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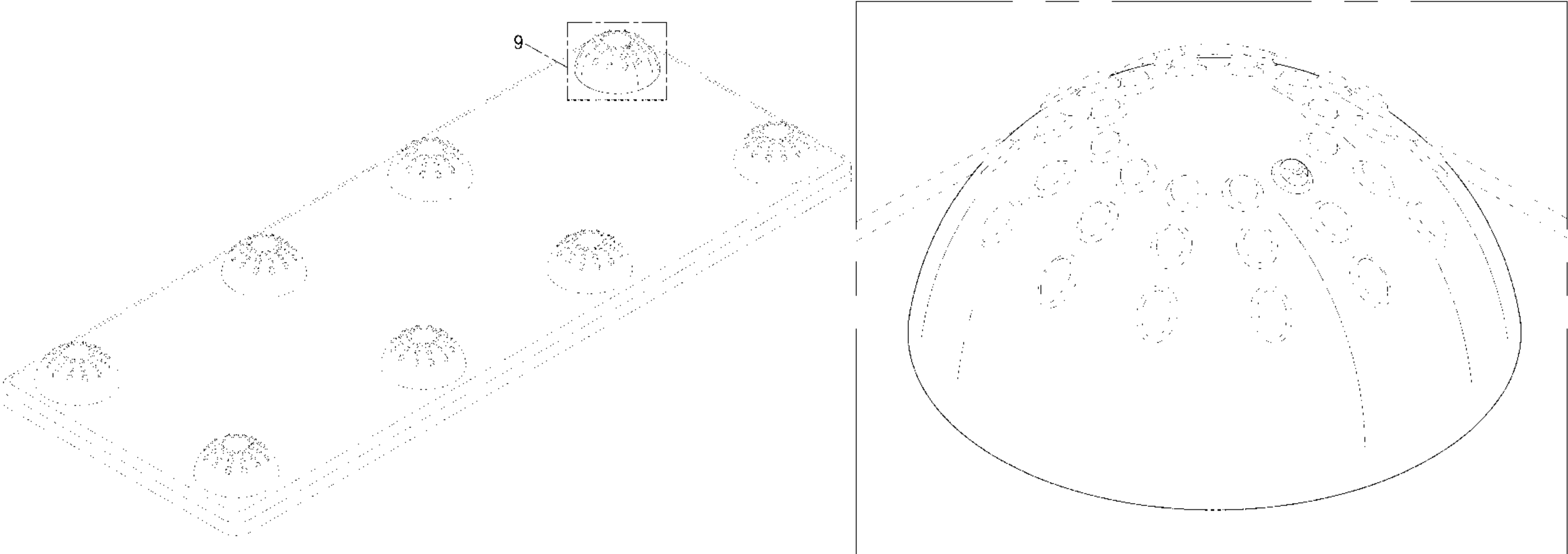
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vibration-proof platform for musical instruments as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first perspective view of a vibration-proof platform for musical instruments showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a second perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top view thereof; FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 9 is an enlarged view of area 9 in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 10 is an enlarged view of area 10 in FIG. 1. The dash broken lines illustrate portions of the vibration-proof platform for musical instruments that form no part of the claimed design. The dot-dash broken lines represent boundaries of the enlarged portions and form no part of the claimed design.

