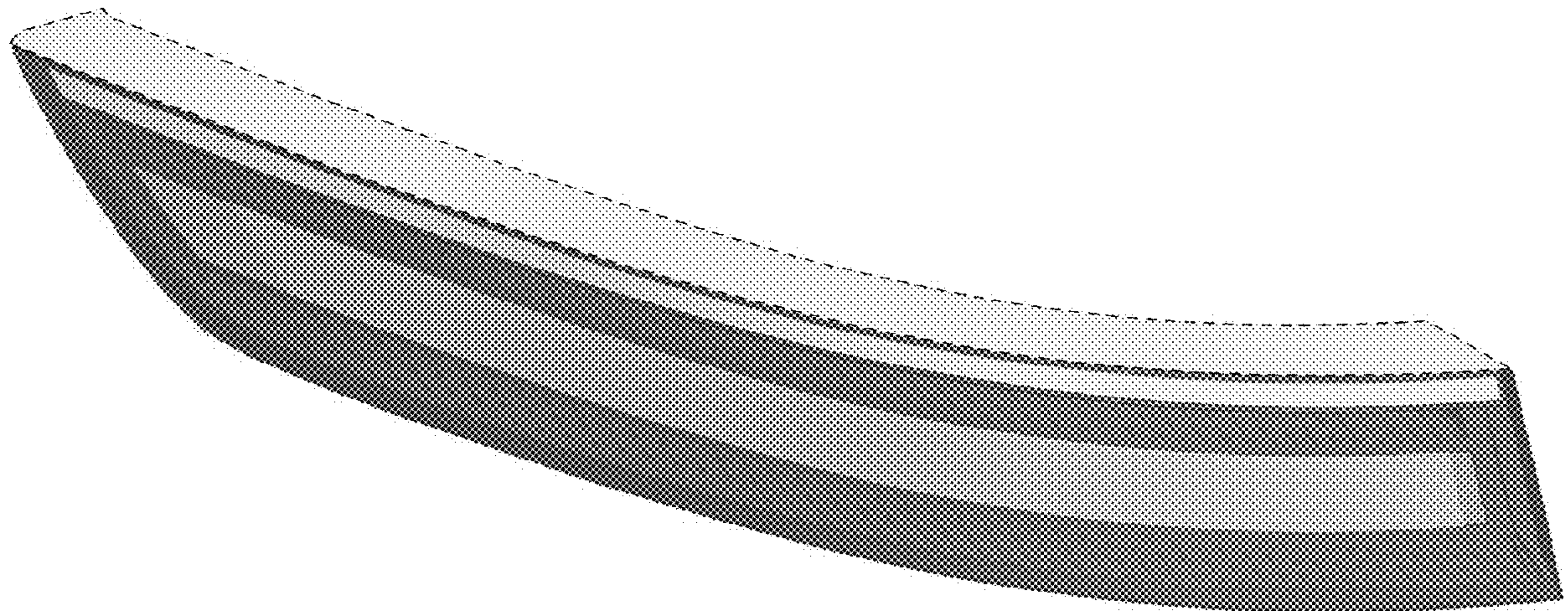
The ornamental design for a rear combination lamp for

