DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first image in a sequence for a graphical user interface (GUI) for the display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface according to a first embodiment;

FIG. 2 is a second image in the sequence for a graphical user interface (GUI) for the display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface according to the first embodiment;

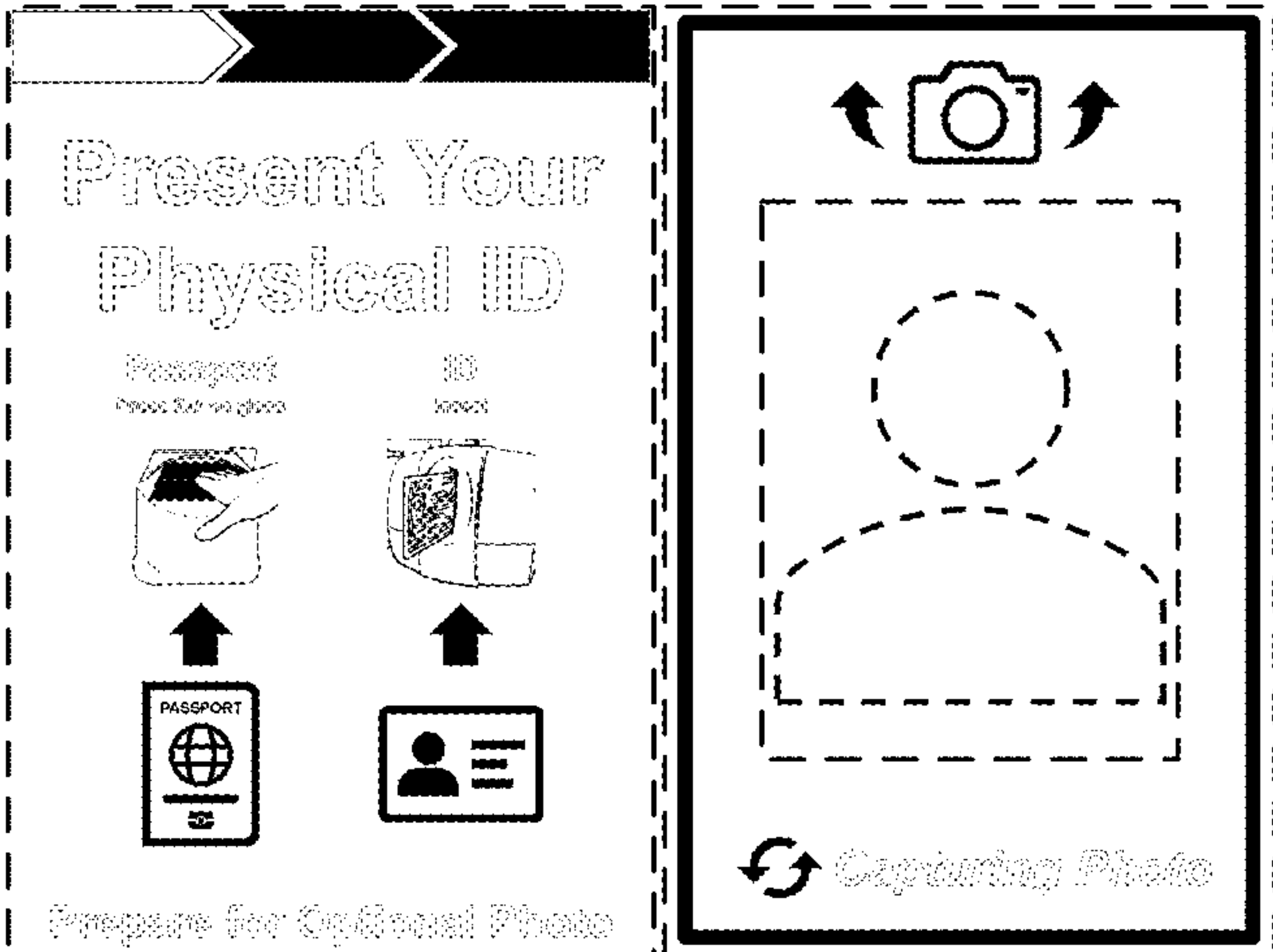
FIG. 3 is a third image in the sequence for a graphical user interface (GUI) for the