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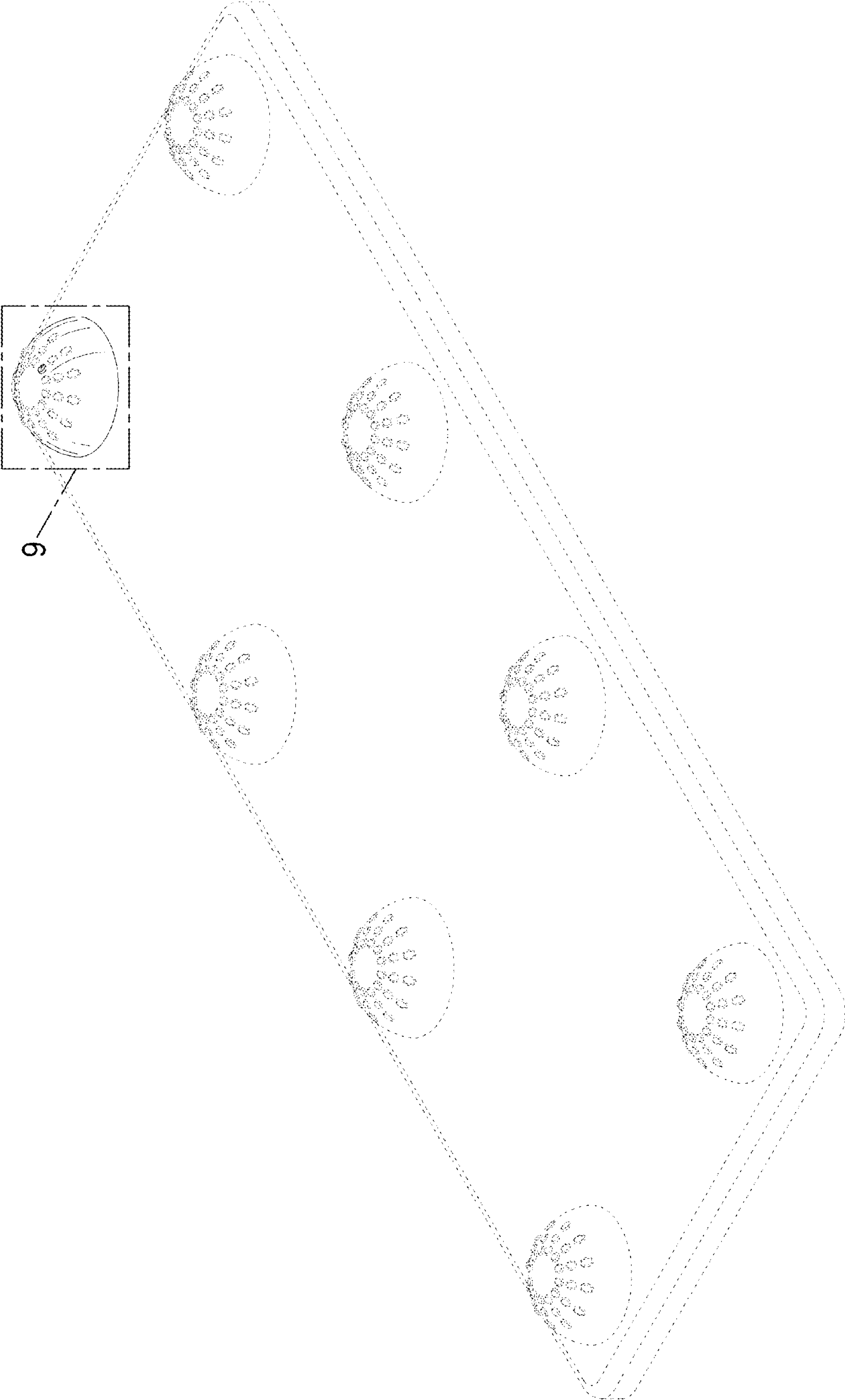