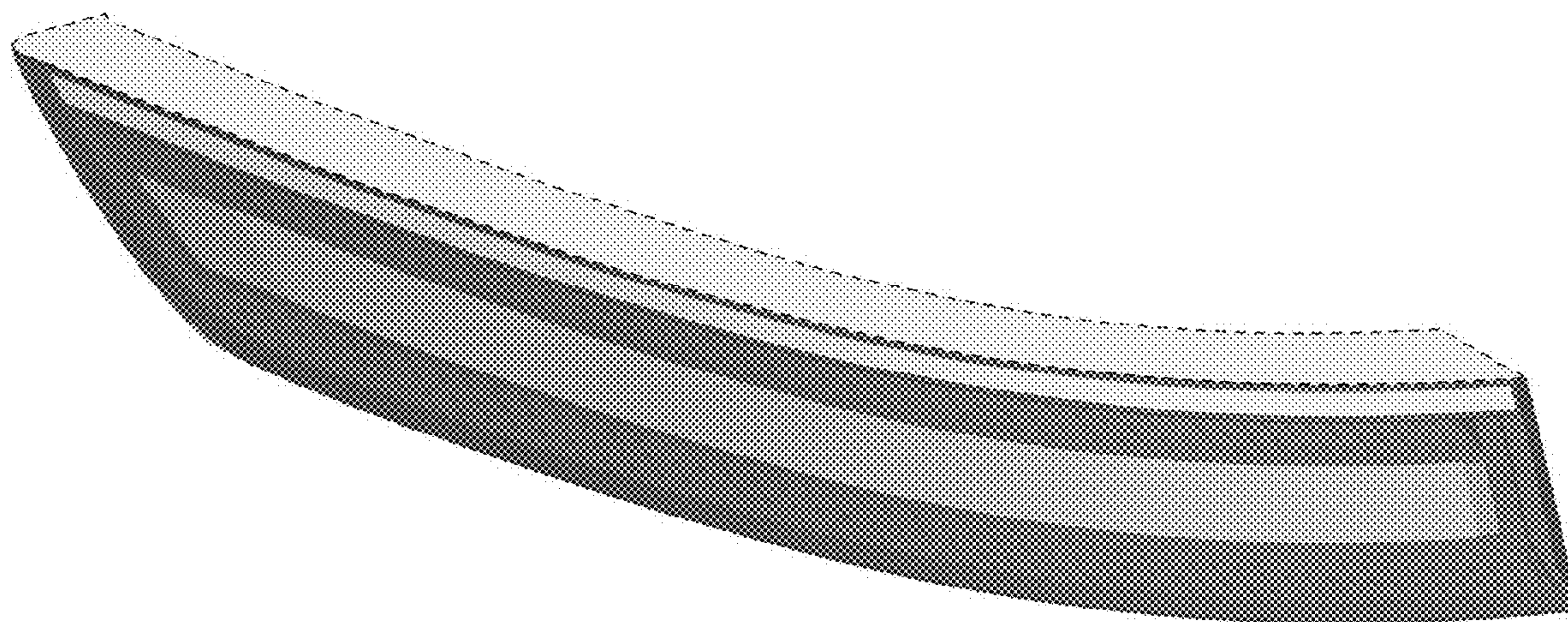

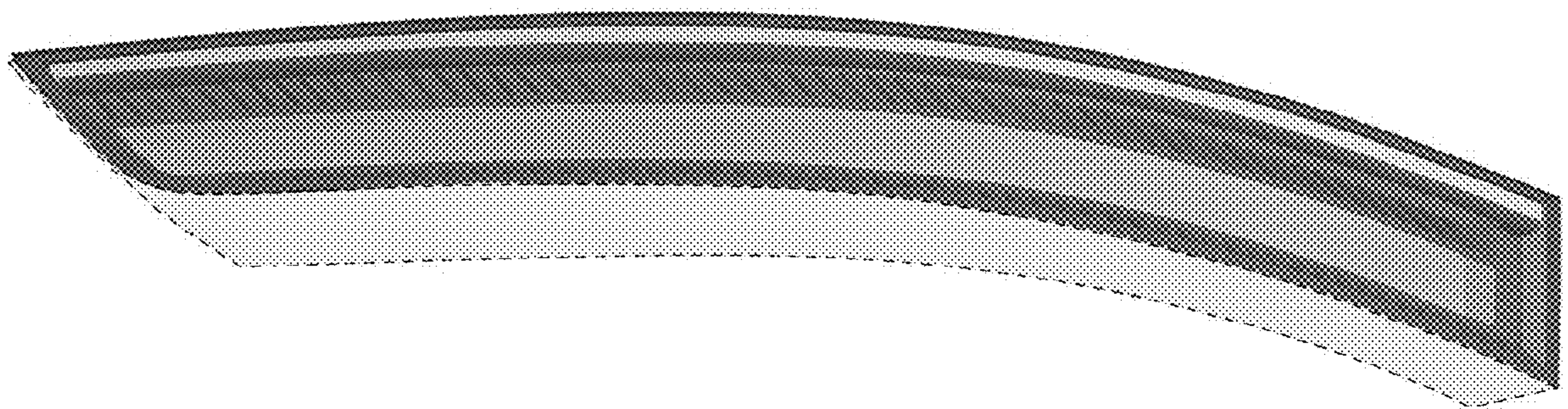

