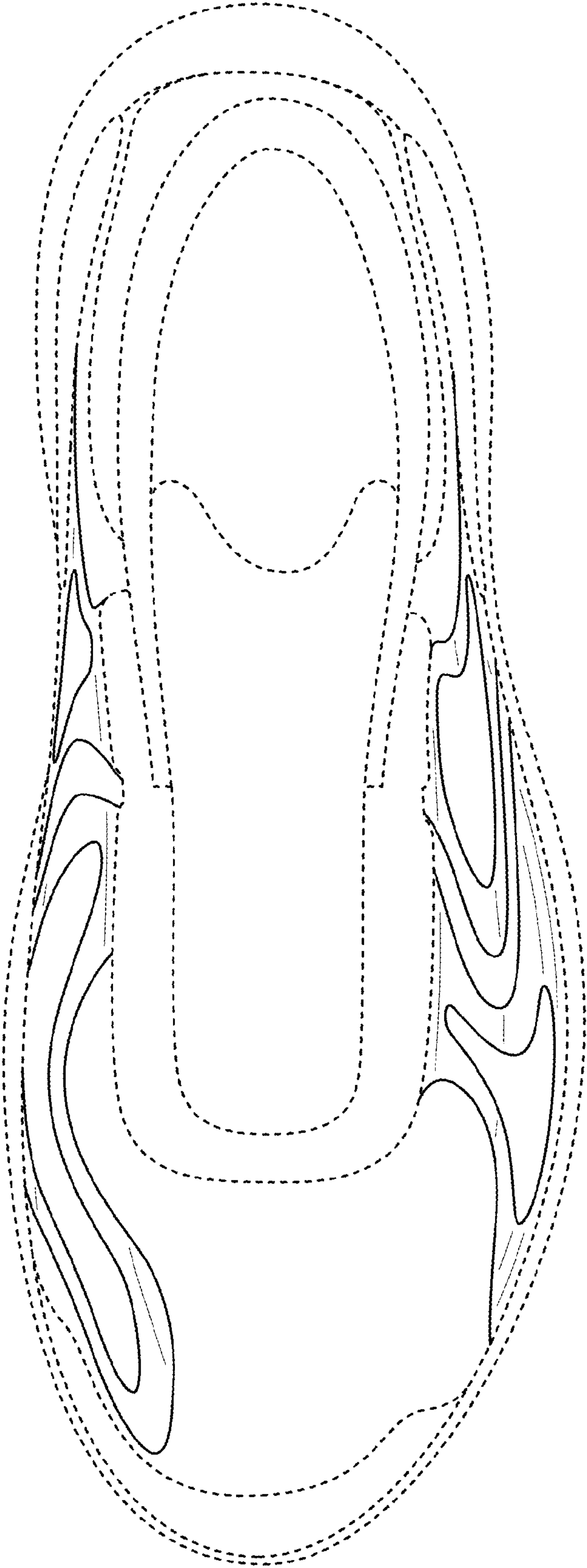