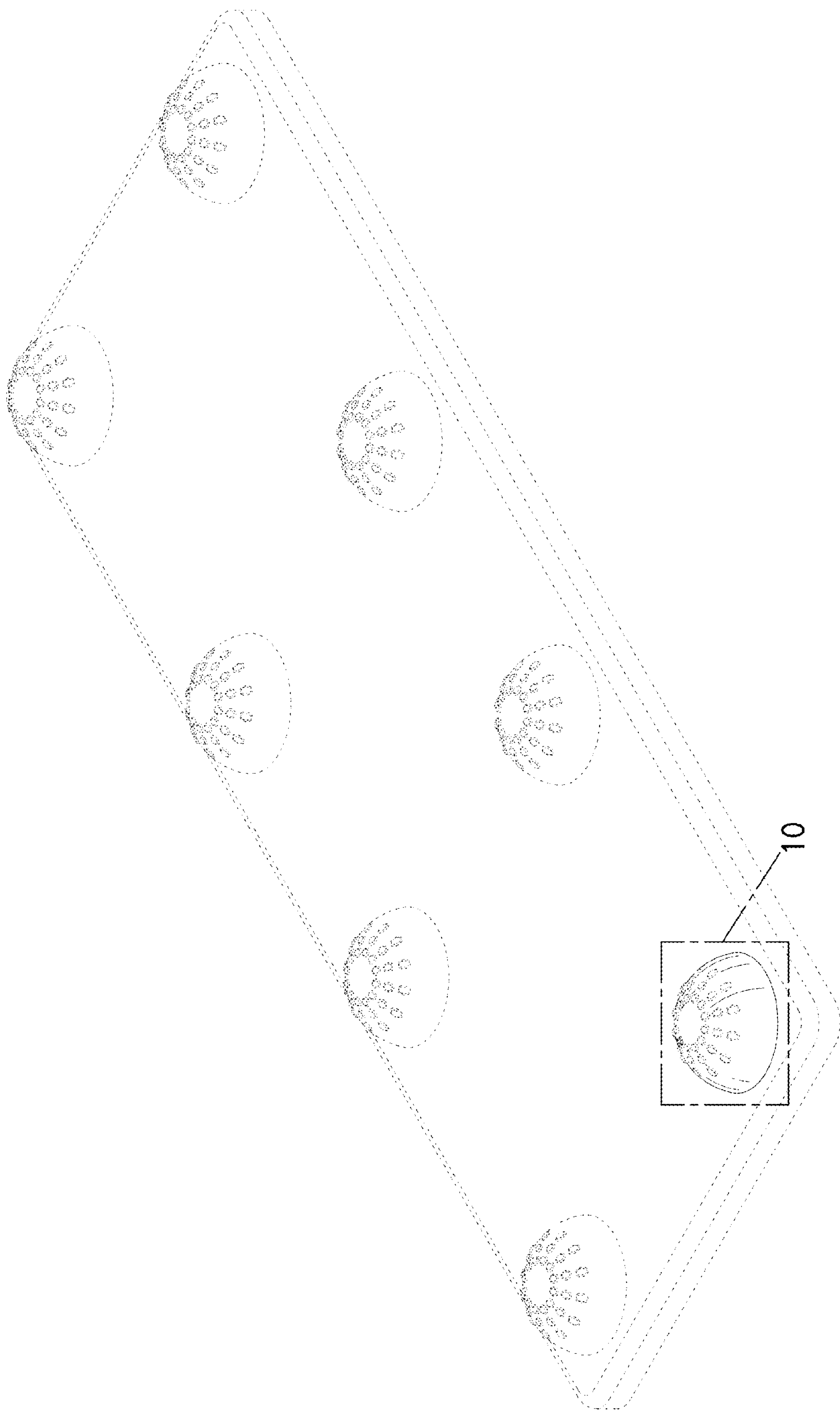