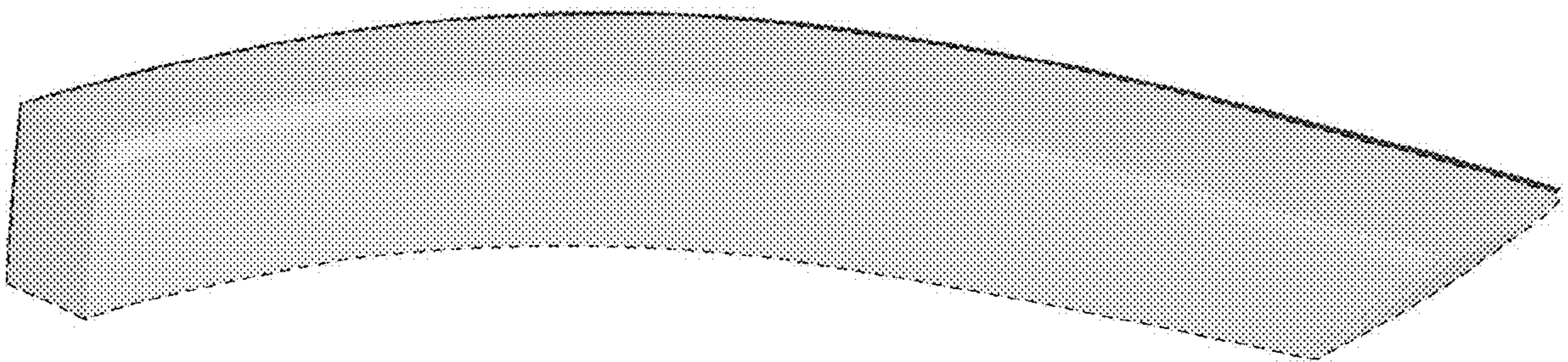

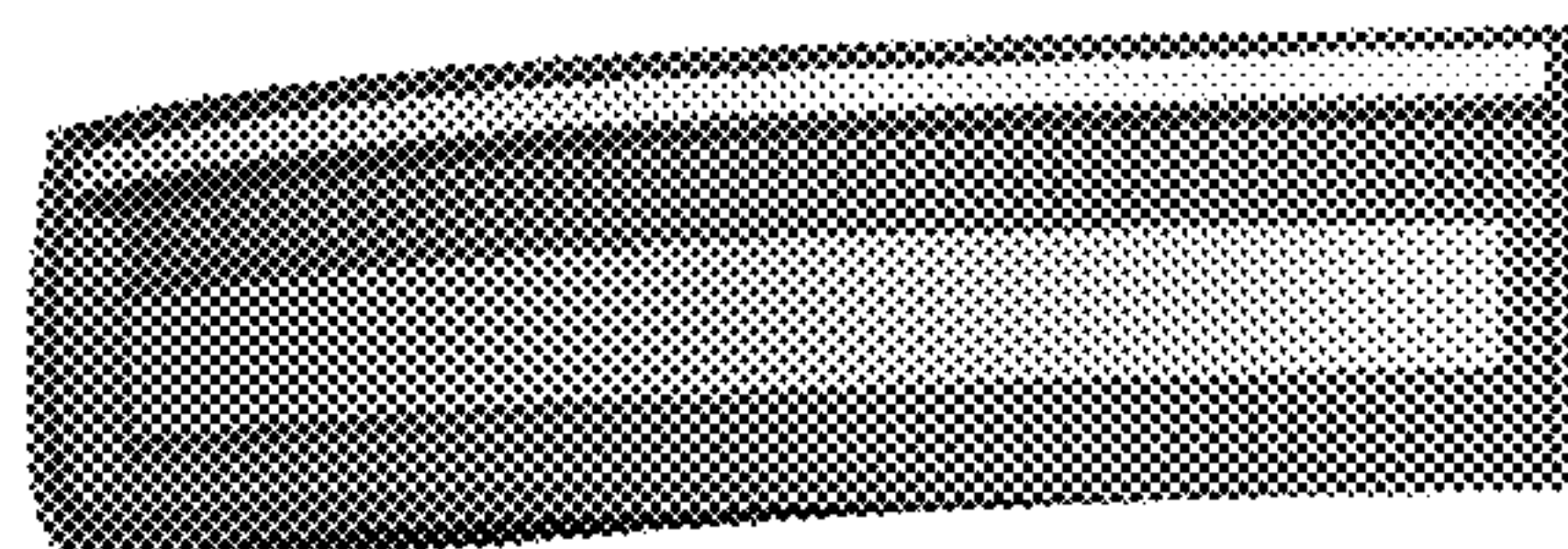