display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface according to the first embodiment;

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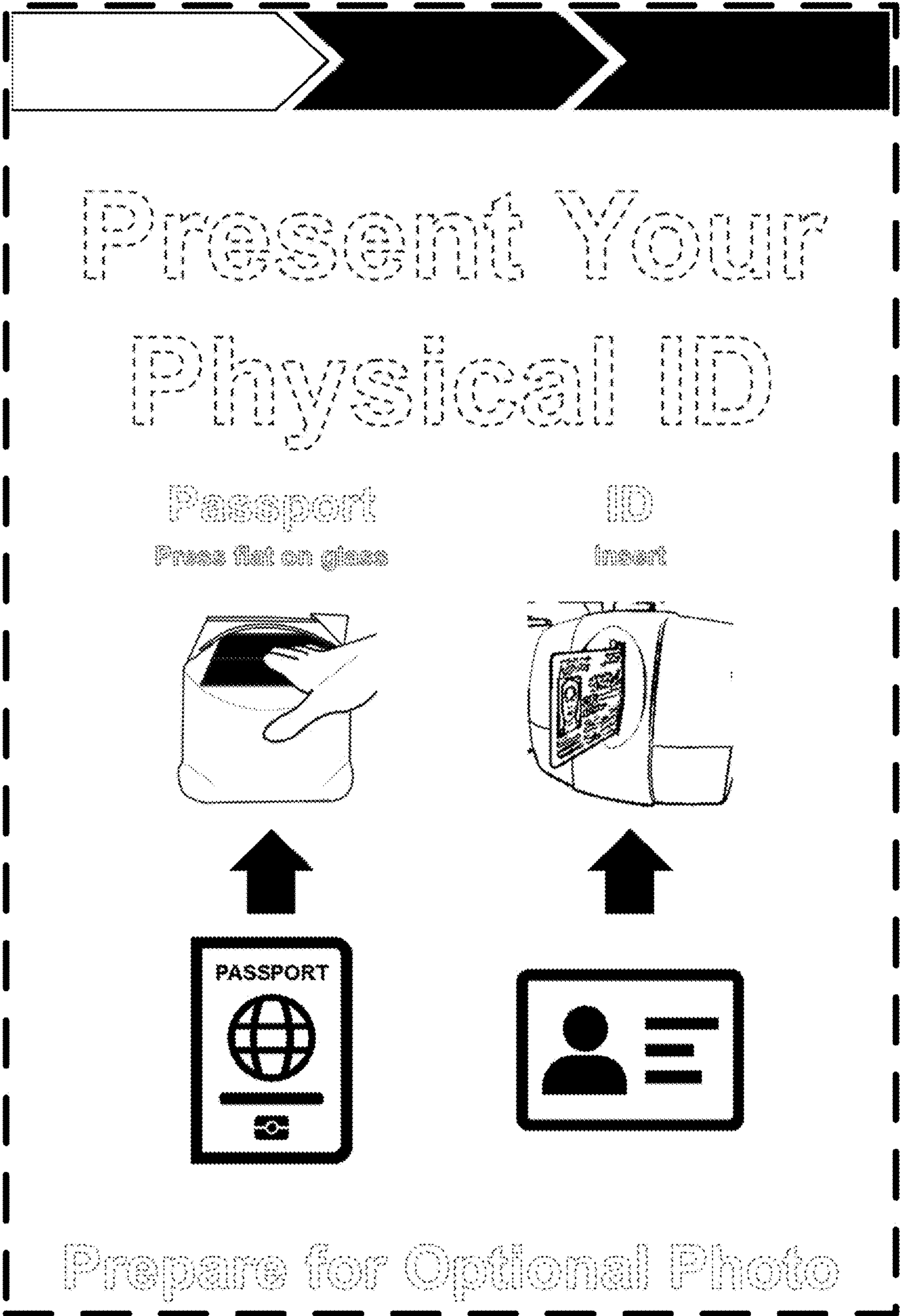

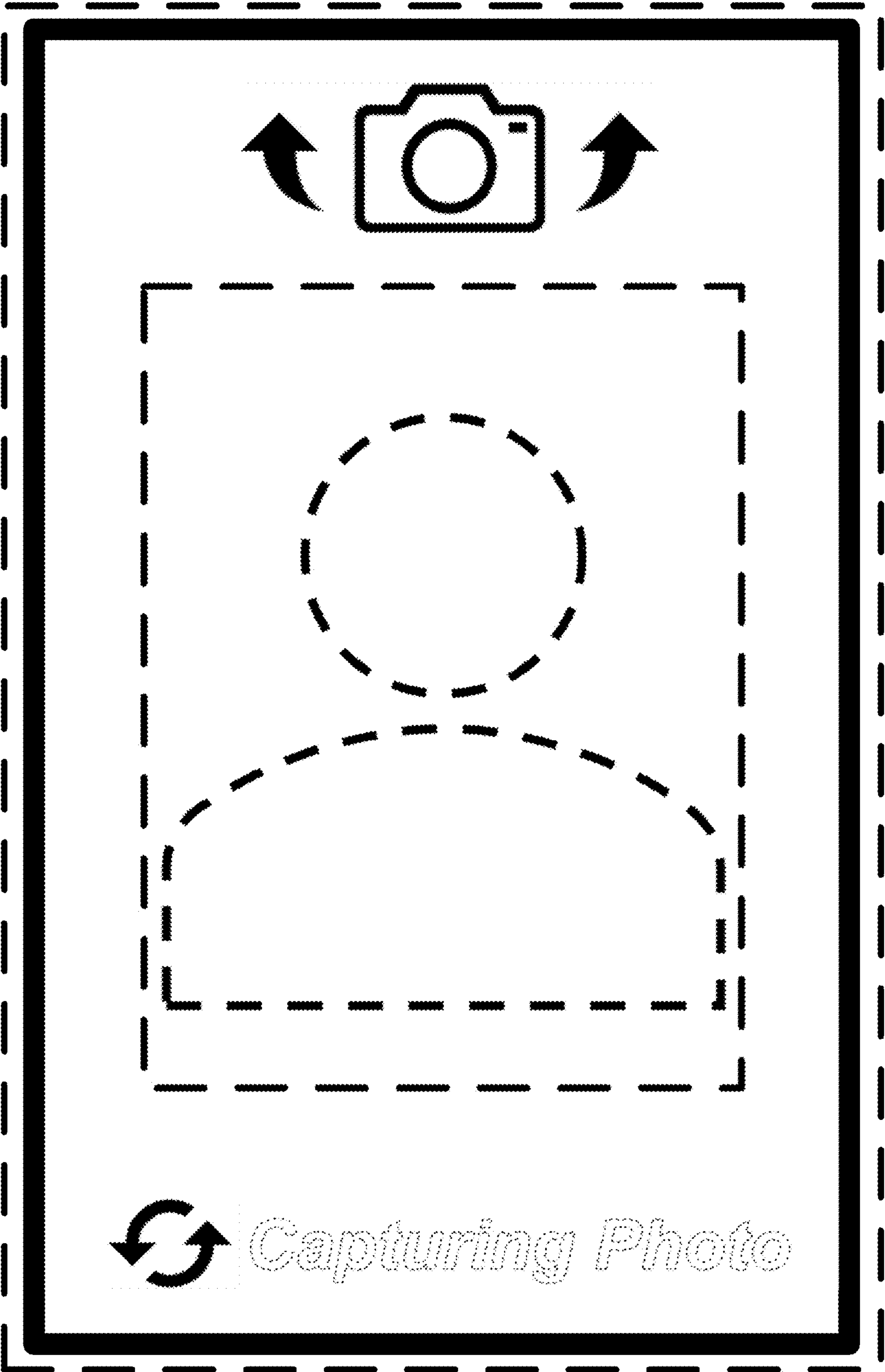

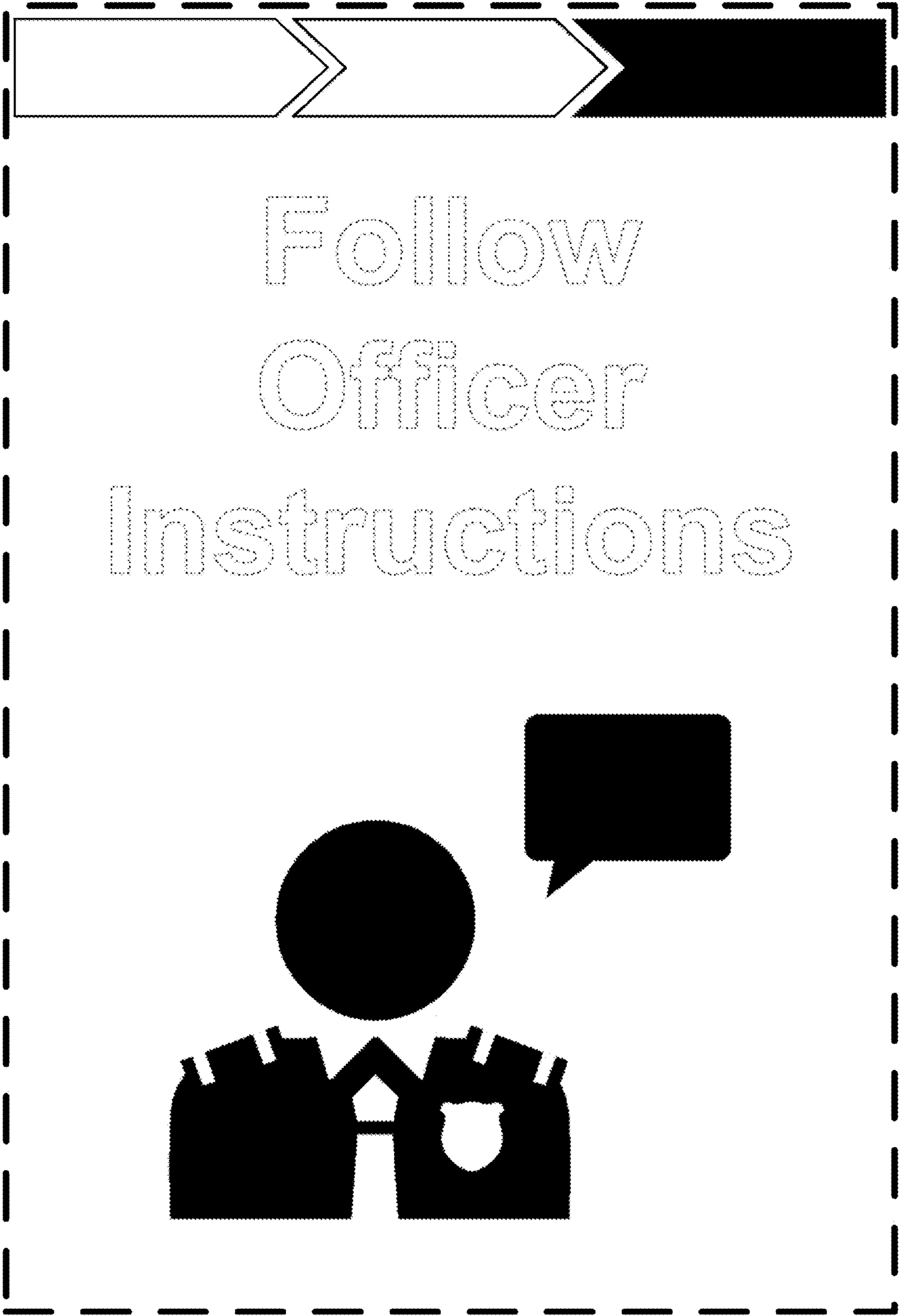