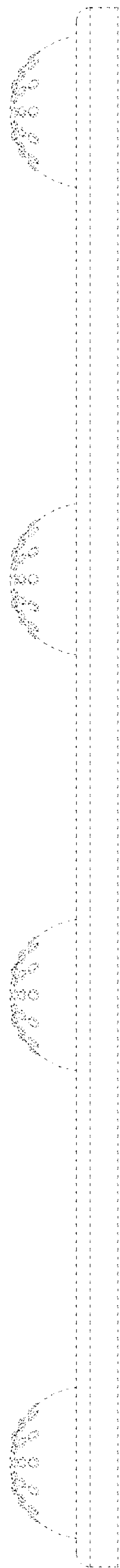

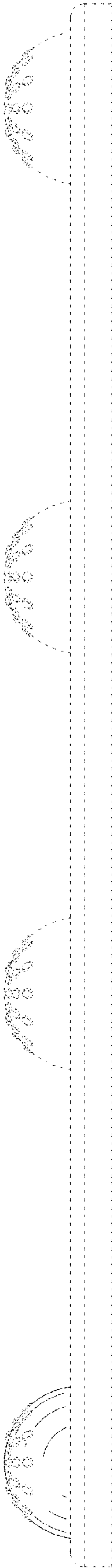

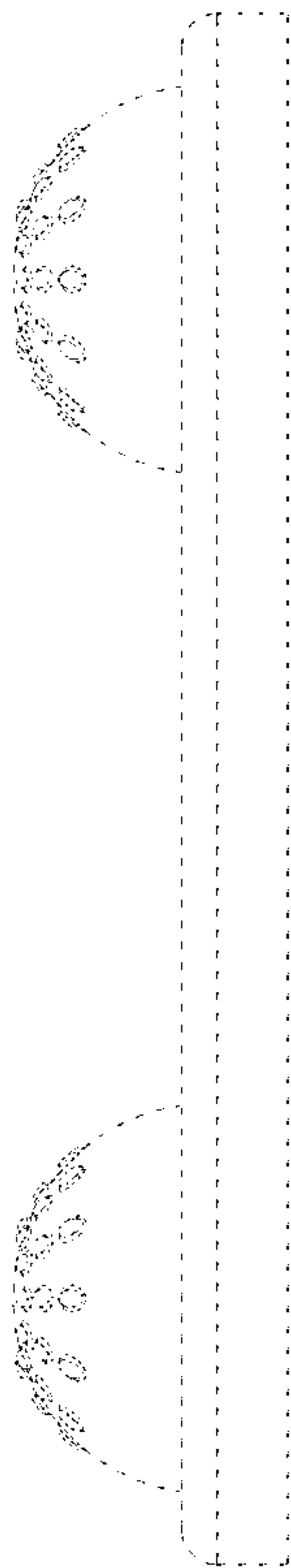

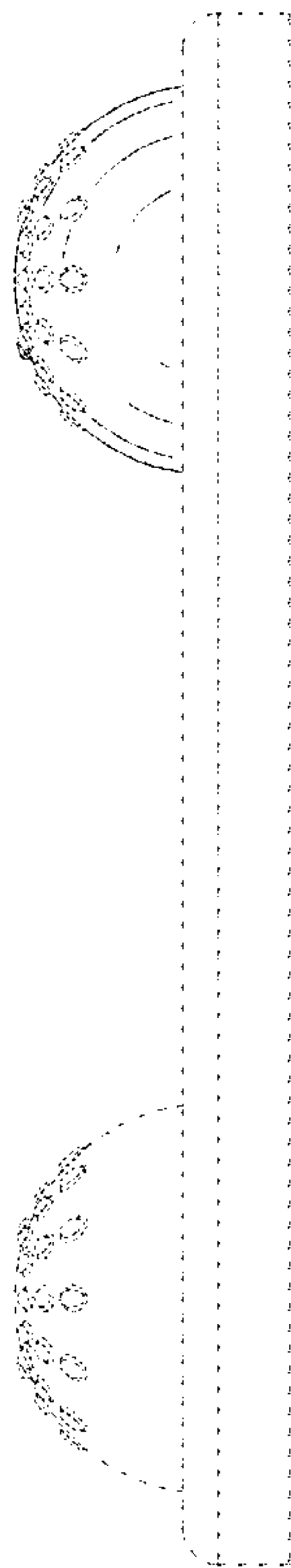