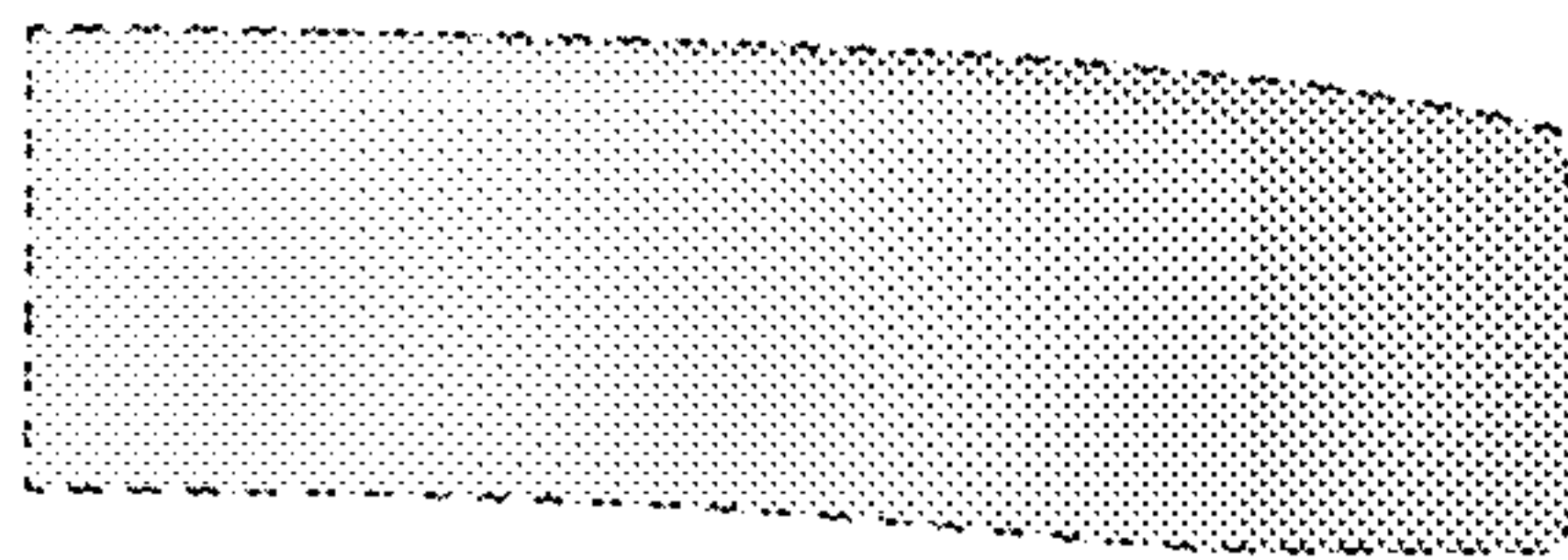

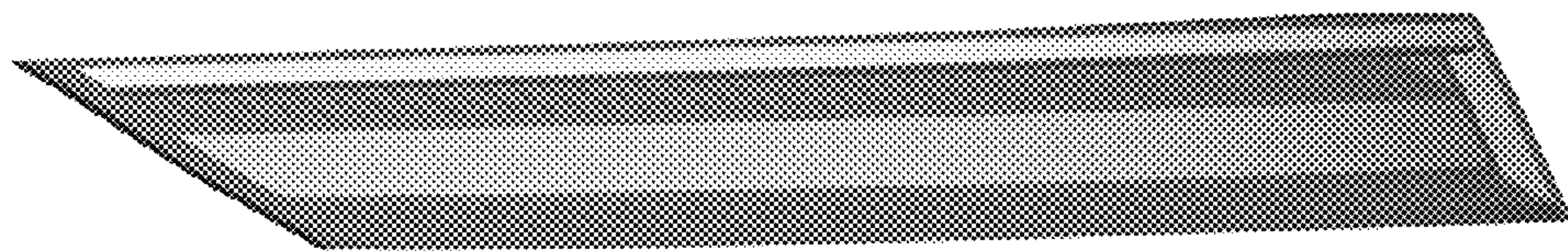