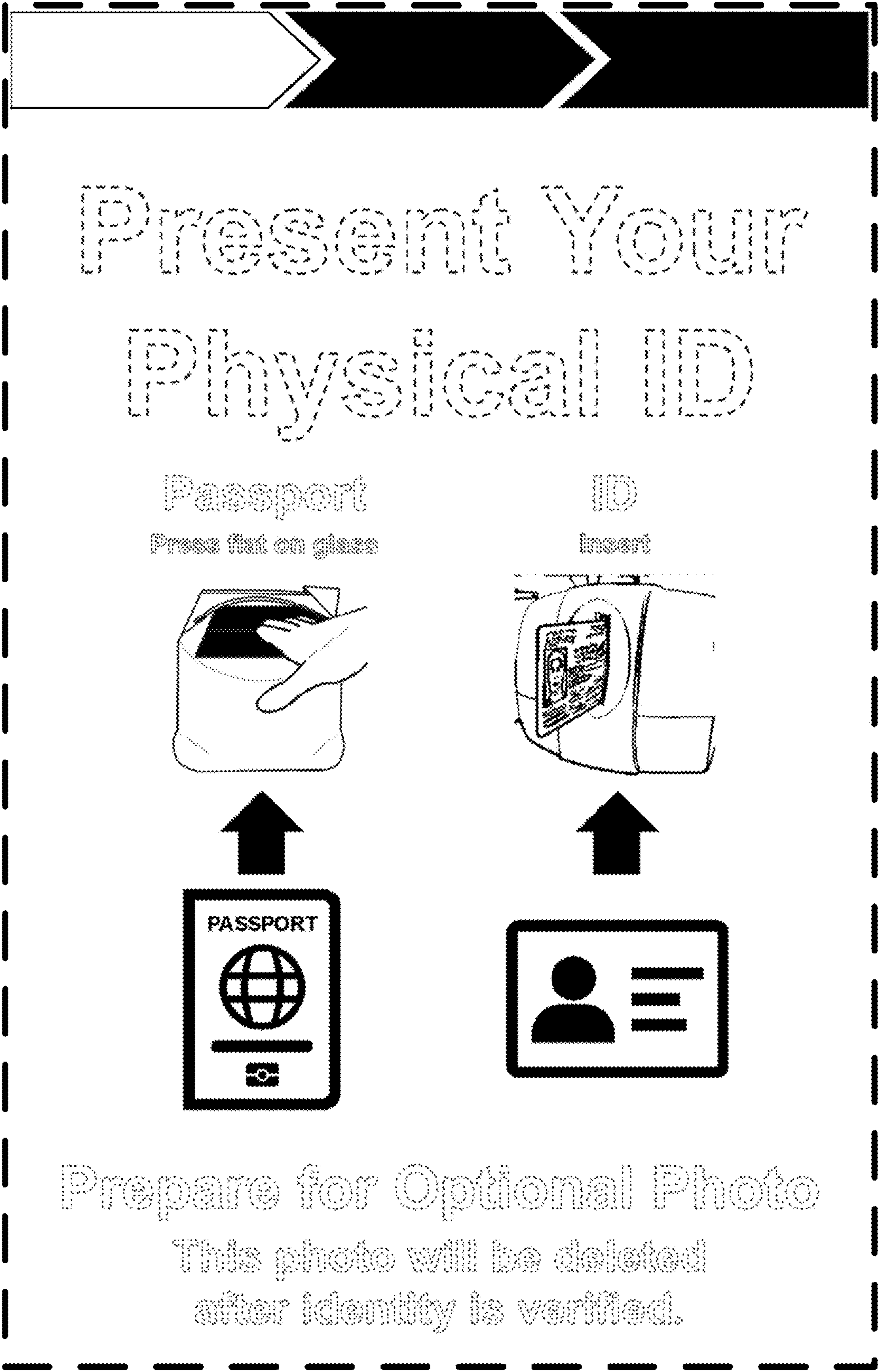

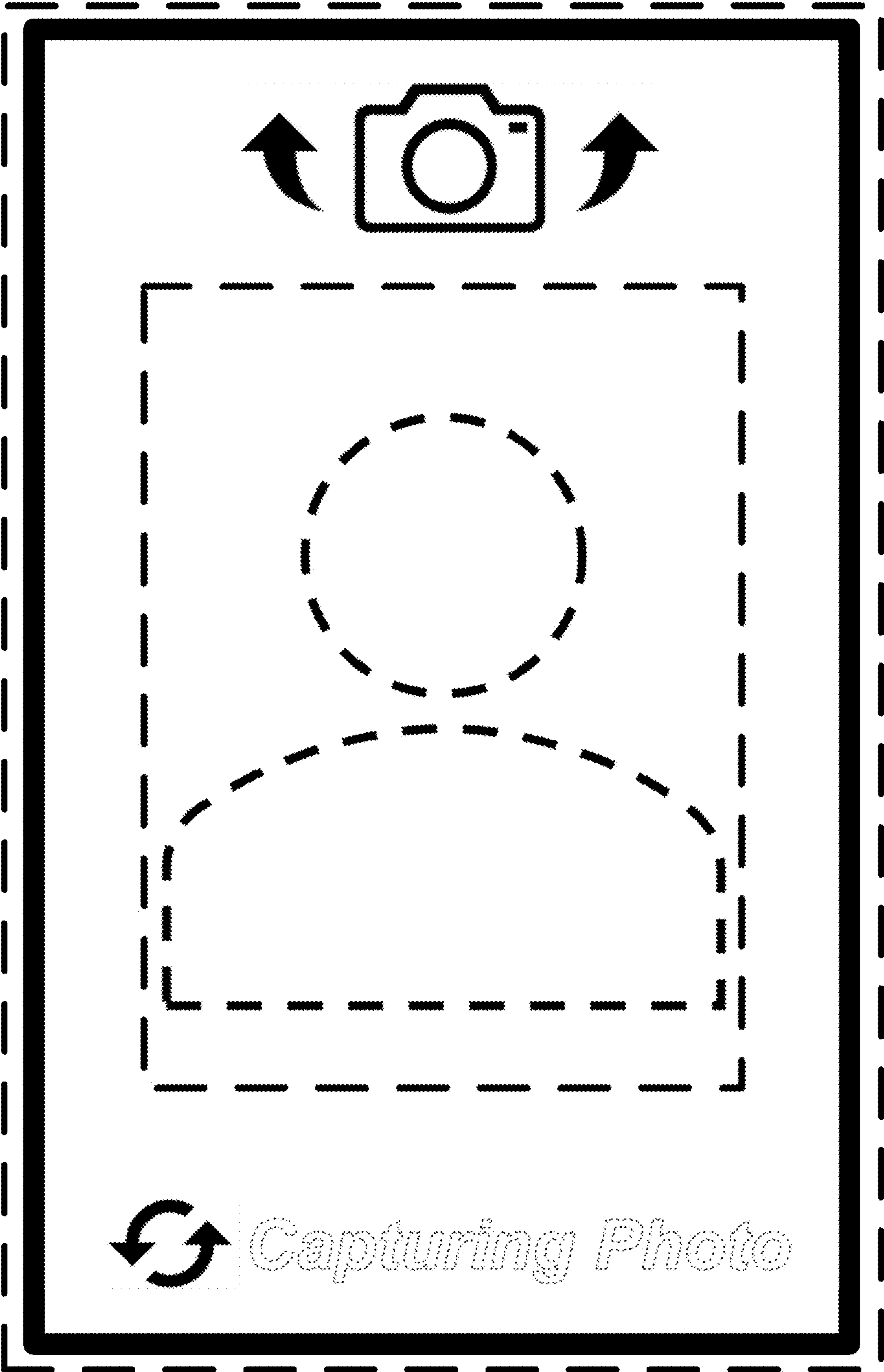

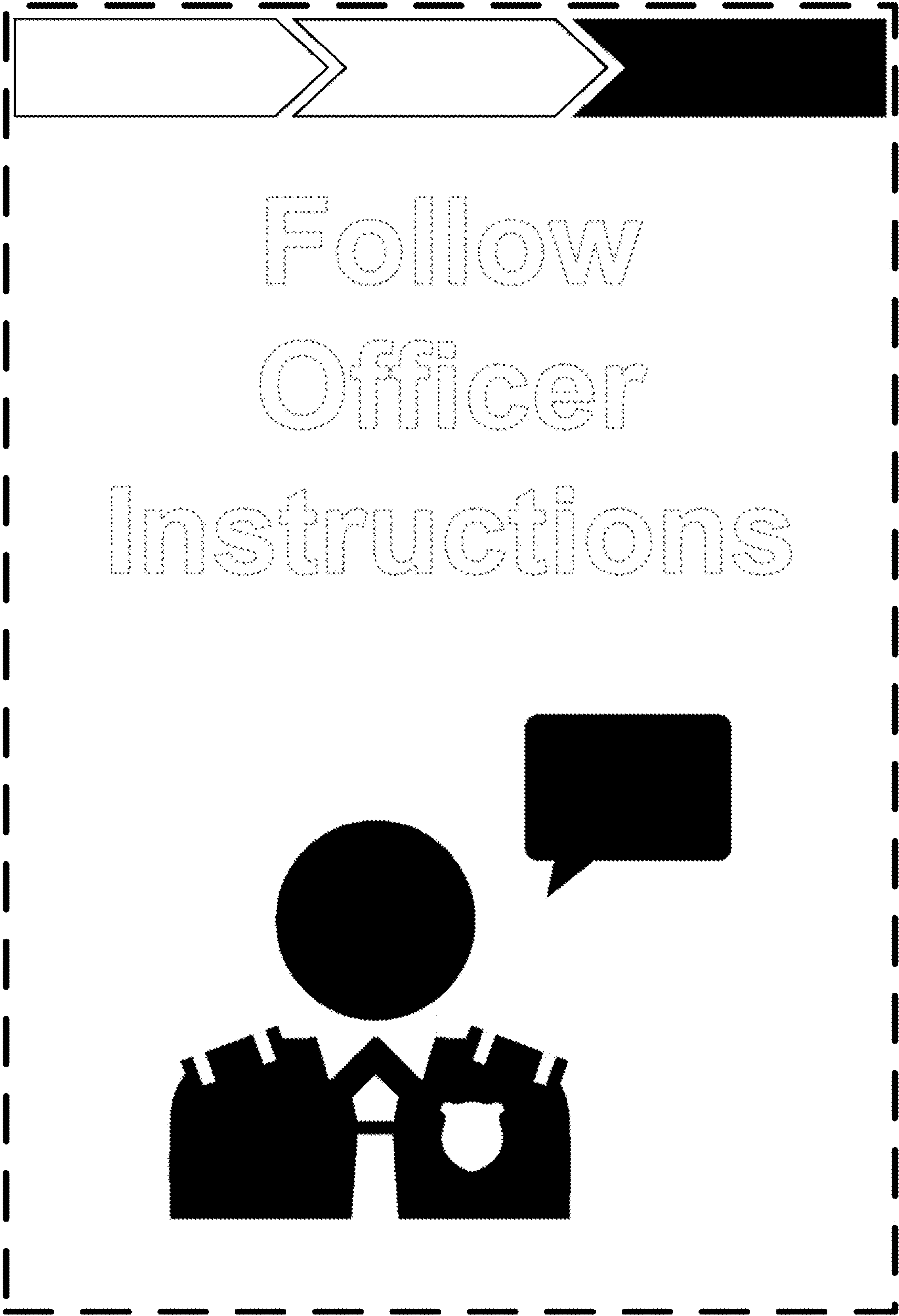