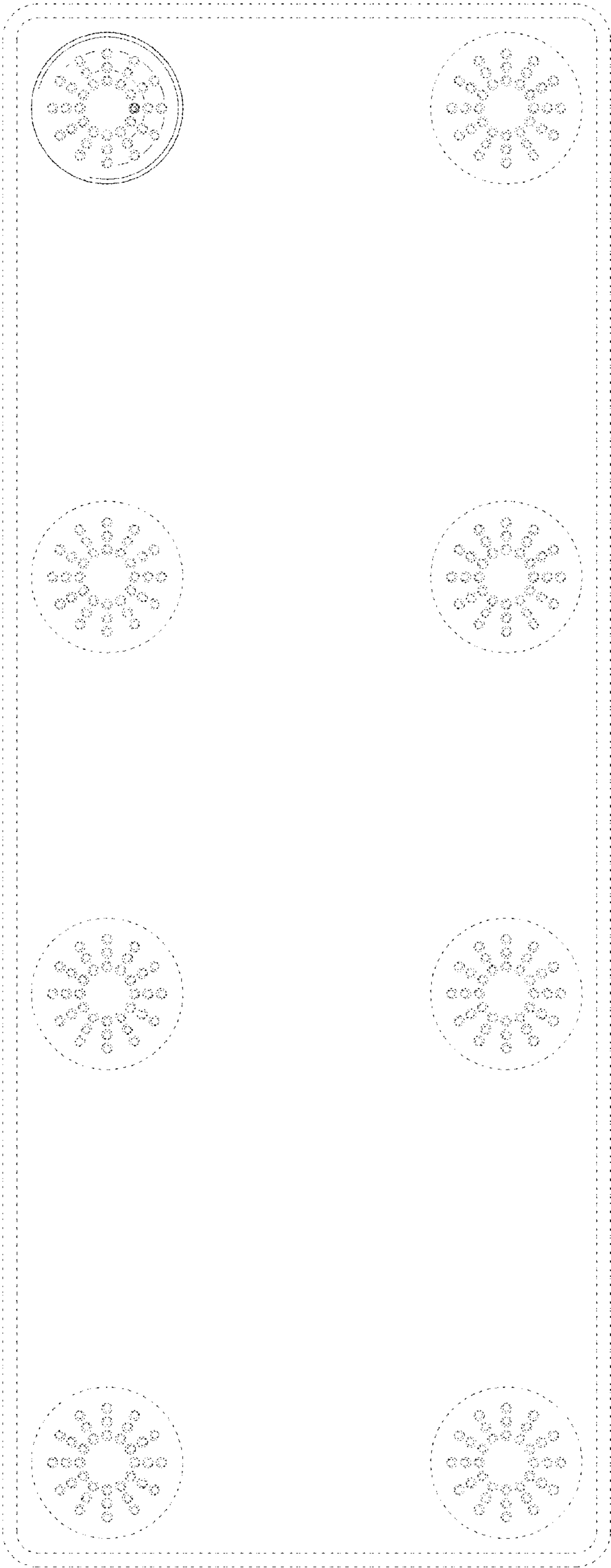

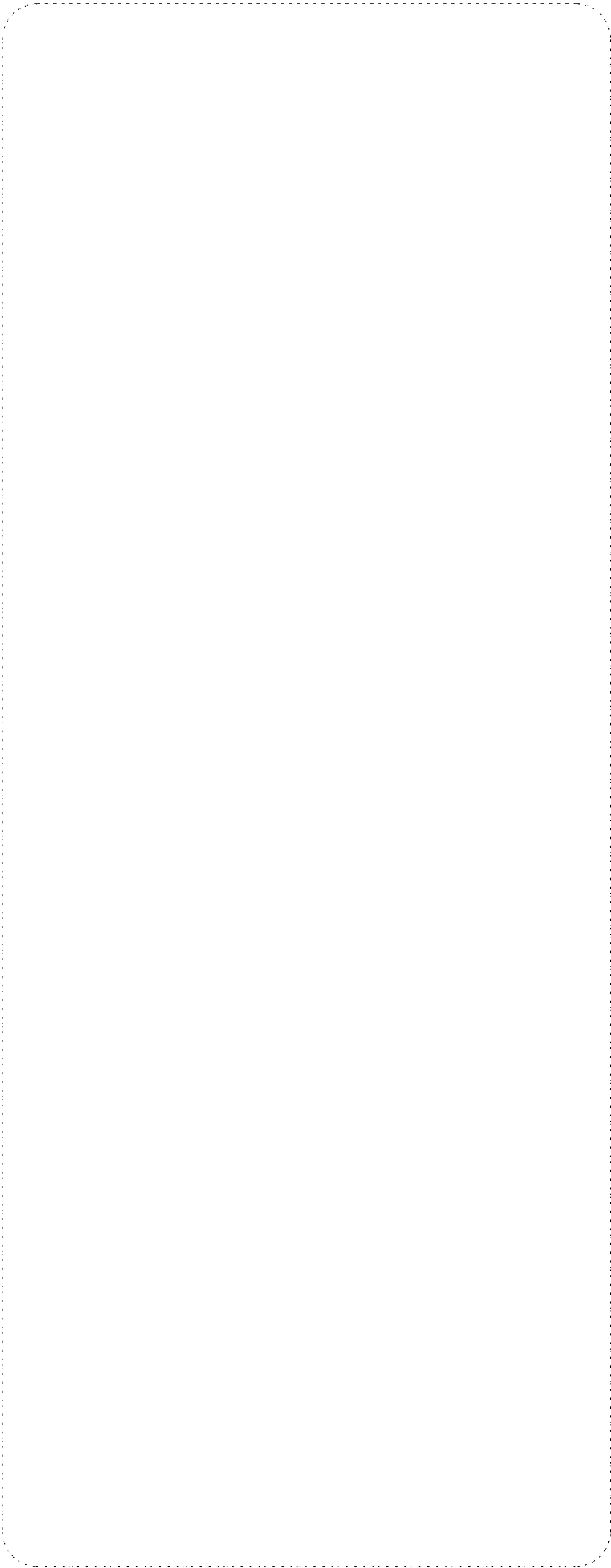