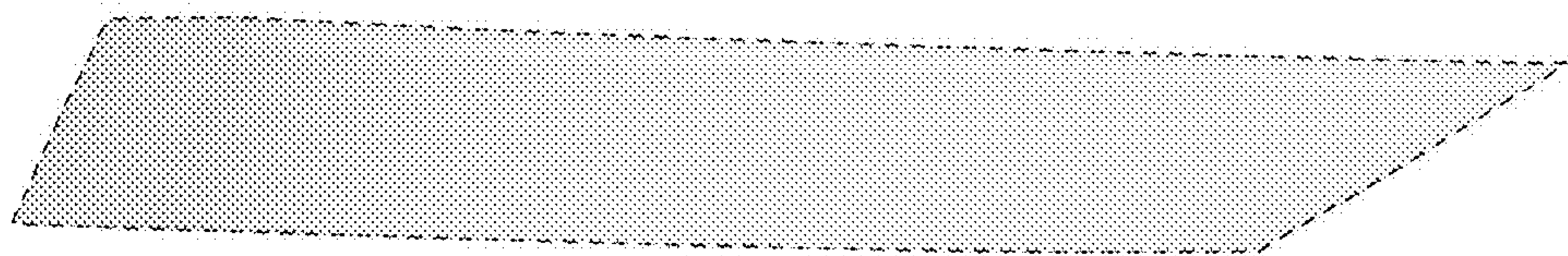

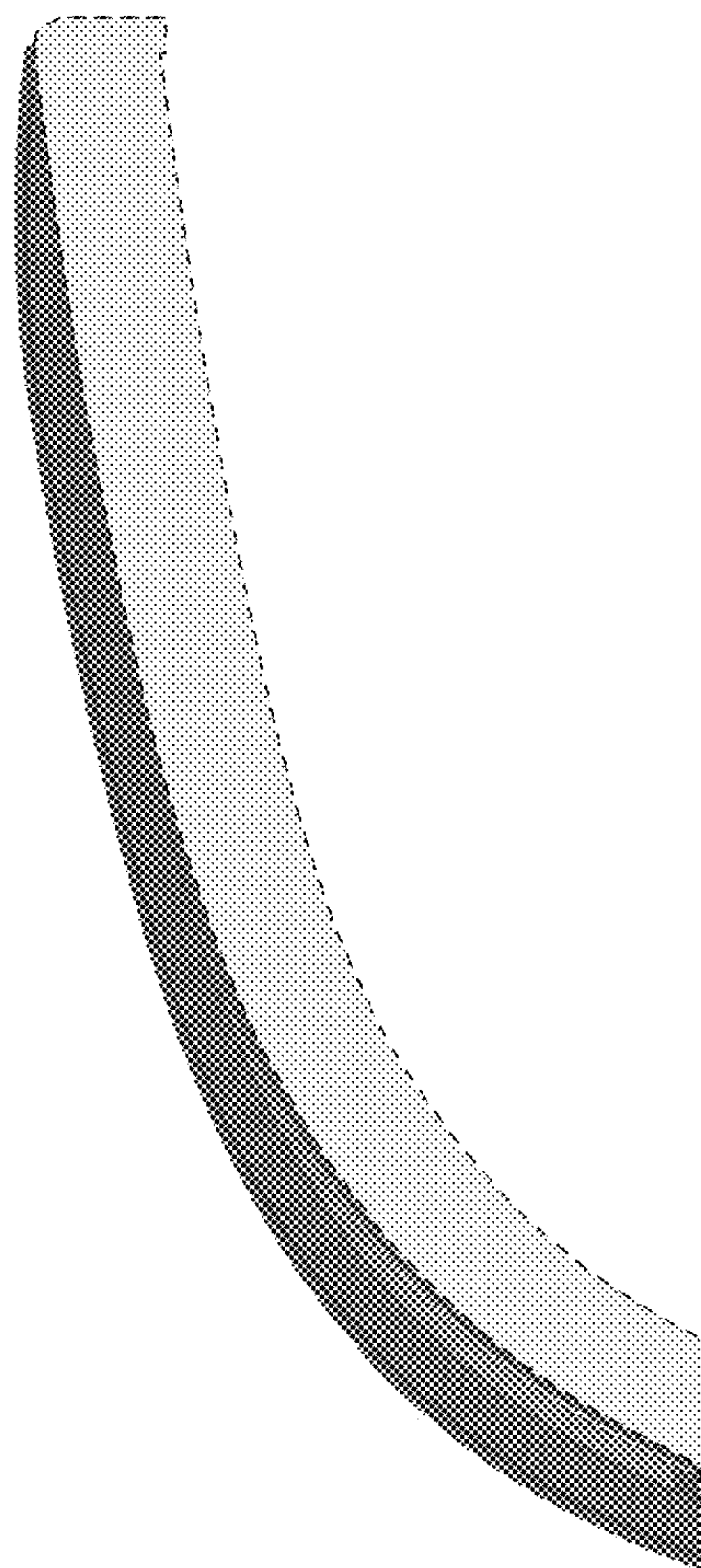