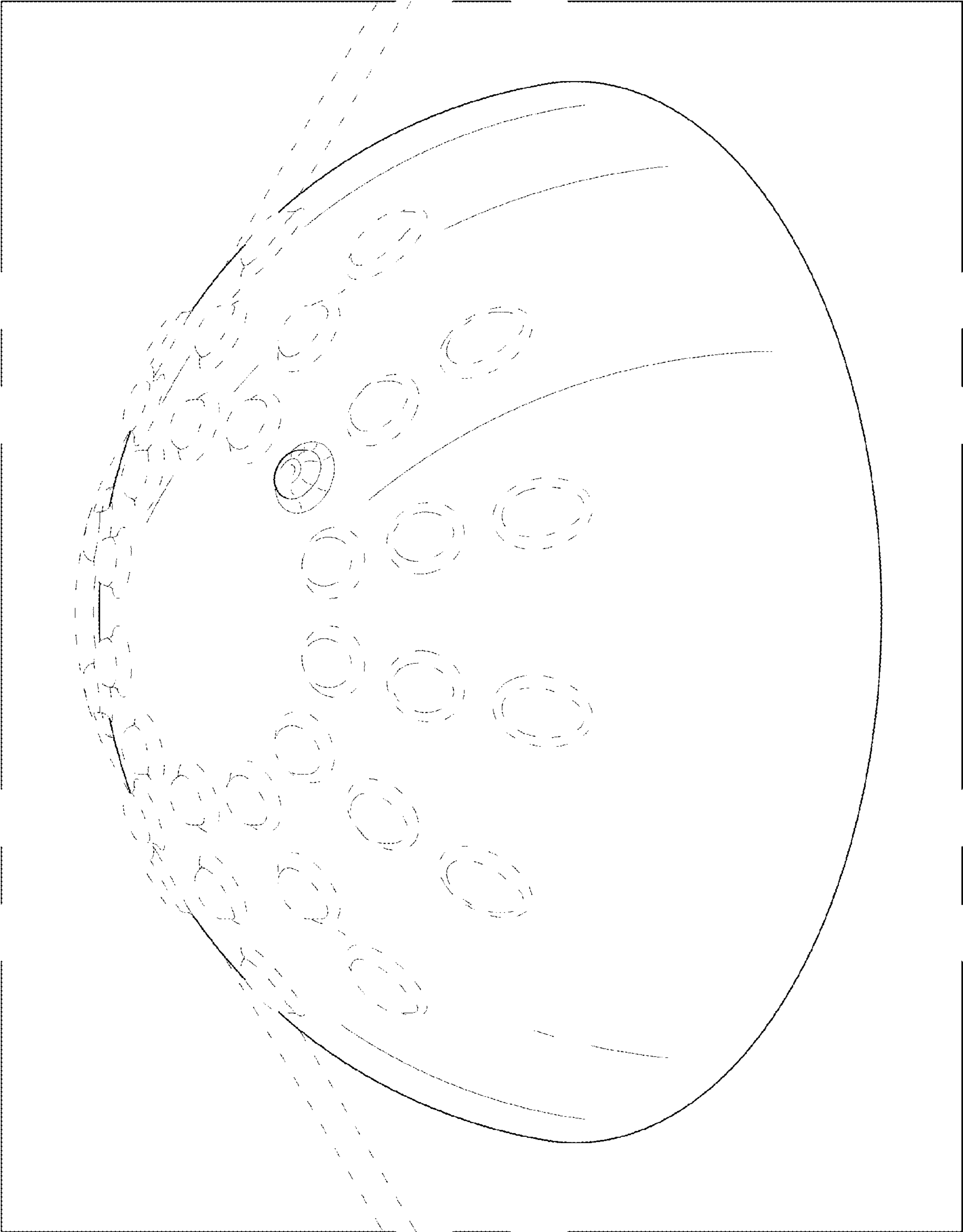

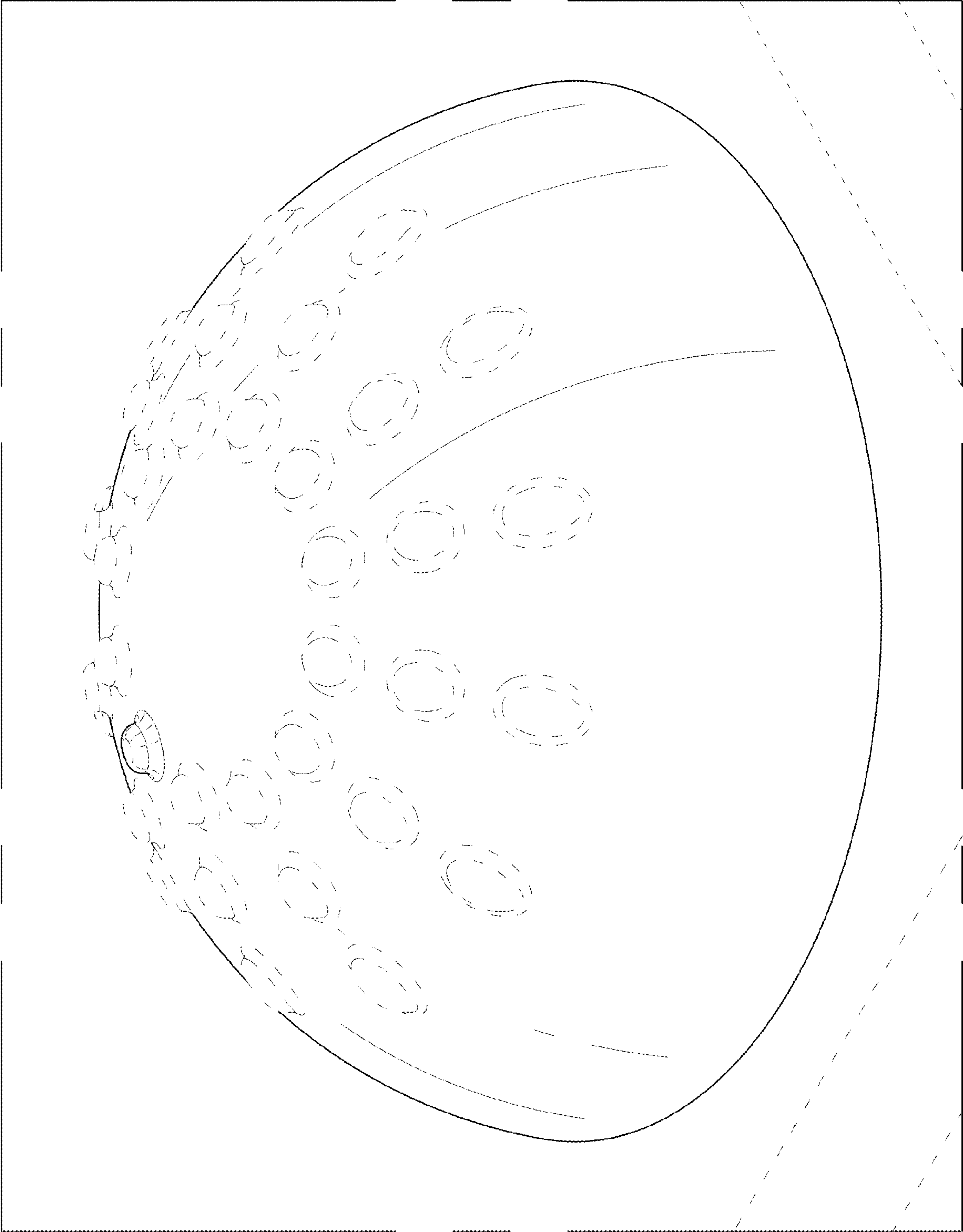
